(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a skullcap with interior clips, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the underside of the skullcap.

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the top of the skullcap.

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the skullcap inverted.

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the skullcap inverted and rotated 90 degrees from the view of FIG. 3.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the skullcap.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing the underside of an alternative embodiment of the skullcap.

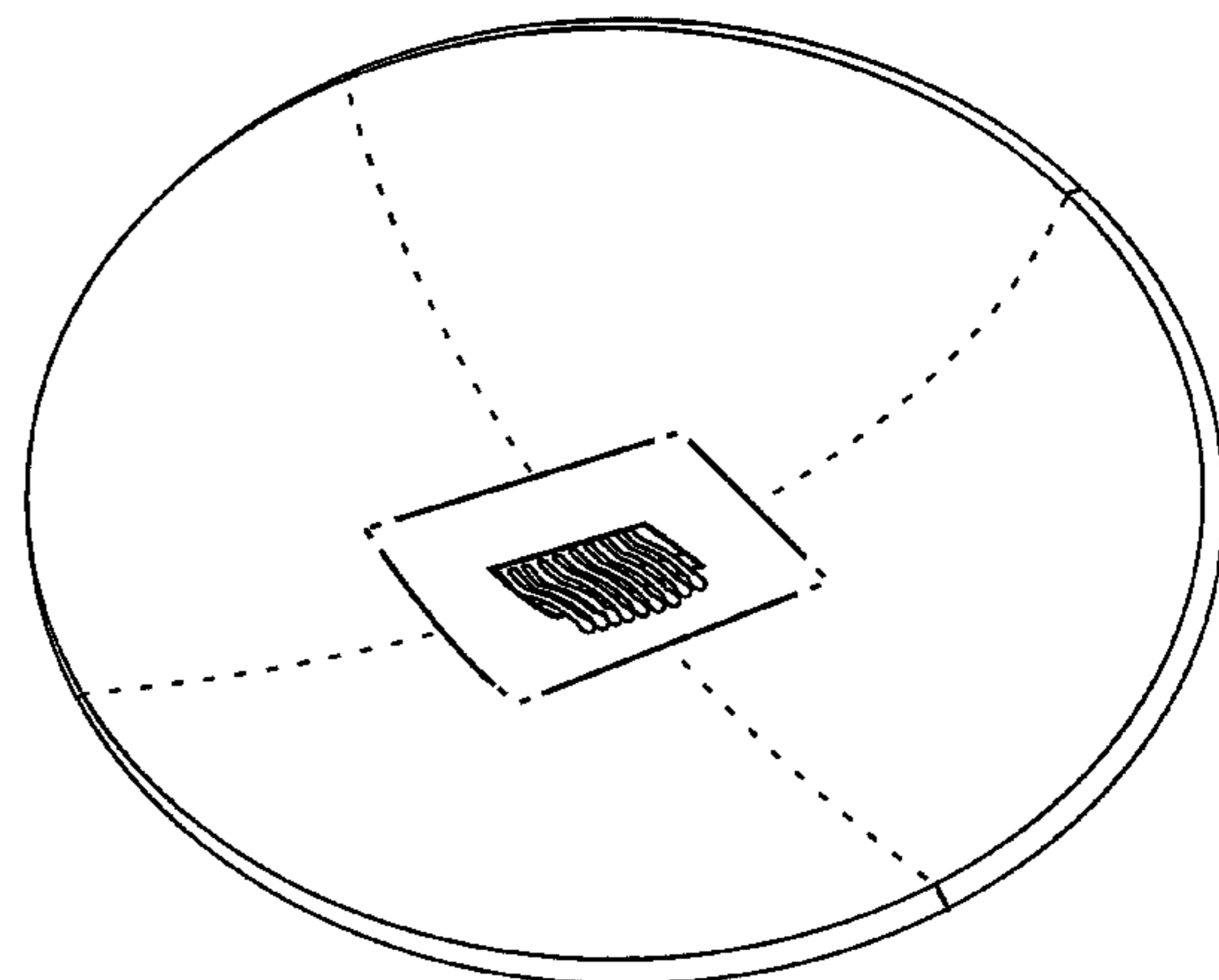
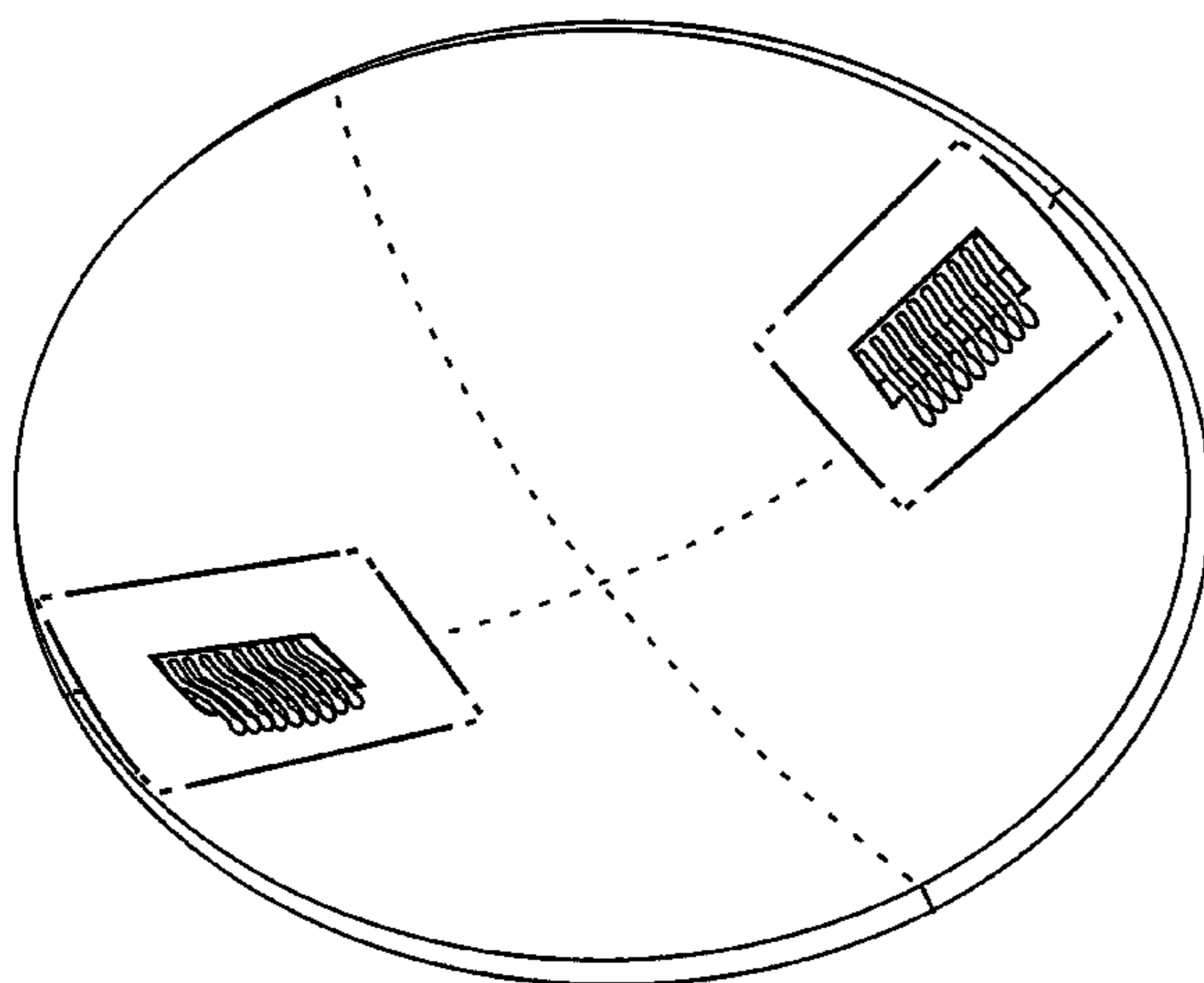
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the top of the alternative embodiment of the skullcap.

FIG. 8 is a side elevation view of the alternative embodiment inverted.

FIG. 9 is a side elevation view of the alternative embodiment inverted and rotated 90 degrees from the view of FIG. 8; and, FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the alternative embodiment.

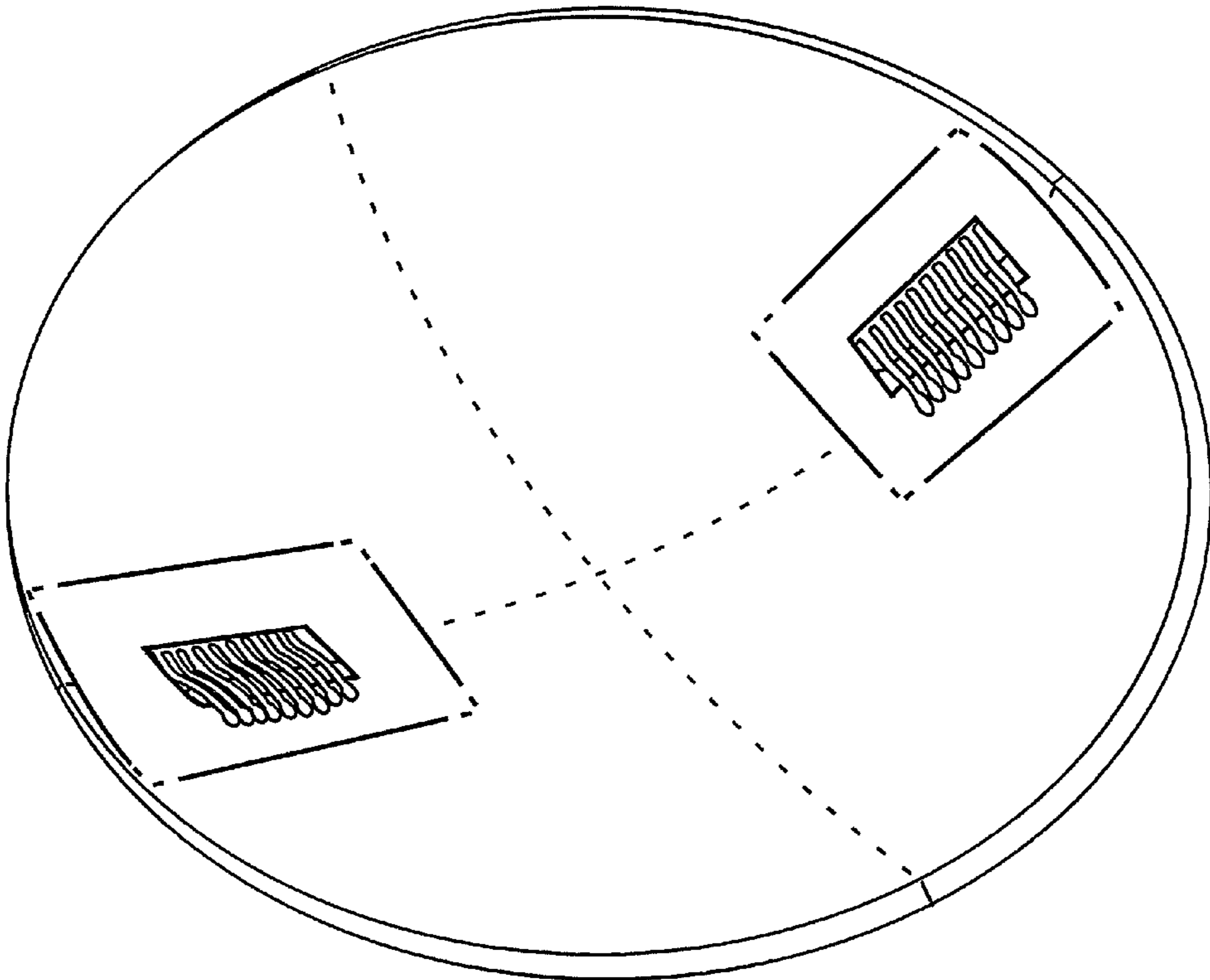

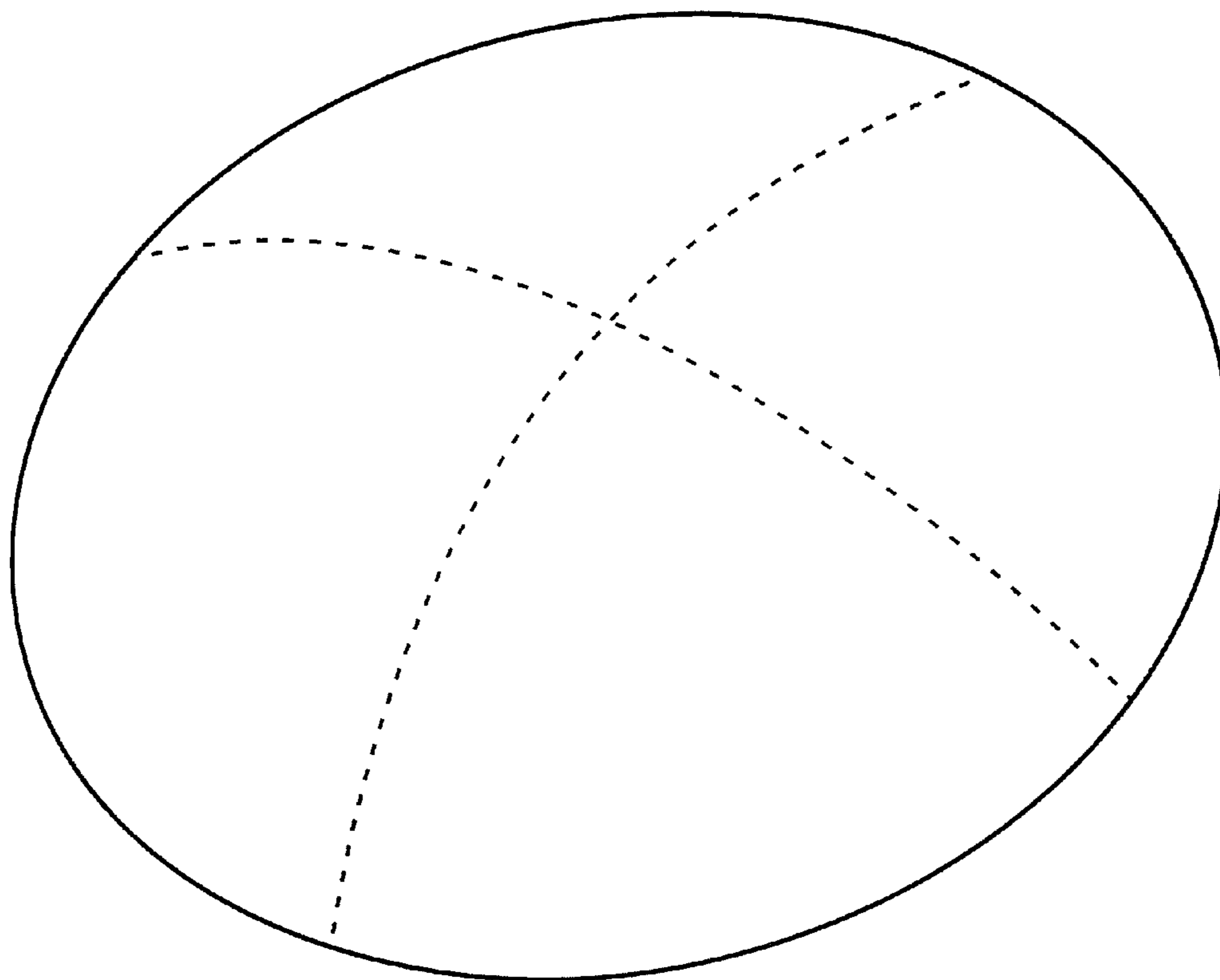

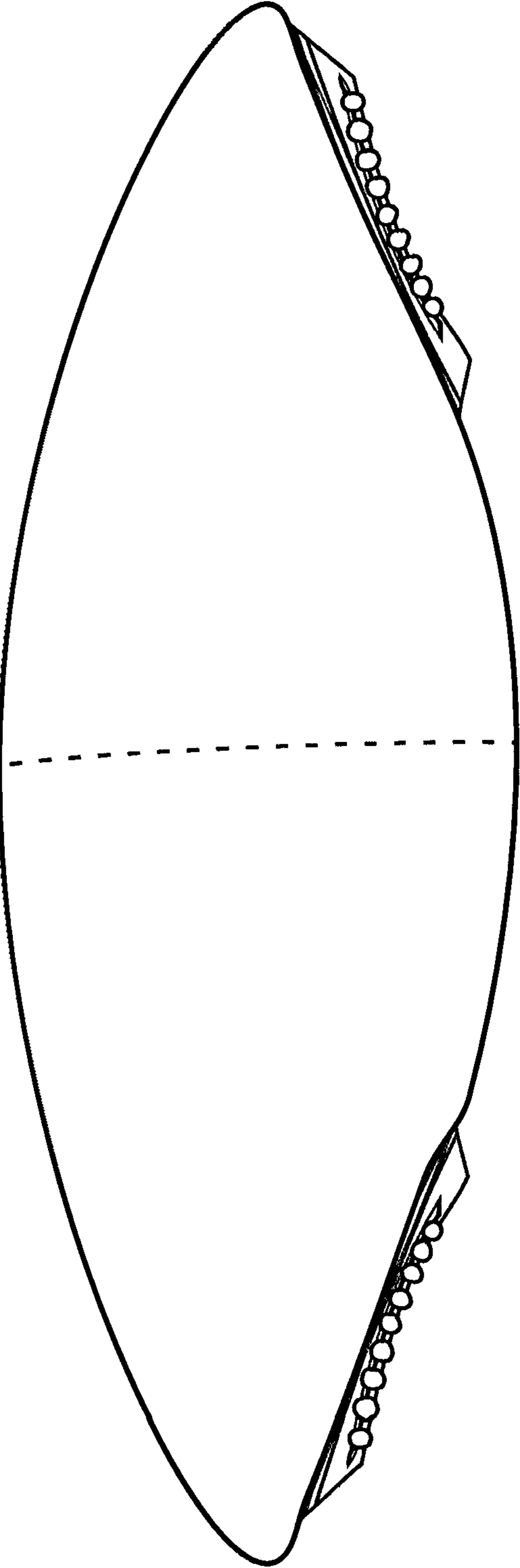

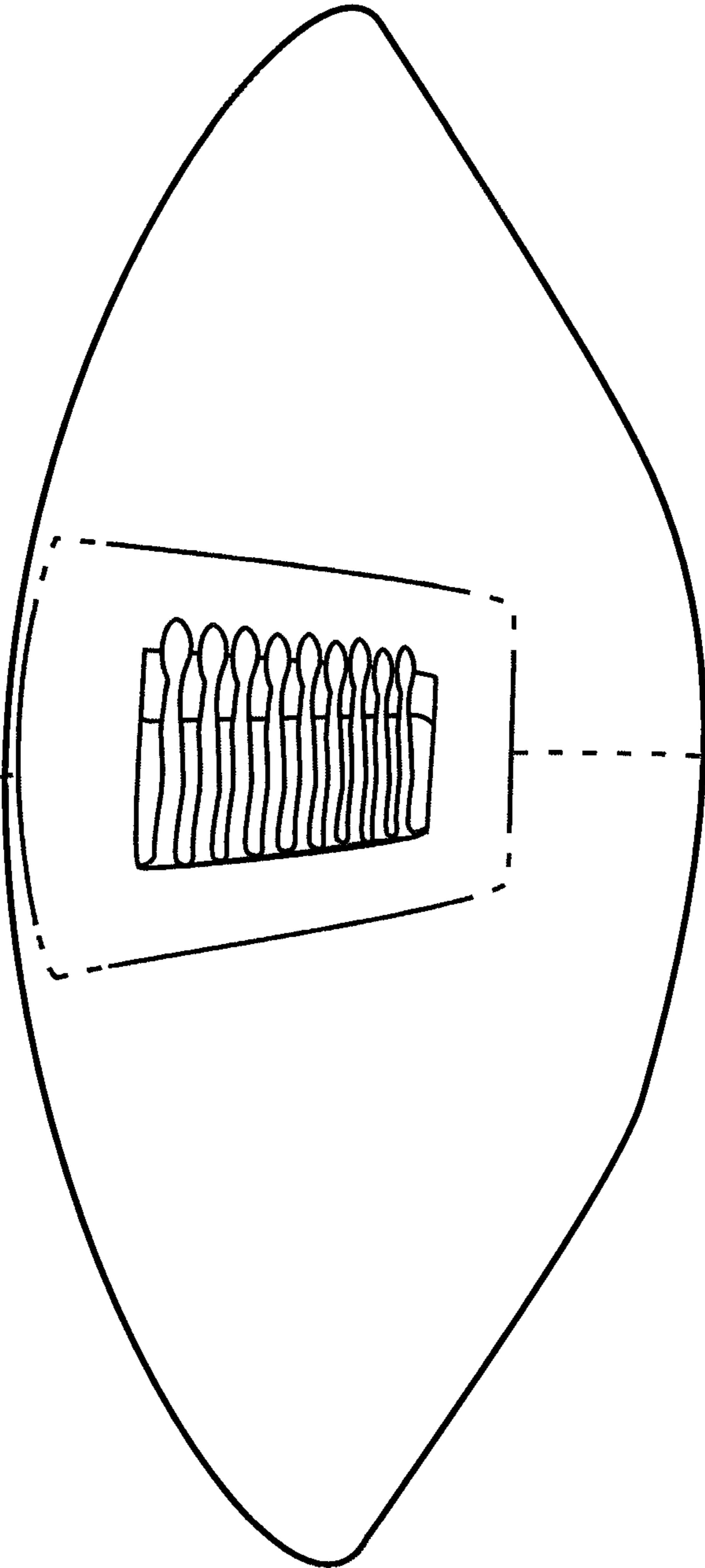

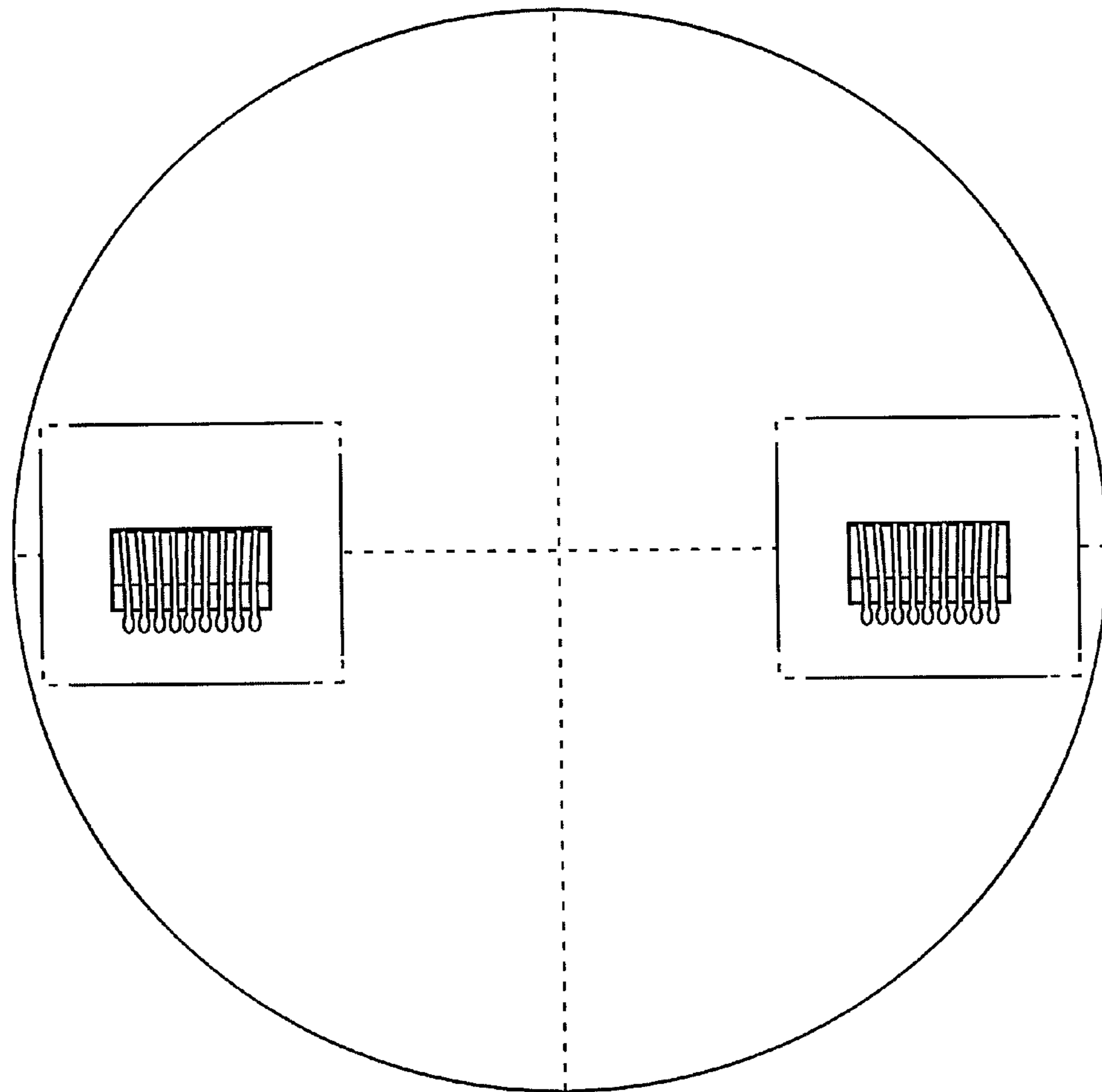

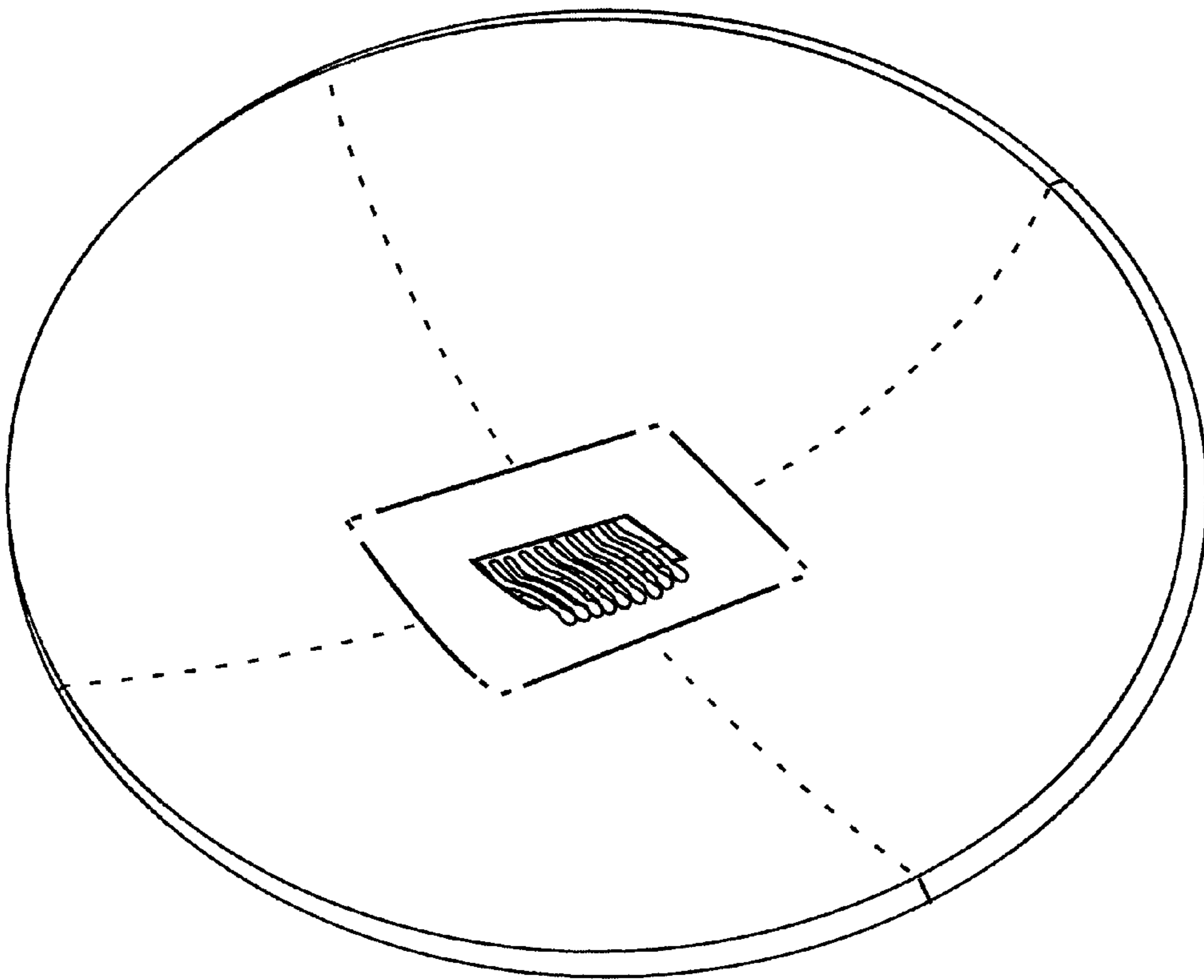

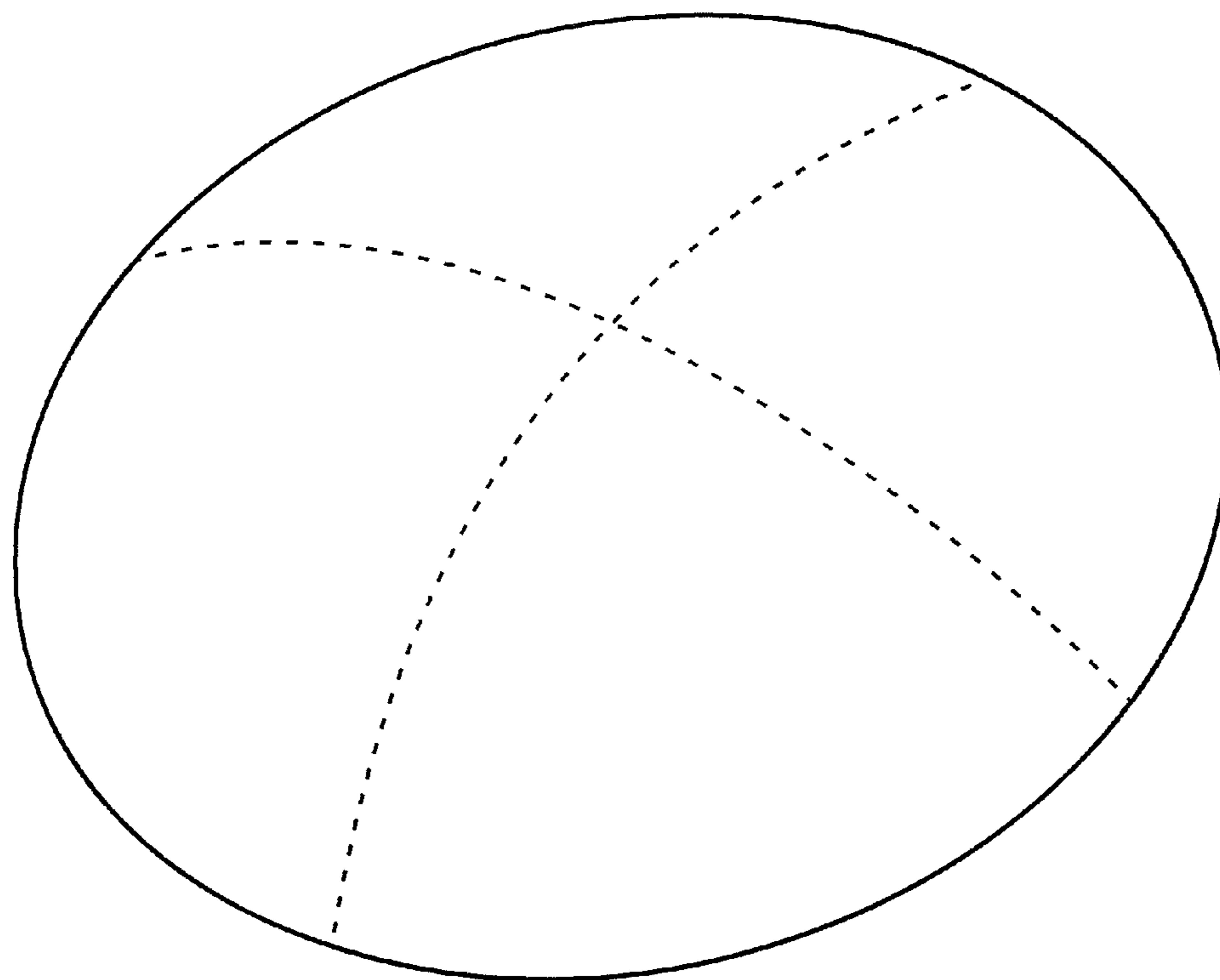

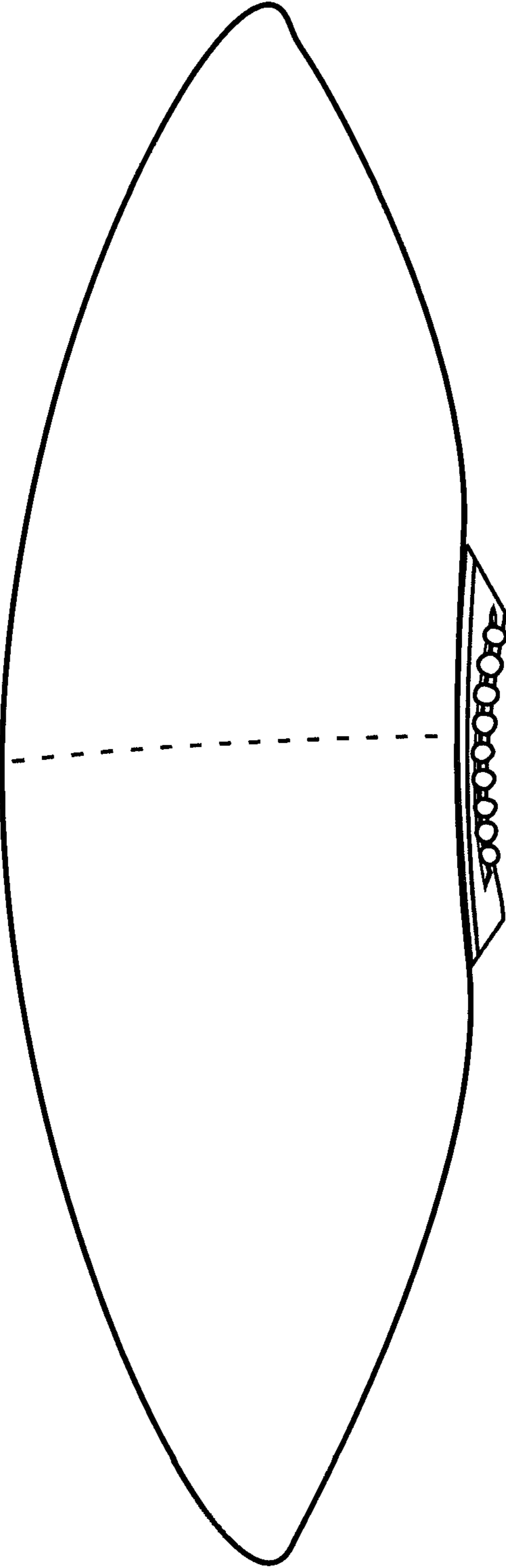

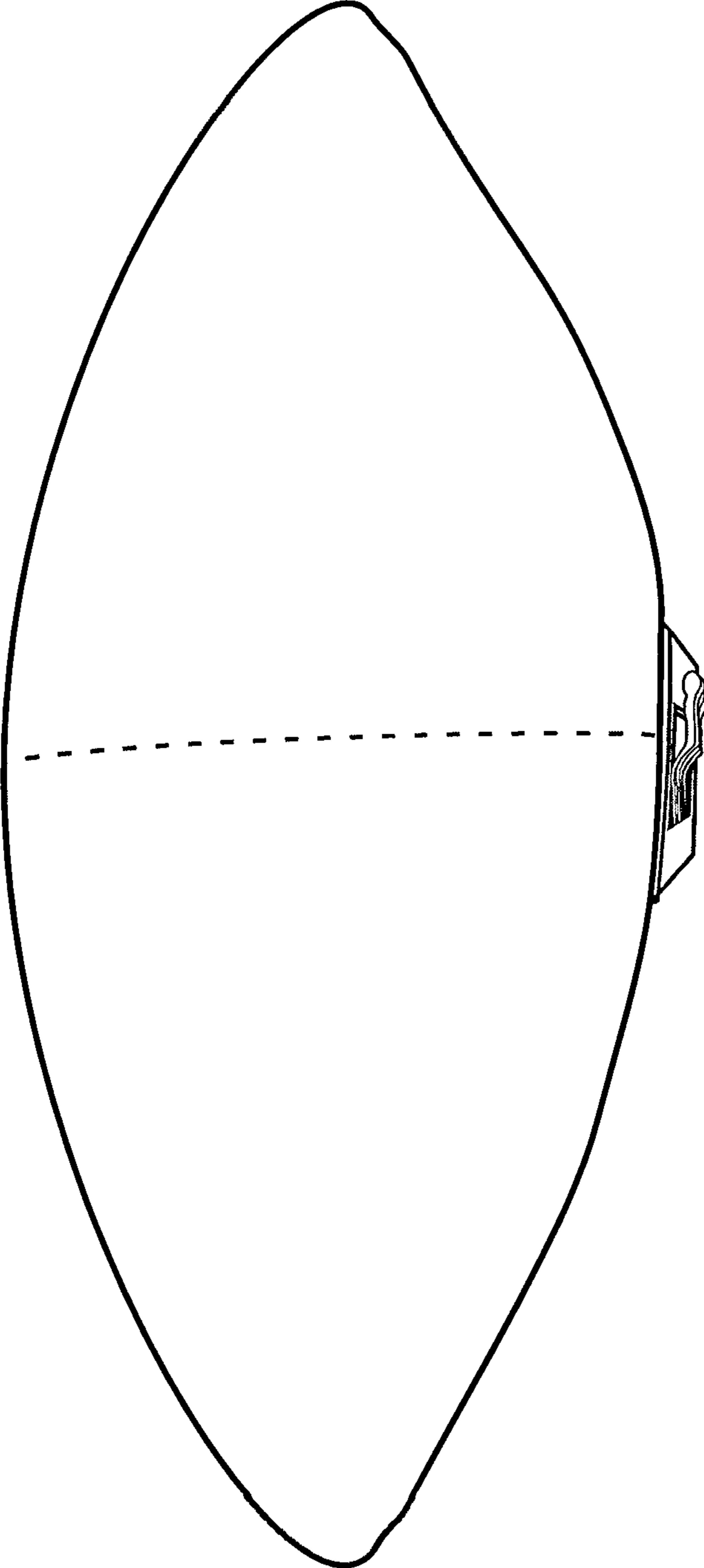

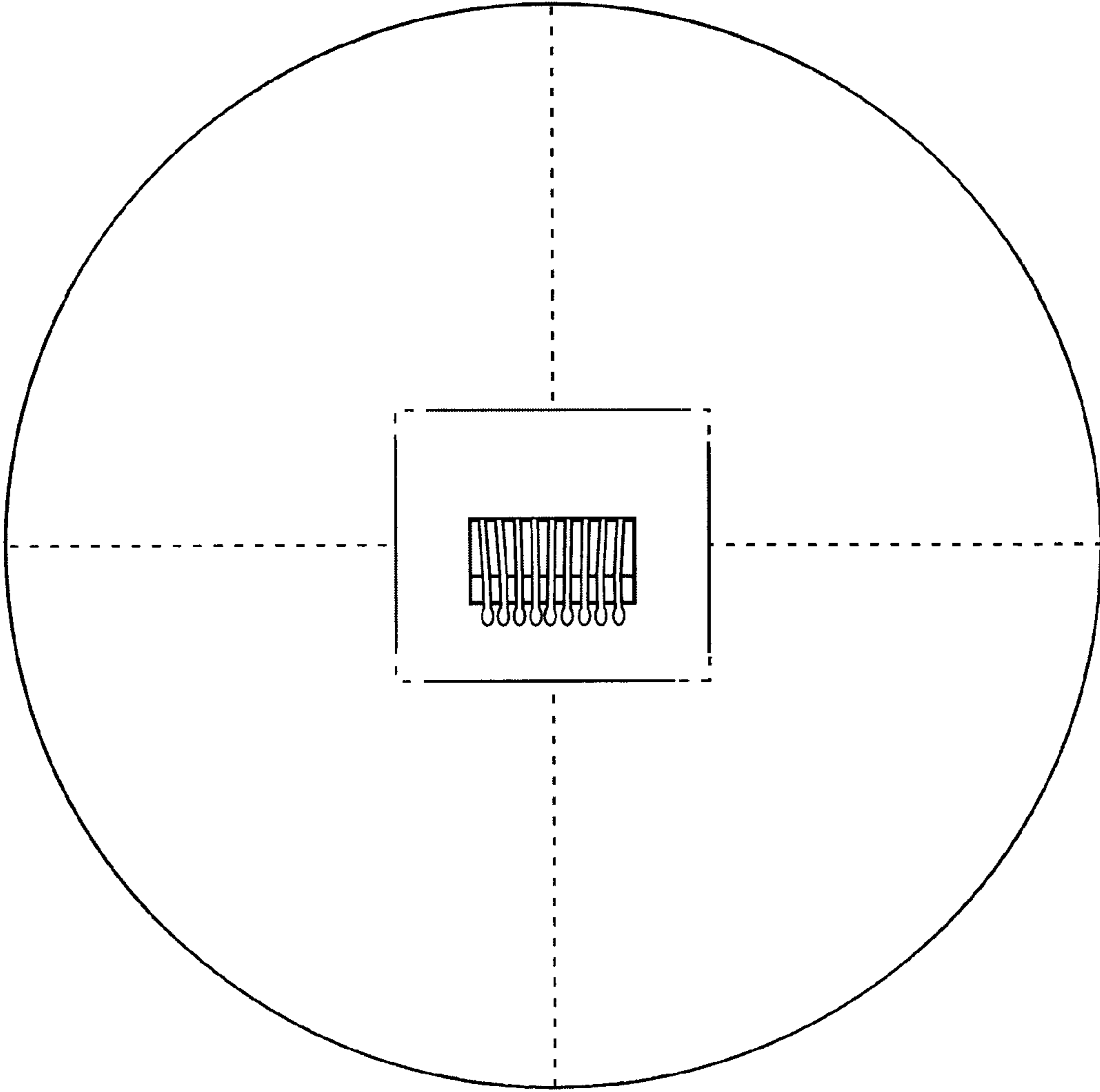
