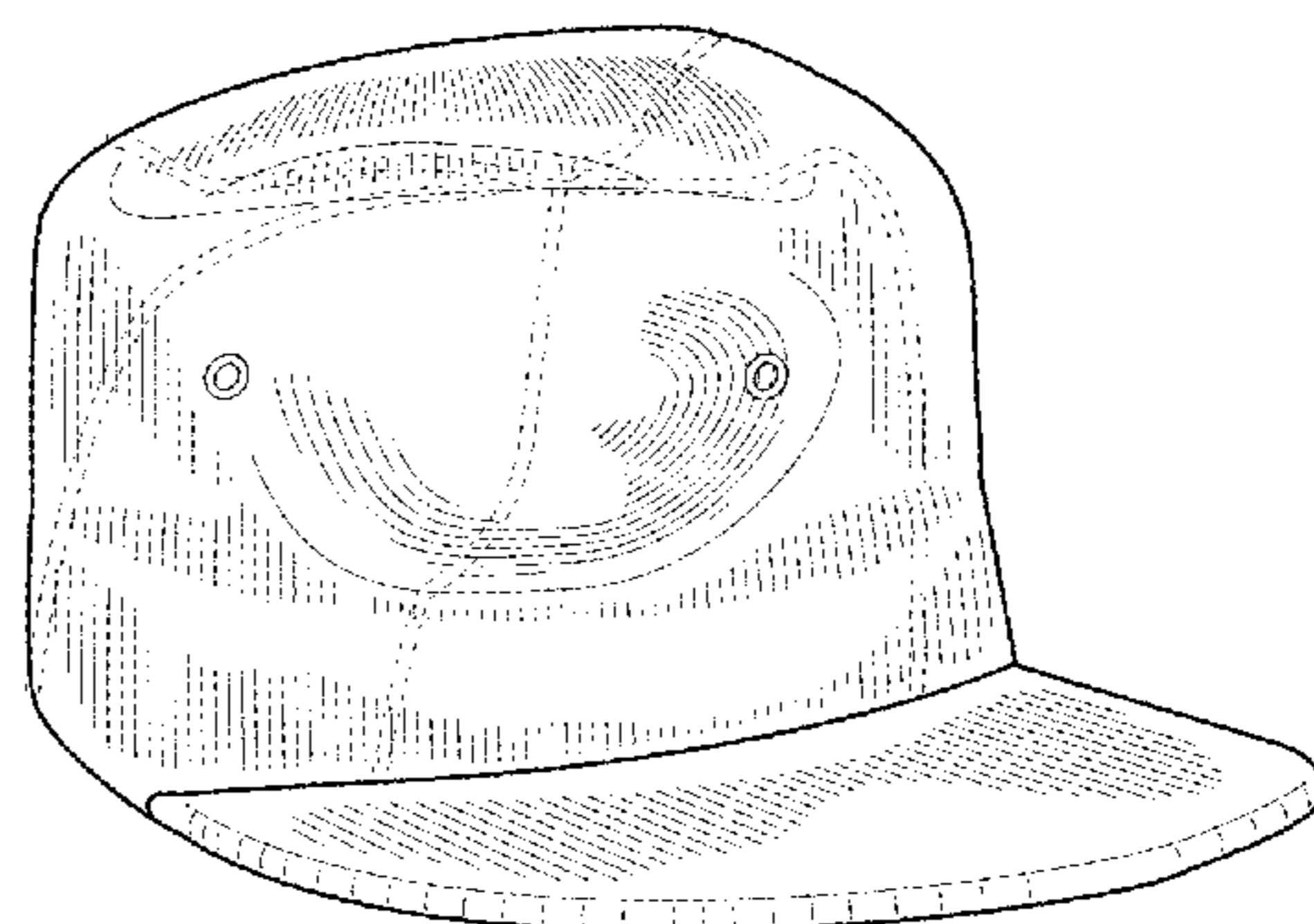
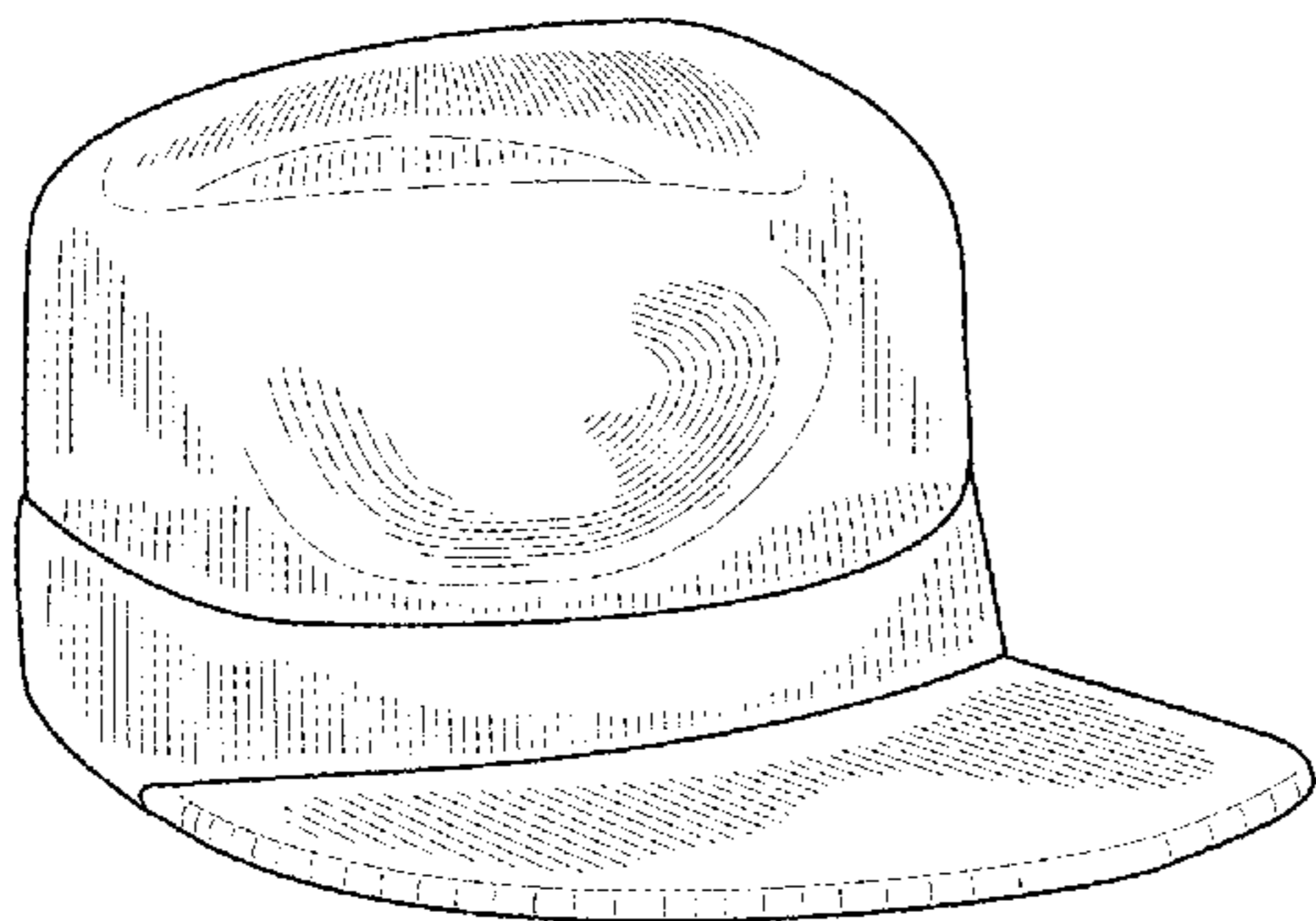
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a hat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a hat, showing a first embodiment of my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the hat as shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the hat as shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the hat as shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of the hat as shown in FIG. 1, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the hat as shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the hat as shown in FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment of the hat thereof;  
 FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view of the hat as shown in FIG. 8;  
 FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the hat as shown in FIG. 8;  
 FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the hat as shown in FIG. 8;  
 FIG. 12 is a left-side elevational view of the hat as shown in FIG. 8, the right-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the hat as shown in FIG. 8; and,  
 FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of the hat as shown in FIG. 8.  
 The broken lines in the figures represent stitching, and are part of the claimed design.

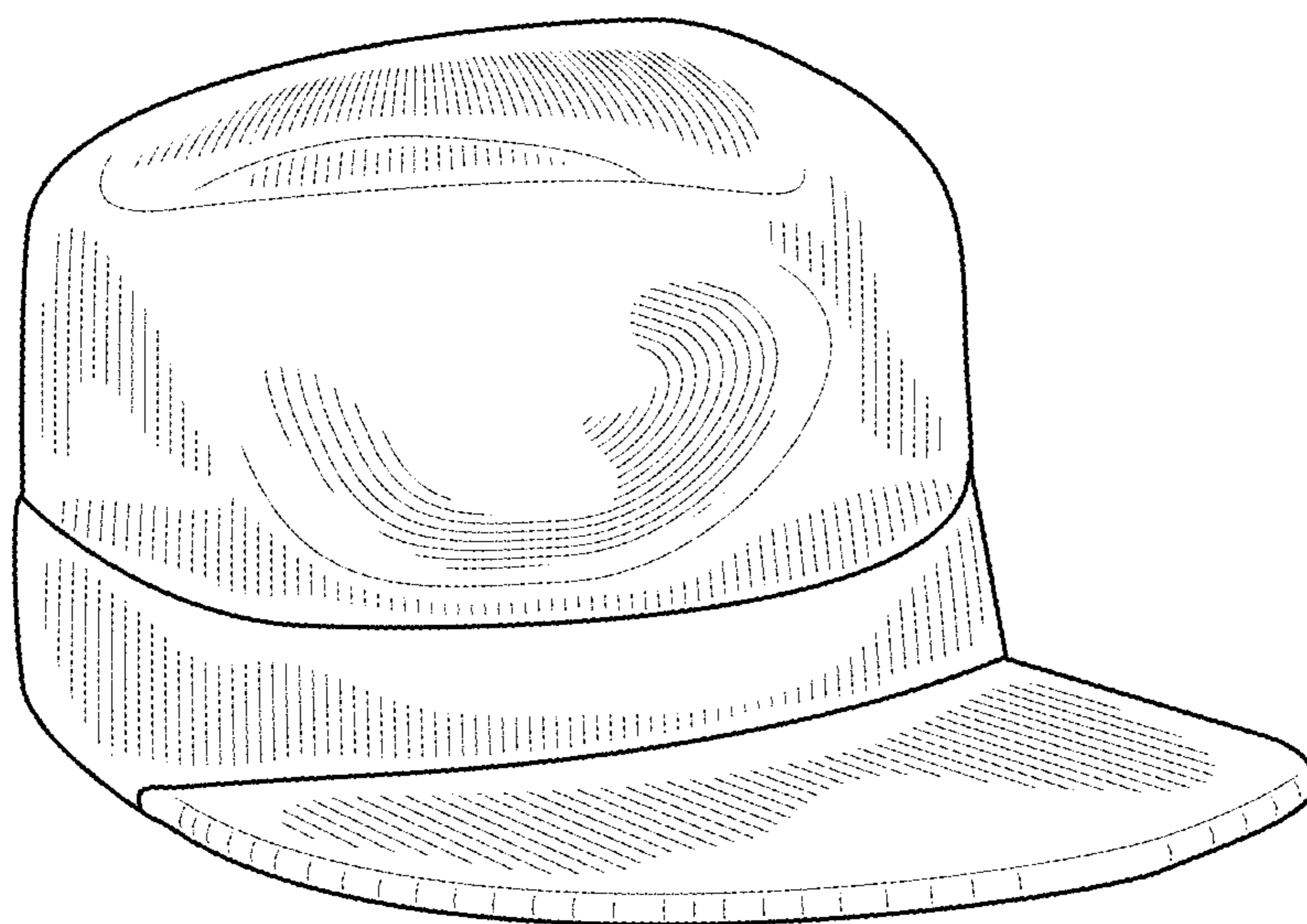

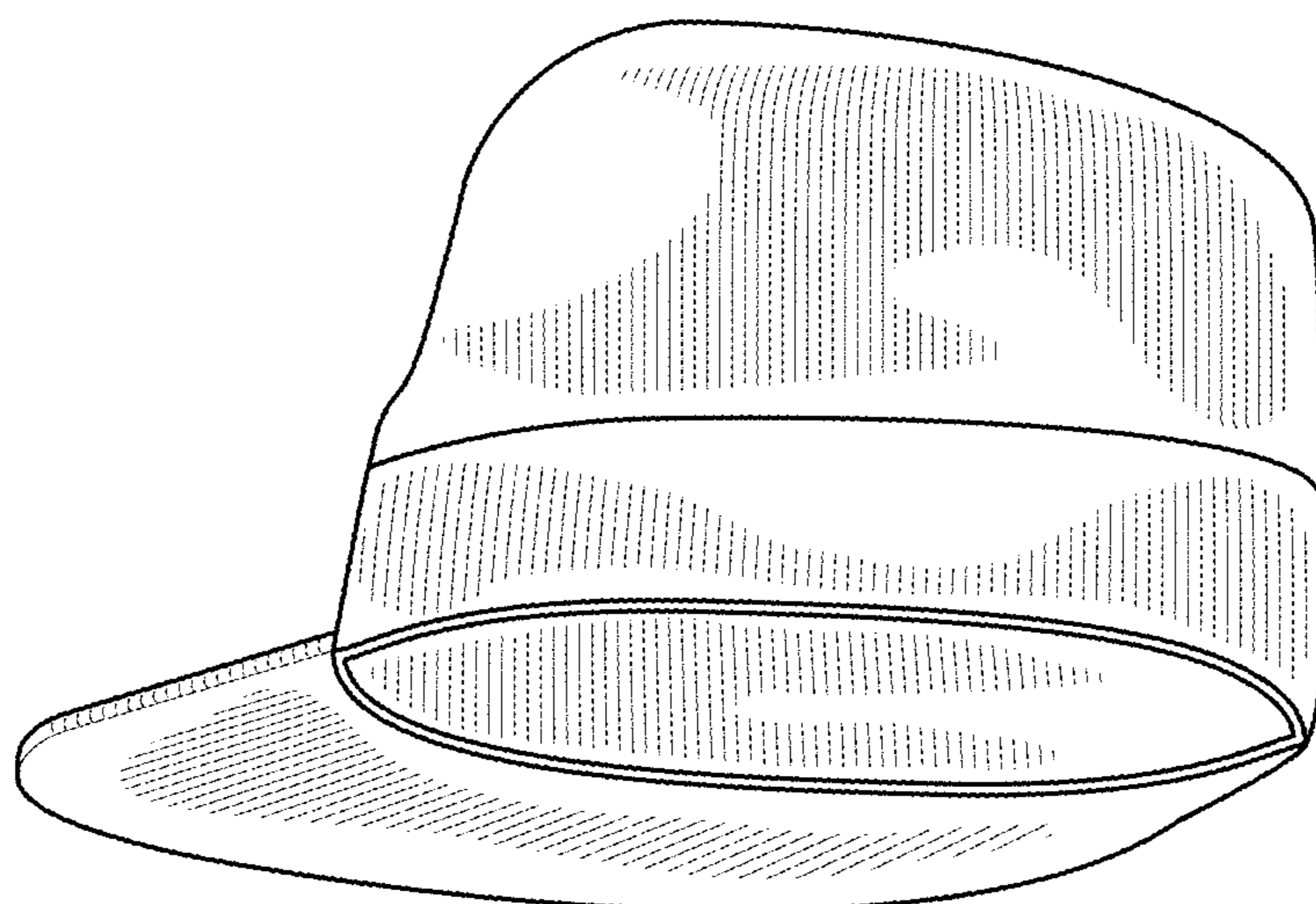

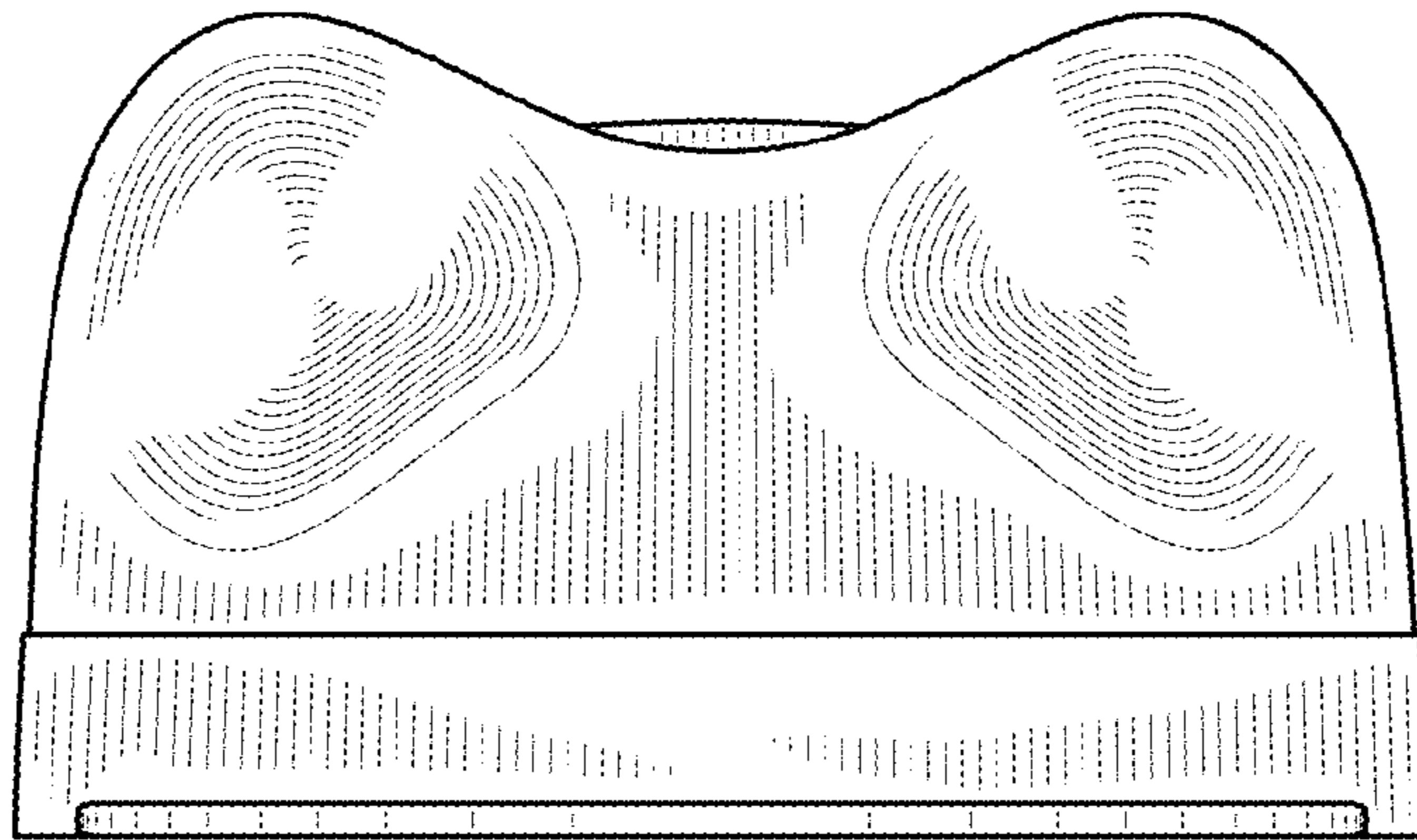

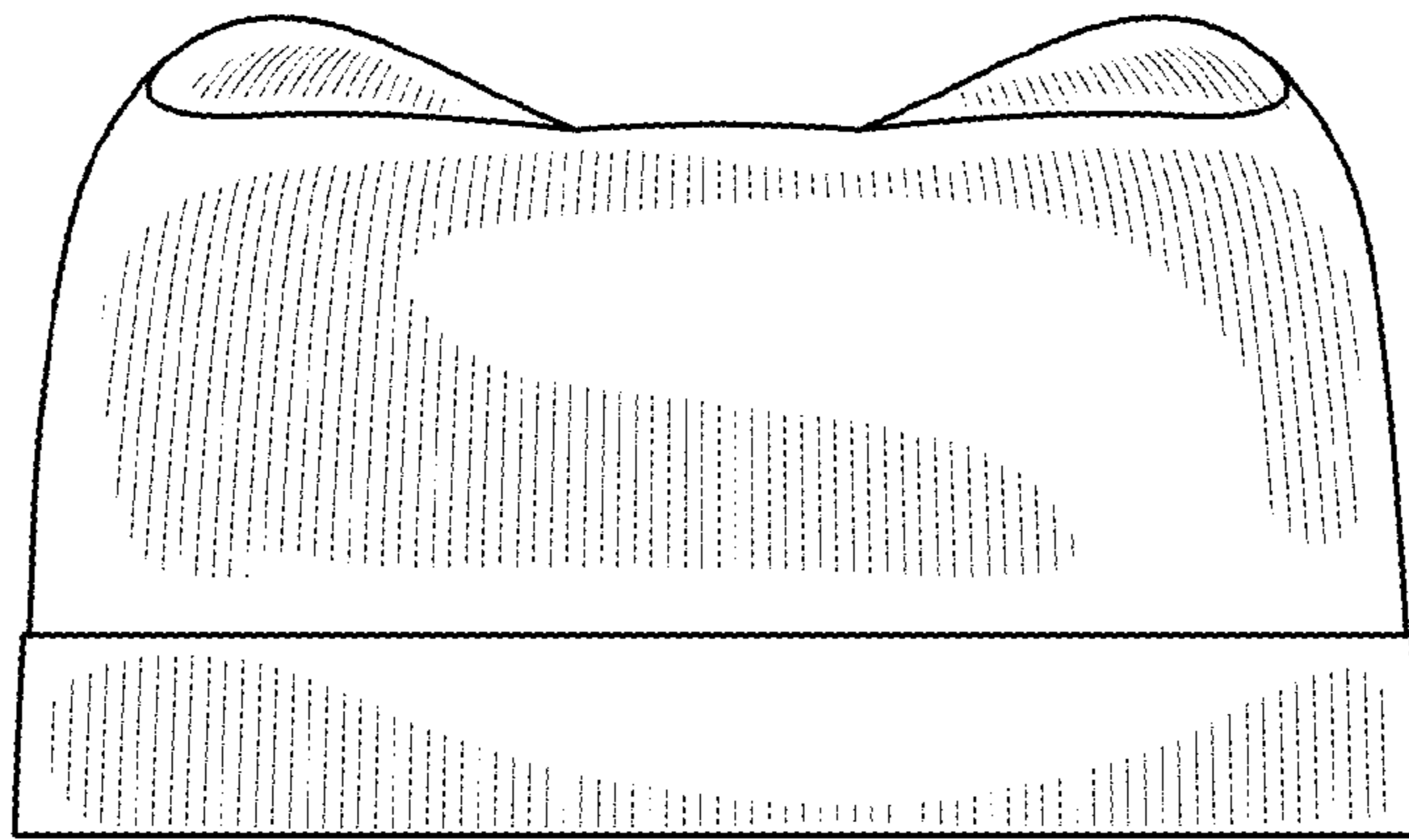

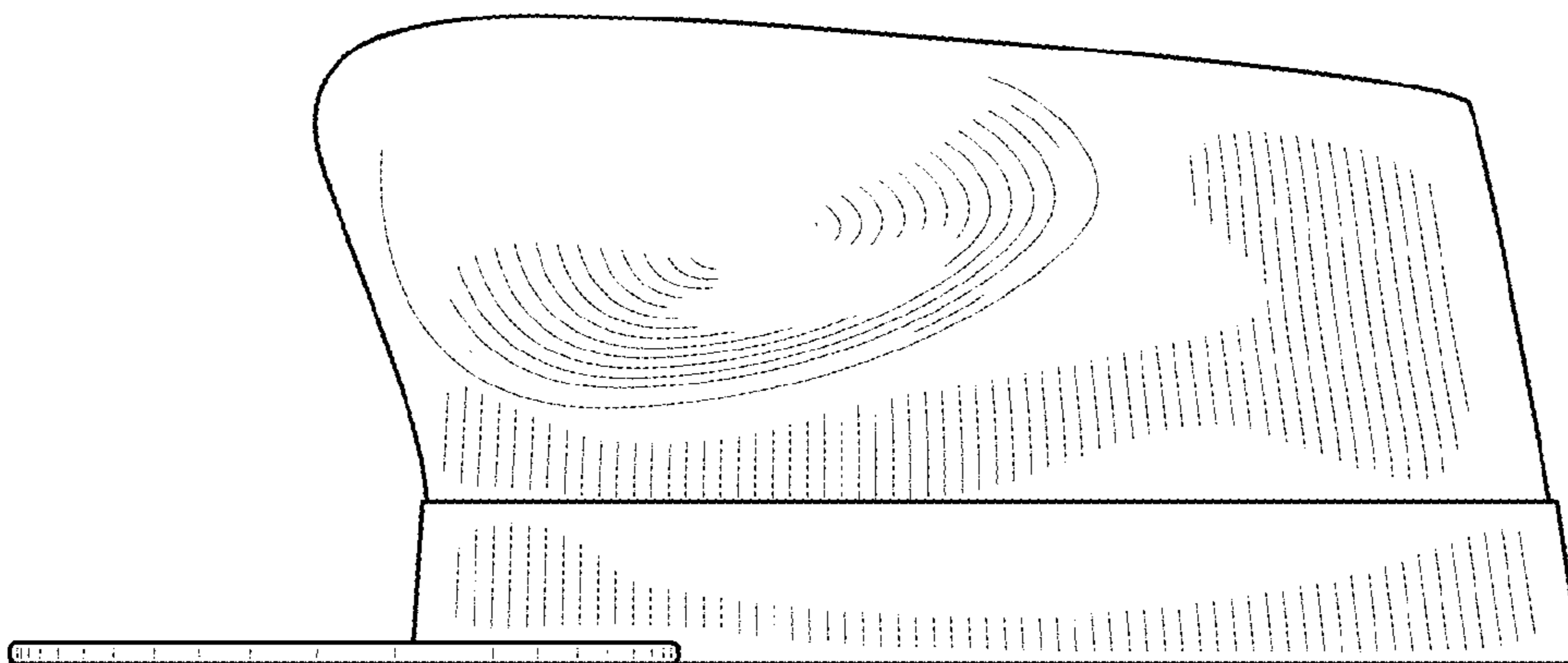

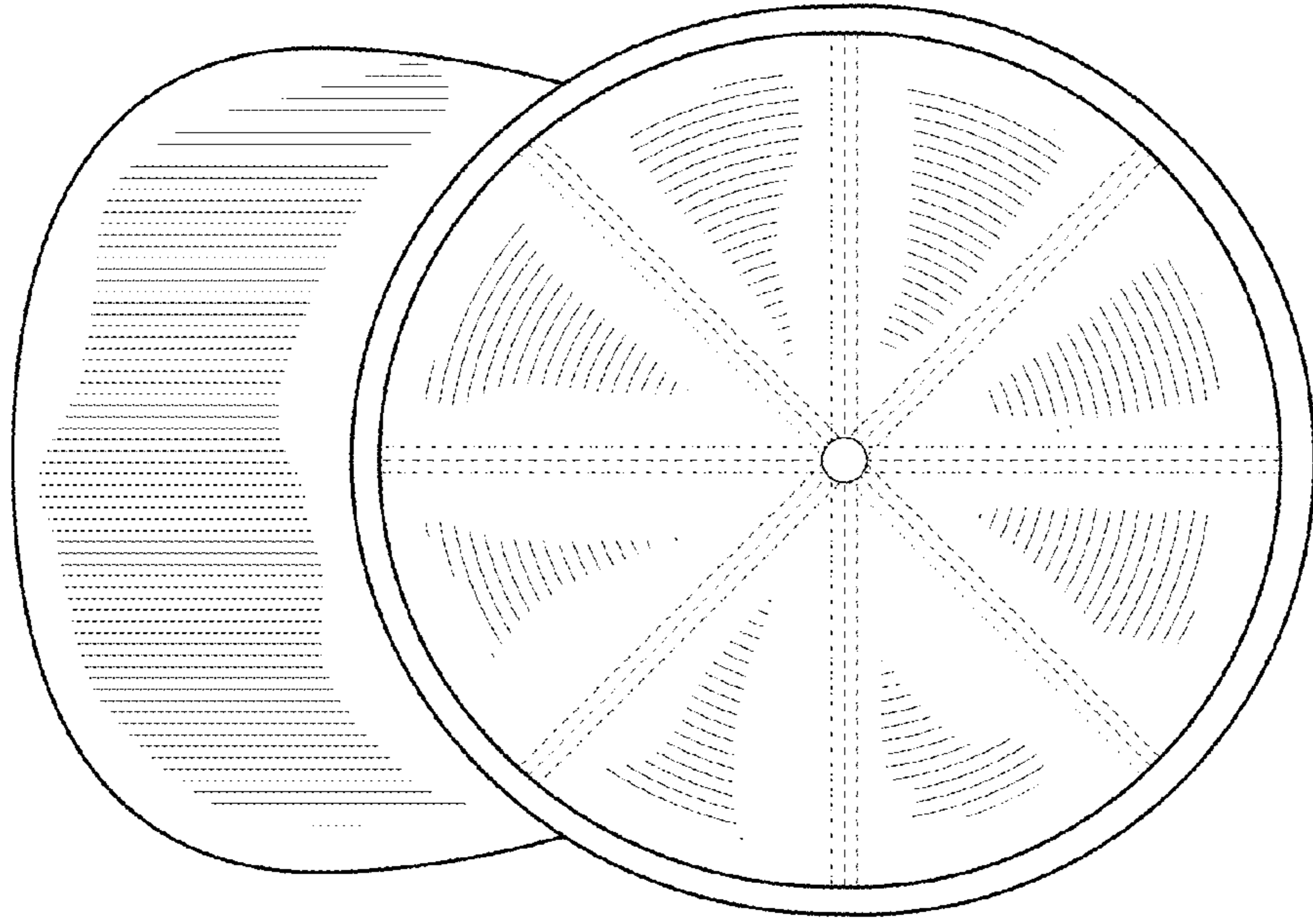

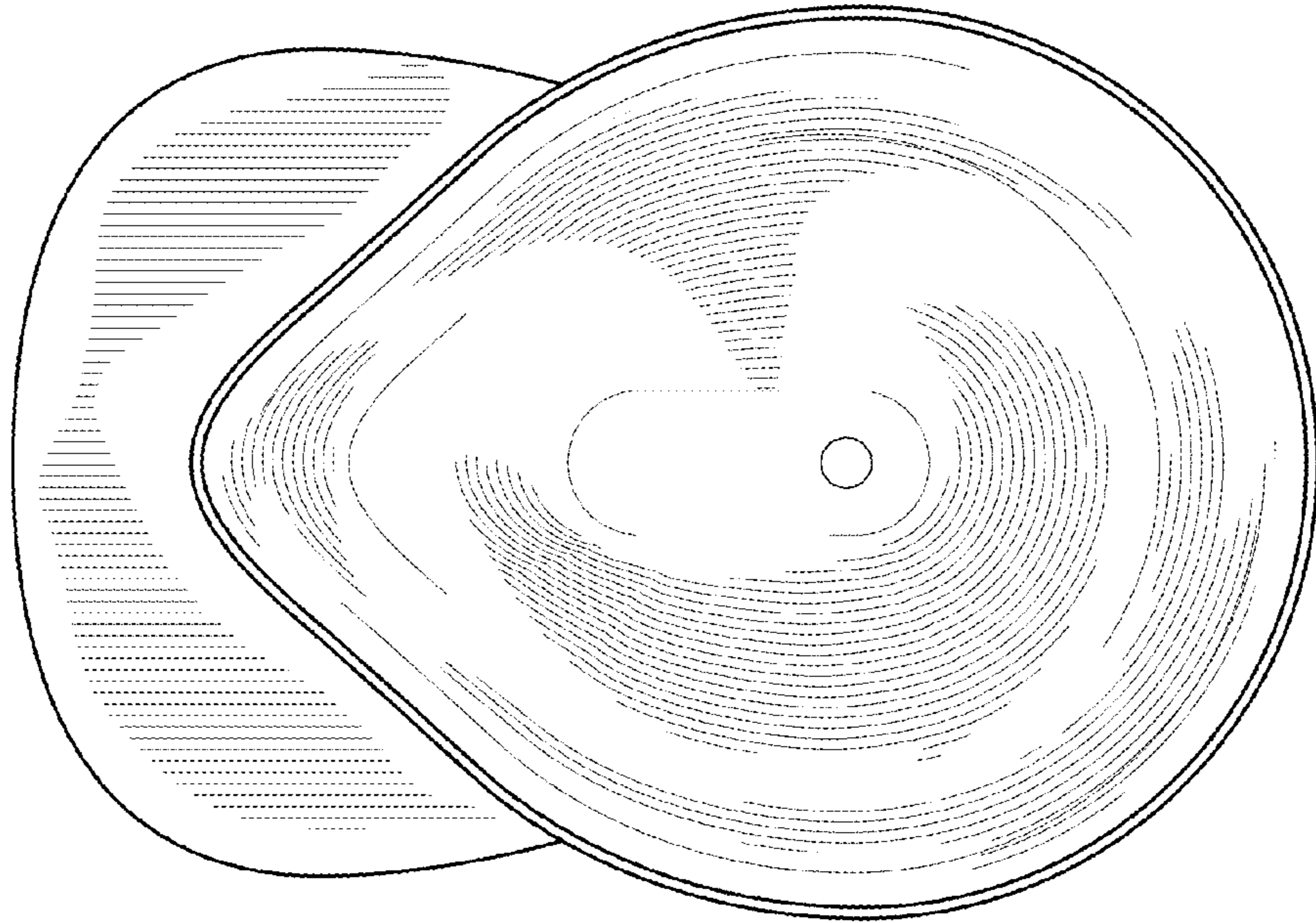

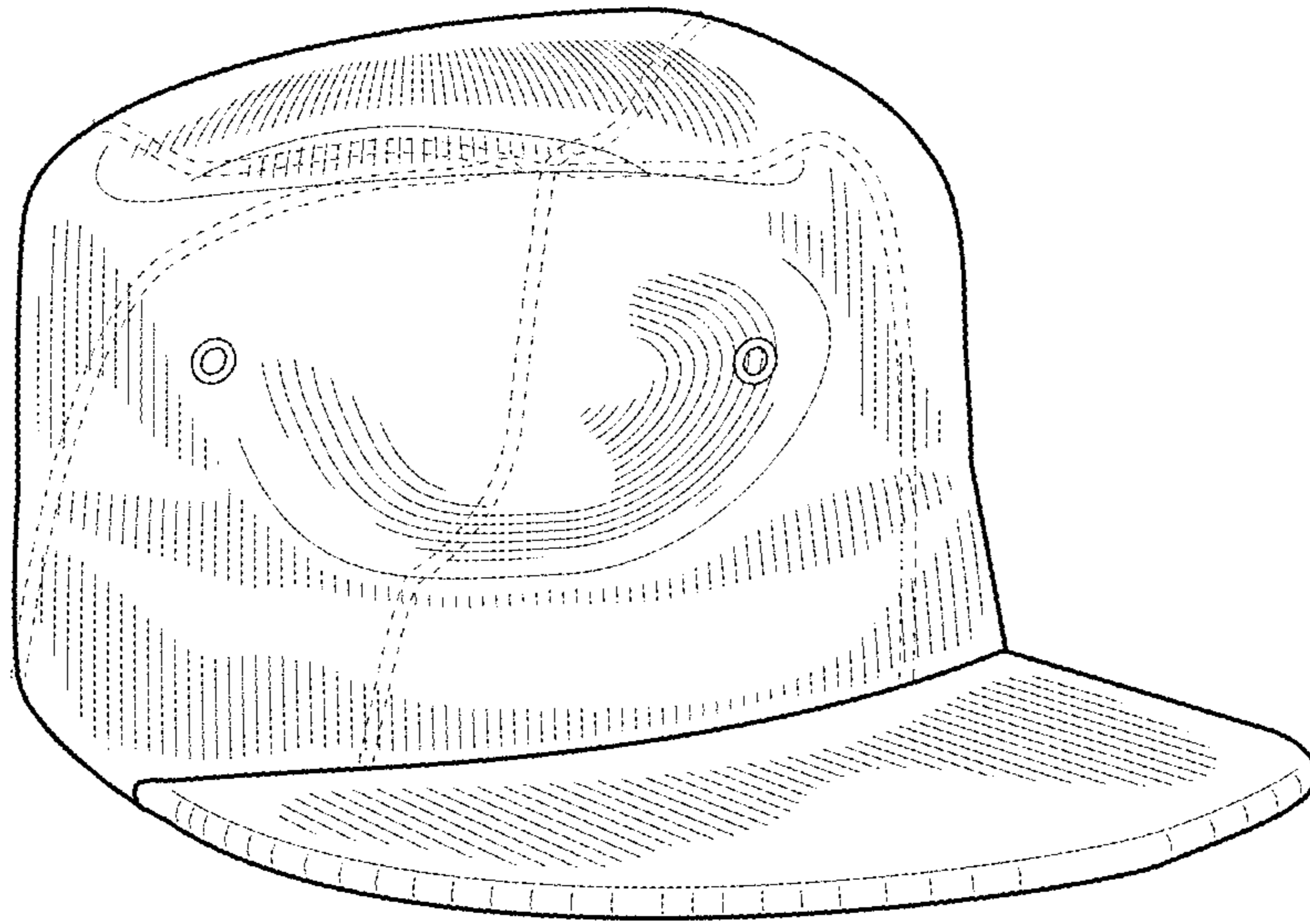

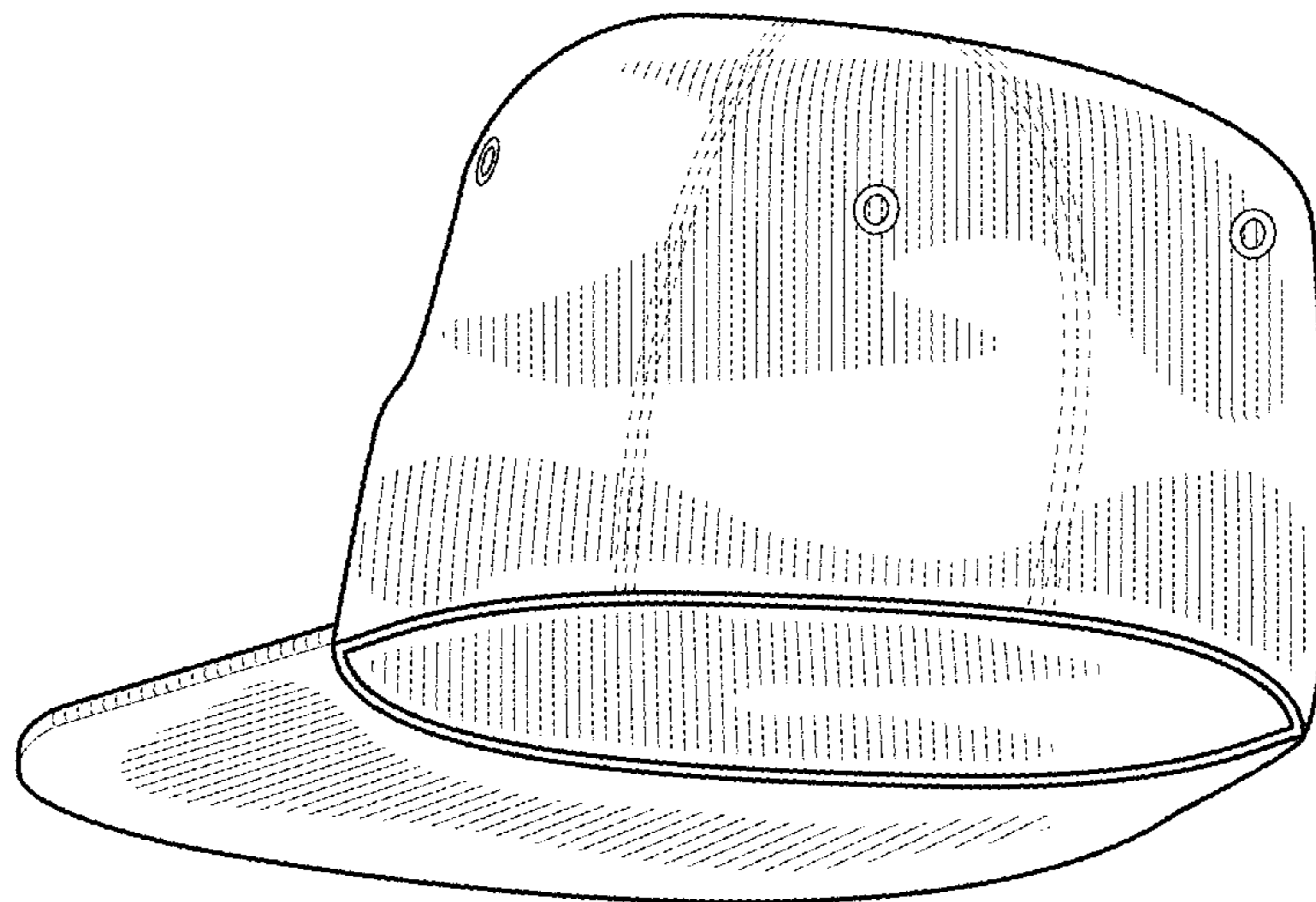

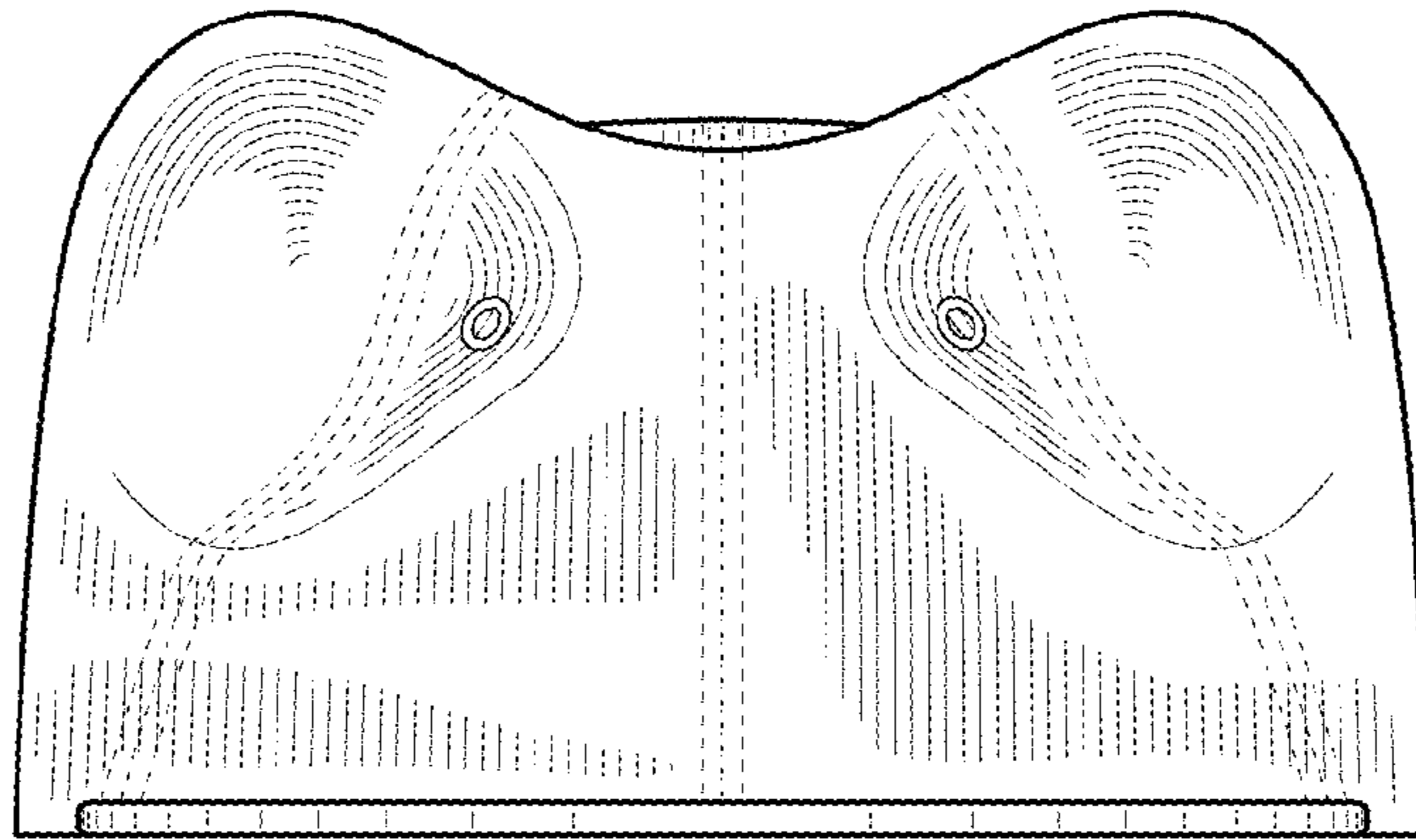

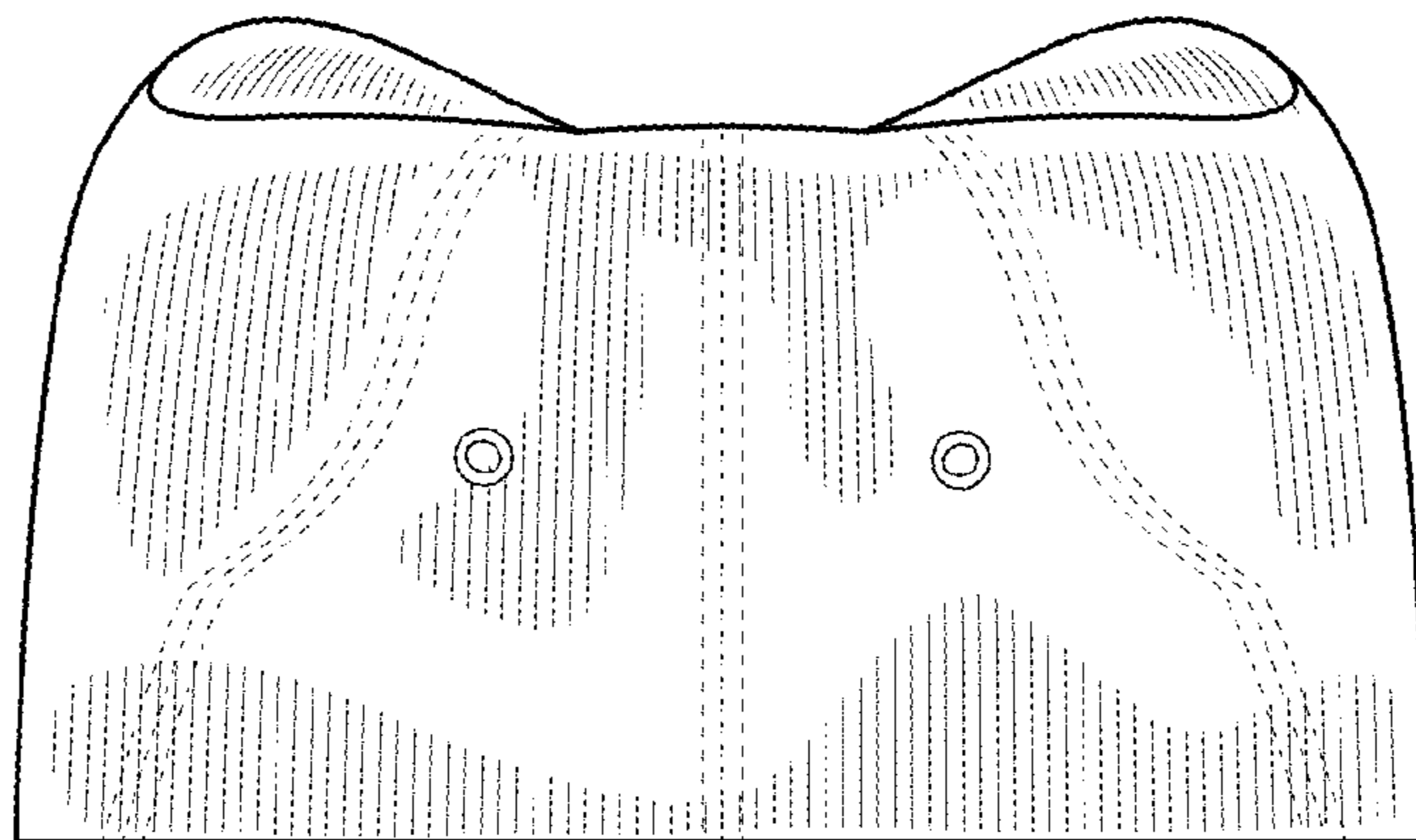

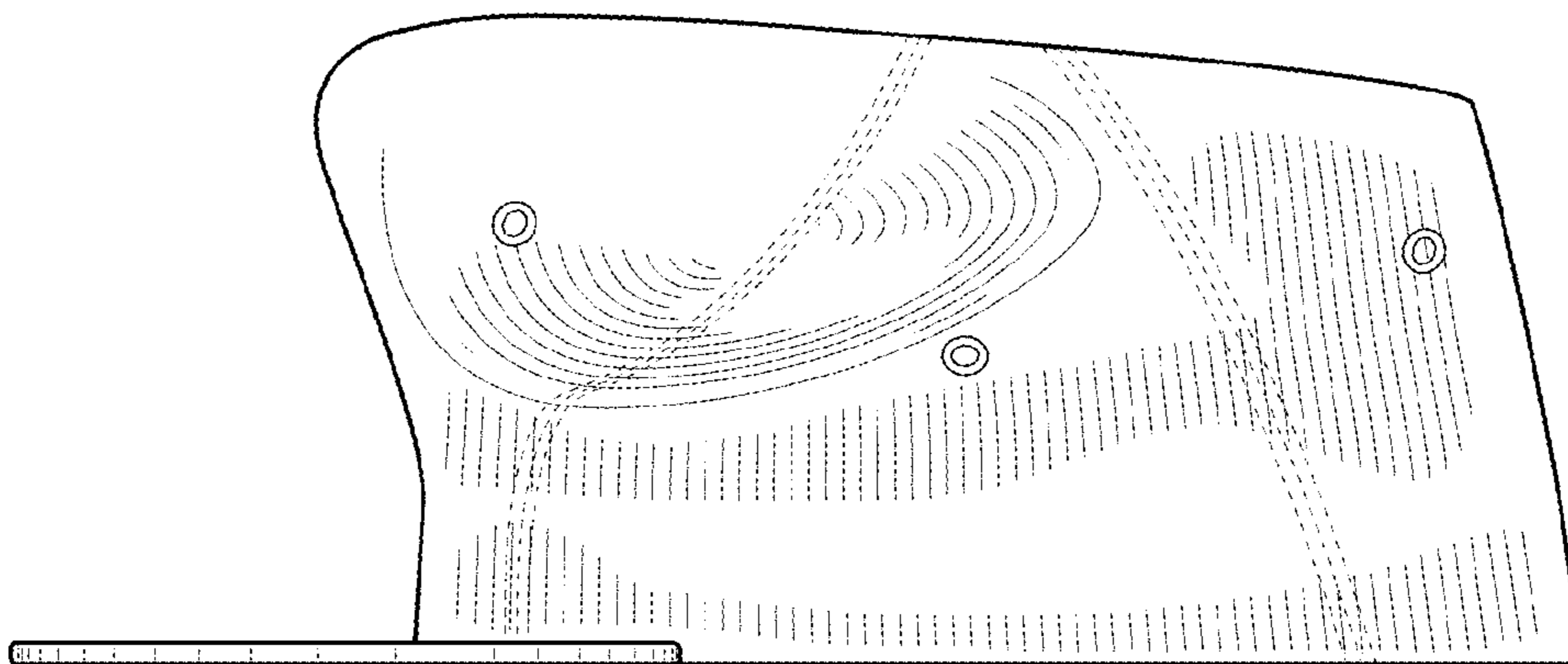

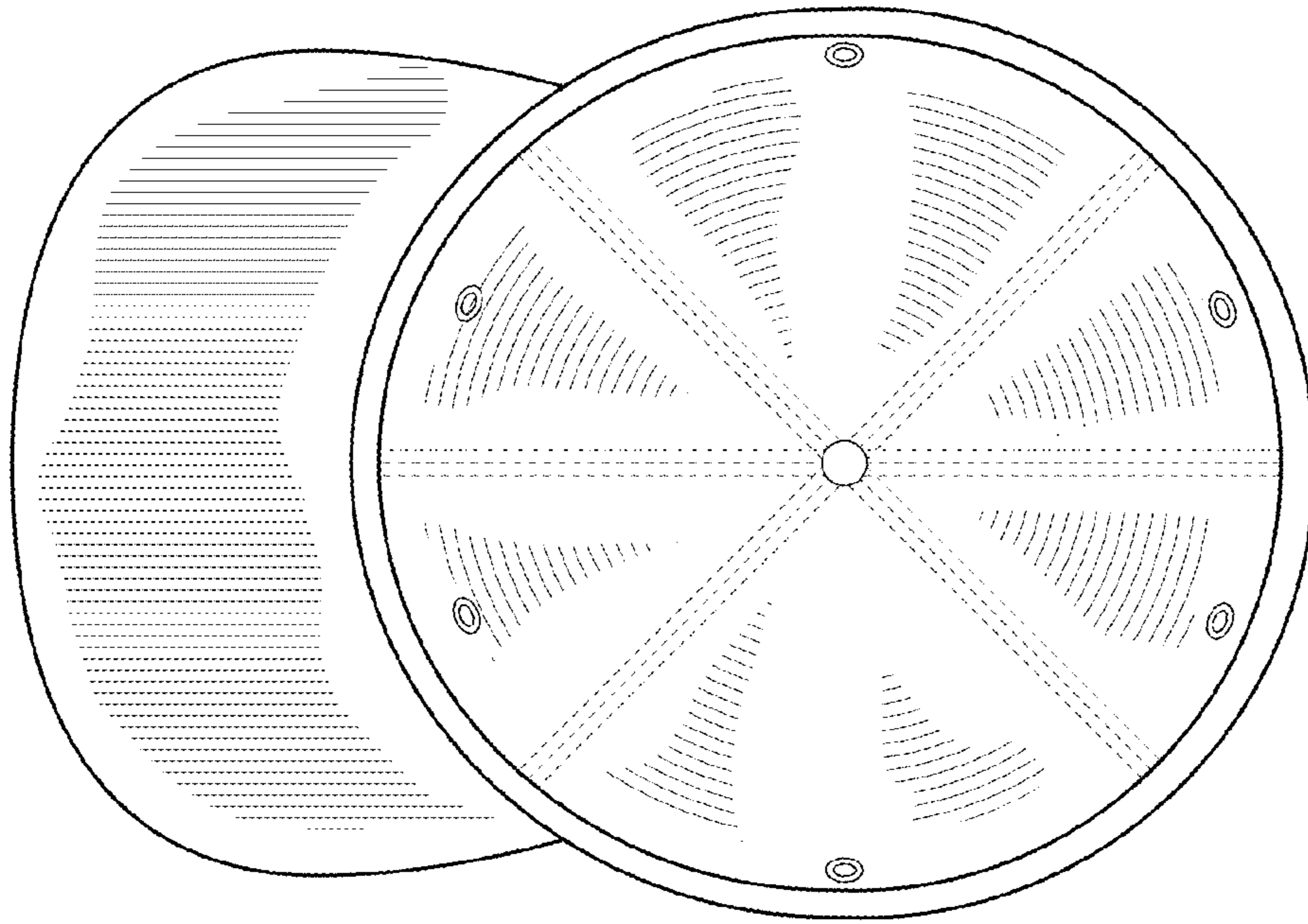

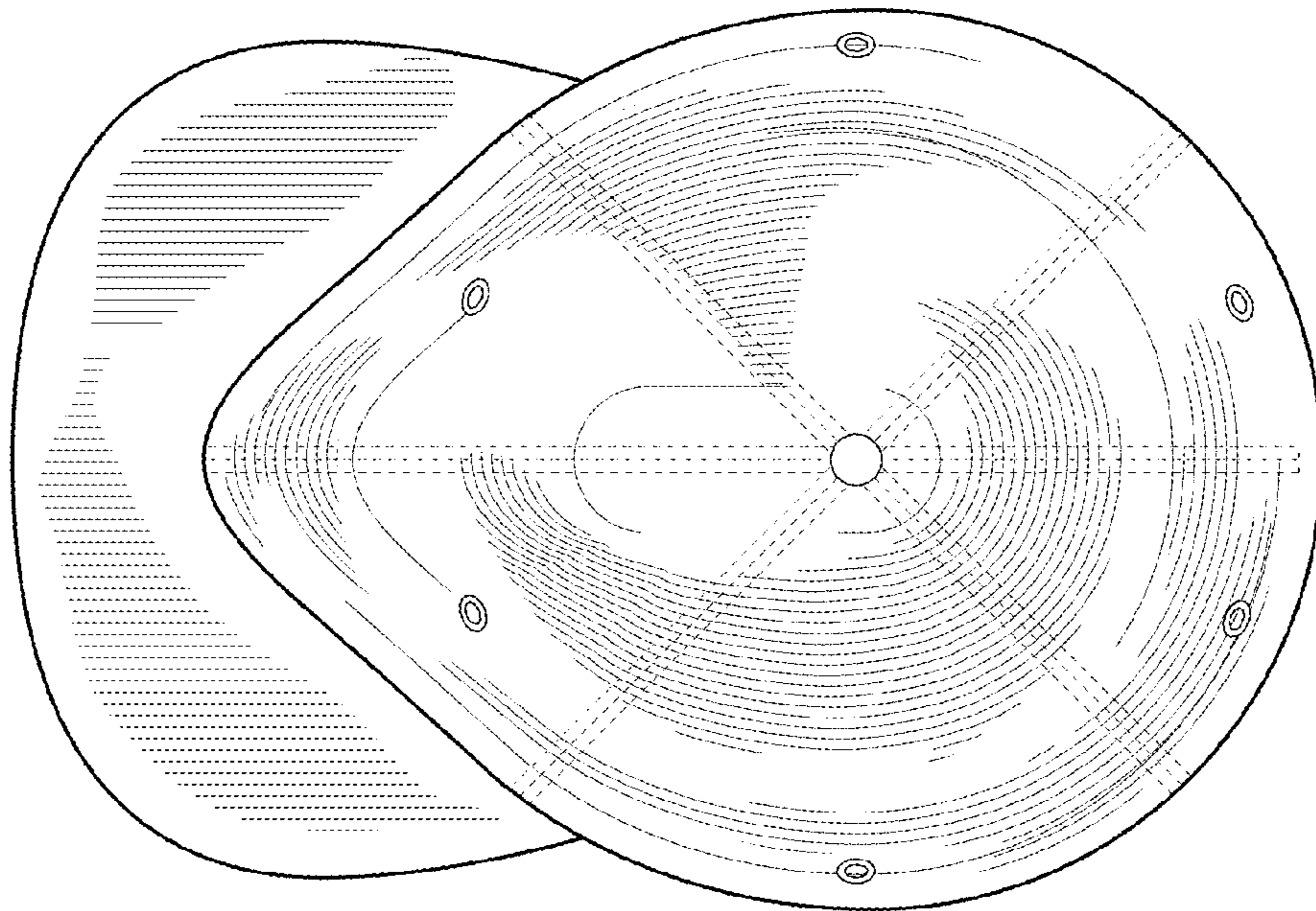
