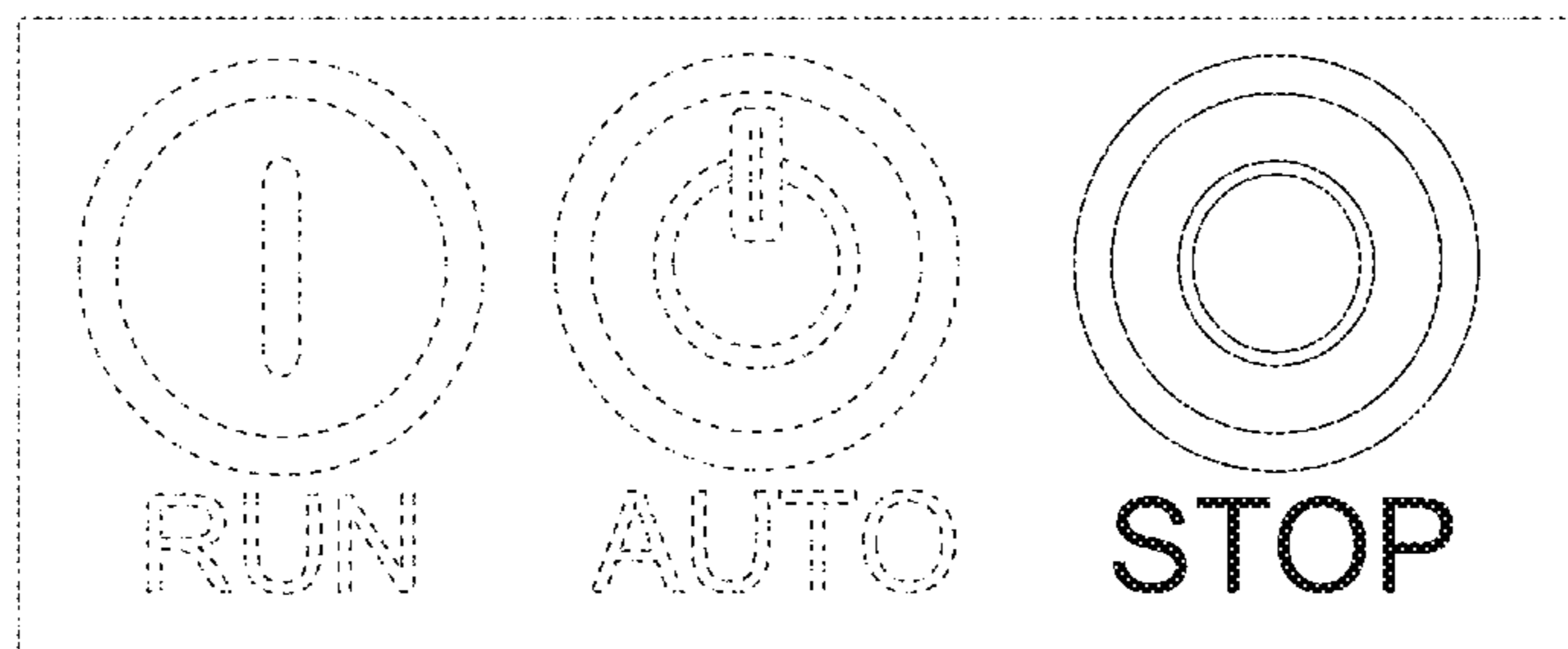
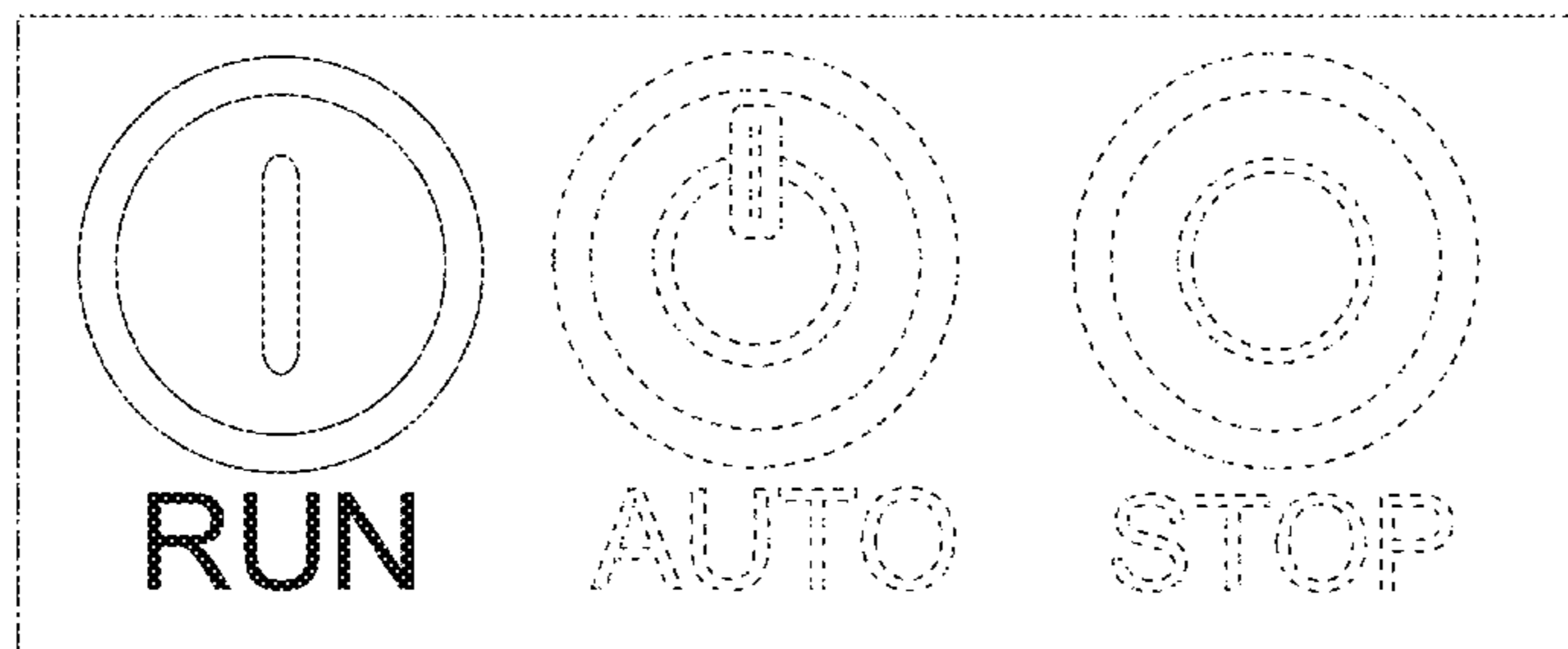
FIG. 1 is a front view of a first image of a portion of a display screen with an animated computer generated icon showing our new design;

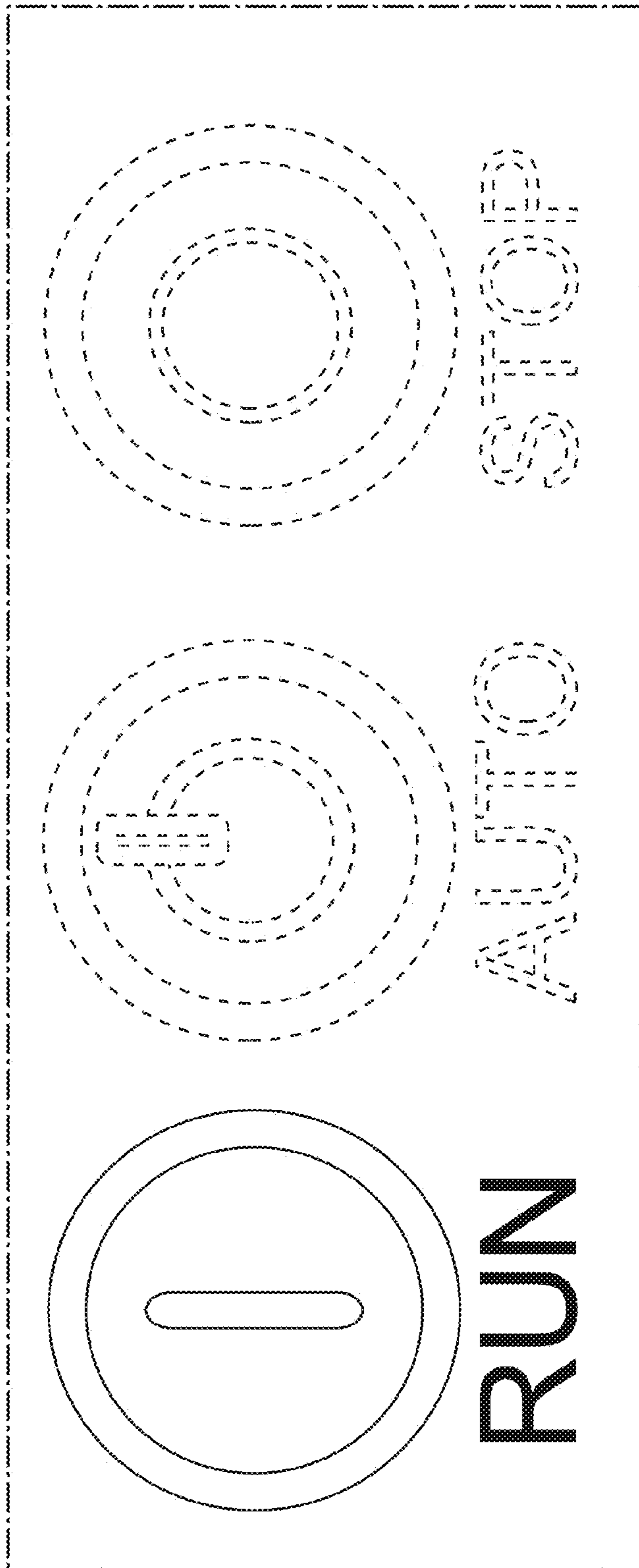

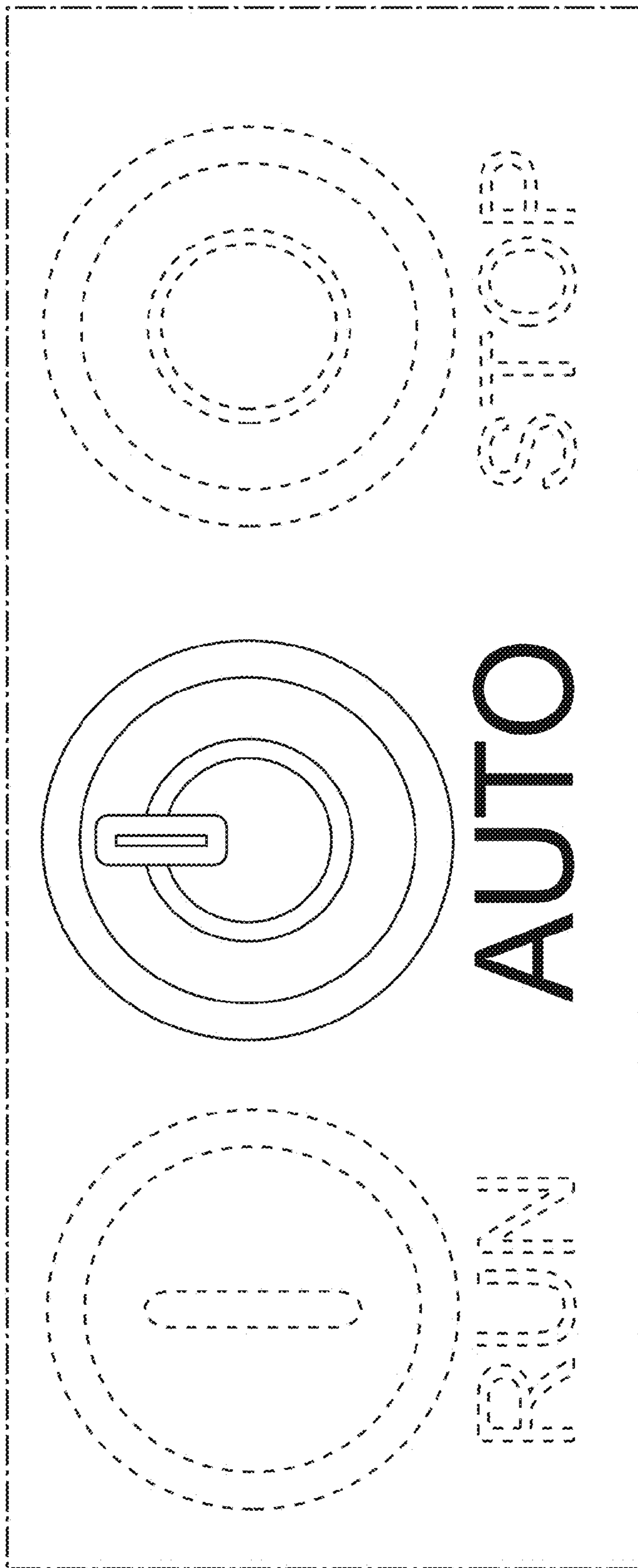

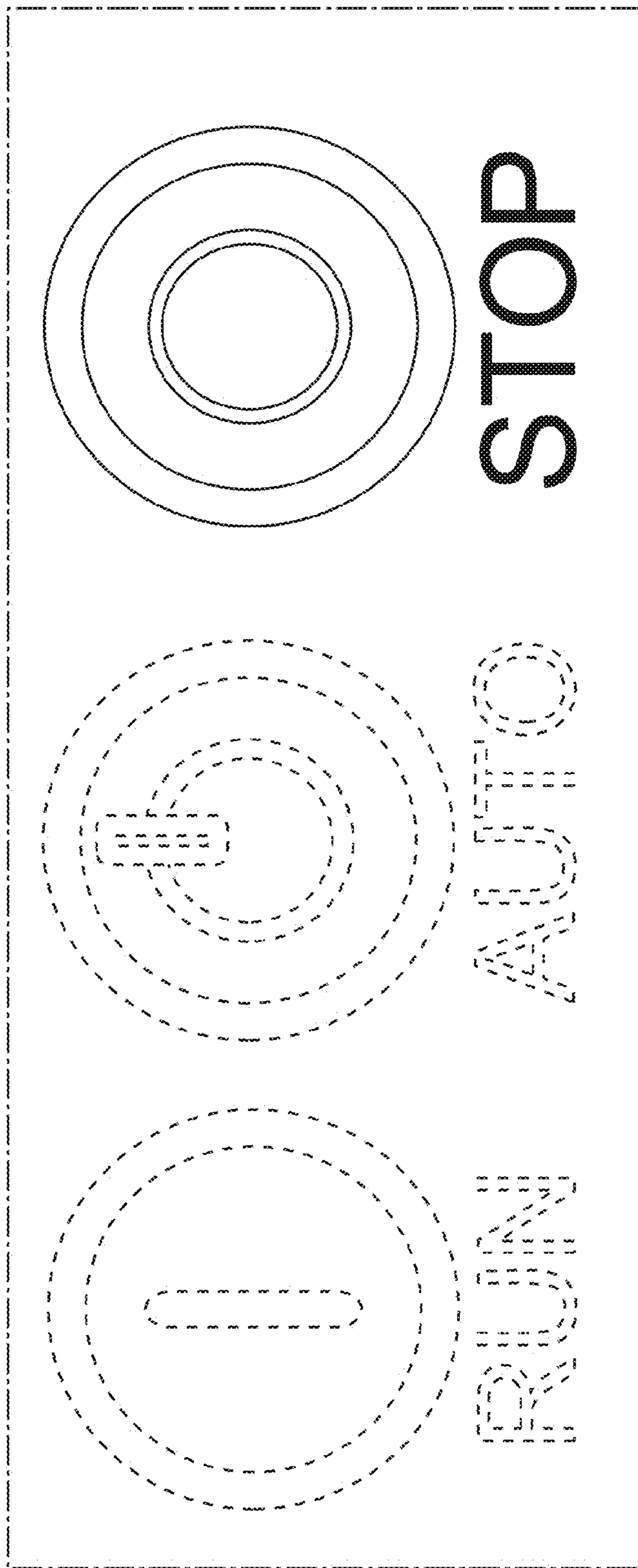
