DESCRIPTION

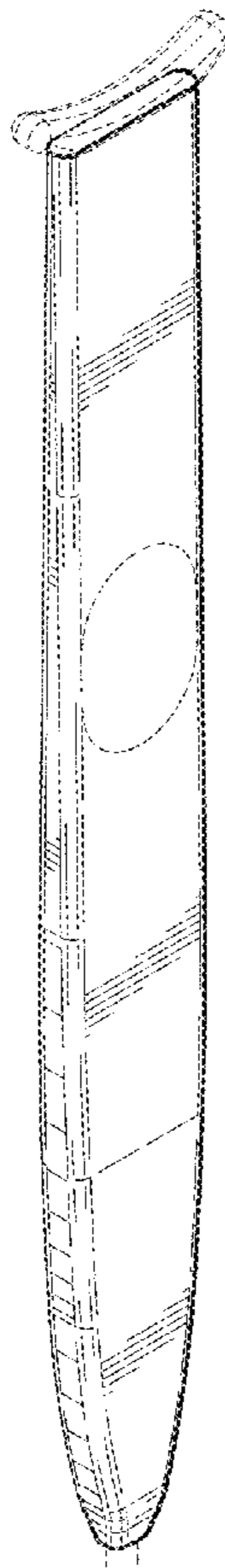
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a crutch decoration showing my new design;

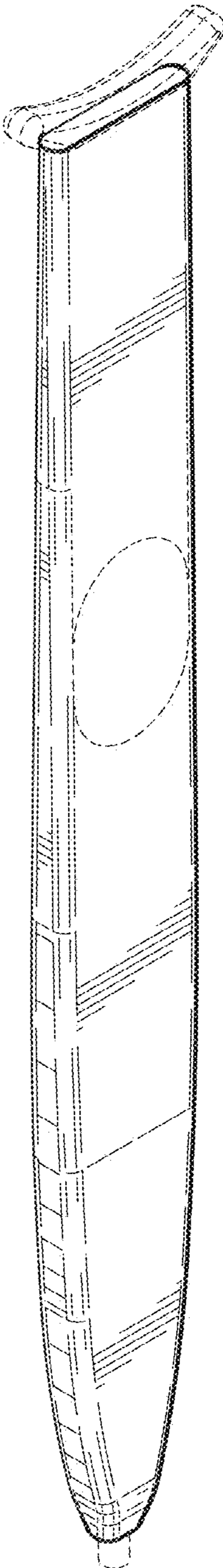

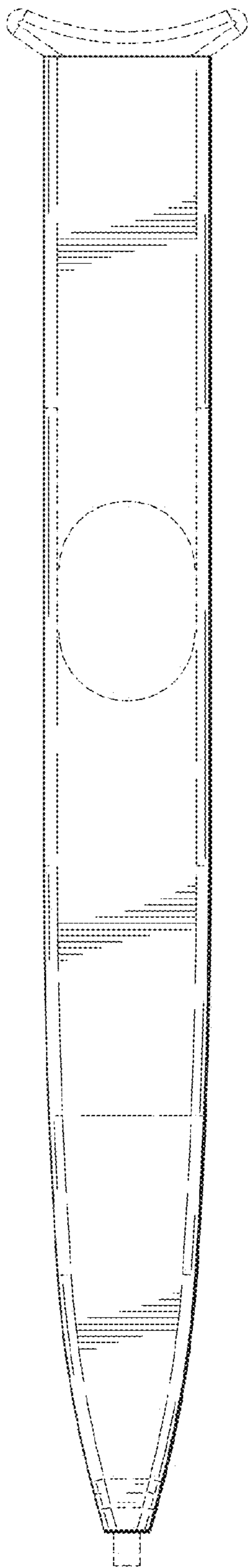

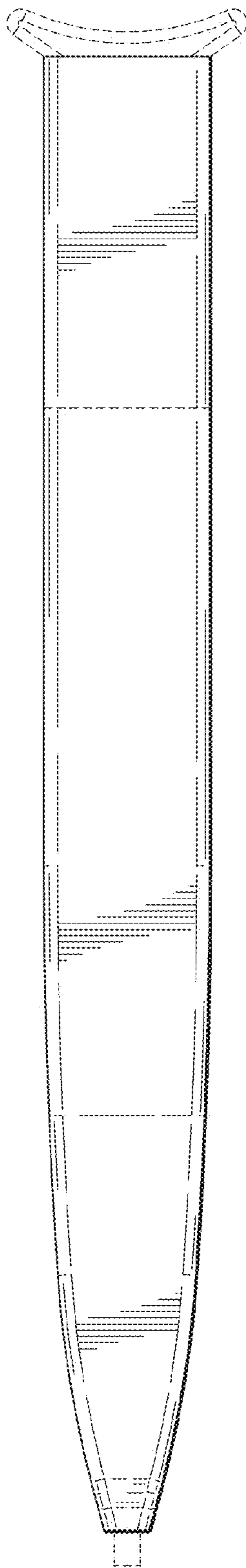

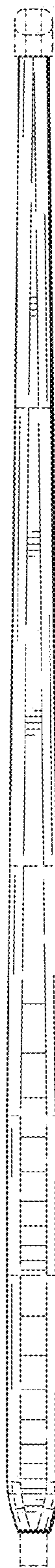
