(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen with a transitional graphical user interface, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of the first image in the sequence for a display screen with a transitional graphical user interface showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is the second image thereof;

FIG. 3 is the third image thereof;

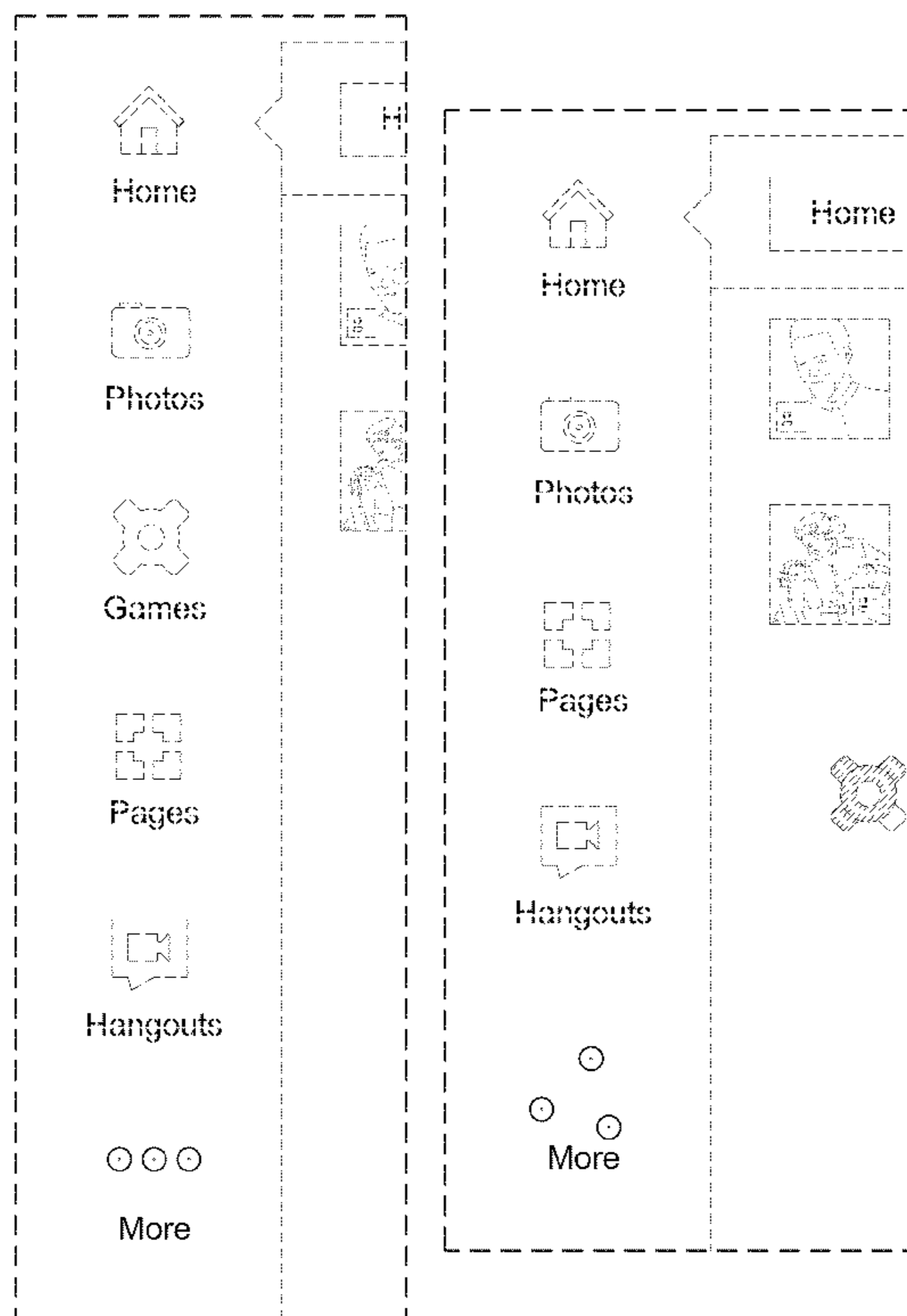
FIG. 4 is the fourth image thereof; and,

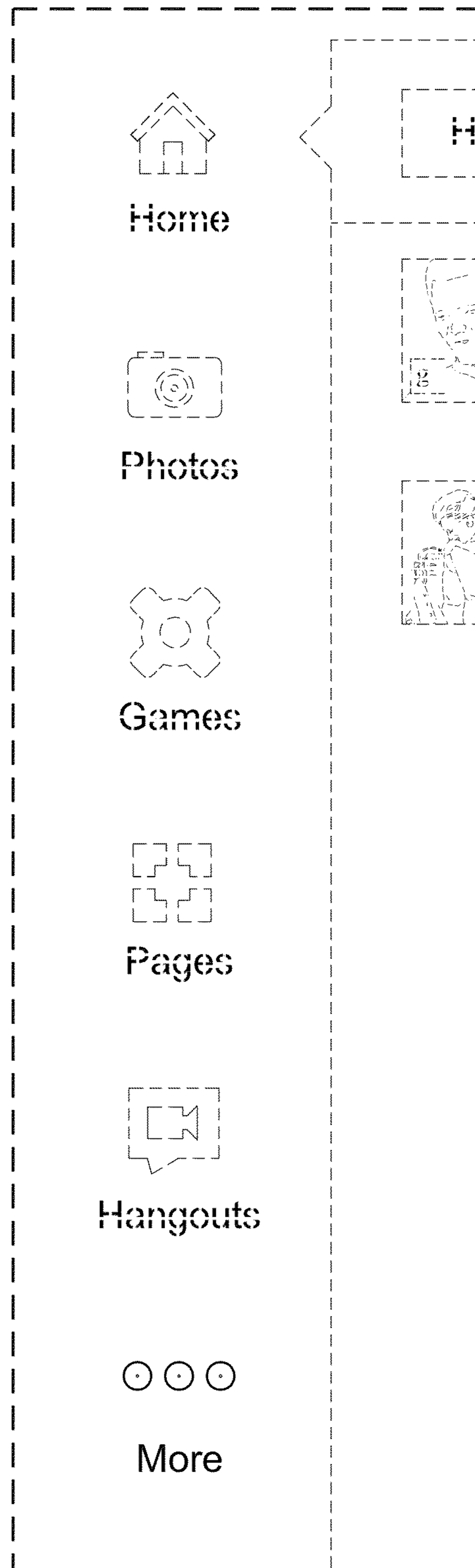

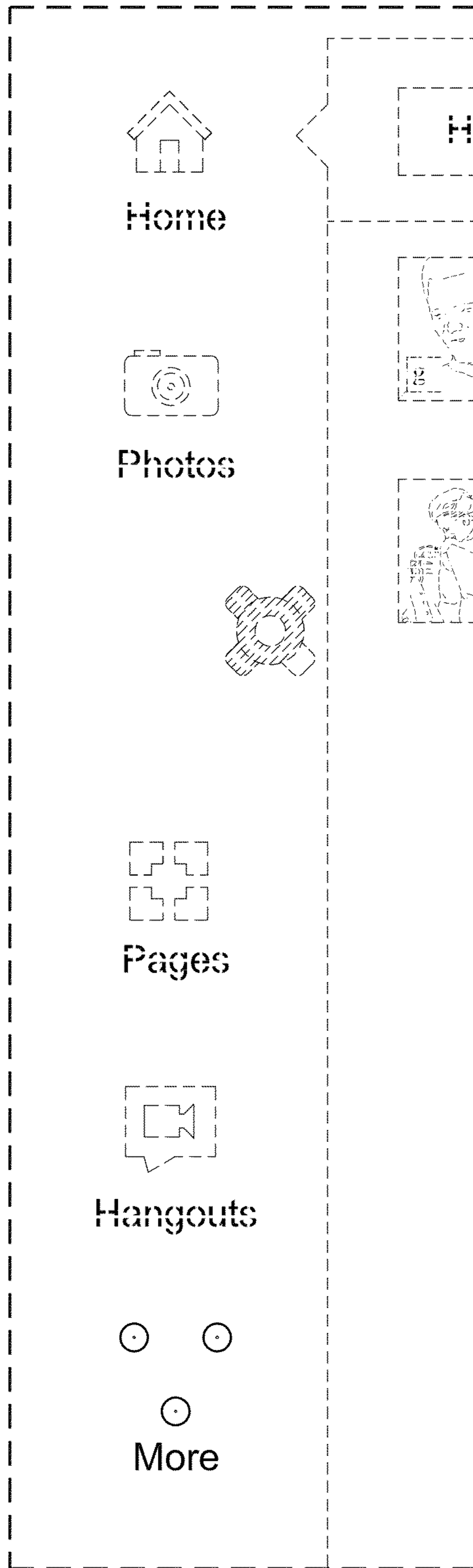

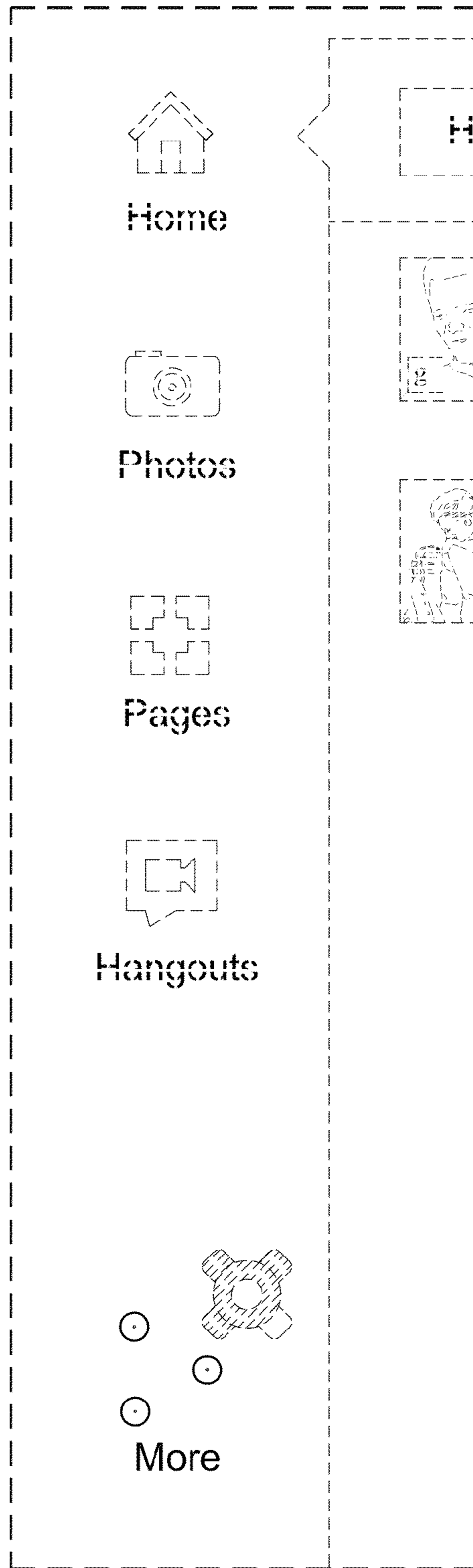

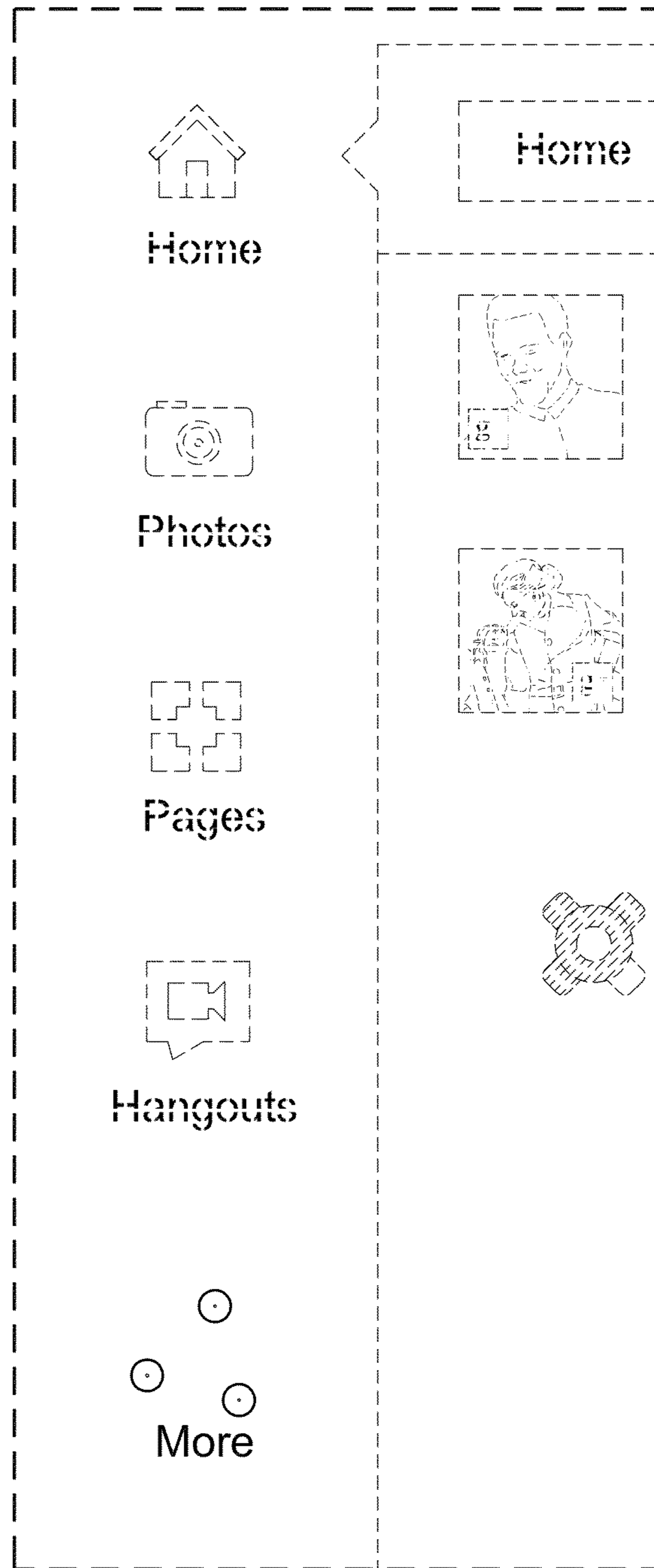

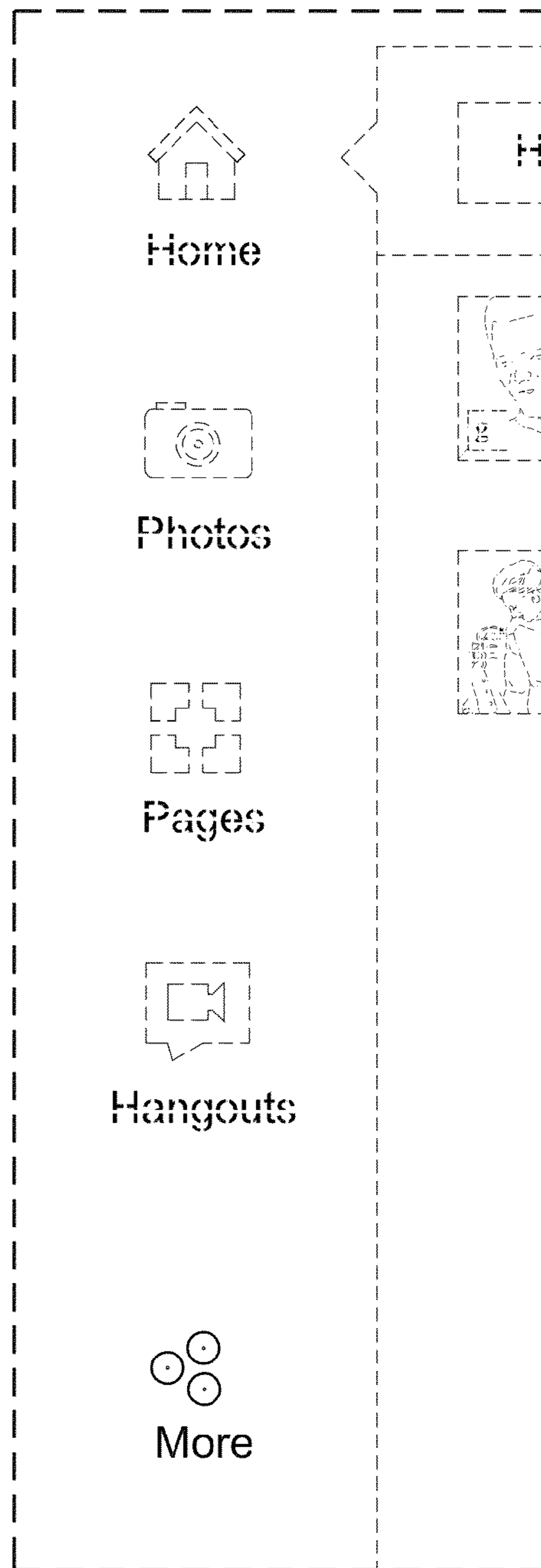
