(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sheet good with surface pattern, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The sole FIGURE is a top view of a sheet good with surface pattern.

The dot dash dot broken line surrounding the design represents the boundaries of the claim and forms no part thereof.

The sheet good with surface pattern is flat and planar. Thickness or depth forms no part of the claimed design.
