FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view thereof.

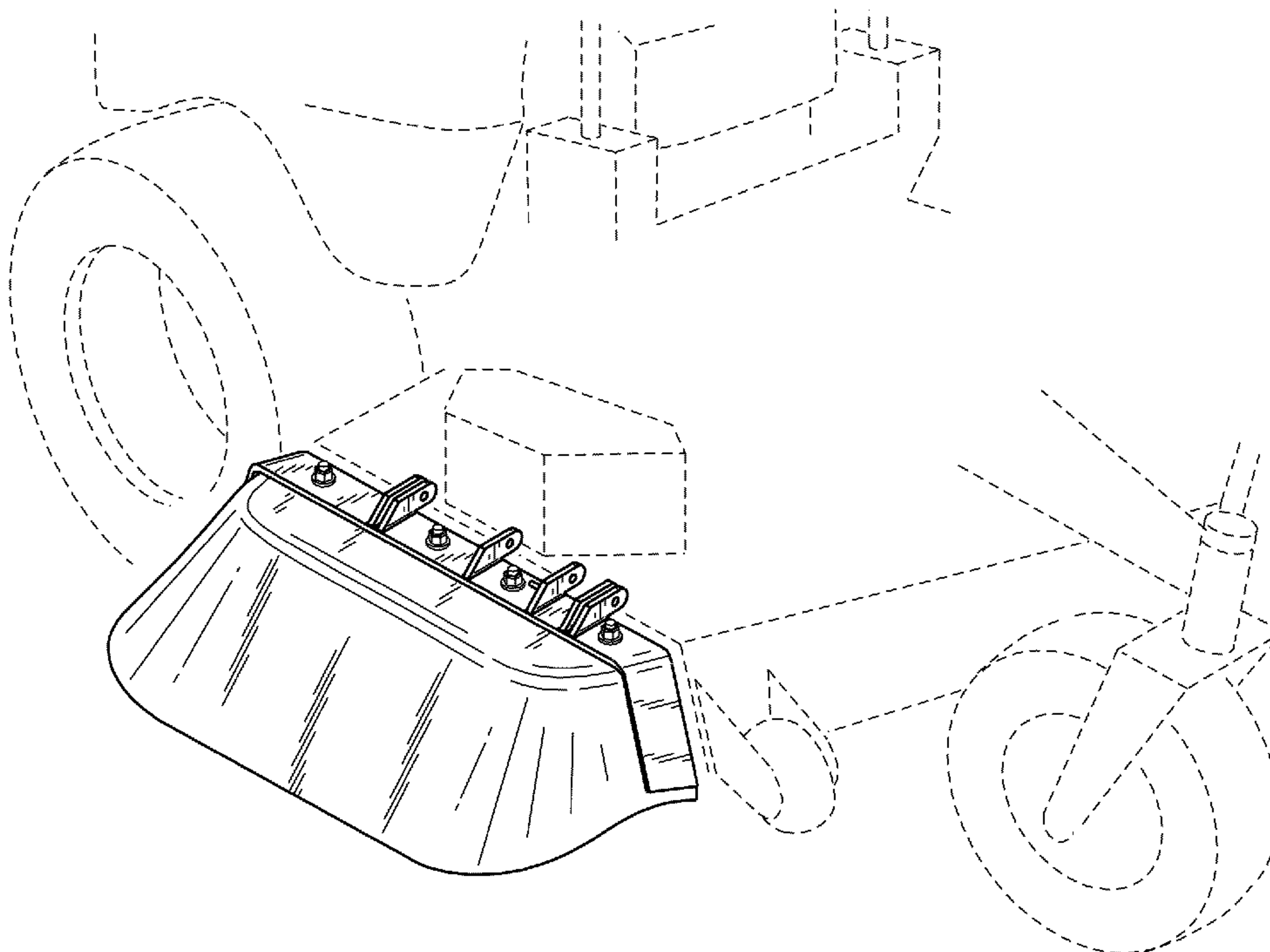
The broken lines showing a lawn mower in FIG. 1 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

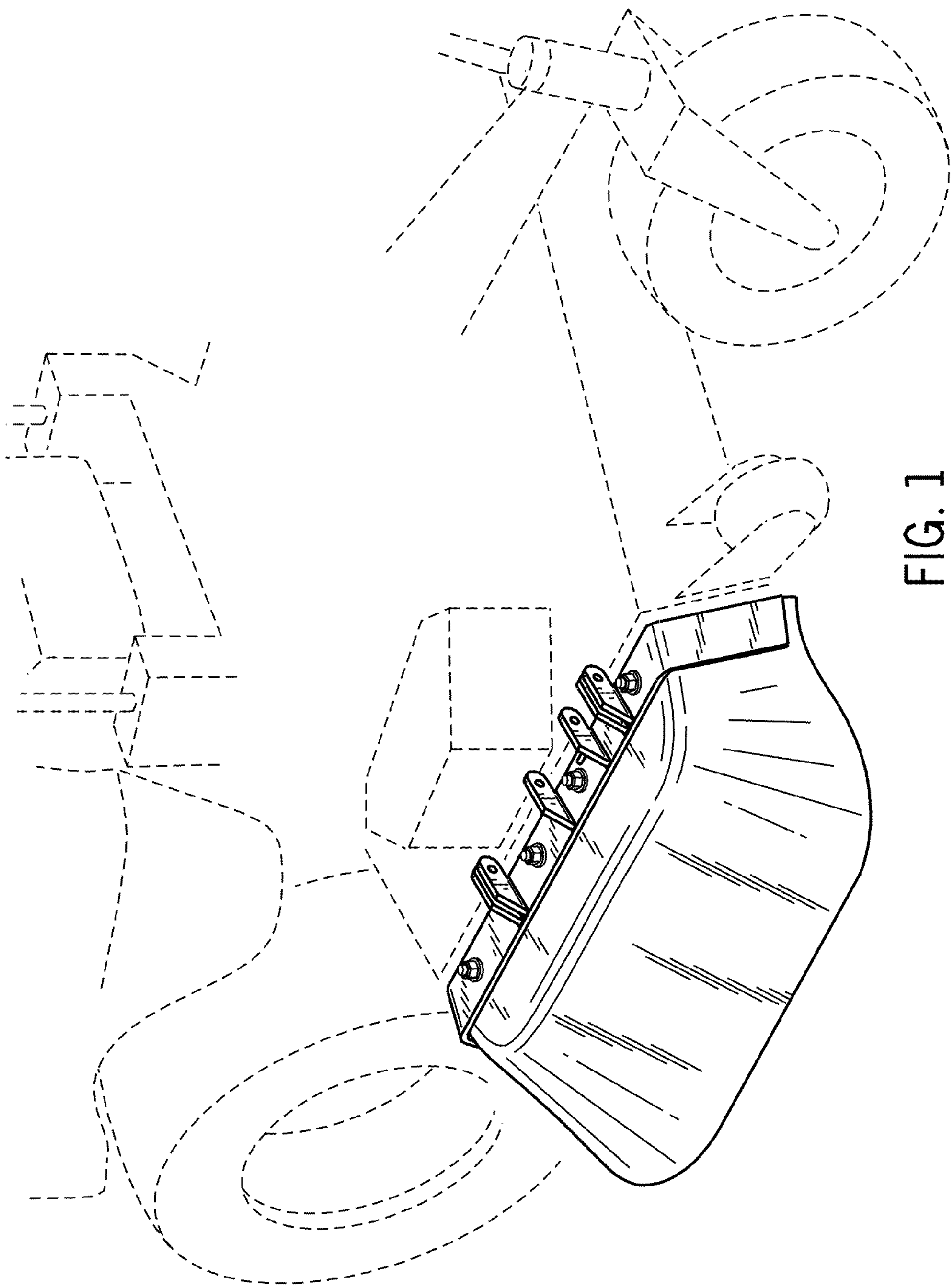

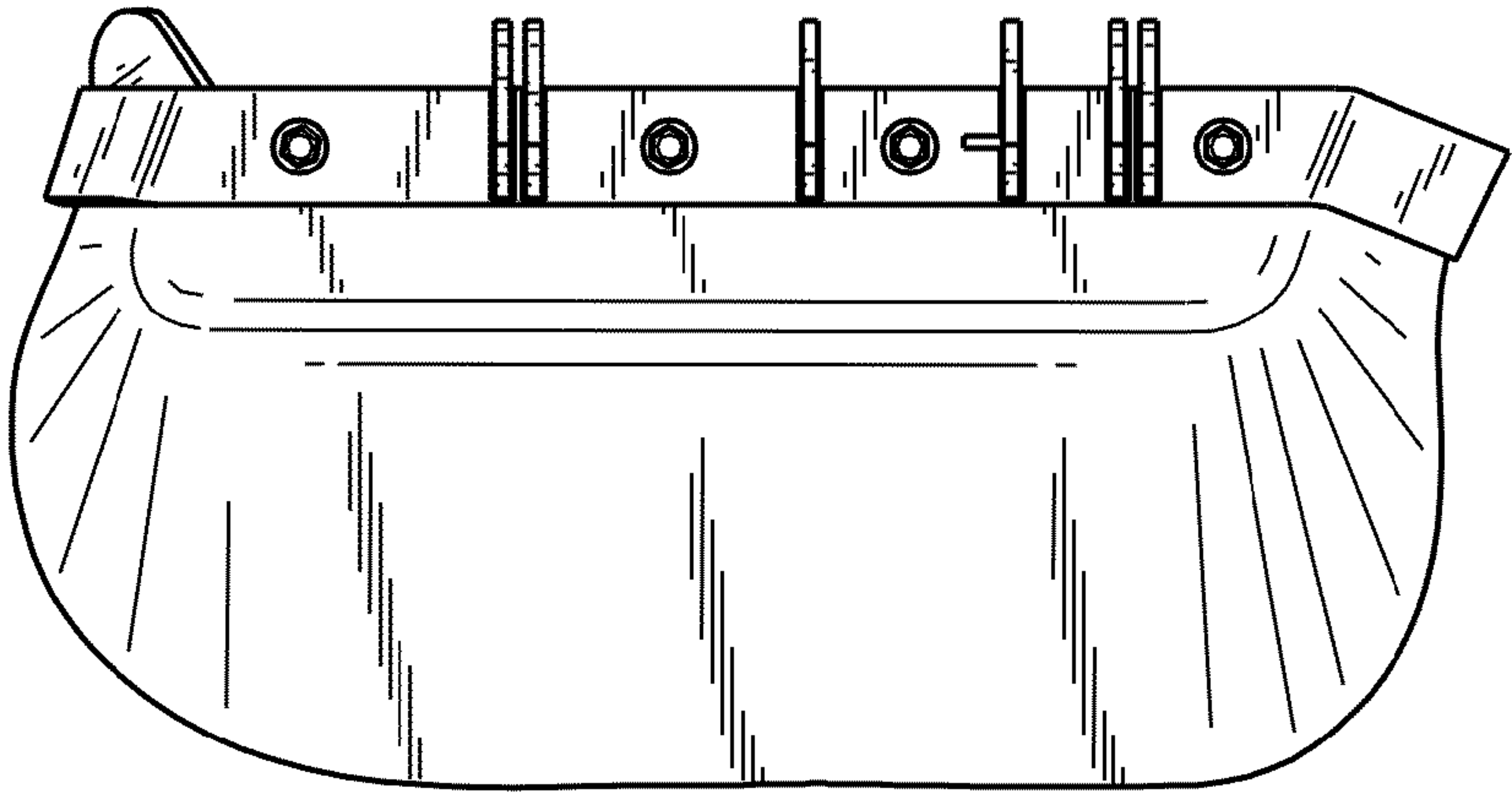

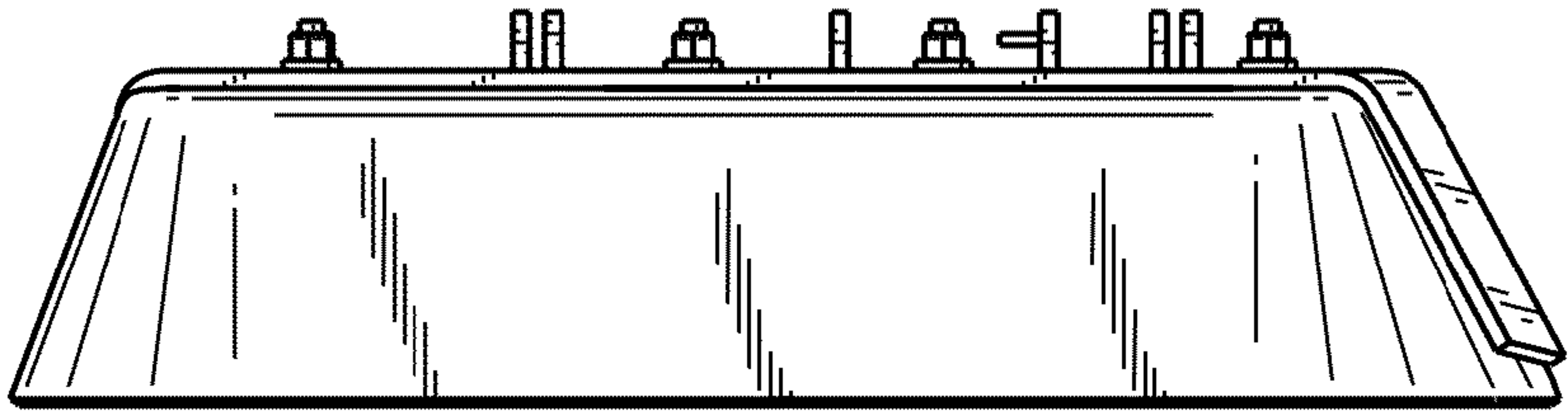
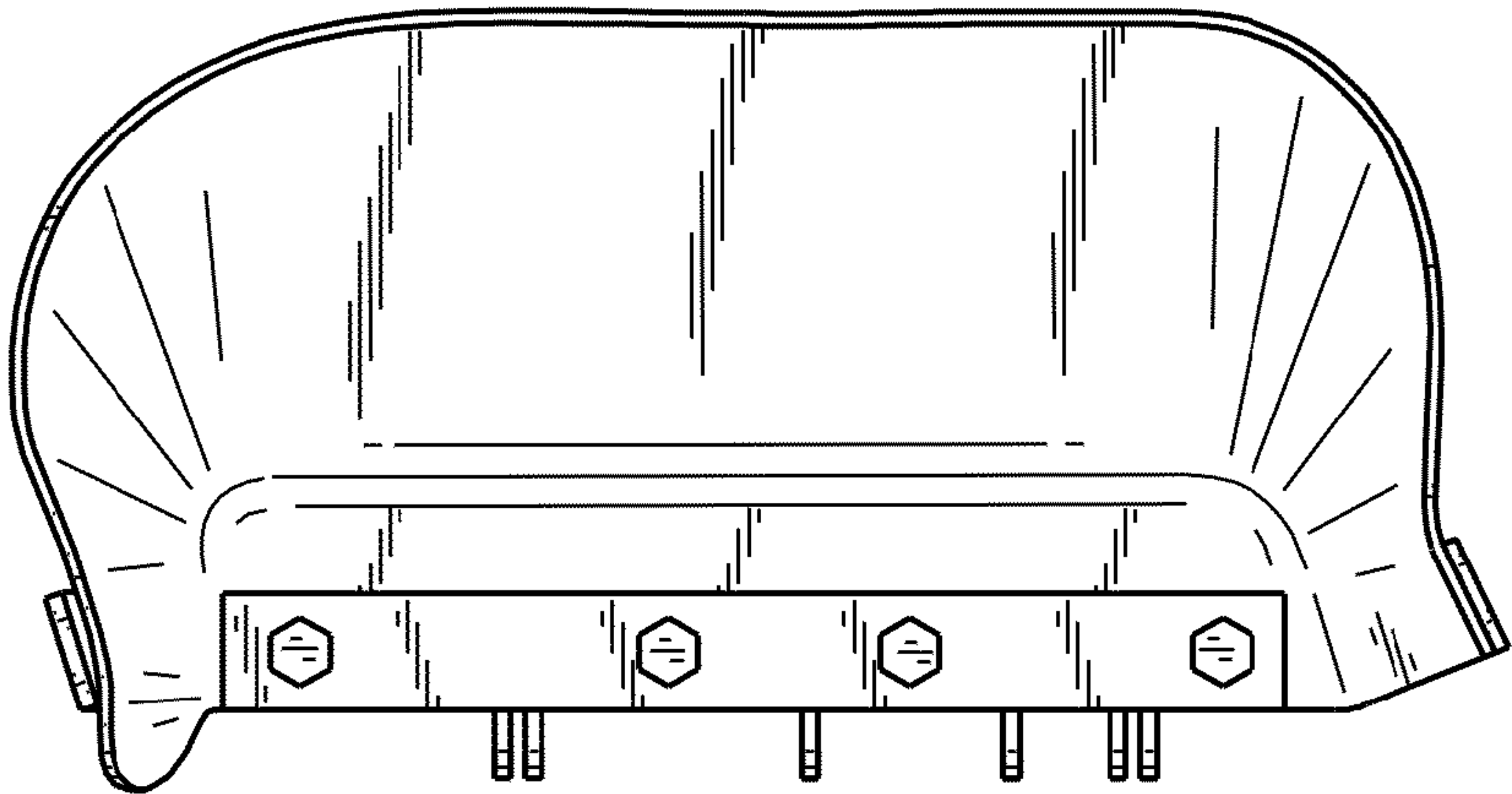

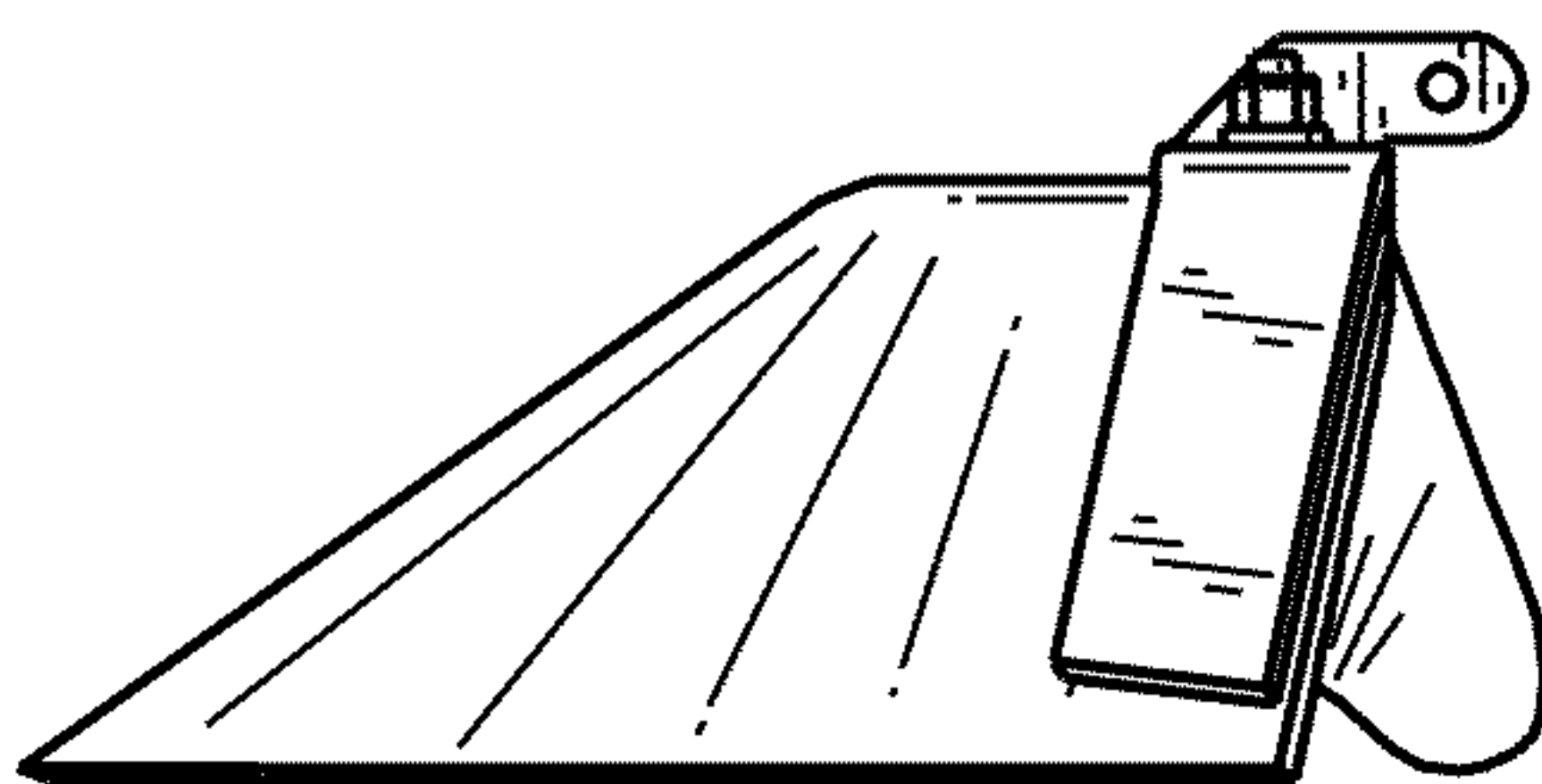

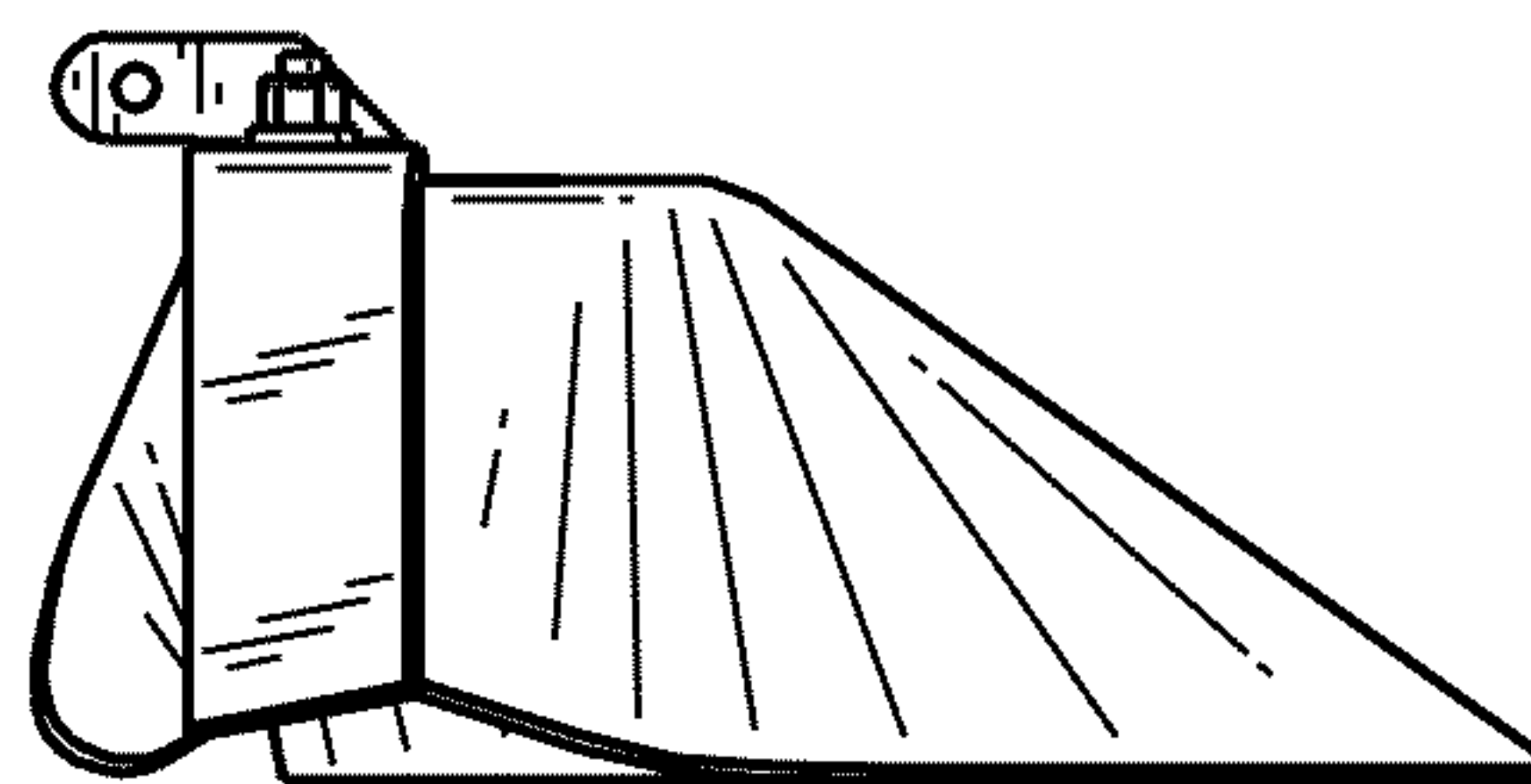
