(57) **CLAIM**


The ornamental design for a digital user interface screen with scan-to-software application icon, as shown and described.


**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a digital user interface screen with scan-to-software application icon in accordance with the present invention; and,


FIG. 2 is an enlarged front view of area 2 circumscribed within FIG. 1.
