(57) **CLAIM**

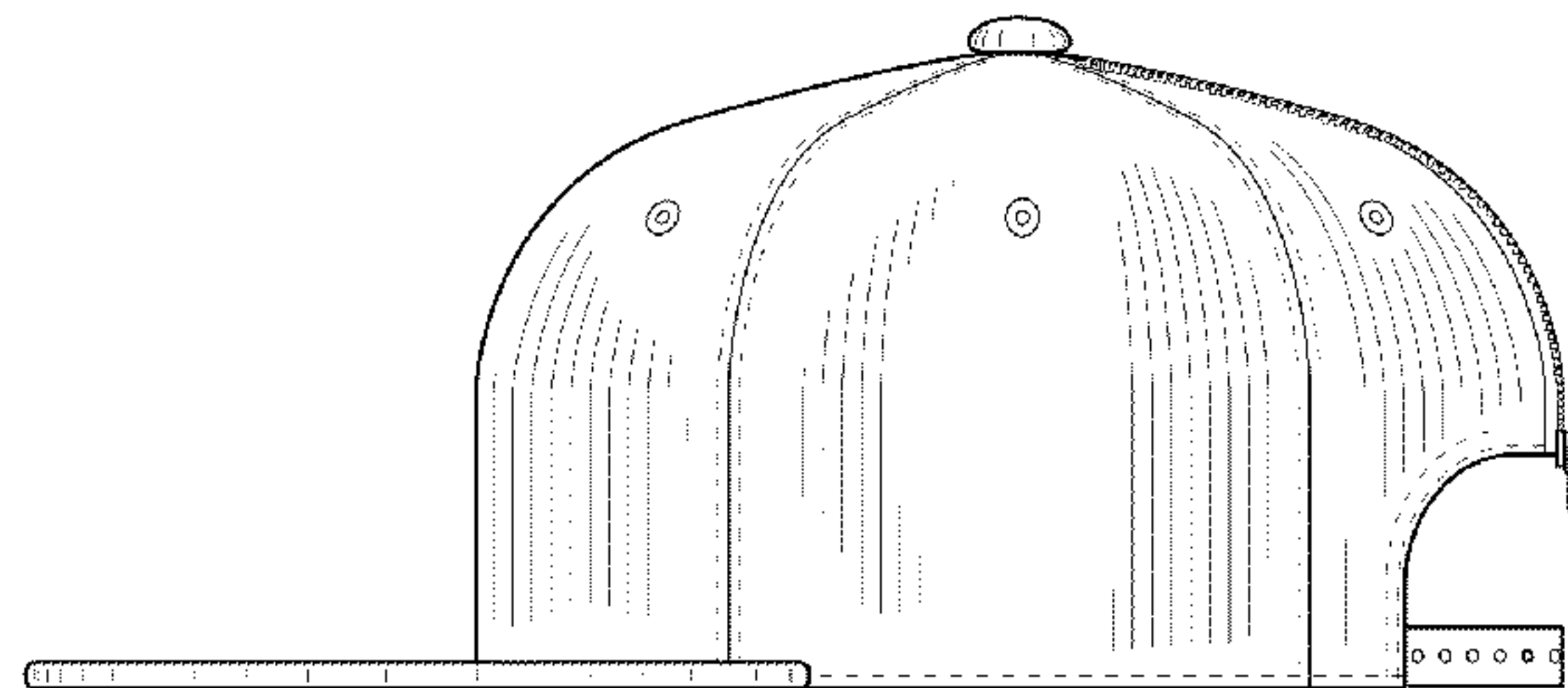
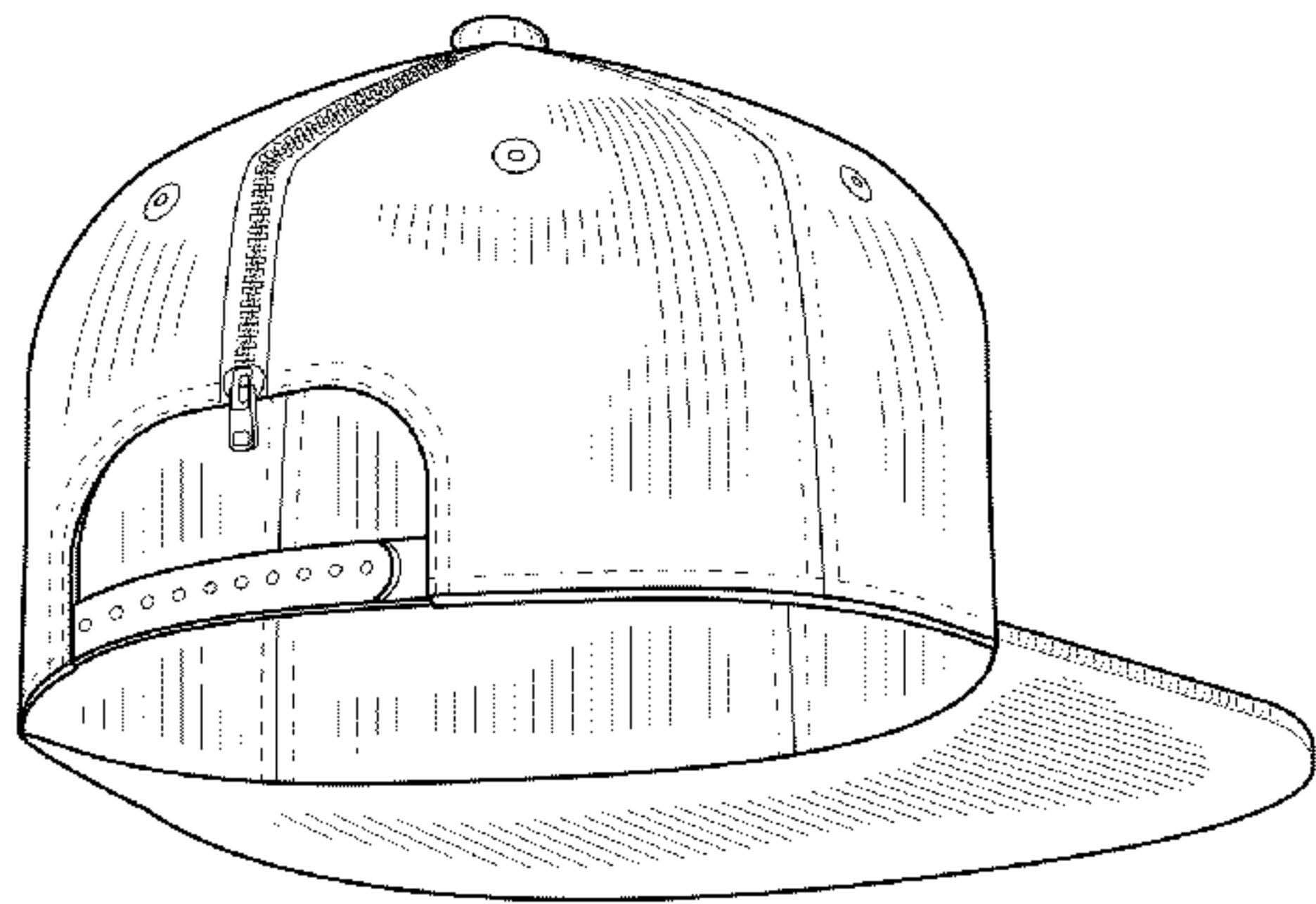
We claim the ornamental design for a zipped baseball cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a zipped baseball cap, showing our new design with a zipper in a lowered position; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view, illustrated with the zipper in a partially raised position; FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1.

The broken lines in the figures represent stitching, and are part of the claimed design.

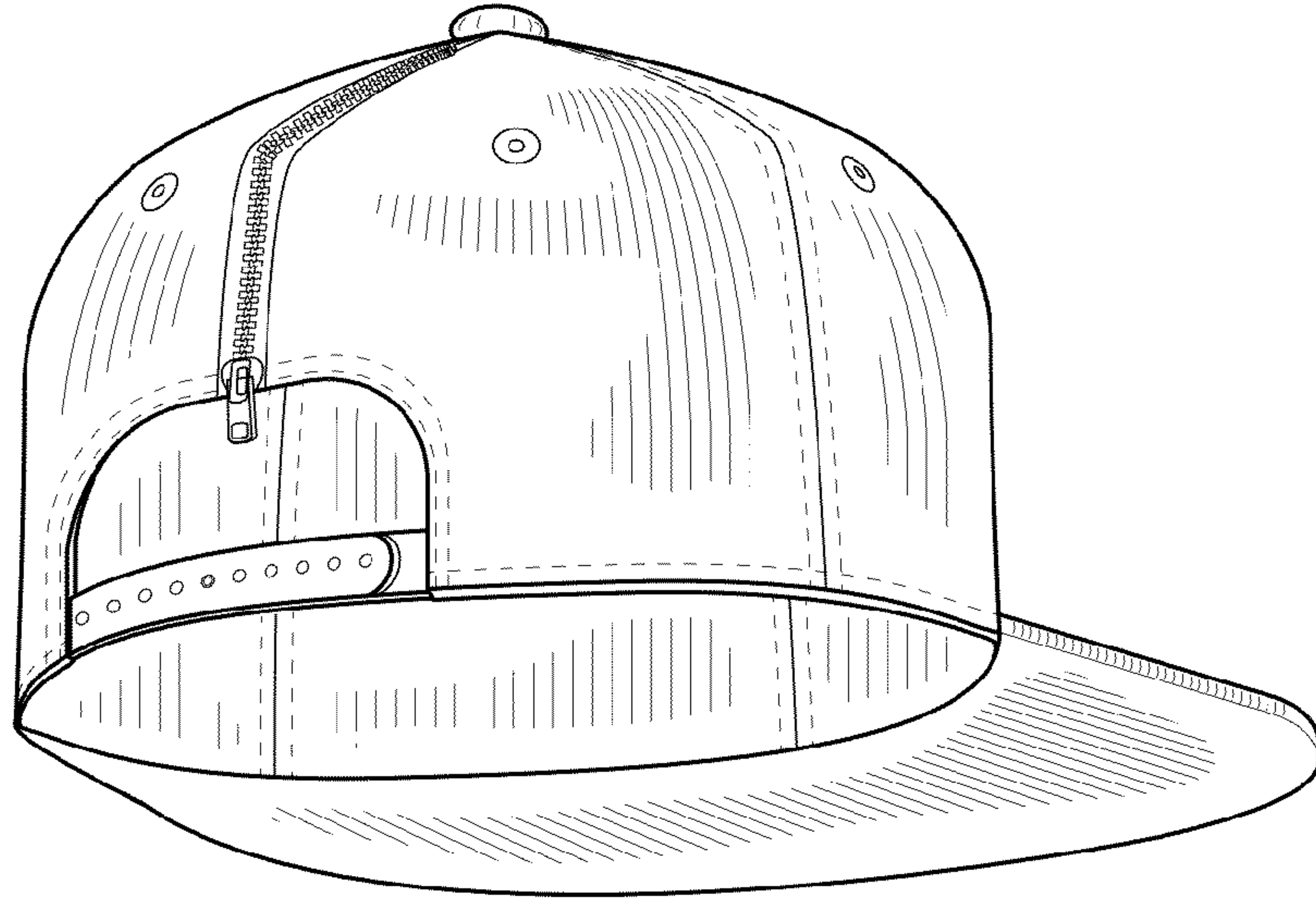

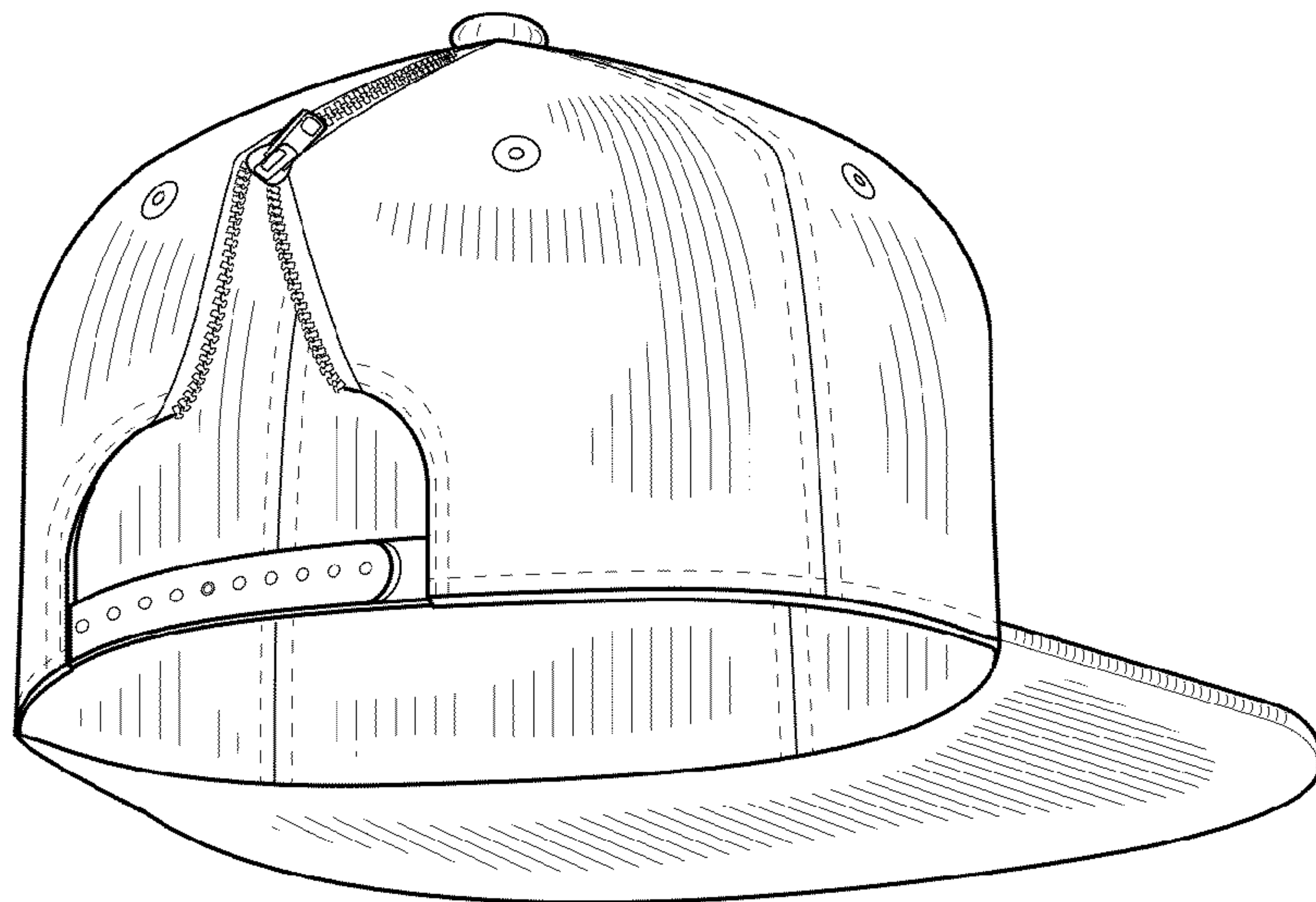

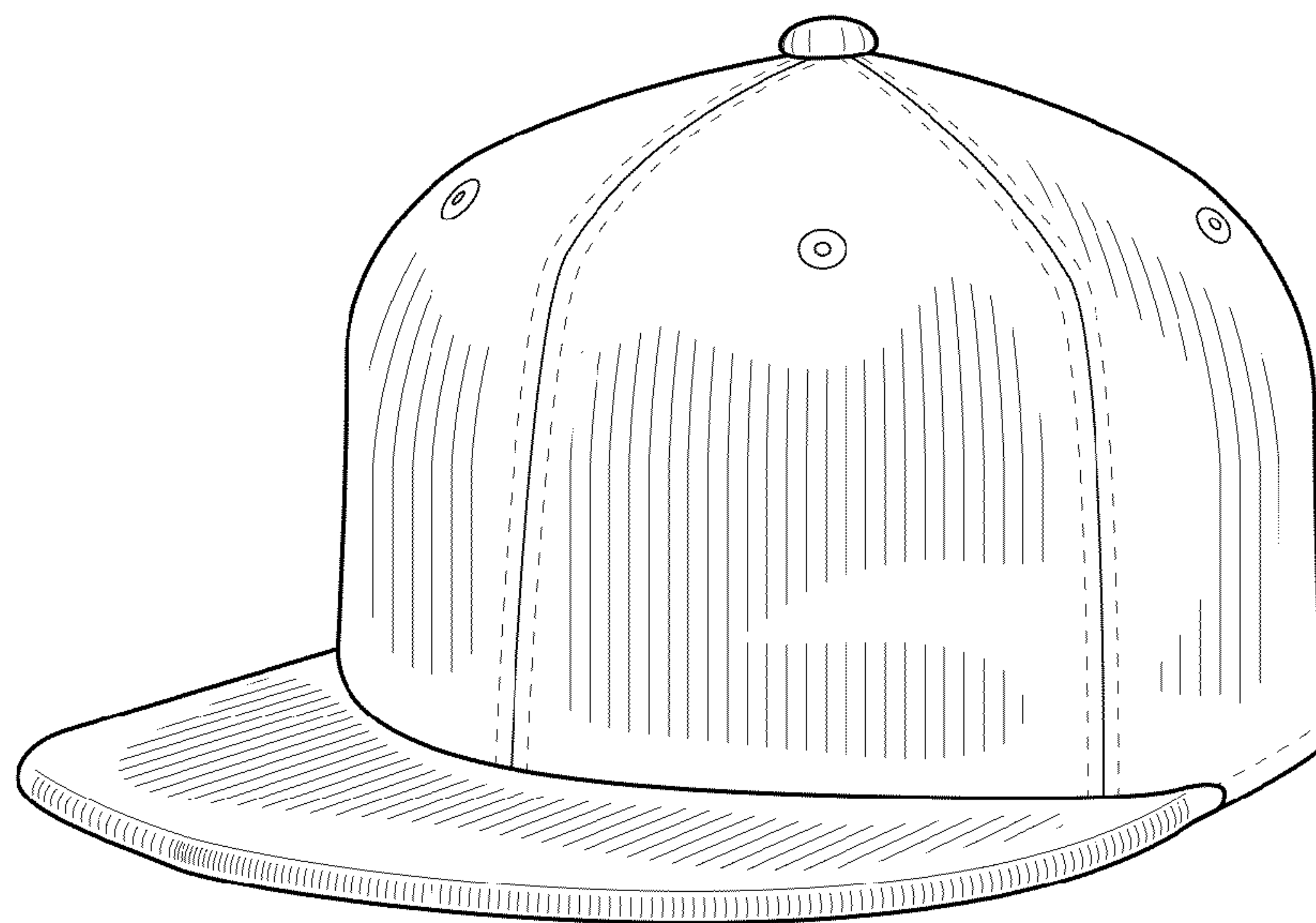

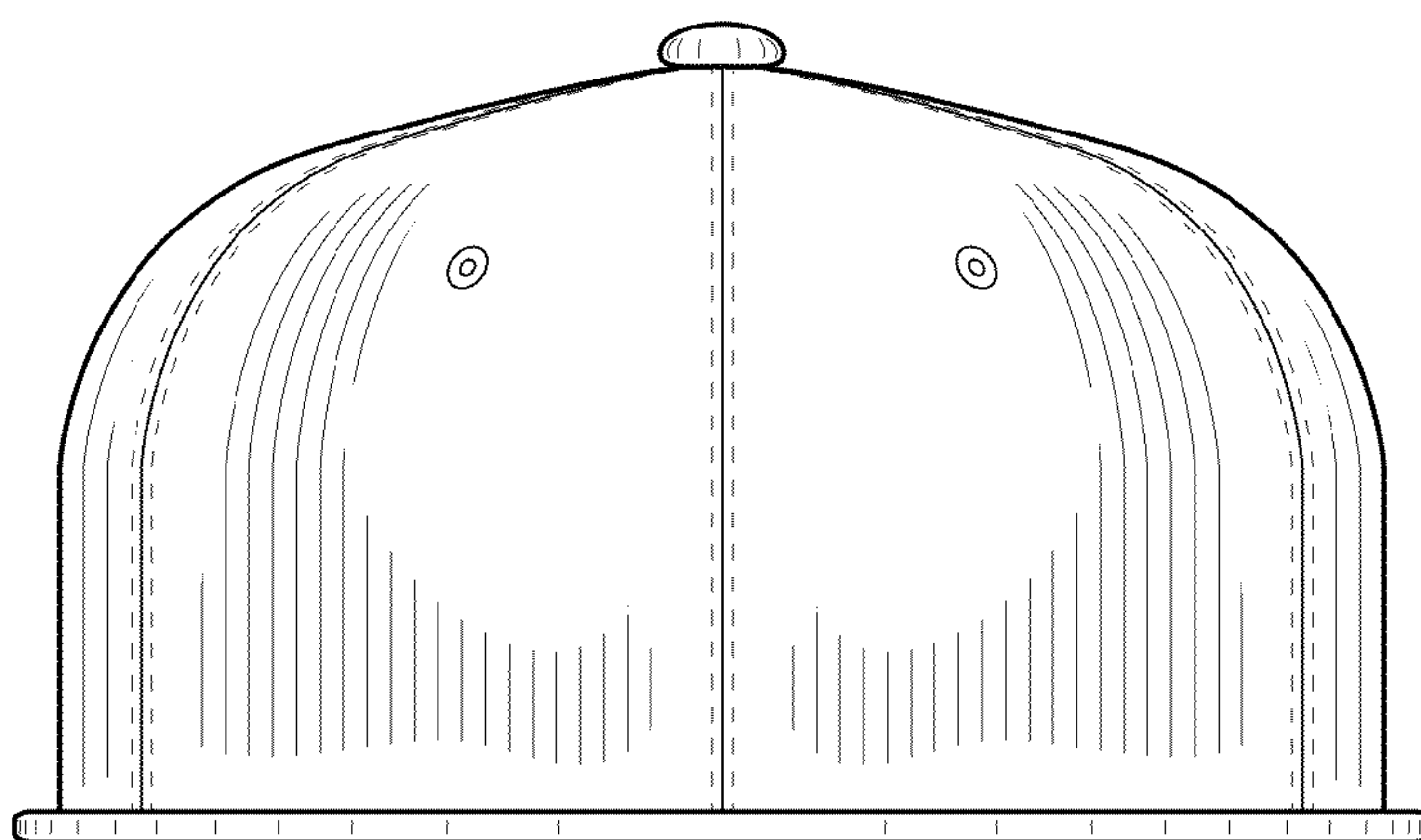

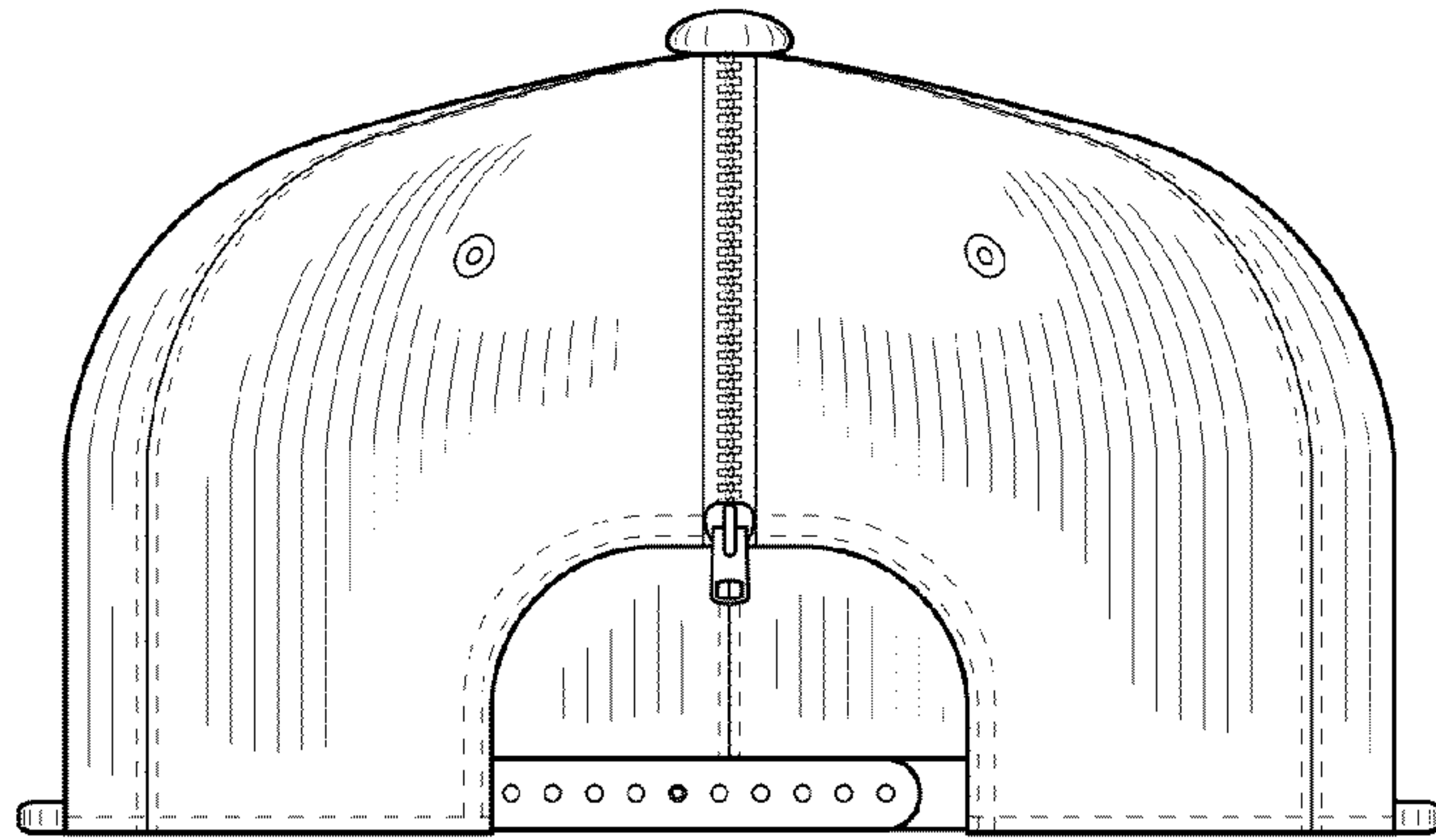

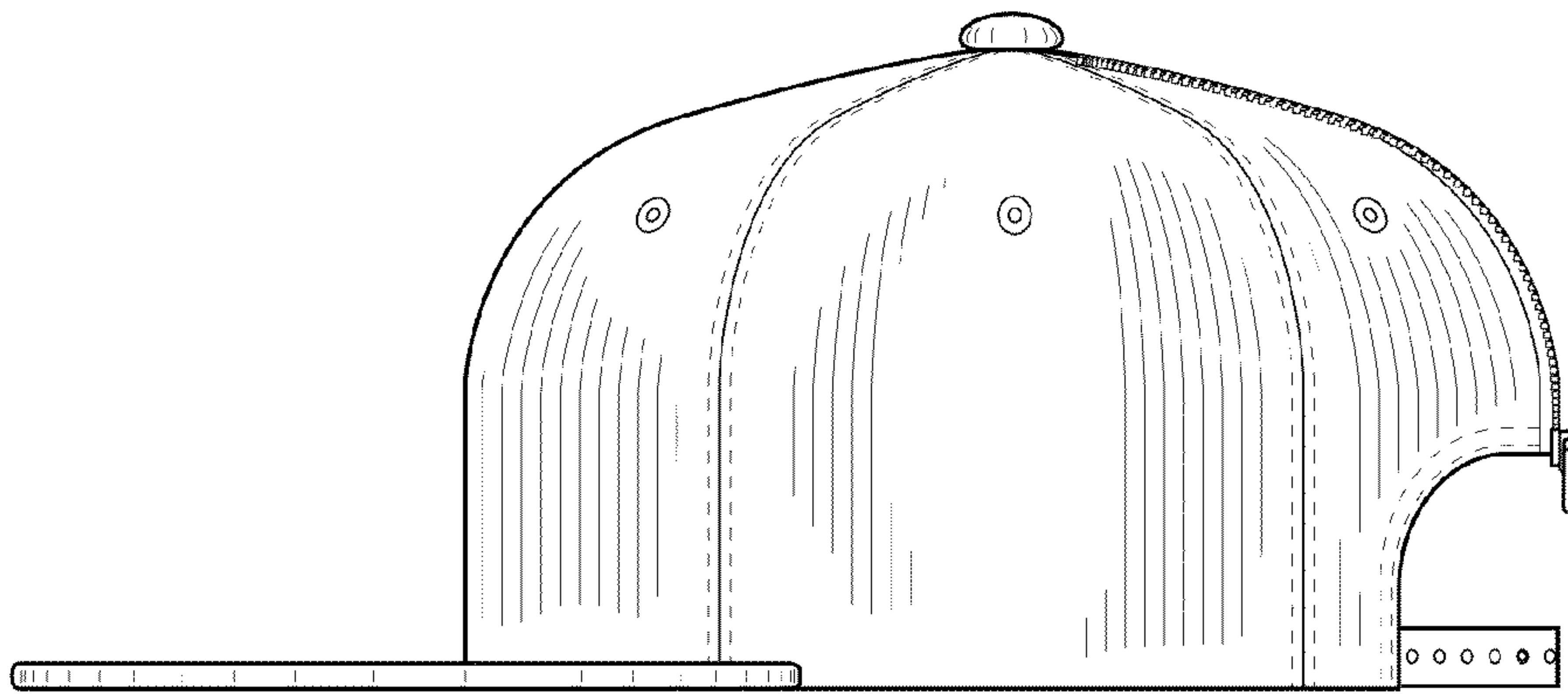

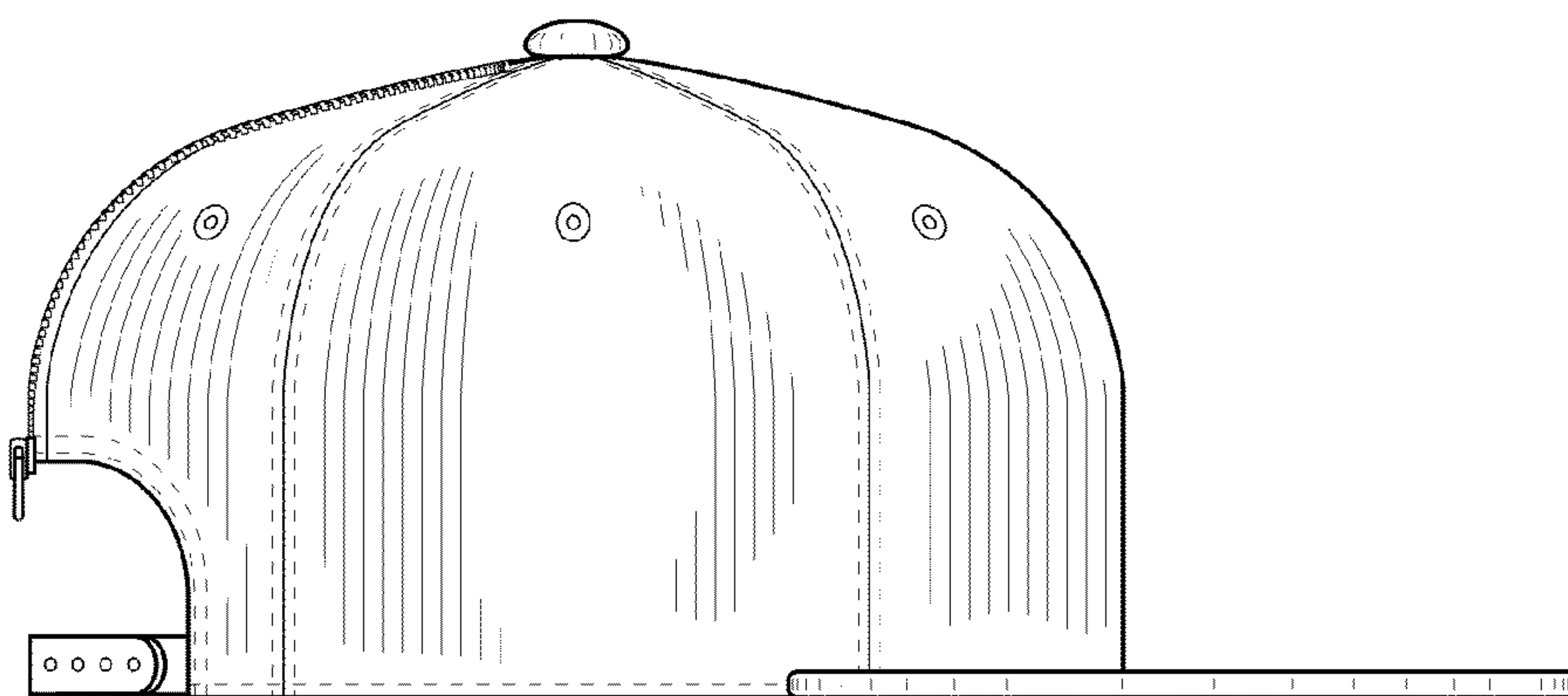

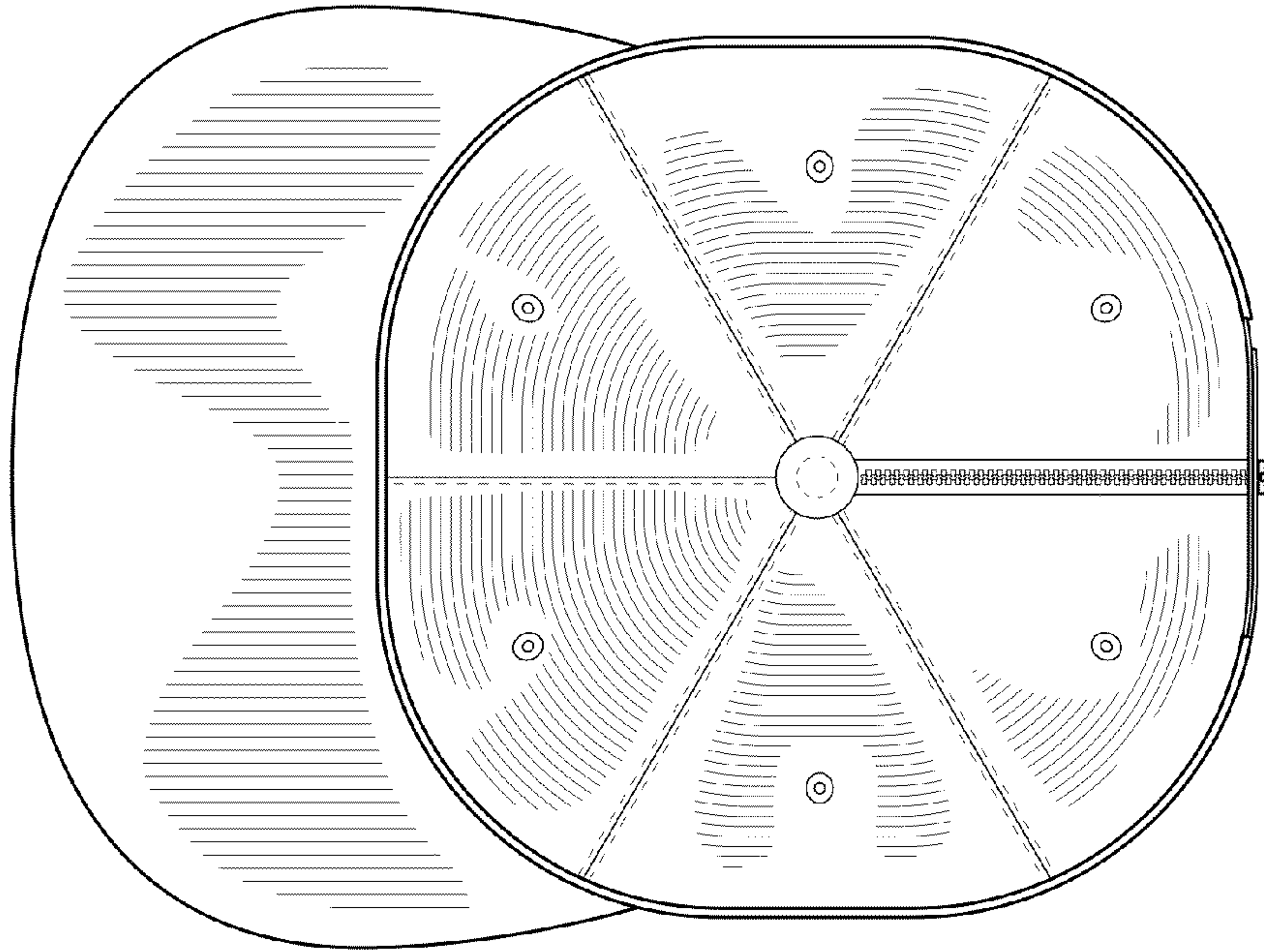

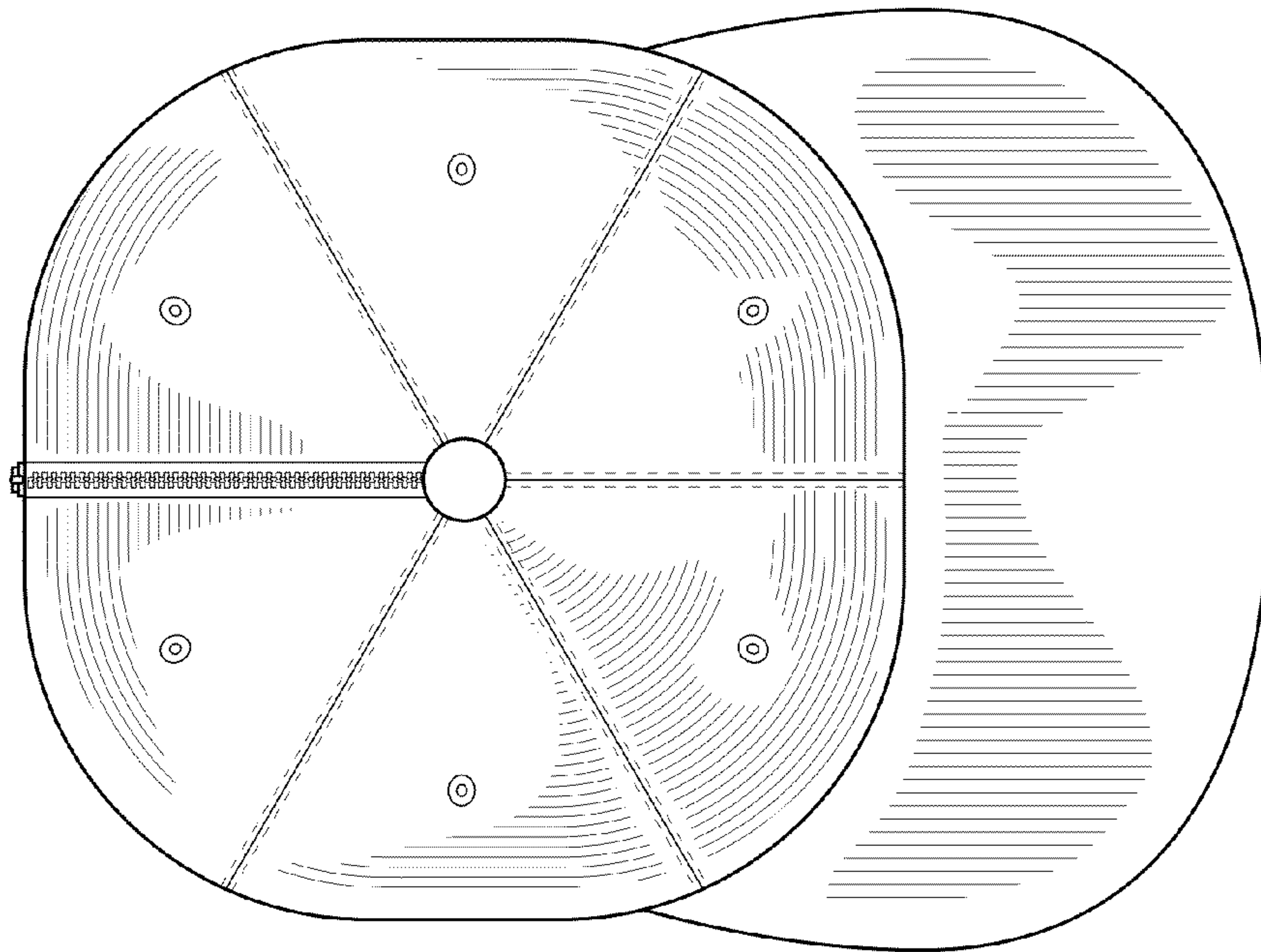
