The ornamental design for a mat with pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a mat with pillow according to one embodiment;


FIG. 2 is a left side view of the mat with pillow illustrated in FIG. 1, the right side view being a mirror image of the left side view;






