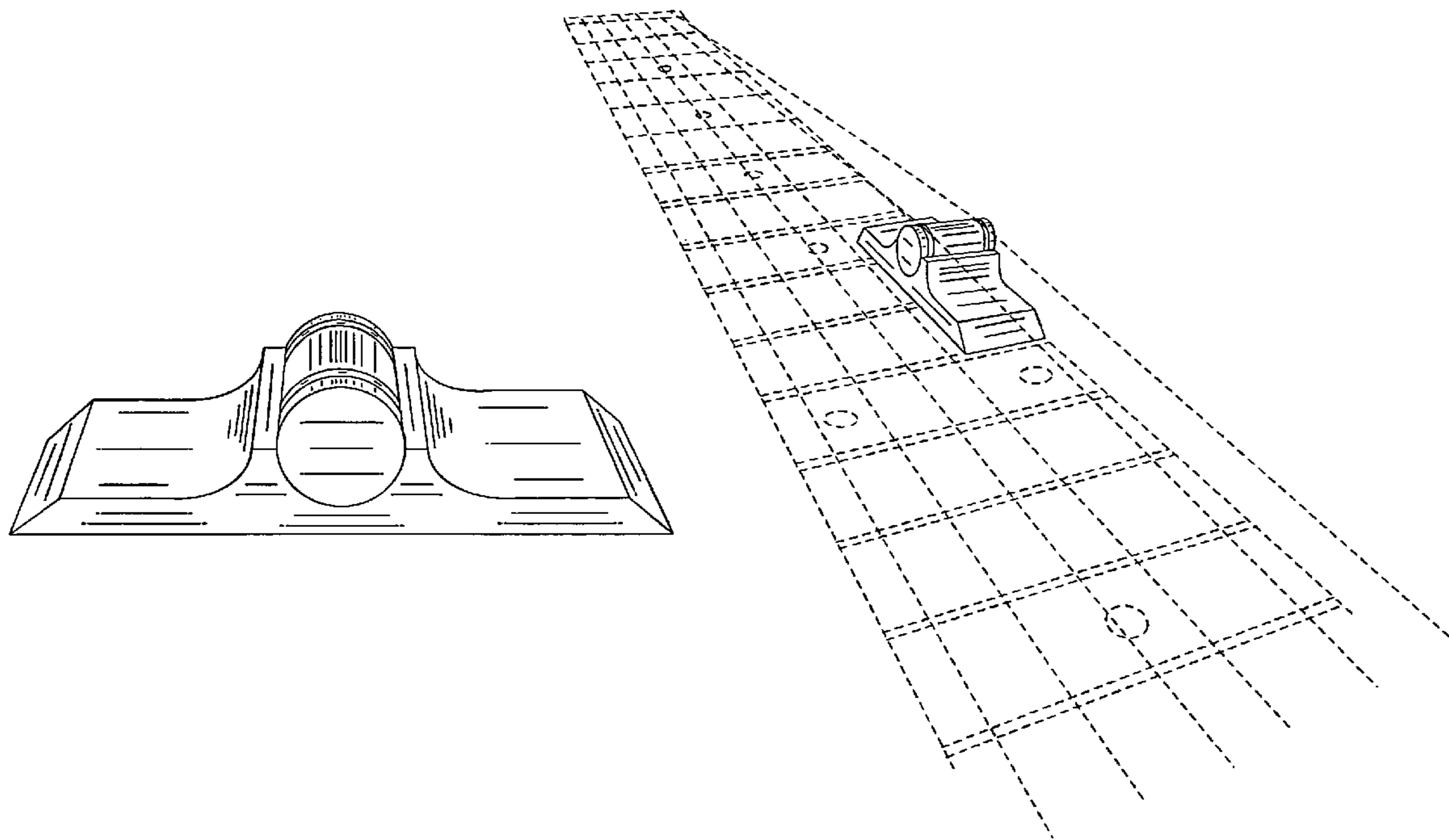
(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a string support for a guitar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a string support for a guitar showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a front view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image; and,
 FIG. 6 is a reduced perspective view of the string support shown in use.
 The broken lines showing a guitar neck in FIG. 6 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.

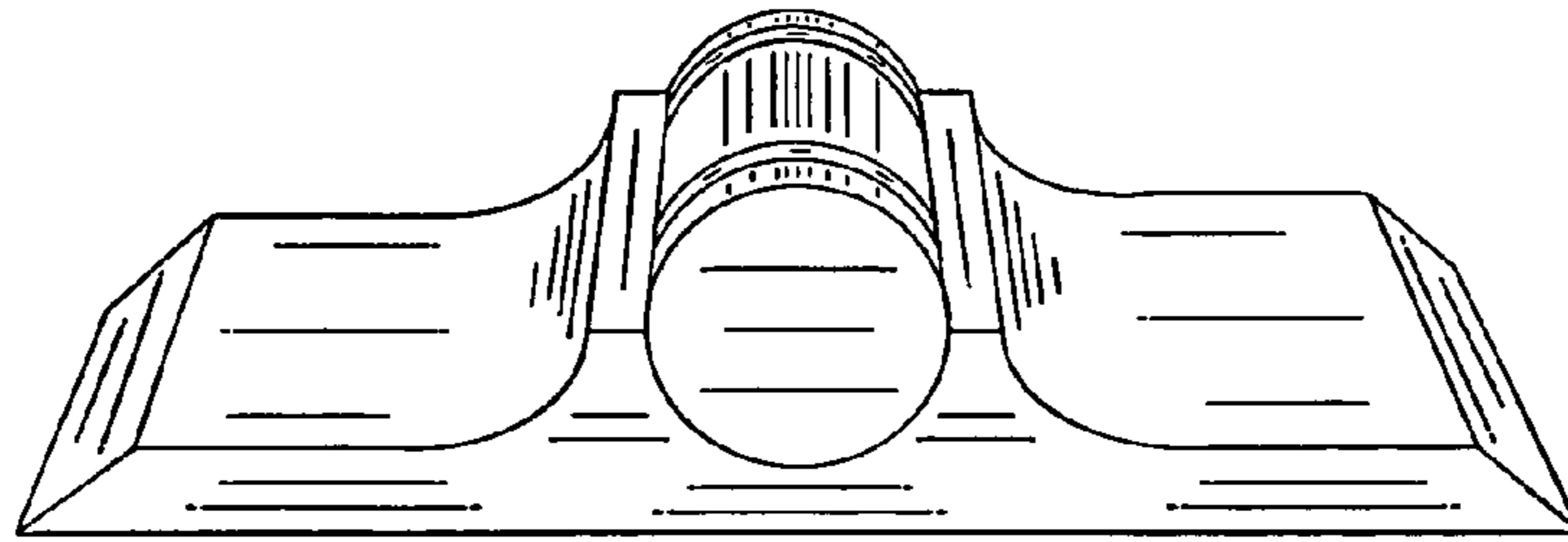

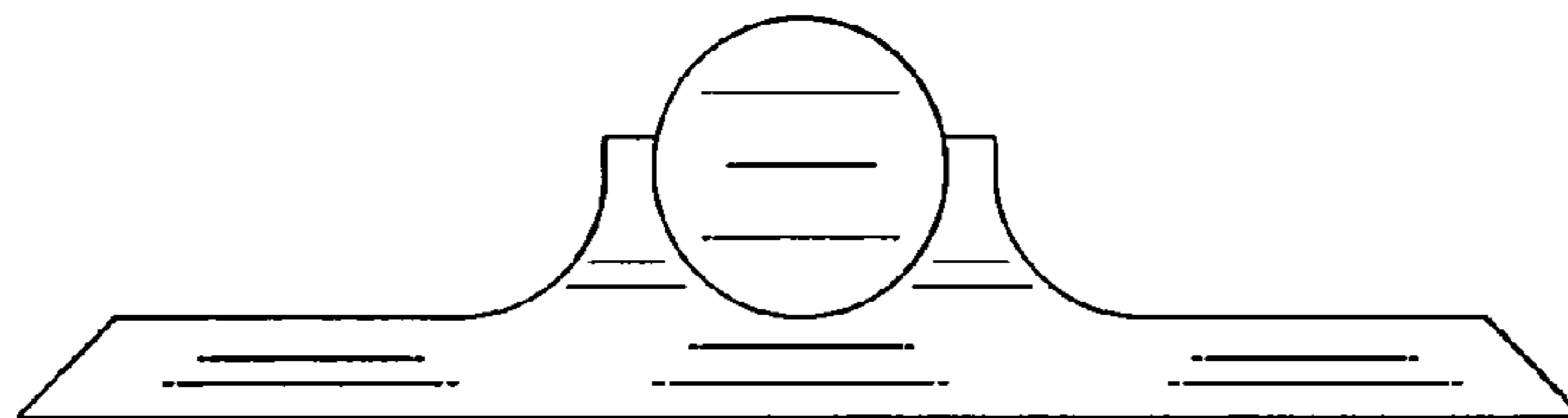

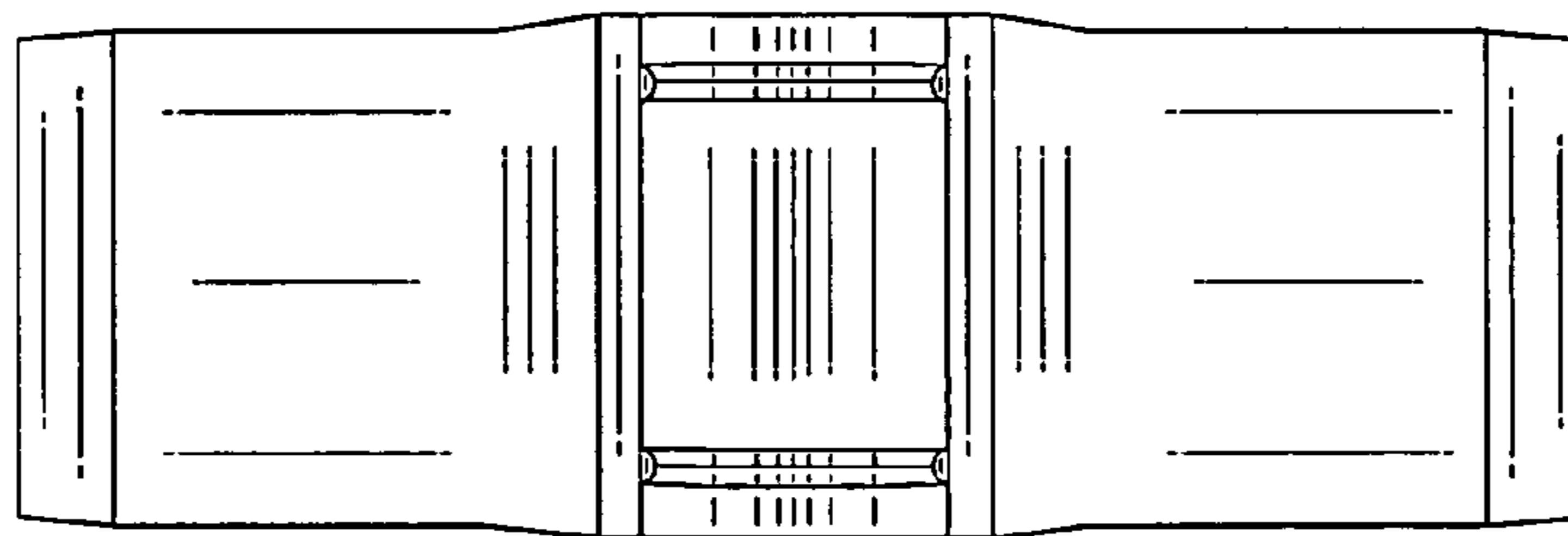

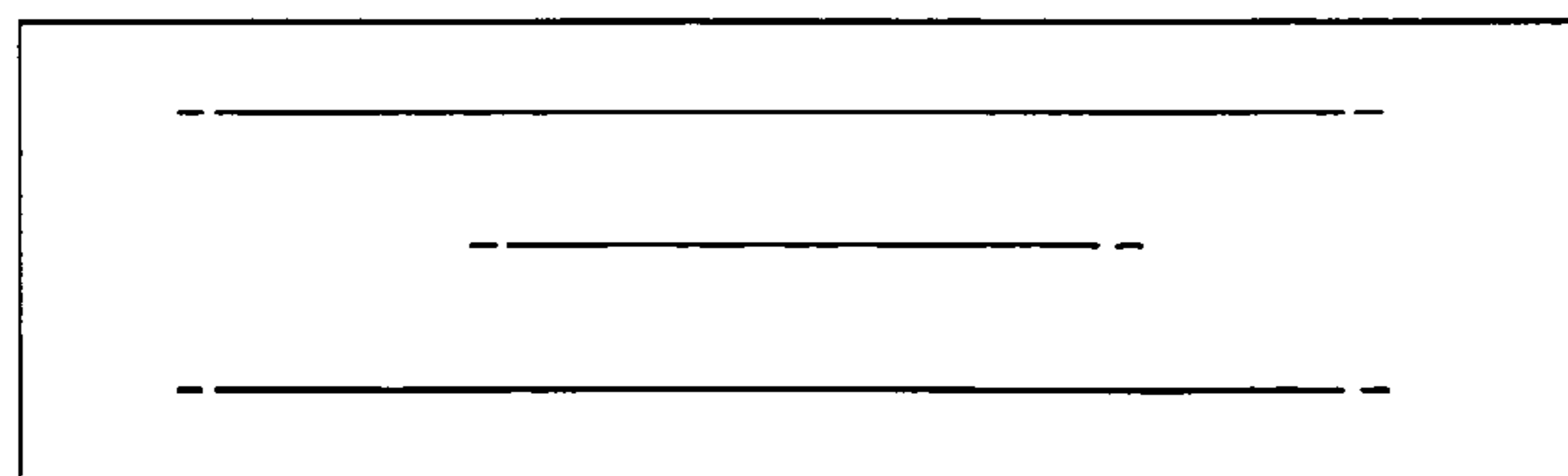

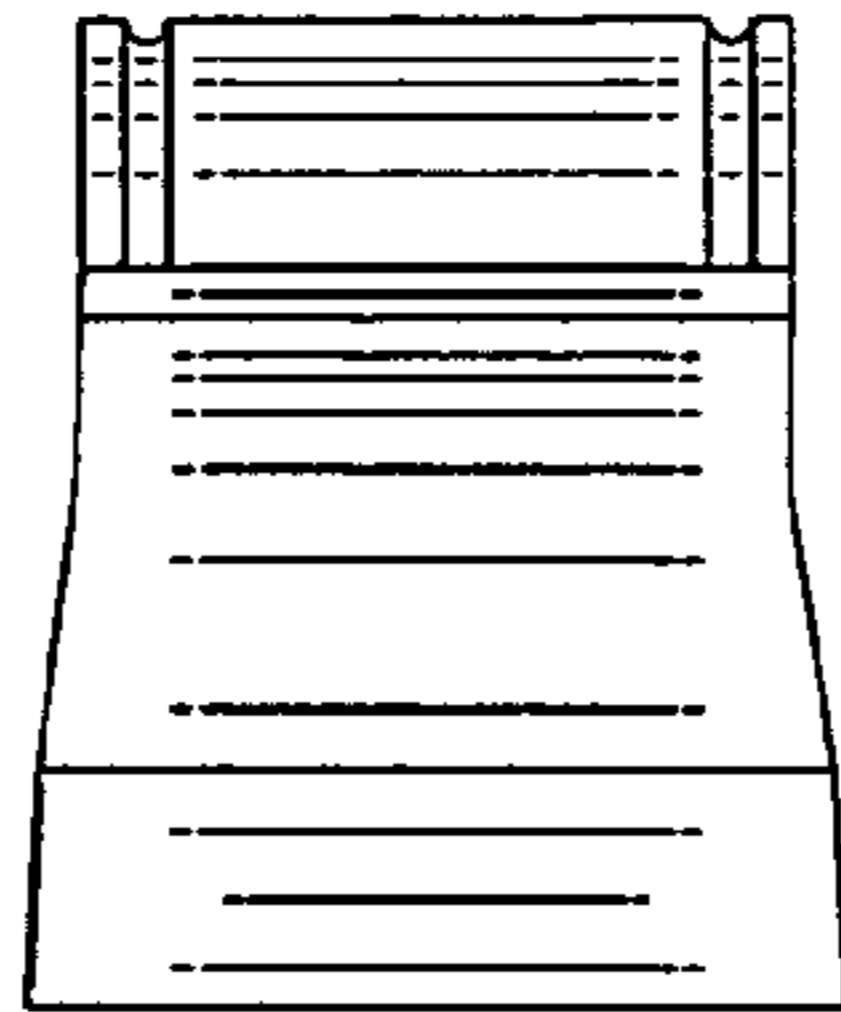

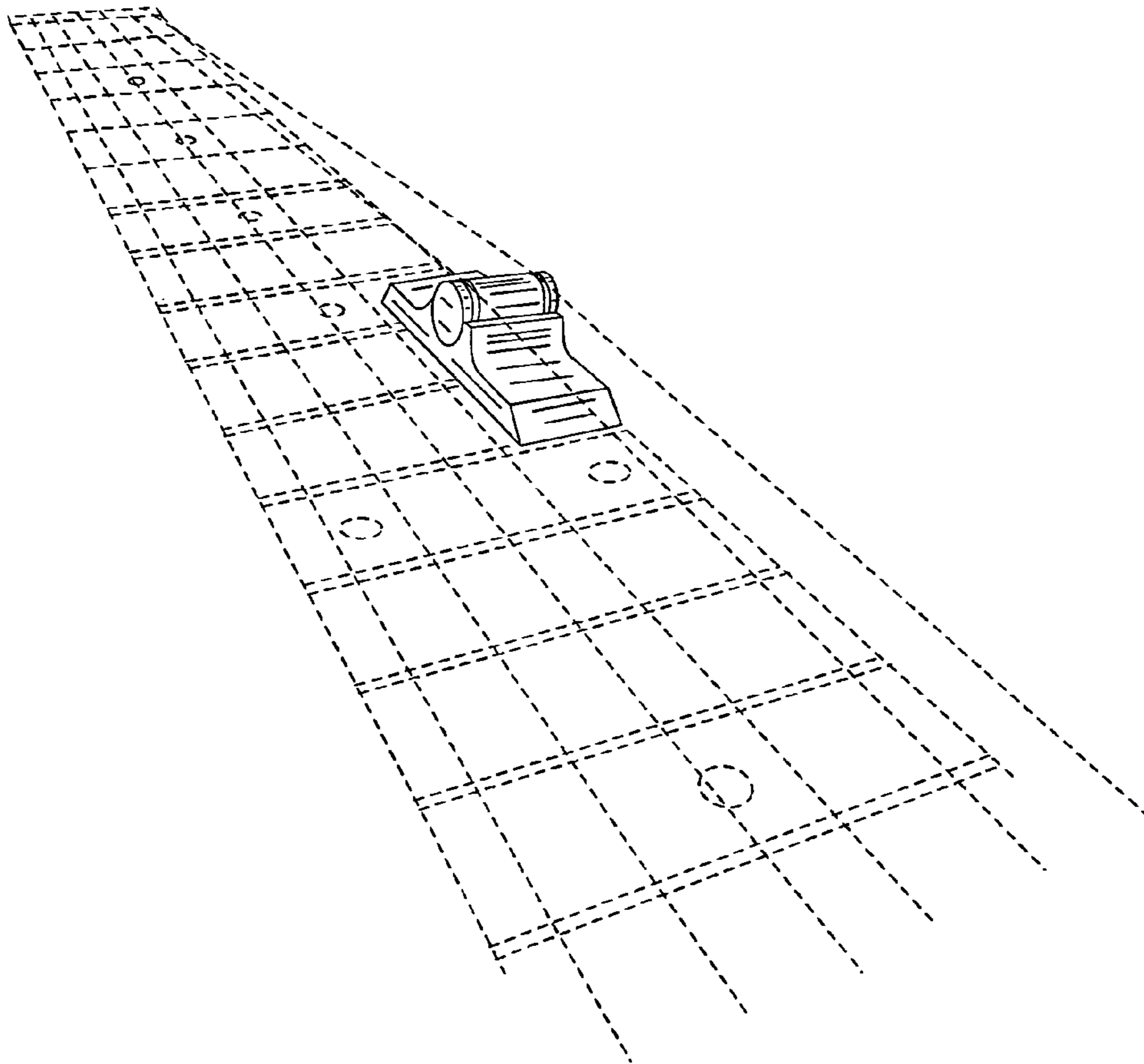
