FIG. 7 is an enlarged partial view of FIG. 1.

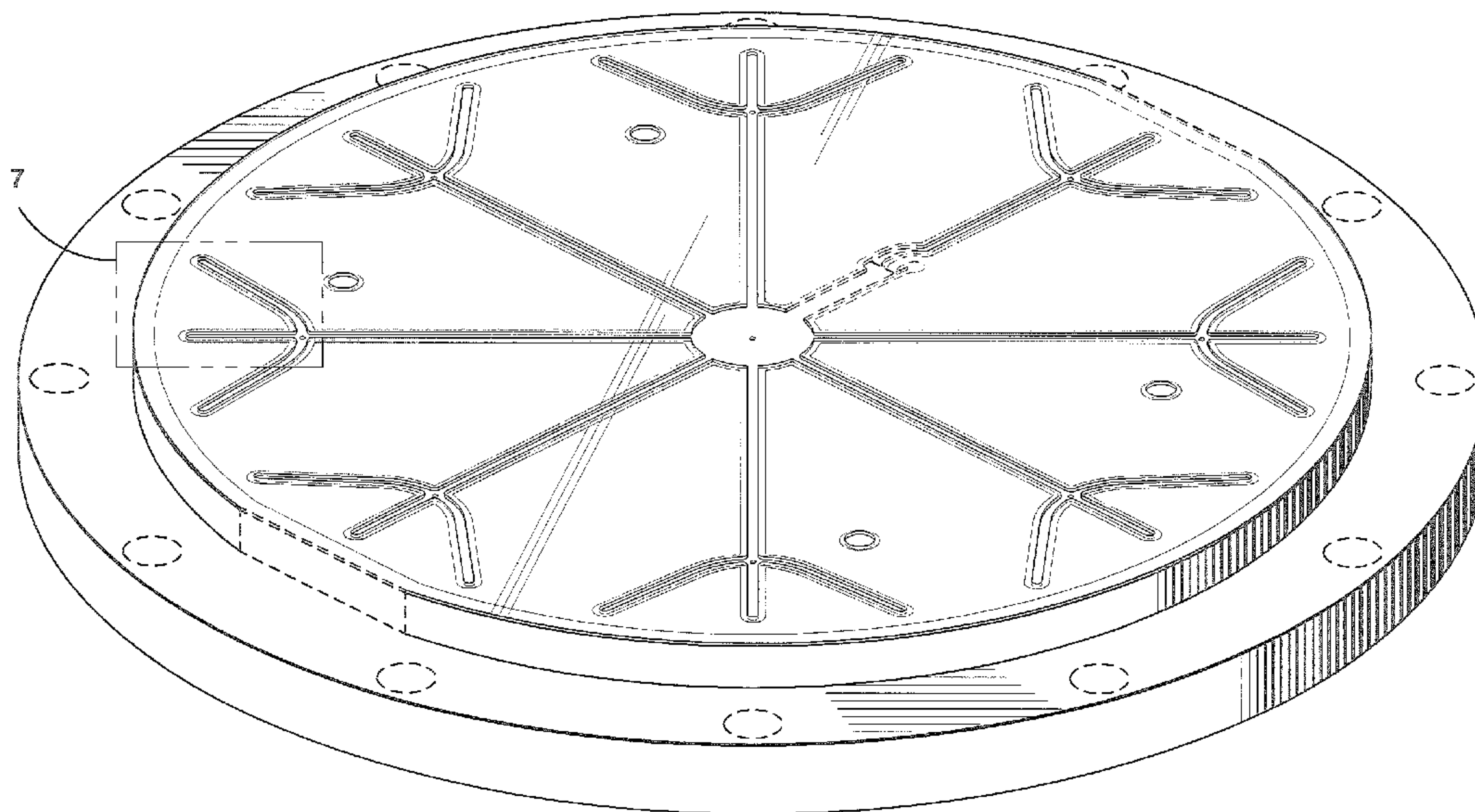
FIG. 8 is a color photograph illustrating the electrostatic chuck of FIG. 2 from a top view; and,

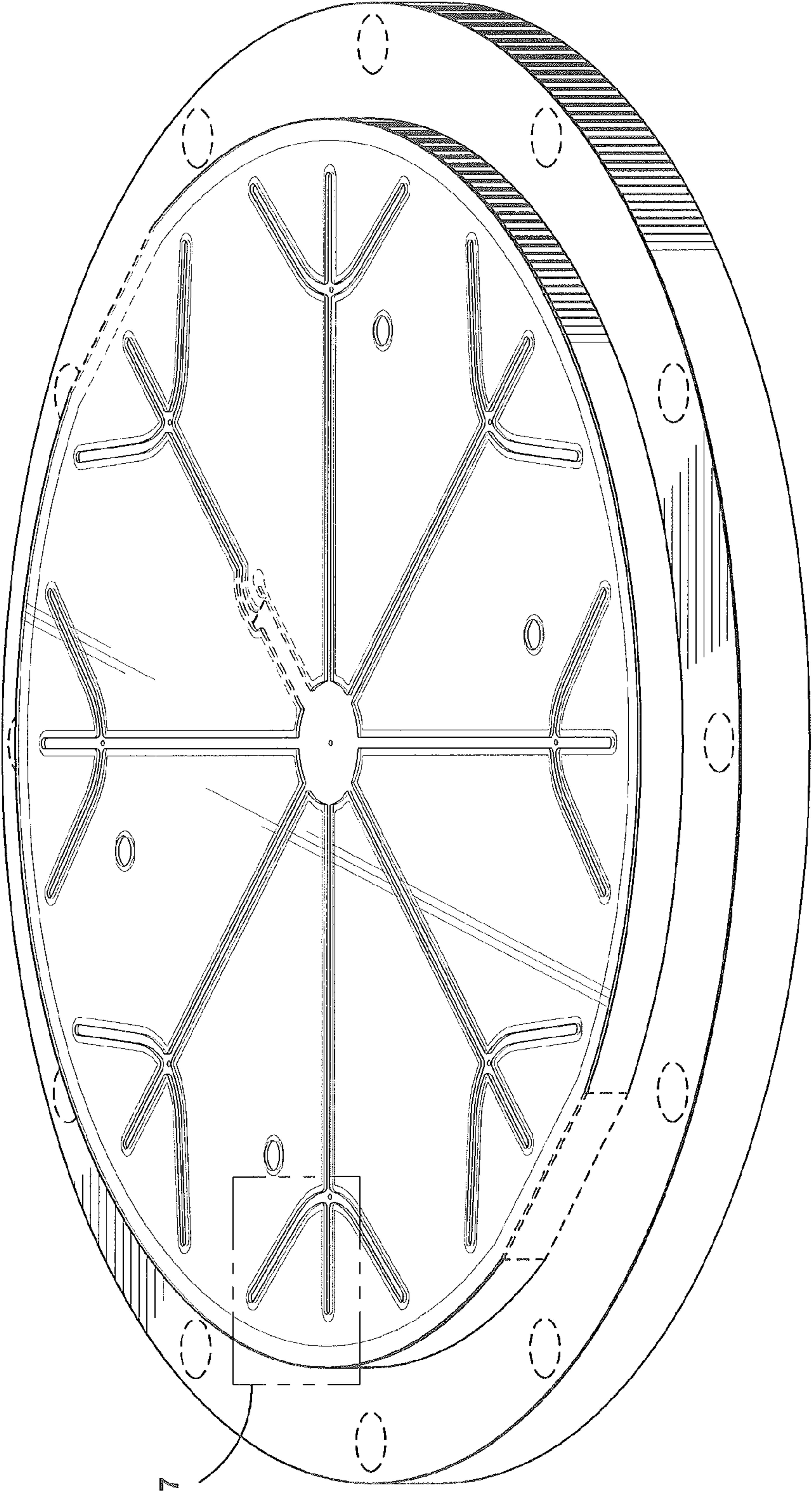

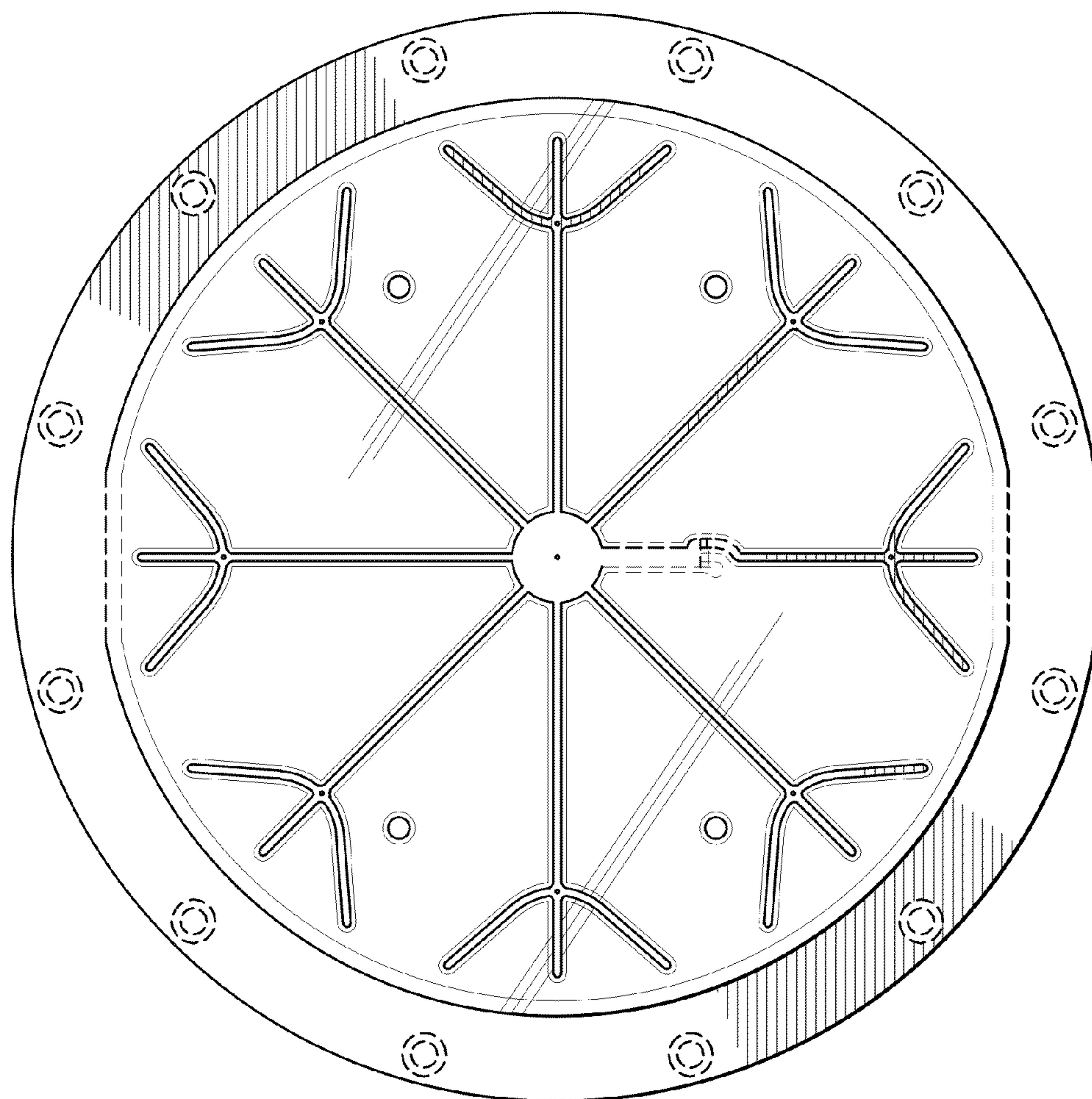

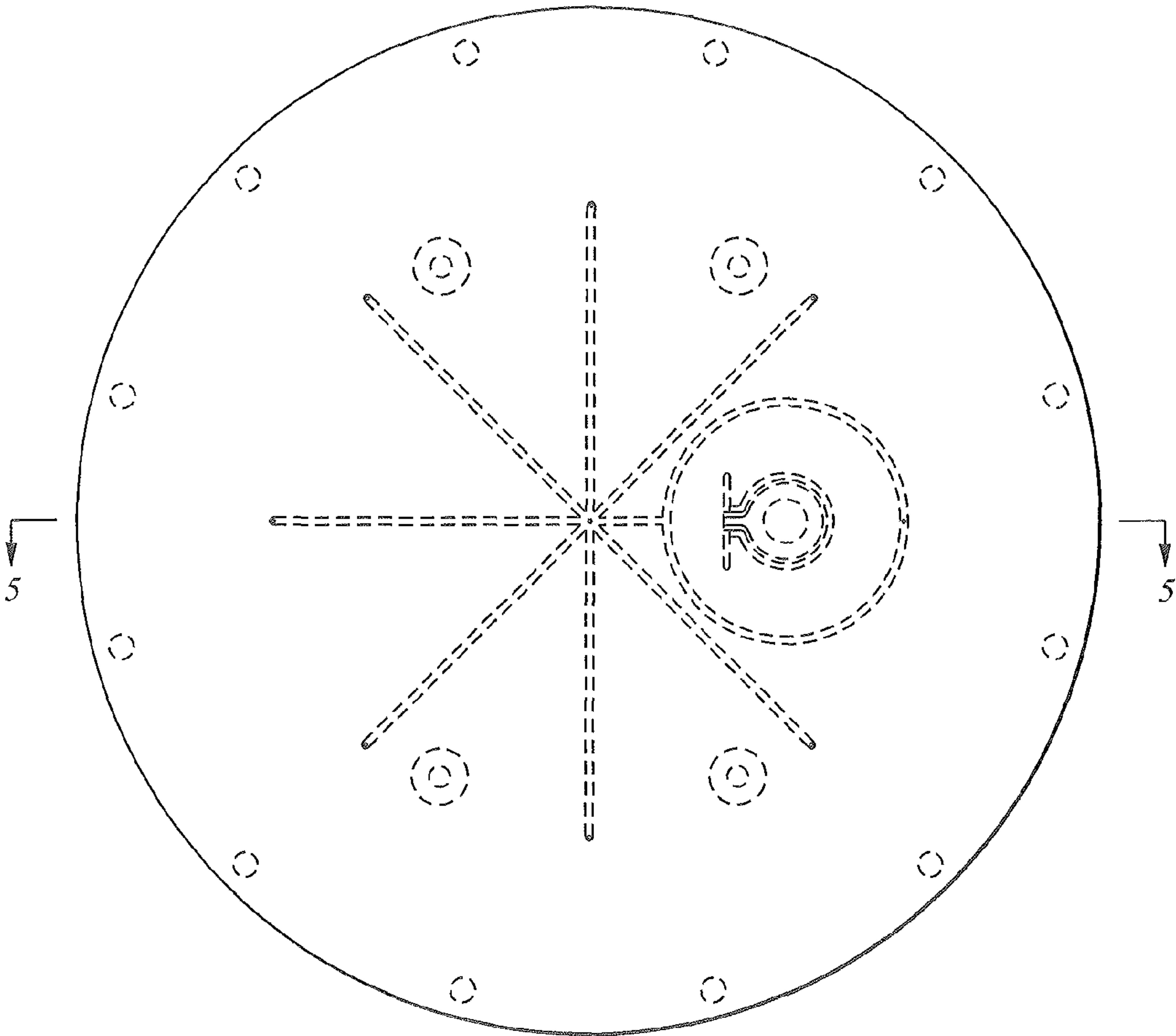

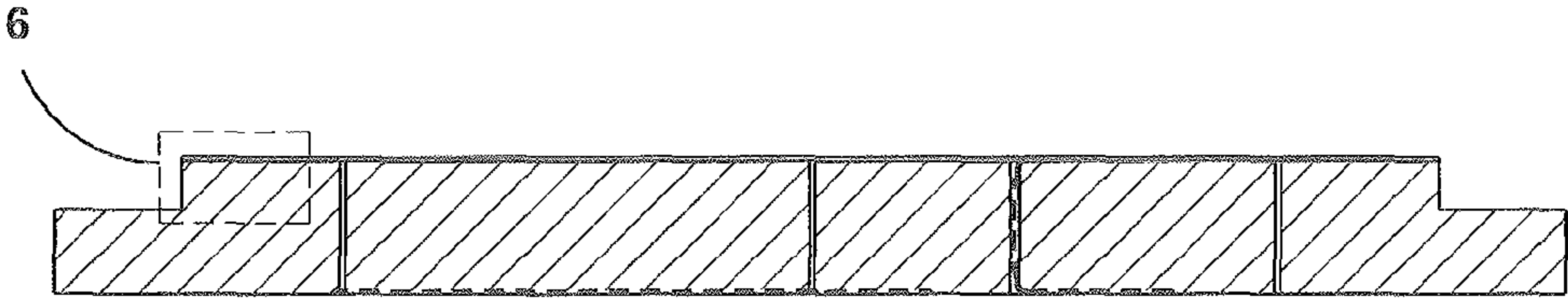

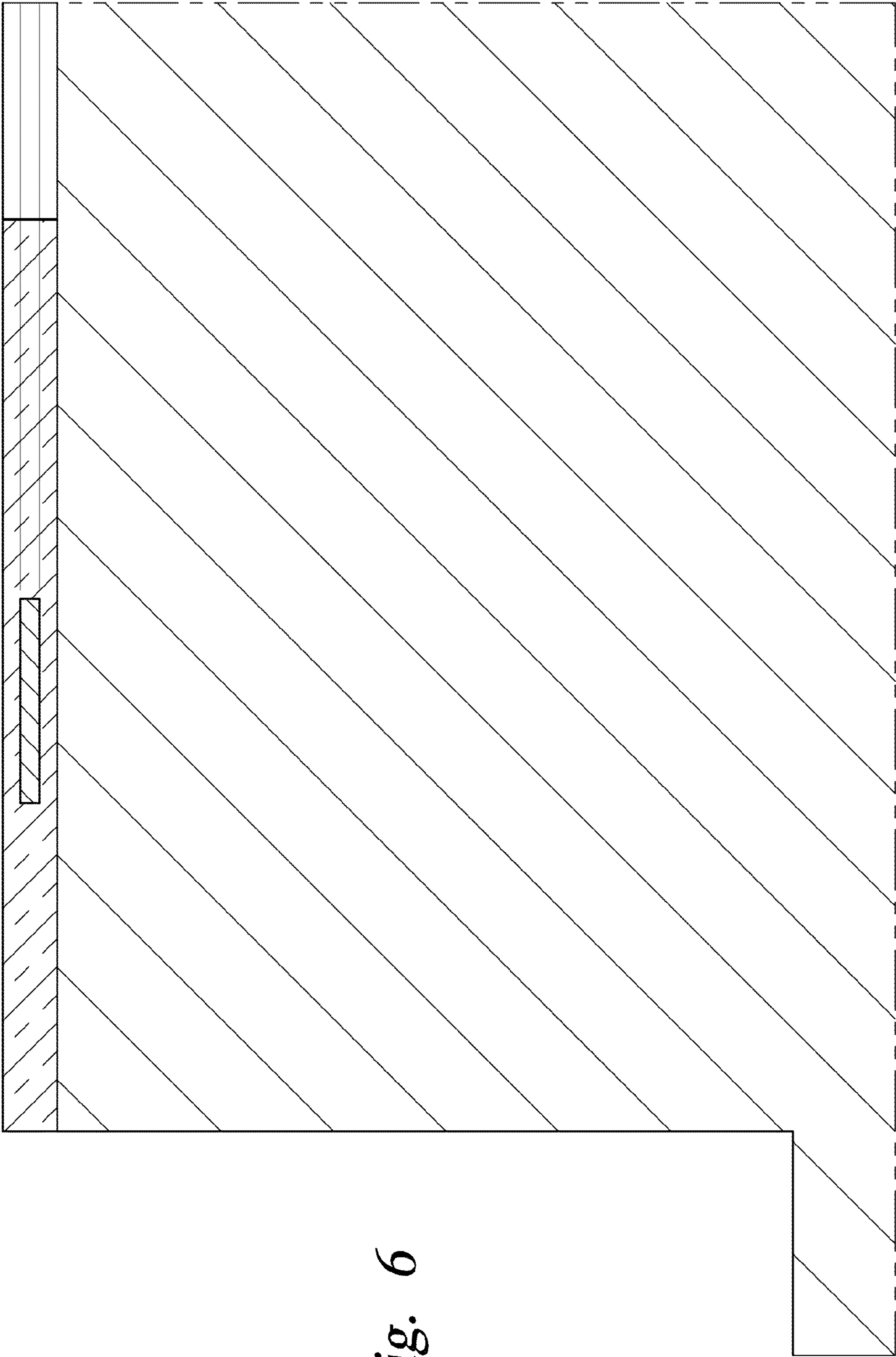

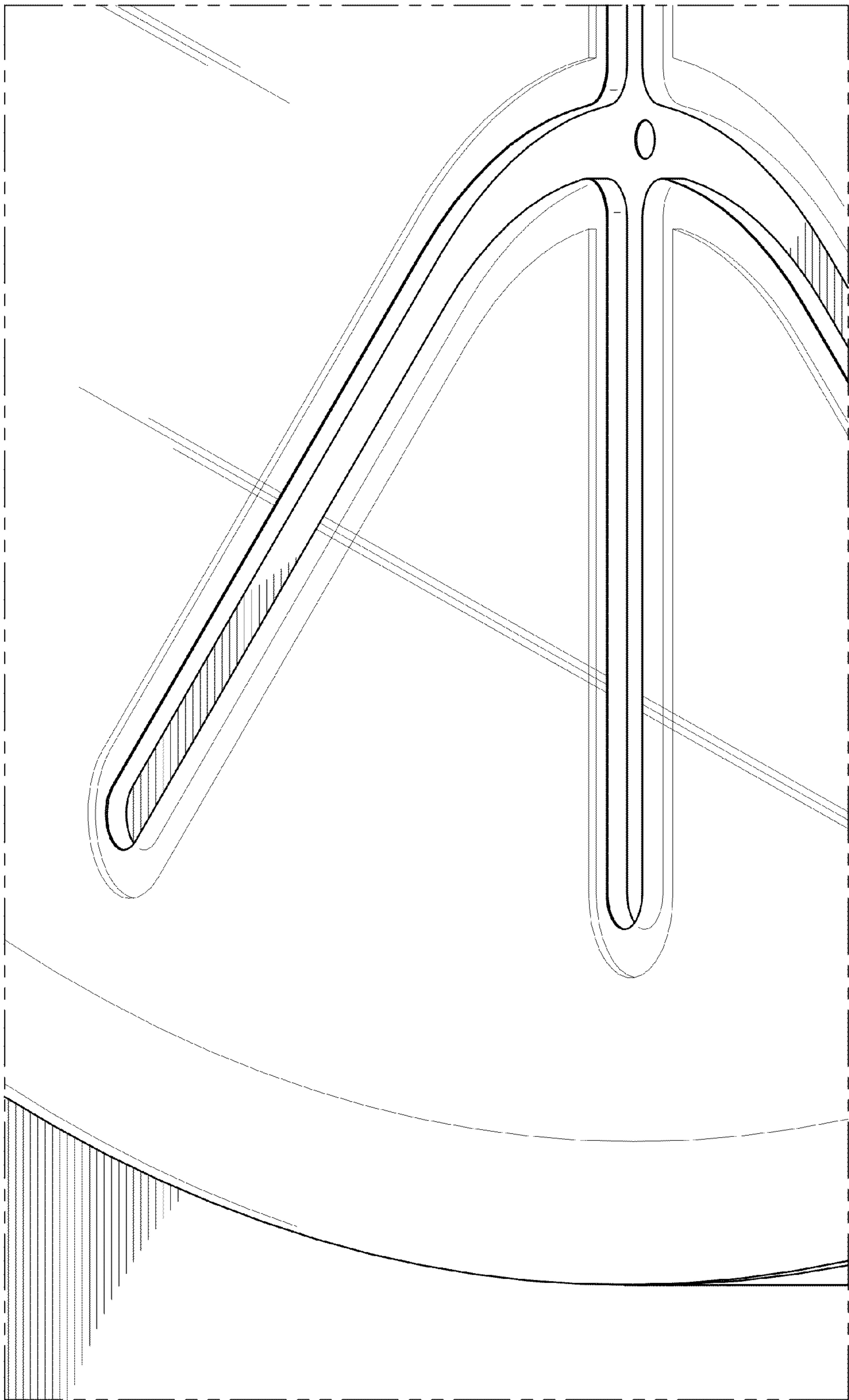

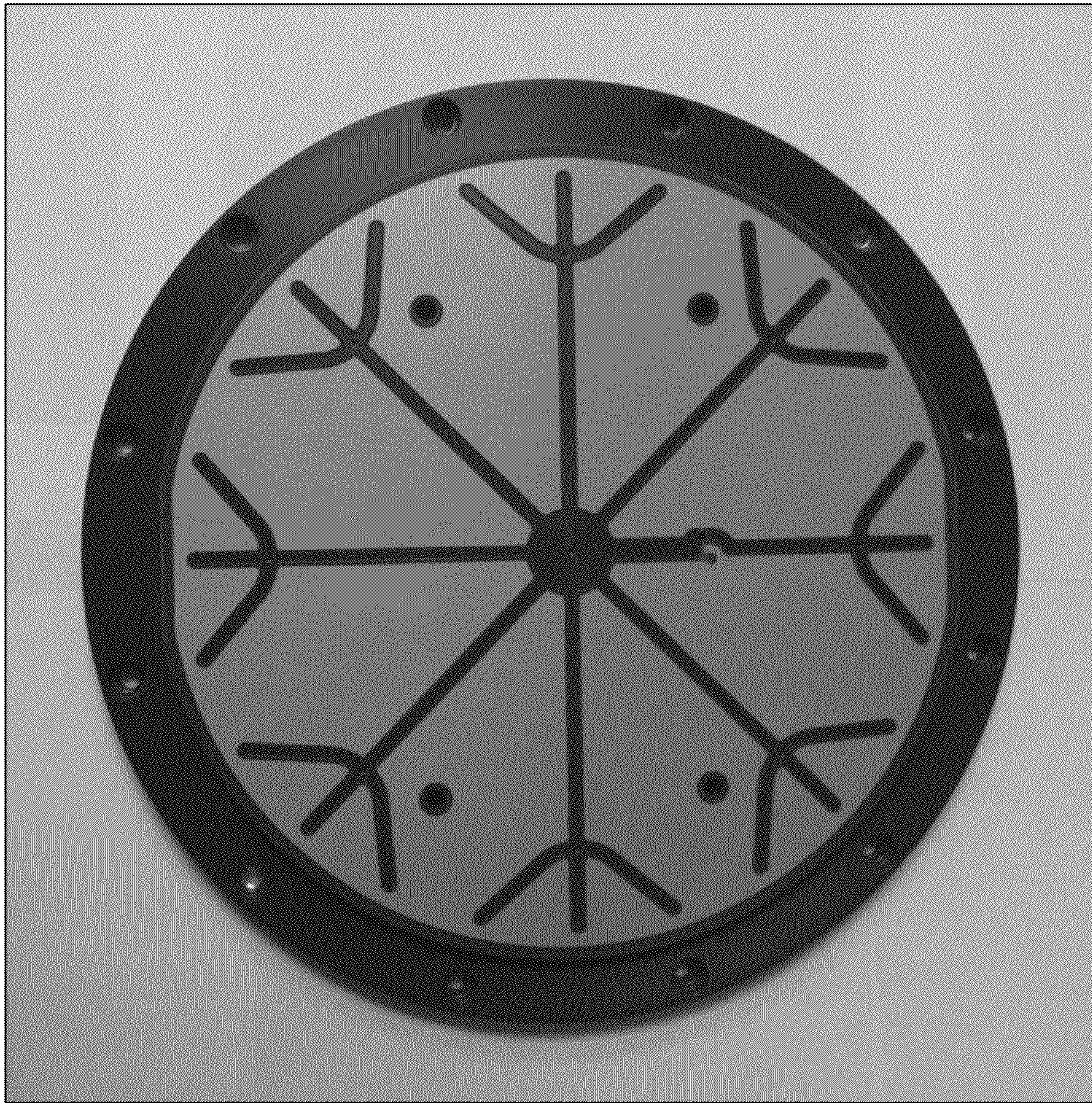

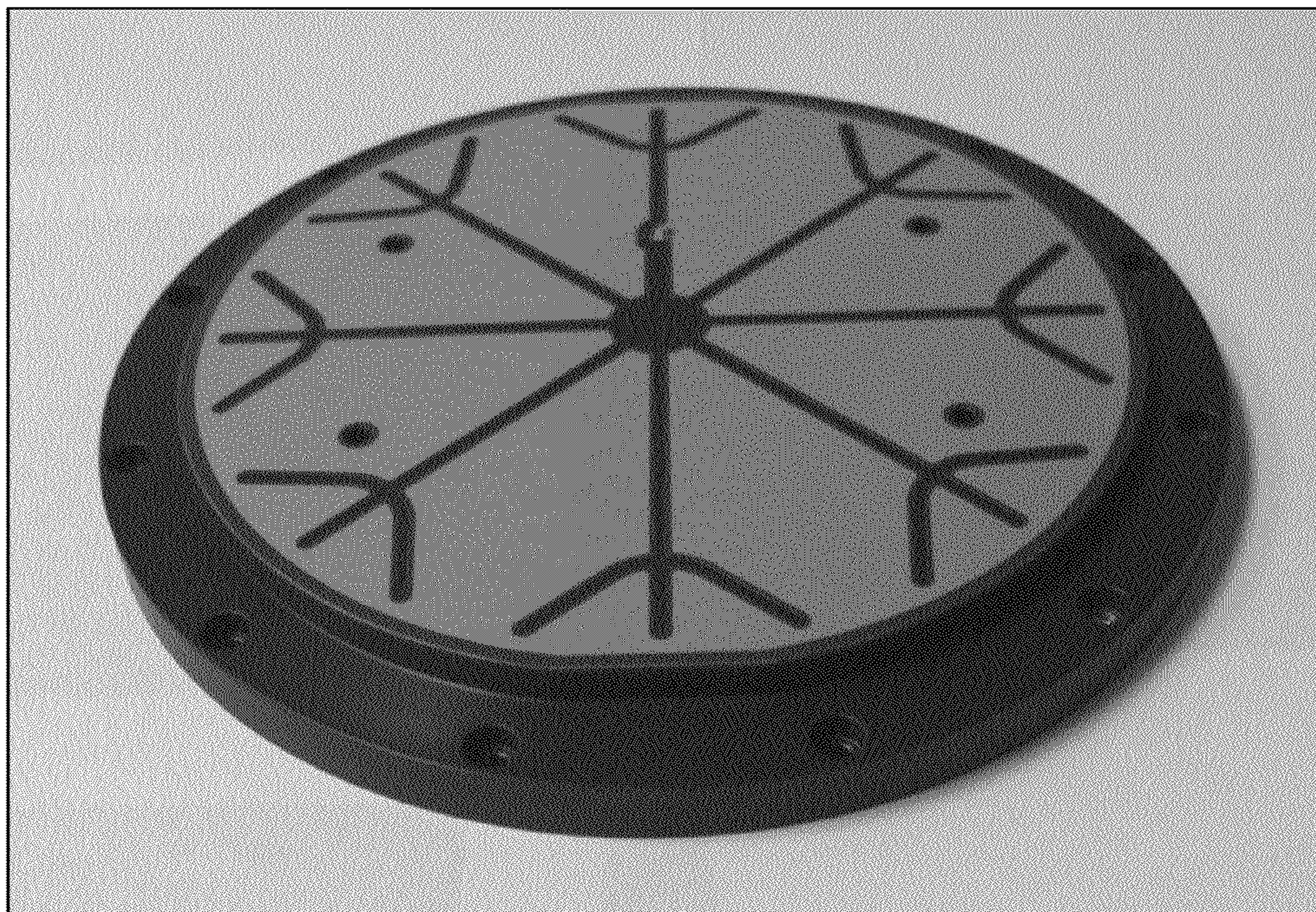
