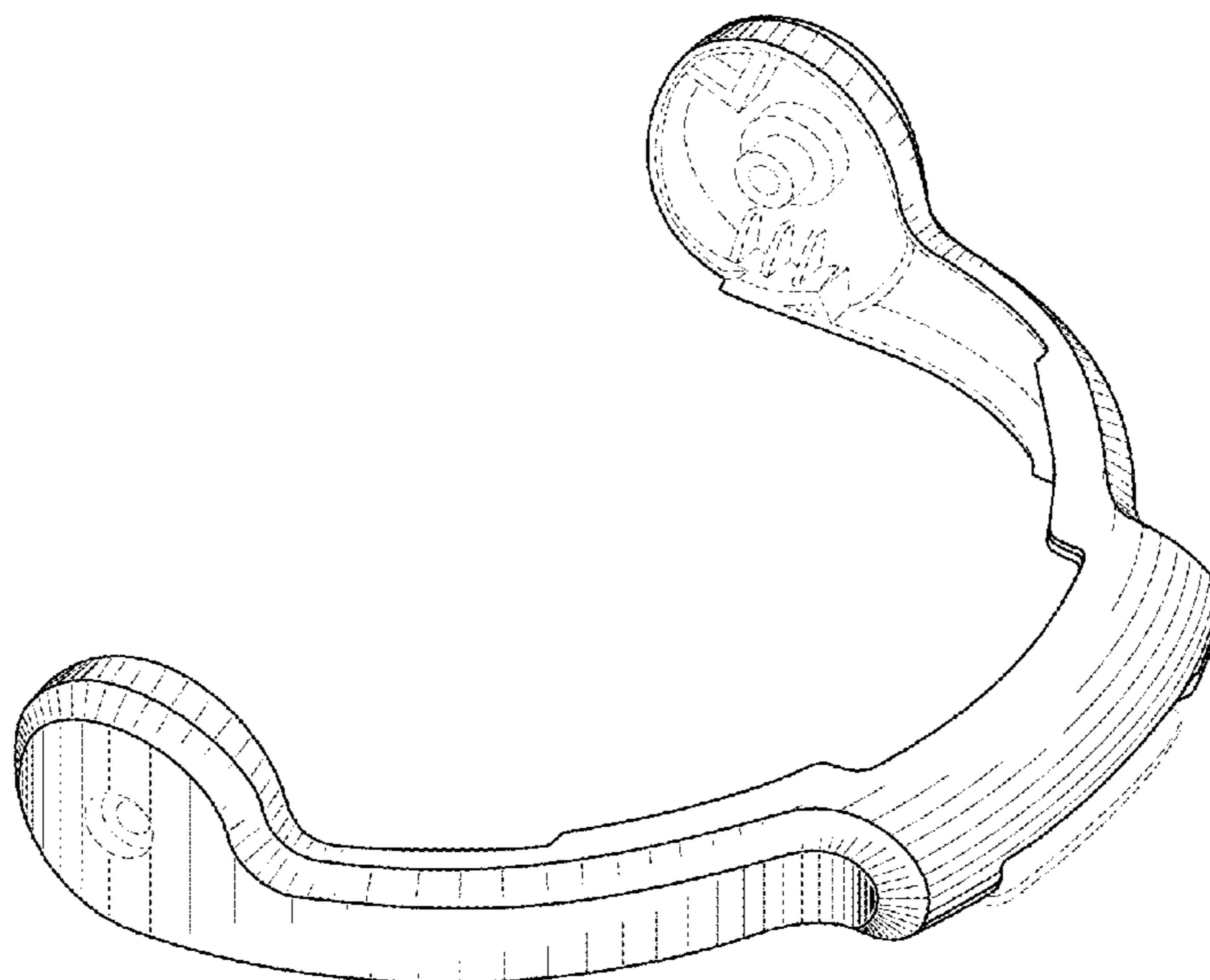
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a handle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; the right side elevational view being a mirror image of FIG. 4;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken lines of FIGS. 1-4 and 6 illustrate portions of the handle that form no part of the claimed design.

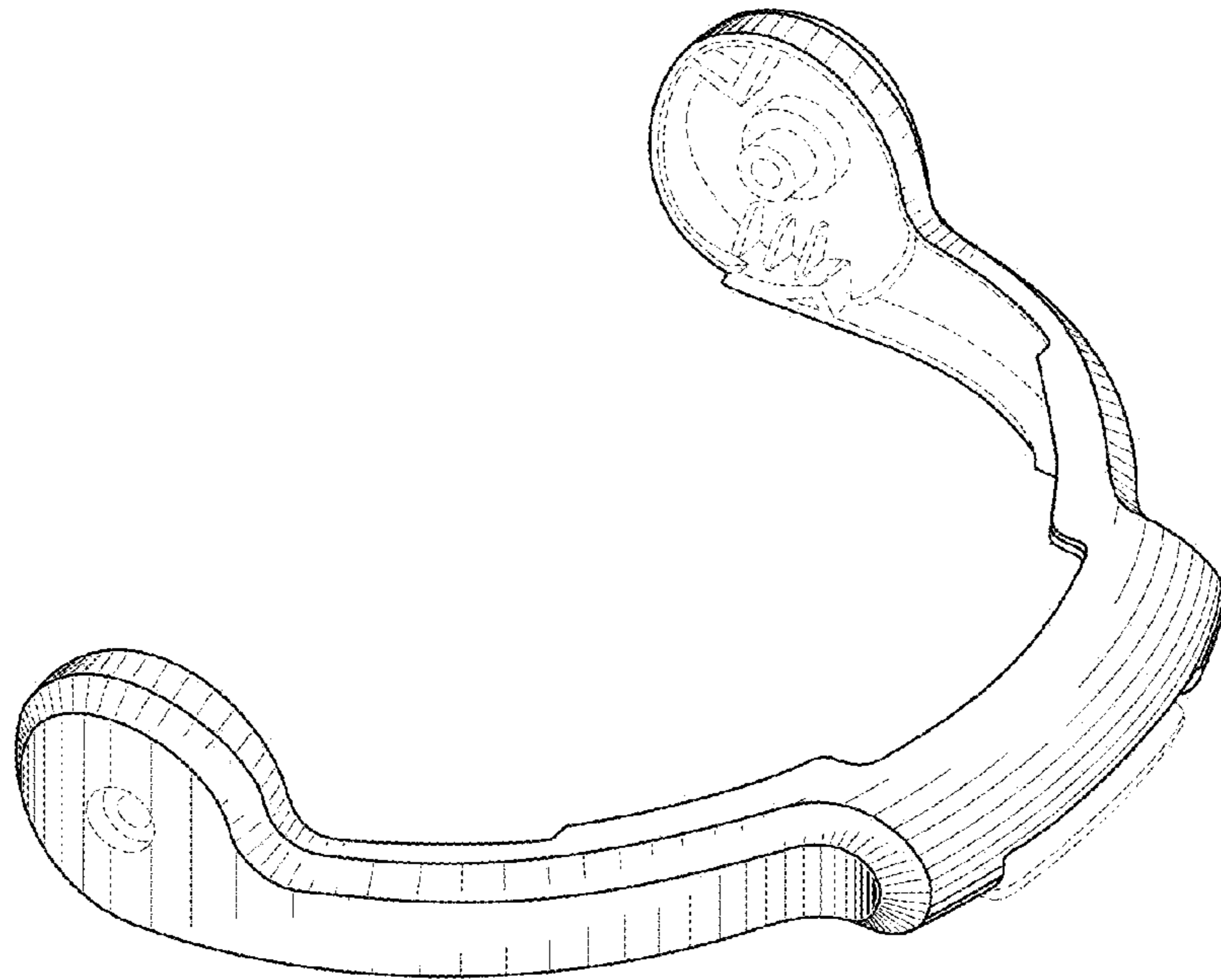

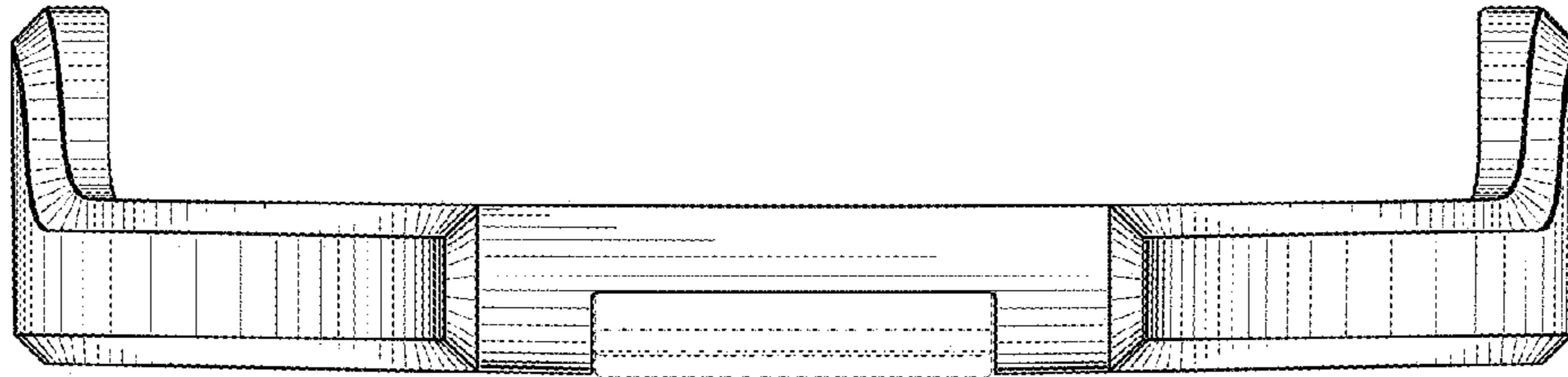

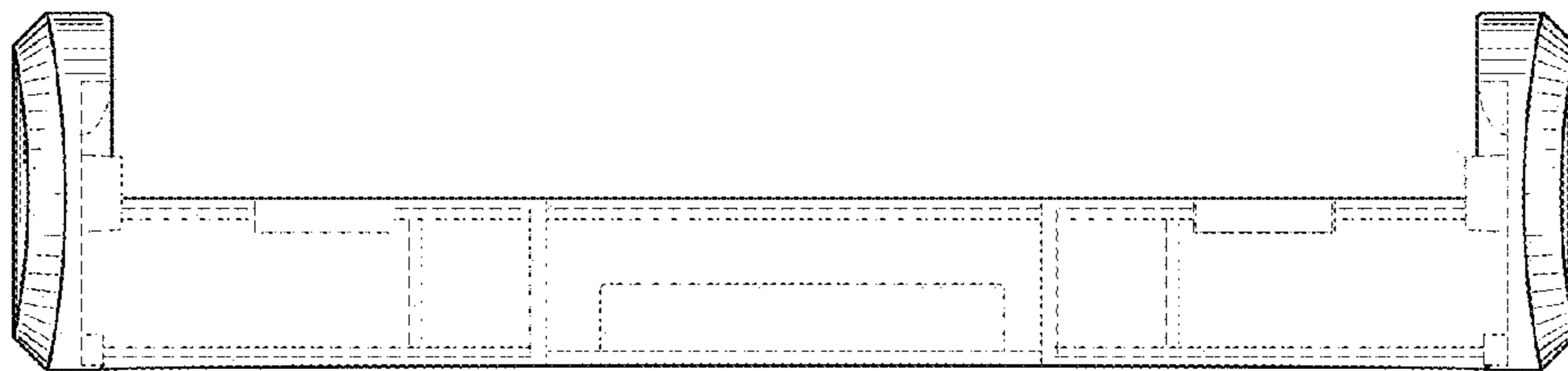

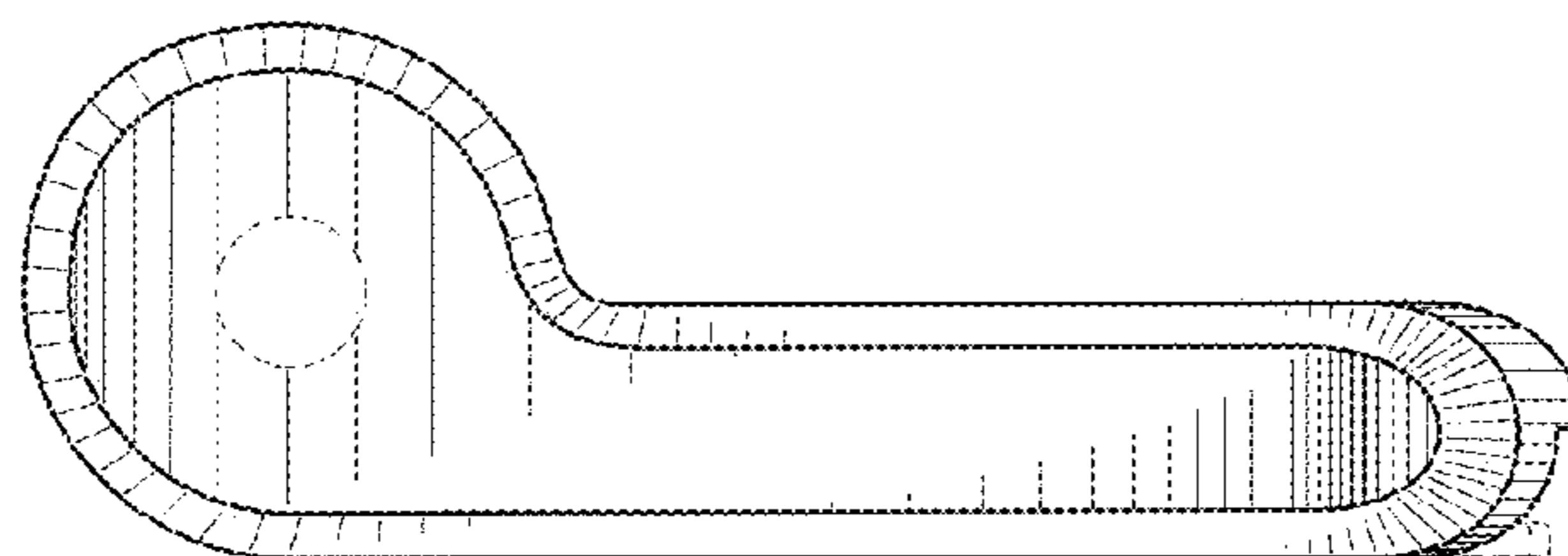

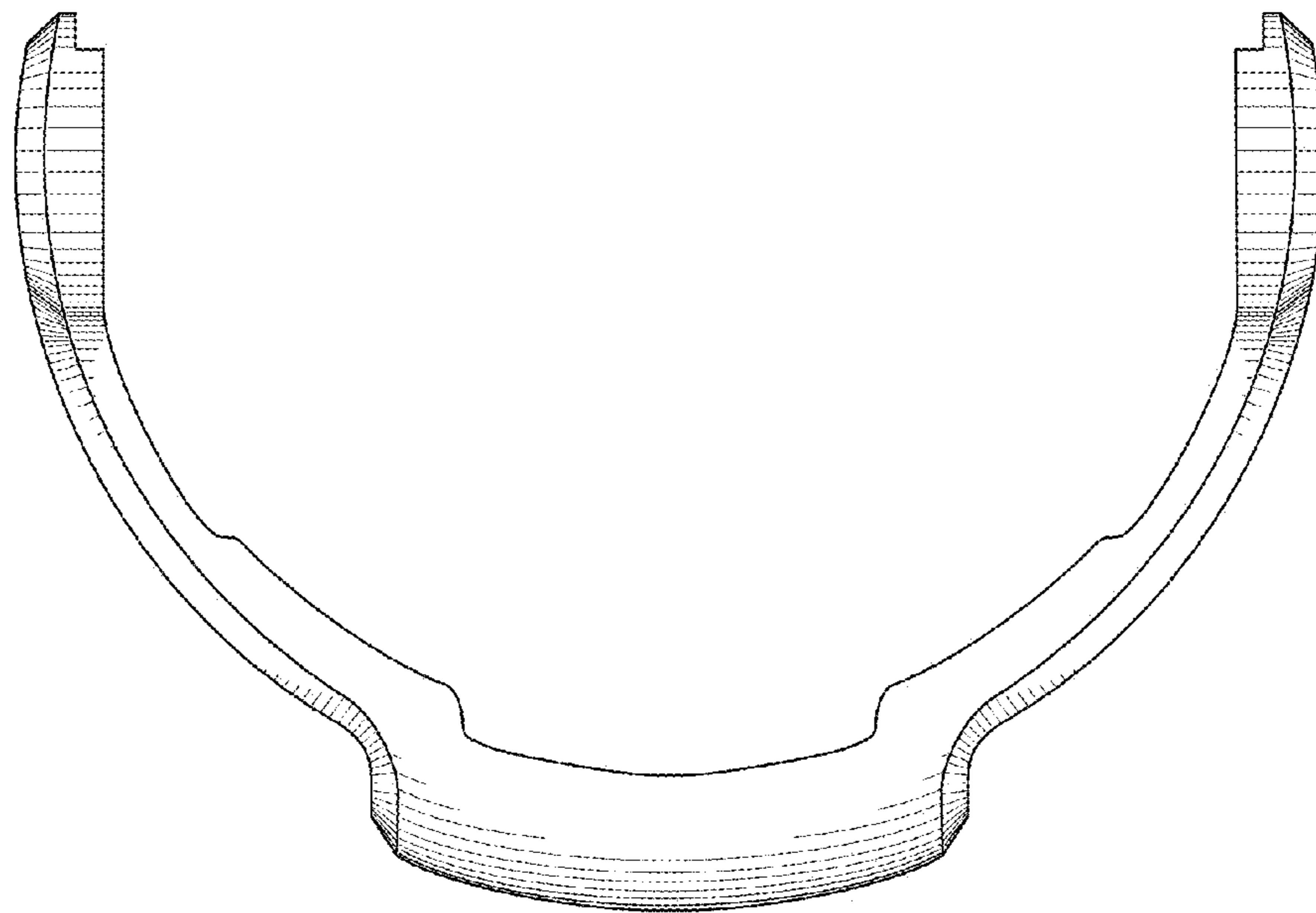

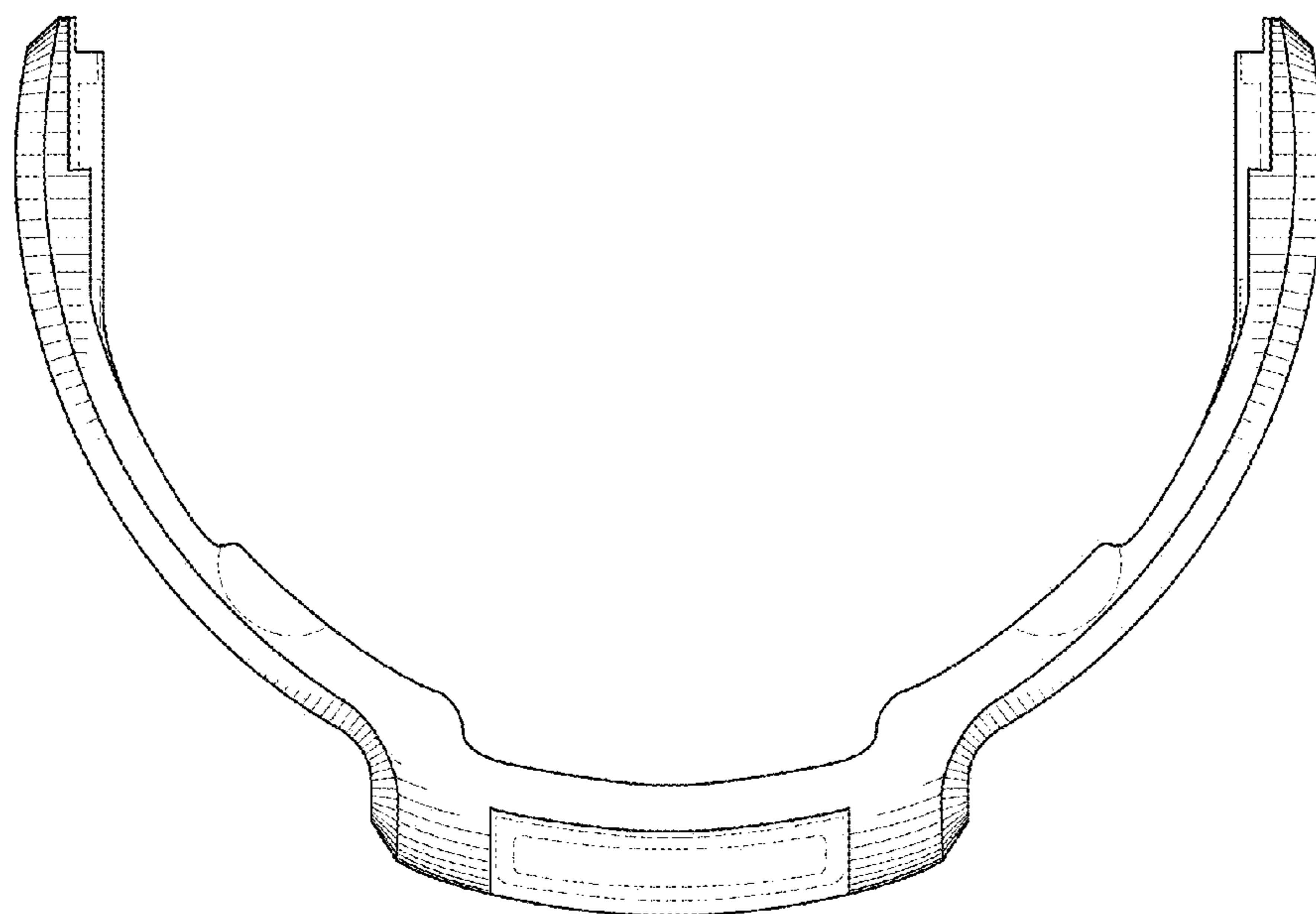
