(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a bra for interchangeable, variable-sized breast cups, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

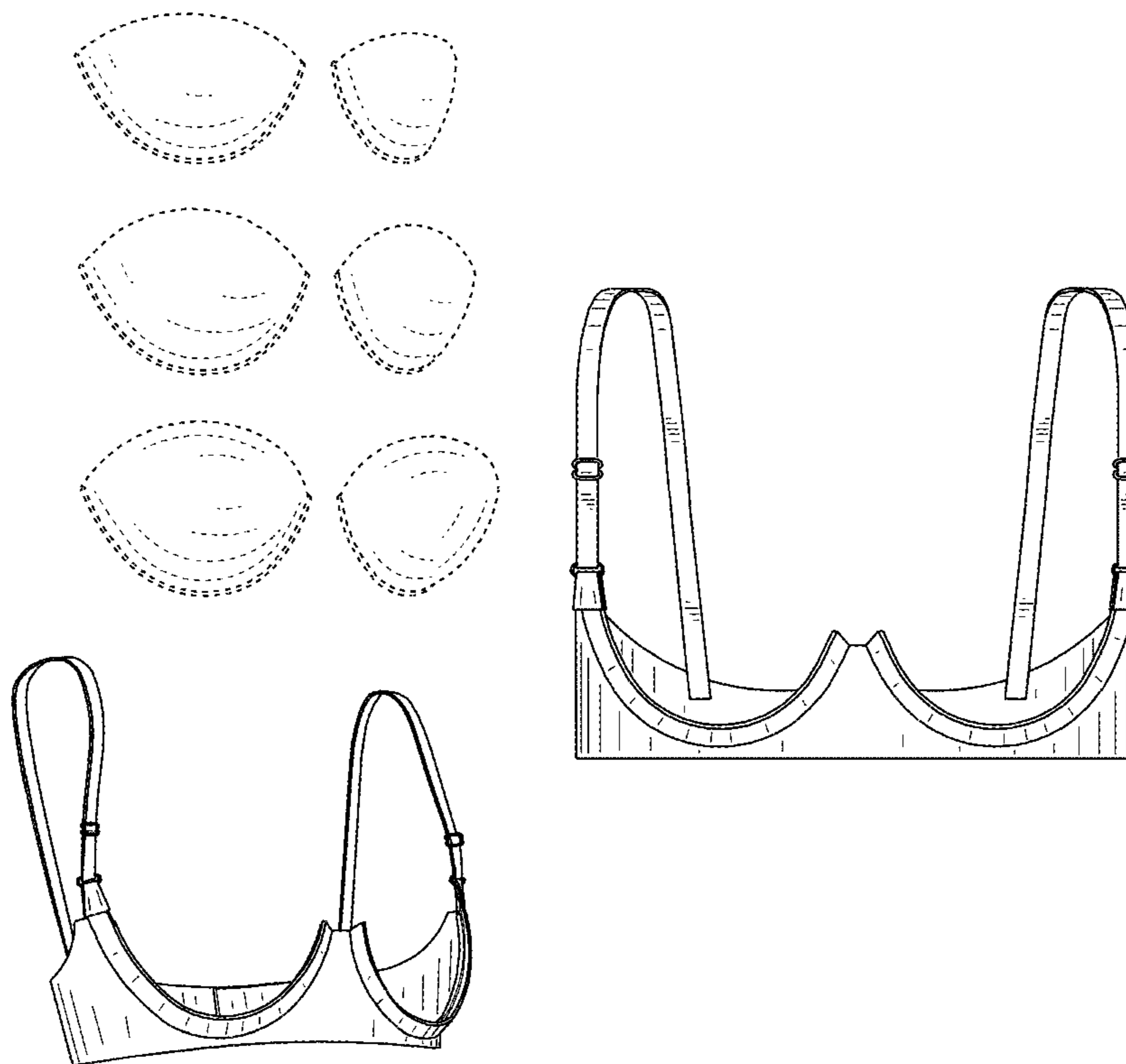
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

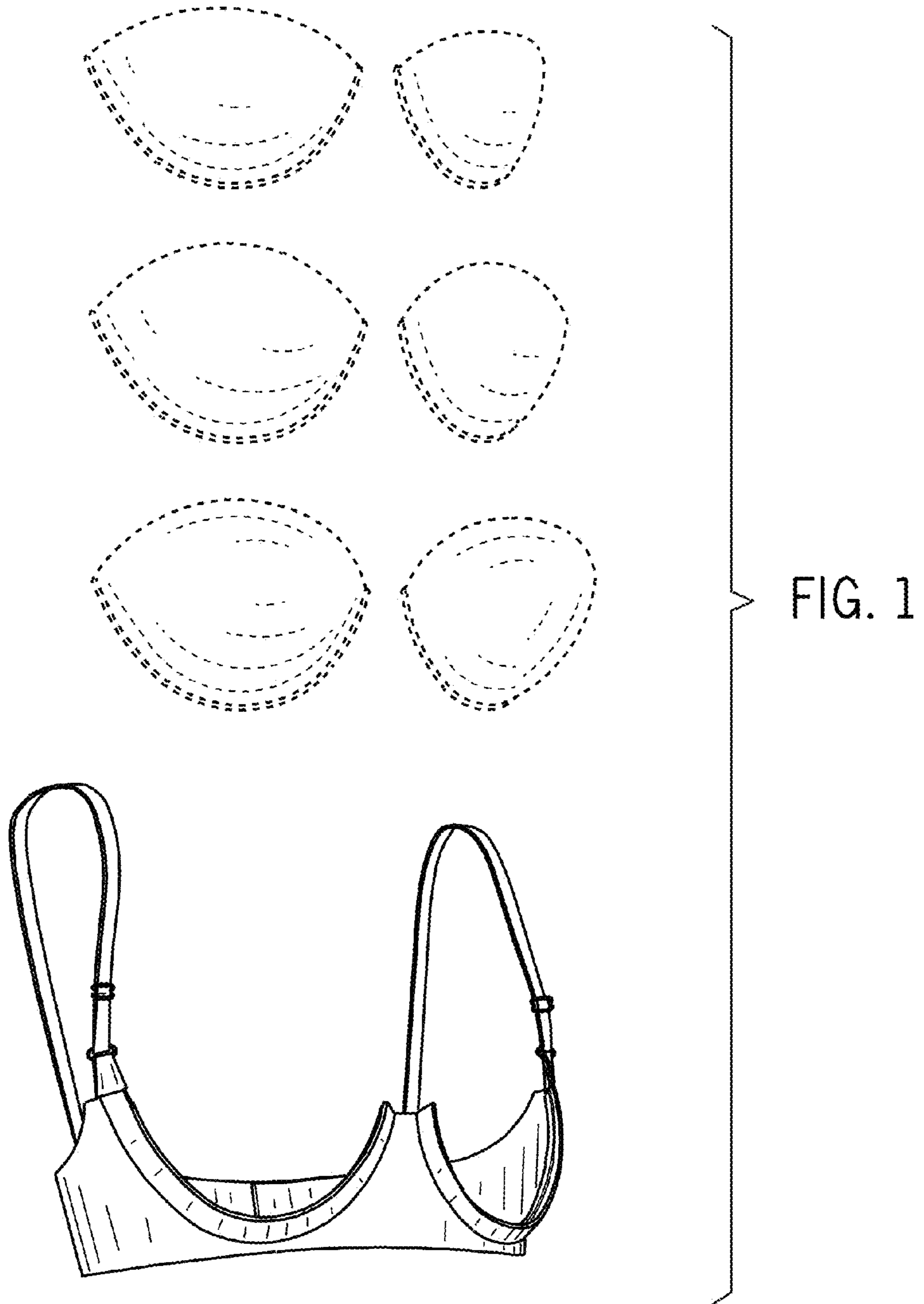
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

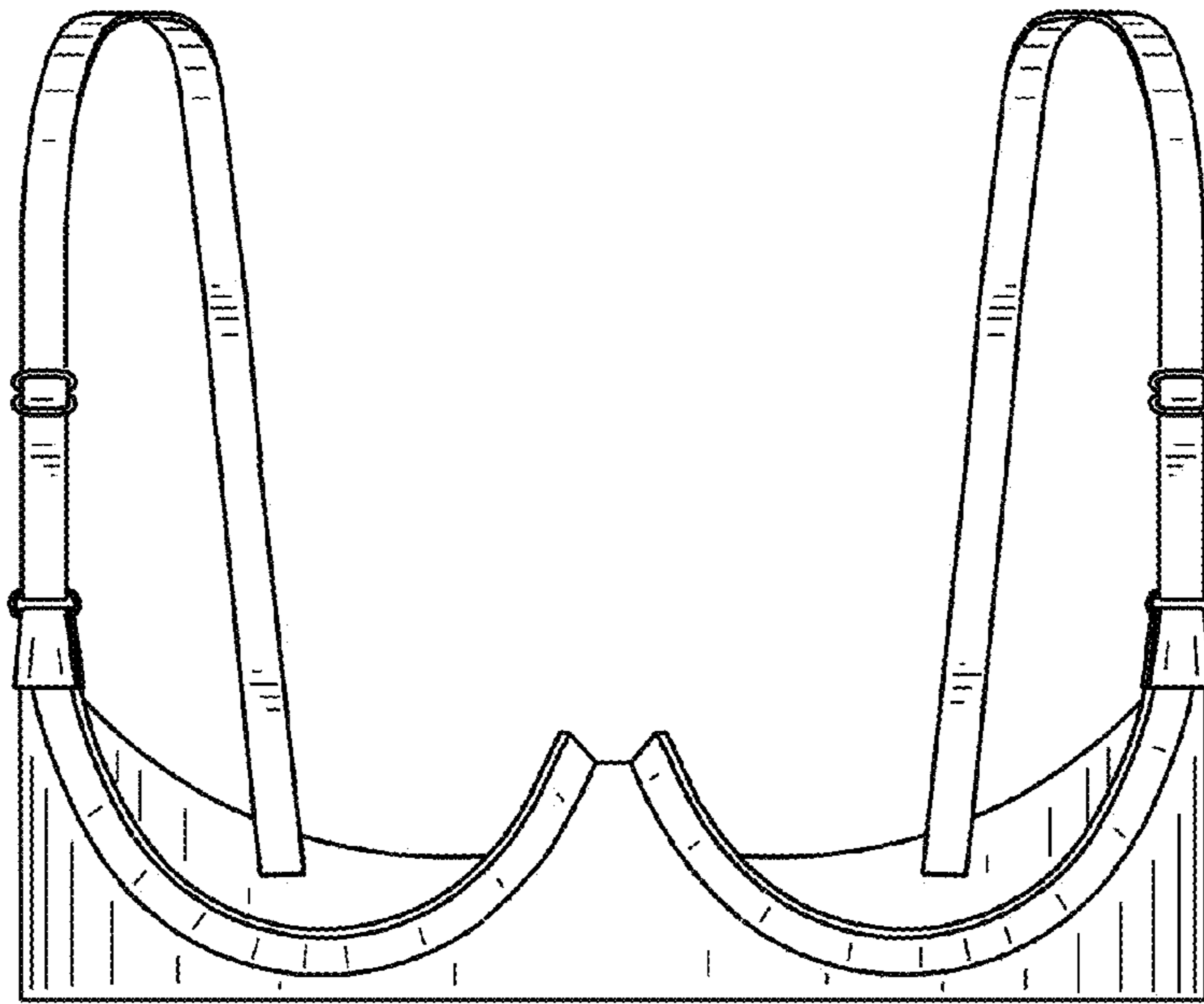

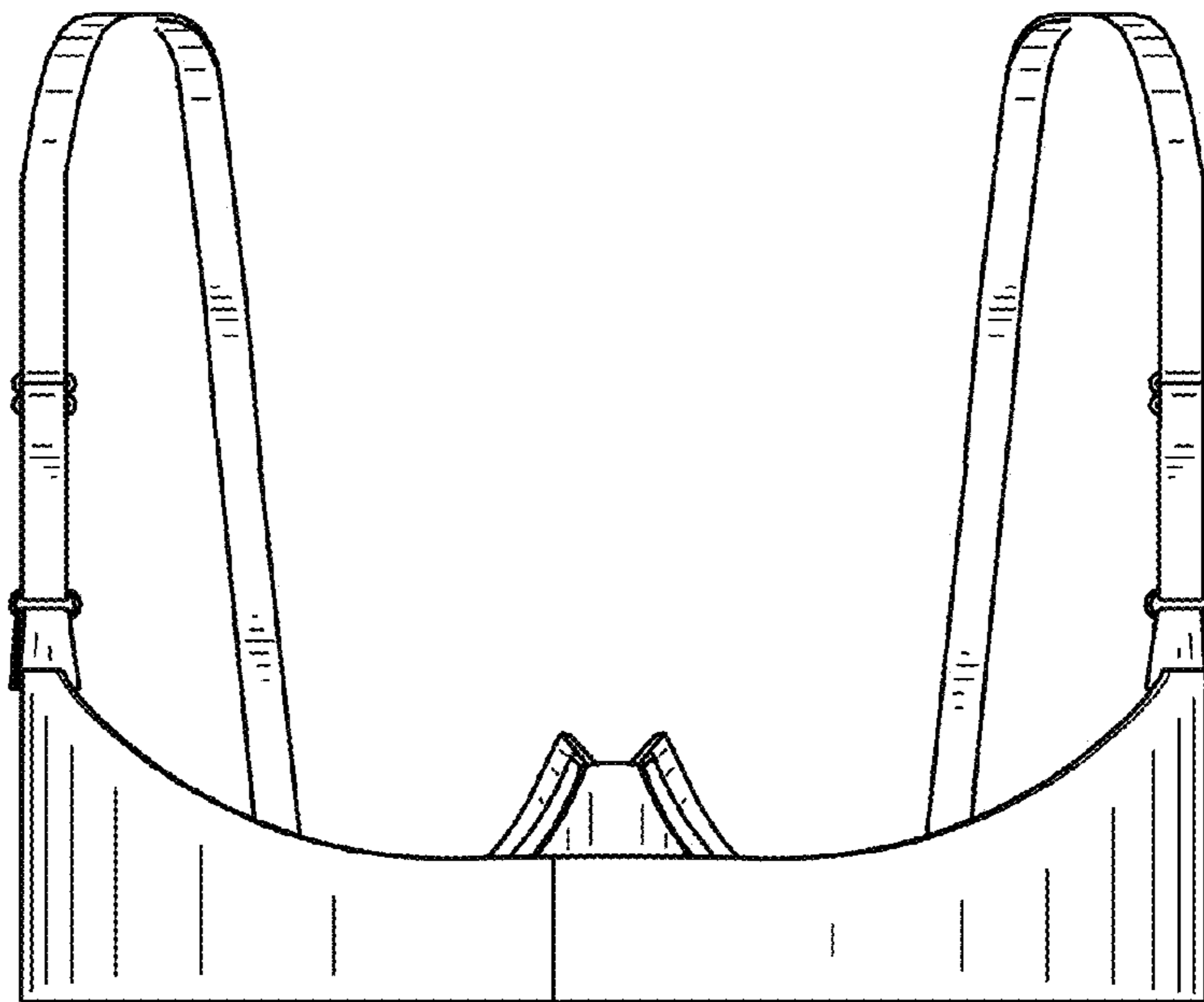

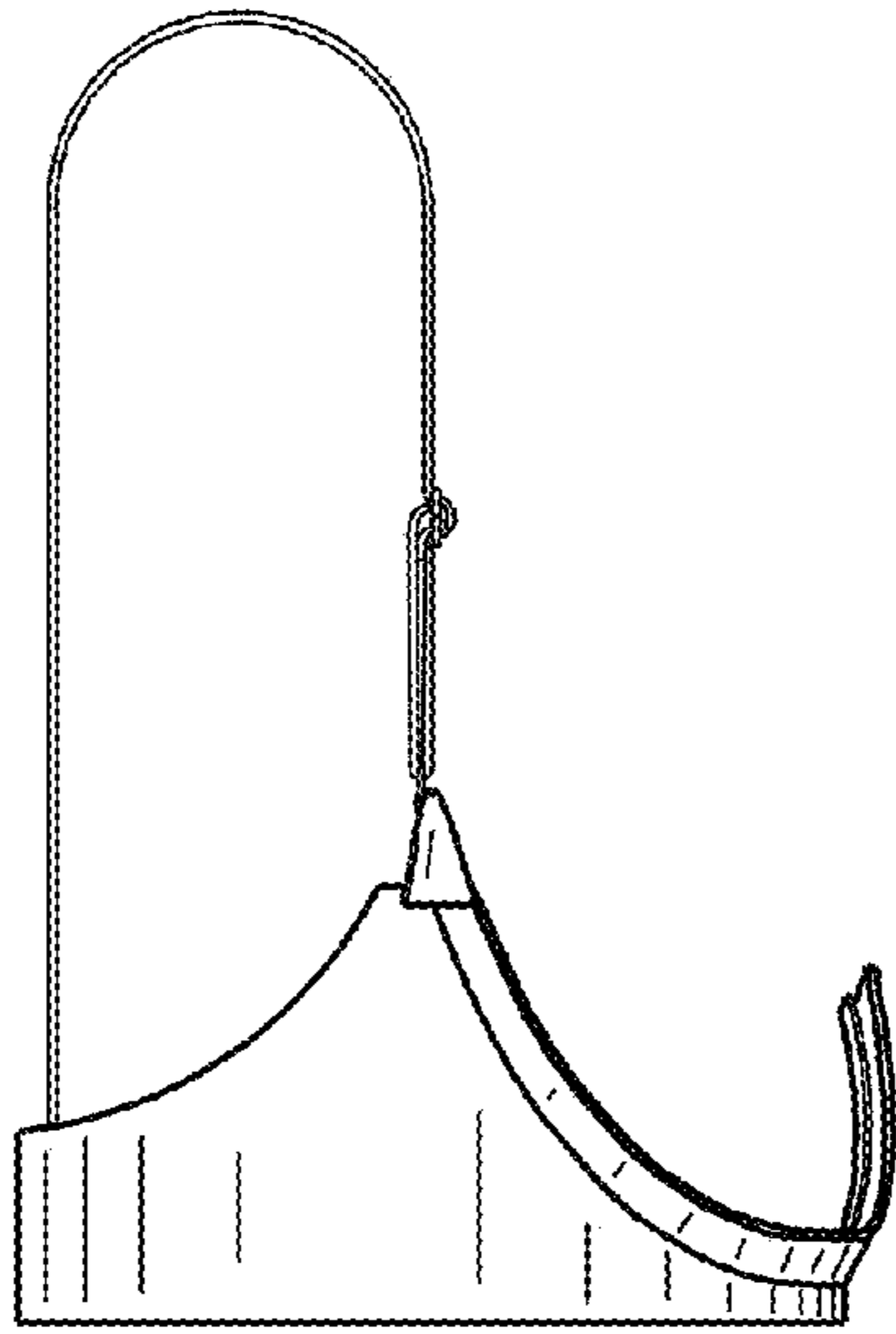

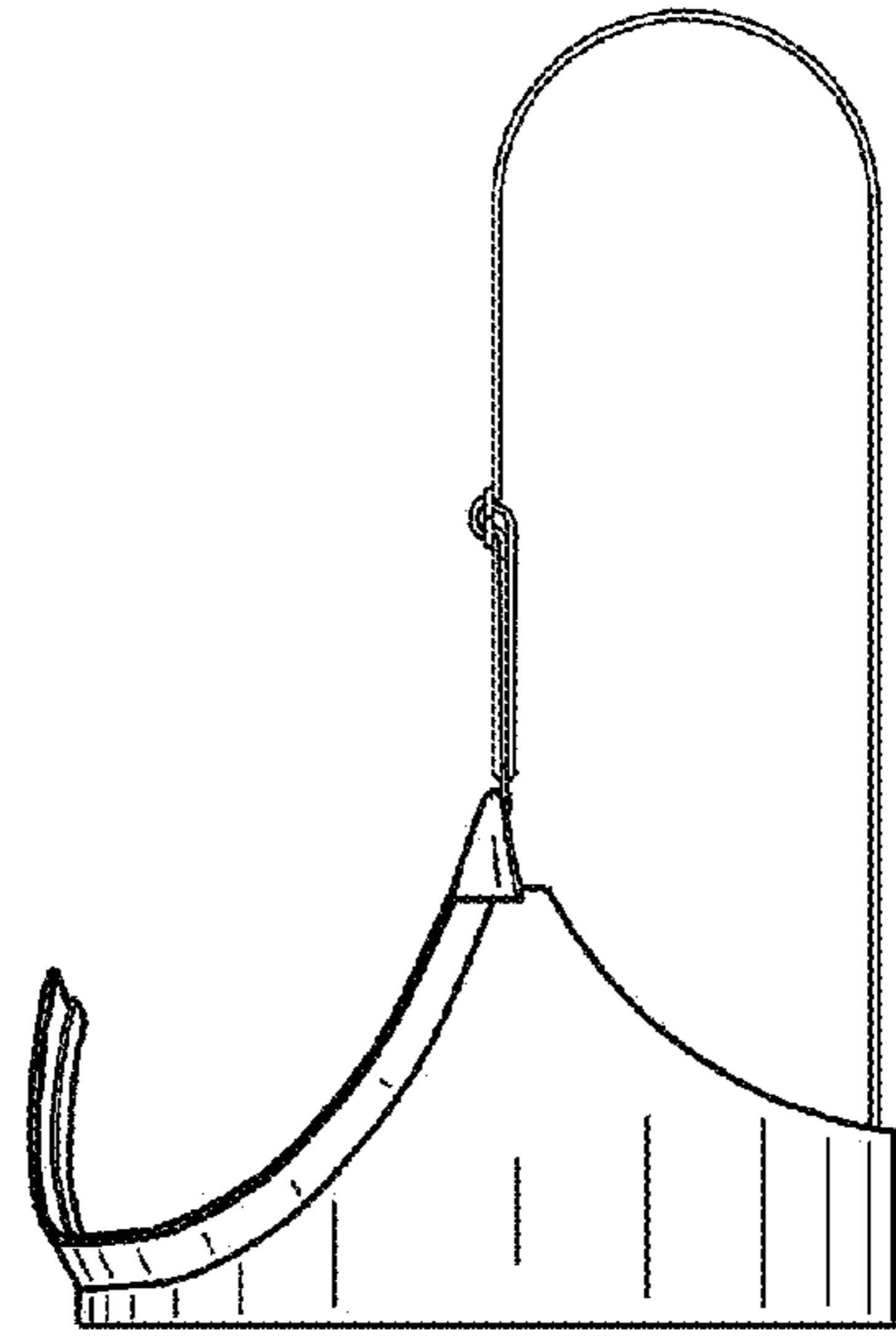

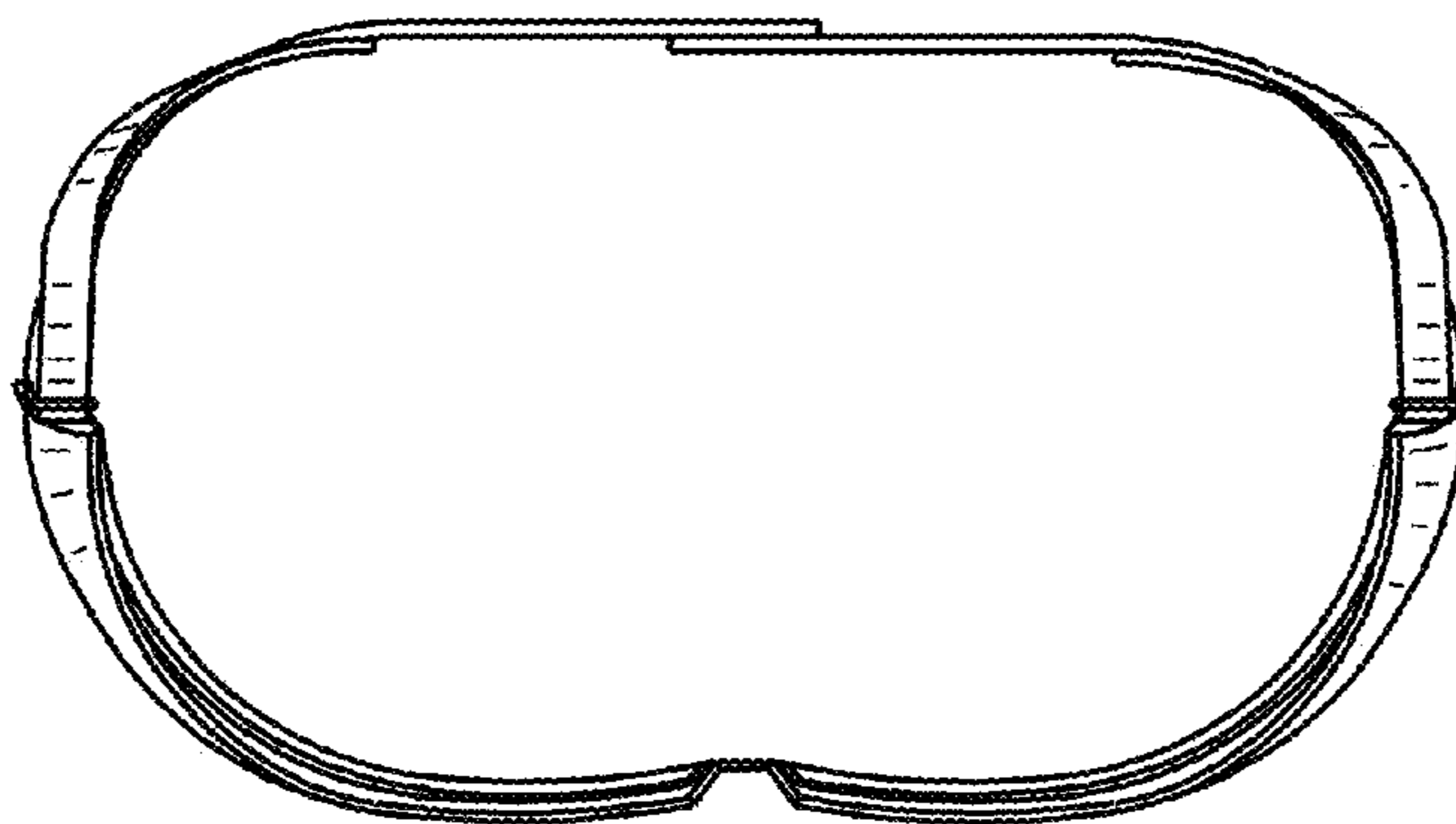

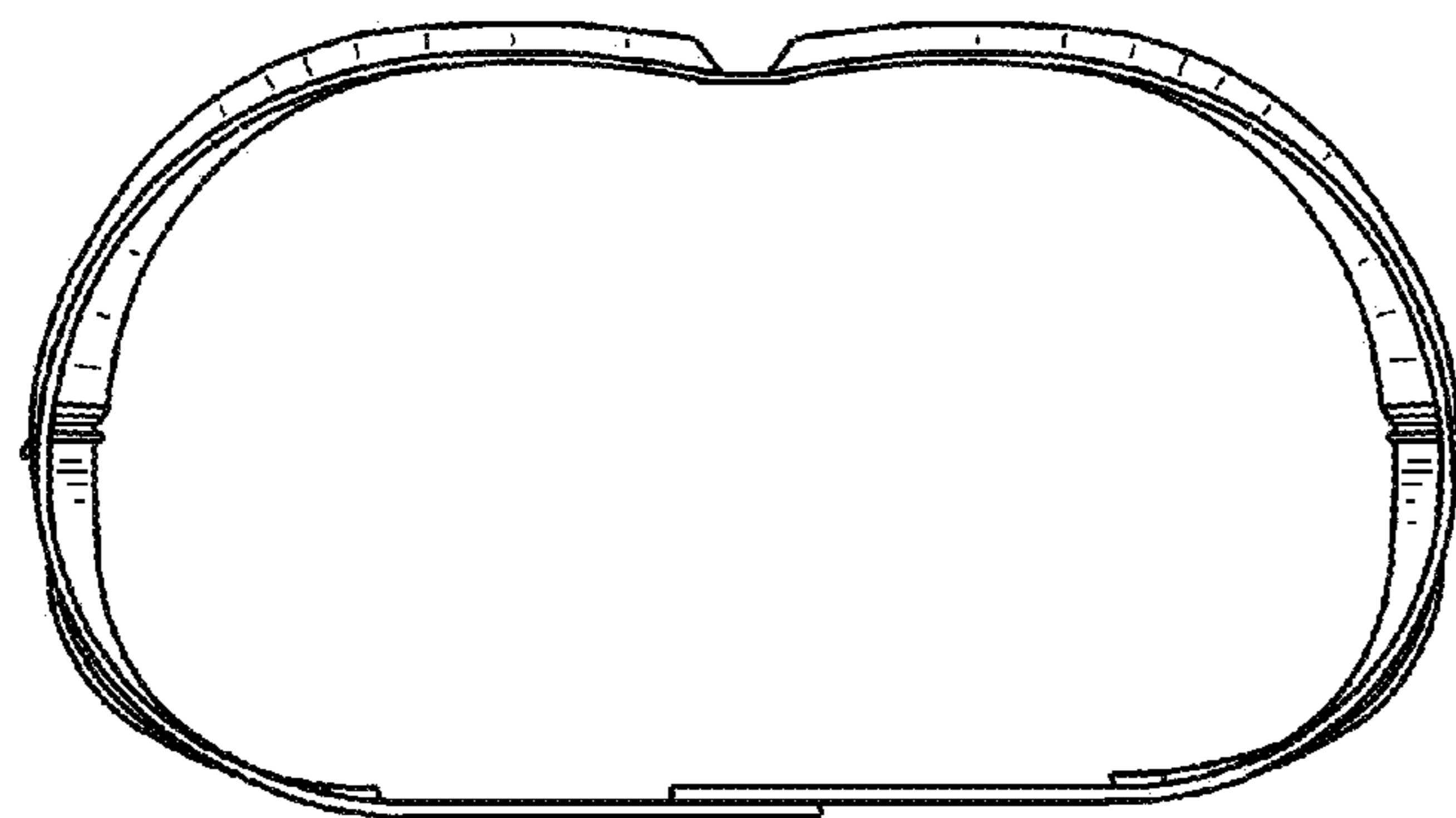
