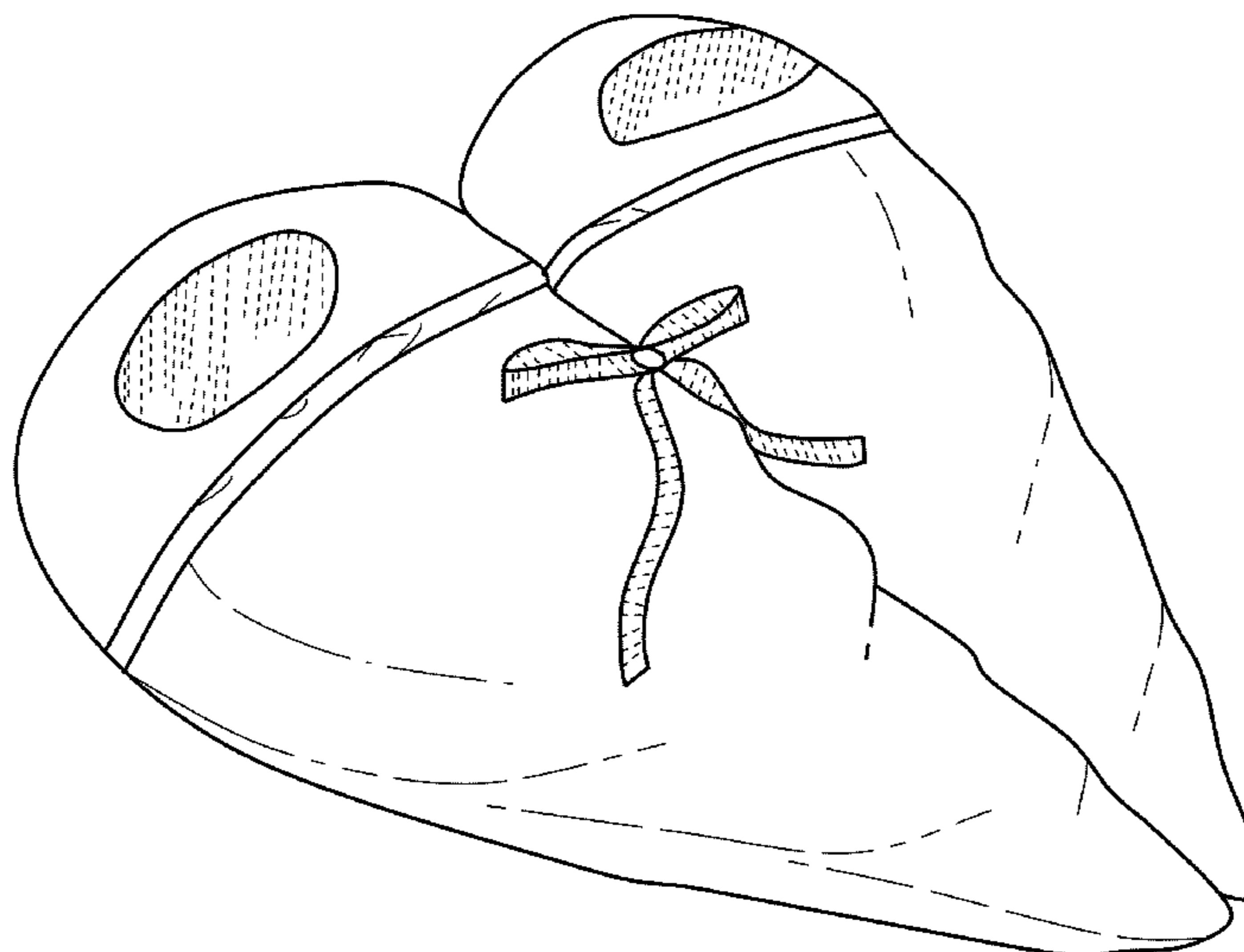
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a “a piece of me” exchange heart pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view for a “a piece of me” exchange heart pillow showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front side view with the ribbons tied thereof; FIG. 3 is a back side view with the ribbons tied thereof; FIG. 4 is a front side view with the ribbons untied and the heart halves slightly separated thereof; FIG. 5 is a back side view with the ribbons untied and the heart halves slightly separated thereof; FIG. 6 is a top side view with the ribbons tied thereof; FIG. 7 is a bottom side view with the ribbons tied thereof; FIG. 8 is a left side view with the ribbons tied, the right side view being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 9 is a sectional view cut through section 9-9 of FIG. 5. The ribbons shown in FIGS. 1-7 and 9 are shown in various tied conditions and may flexibly lay in different orientations. The broken lines in FIGS. 1-9 depict environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design.

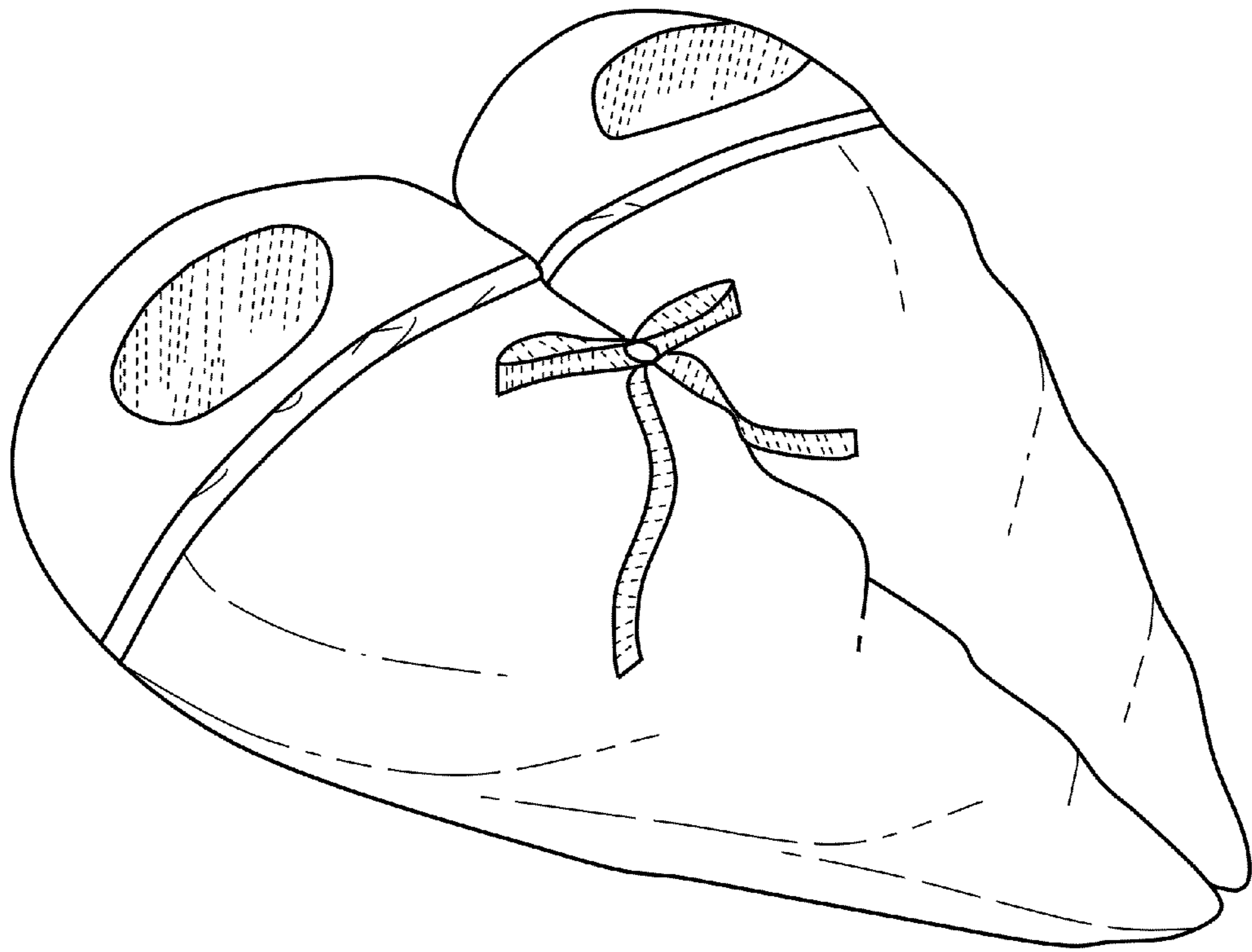

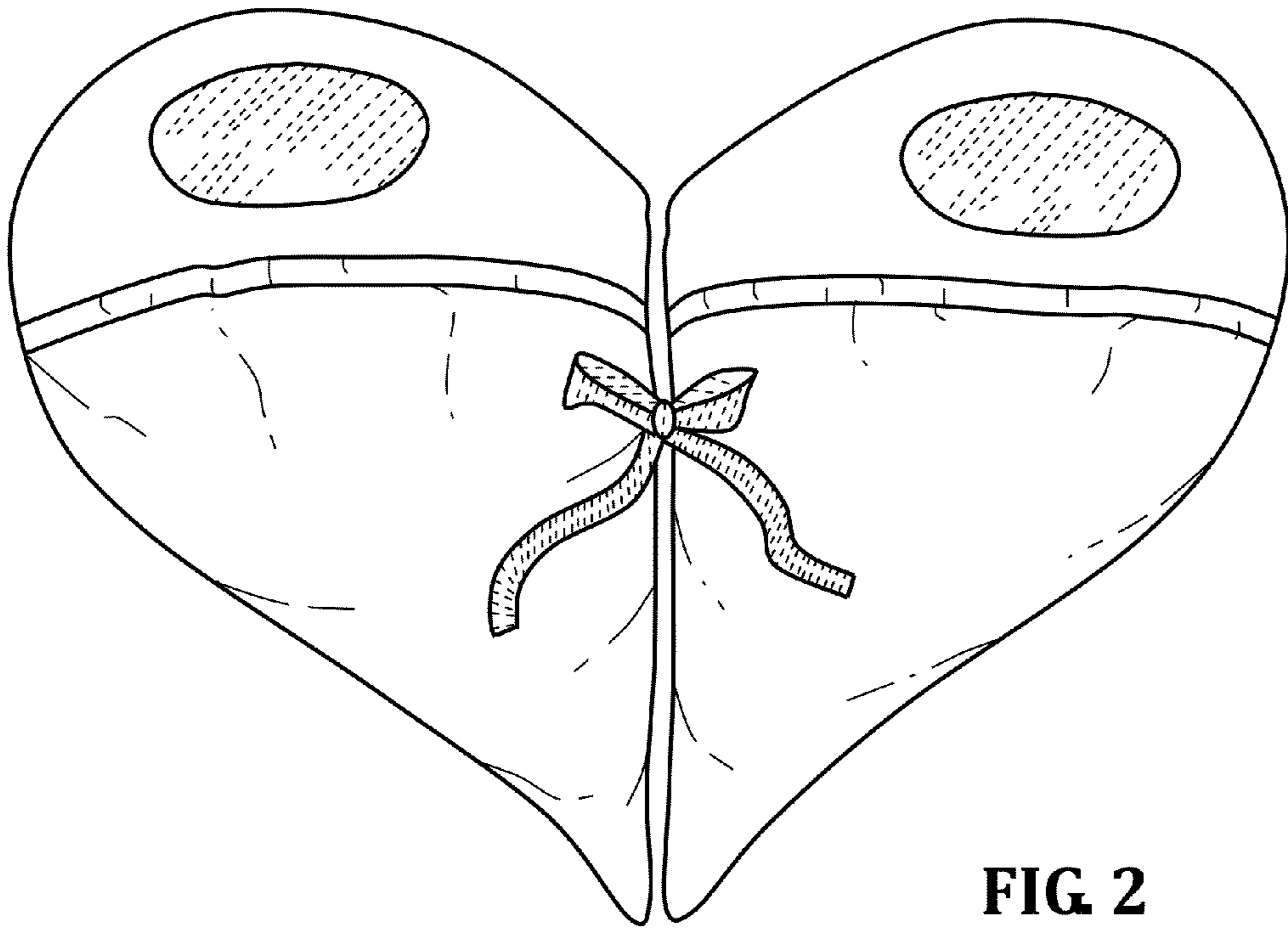

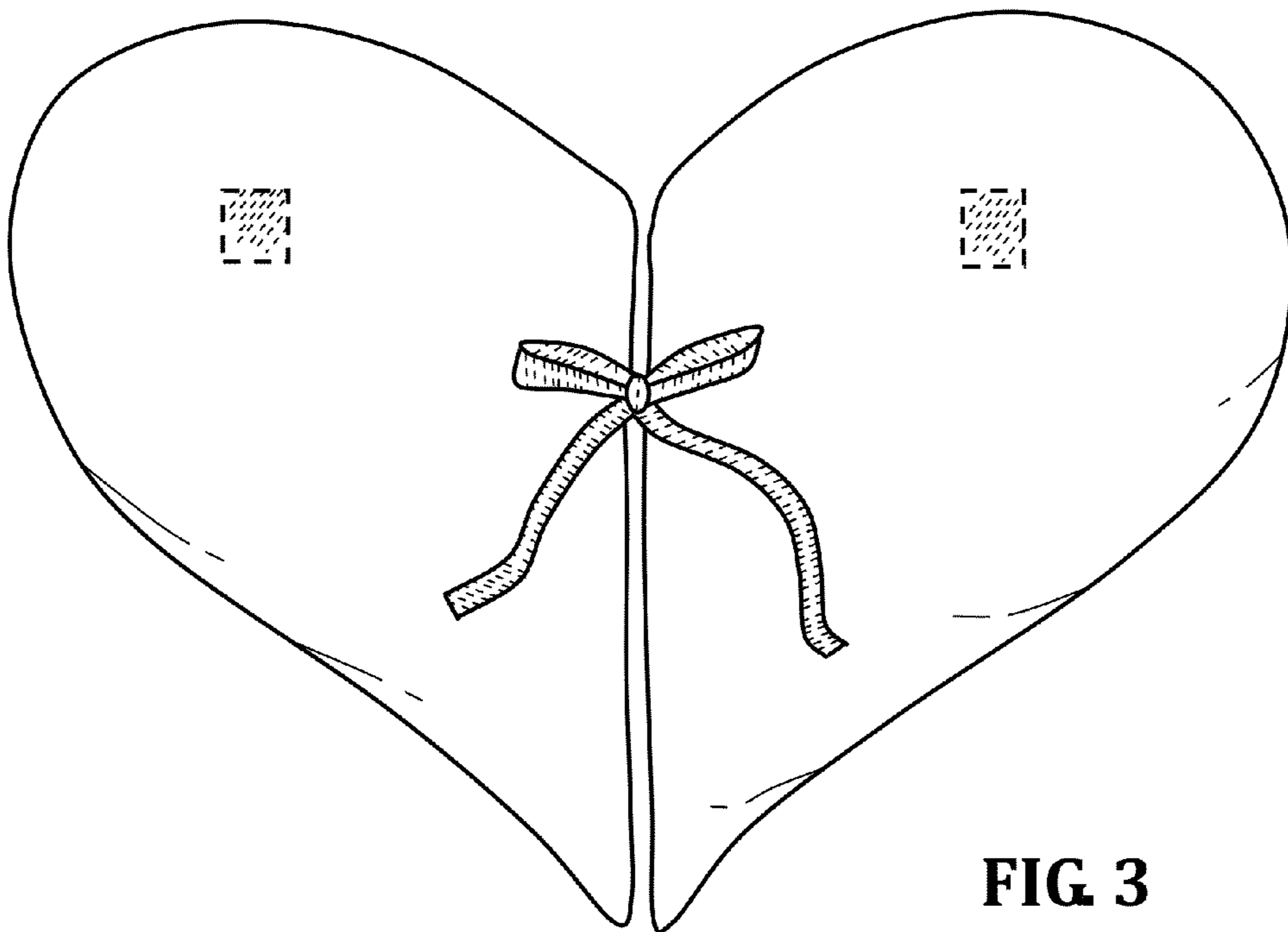
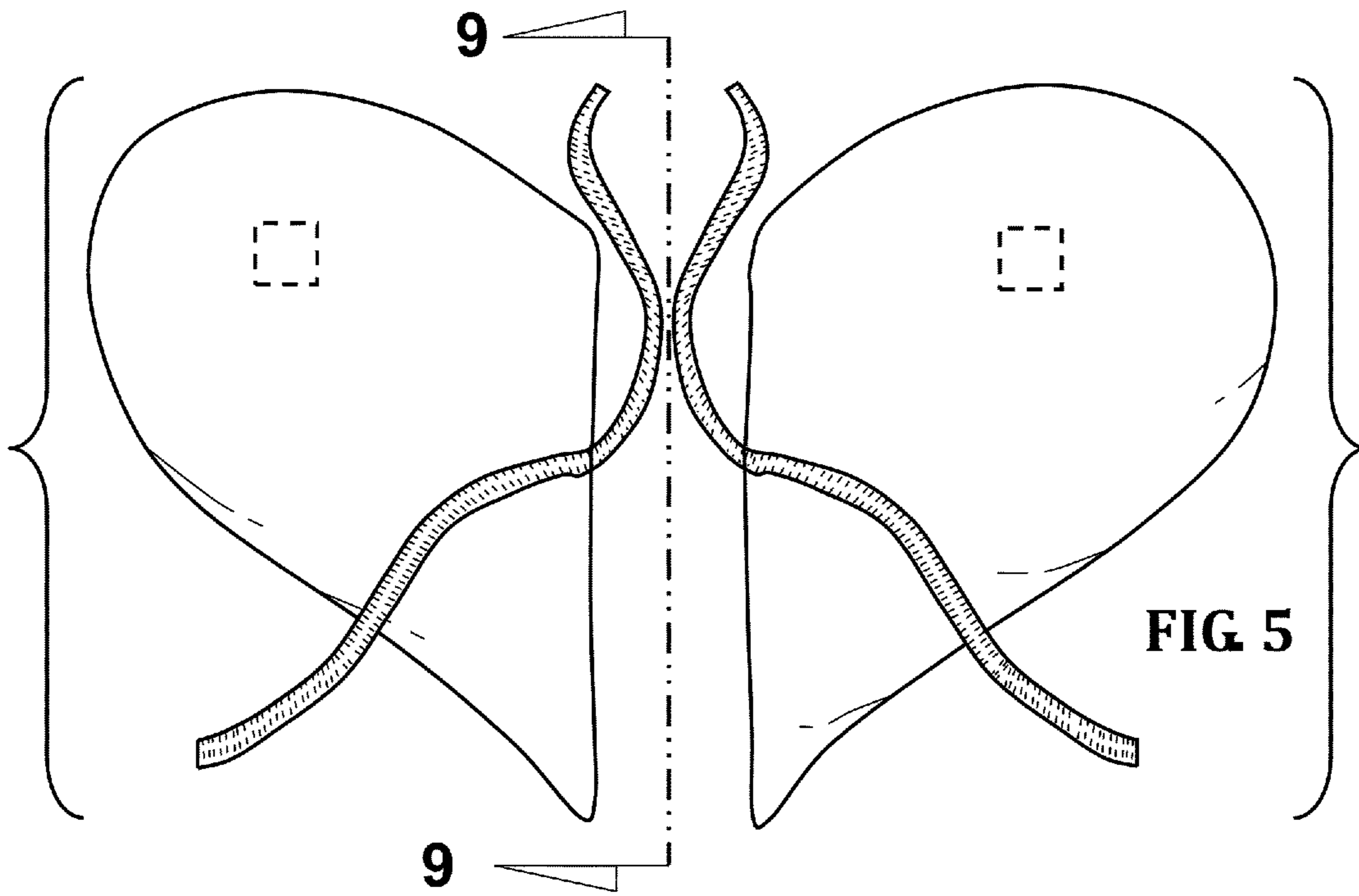
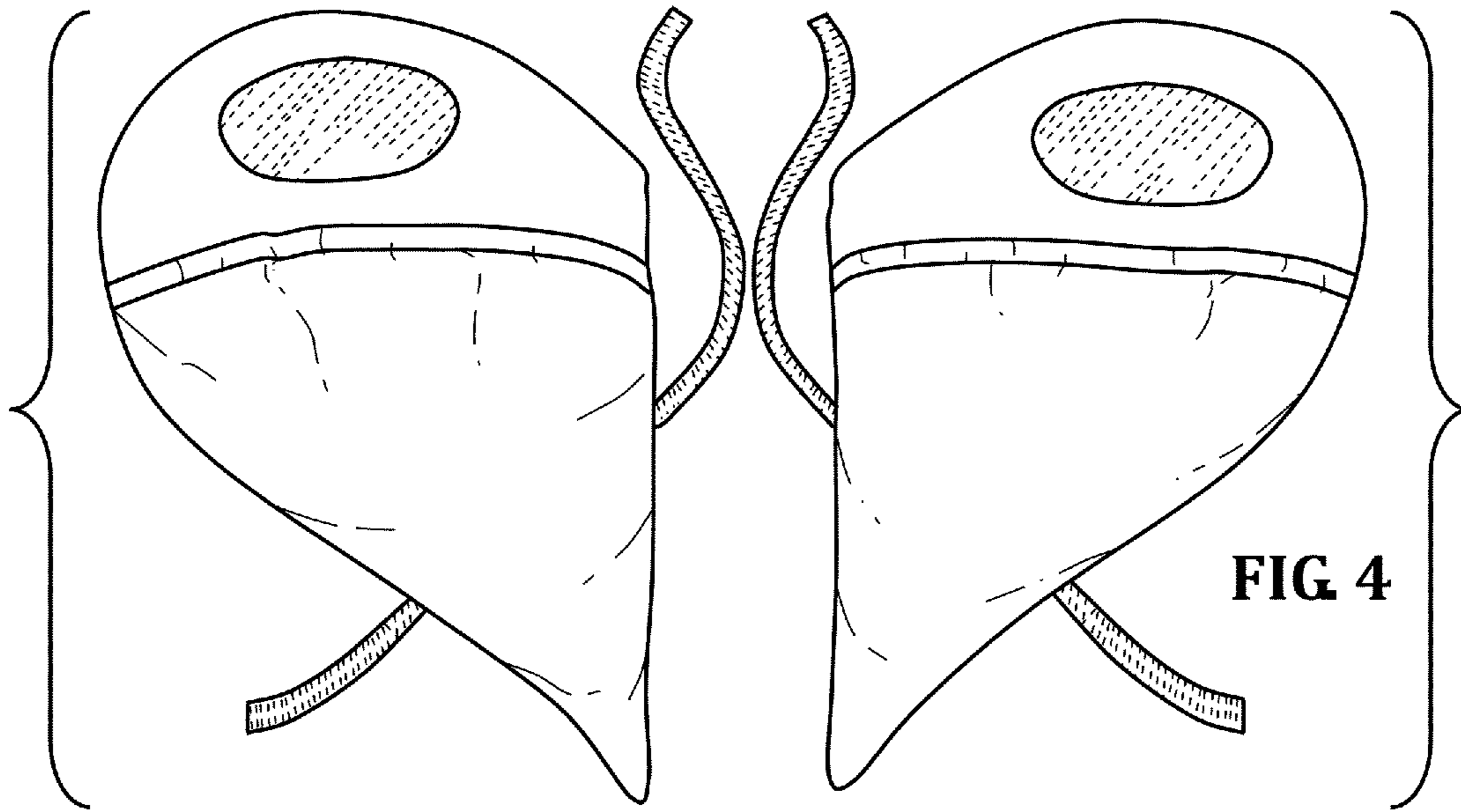

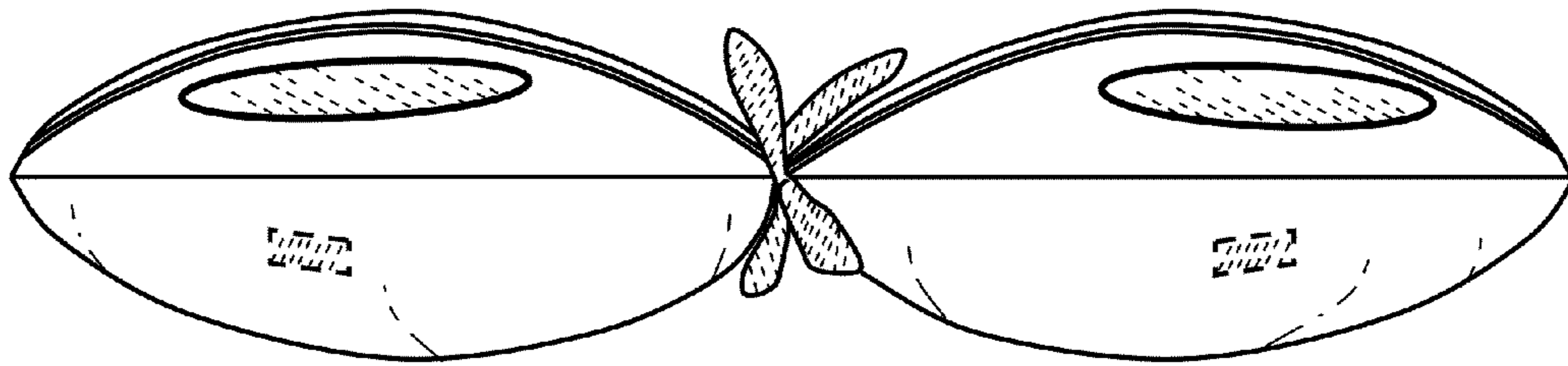

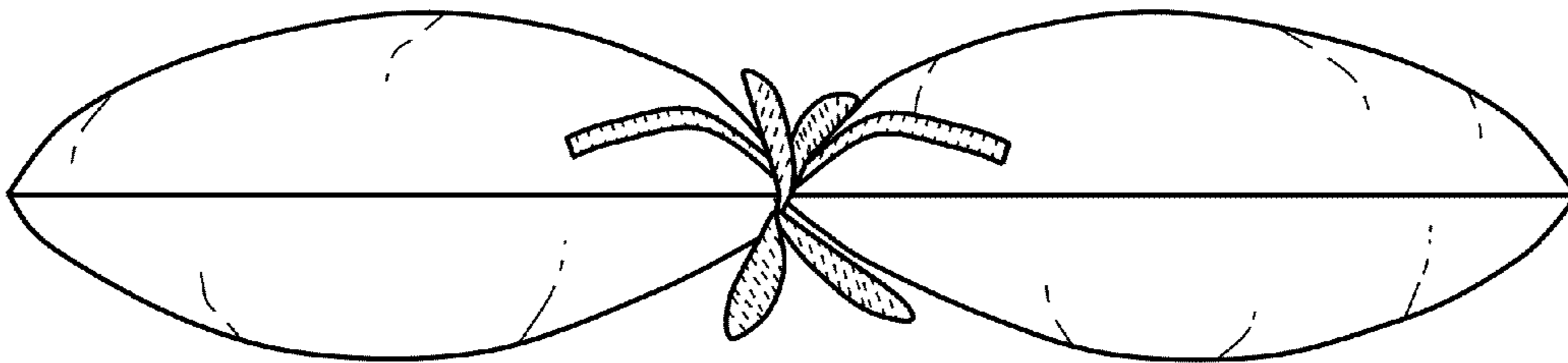

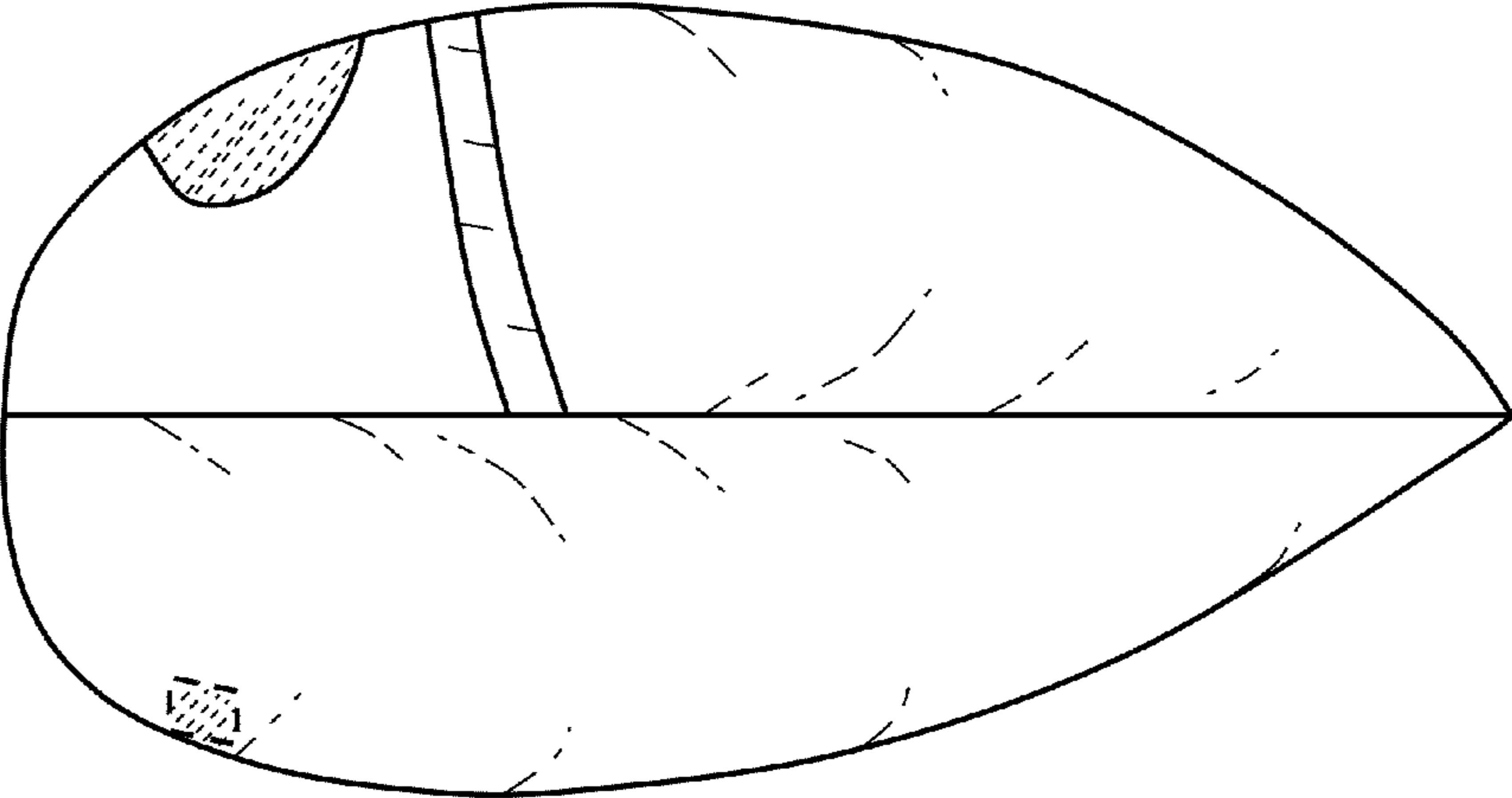

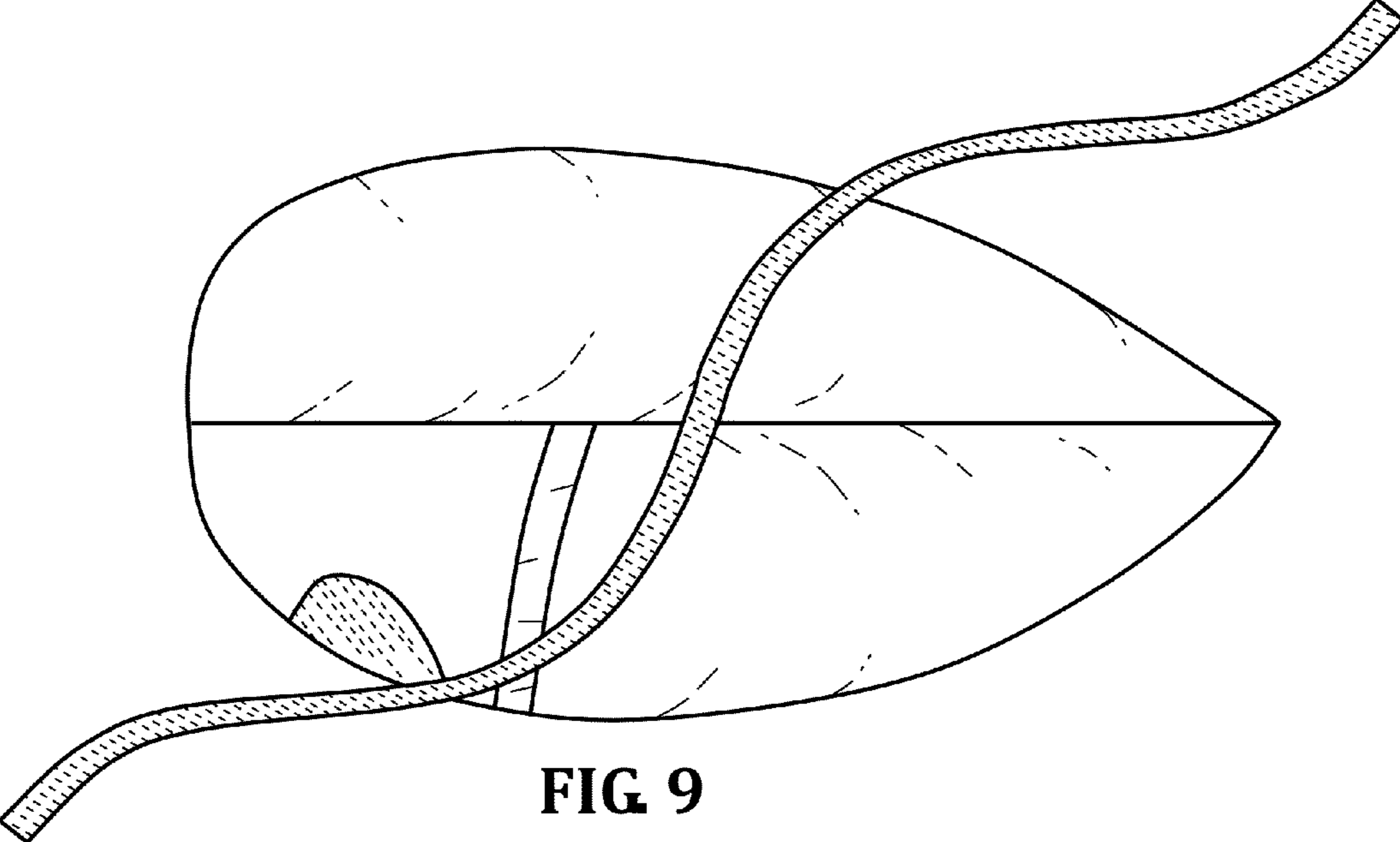
