DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a bracelet; showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the bracelet of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the bracelet of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the bracelet of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a front view of a second embodiment of a bracelet
which is identical to the first embodiment except the tether
feature is unclaimed. The broken lines showing a tether
between the cap and body represent portions of the bracelet
which form no part of the claimed design.

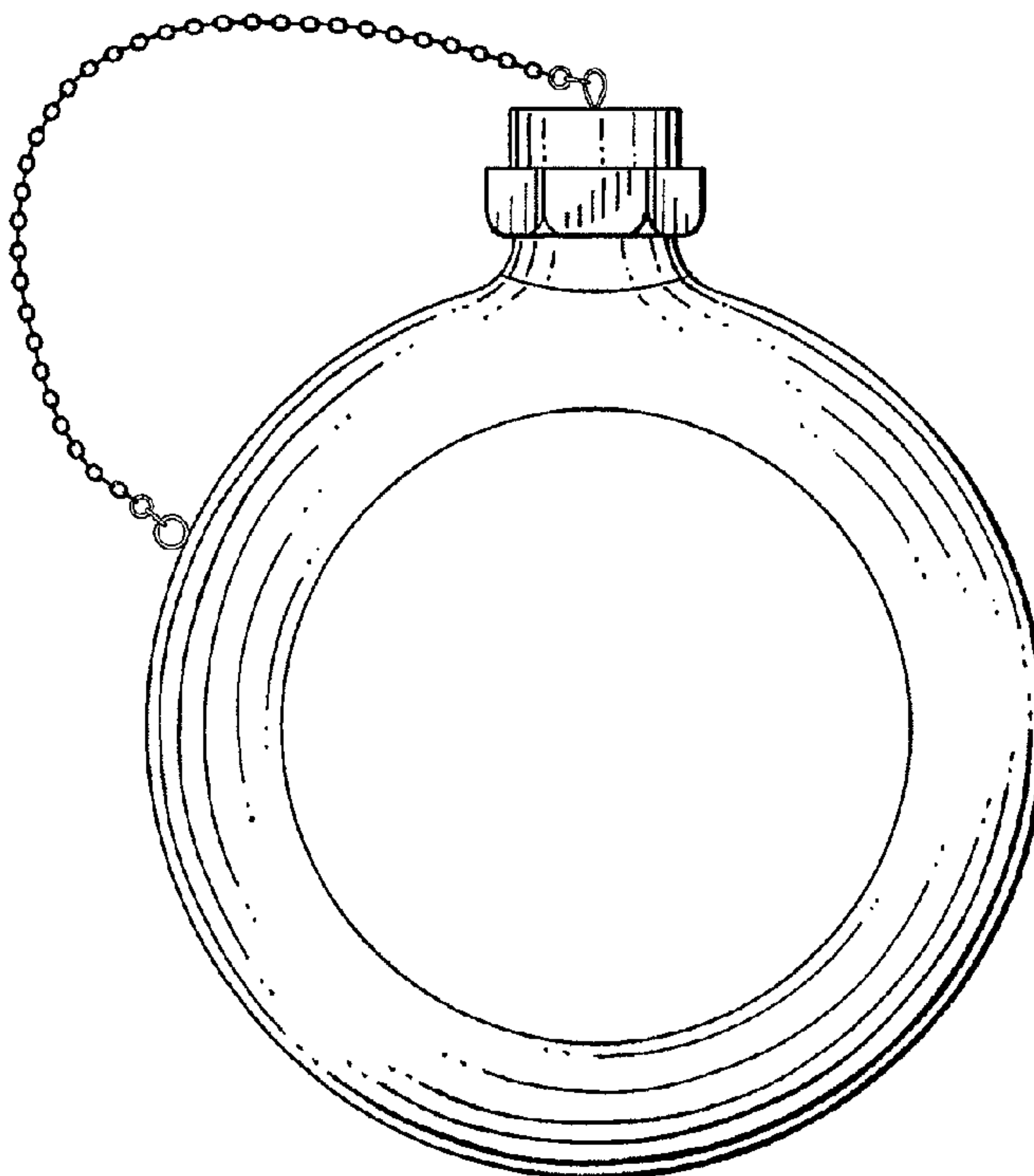

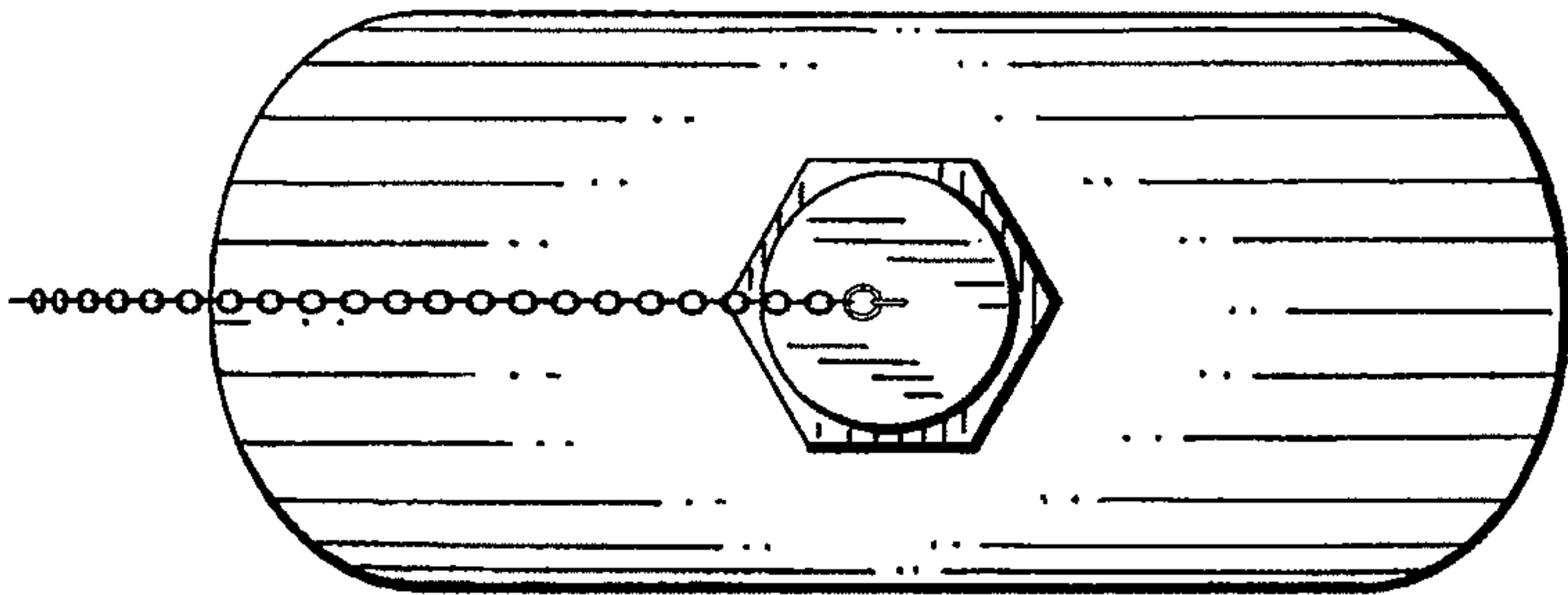

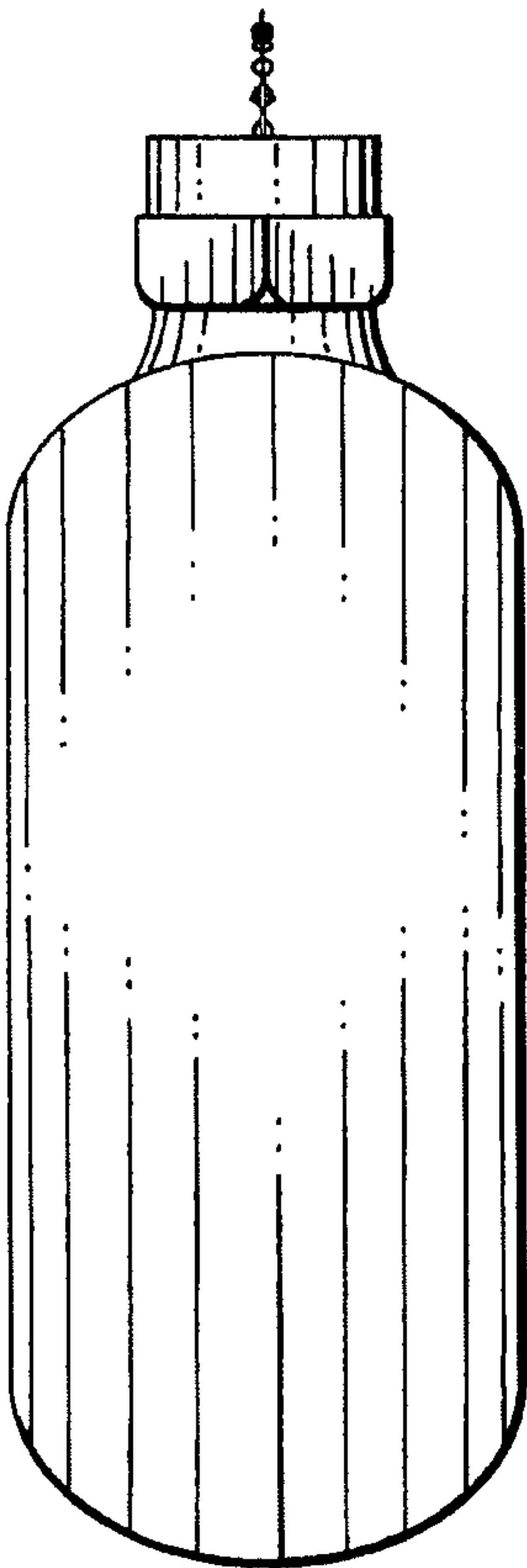

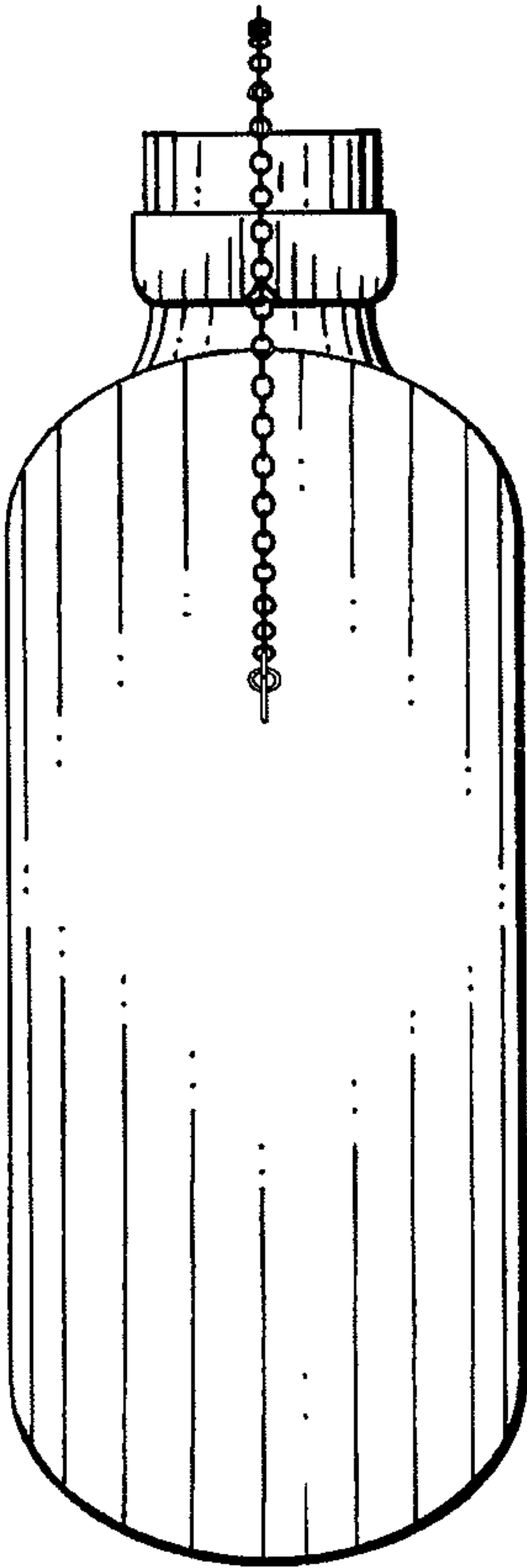

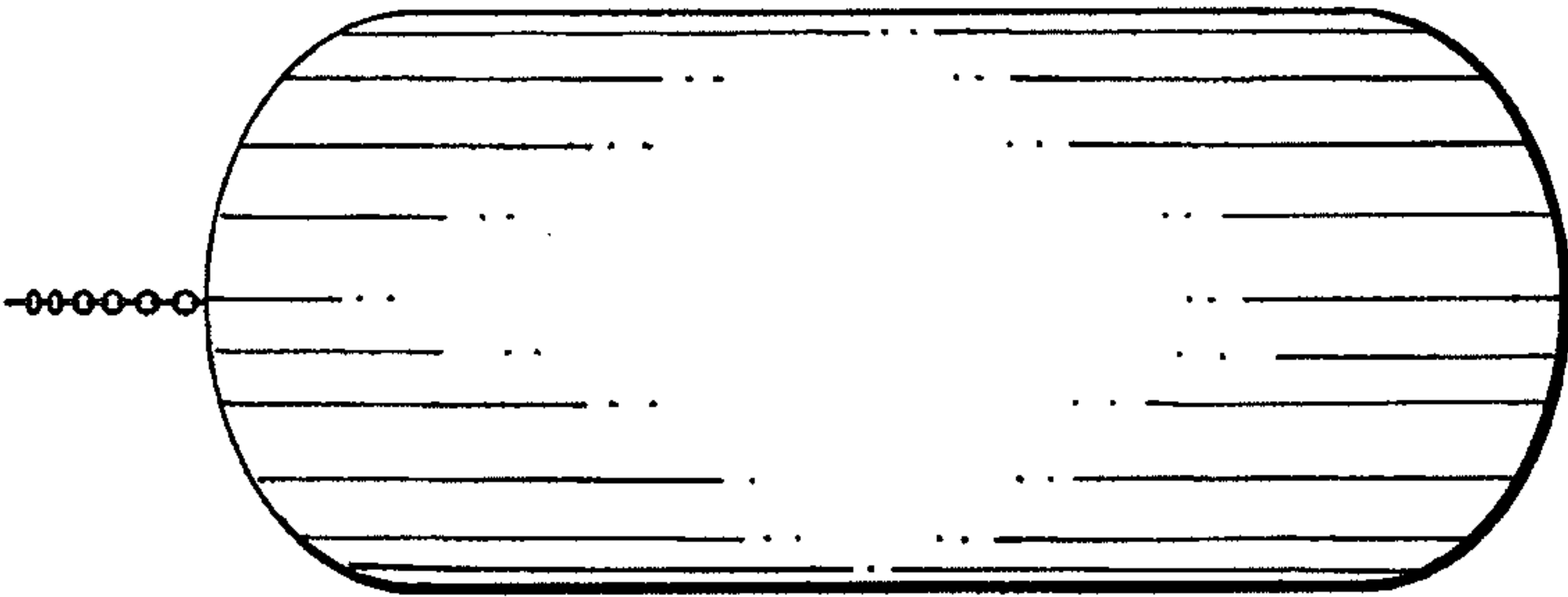
