(57) **CLAIM** The ornamental design for a rear combination lamp for an automobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an outside elevational view of a rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with a first embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 2 is an inside elevational view of the rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with the first embodiment of our new design of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with the first embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1 and 2; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with the first embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1 to 3; FIG. 5 is a front side elevational view of the rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with the first embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1 to 4; FIG. 6 is a rear side elevational view of the rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with the first embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1 to 5; and, FIG. 7 is a front-outside side perspective view of the rear combination lamp for an automobile in accordance with the first embodiment of our new design of FIGS. 1 to 6. A second embodiment of our new design is identical to the first embodiment except that the inside elevational view of FIG. 2, the bottom plan view of FIG. 4 and the rear side elevational view of FIG. 6 form no part of the claimed design. In addition, in the second embodiment, the appearance of the inside structures, the bottom structures and the rear side struc-
