with my design;

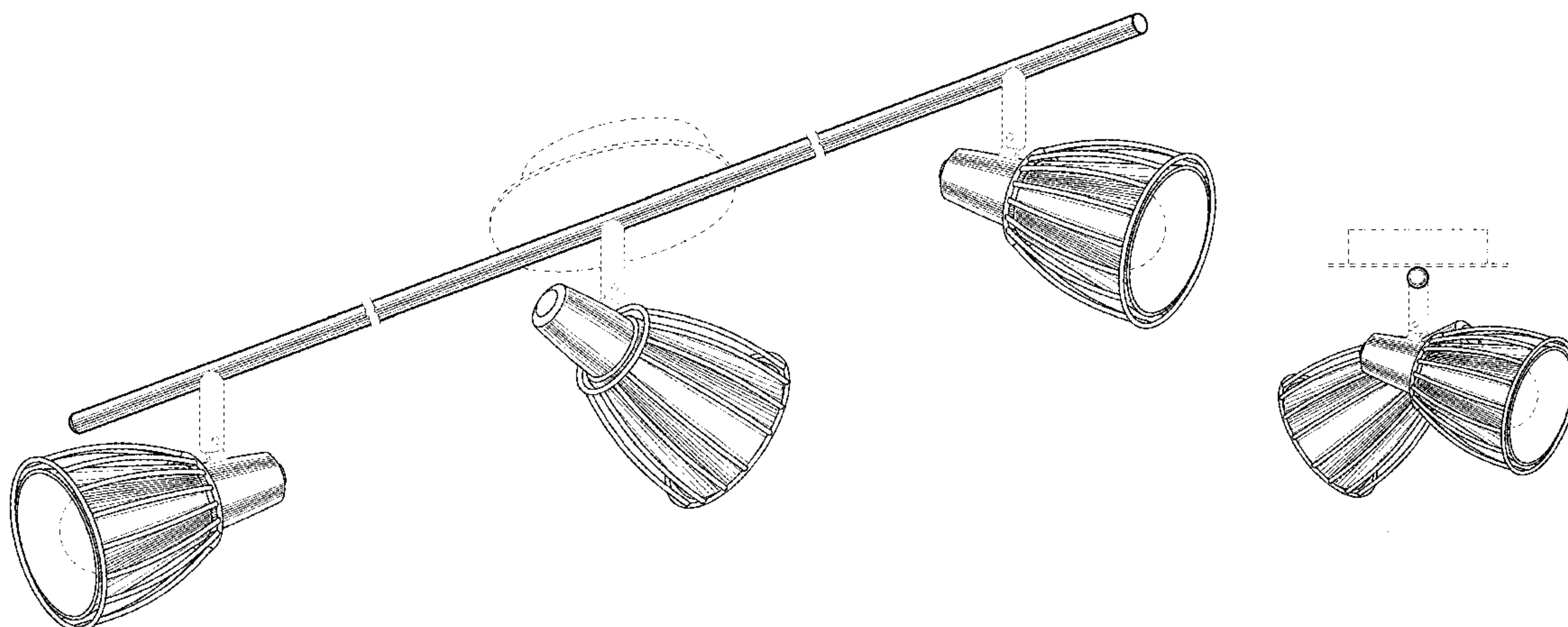
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the light fixture in accordance

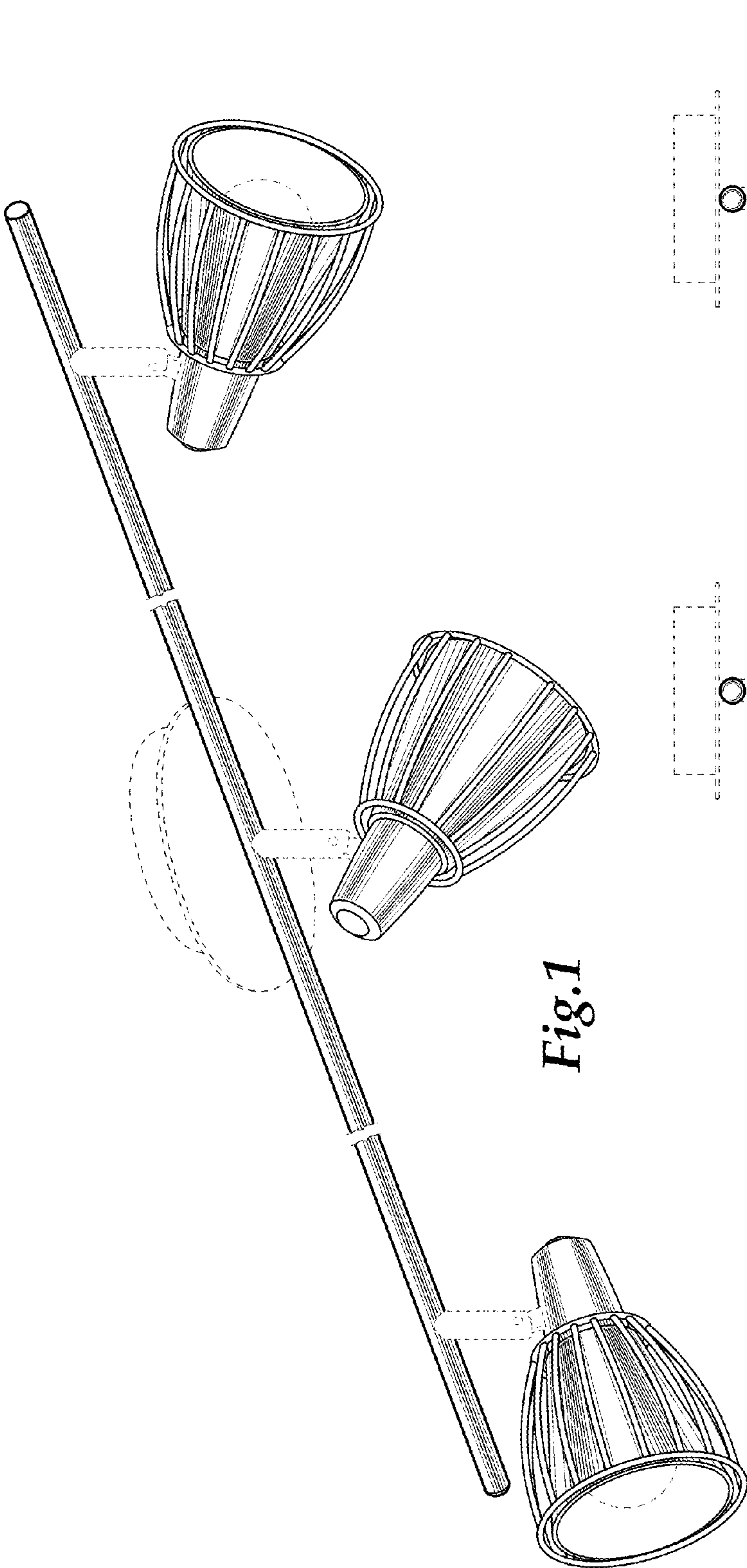

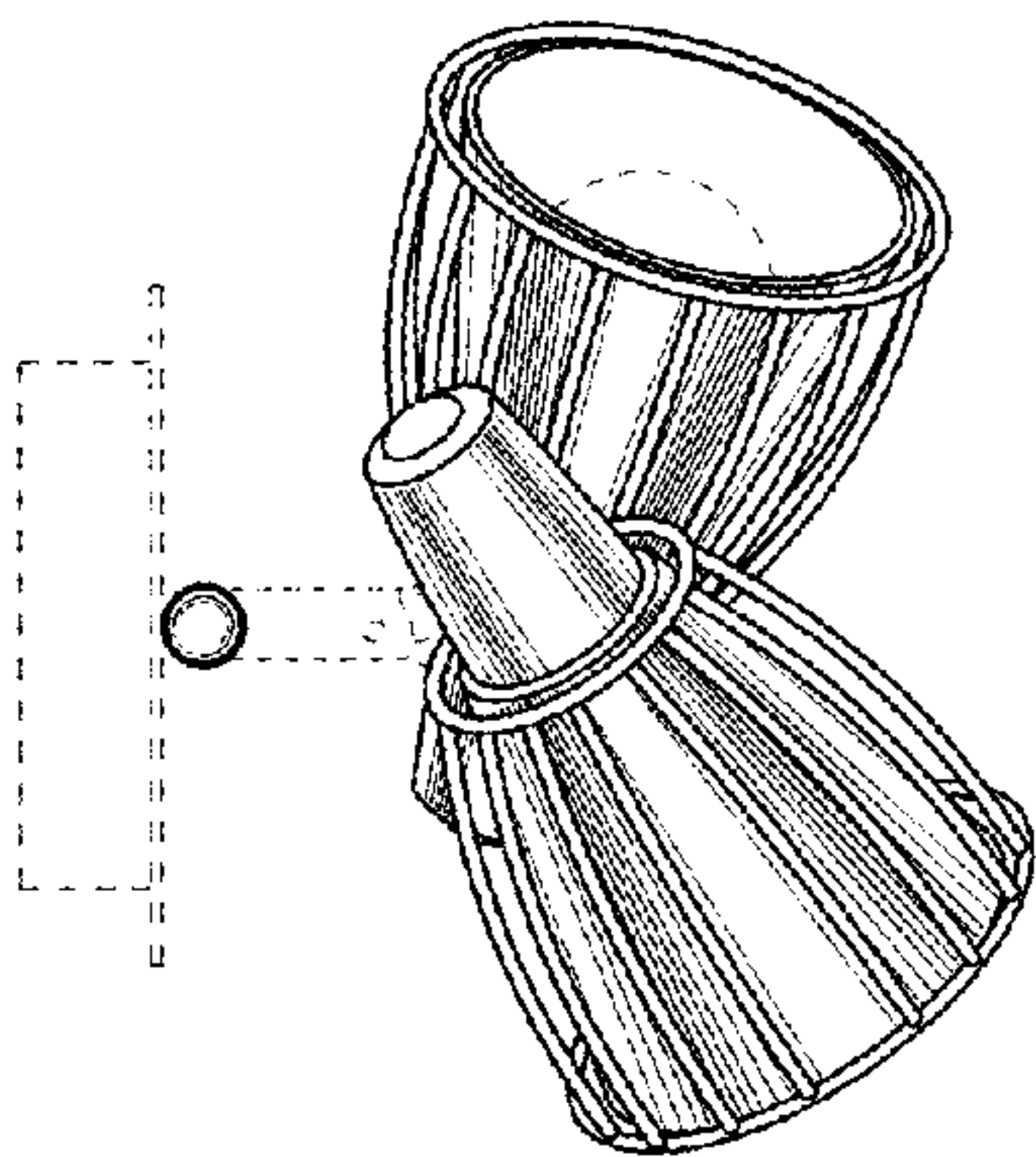

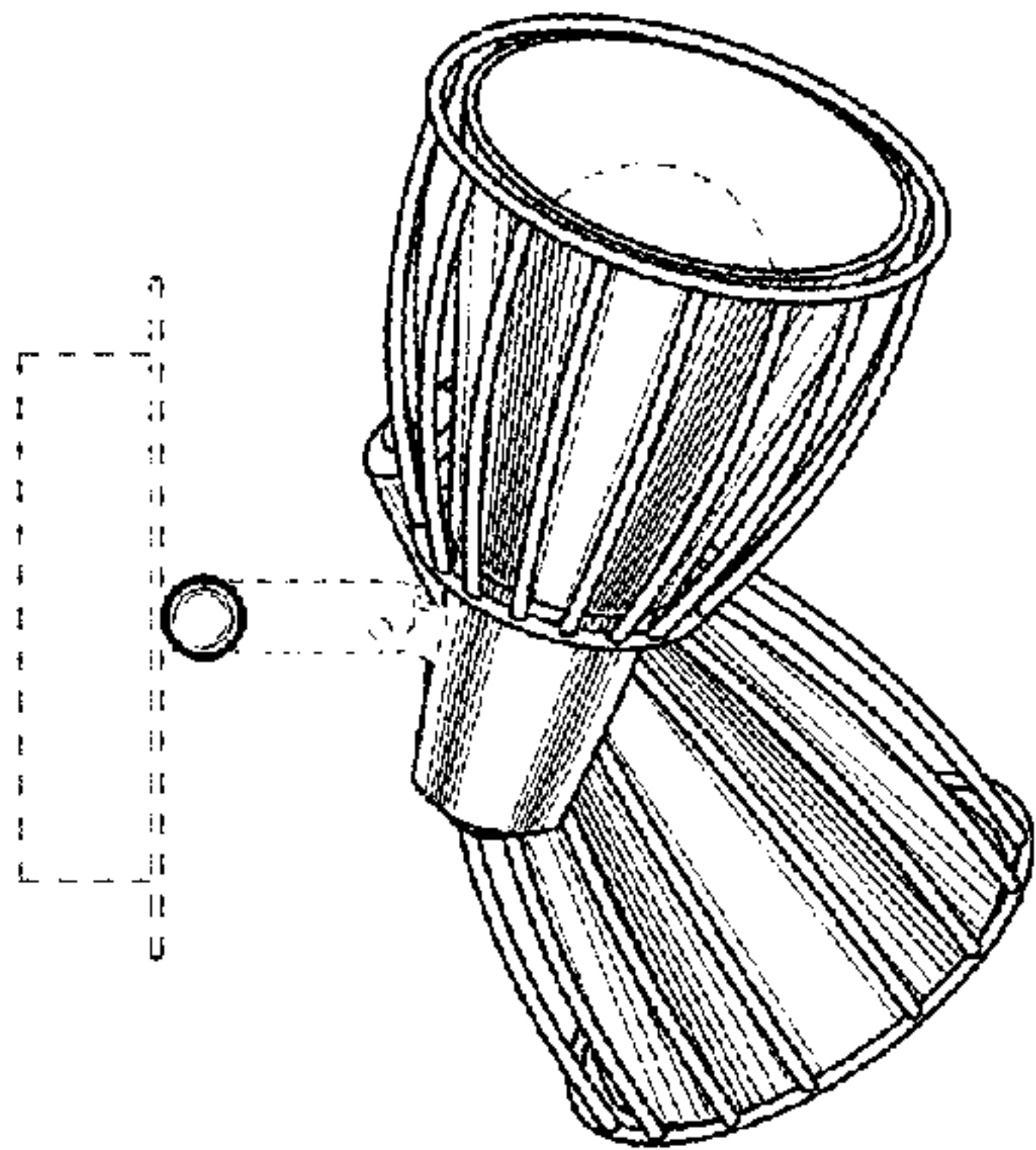

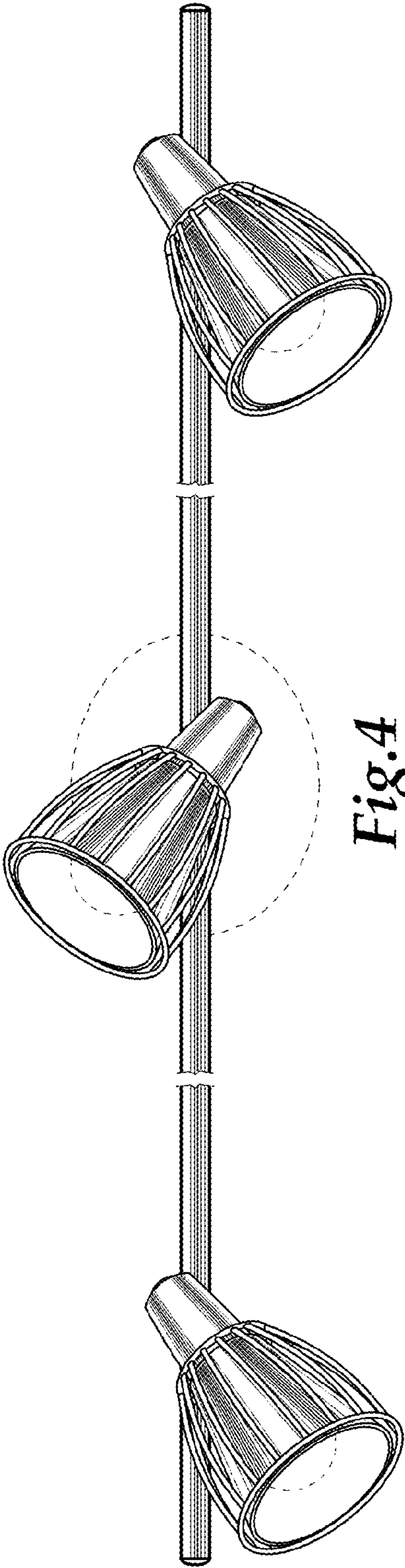

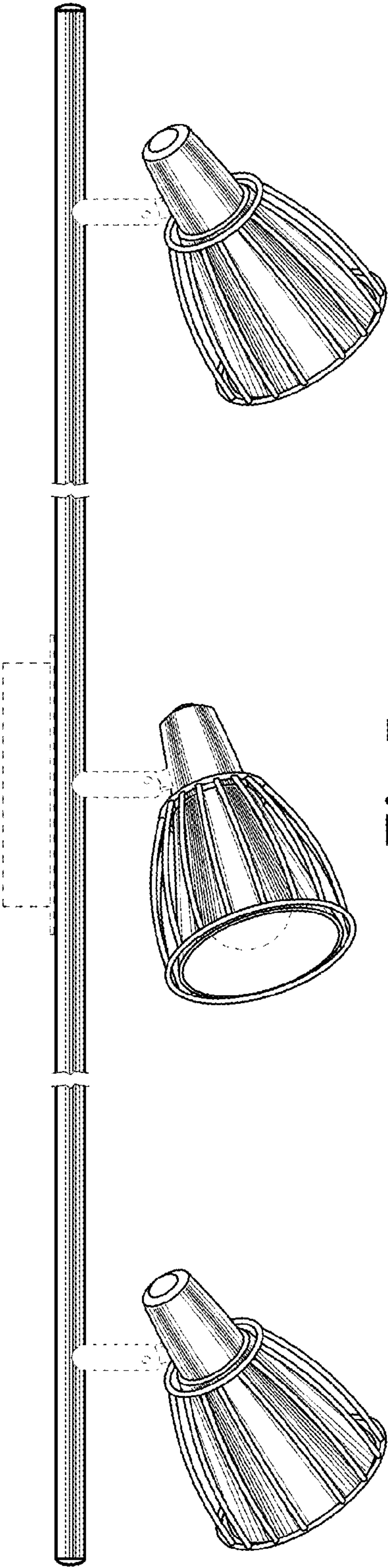
