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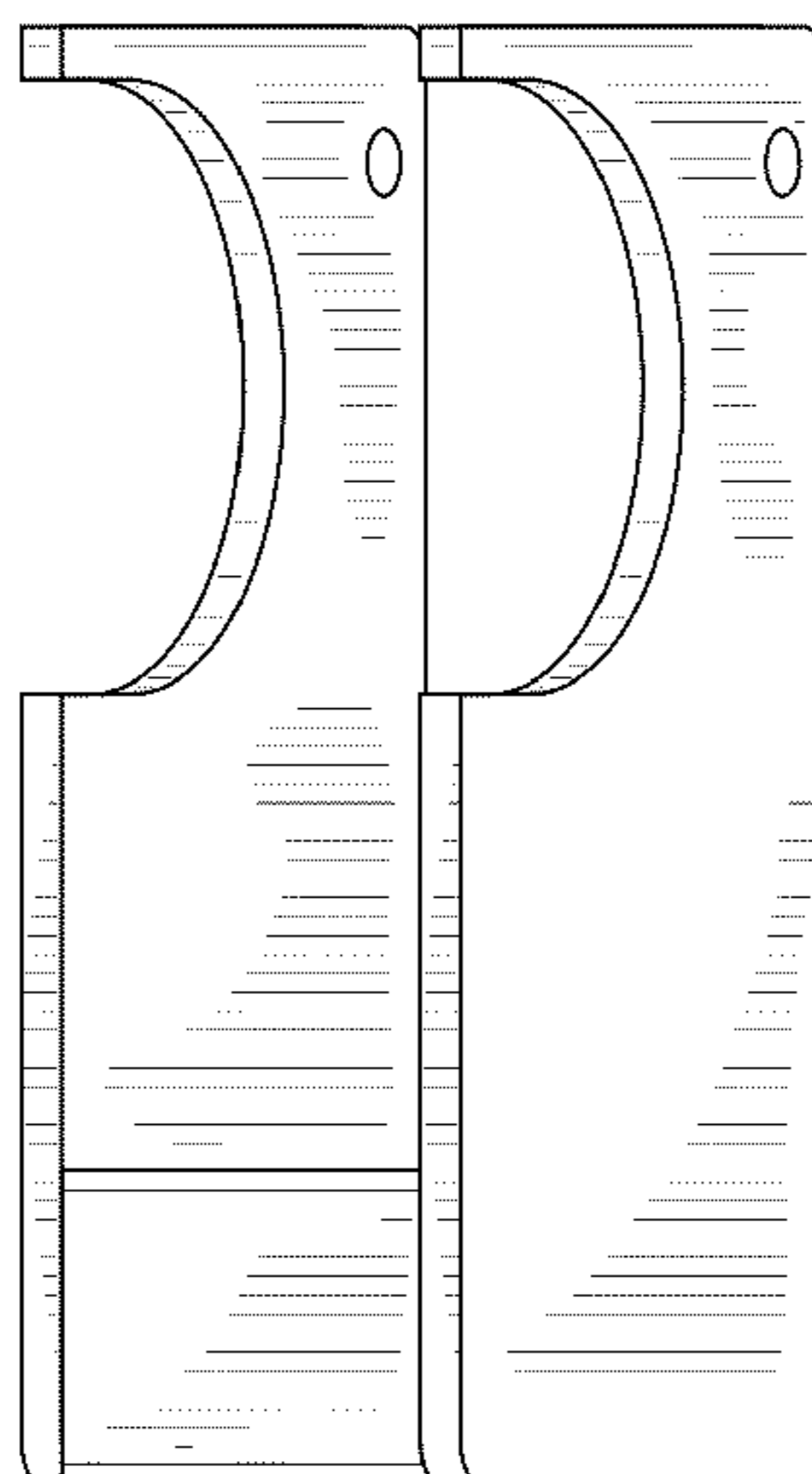
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a maintenance support for a test head removed from a portable brinell metal hardness tester, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view showing the front, and right side of the maintenance support for a test head removed from a portable brinell metal hardness tester of the invention.
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the maintenance support for a test head removed from a portable brinell metal hardness tester of the invention.
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevation of the maintenance support for a test head removed from a portable brinell metal hardness tester of the invention.

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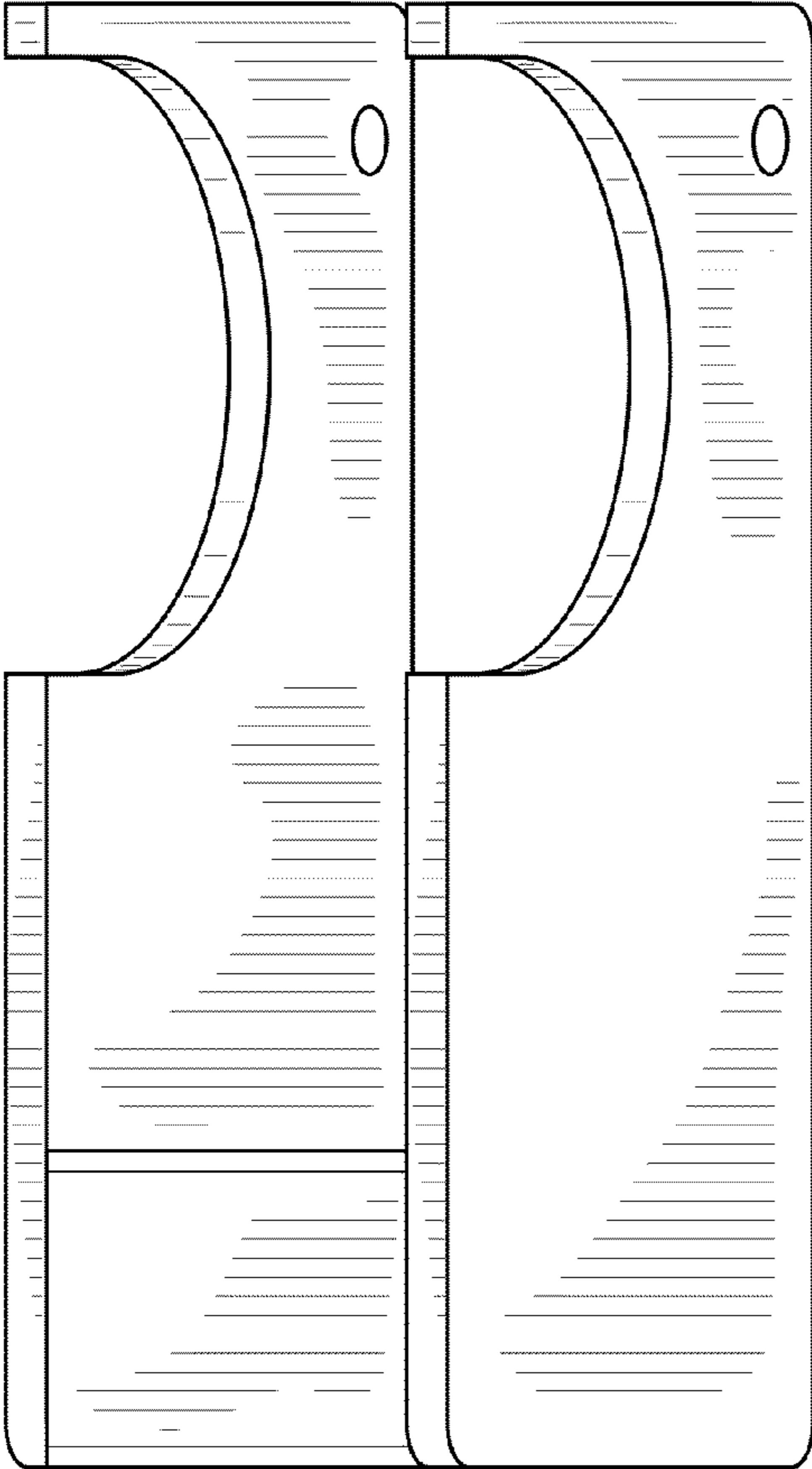

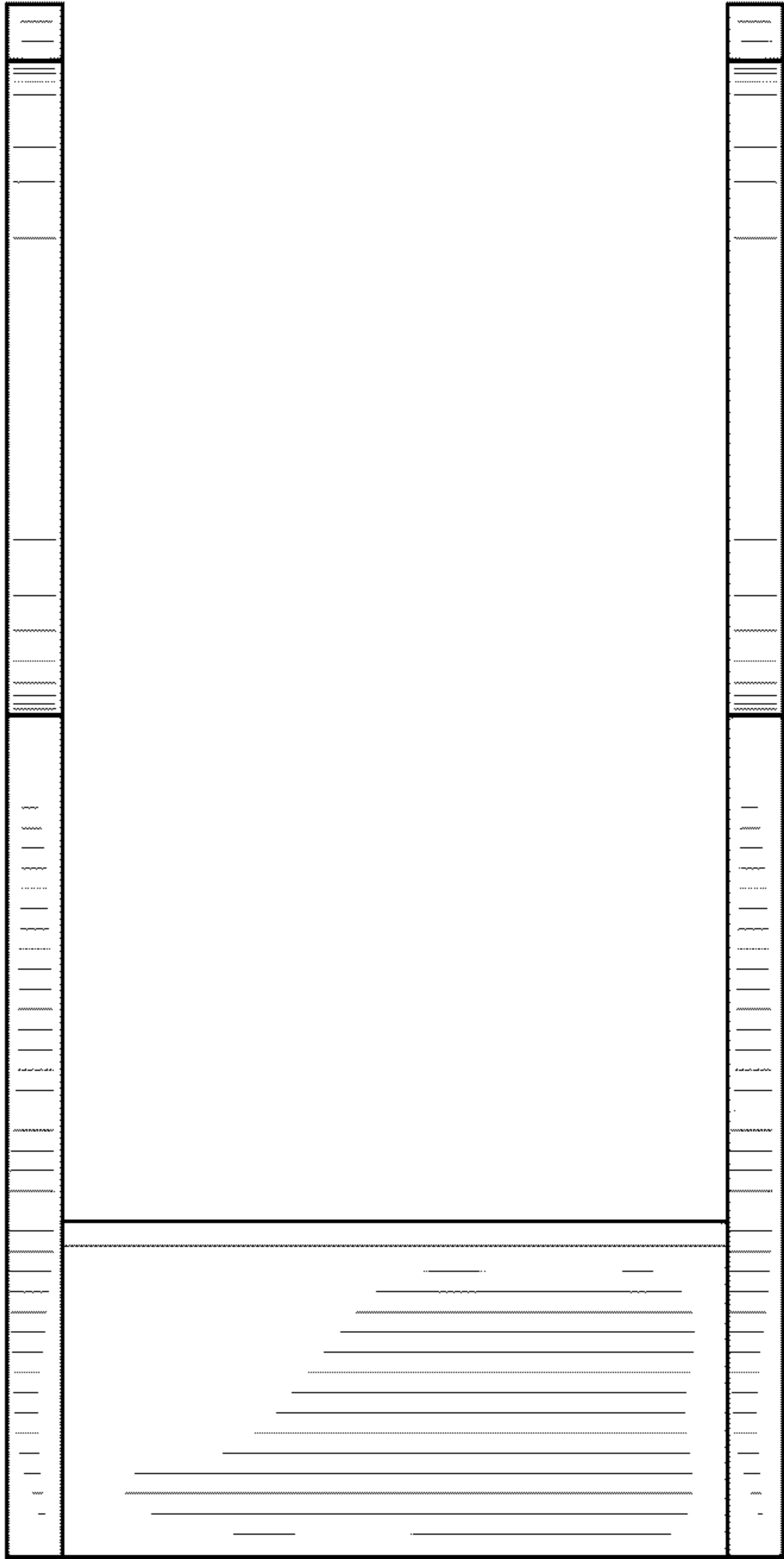

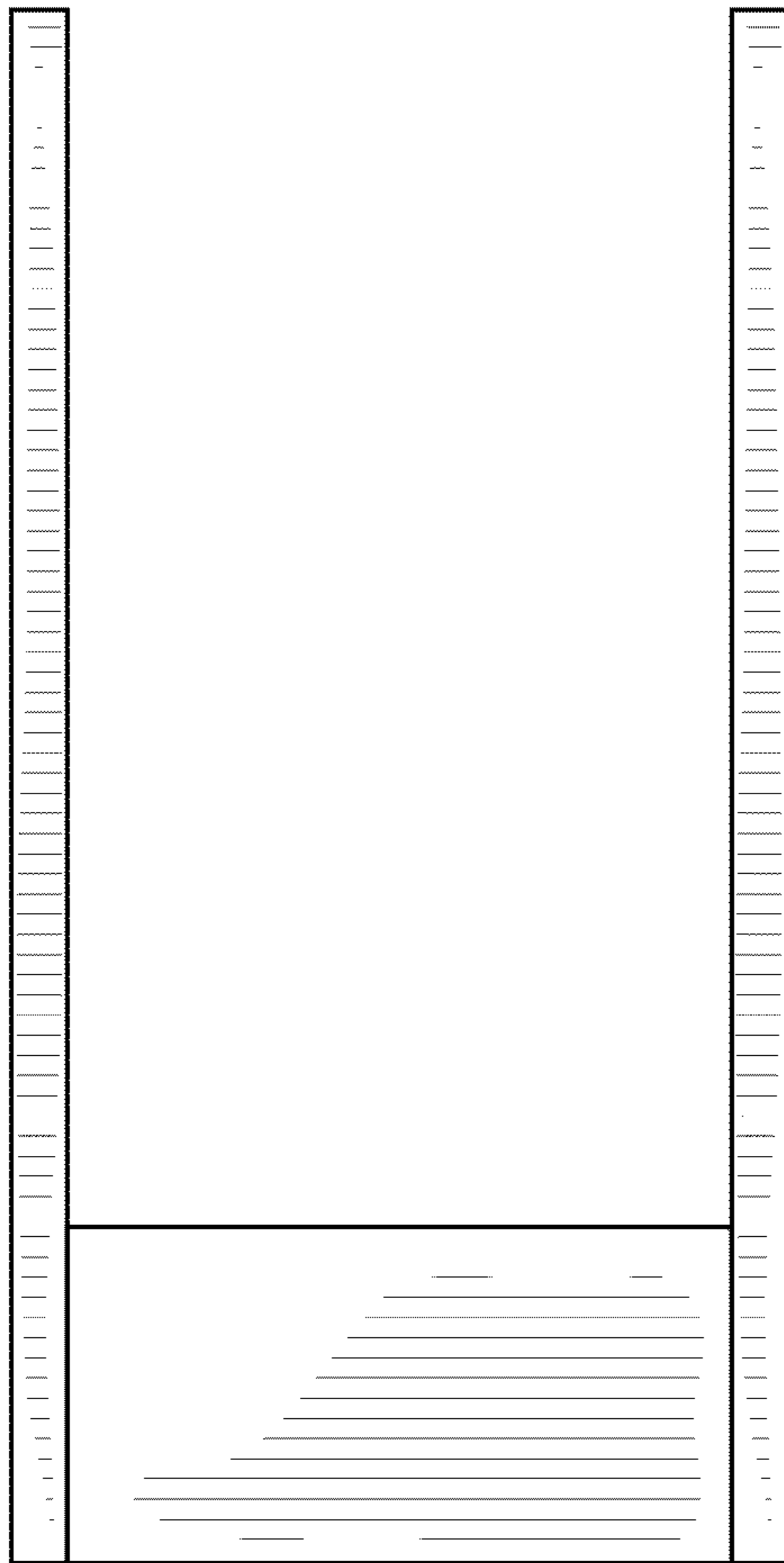

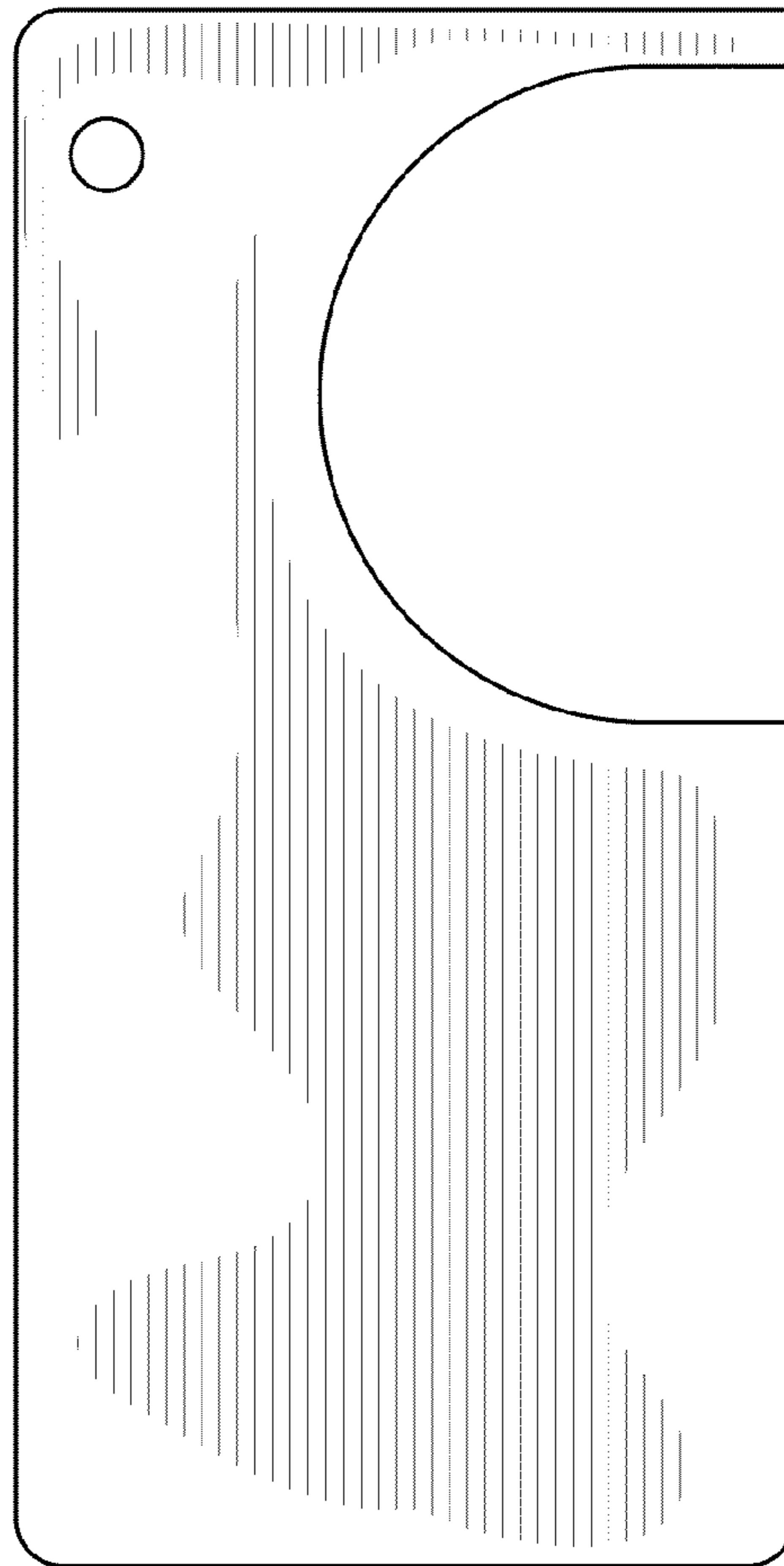

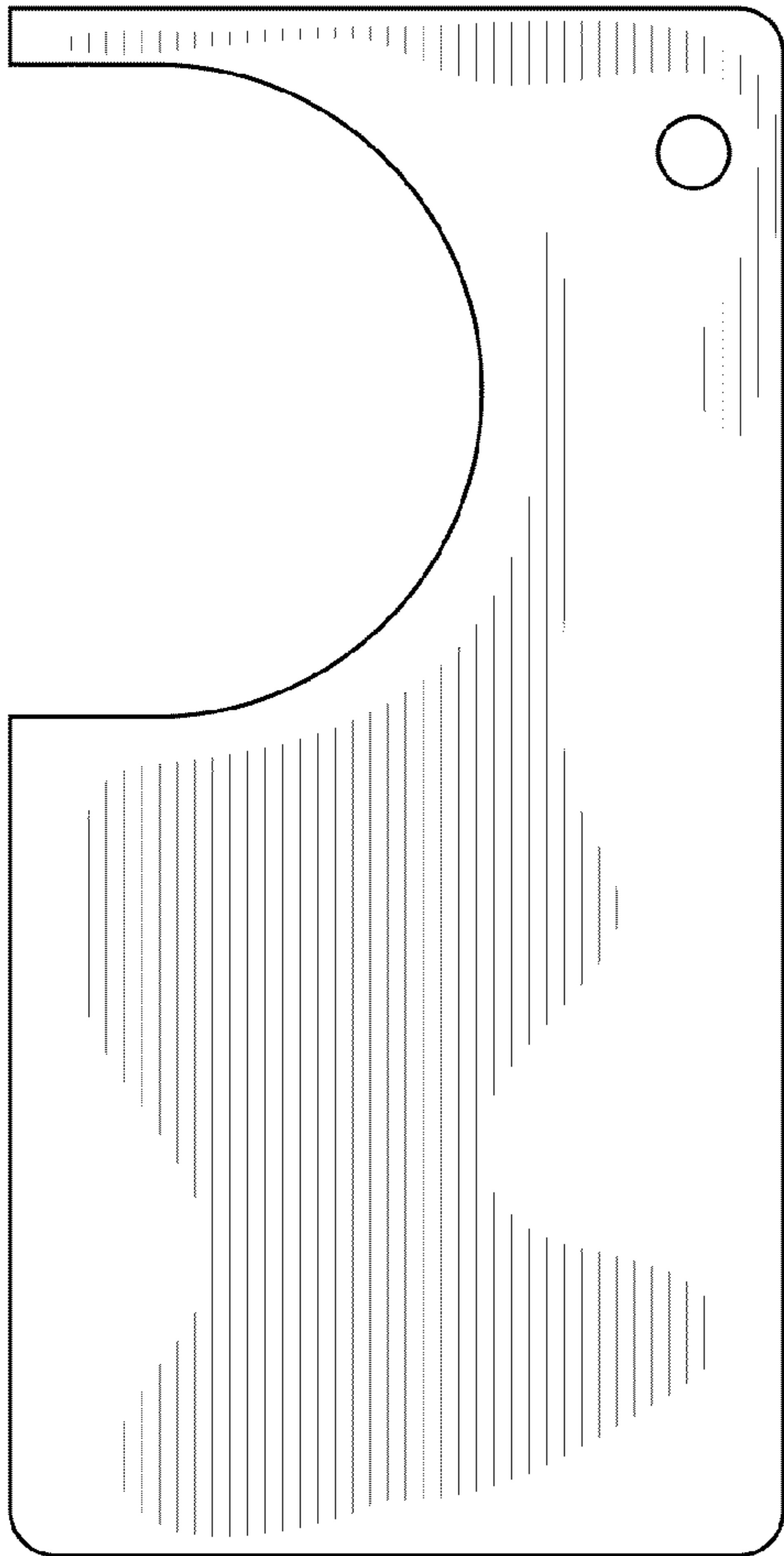

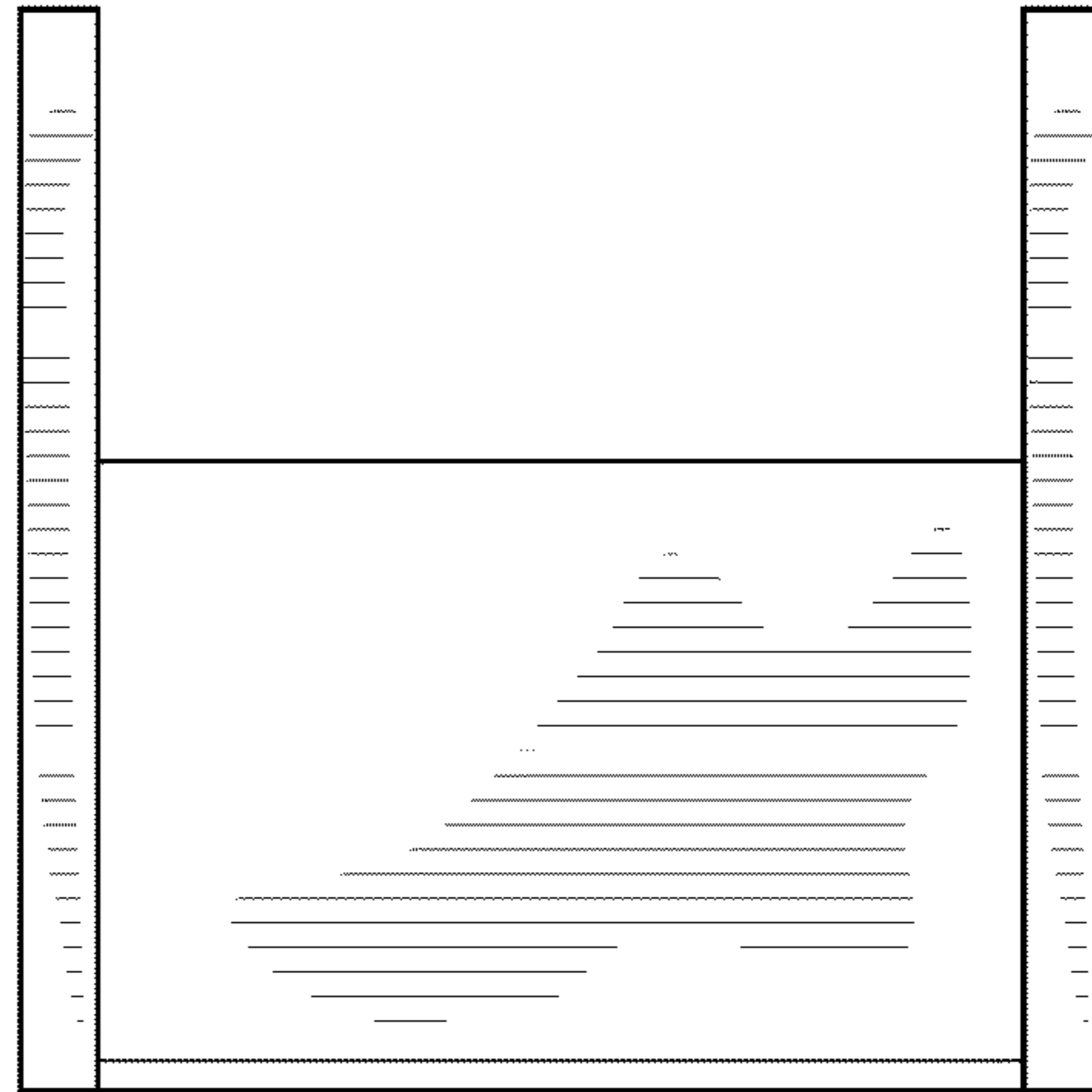

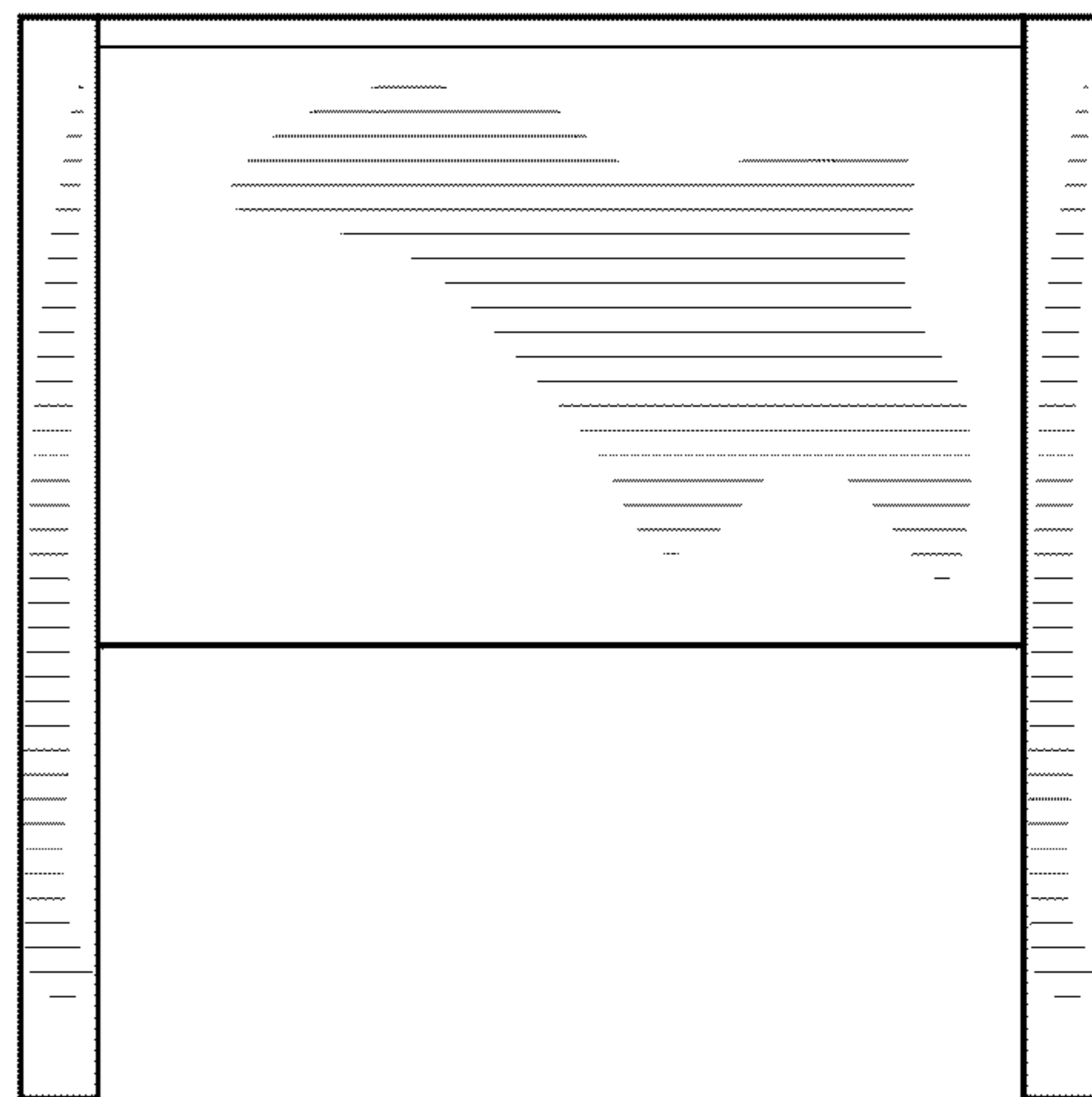
