FIG. 2. is an exploded view of the storage container, game flags, scoring pegs, playing cards, scoring and trump indicator board, and four individual trick organizing player boards for tracking card games in which the trump suit changes. FIG. 3. is a top plan view of the assembled parts secured with a strap.

FIG. **4**. is a top plan view of the scoring and trump indicator board.

FIG. 5. is a top plan view of the storage container with scoring pegs, game flags (1st, dealer, order up, and walk alone), and playing cards.

FIG. **6**. is a front elevational view of the storage container, scoring and trump indicator board and the four individual trick organizing player boards stacked and secured with a strap.

FIG. 7. is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 8. is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 9. is a left side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 10. is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. **11**. is a perspective view of the scoring and trump indicator board; and,
