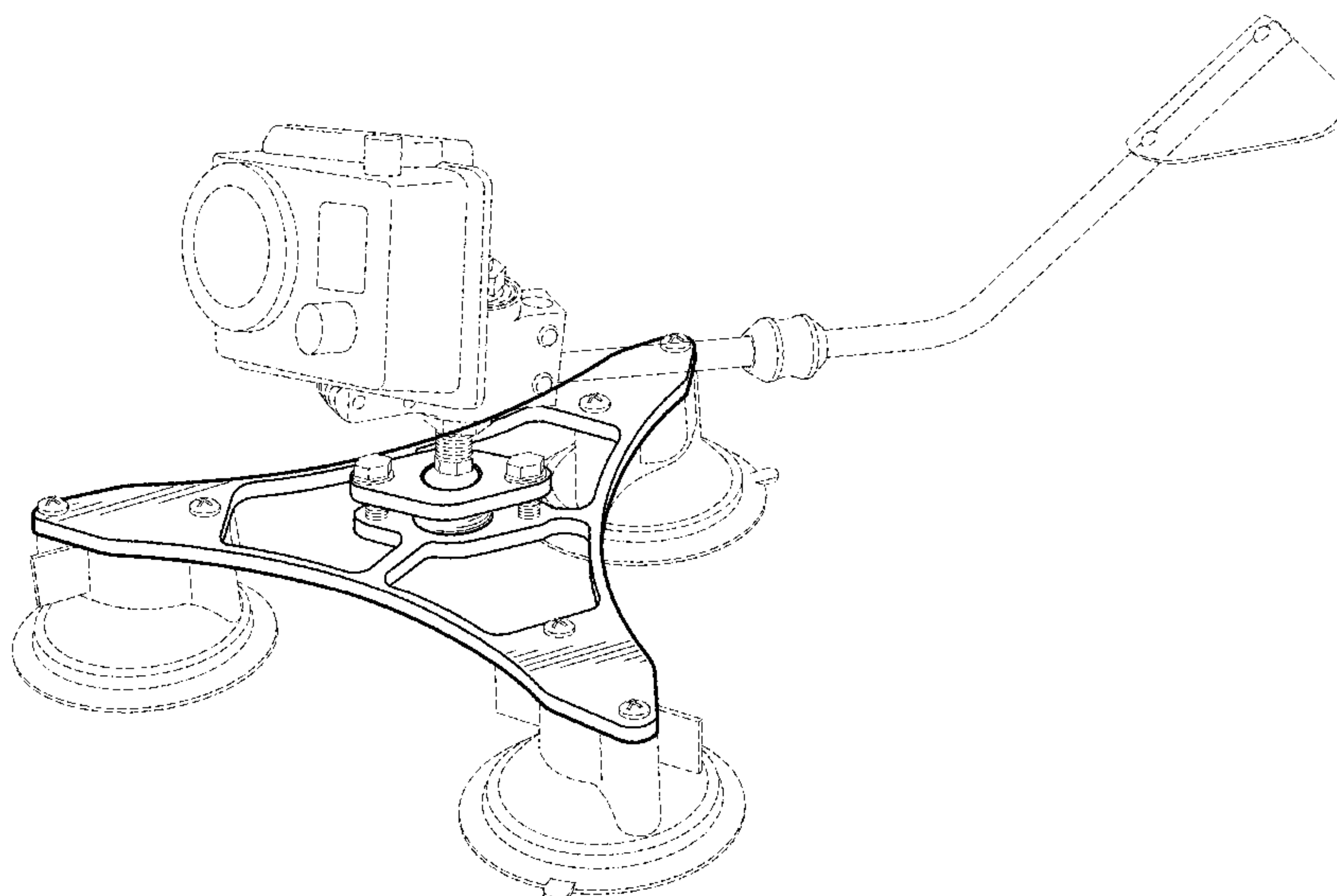

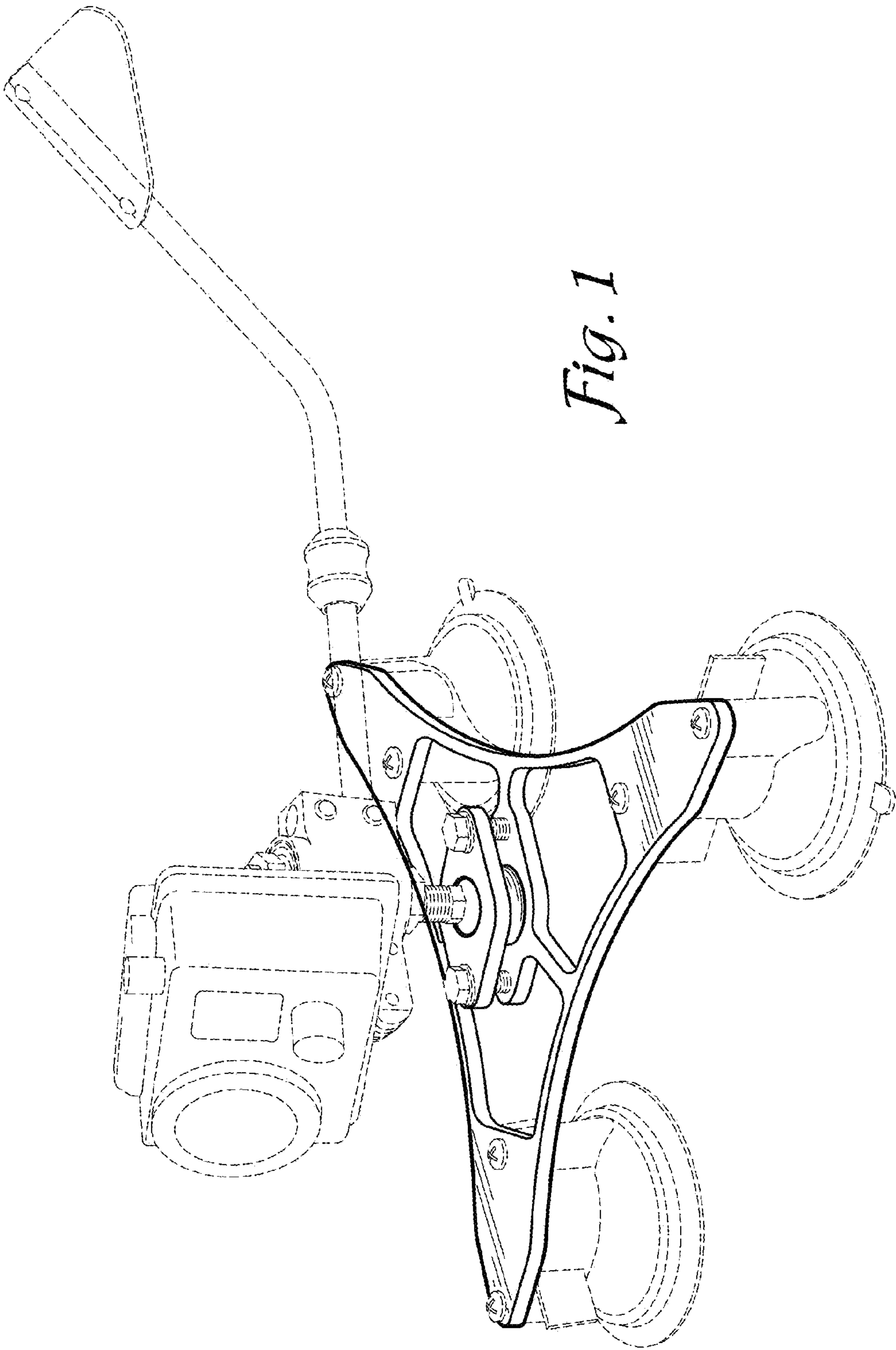
The ornamental design for a base for a camera mount, as

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right, front perspective view of a base for a camera
mount according to the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side
elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

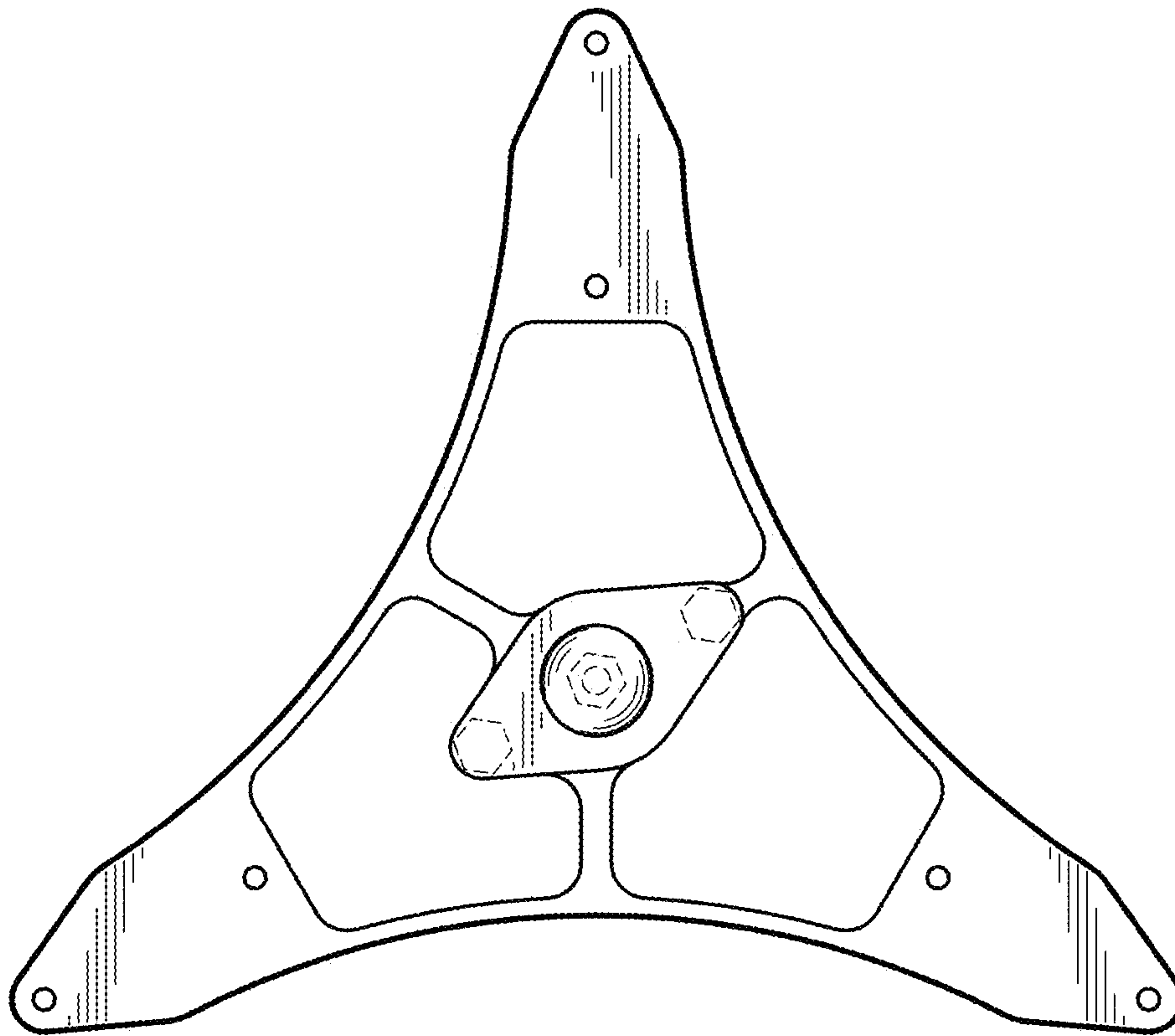

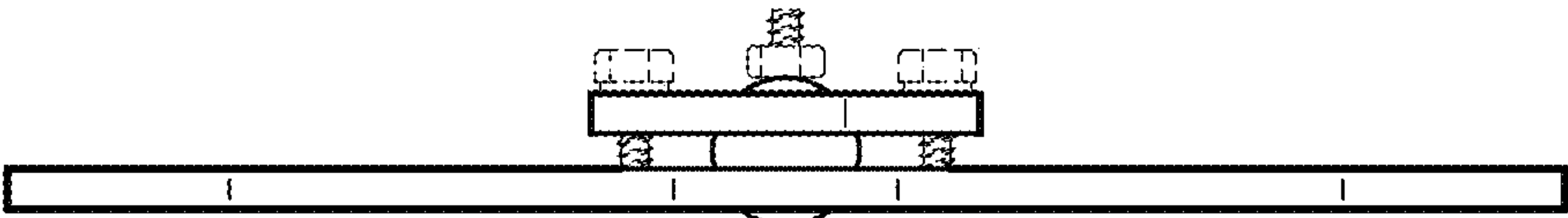

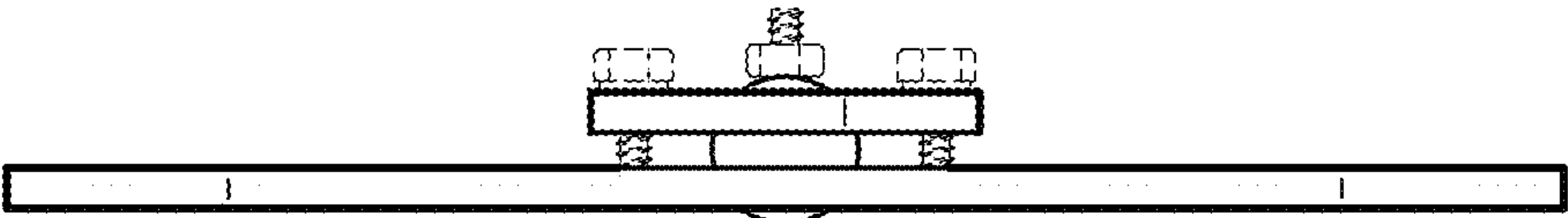

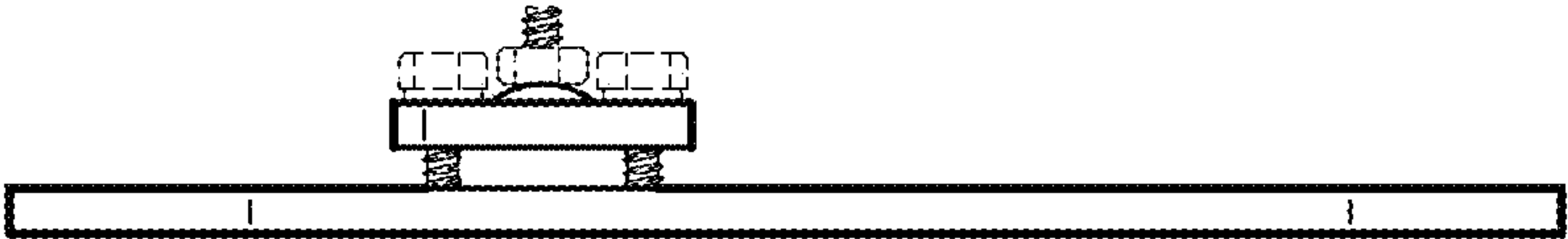

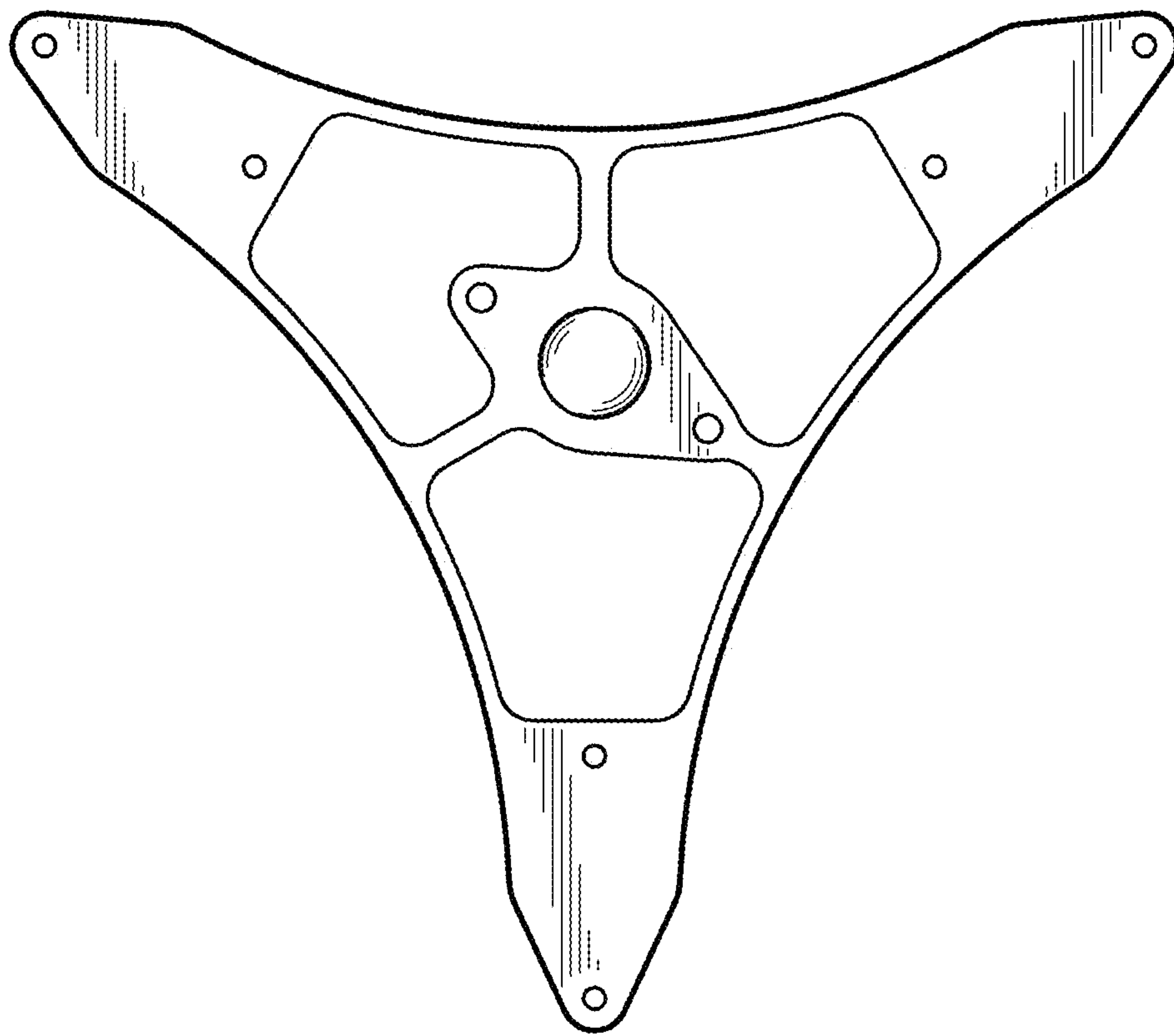
