FIG. 7 is a bottom perspective view of the skateboard deck with a surface ornamentation consisting of a mirror-like reflective appearance.

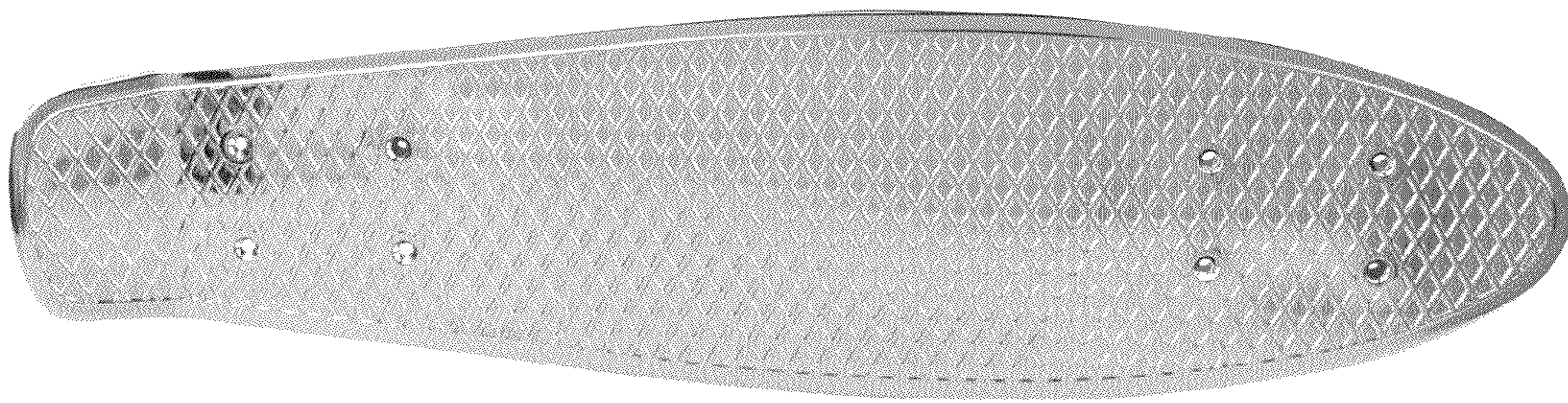

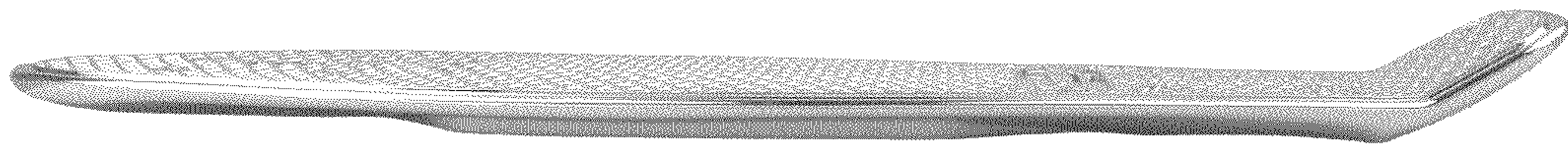

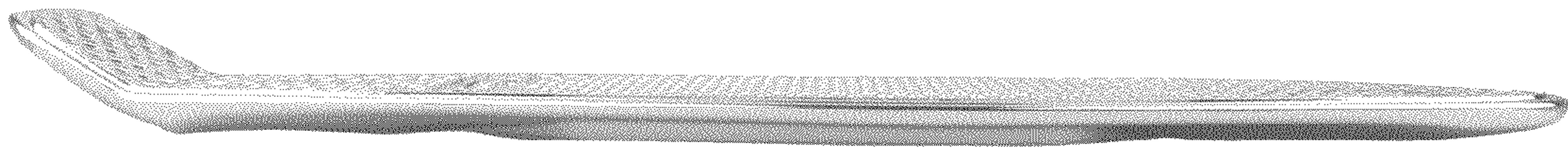

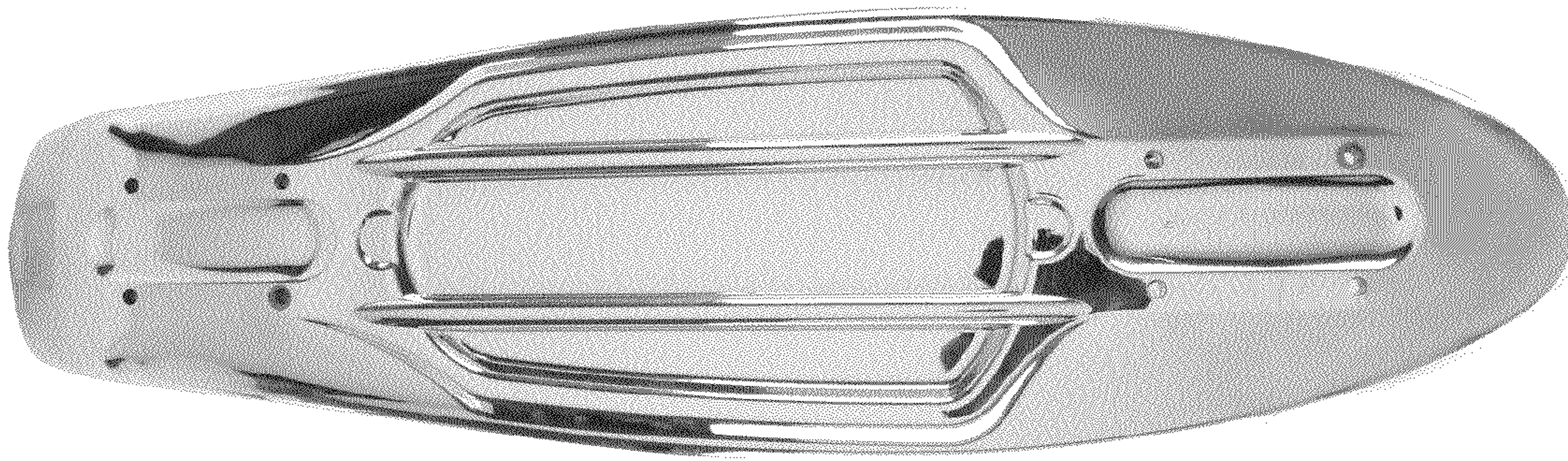

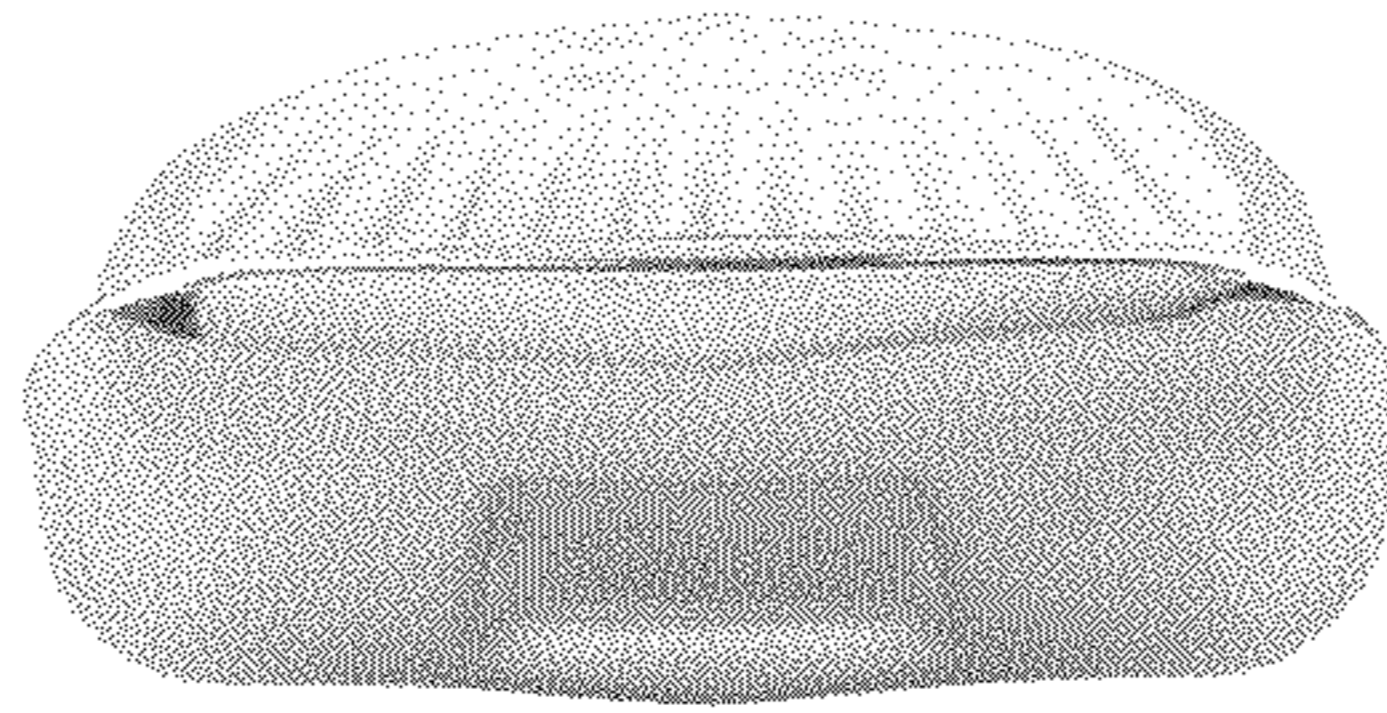

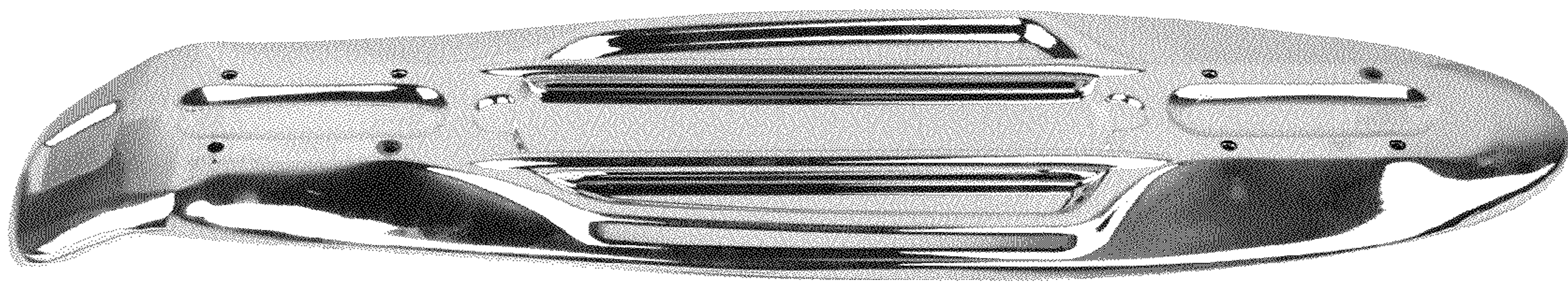
