The ornamental design for a clamp for fence panels, as described and shown in the figures.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a clamp for fence panels according to the invention.

FIG. 2 is a left side view of a clamp for fence panels according to the invention.

FIG. 3 is a right side view of a clamp for fence panels according to the invention.

FIG. 4 is a front view of a clamp for fence panels according to the invention.

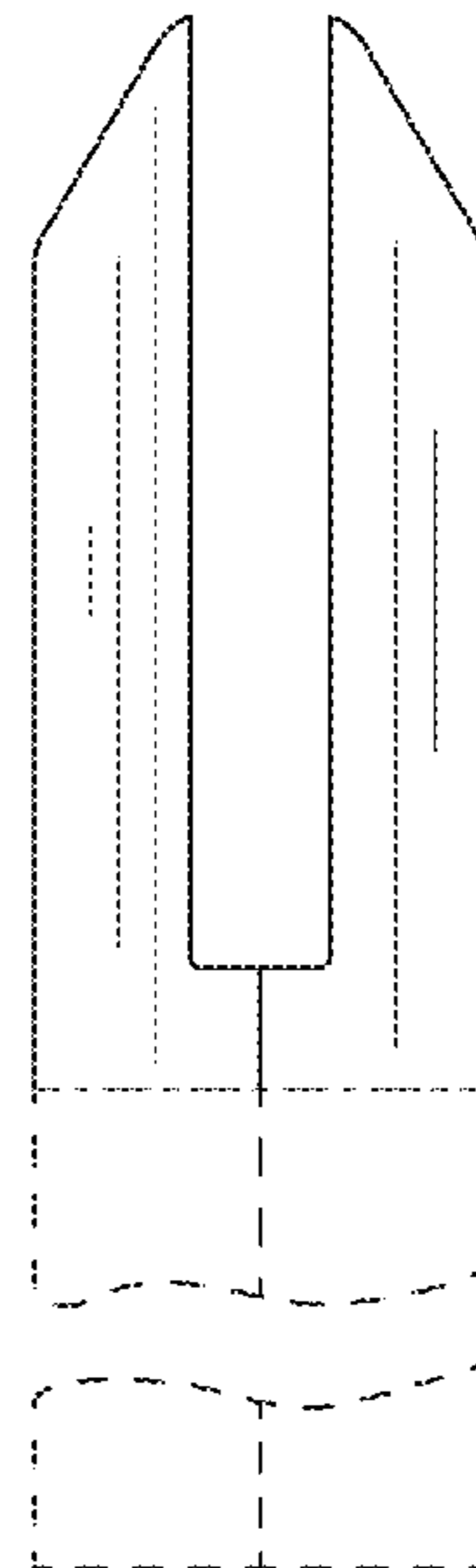
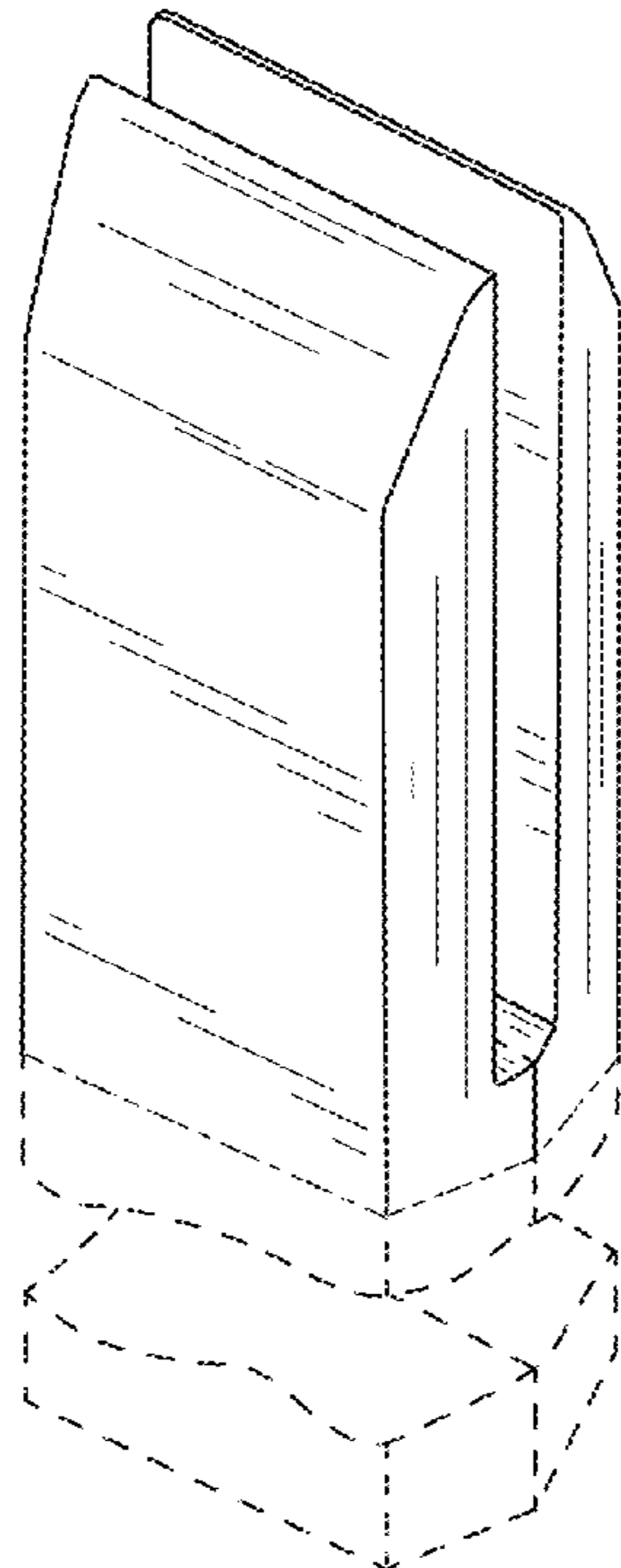
FIG. 5 is a rear view of a clamp for fence panels according to the invention.

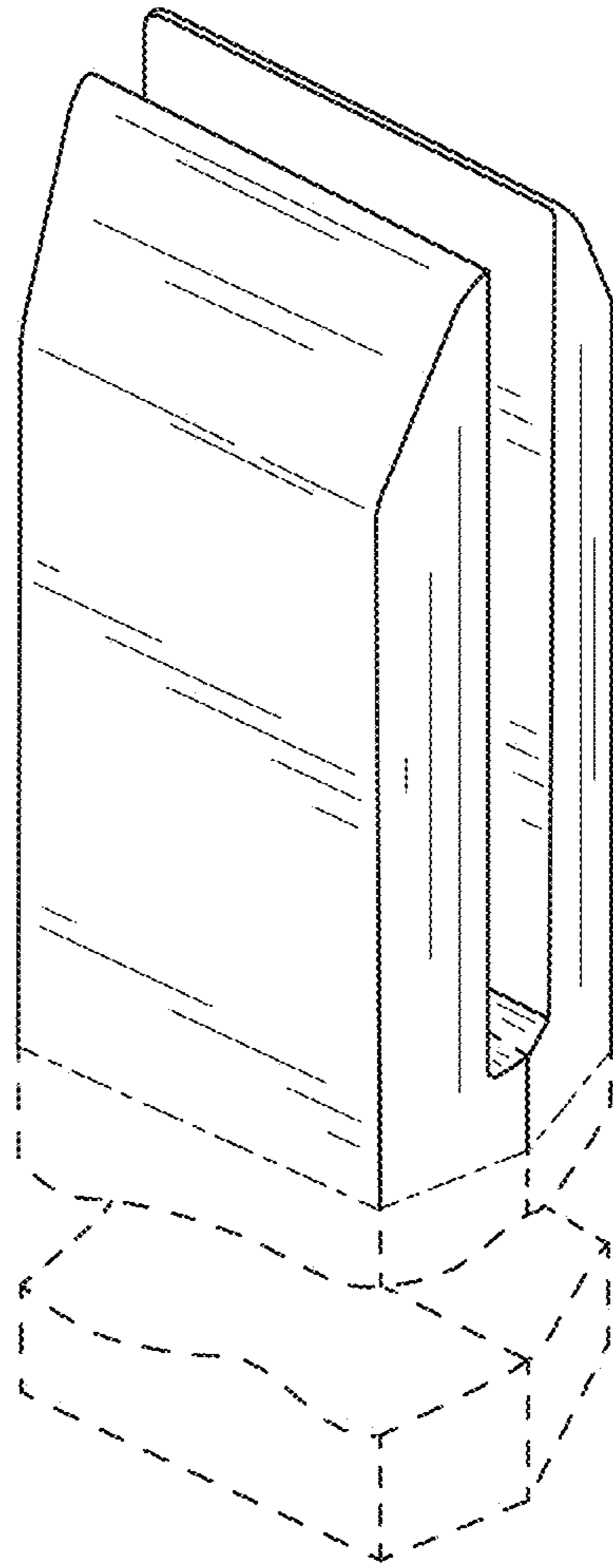

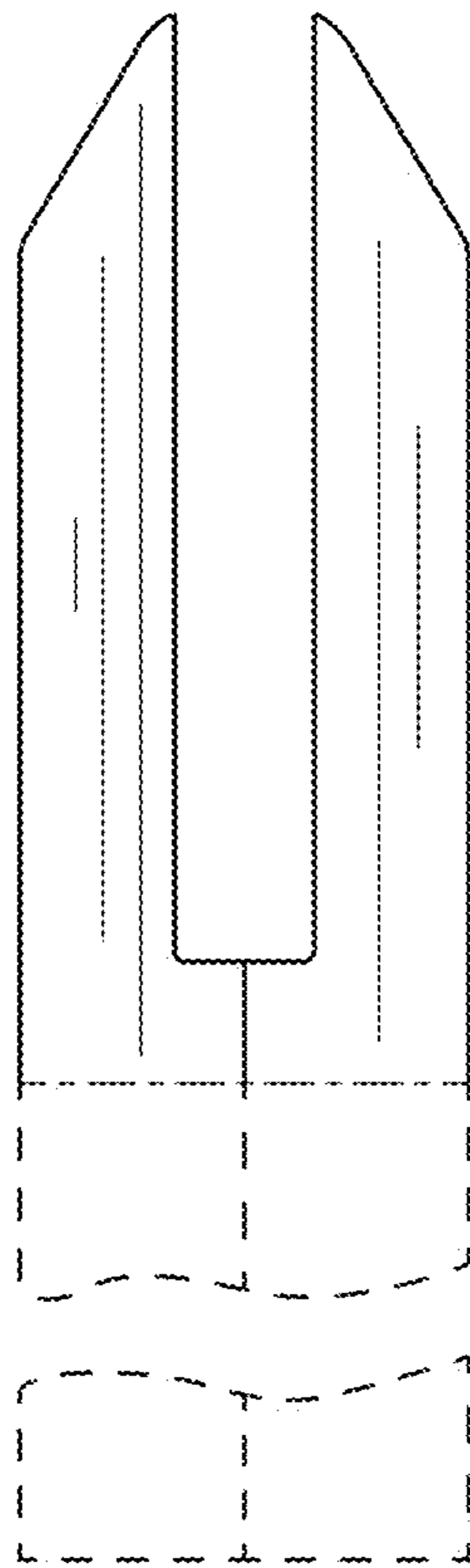

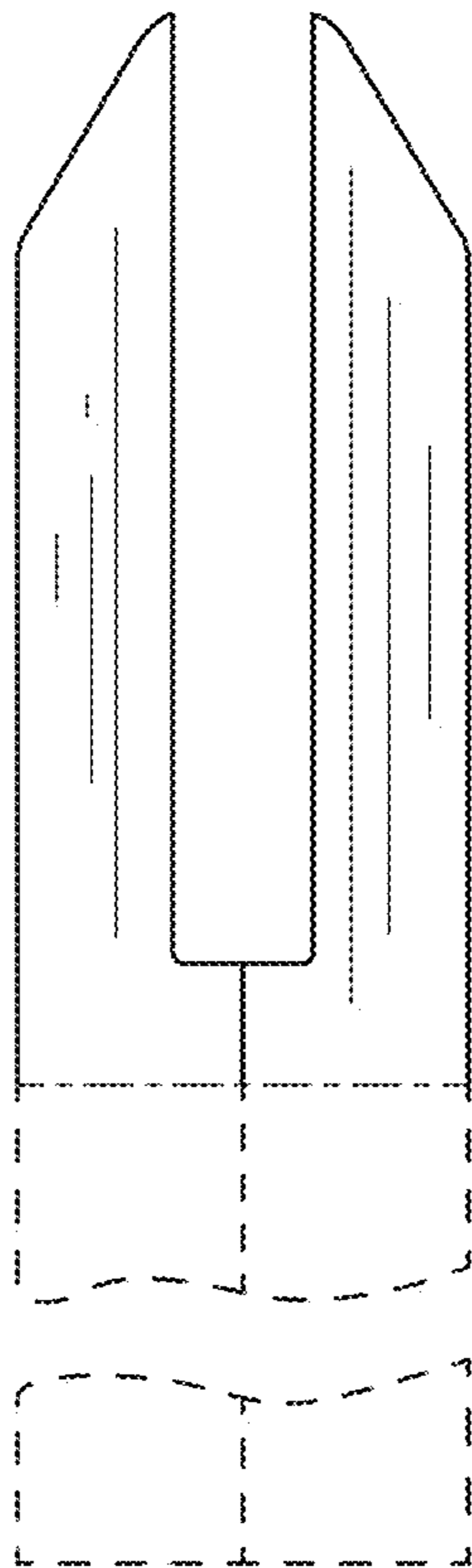

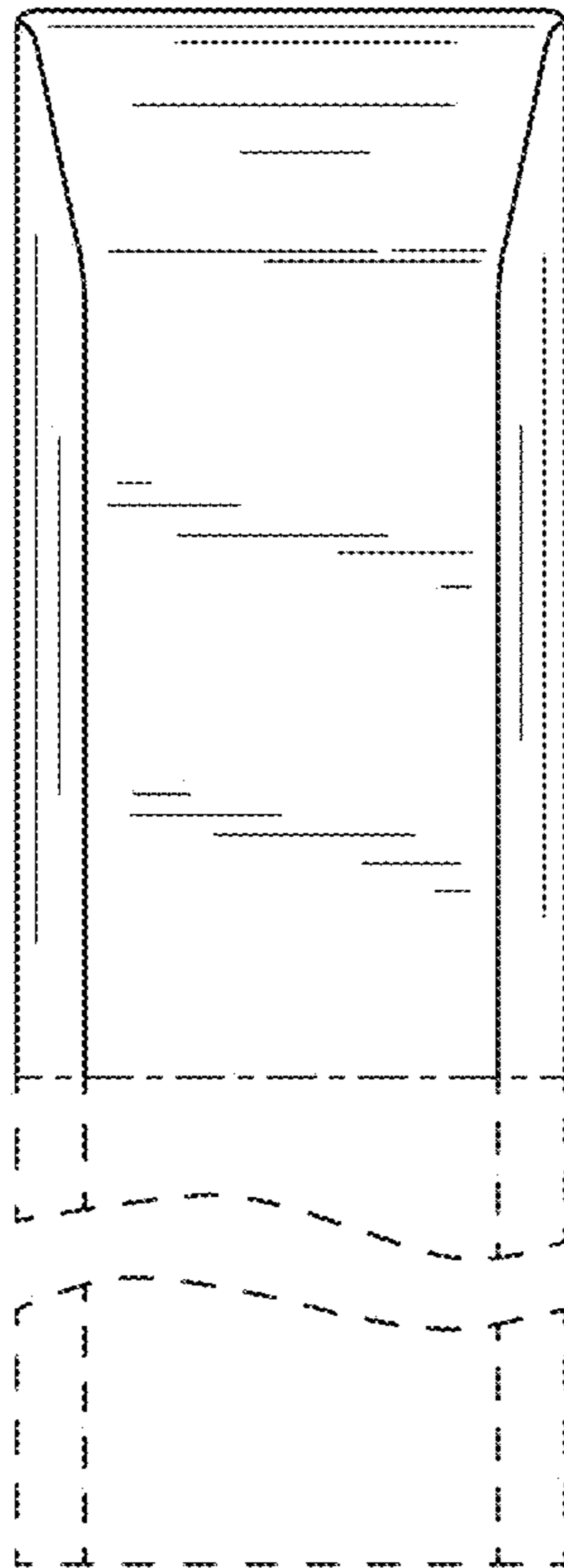

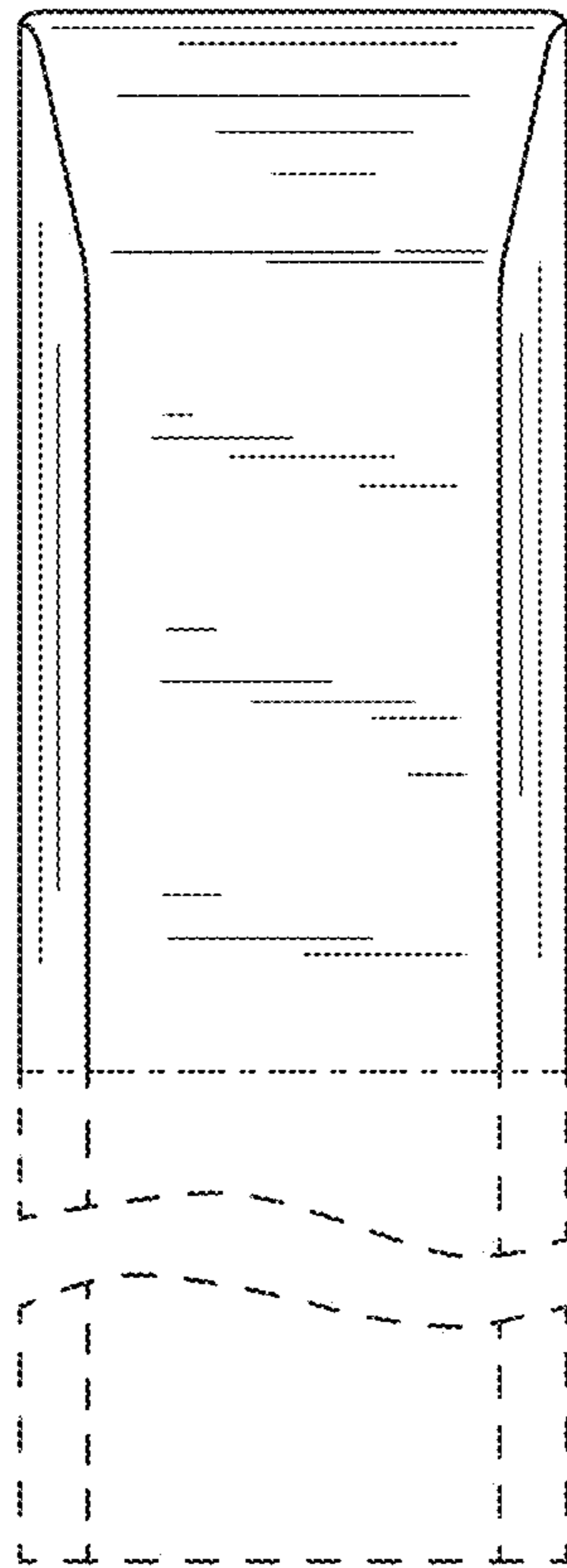

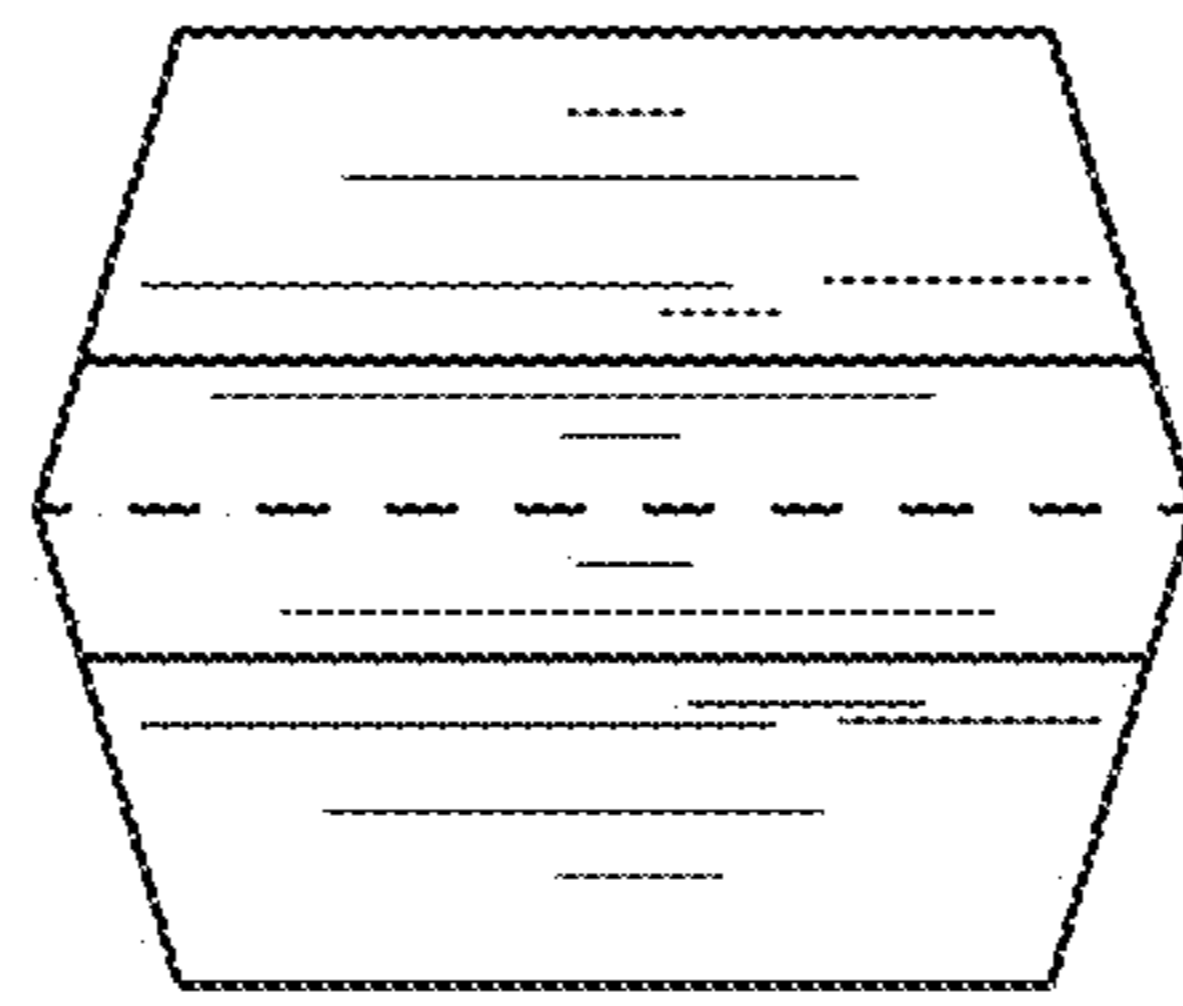

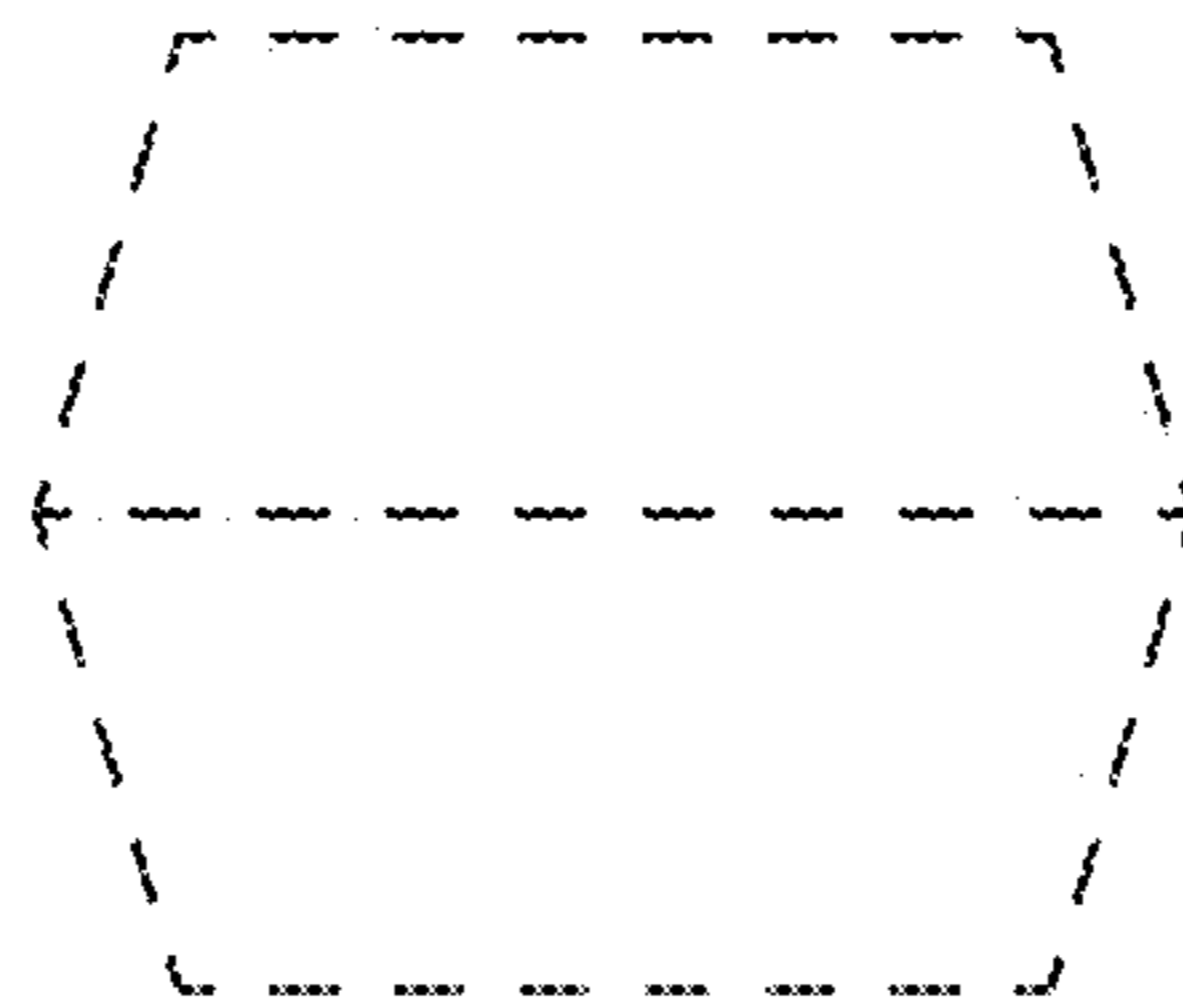
