(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an table runner with electric lamps, as shown and described.

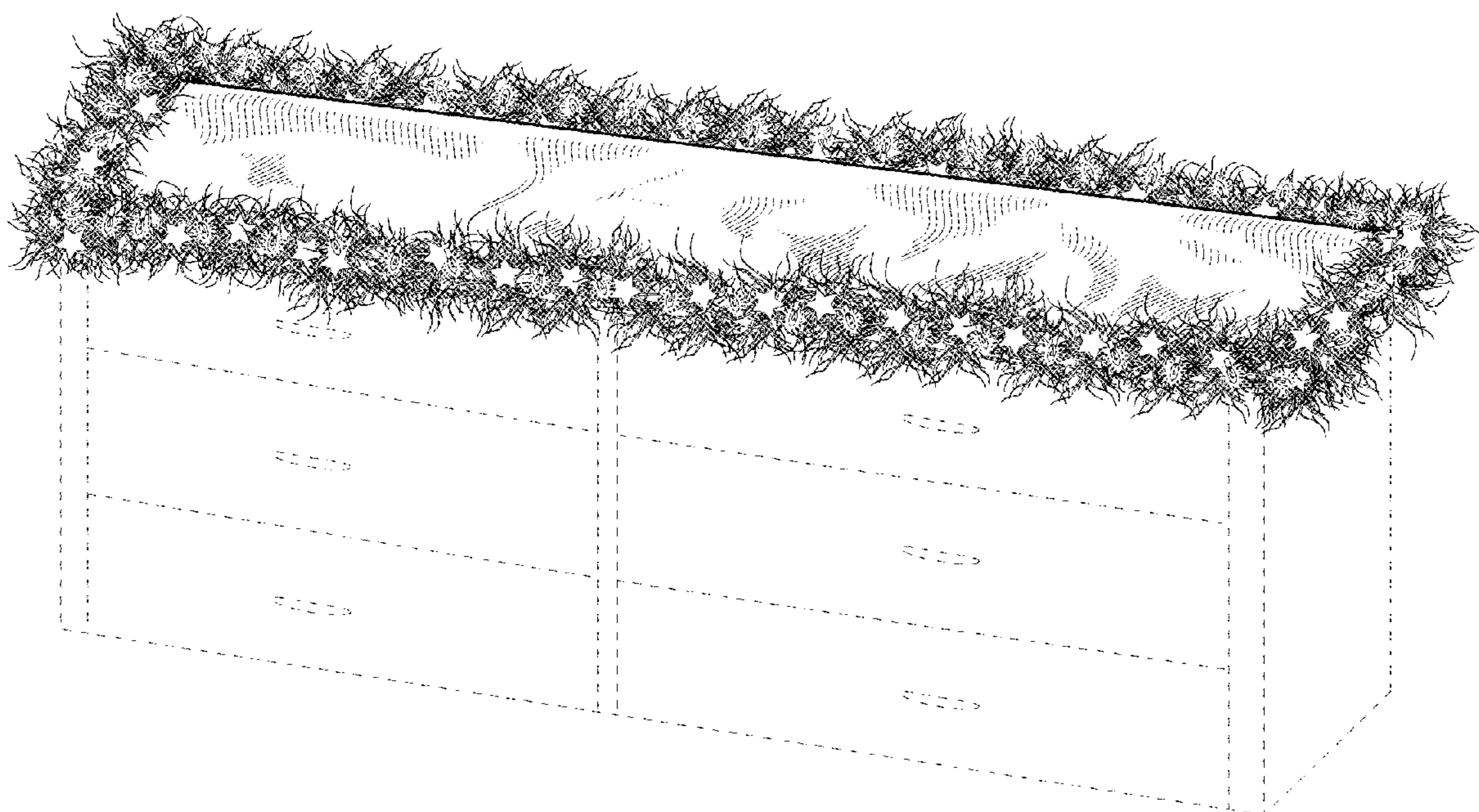
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an table runner with electric lamps, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken lines showing an article of furniture in FIG. 1 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

The table runner with electric lamps is shown with a symbolic break along the electric cord. Any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.

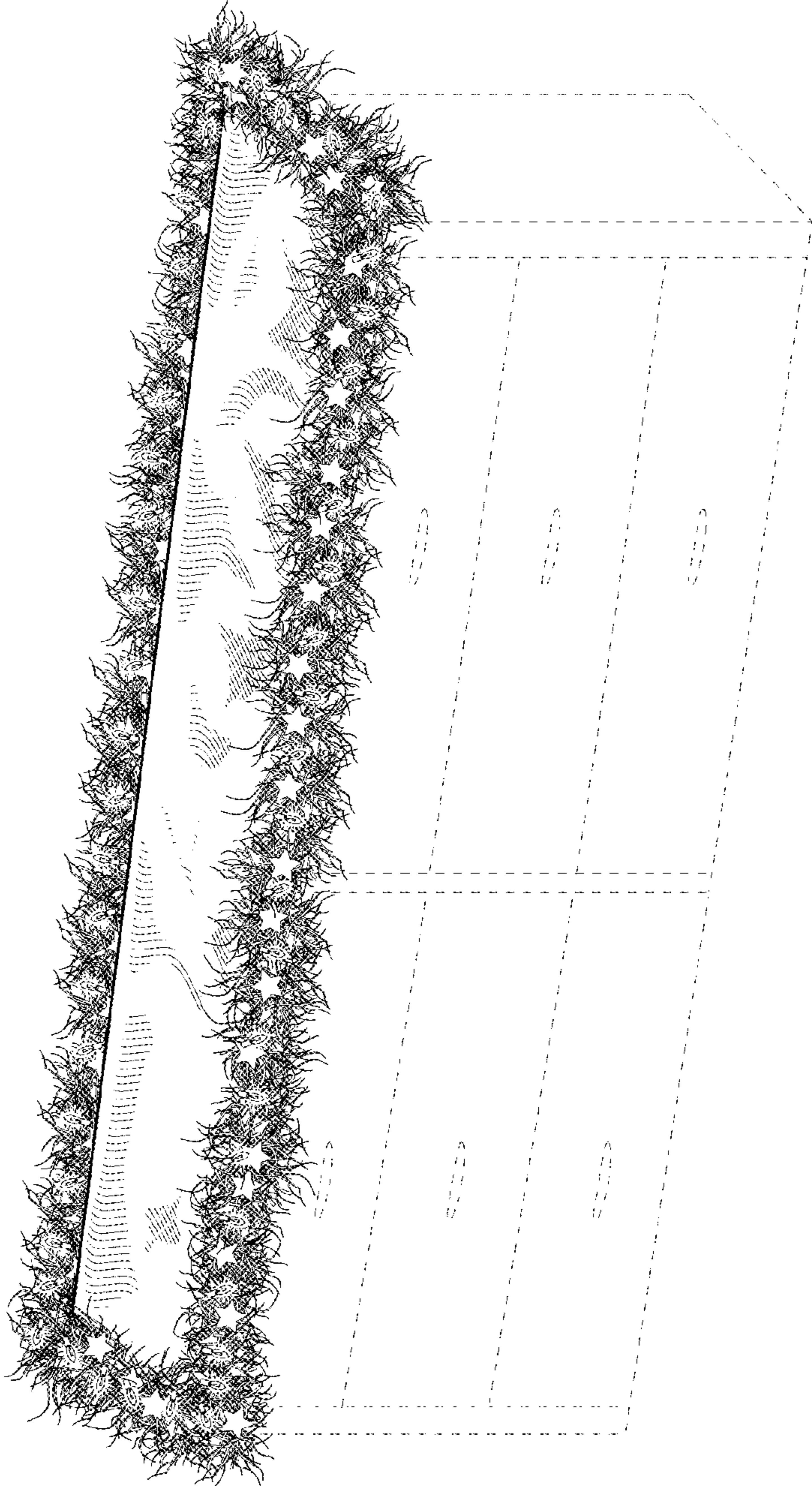

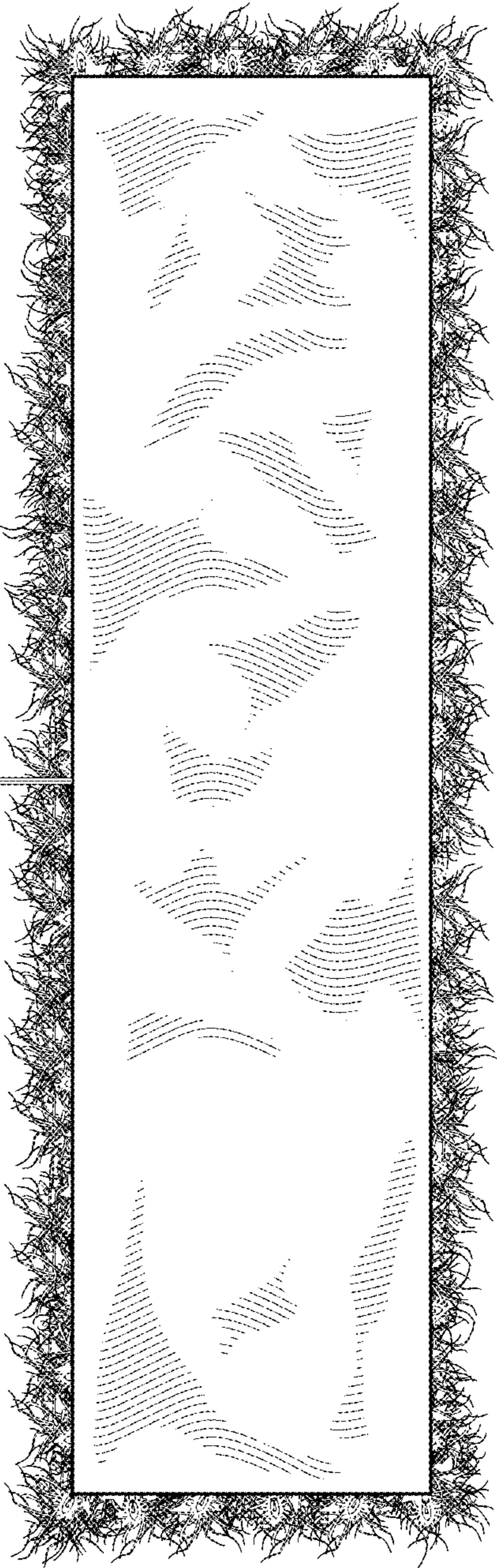
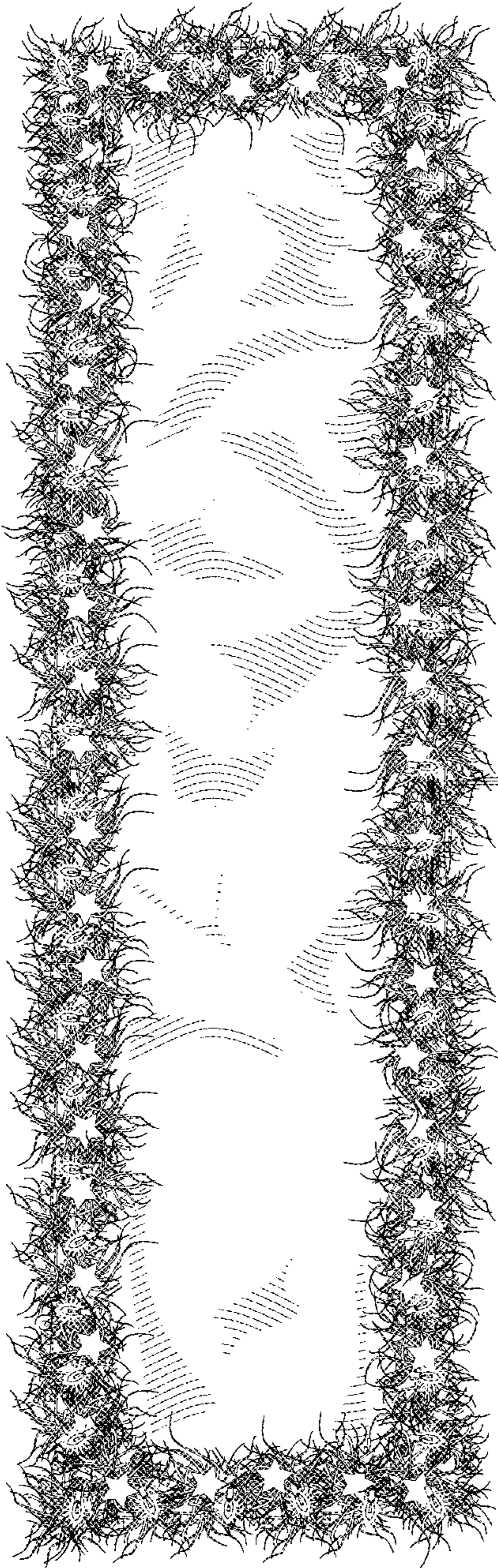

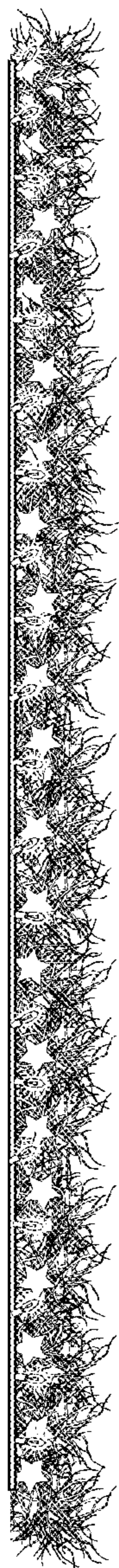
