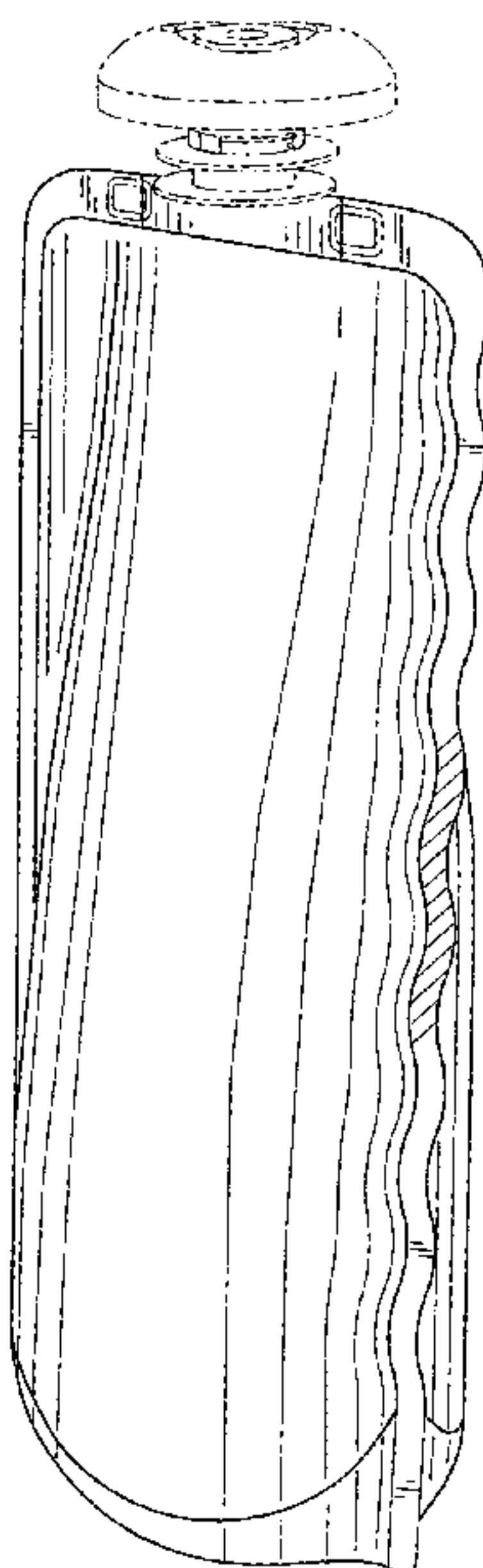
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a flexible pouch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front of a flexible pouch; FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the front of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a plan bottom view of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the side of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the back of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is an elevational view of the other side of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 7 is a plan top view of the flexible pouch of FIG. 1. It should be appreciated that the broken lines are merely illustrative of the environment of the design, and not part of the claimed design.

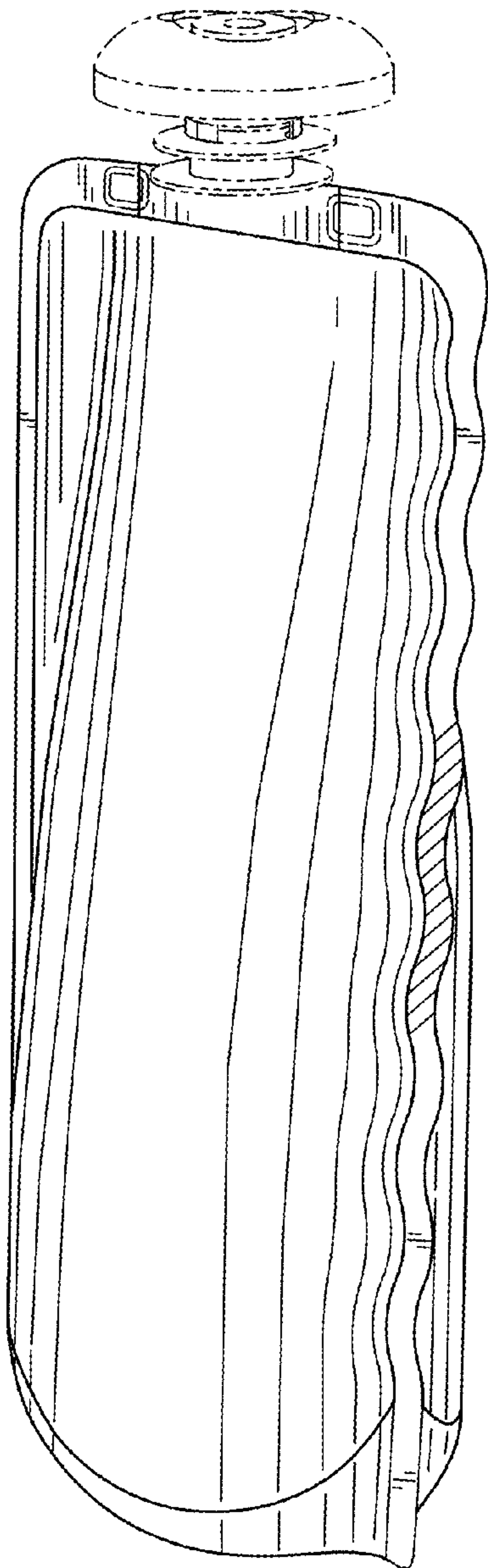

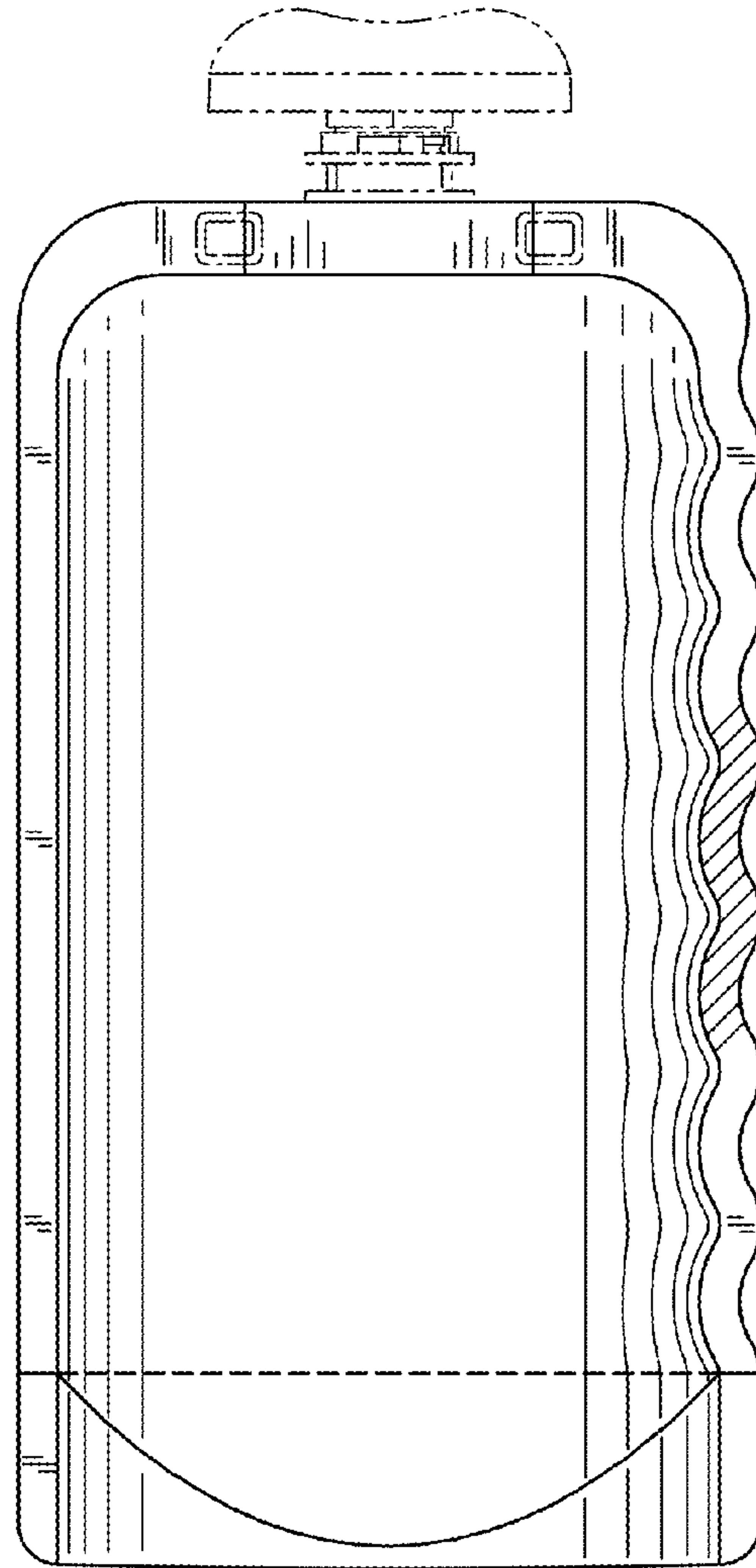

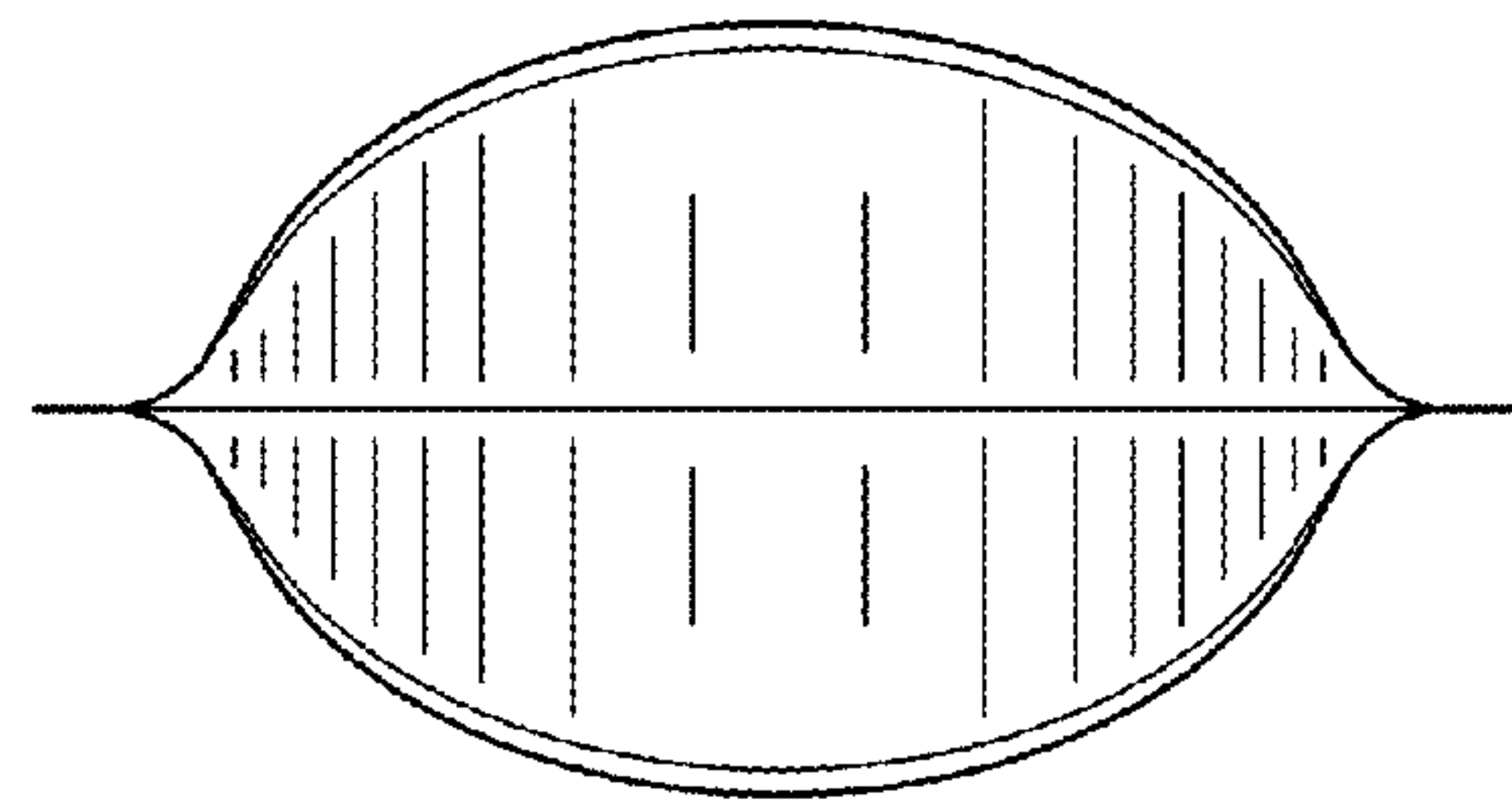

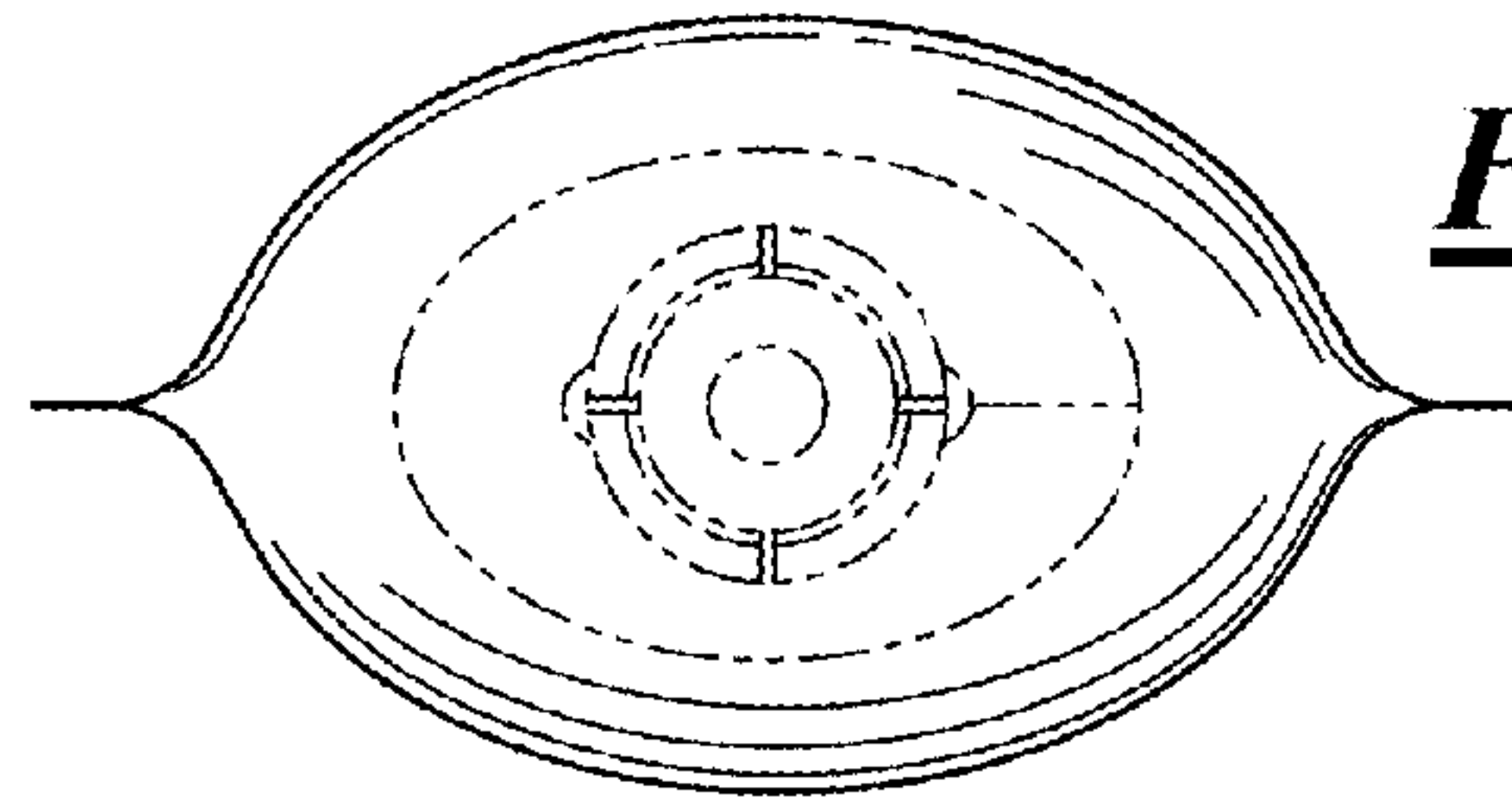

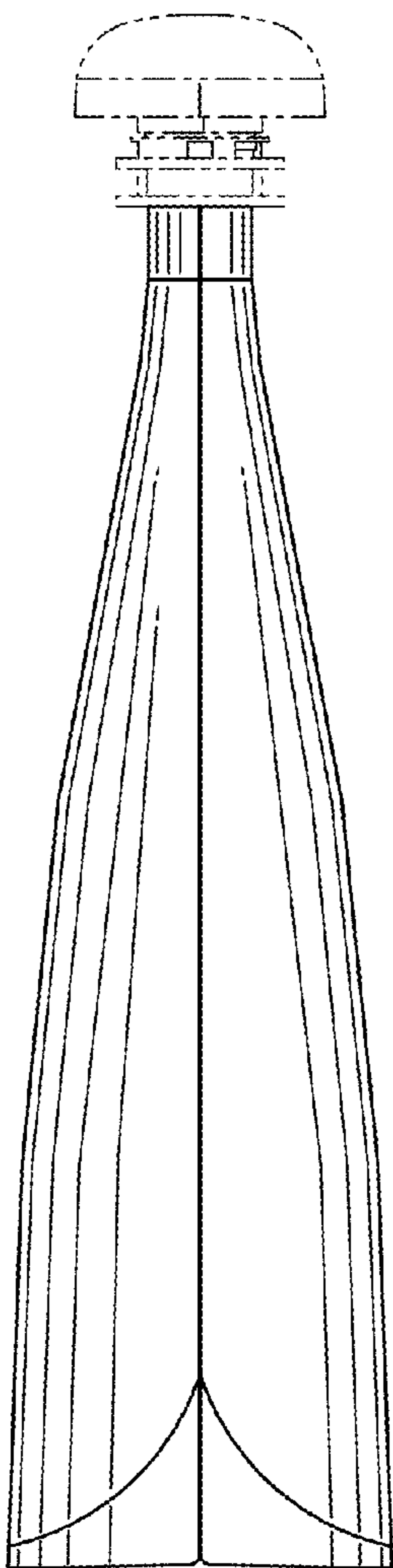

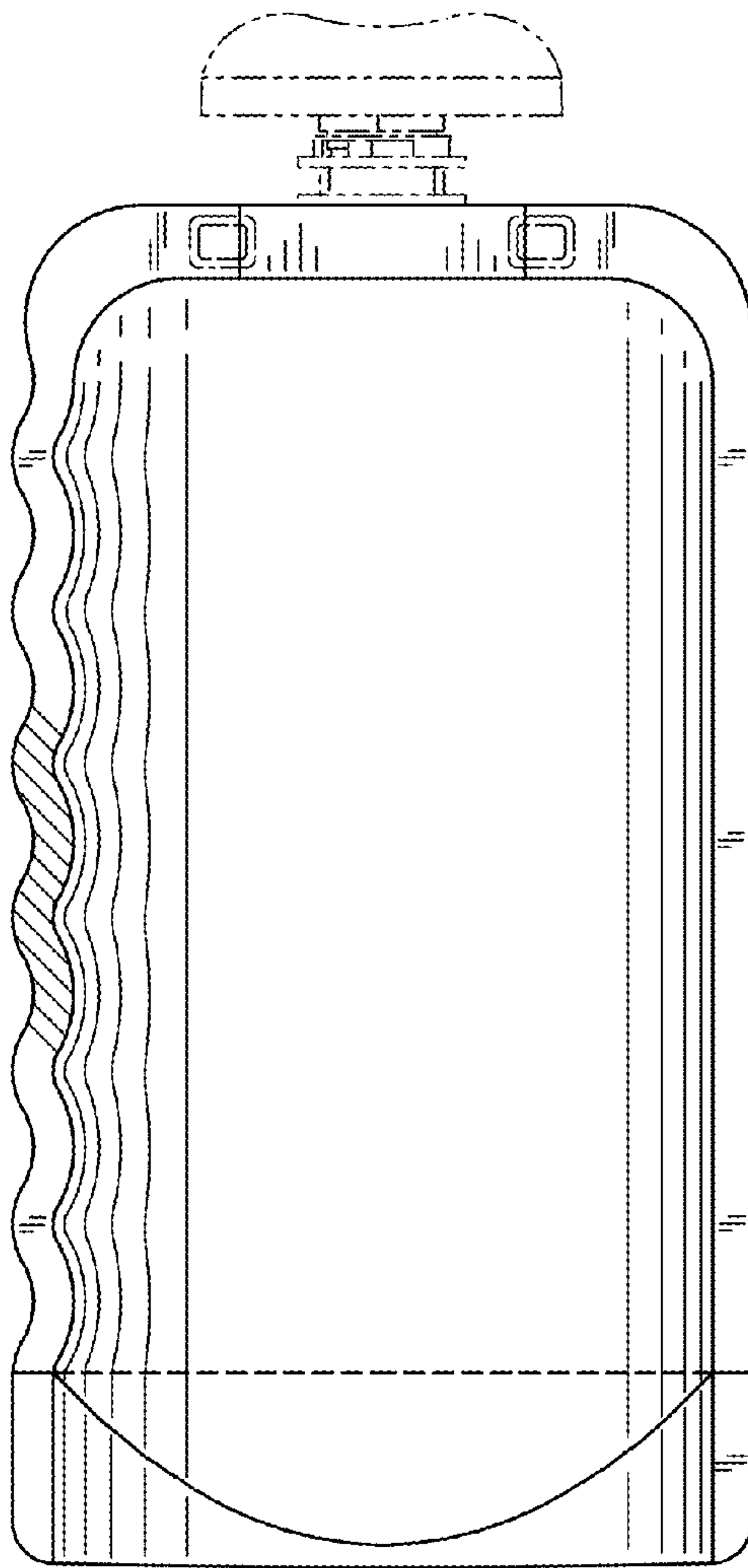

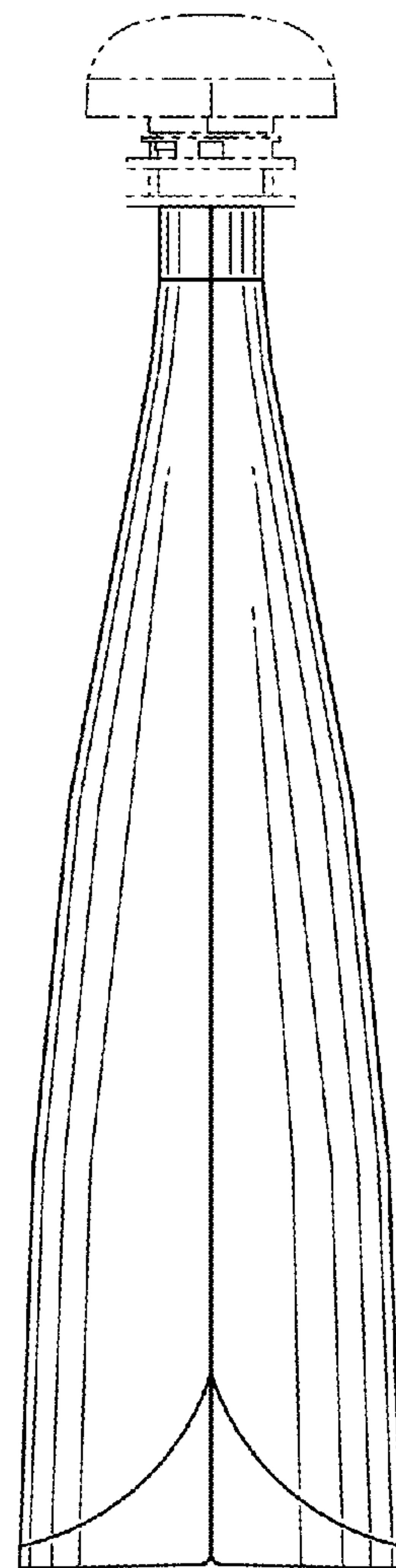
