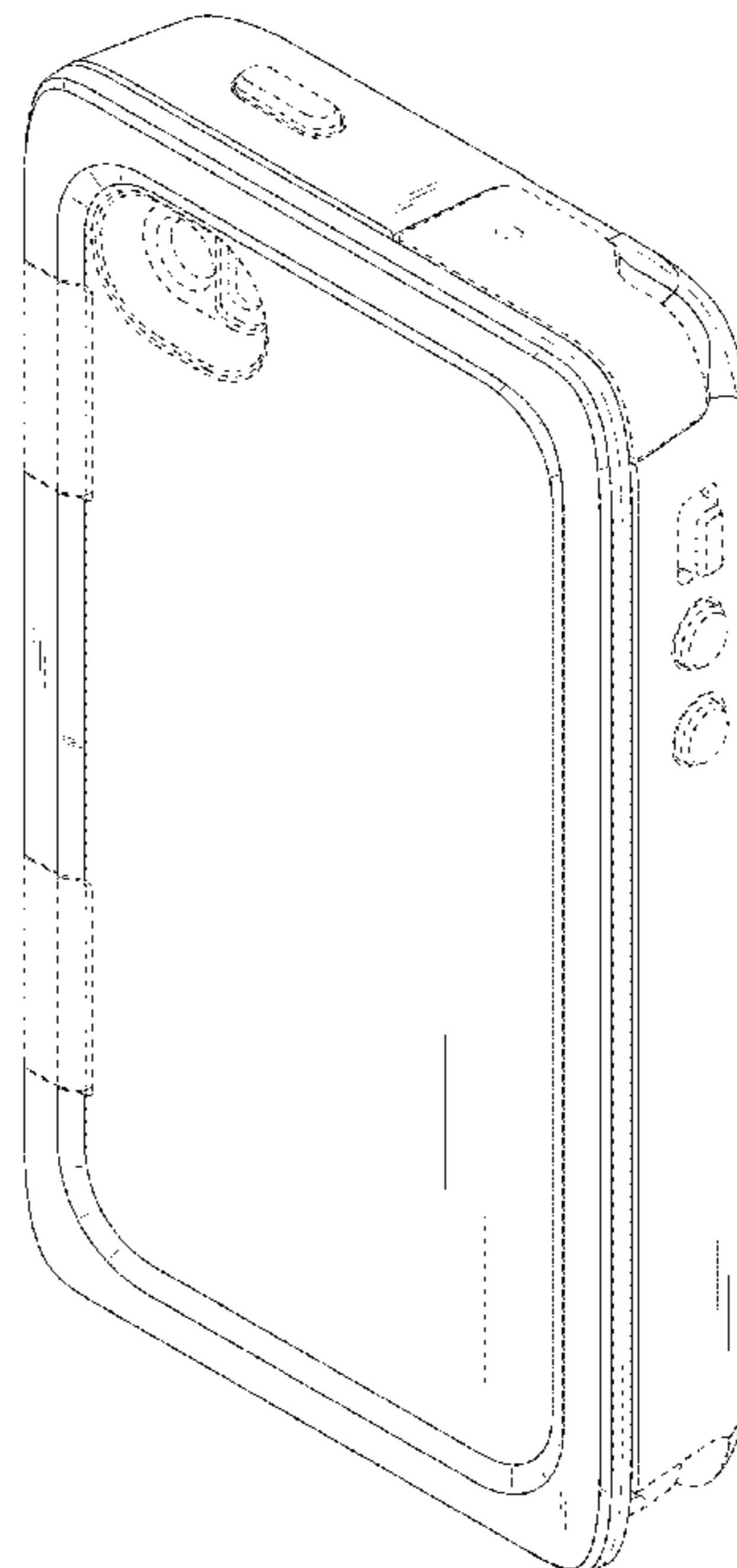
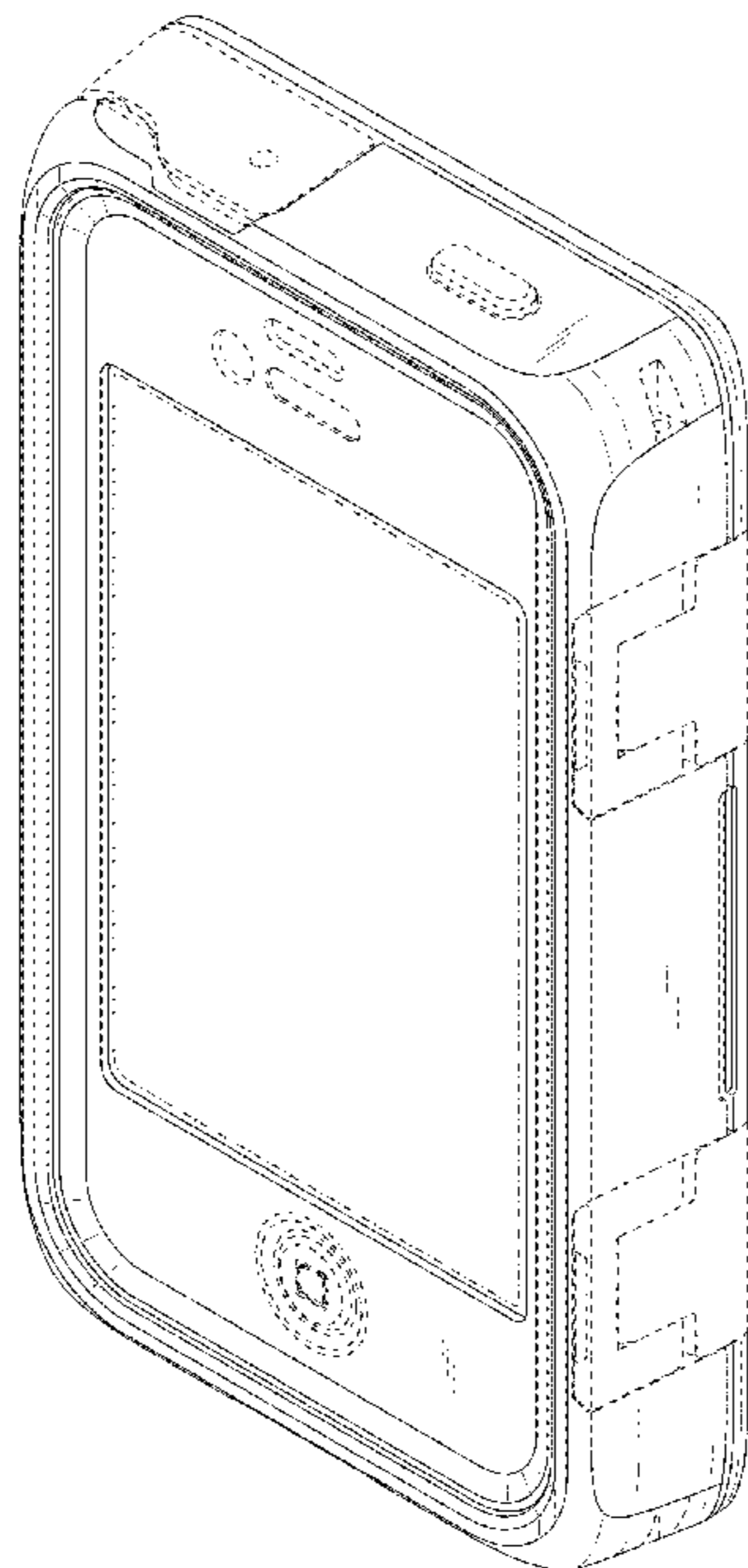
The ornamental design for a case for electronic device, as shown and described.

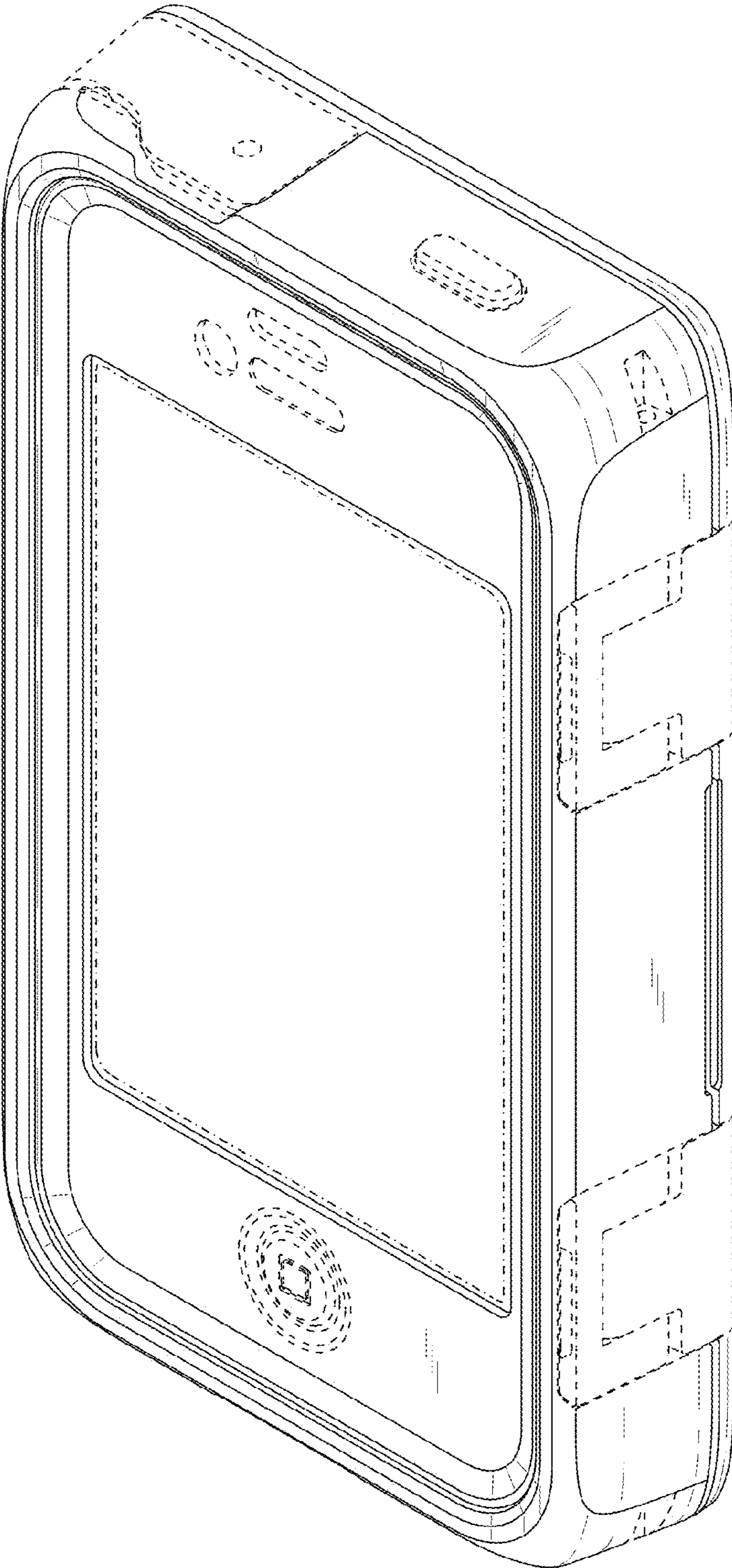

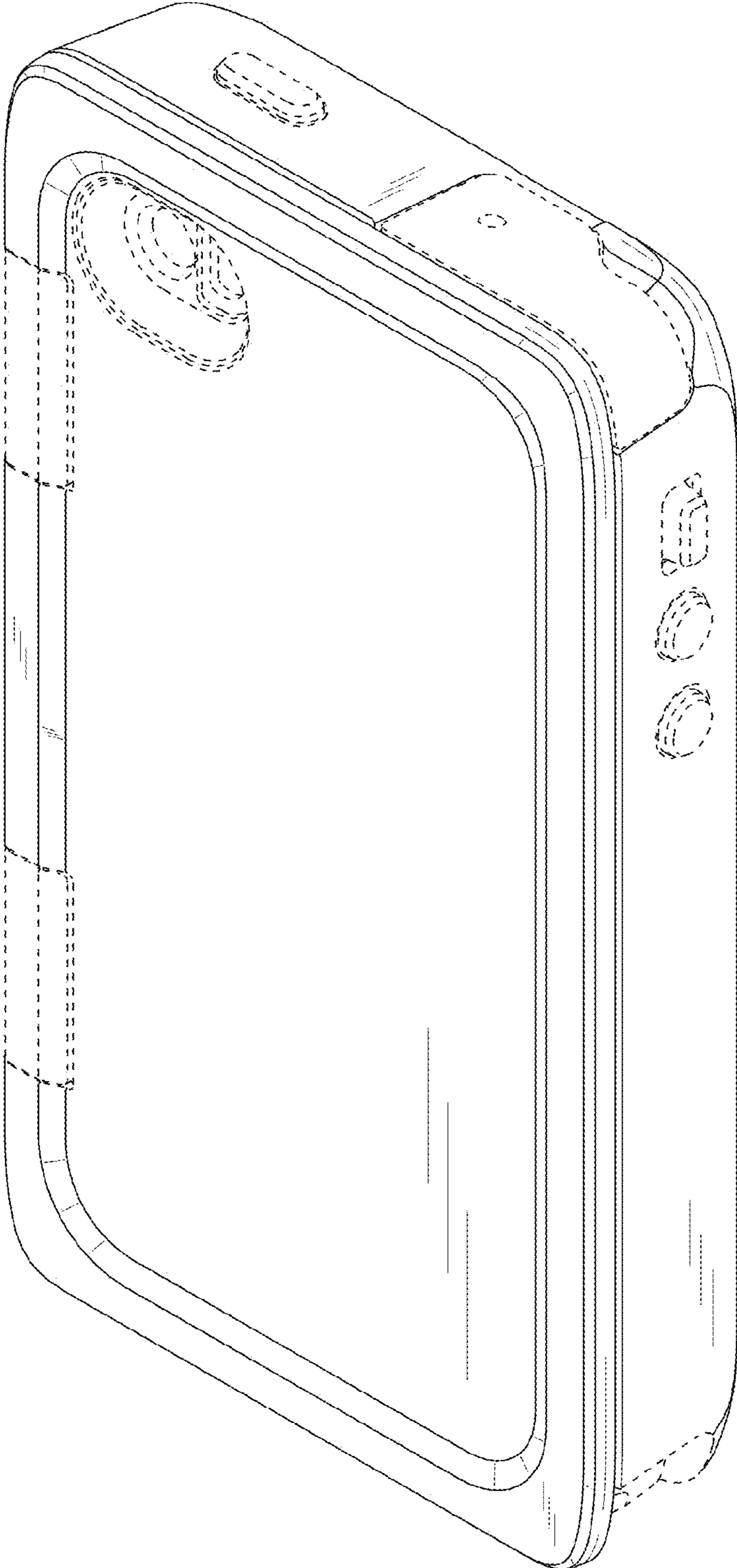

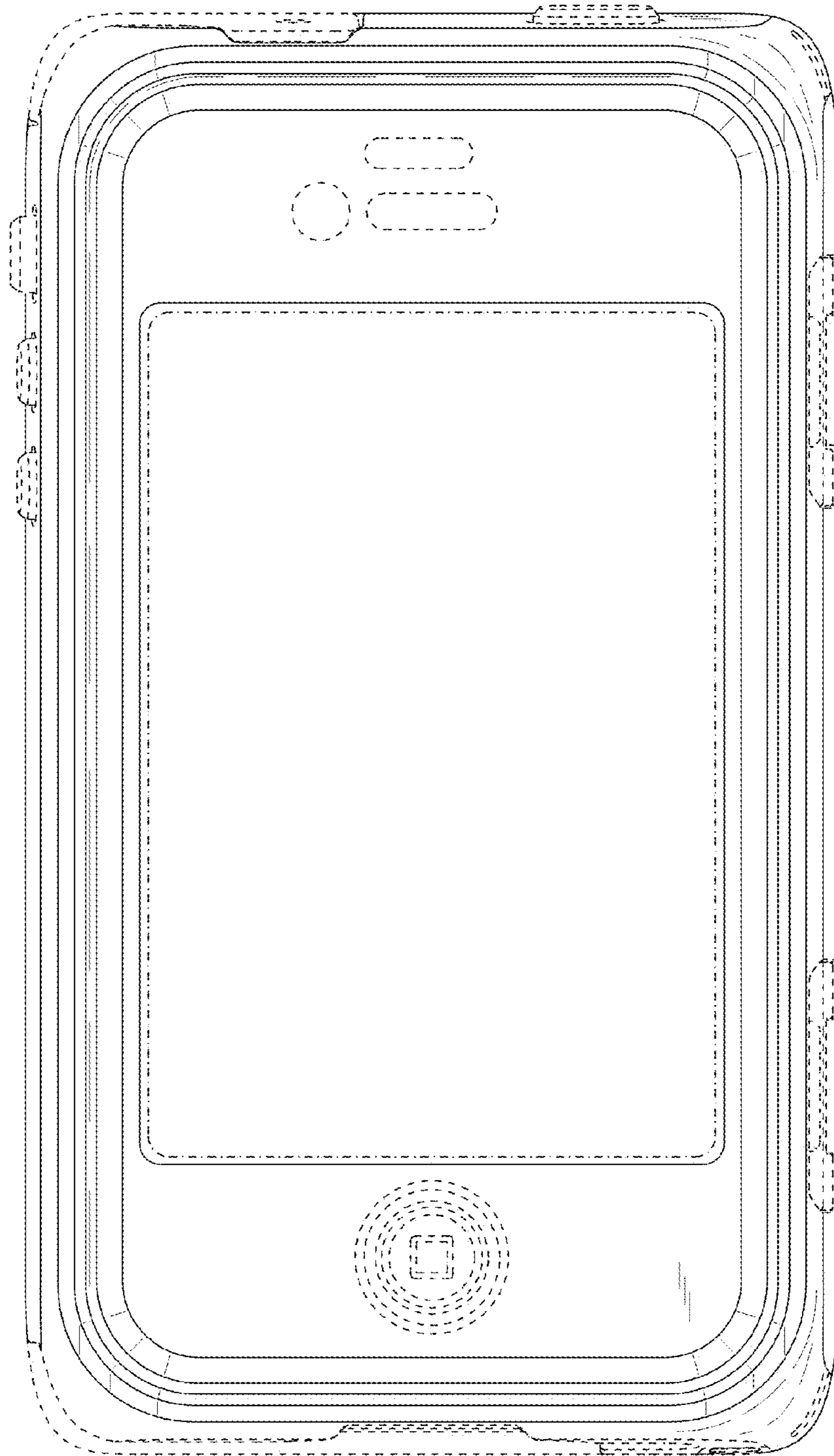

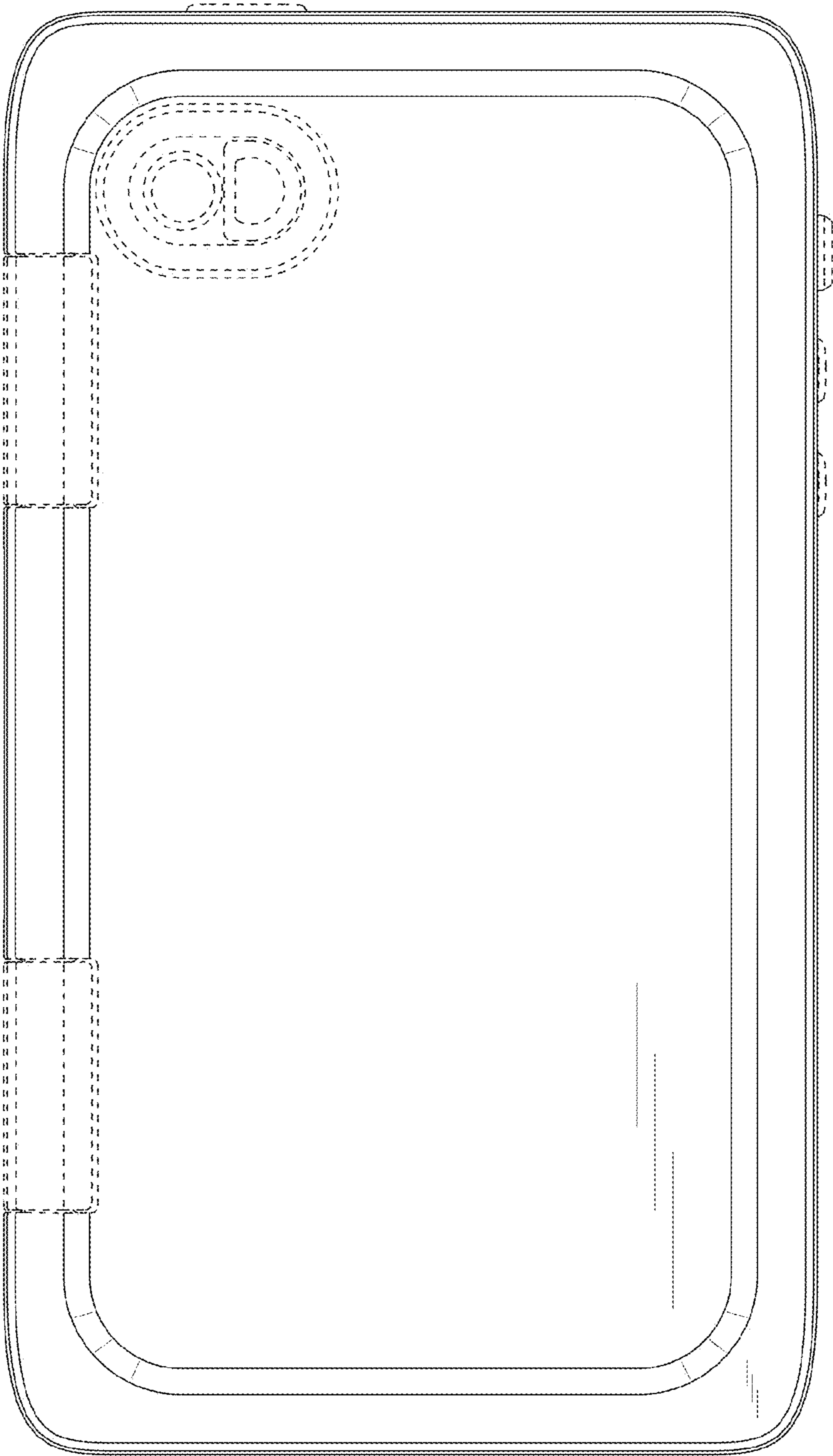

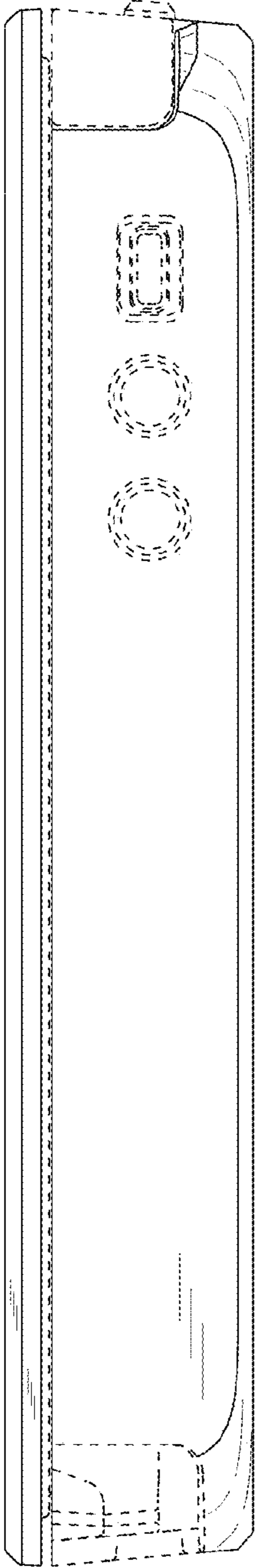

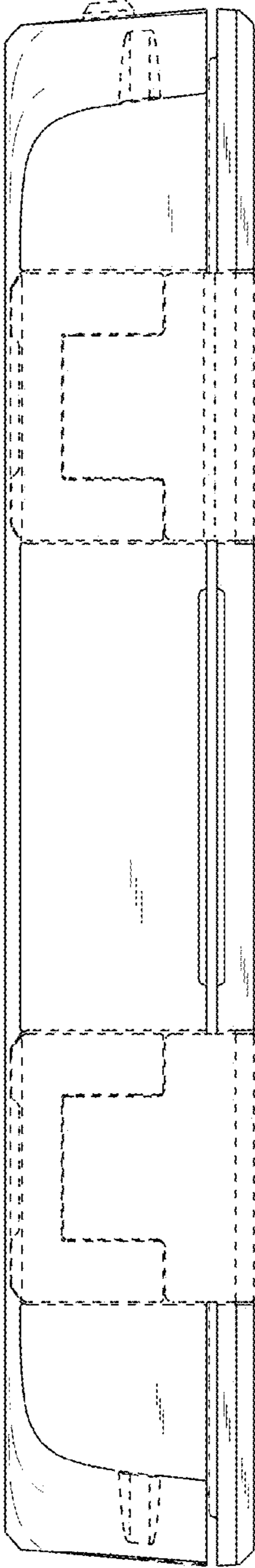

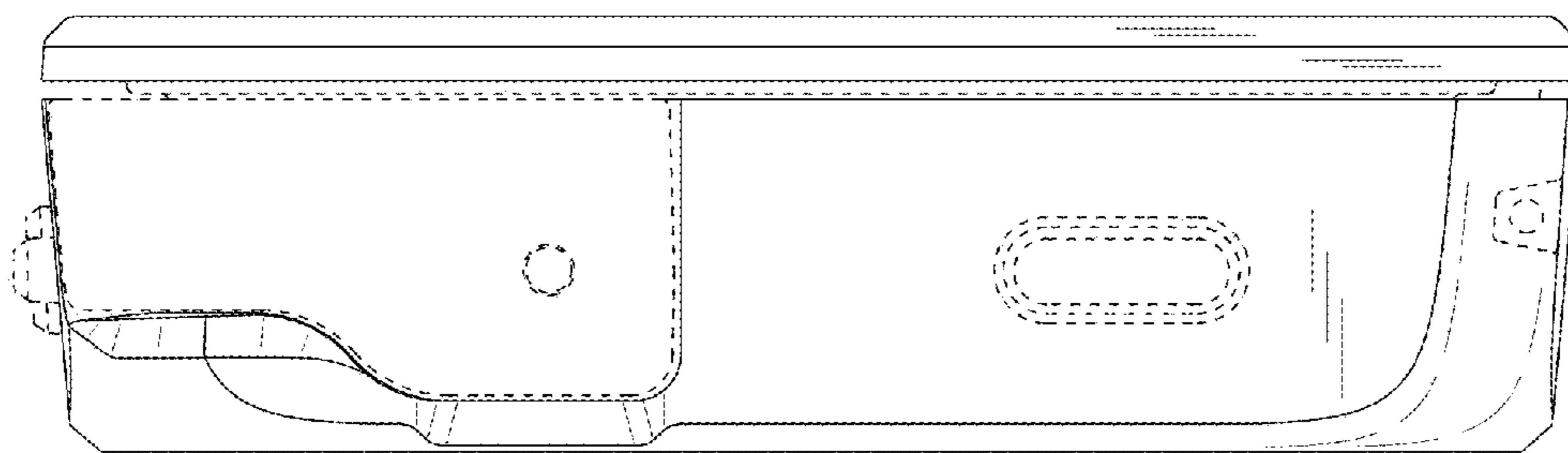

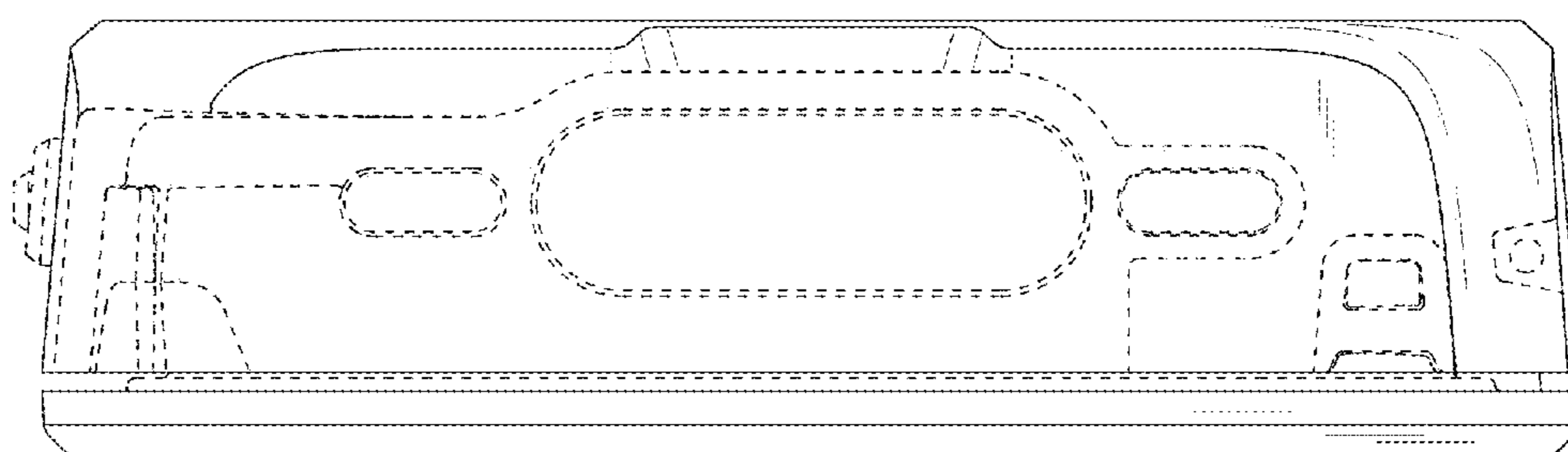
