FIG. 2 is a side view of the same;

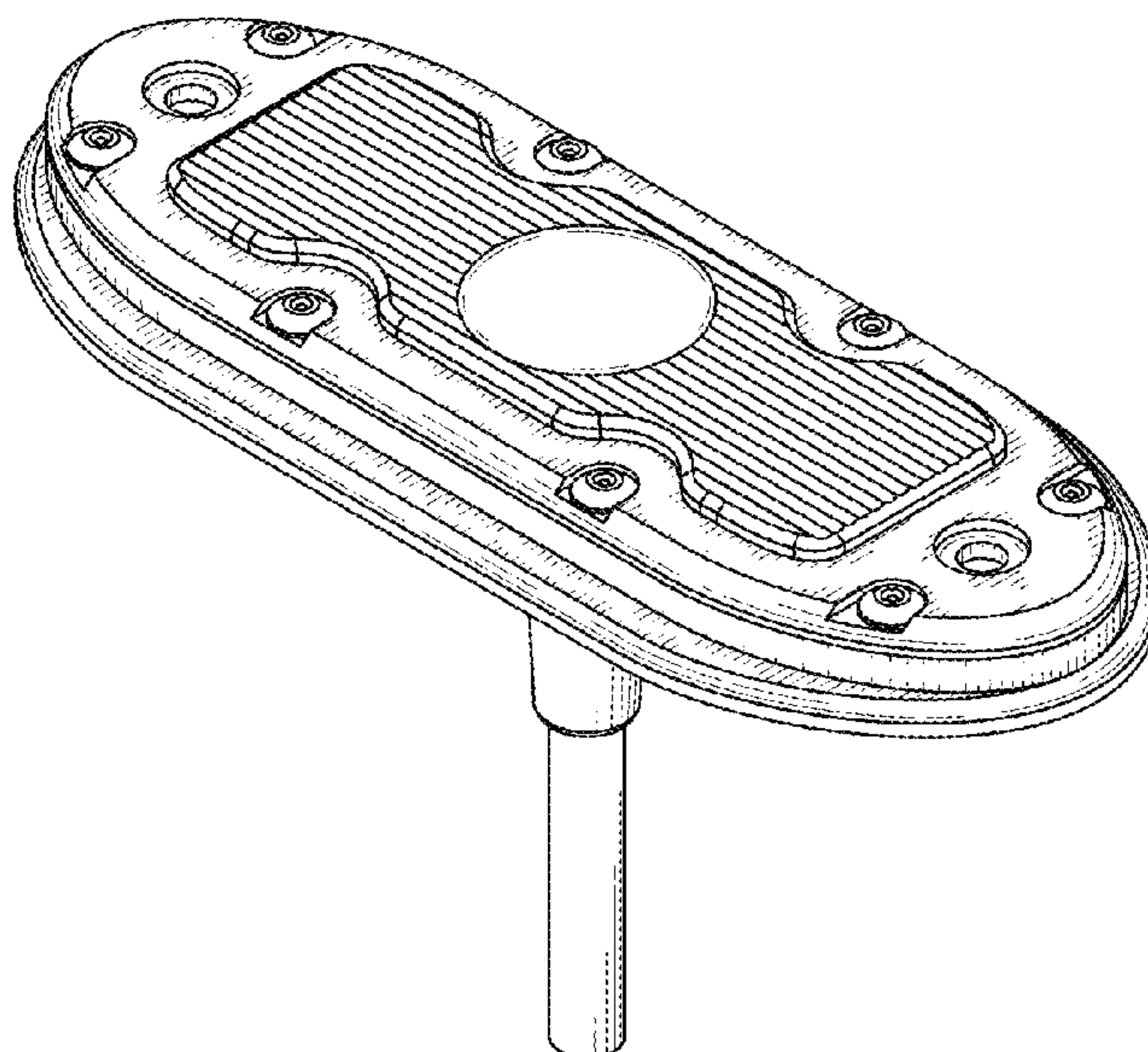
FIG. 3 is an end view of the same;

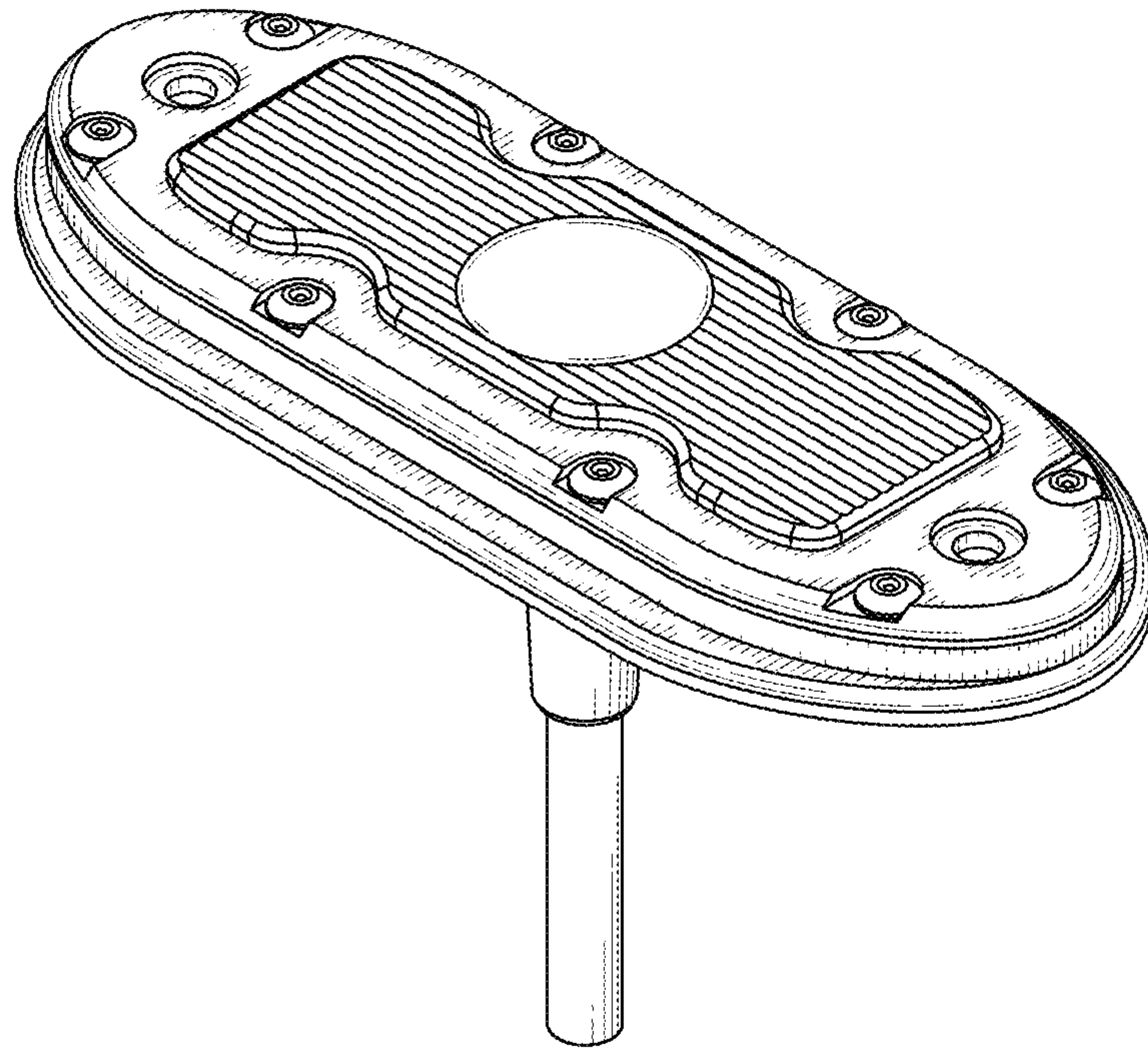

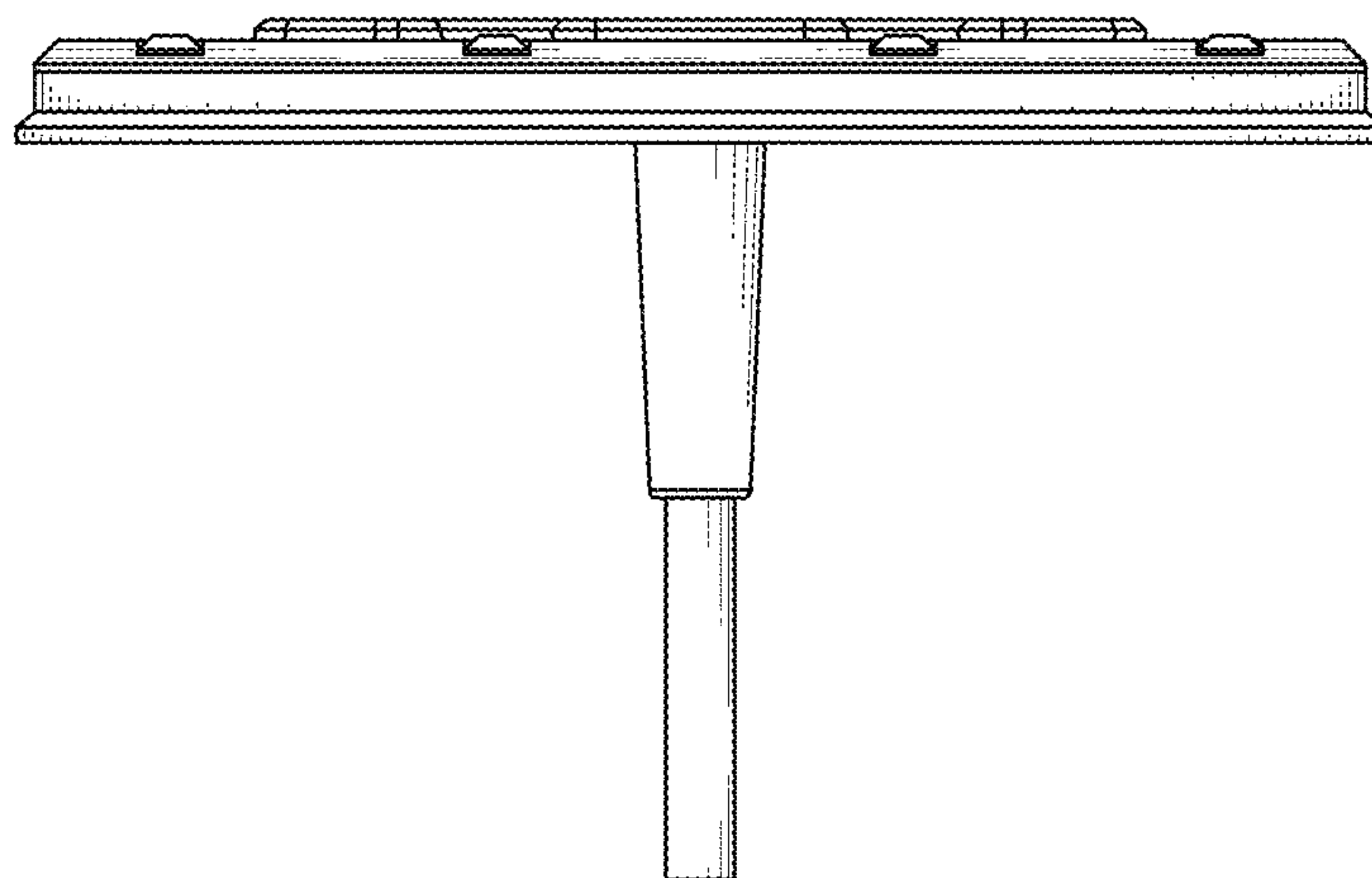

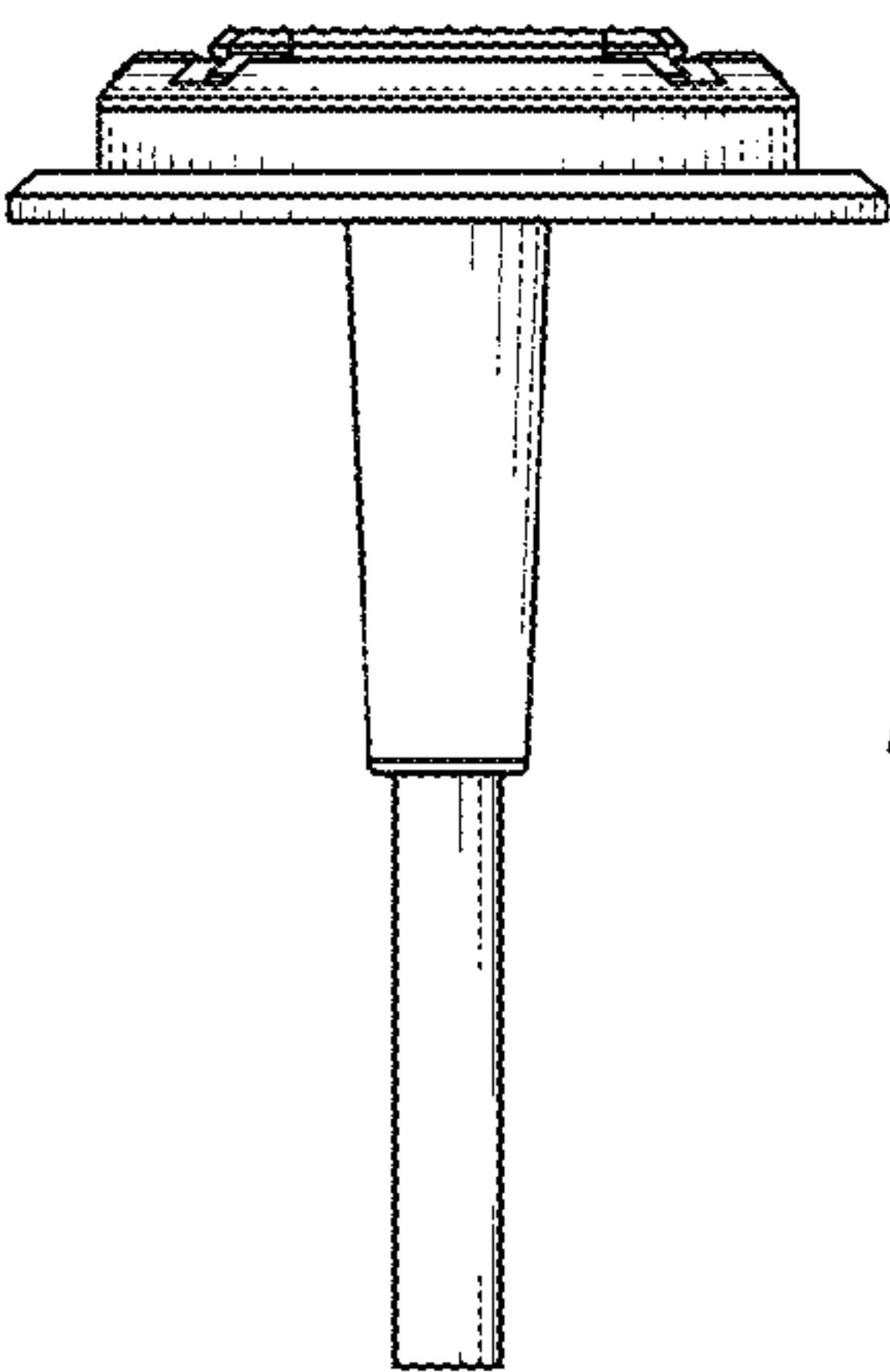

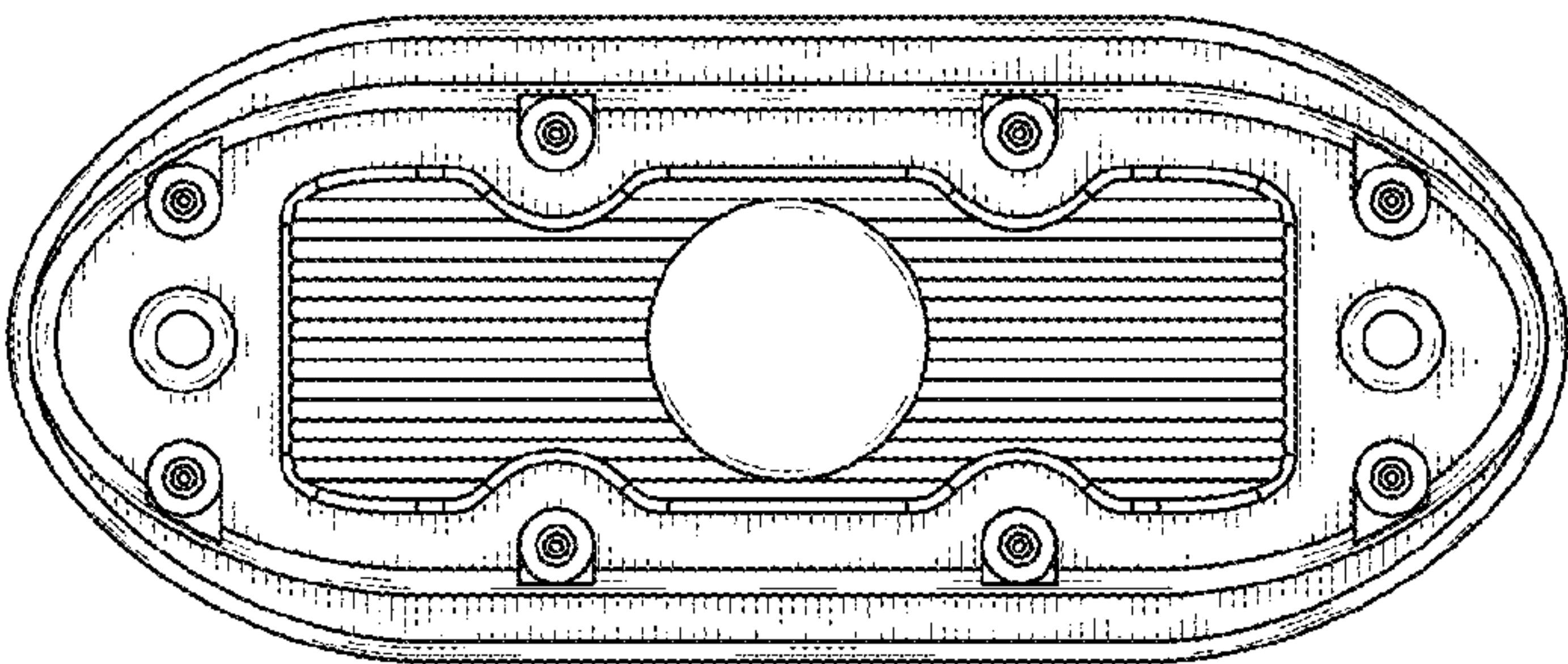

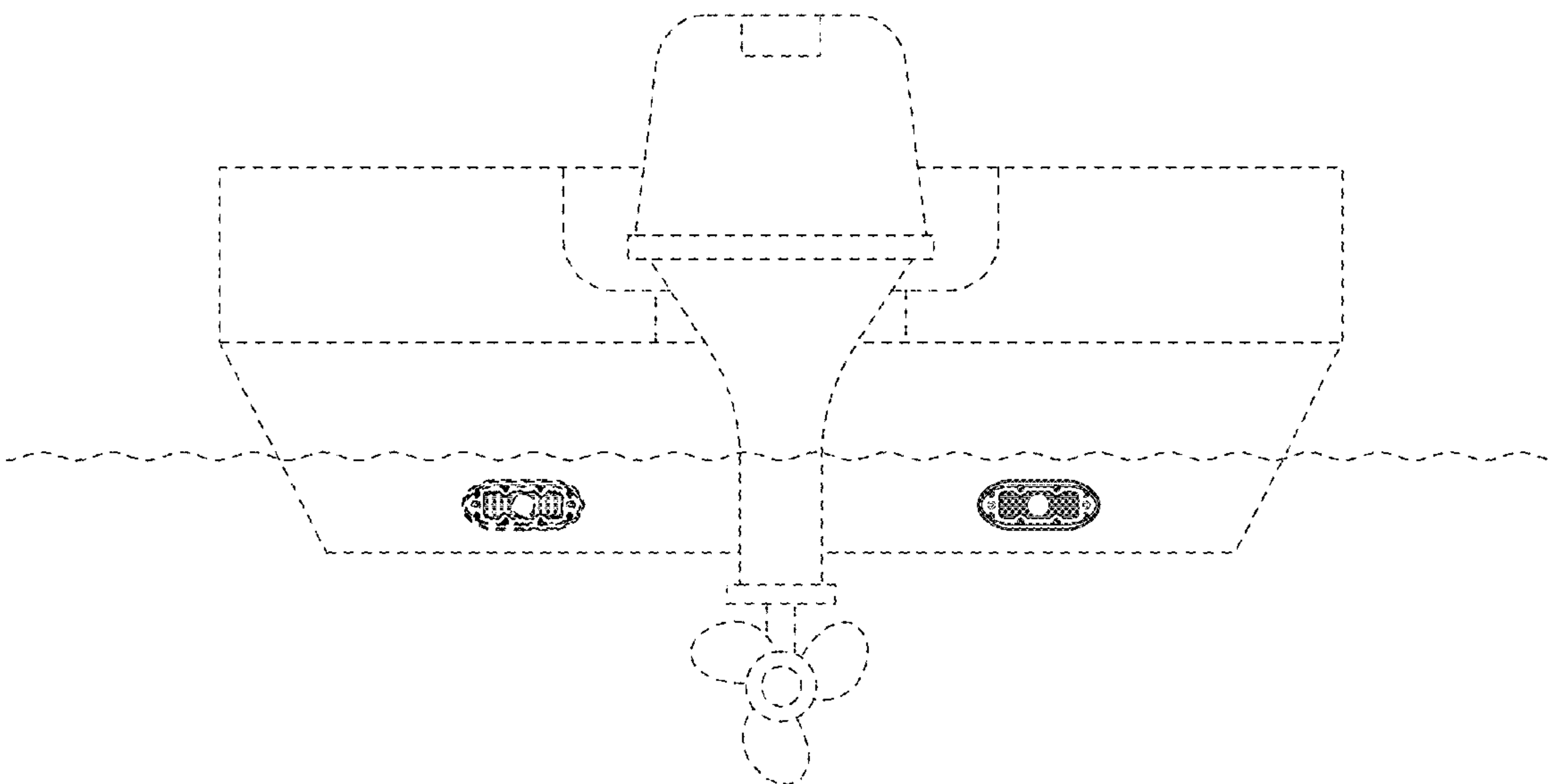
