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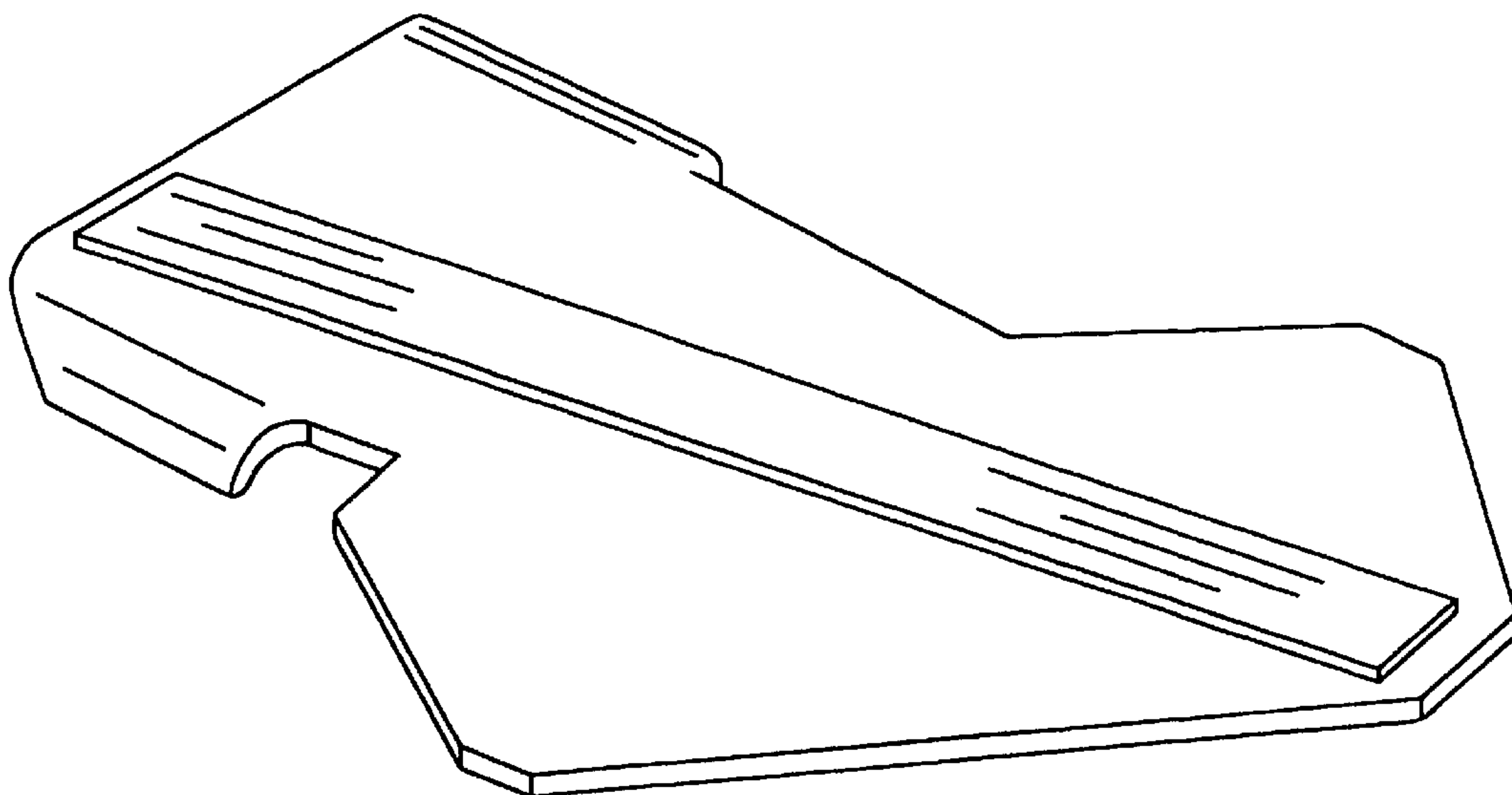
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view favoring the interior wall;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view favoring the exterior wall;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The shape generally represents a neonatal foot splint for stabilizing a foot.

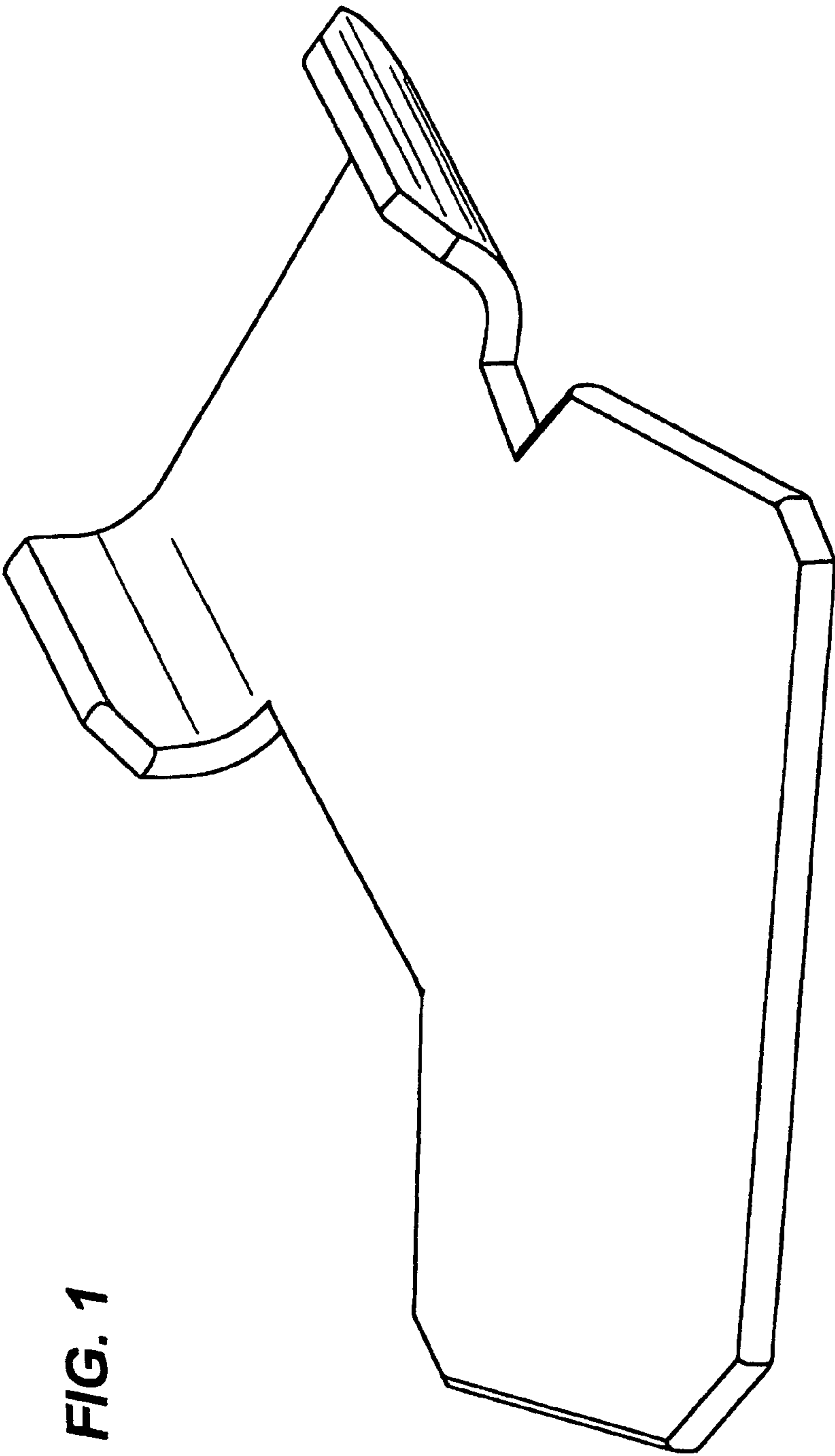
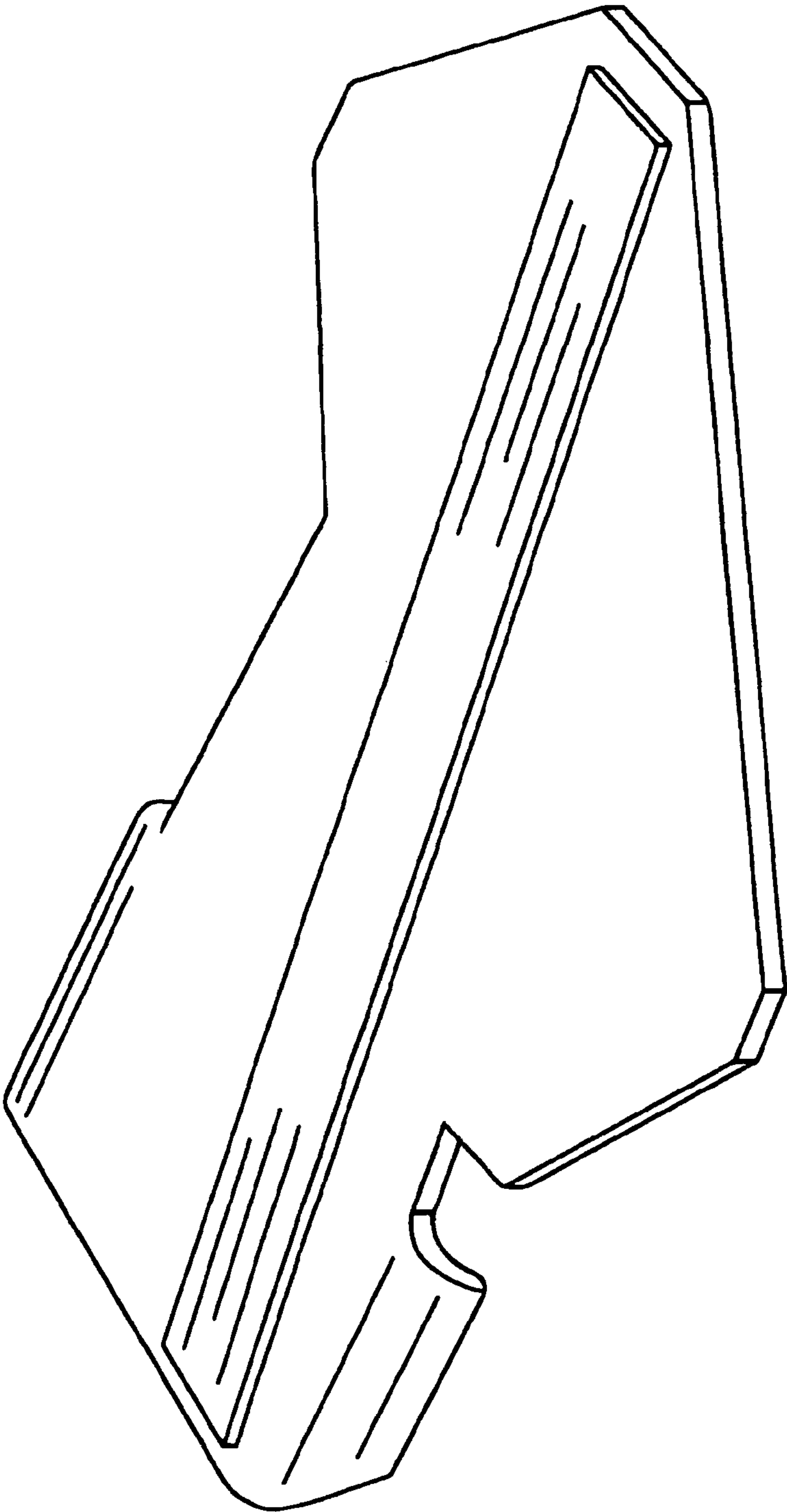

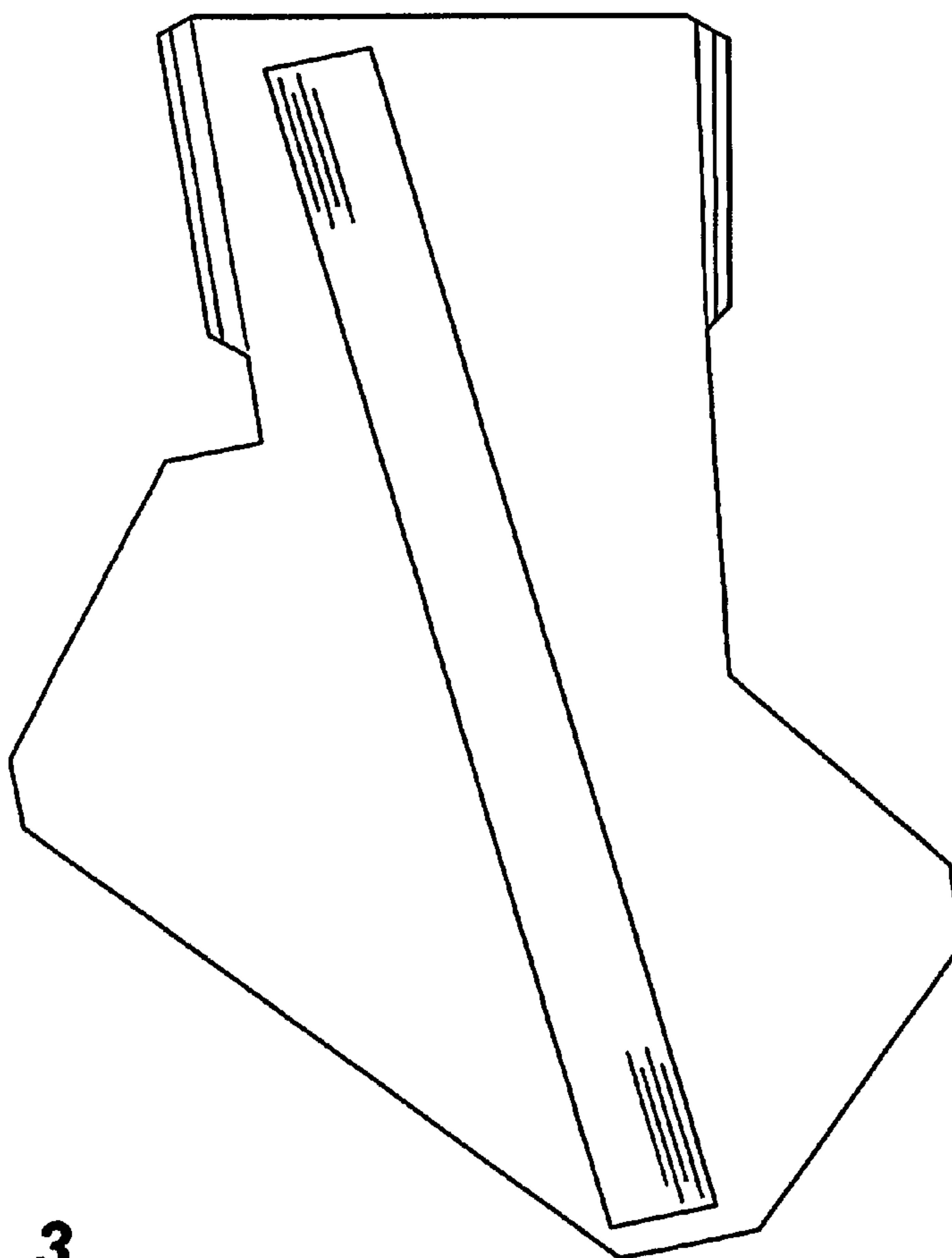
