(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an artificial marble, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a photograph showing a perspective view of an artificial marble;

FIG. 2 is a photograph showing a front view of the artificial marble;

FIG. 3 is a photograph showing a rear view of the artificial marble;

FIG. 4 is a photograph showing a left side view of the artificial marble;

FIG. 5 is a photograph showing a right side view of the artificial marble;

FIG. 6 is a photograph showing a top plan view of the artificial marble; and,

FIG. 7 is a photograph showing a bottom plan view of the artificial marble.

The article can be used for interior surface-finishing materials, such as panels for kitchens, including panels for floors, countertops, and walls.

The article is formed of a material including natural quartz and synthetic resins, and gold dust chips as inner dispersed parts or phases of the artificial marble.

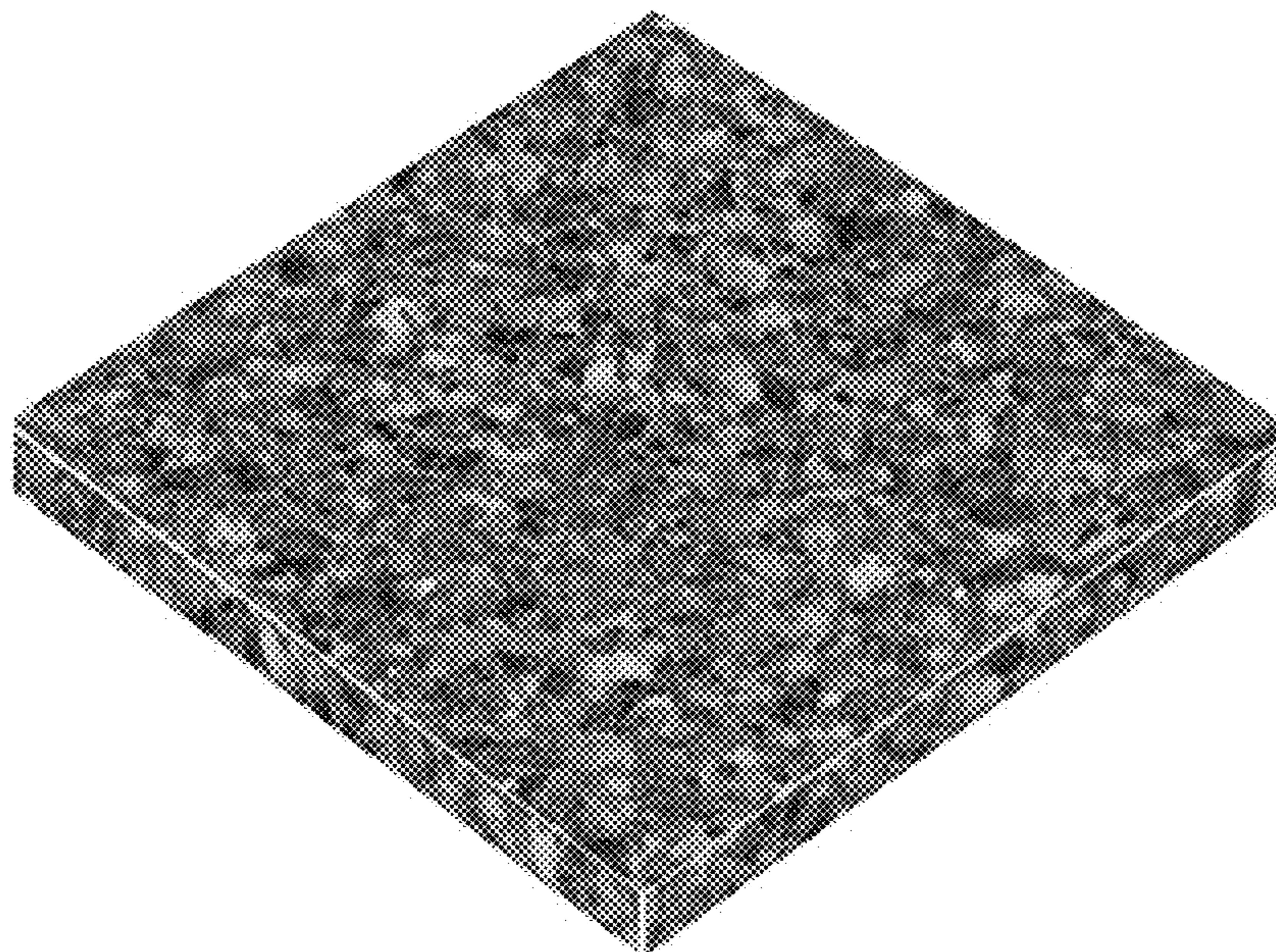

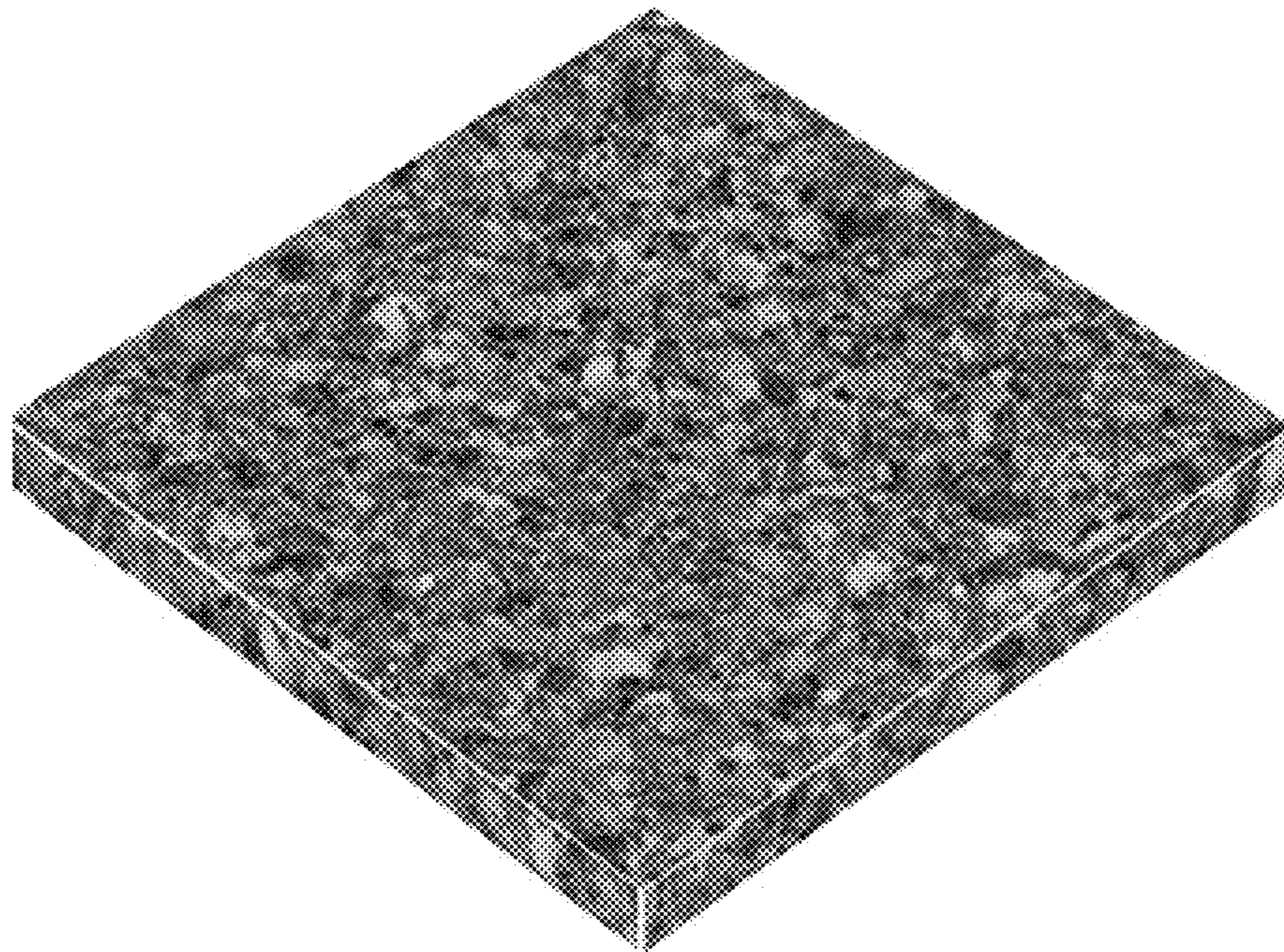

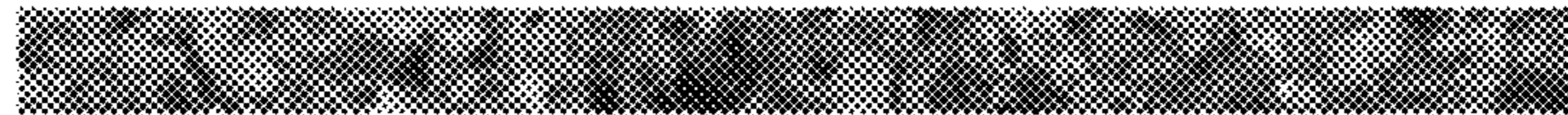

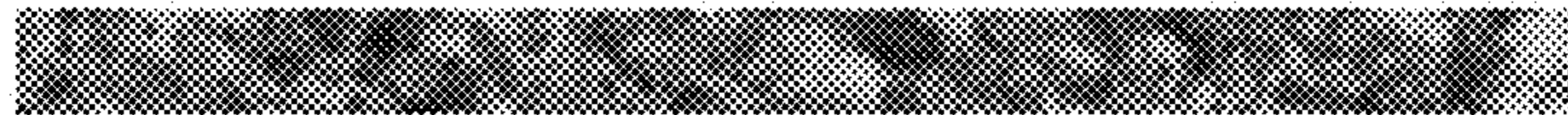

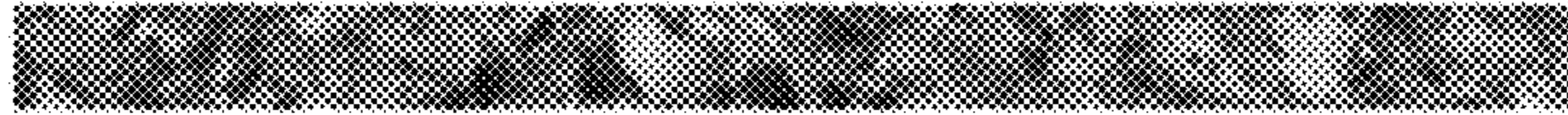

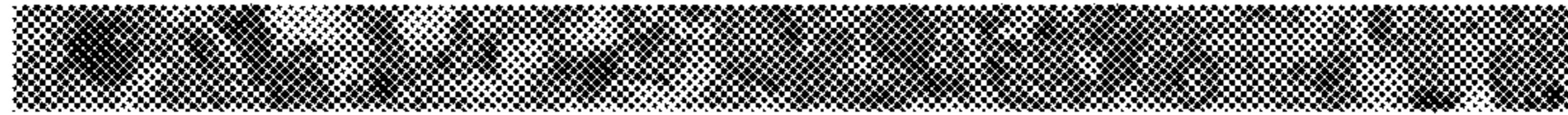

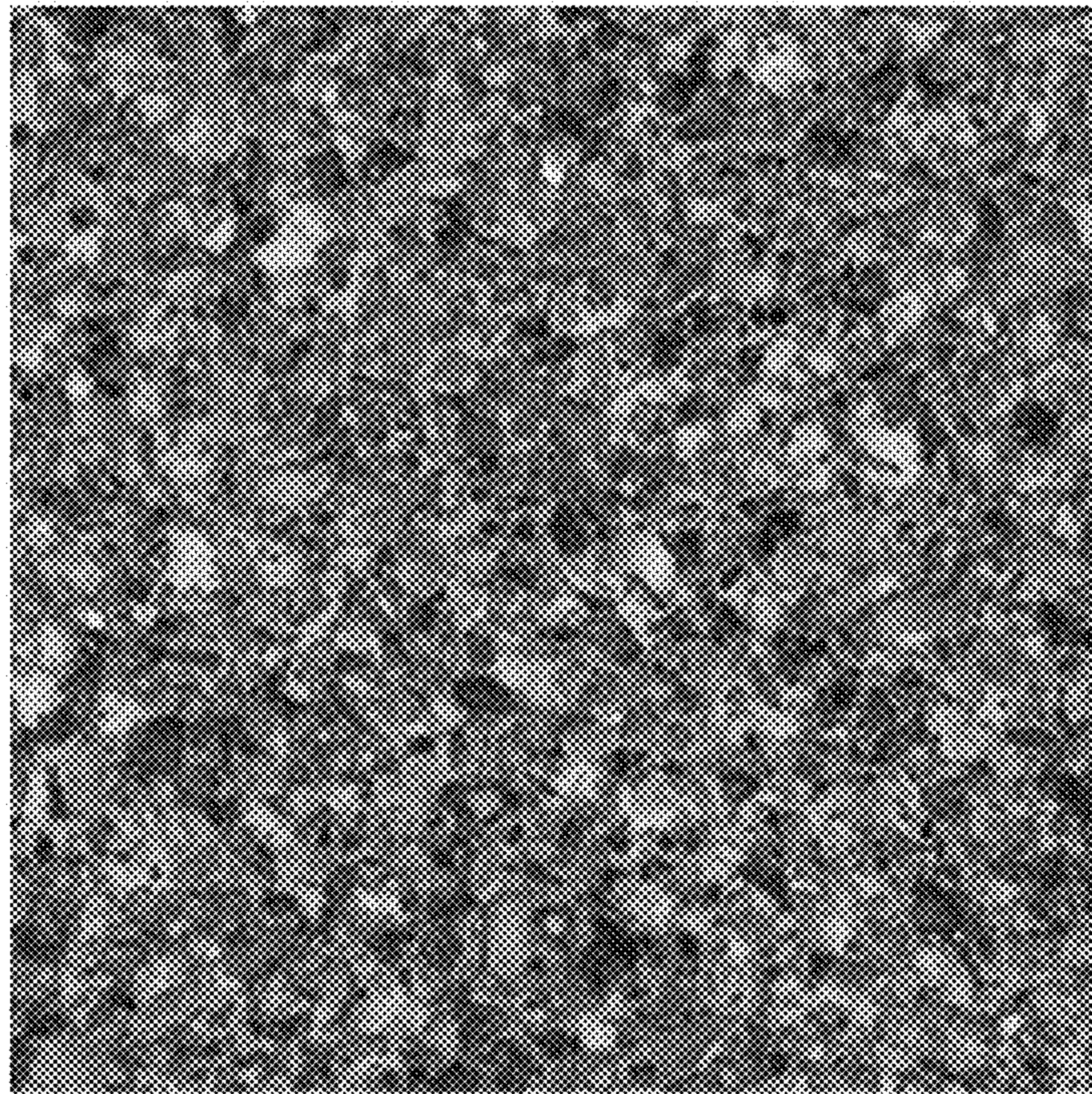
