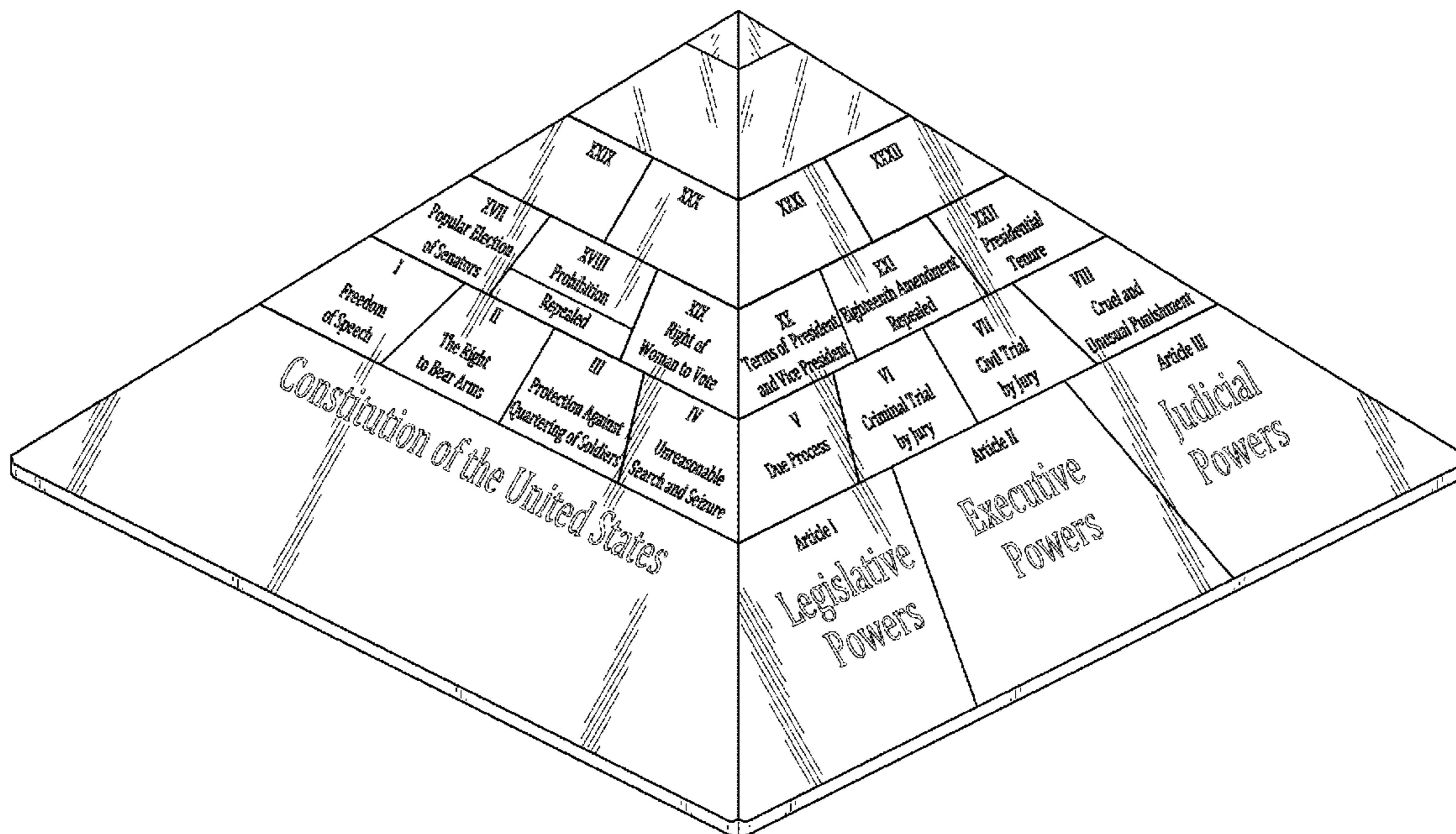
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective front view of the pyramid representing the US Constitution;

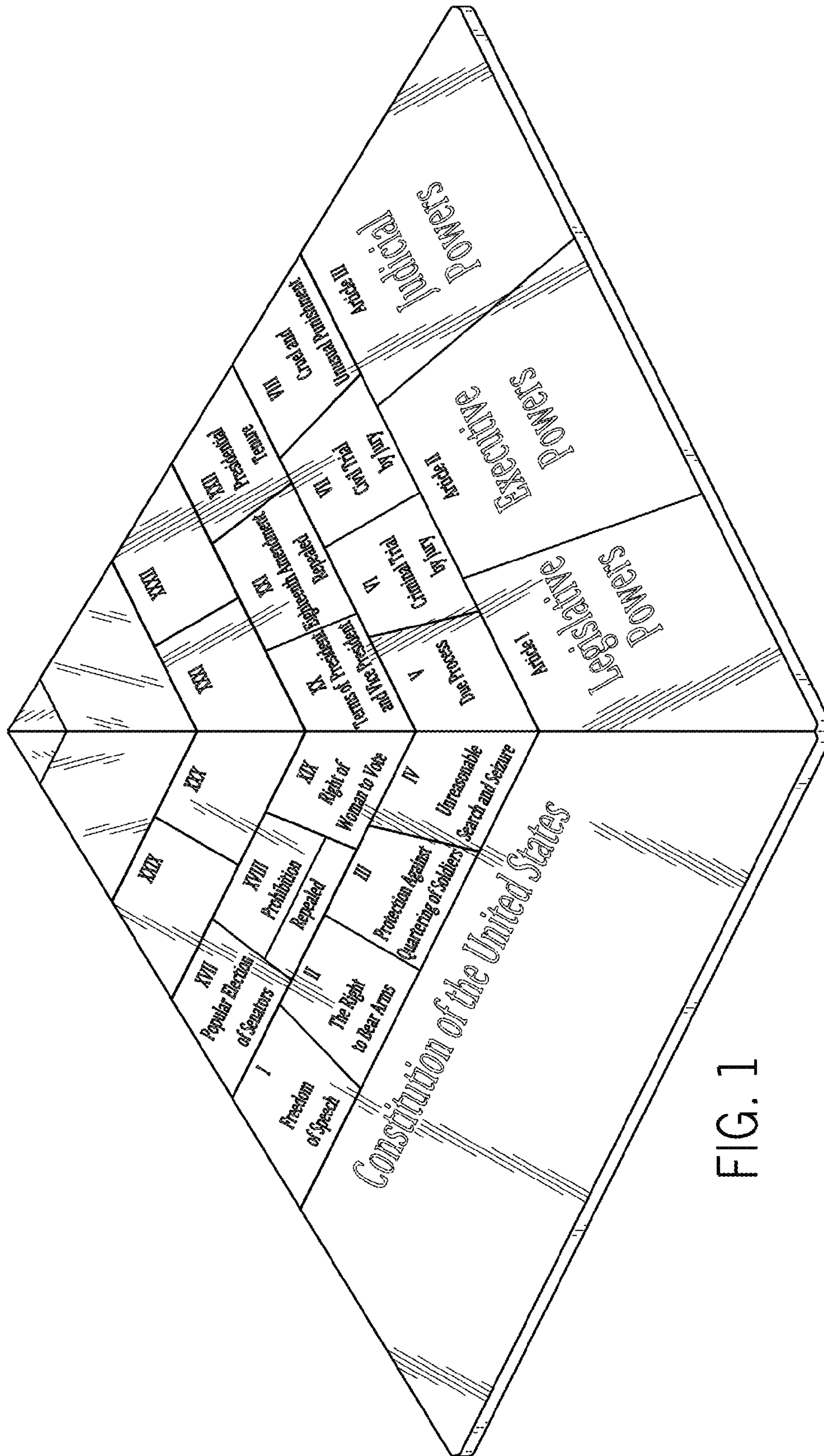

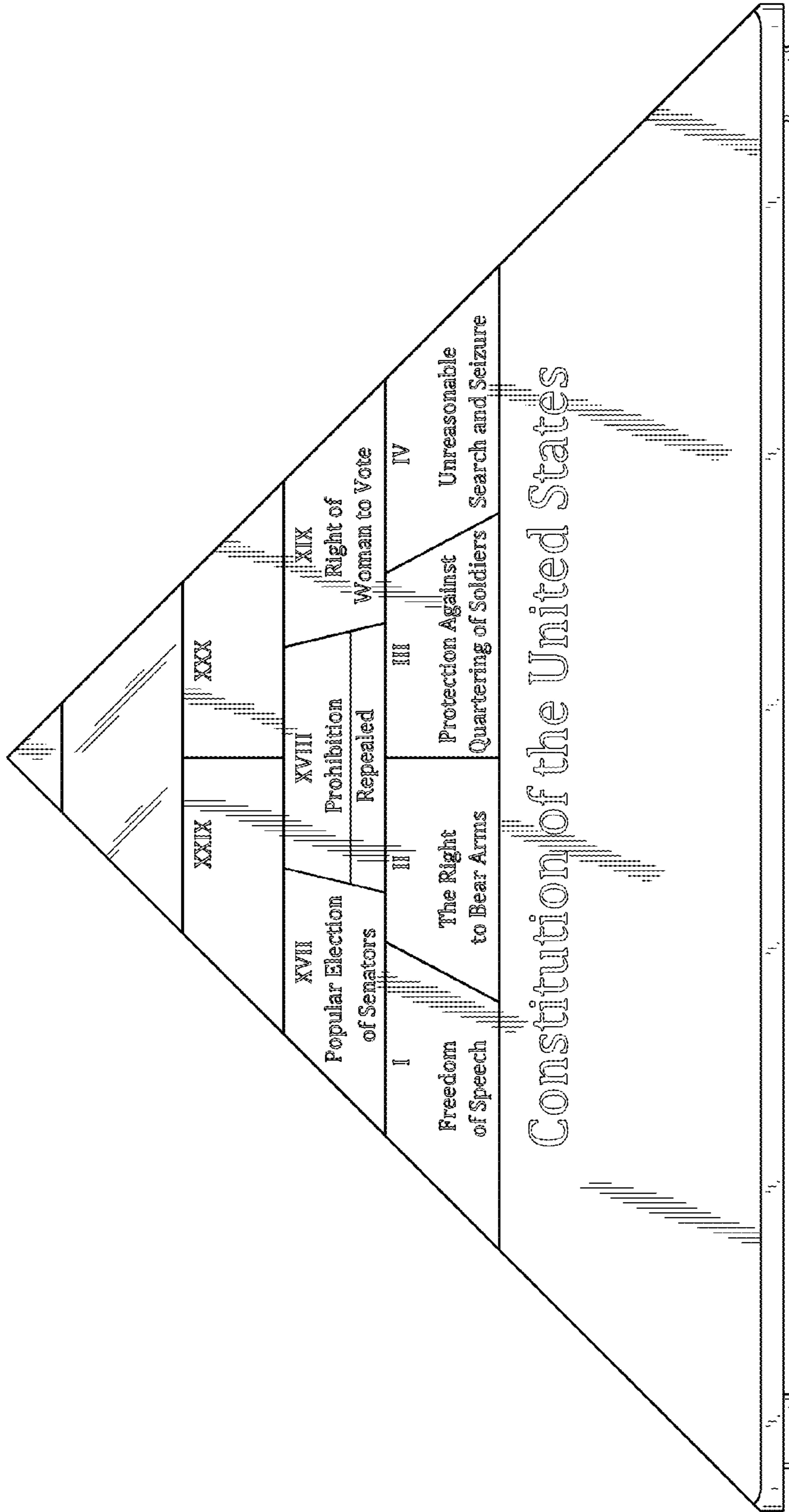

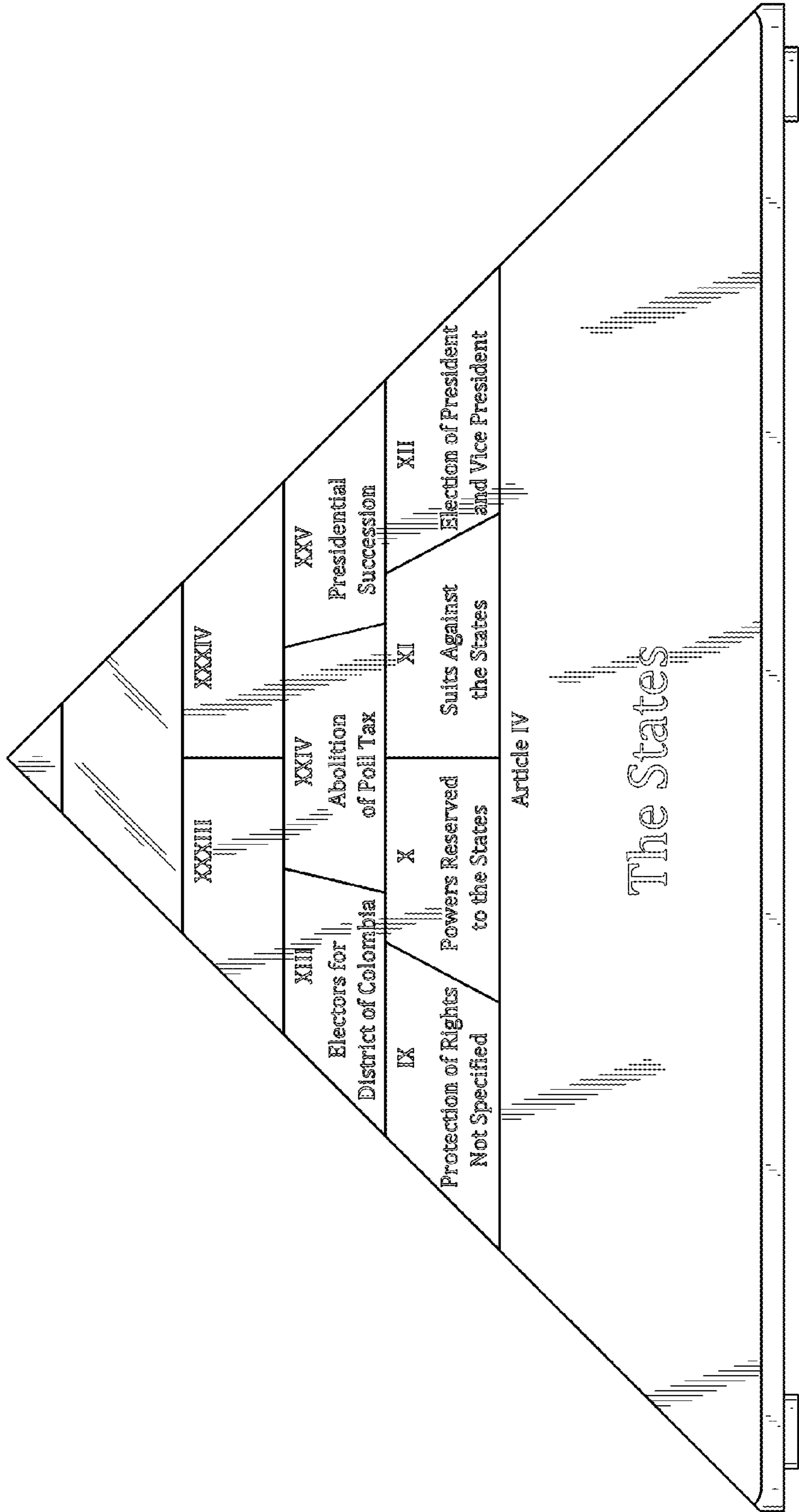

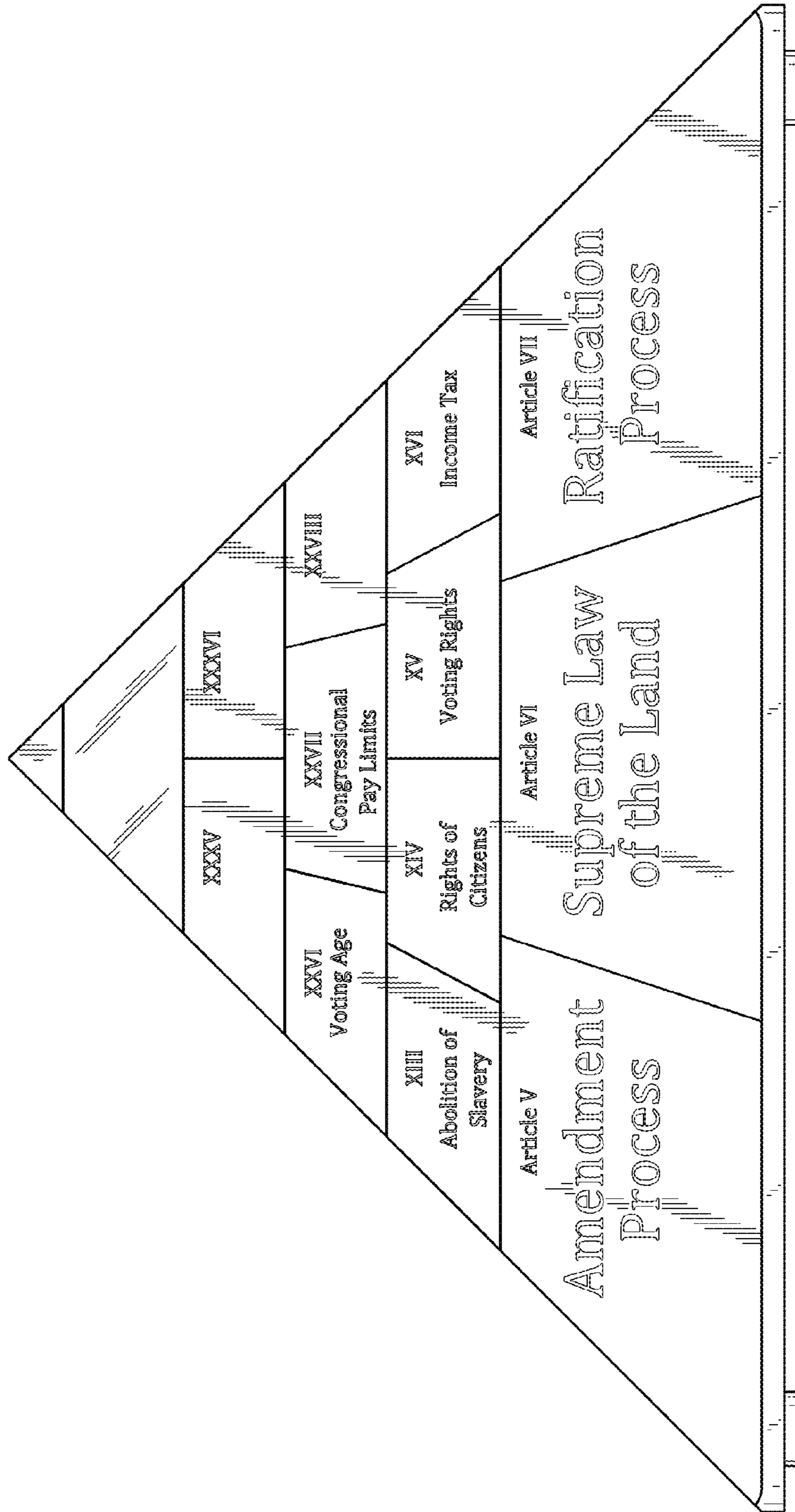

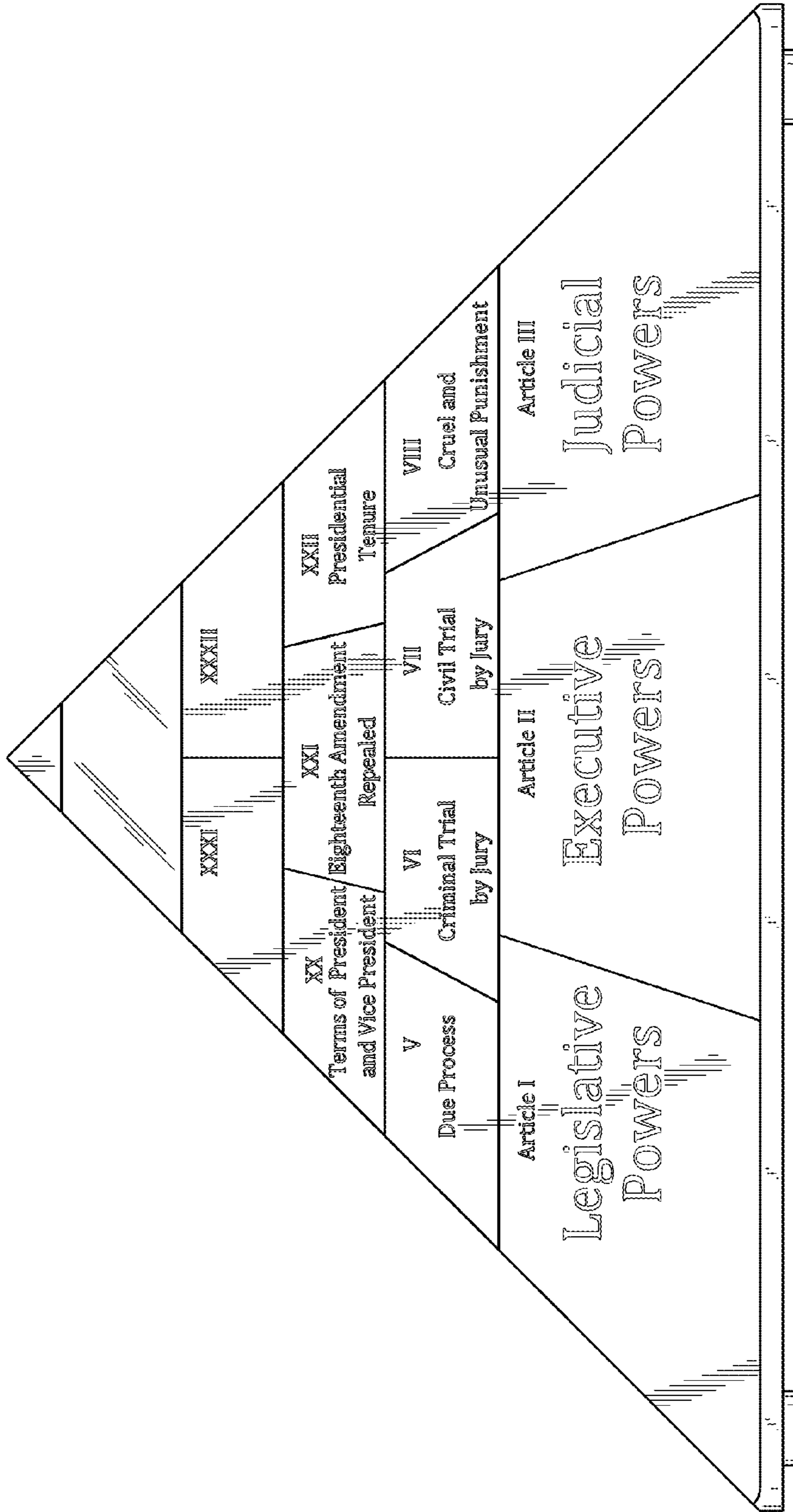

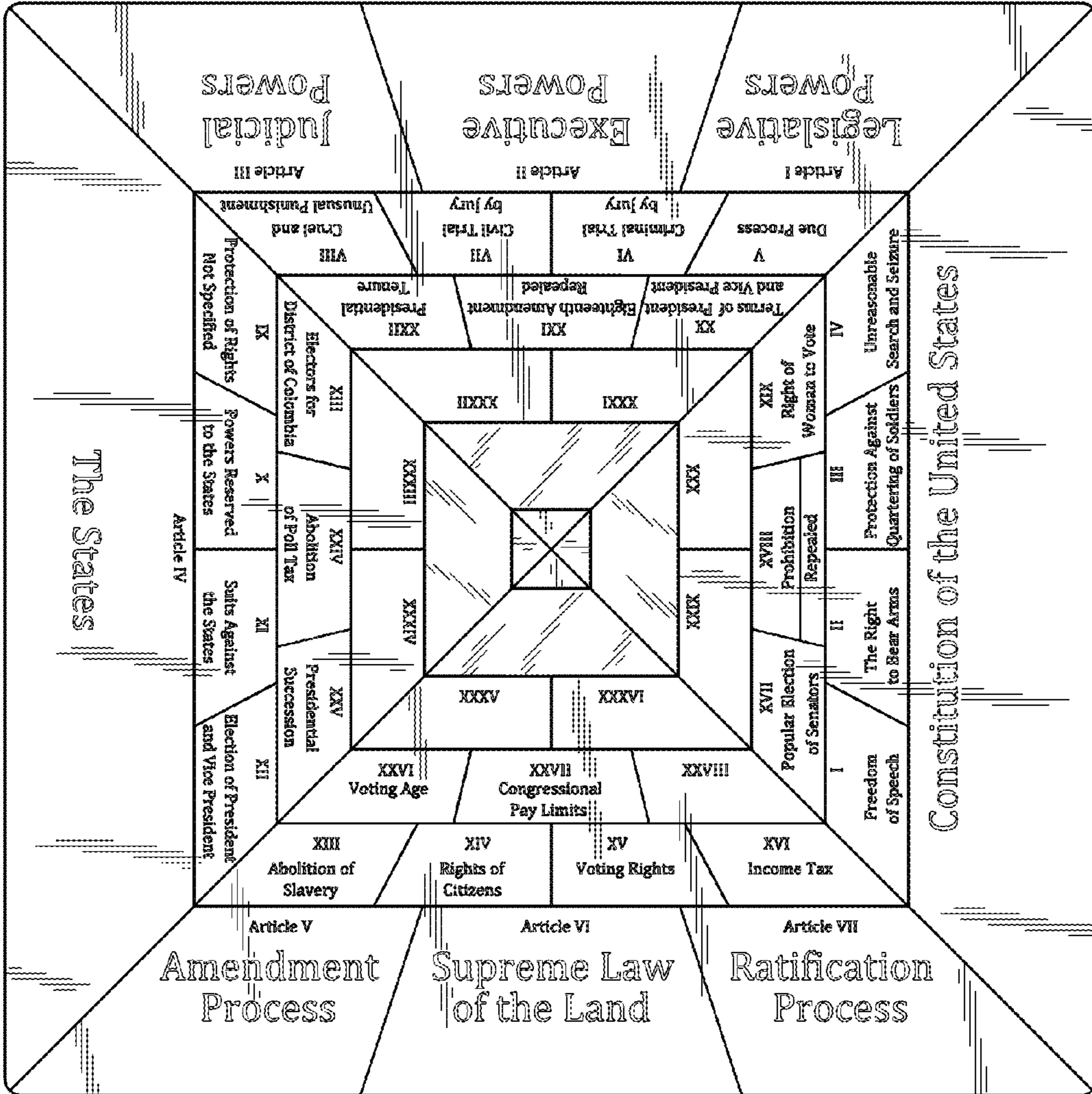

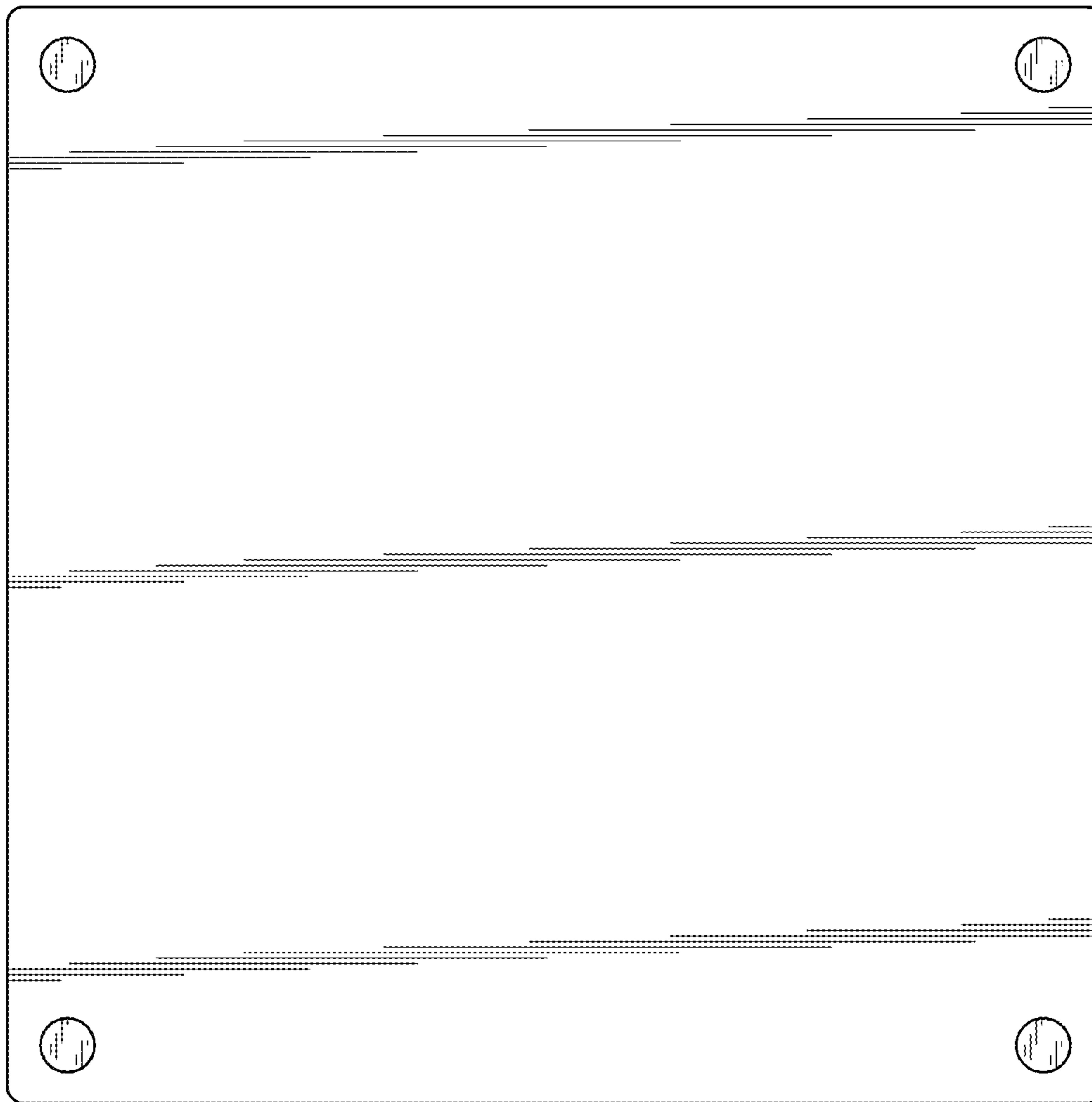
