DESCRIPTION

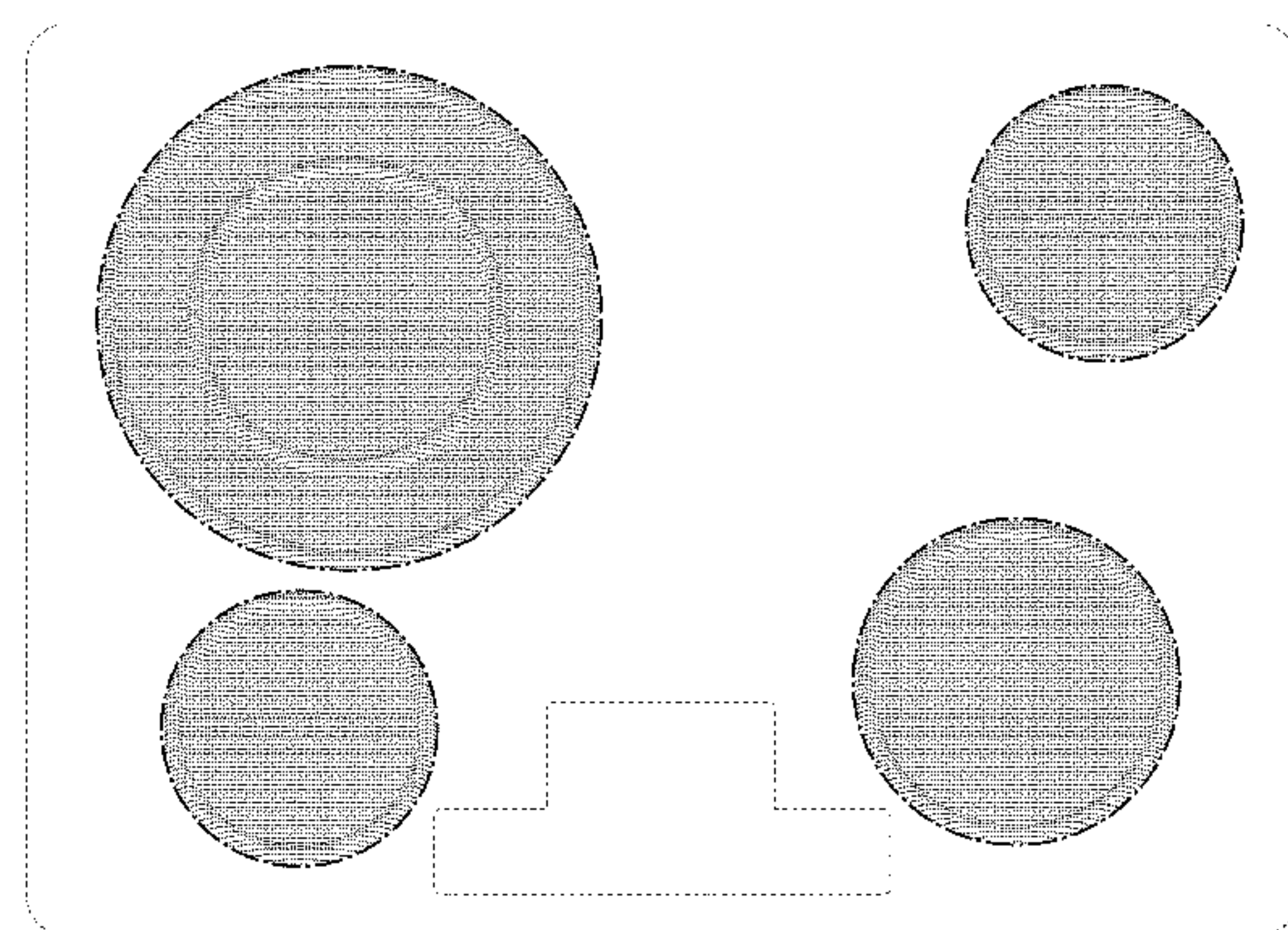
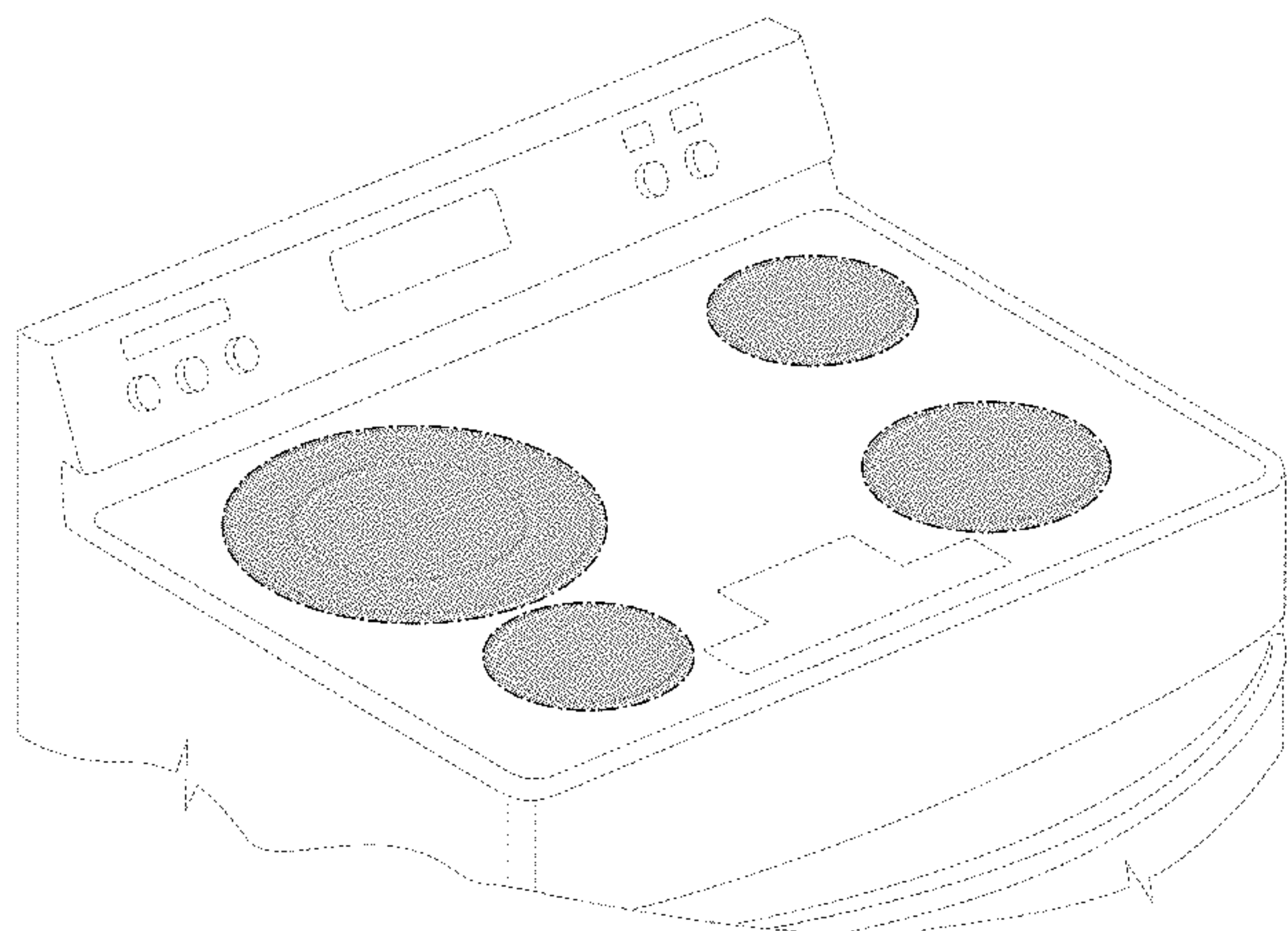
FIG. 1 is a top, left perspective view of a cooktop with graphically-simulated three-dimensional effect showing my new design; and,

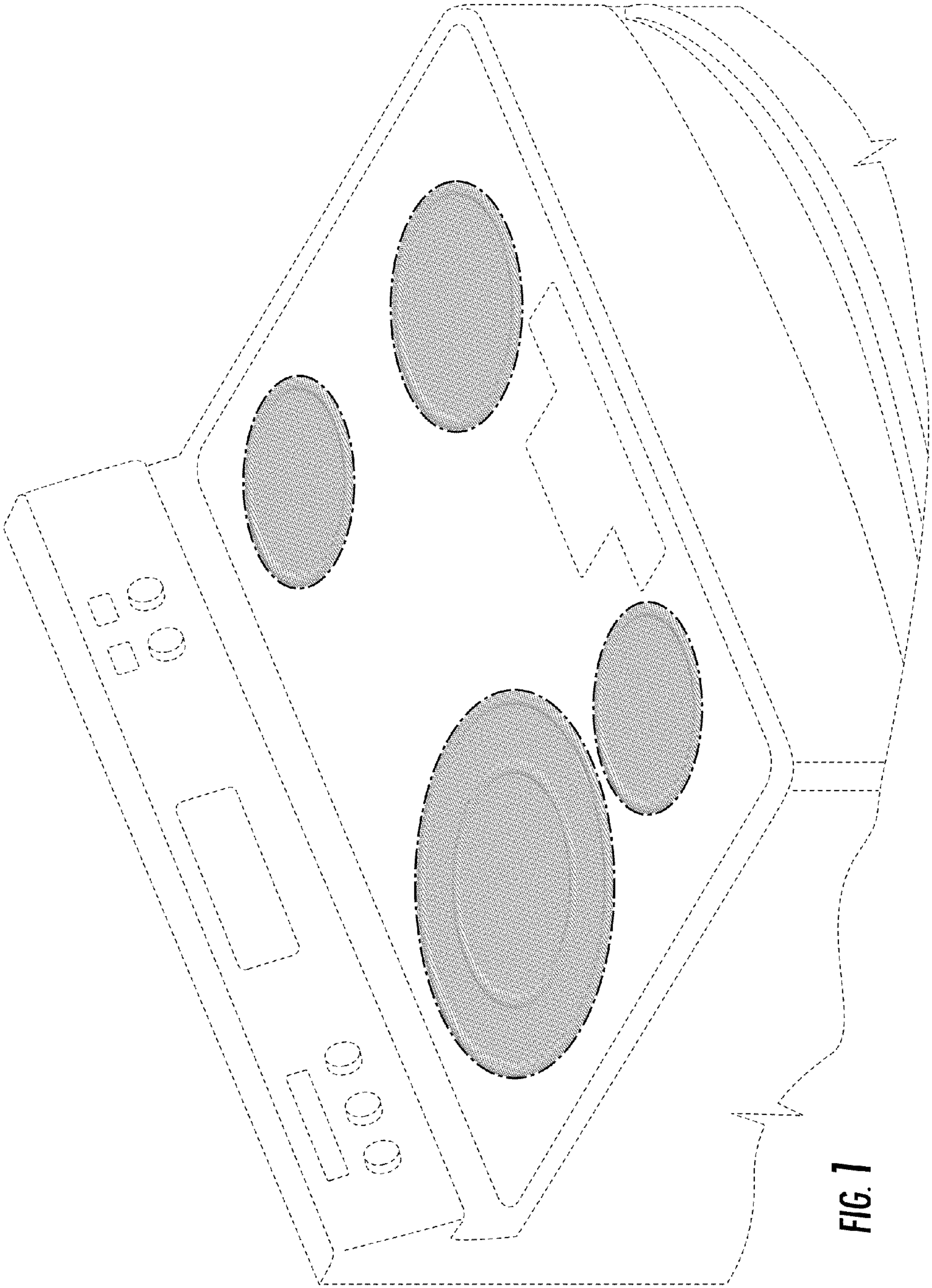
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

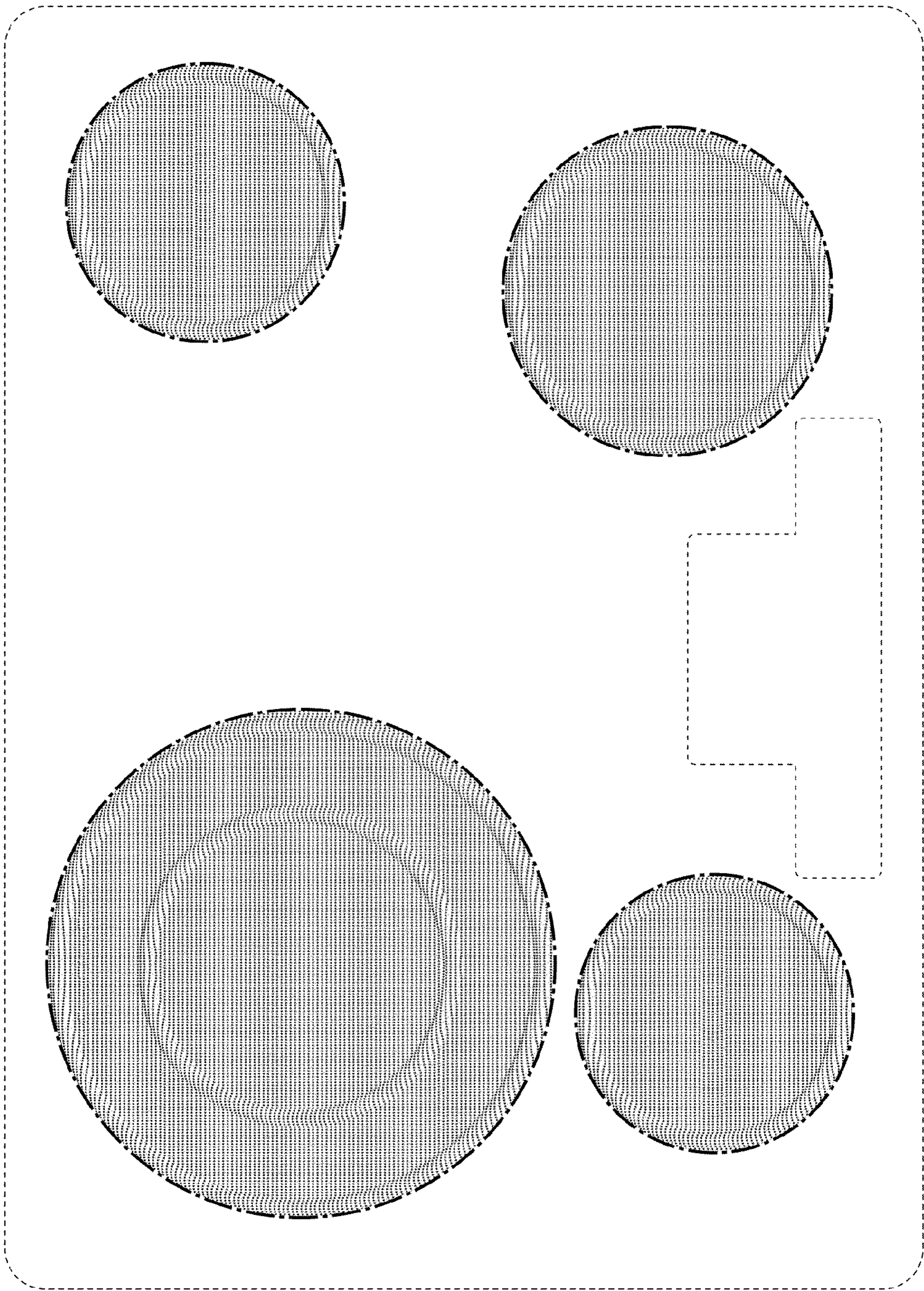
