(57) **CLAIM**

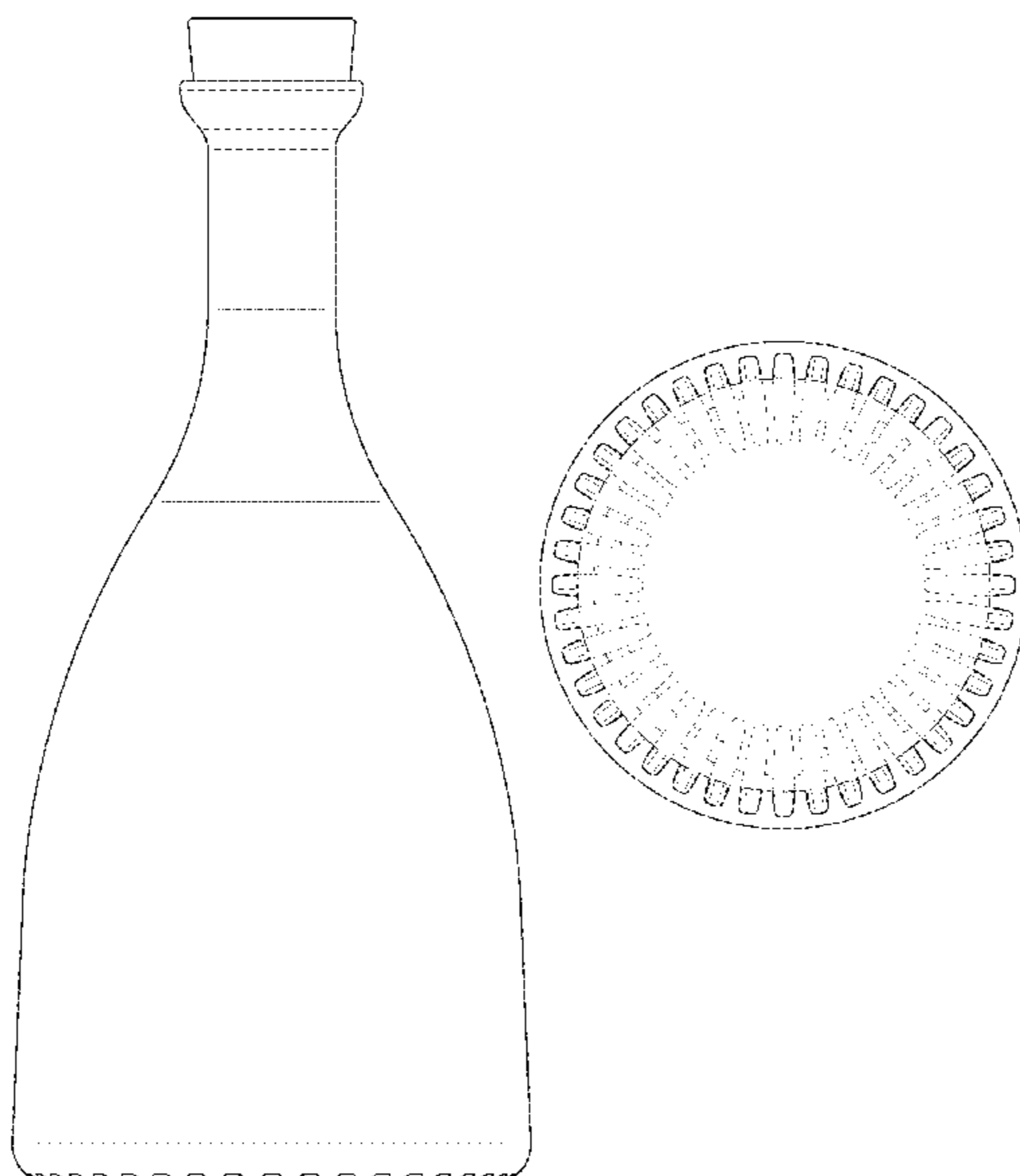
The ornamental design for a bottle for wine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a bottle for wine, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

 FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a bottle for wine according to the invention;
 FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a back elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof; and,

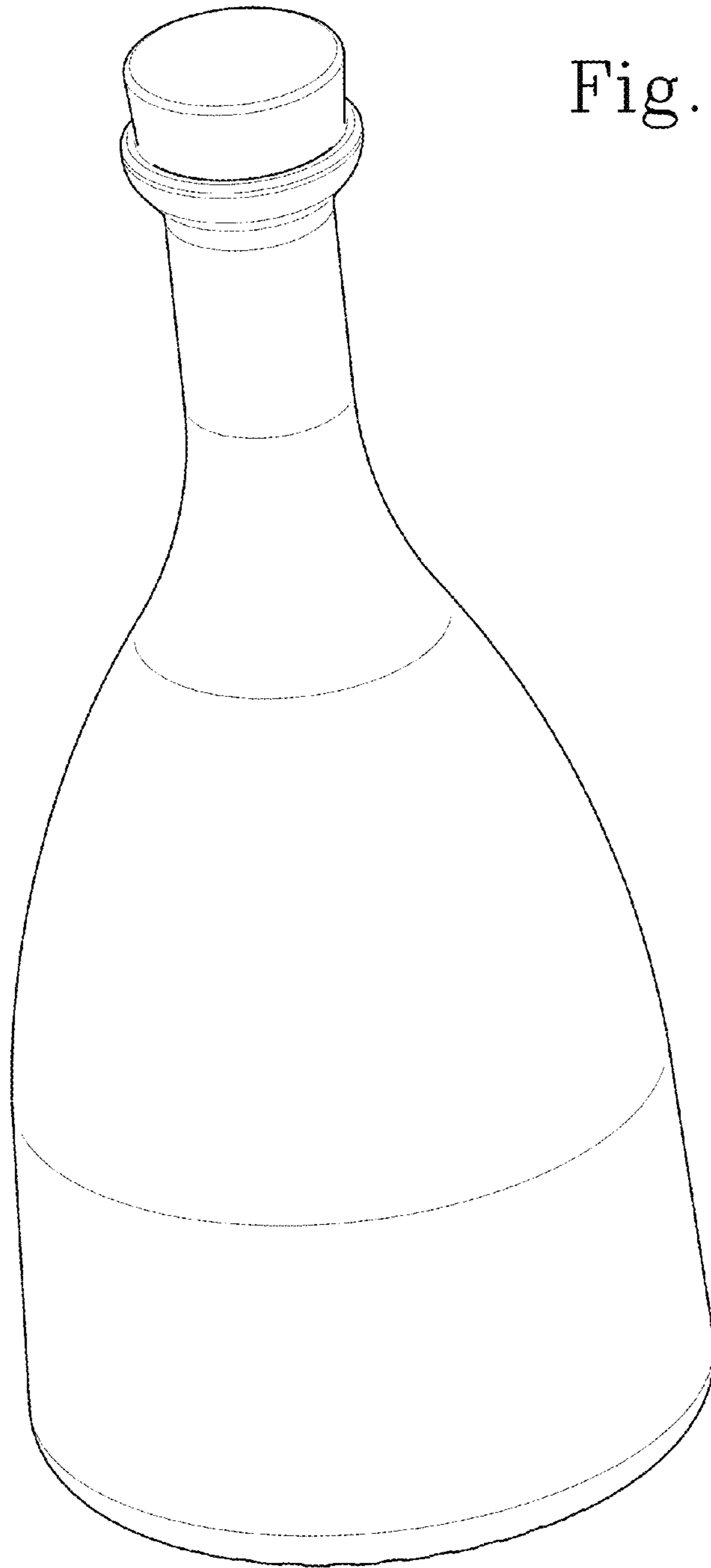

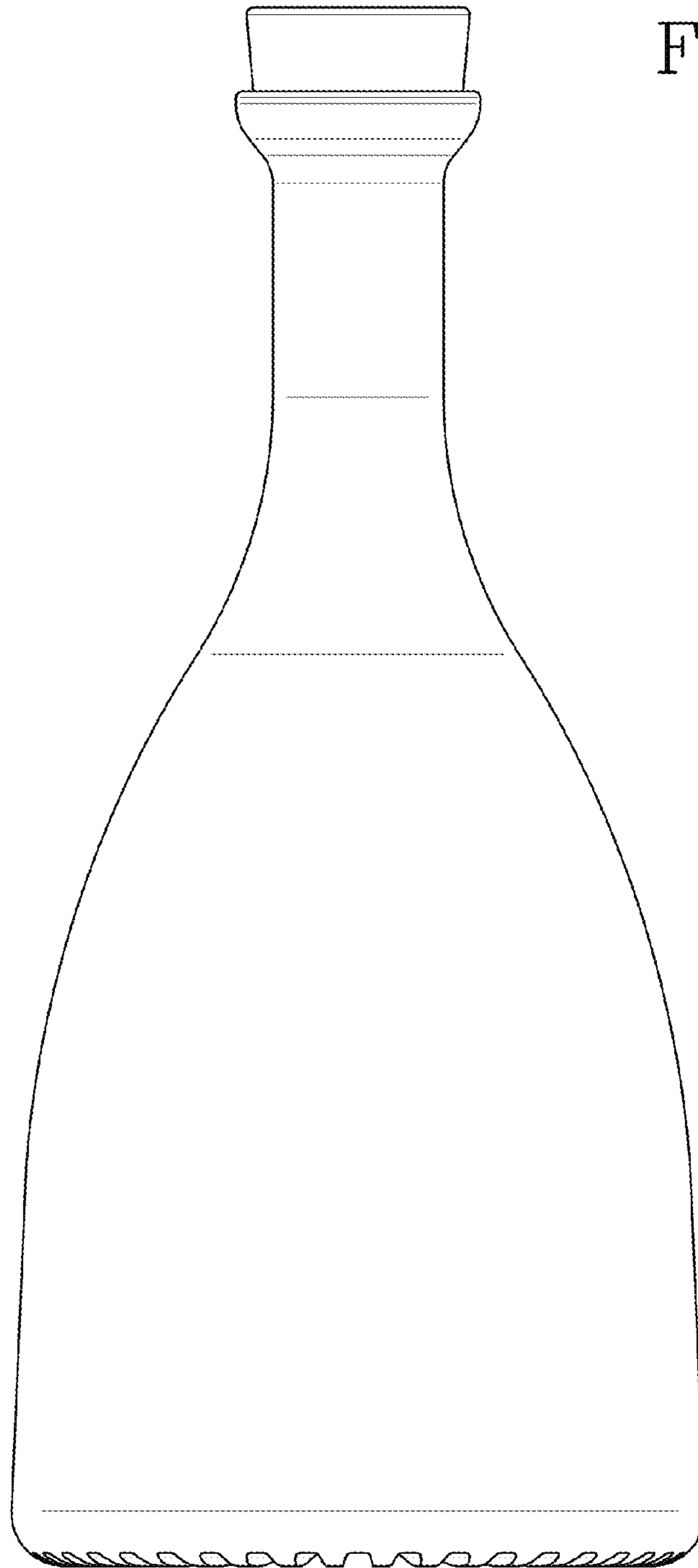

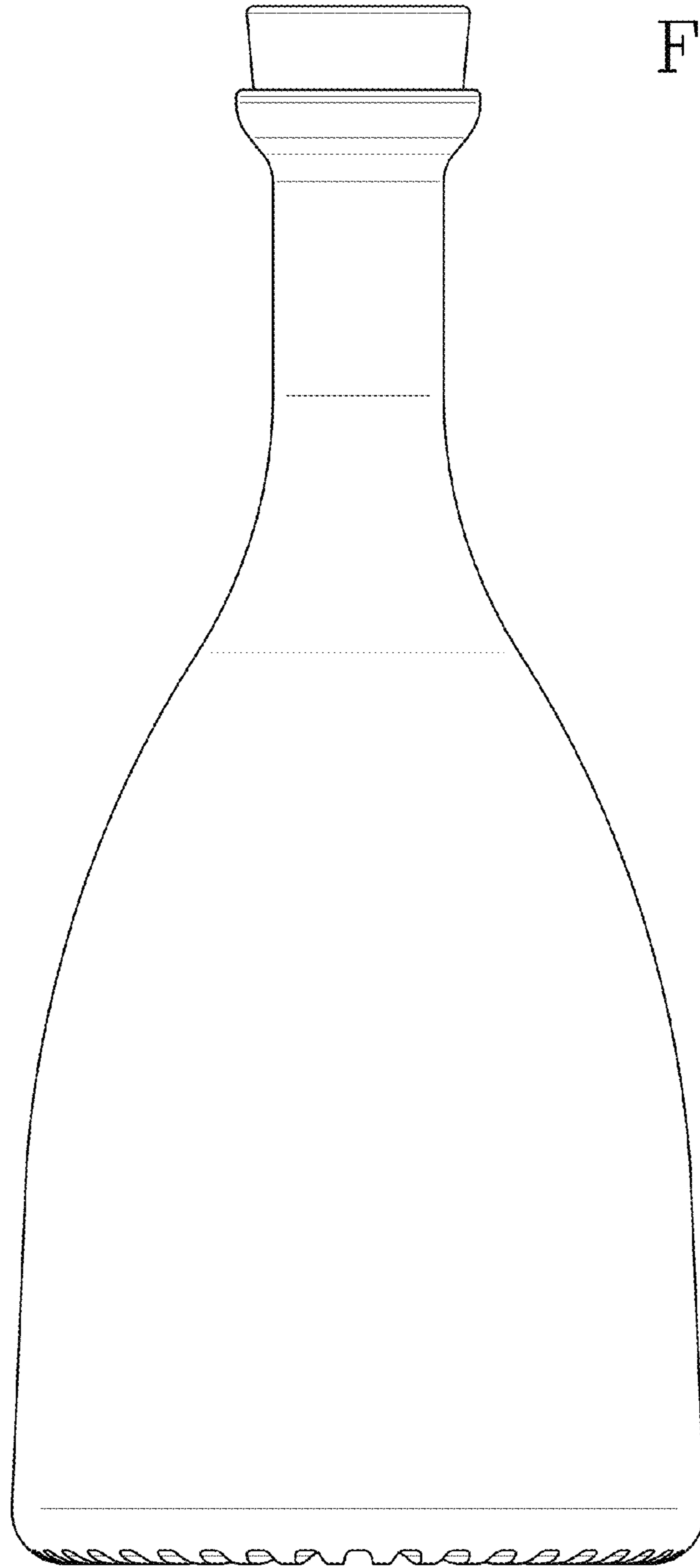

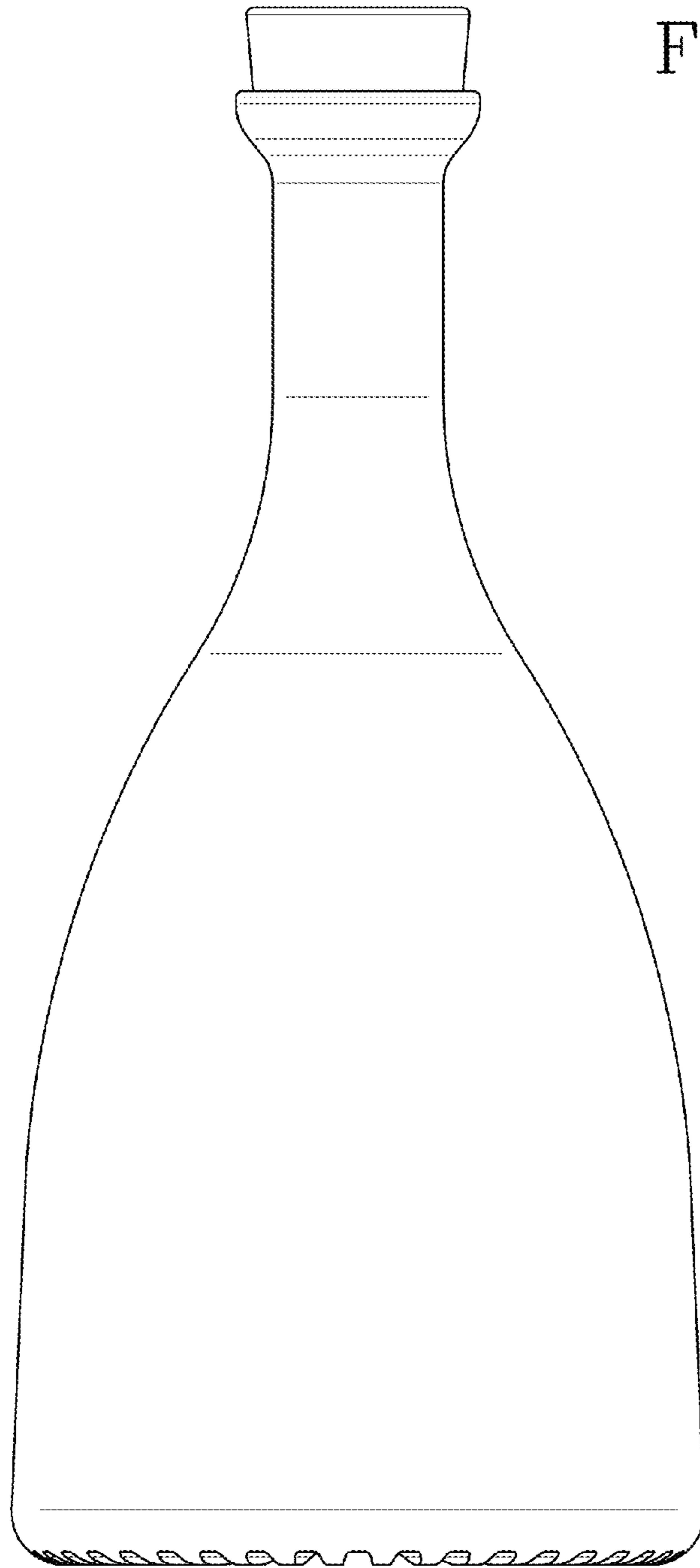

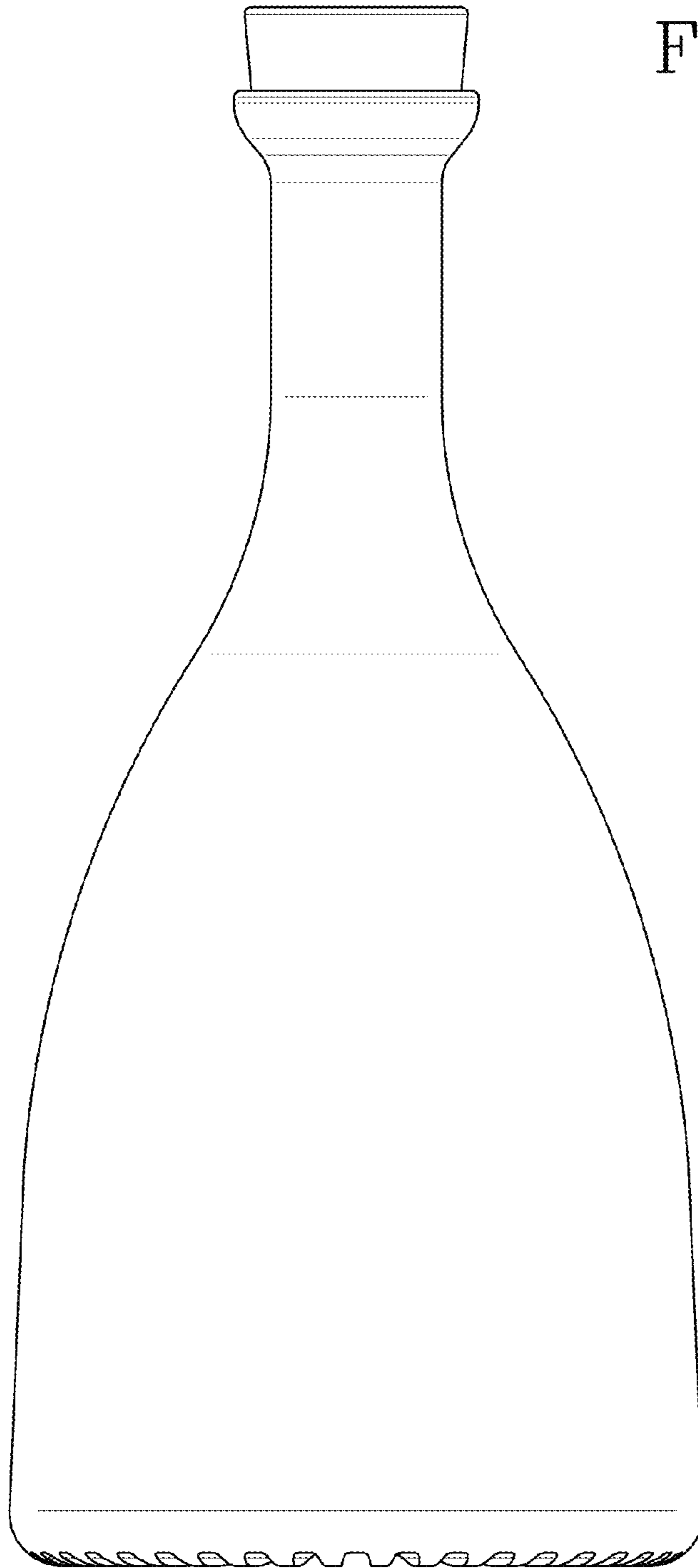

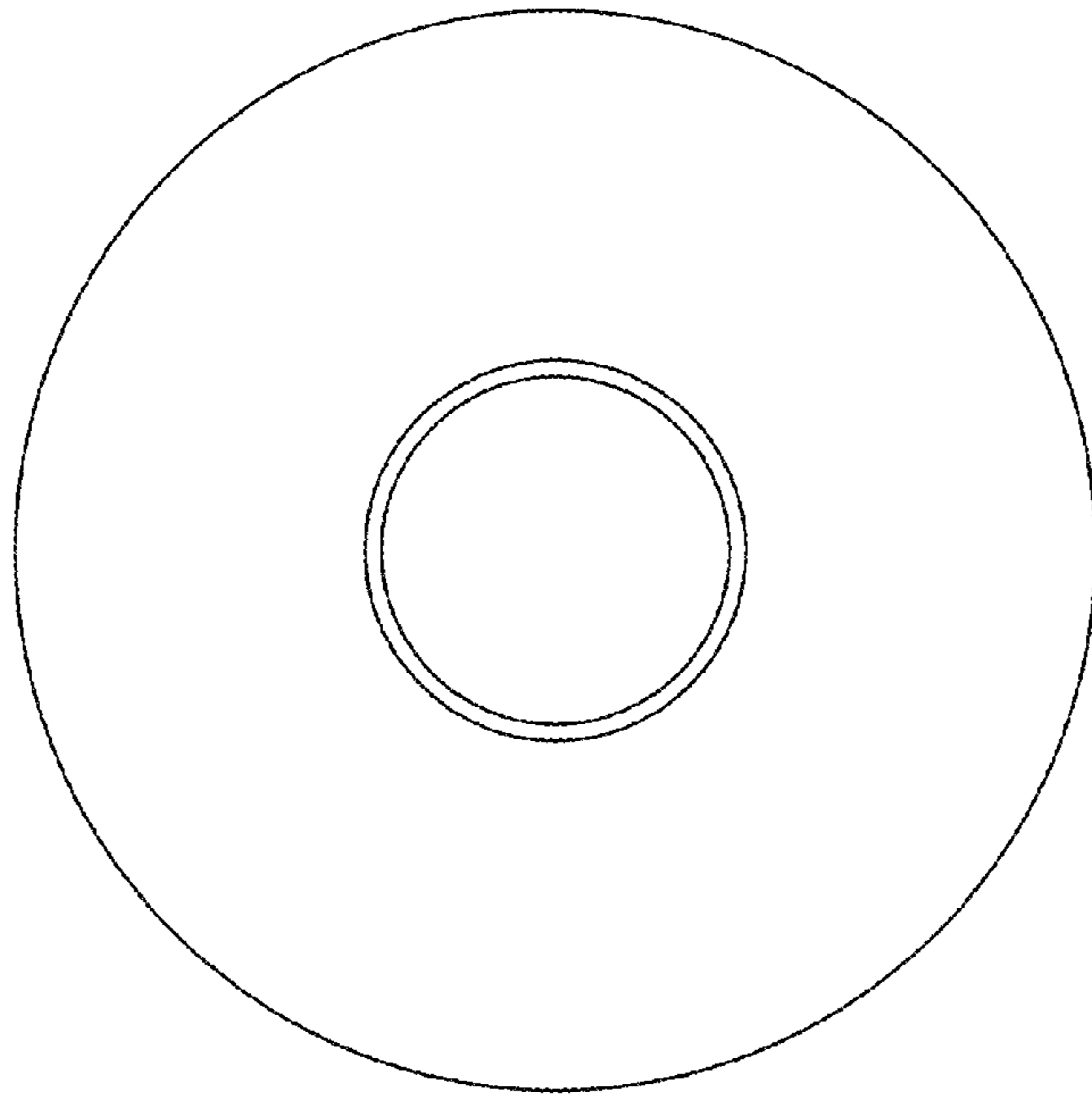
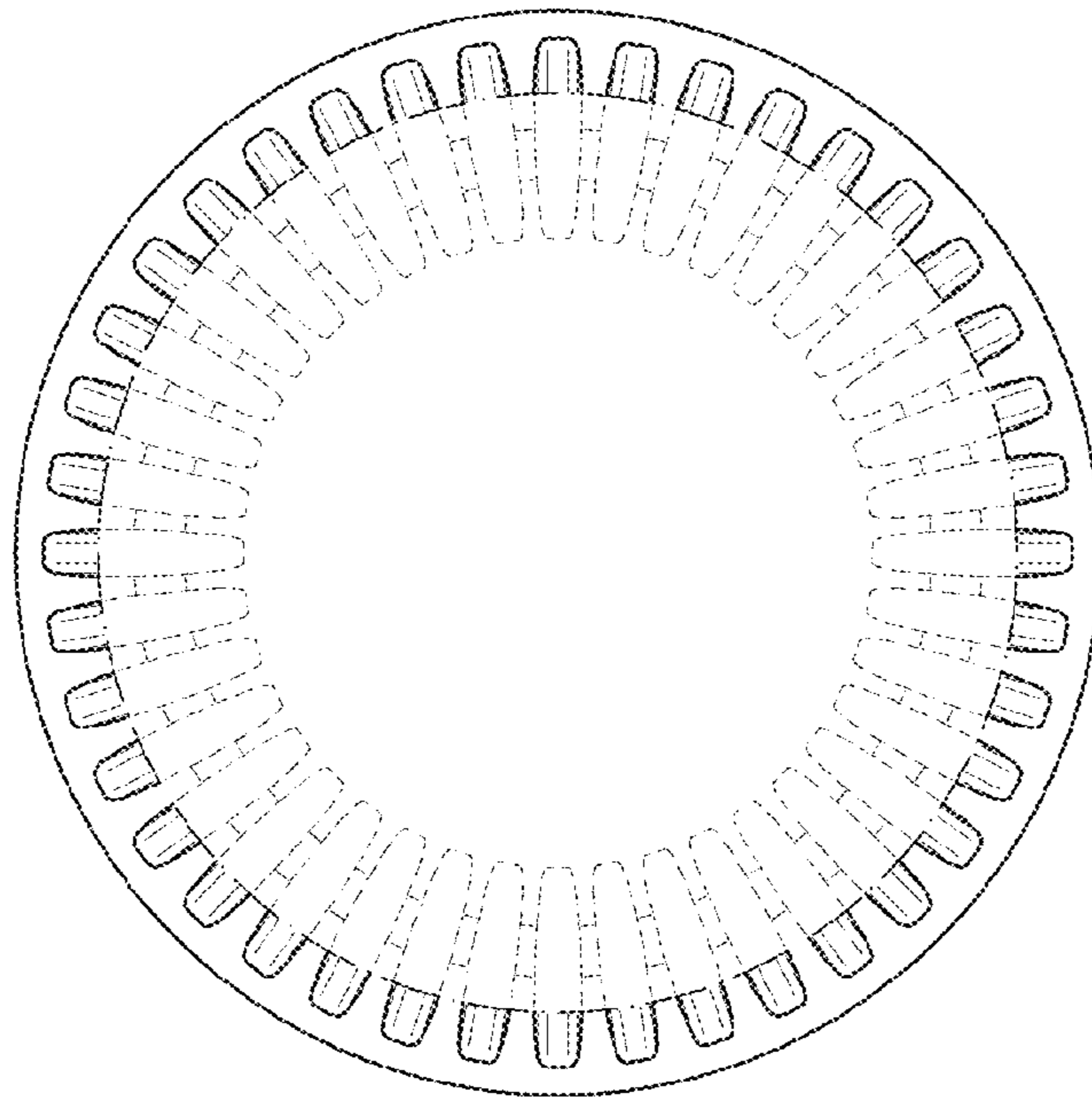
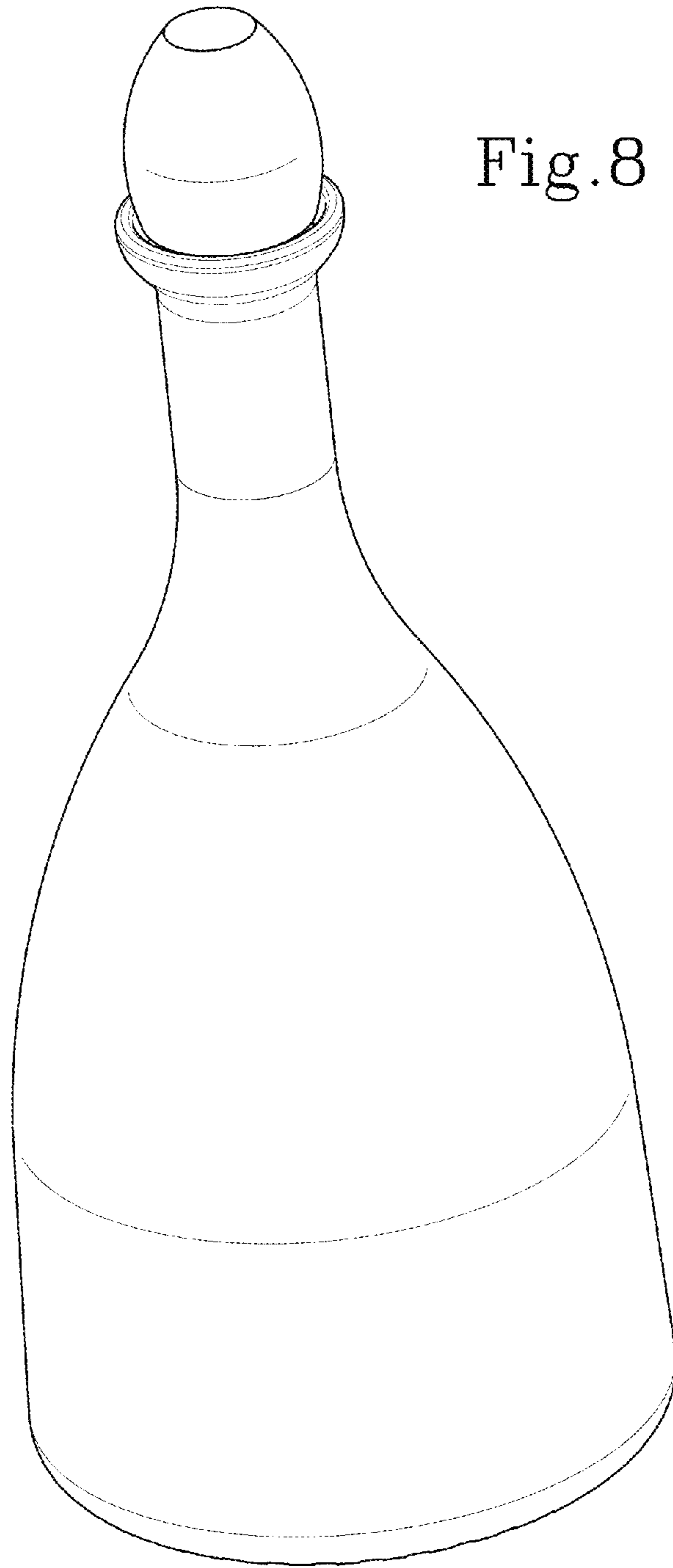

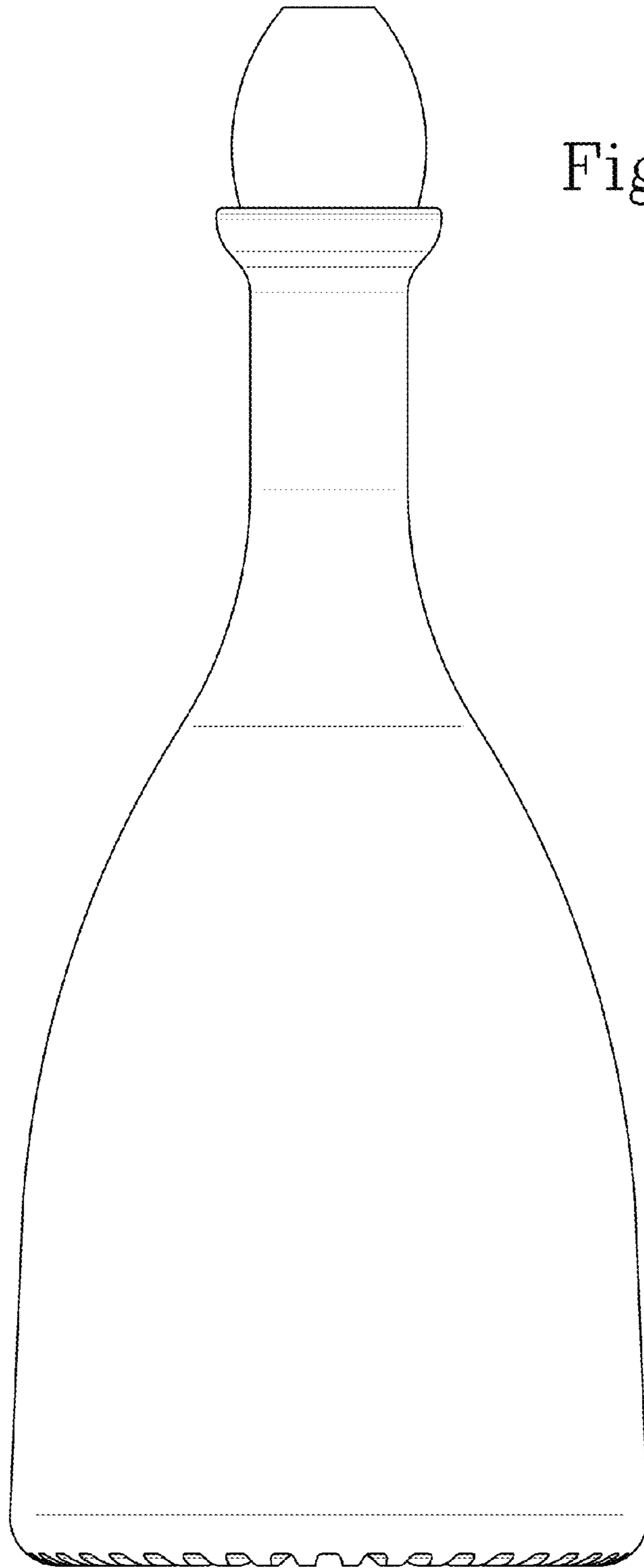

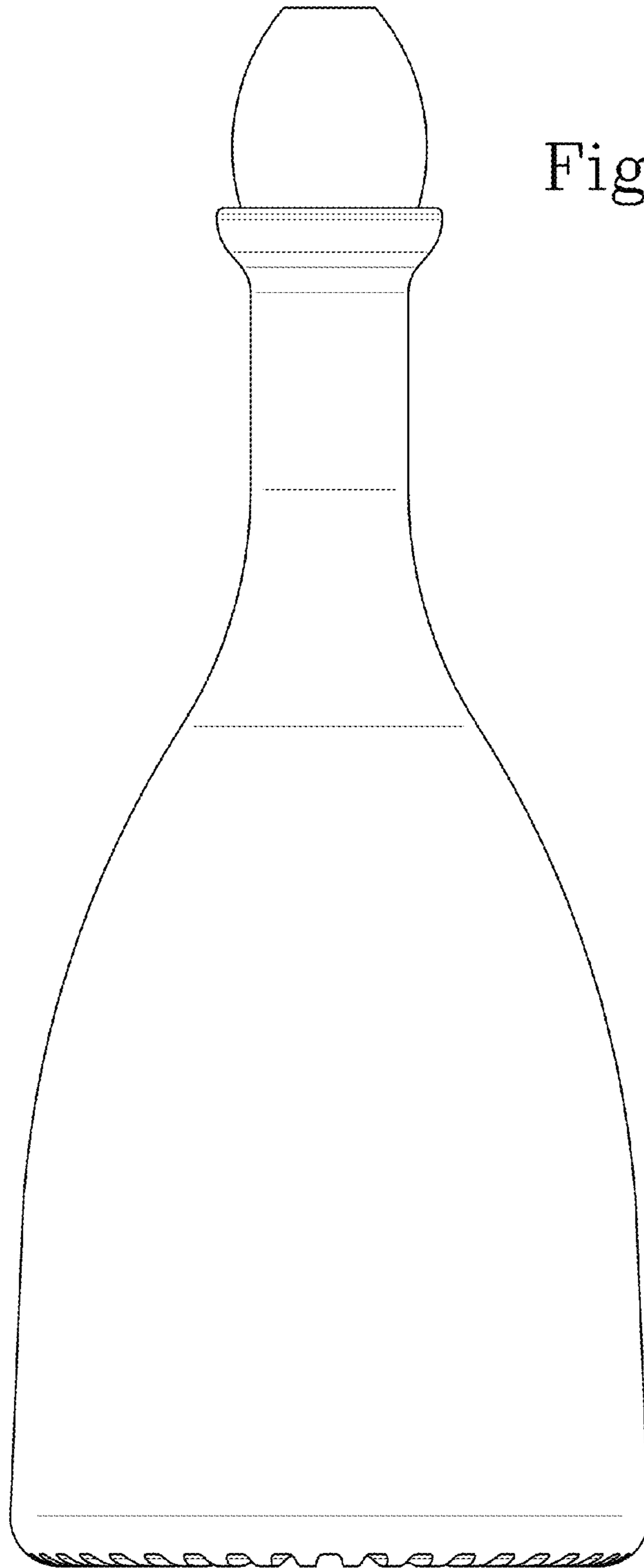

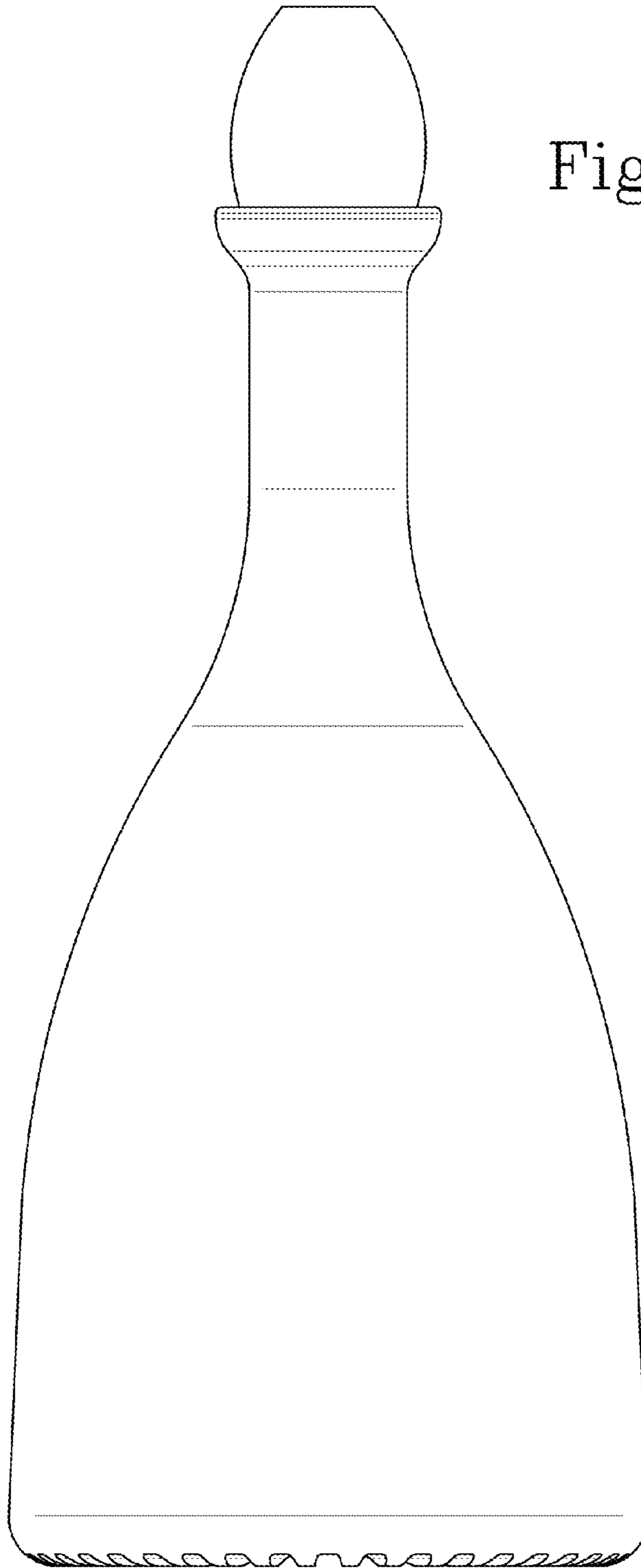

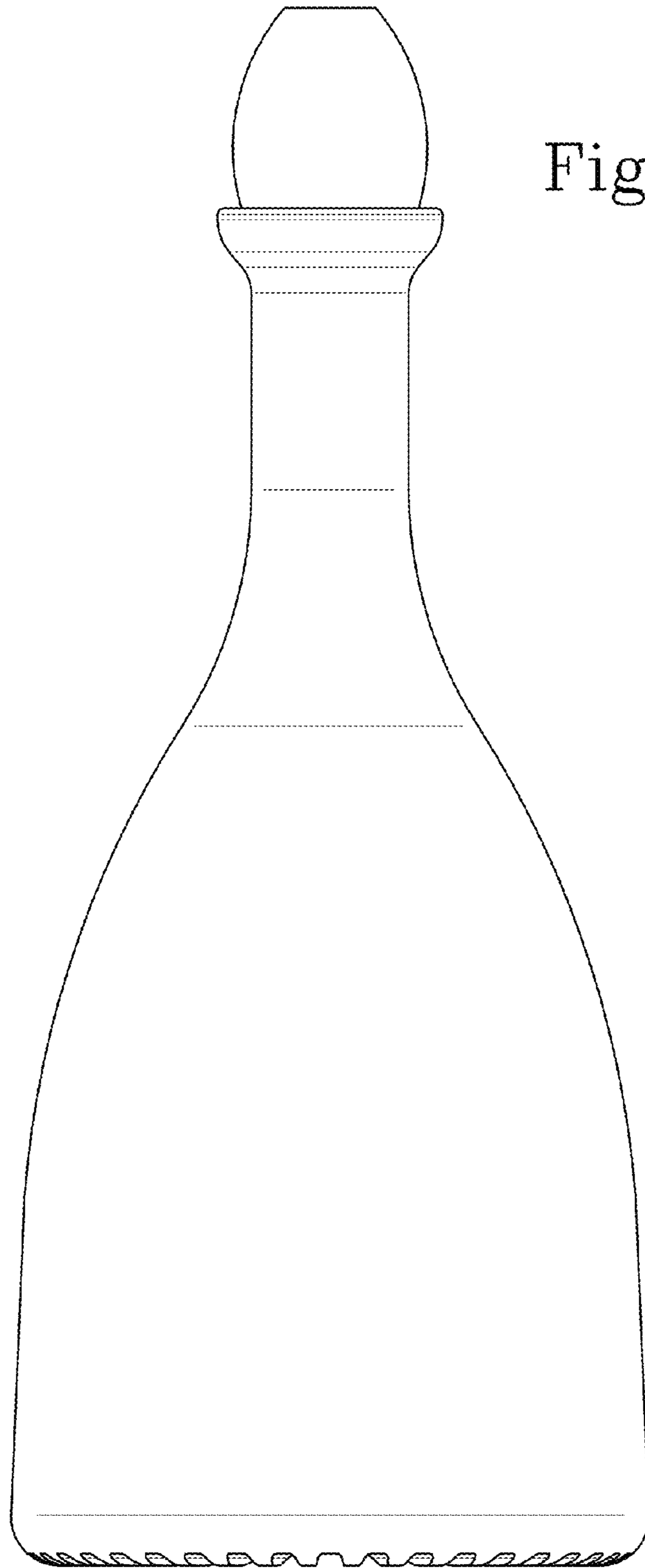

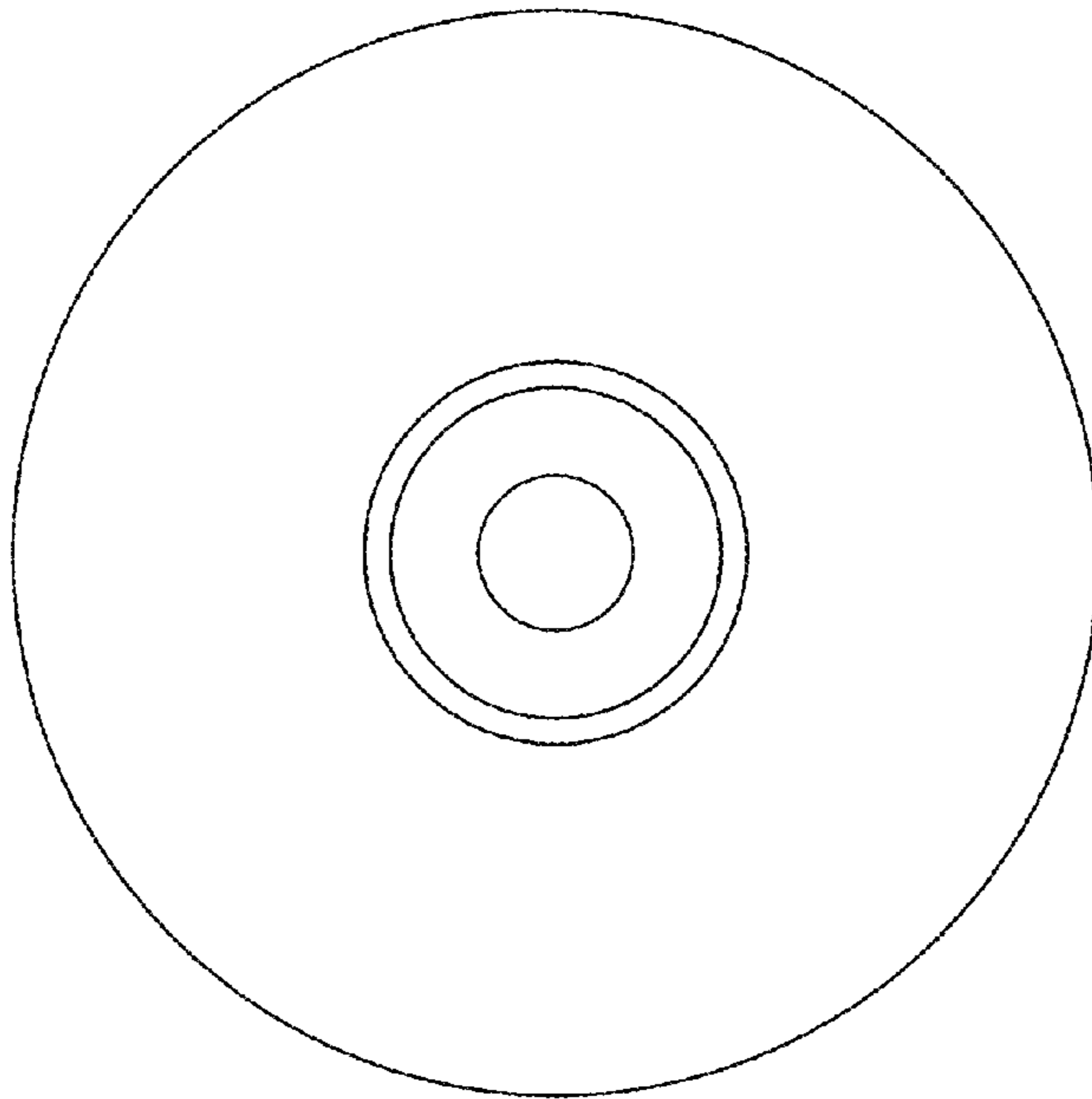
