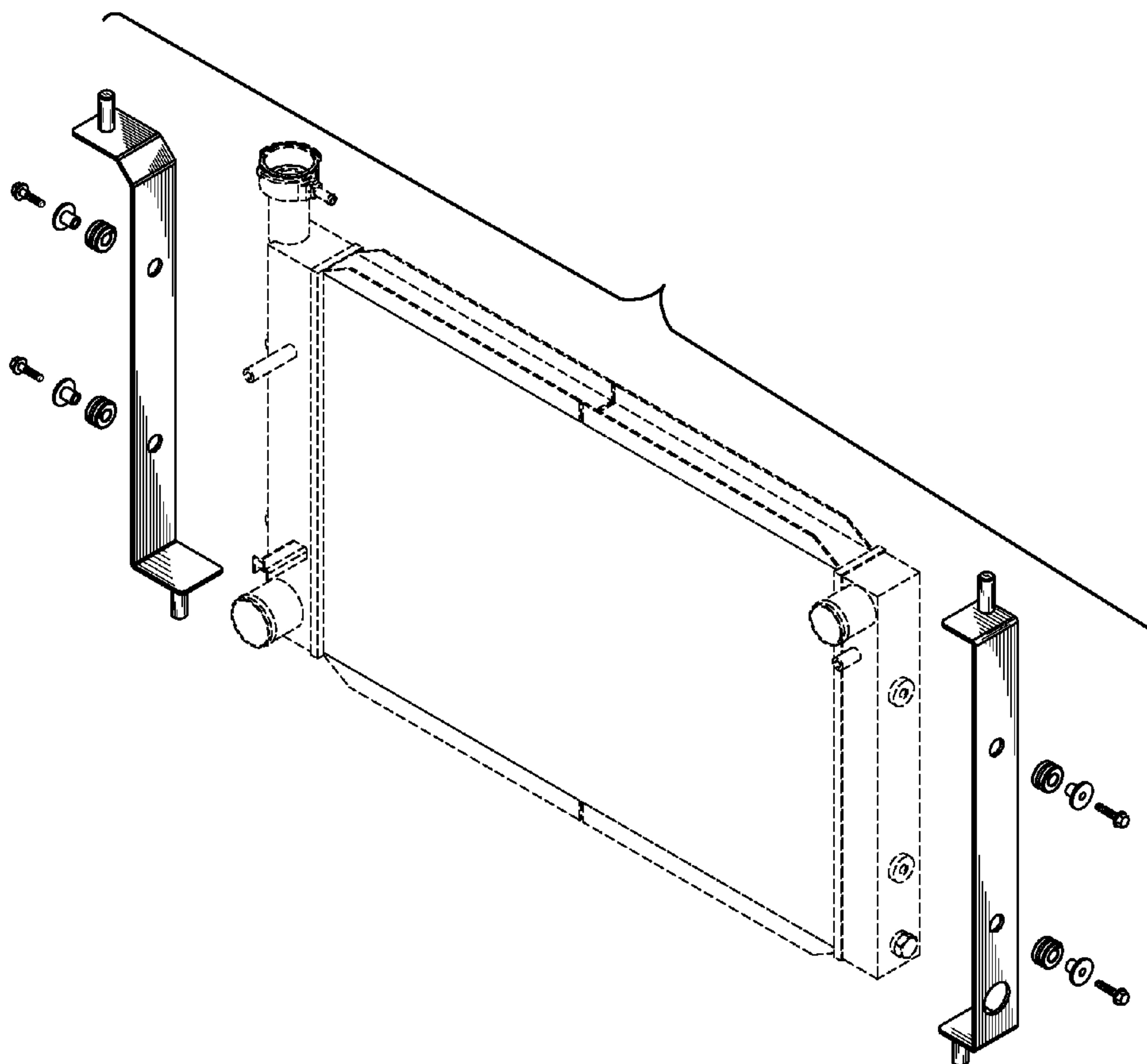
We claim the ornamental design for a set of radiator brackets, as shown and described.

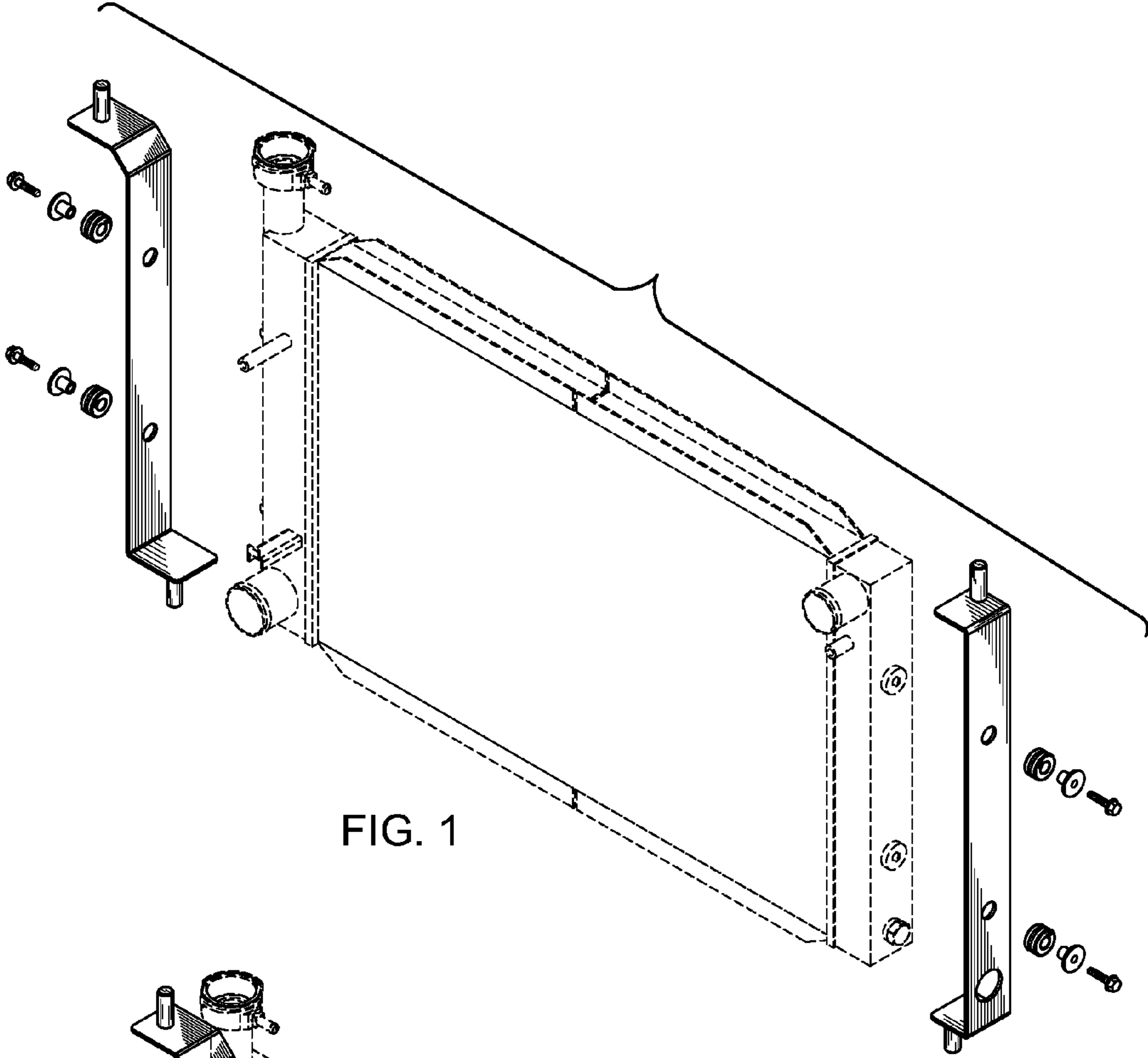

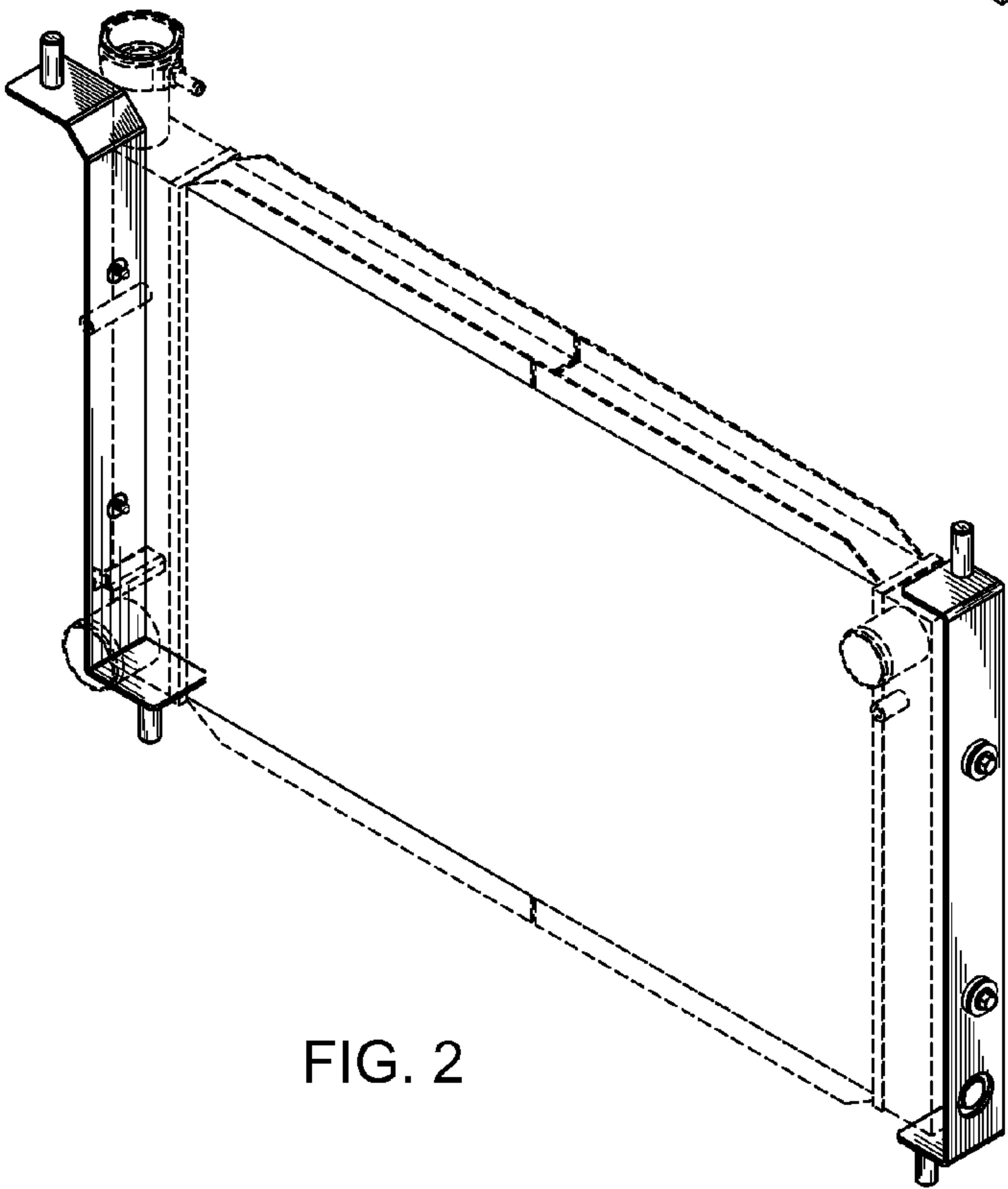

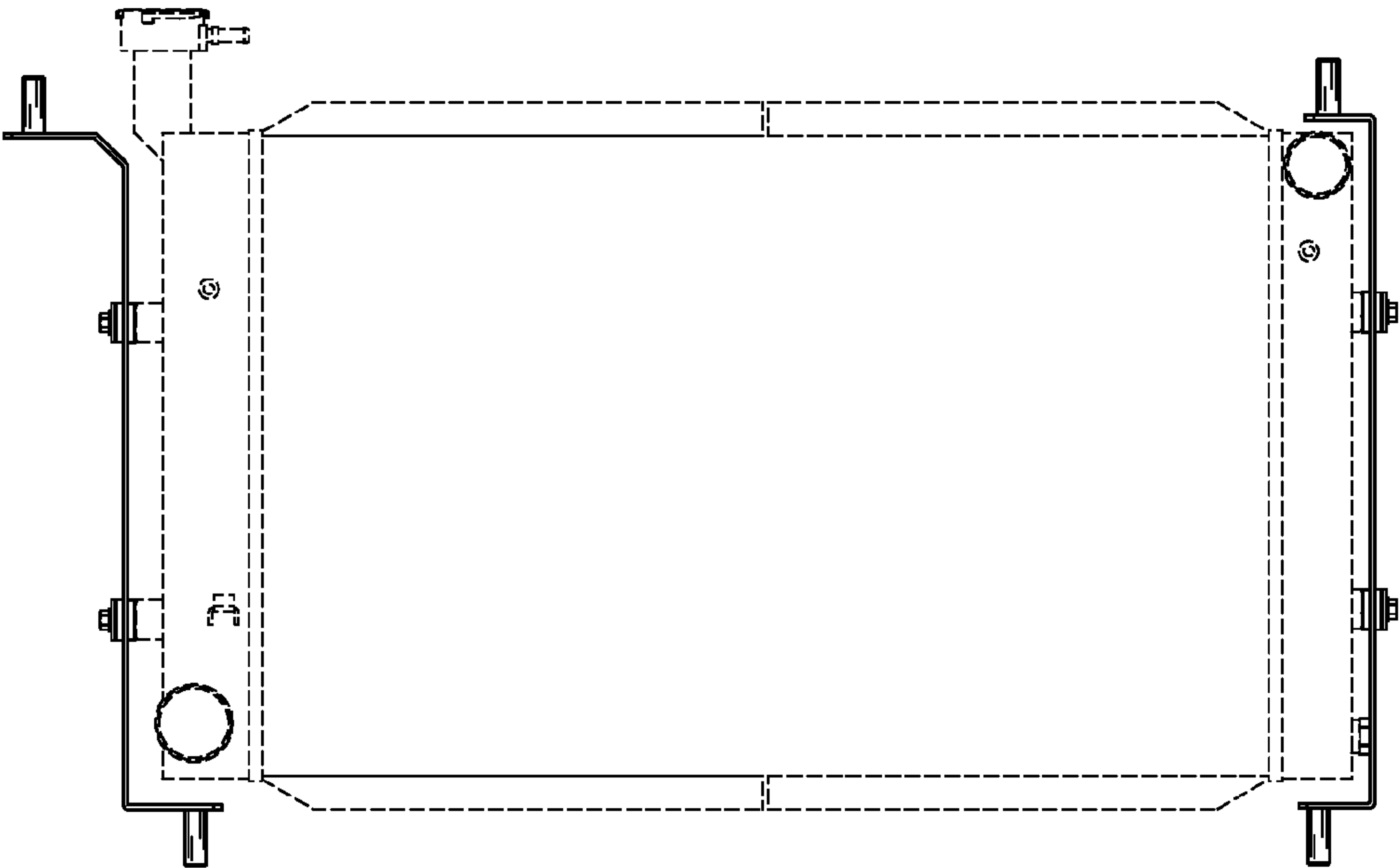

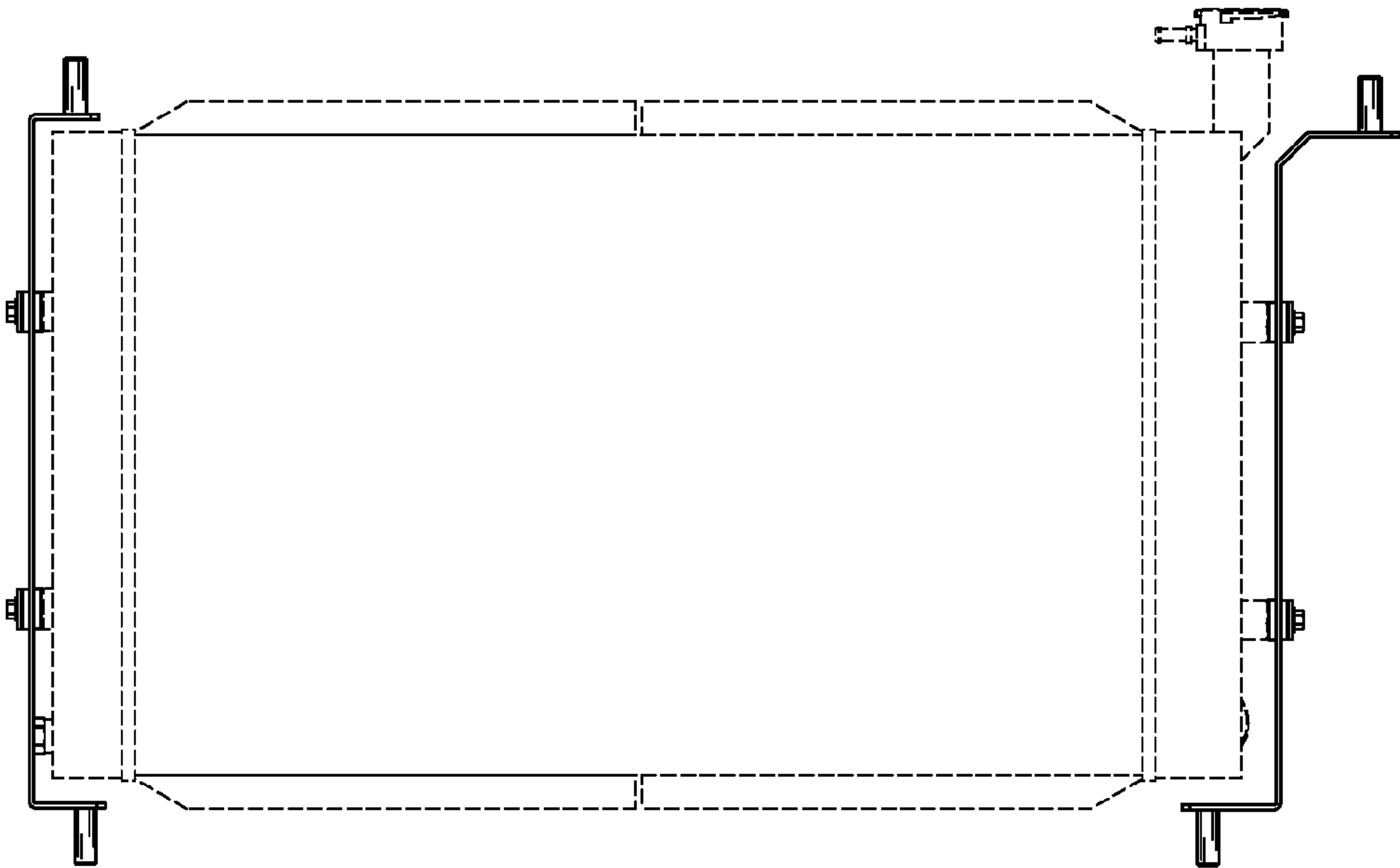

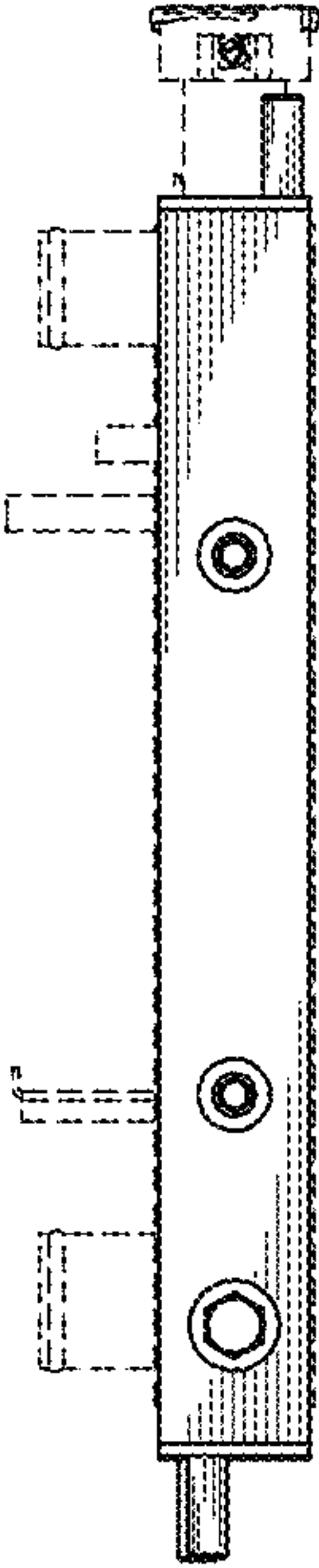

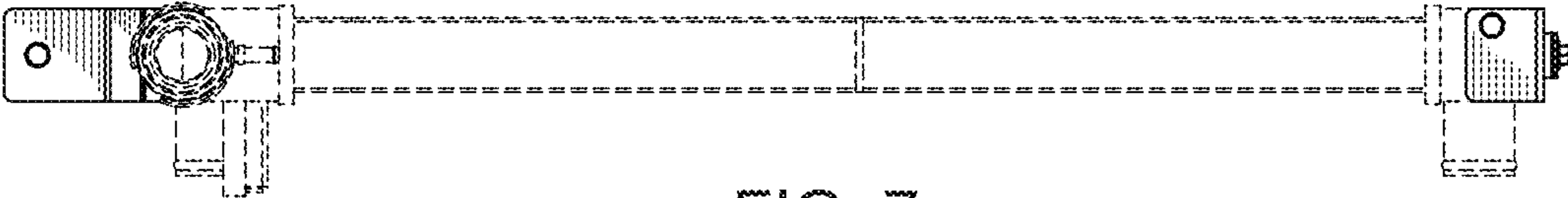

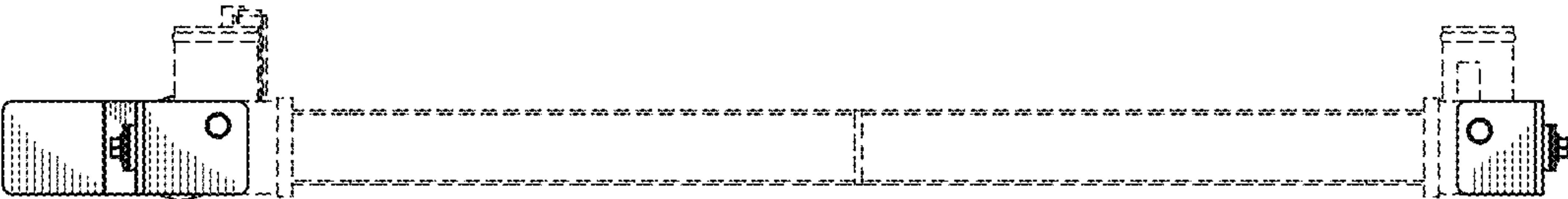
