I claim the ornamental design for a staining and sealing brush head and cap combination, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a staining and sealing brush head, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

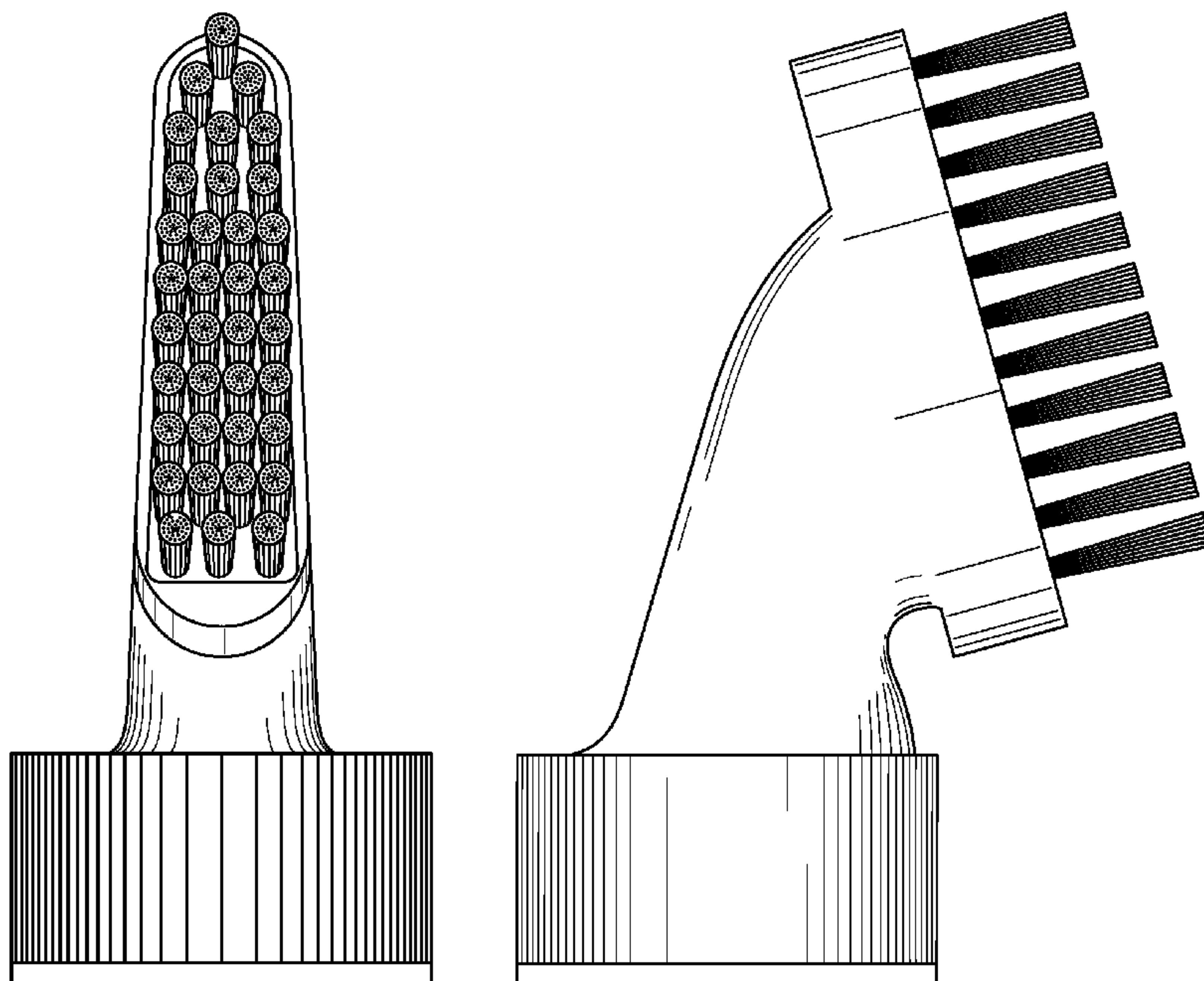
FIG. 4 is an enlarged right-side elevational view thereof, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

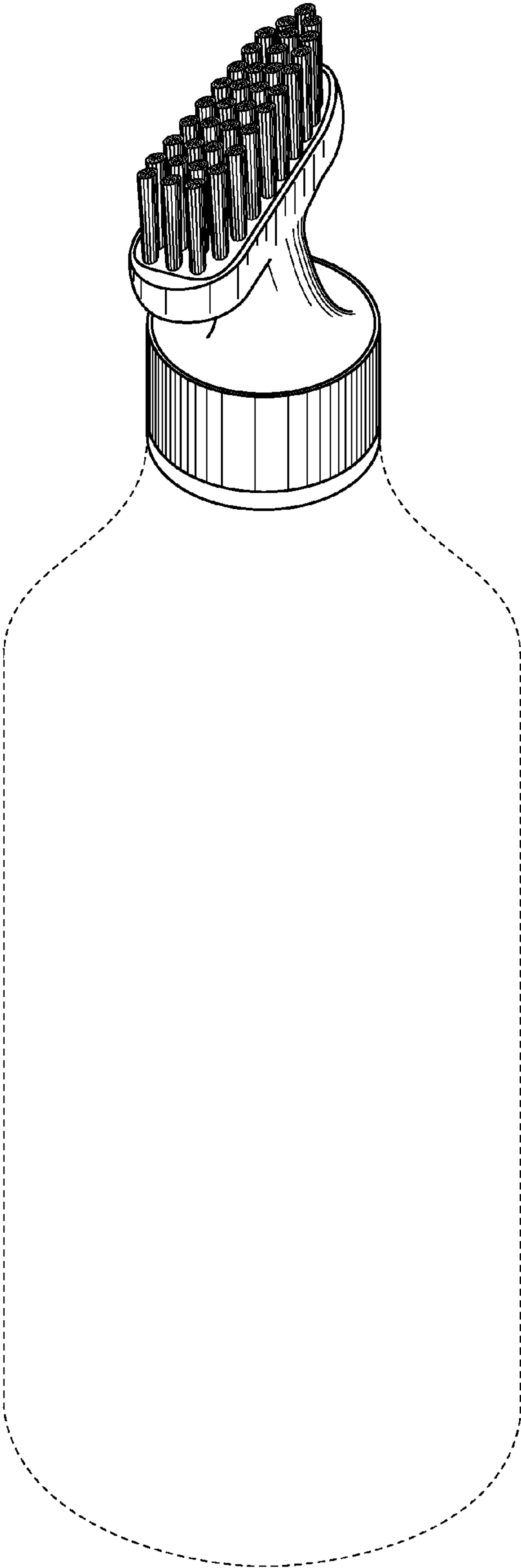

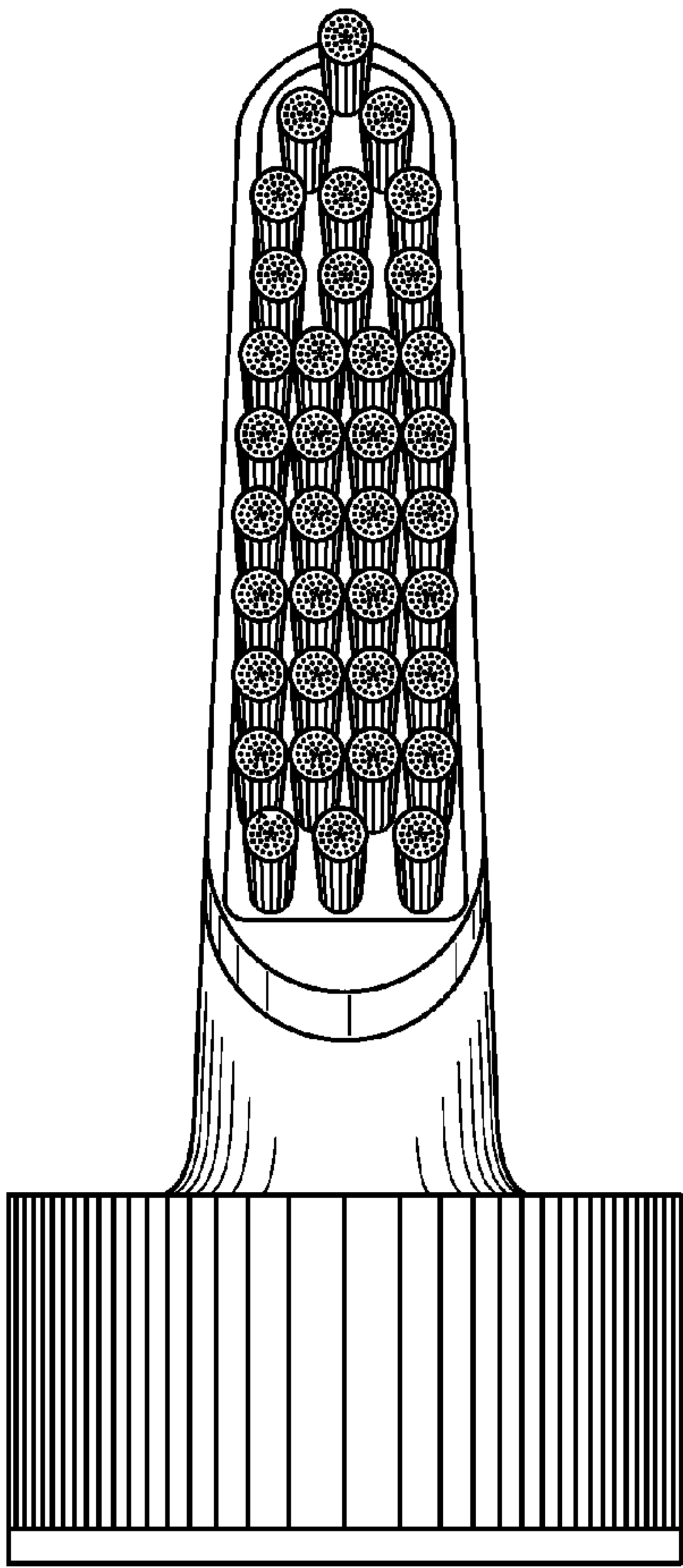

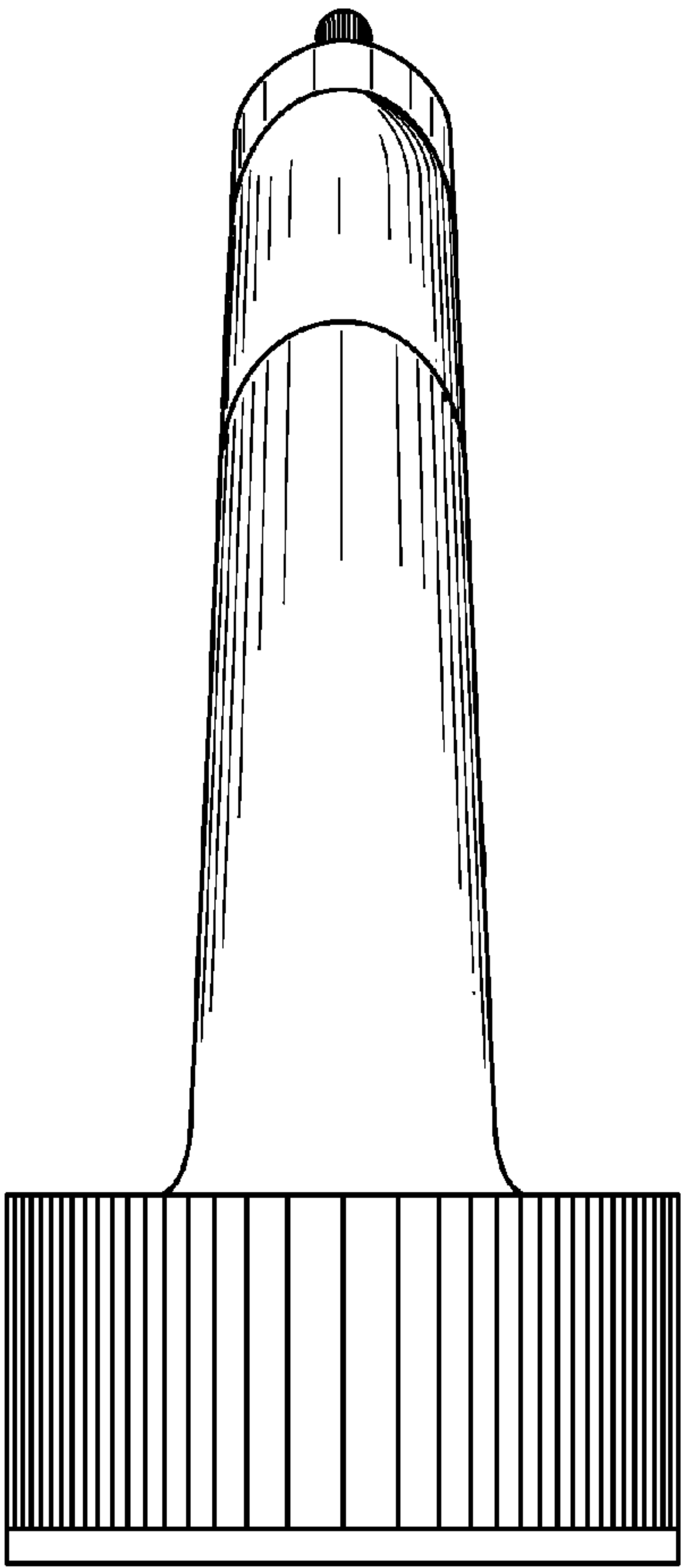

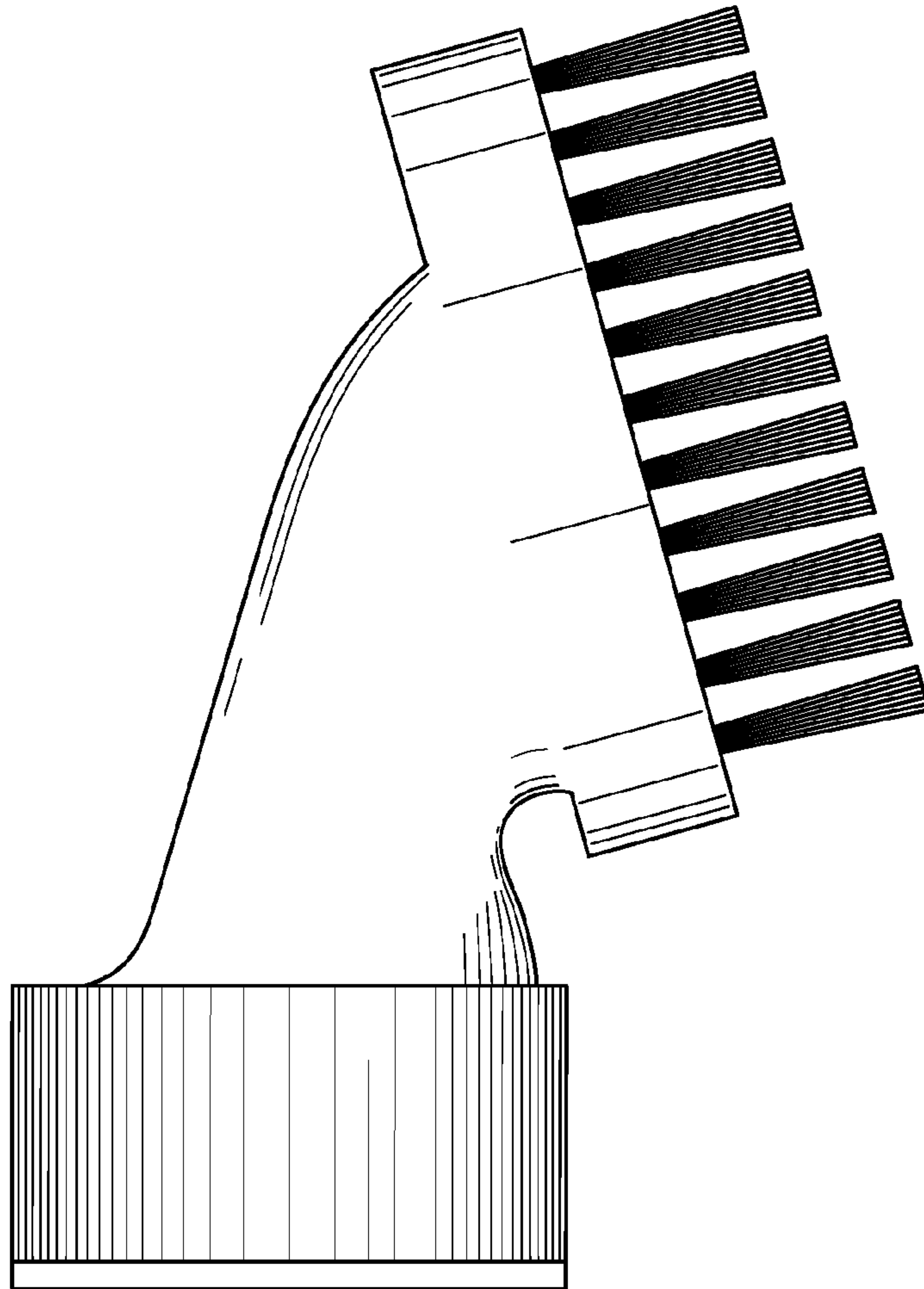

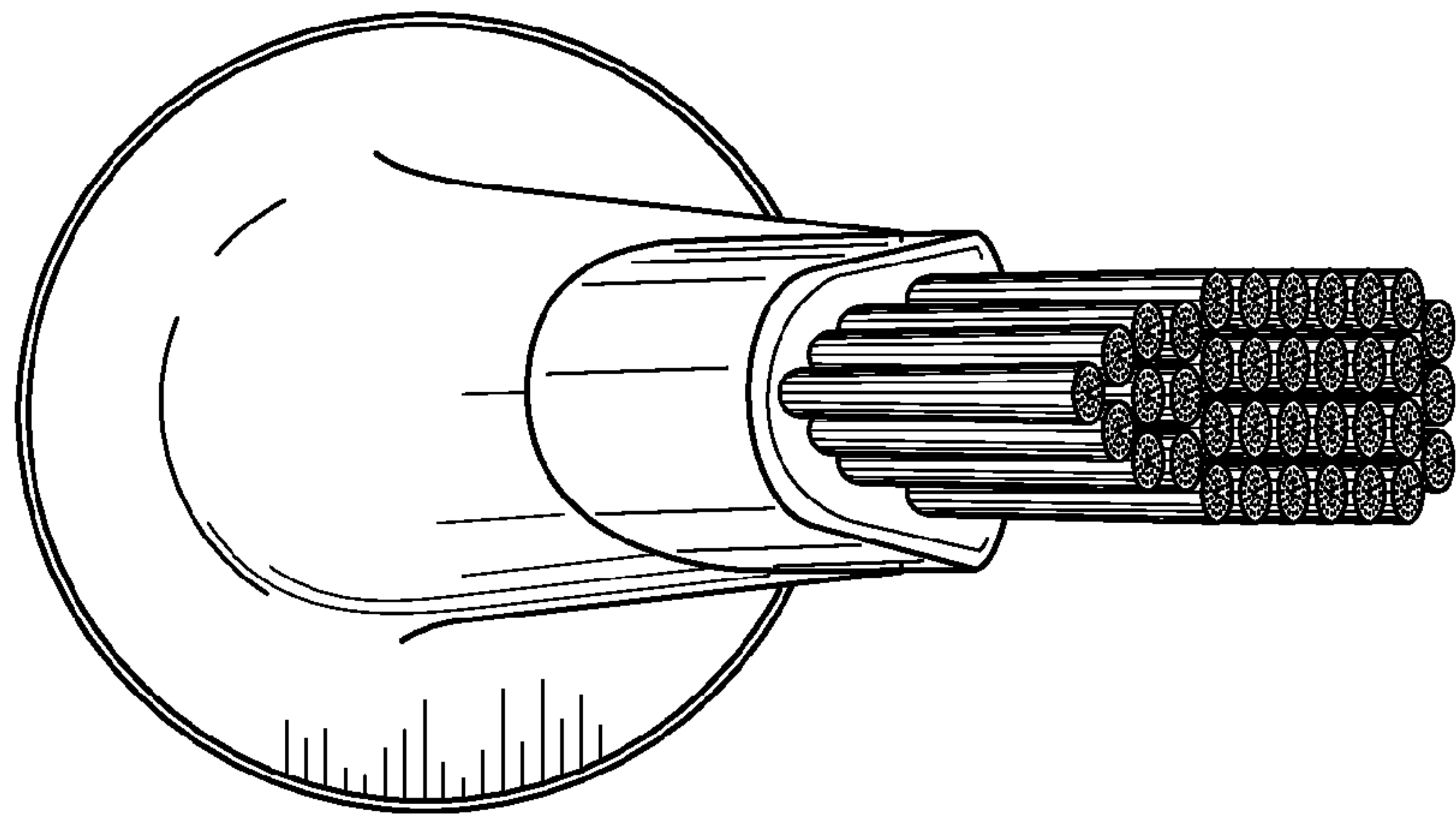

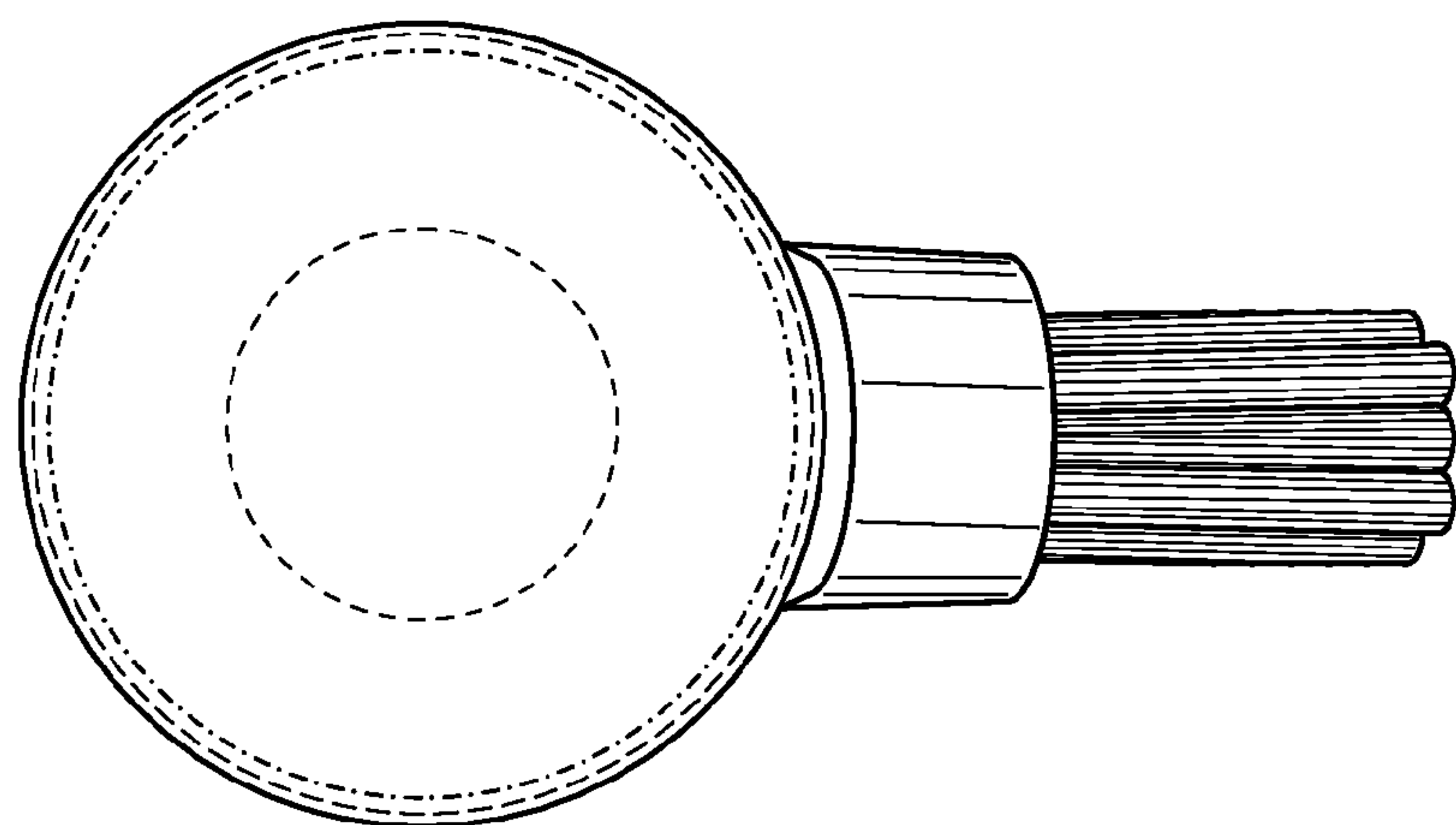
