I claim the ornamental design for a block for a garden box, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a block for a garden box of
undetermined length and having a repeating pattern along the
length, the garden box including my new design.

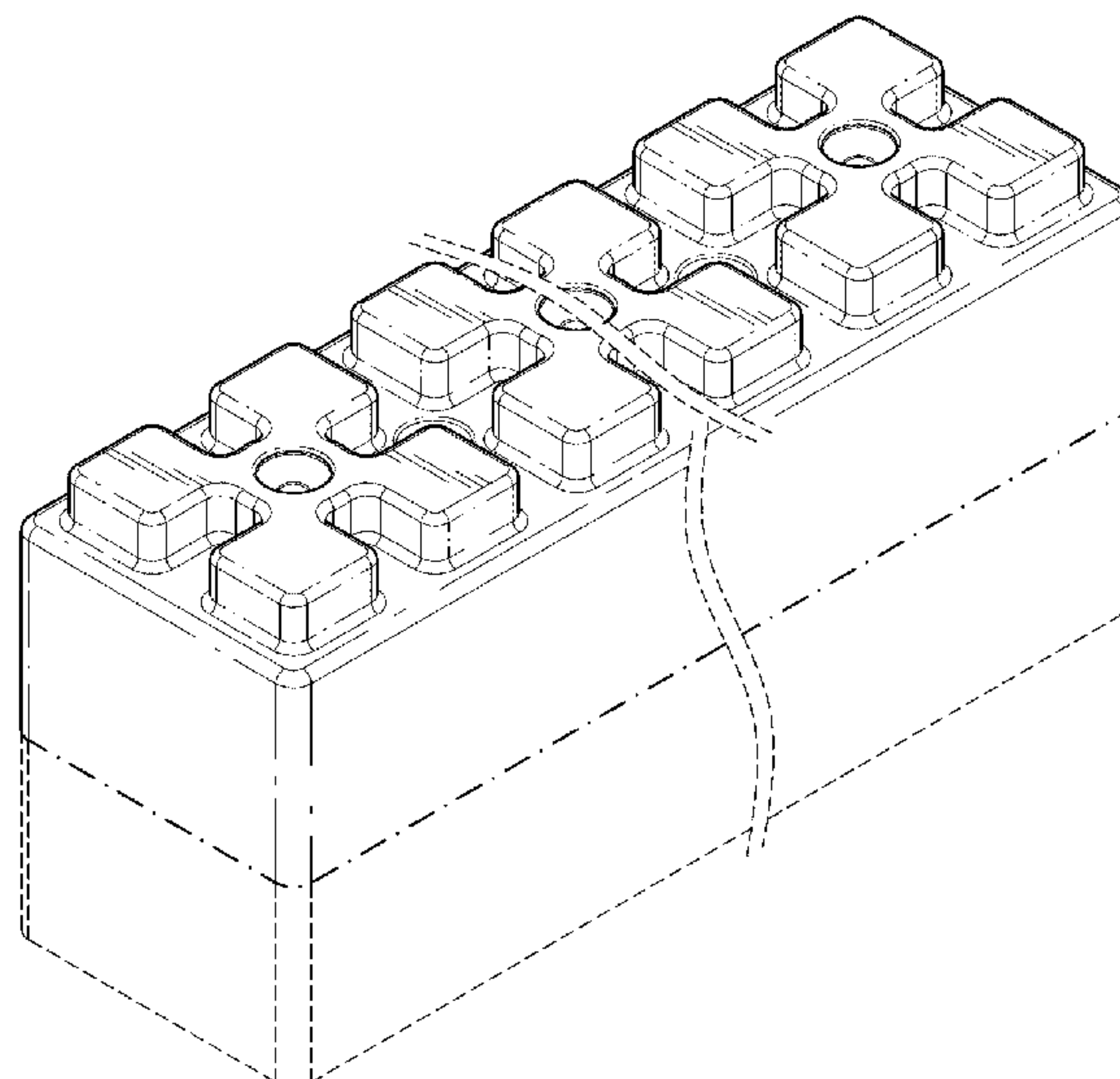
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the block for a garden box.

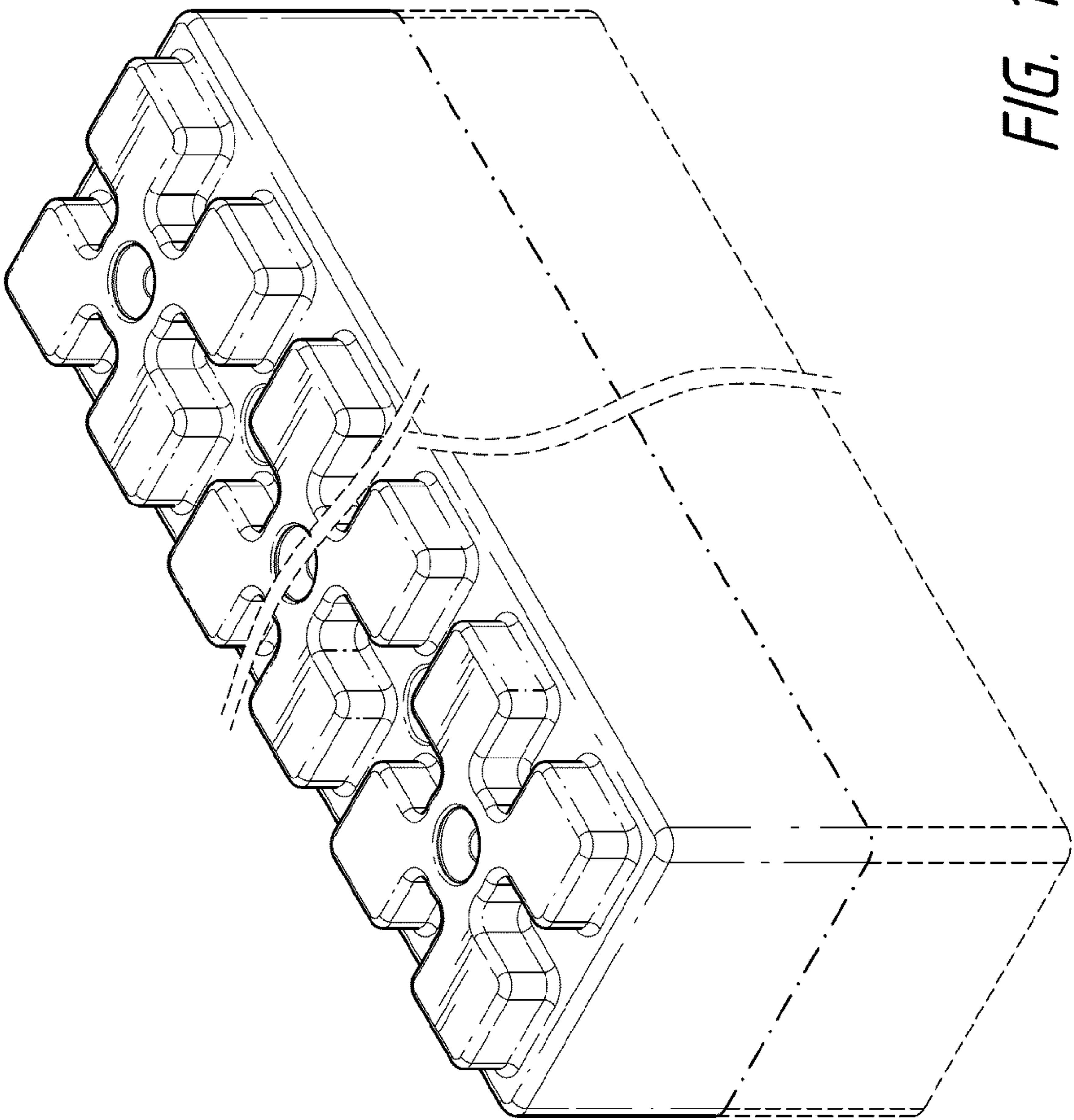
FIG. 3 is a front view of the block for a garden box, the back
view being a mirror image of the front view; and,

FIG. 4 is a first side view of the block for a garden box, the
second side view being a mirror image of the first side view.

the bounds of the claim, and all other broken lines are
included to for the purpose of illustrating the unclaimed por-
tions of the block. None of the broken lines form a part of the
claimed design.

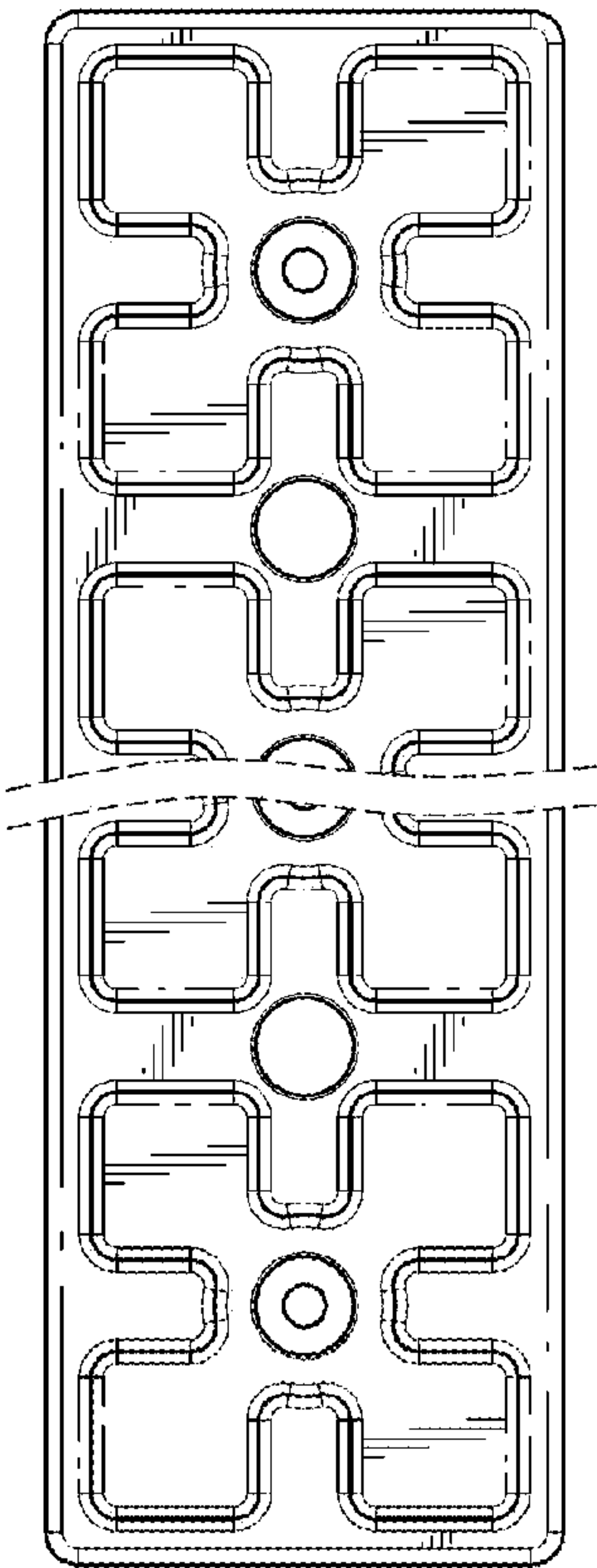

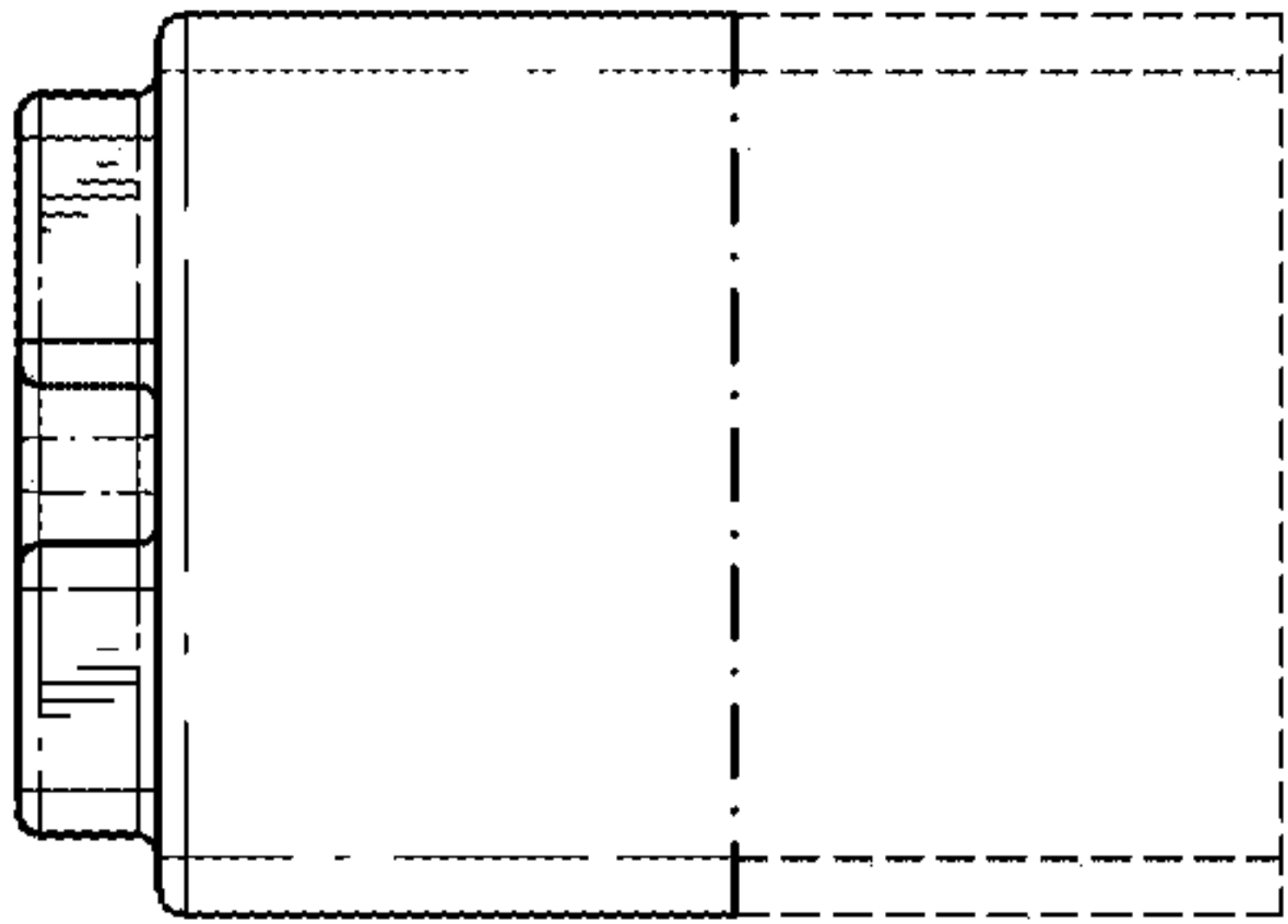

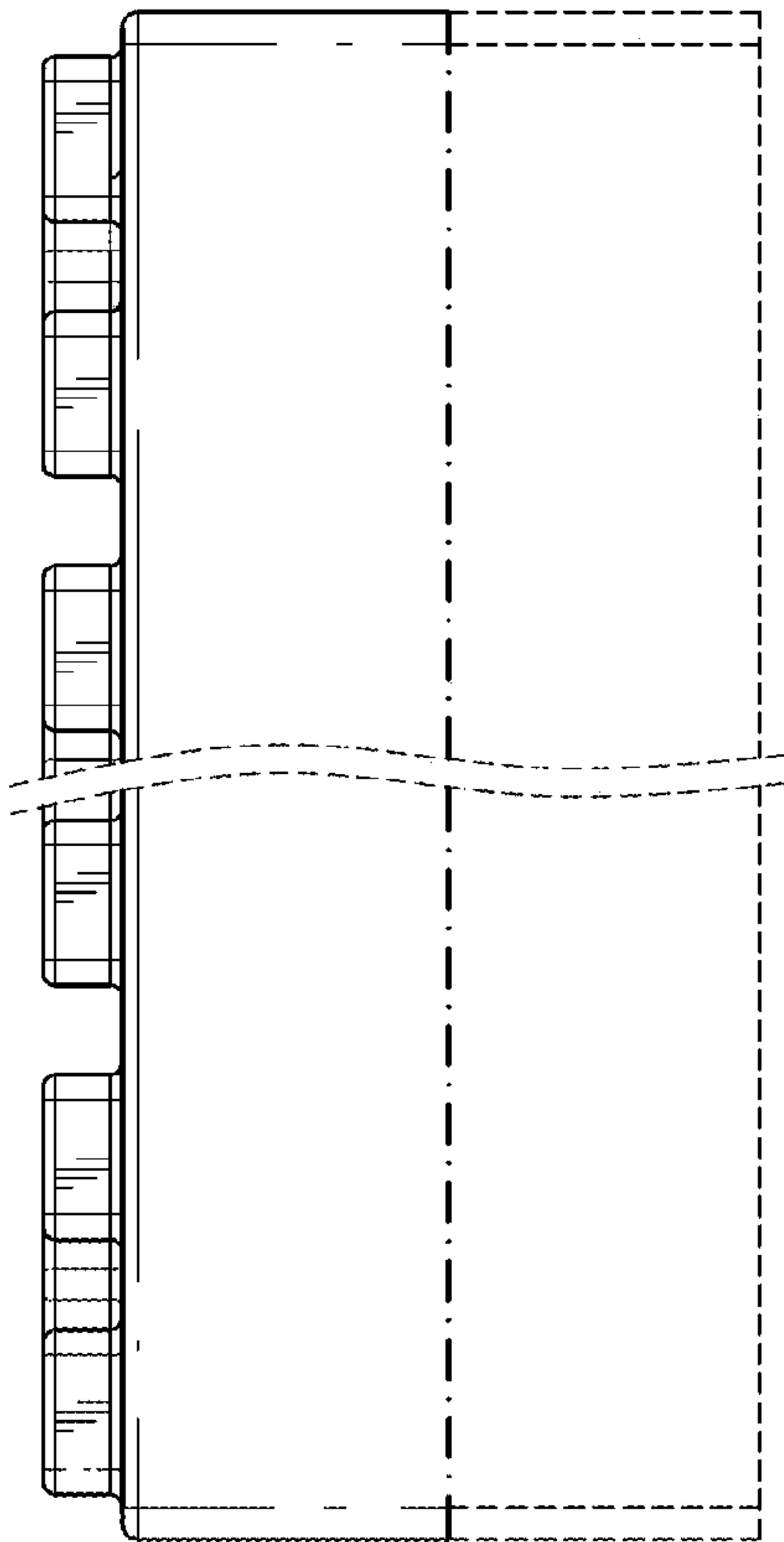
