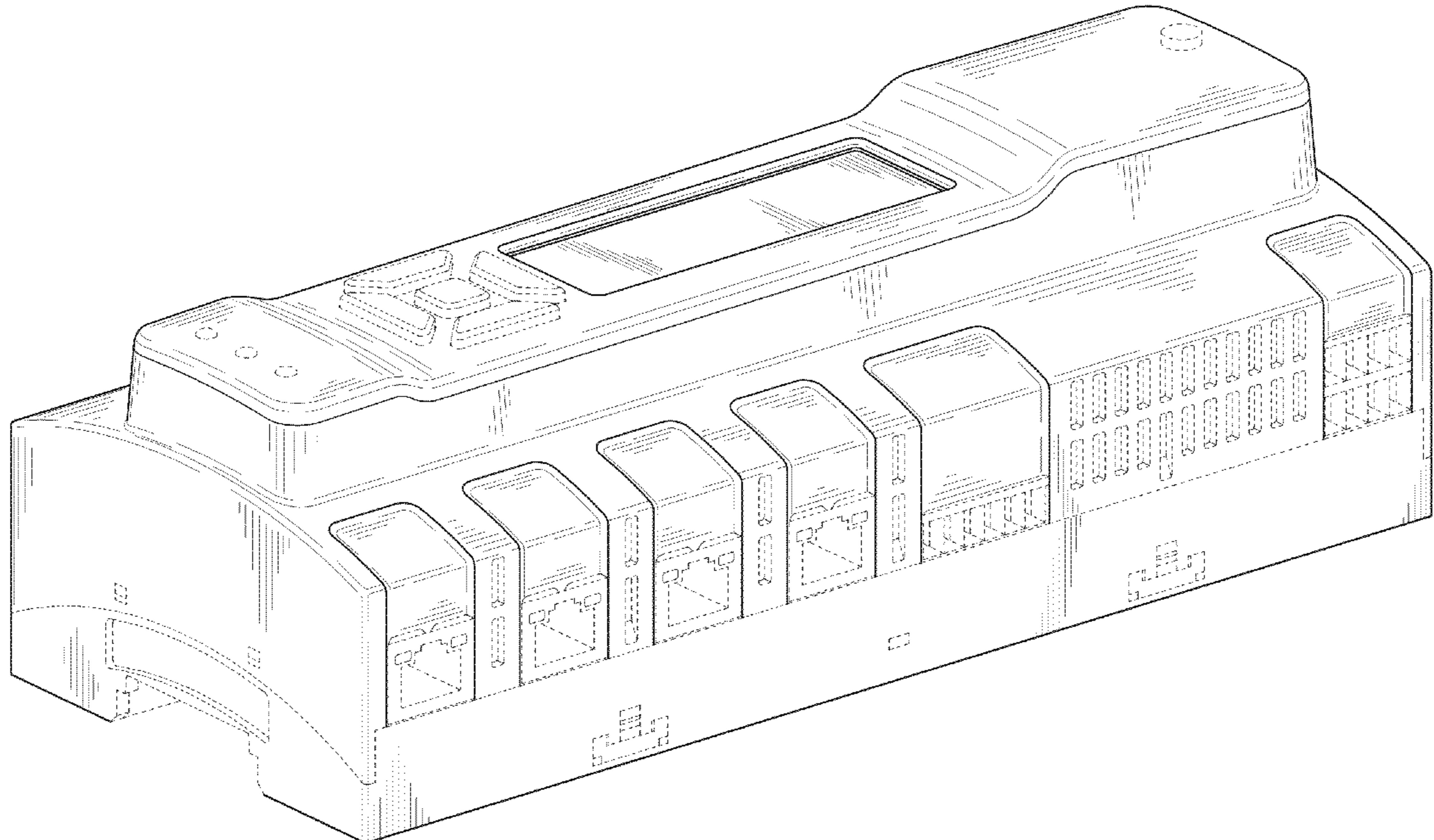

The ornamental design for an electrical apparatus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of an electrical apparatus showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top, front, and right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a back elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

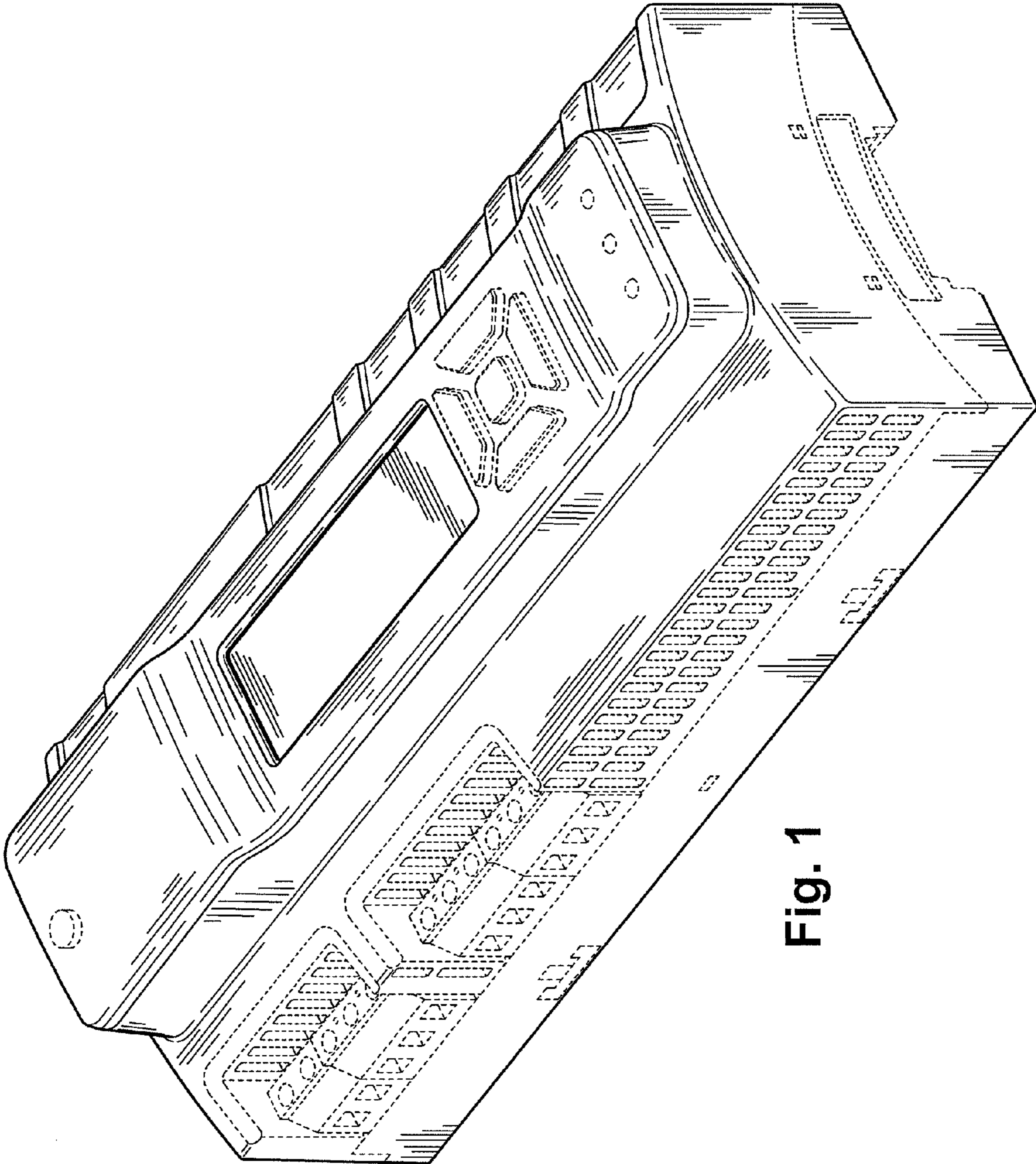

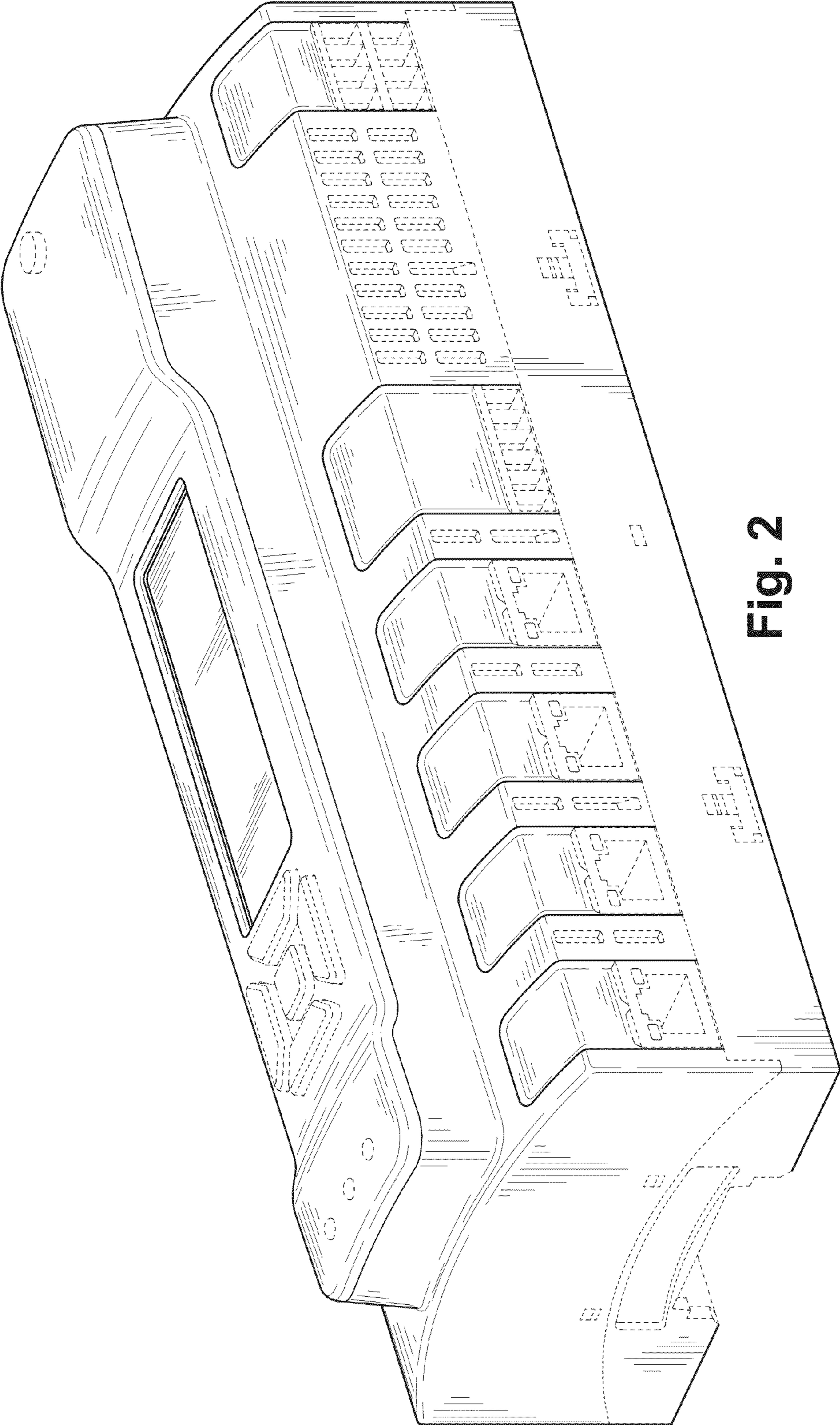

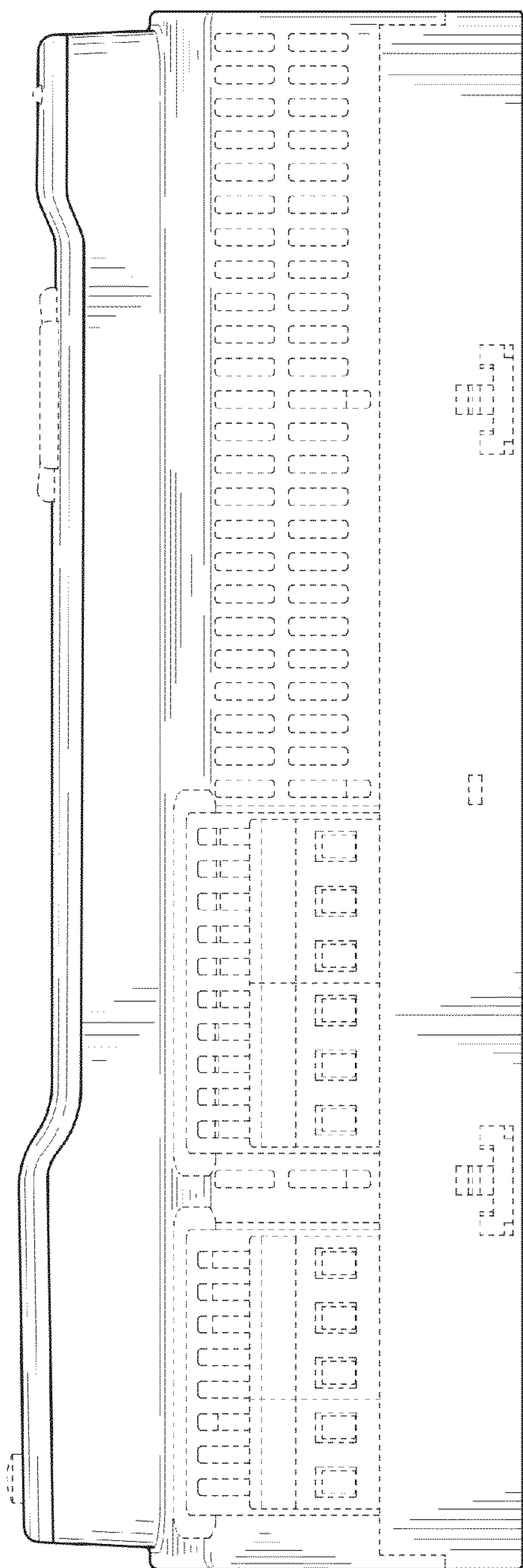

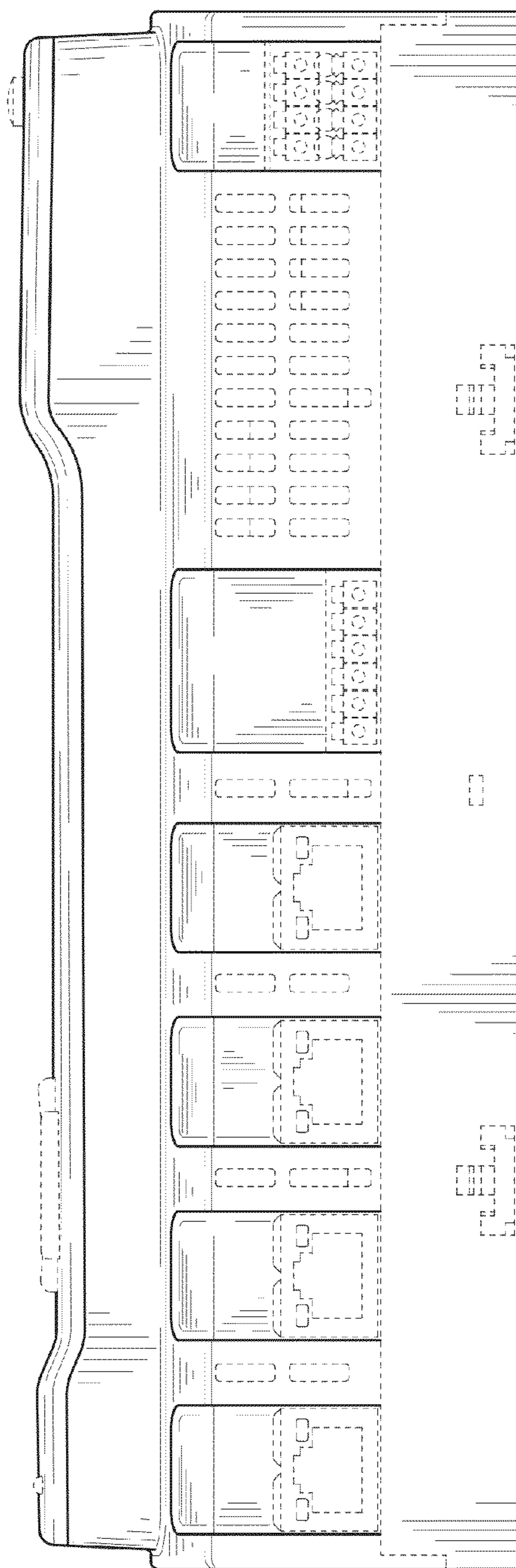

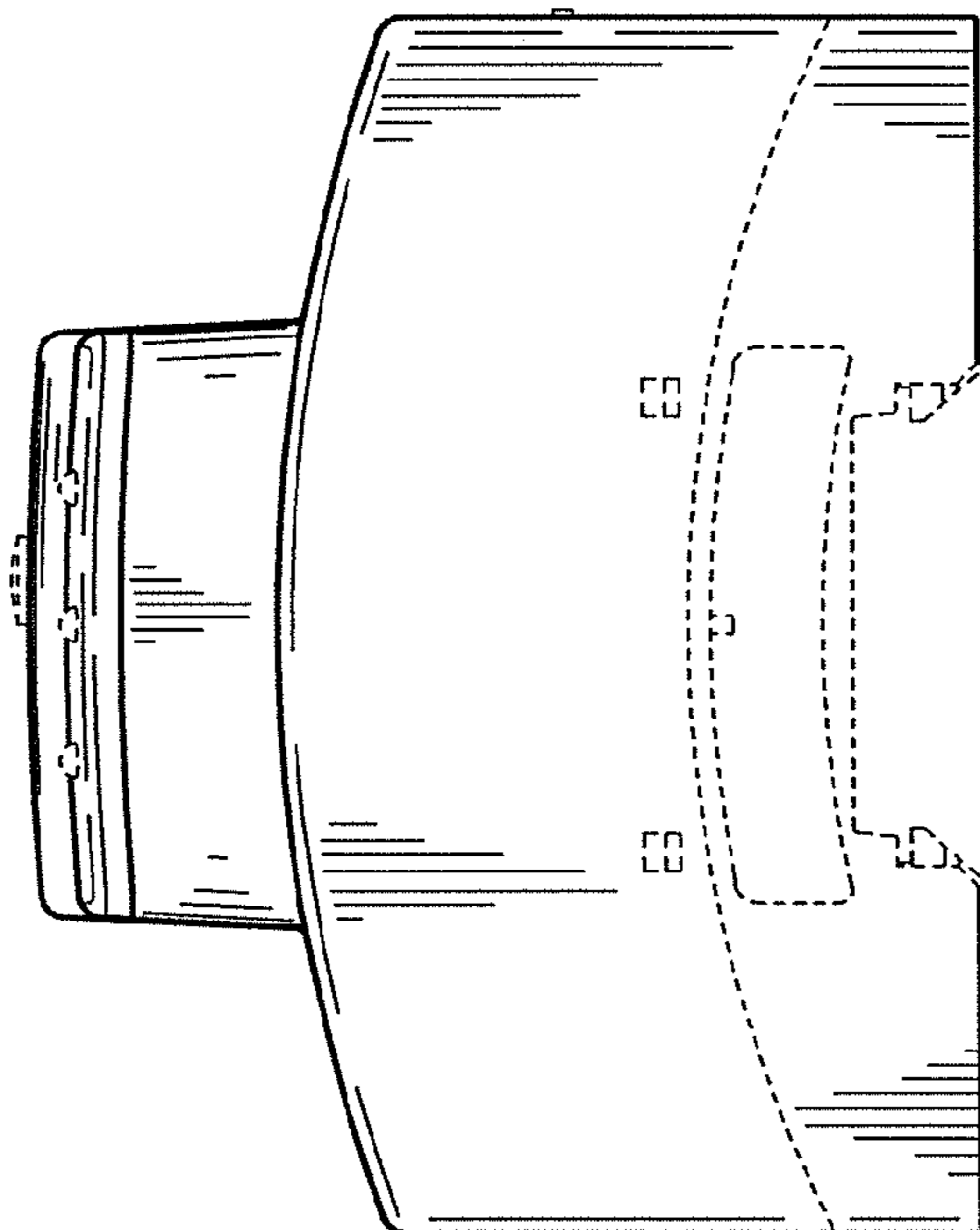

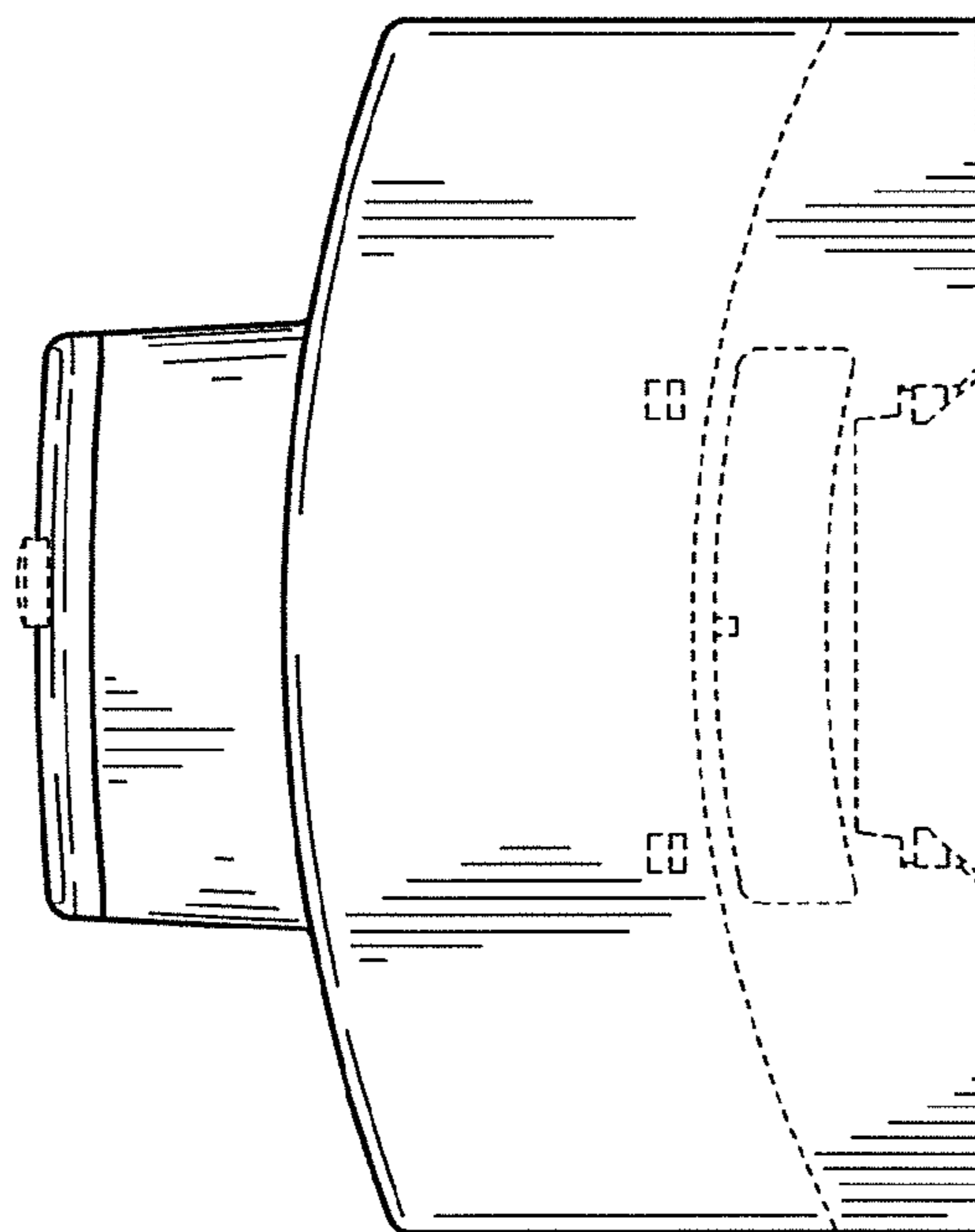

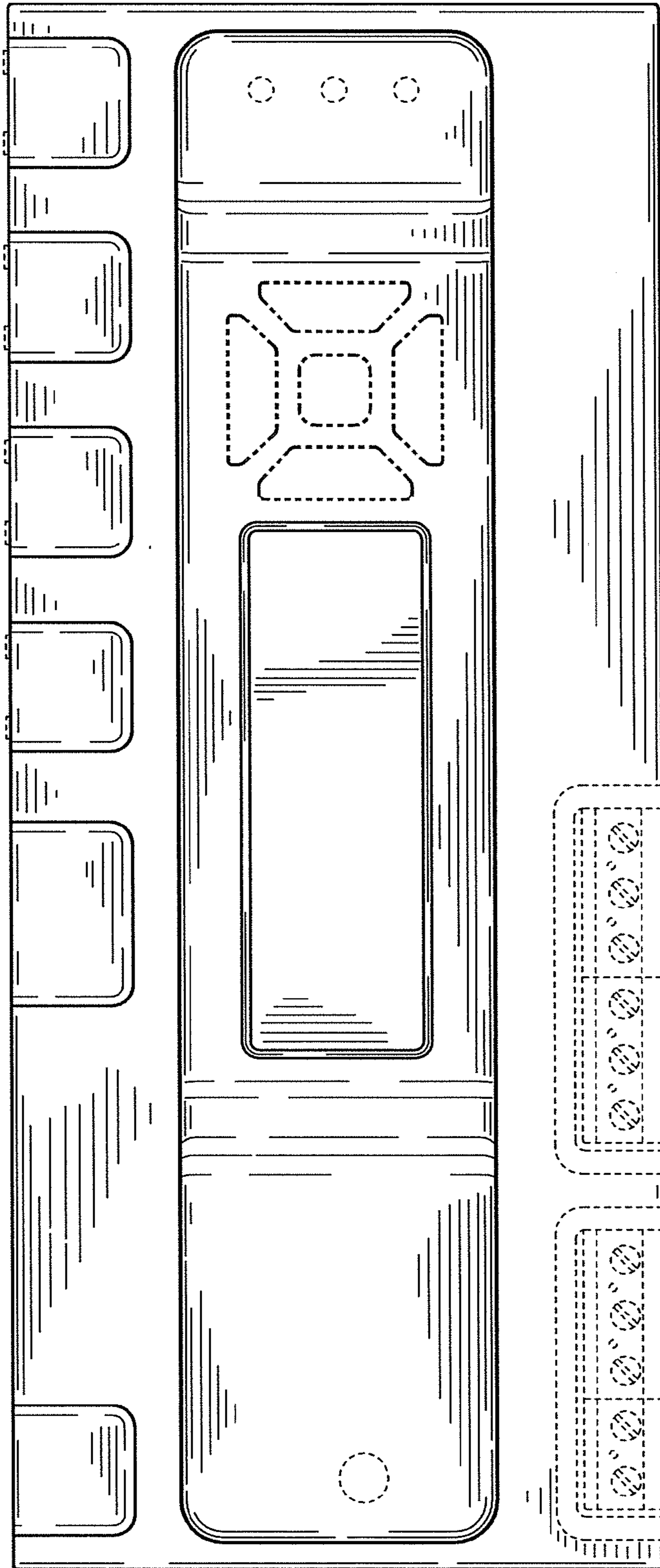

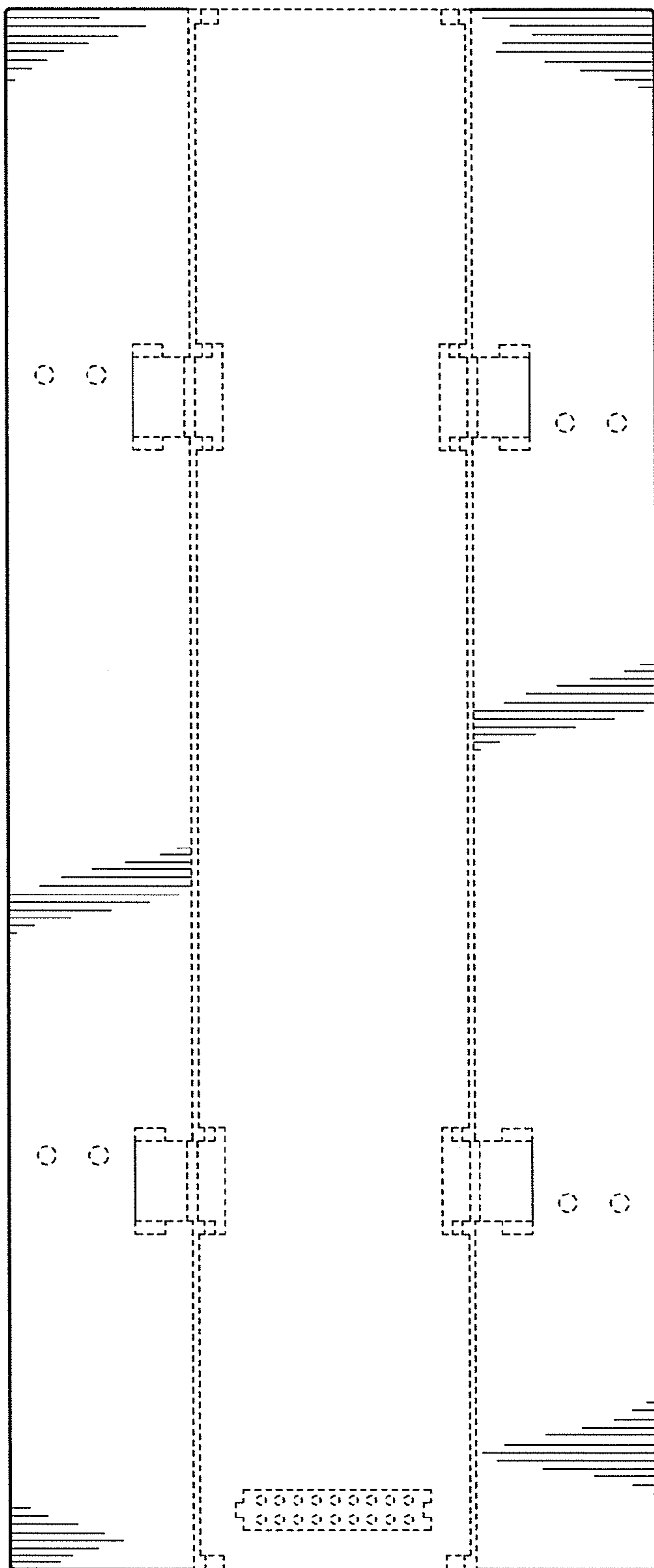
