(57) CLAIM


The ornamental design for a handbag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an embodiment of a handbag according to my new design, in a fully closed position, the rear view of which is a mirror image thereof,
- FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof, in a fully closed position,
- FIG. 3 is side elevational view thereof, the other side being a mirror image thereof, in a fully closed position,
- FIG. 4 is a top elevational view thereof, in a fully closed position,
- FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, in a semi-closed position, showing optional surface treatment, the rear view of which is a mirror image thereof,
- FIG. 6 is a side perspective view thereof, in a semi-closed position, the other side being a mirror image thereof,
- FIG. 7 is a top elevational view thereof, in a semi-closed position,
- FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the handbag;
- FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the handbag;
- FIG. 10 is a side perspective view thereof, in a second semiclosed position, showing optional surface treatment,
- FIG. 11 is a side elevational view thereof, in a second semiclosed position,
- FIG. 12 is a top elevational view thereof, in a second semiclosed position,
- FIG. 13 is a side elevational view of an embodiment of a handbag according to my new design in a fully opened position,
- FIG. 14 is a side perspective view thereof, in a fully opened position, showing optional surface treatment,
- FIG. 15 is a side perspective view thereof, in a fully opened position, showing the handles fully extended,
- FIG. 16 is a top elevational view thereof, in a fully opened position with the handles not fully extended; and,
- FIG. 17 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken lines showing stitching are part of the claimed design.




















