FIG. 4 is a top view of the shoe rack design of the present invention.

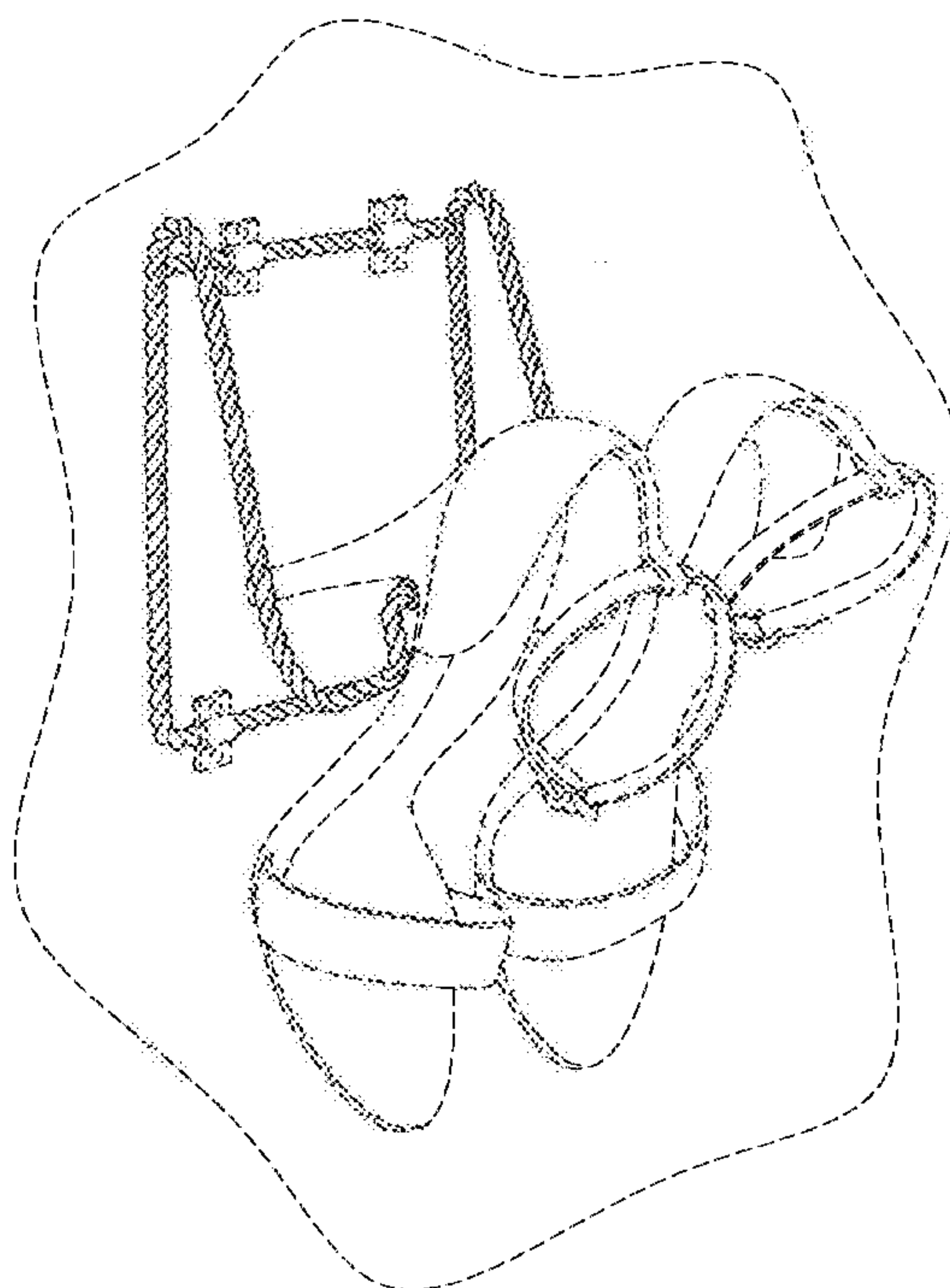
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the shoe rack design of the present invention.

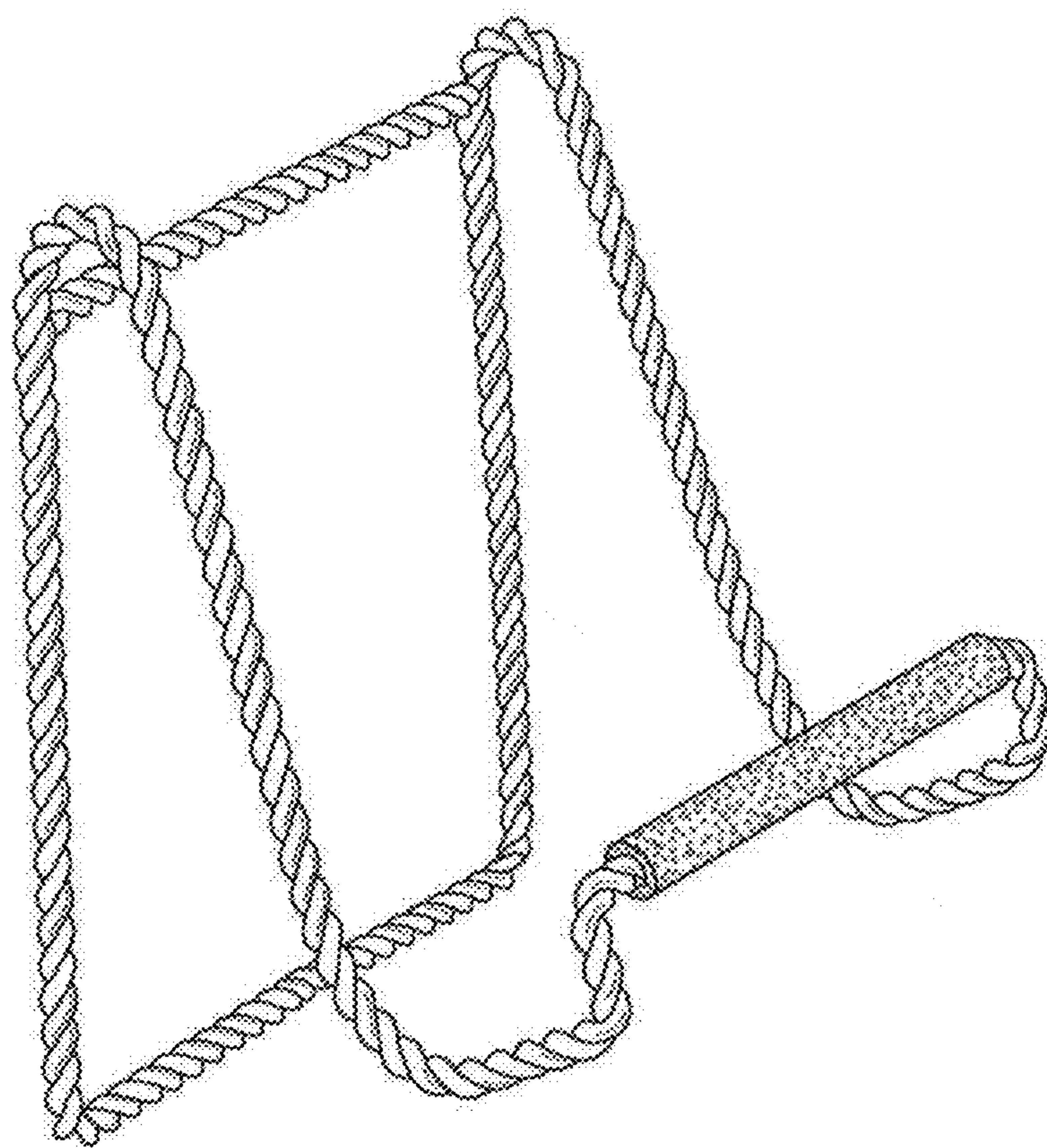

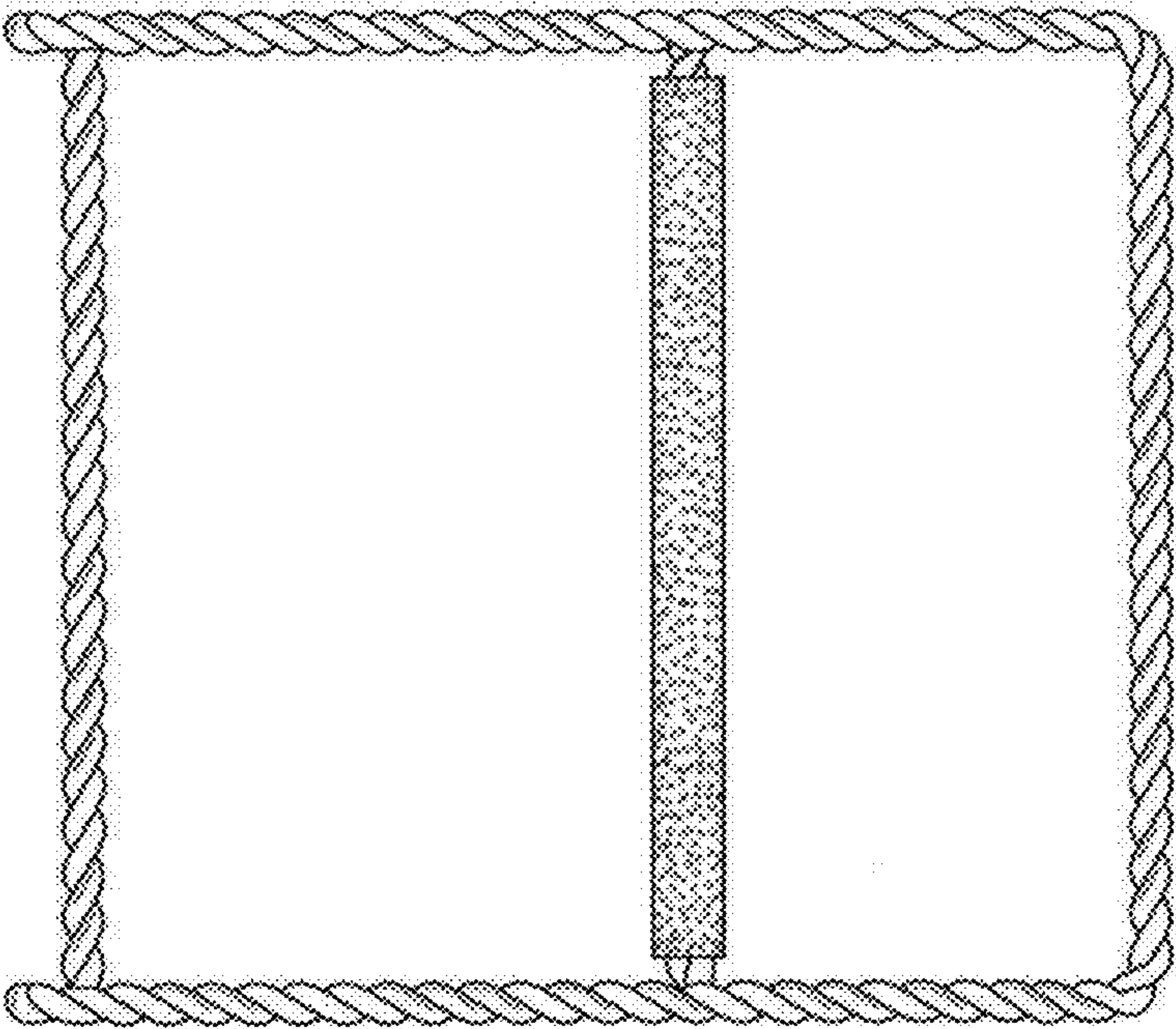

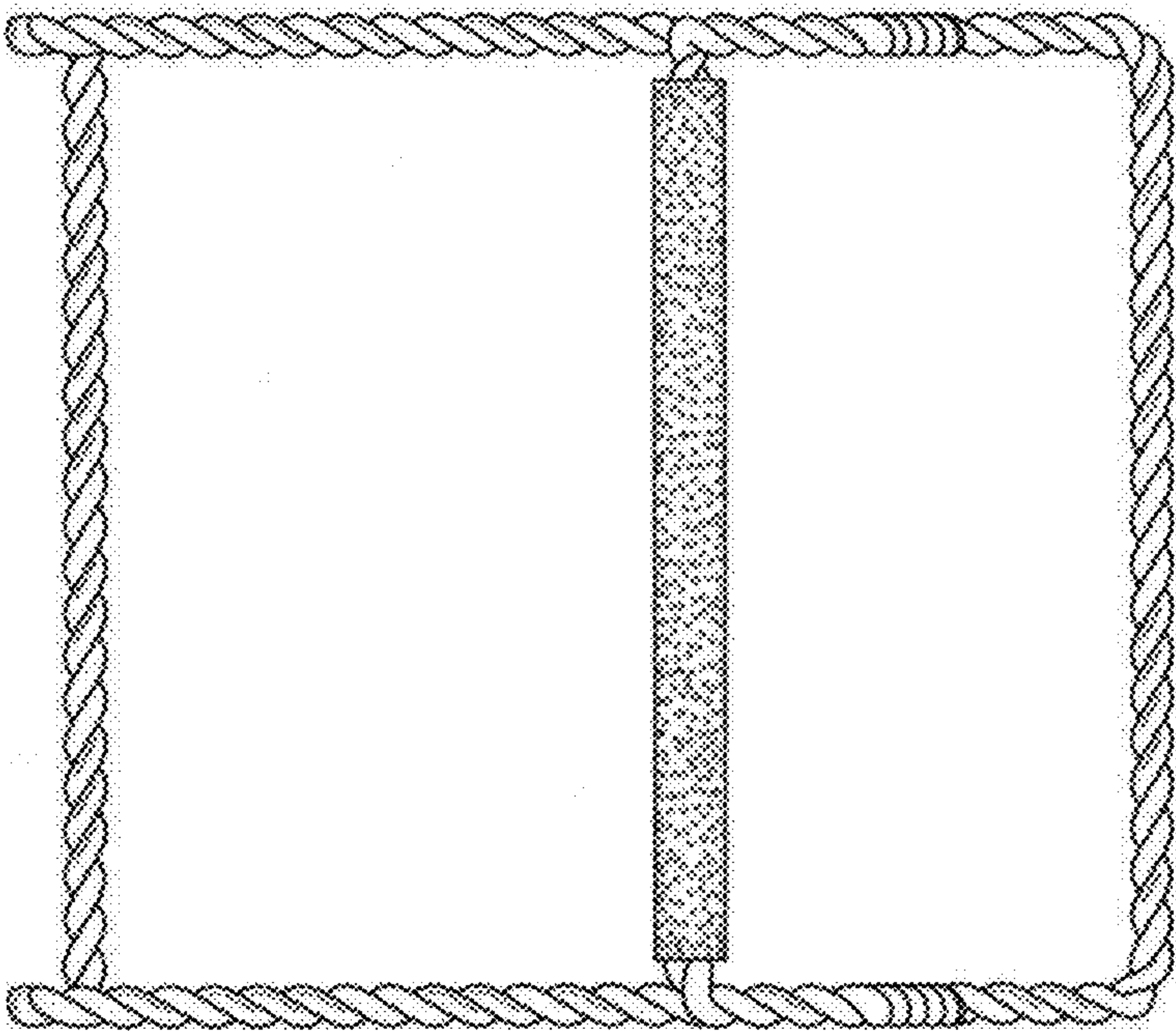

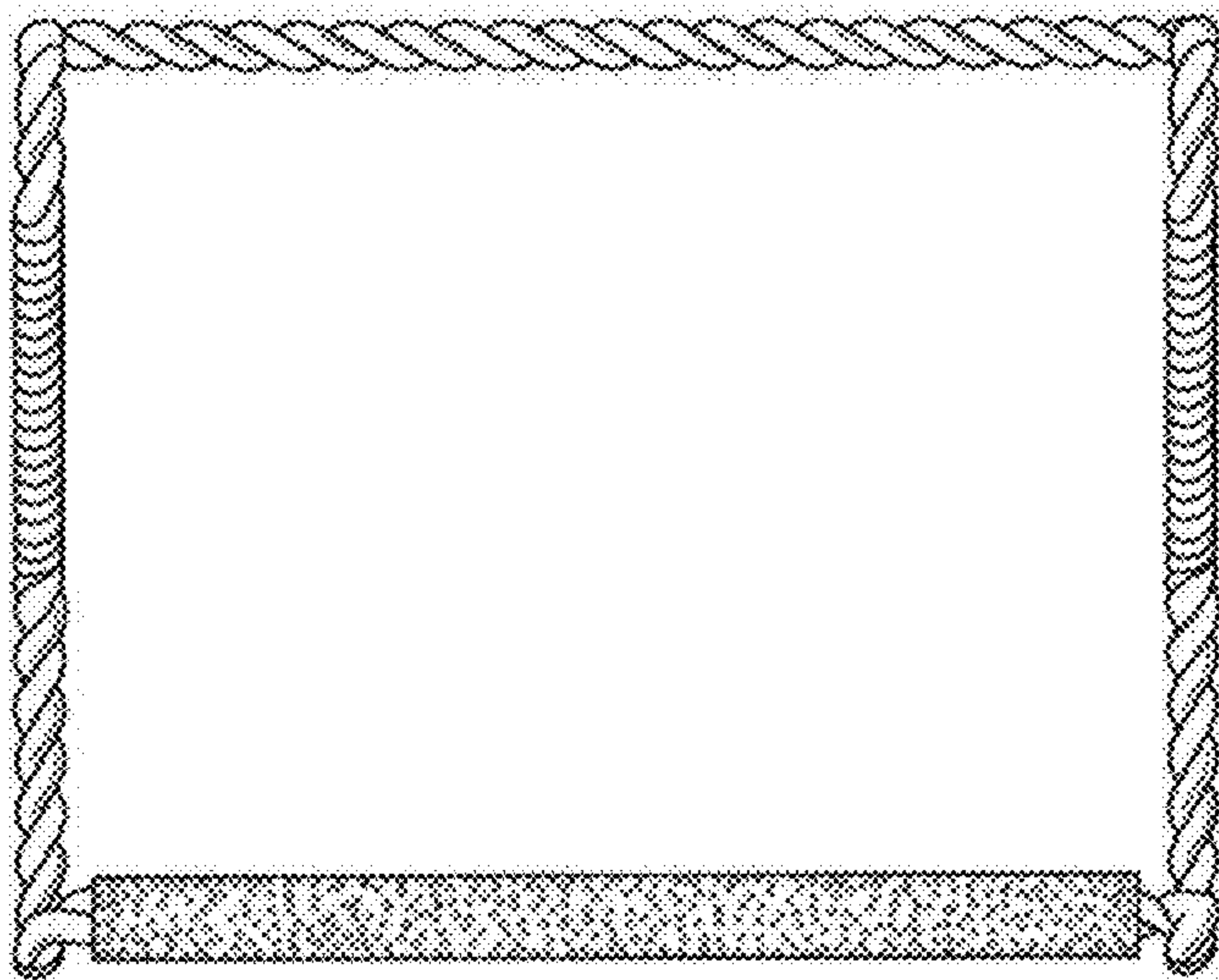

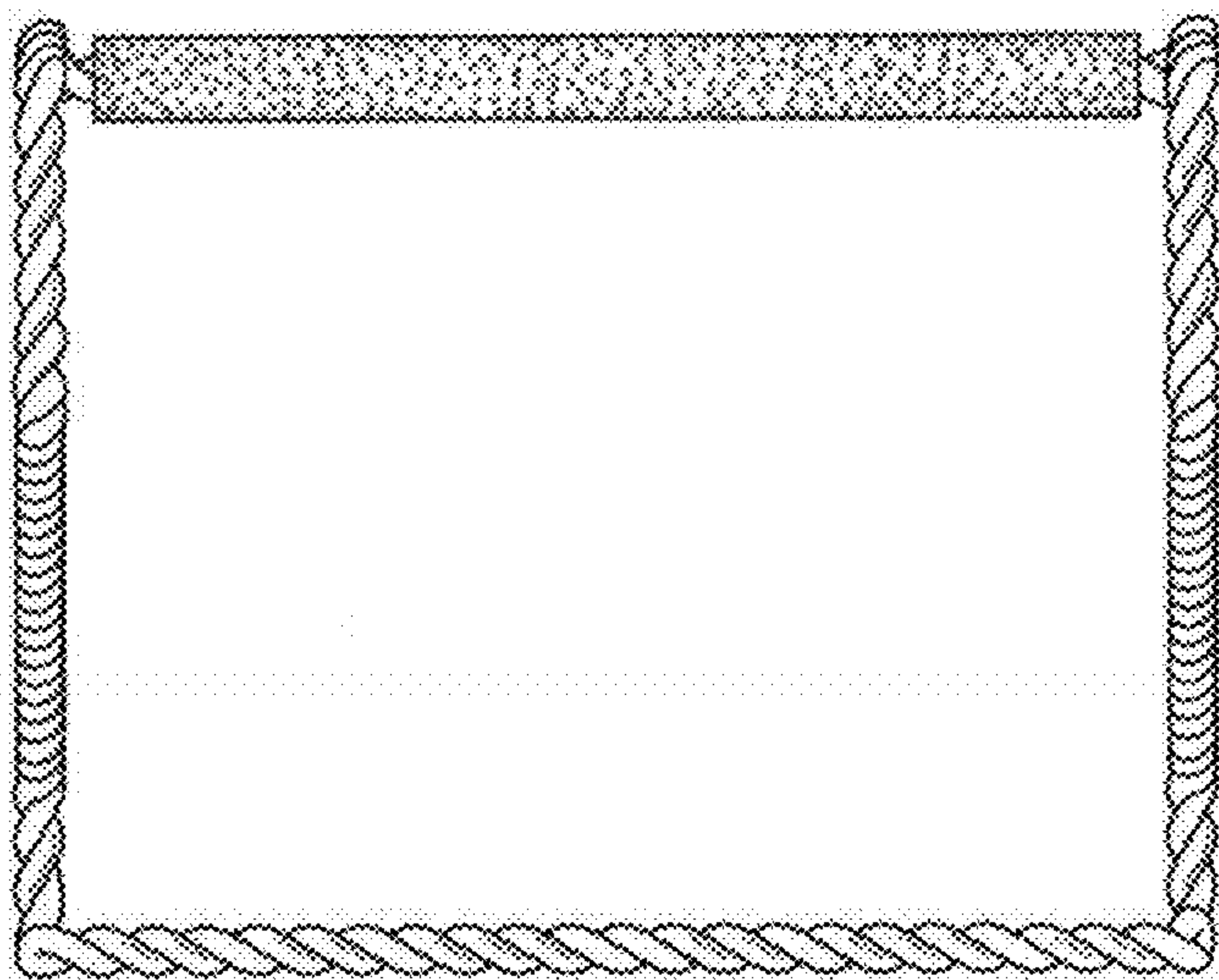

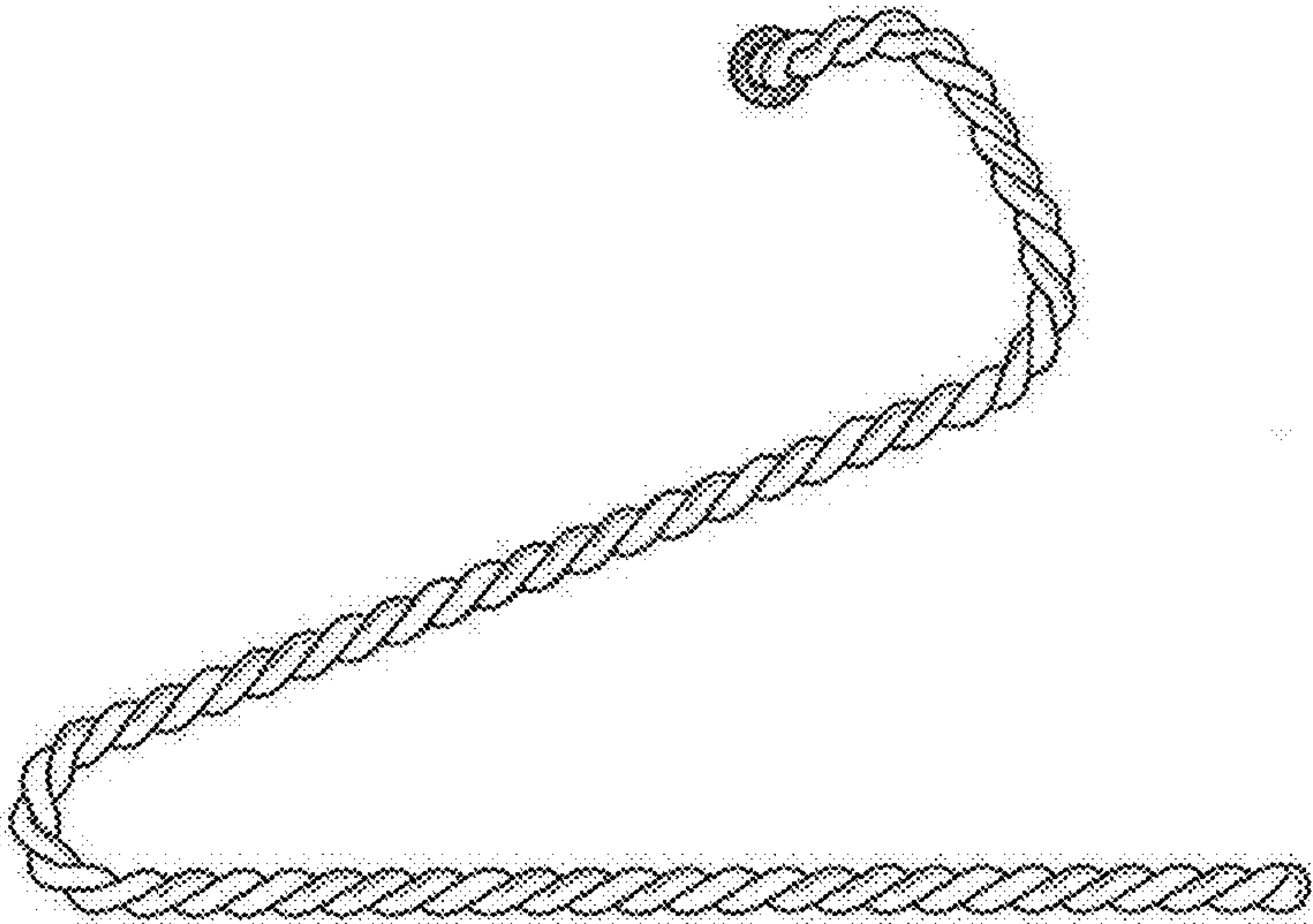

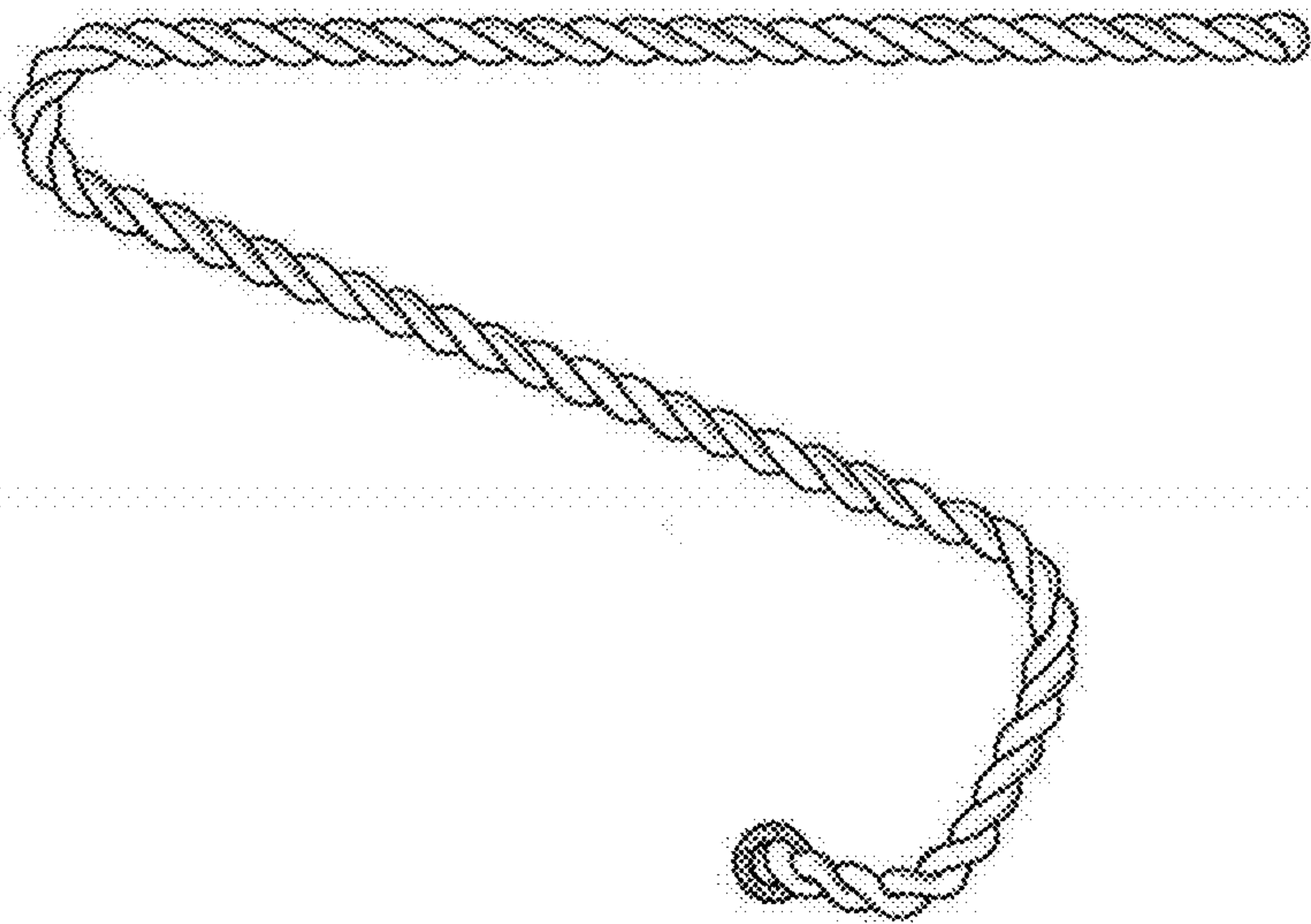

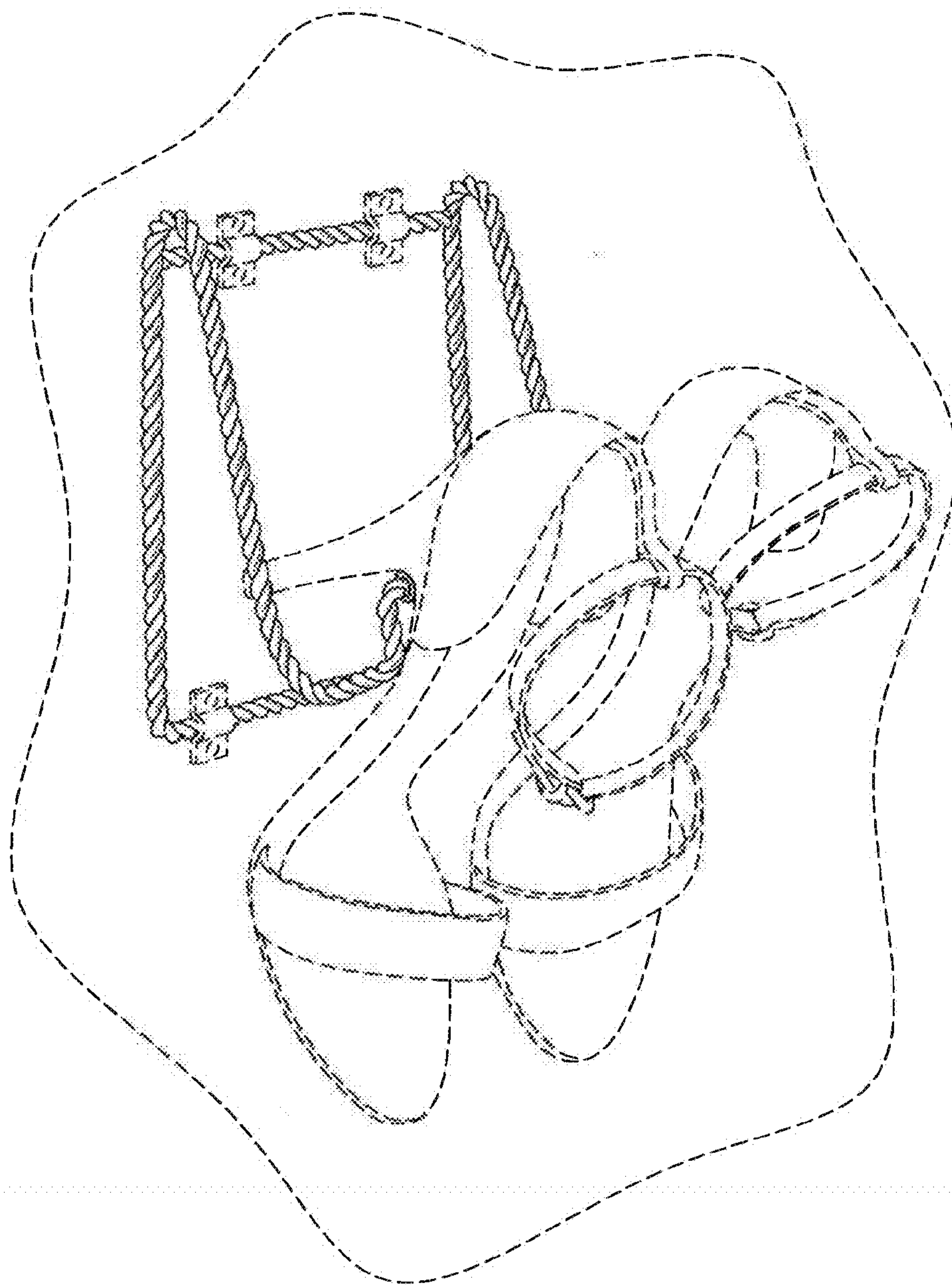
