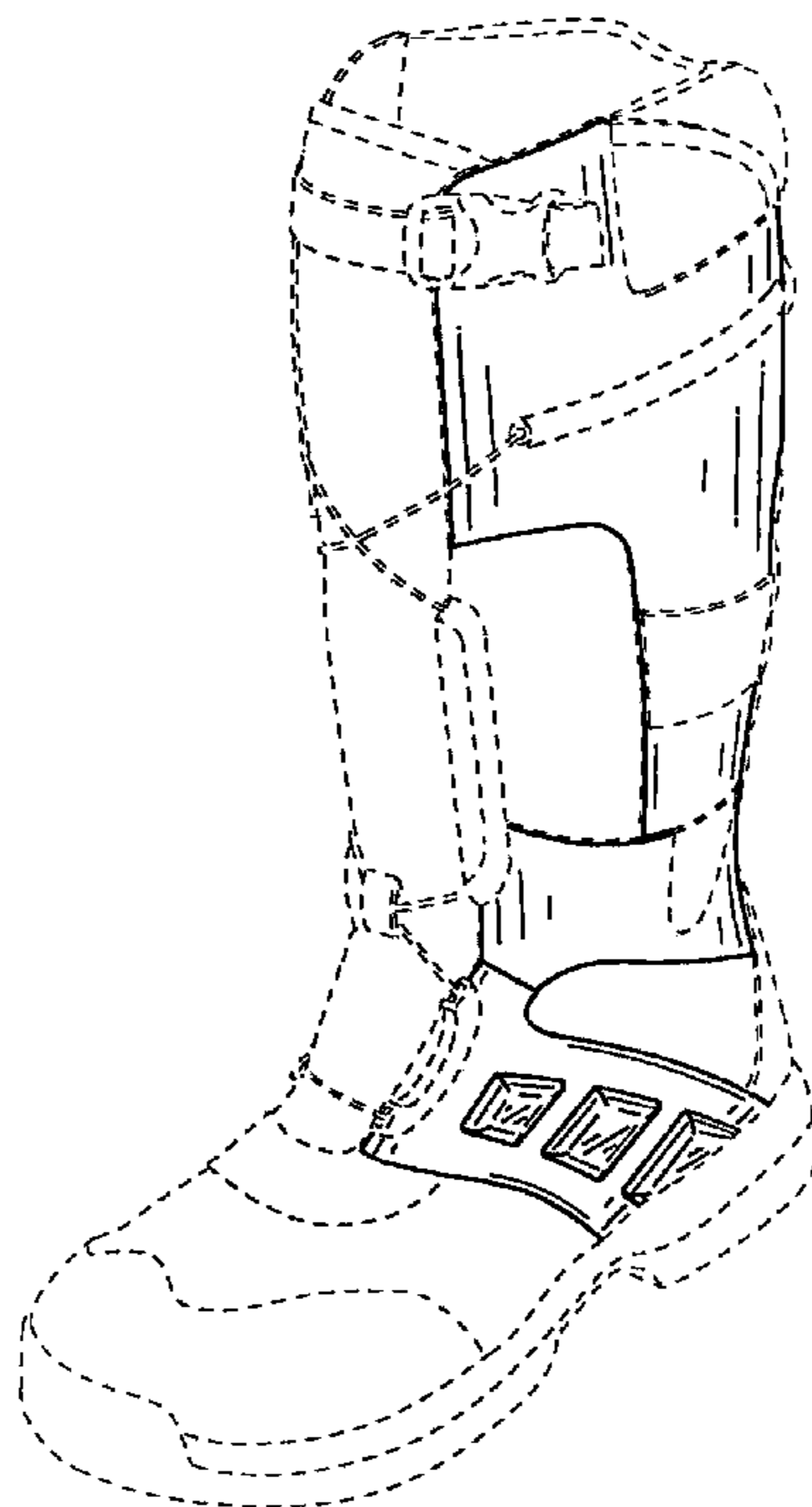
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The broken line representations in the figures show unclaimed environment or boundaries, and thus form no part of the claimed design.

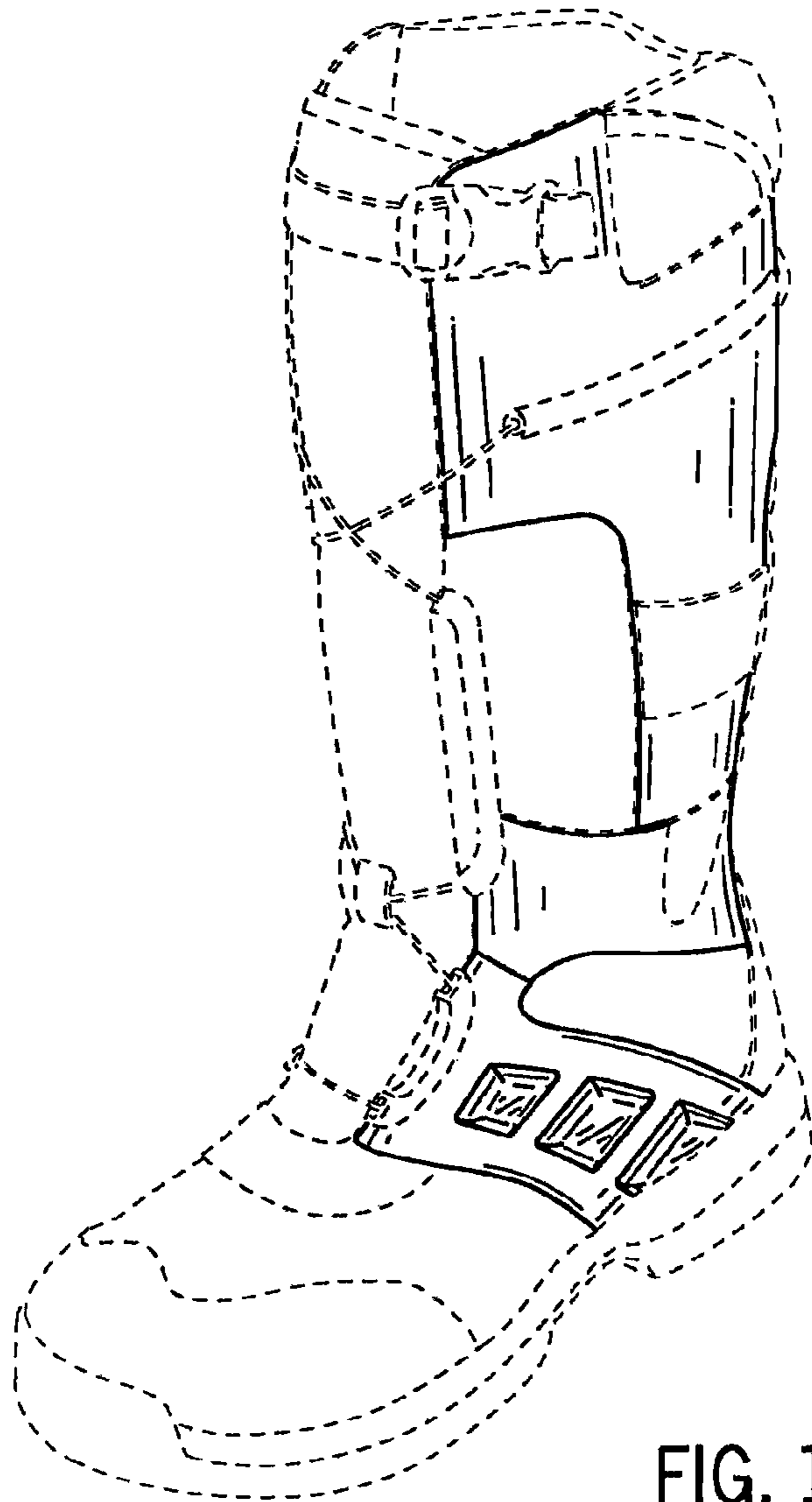

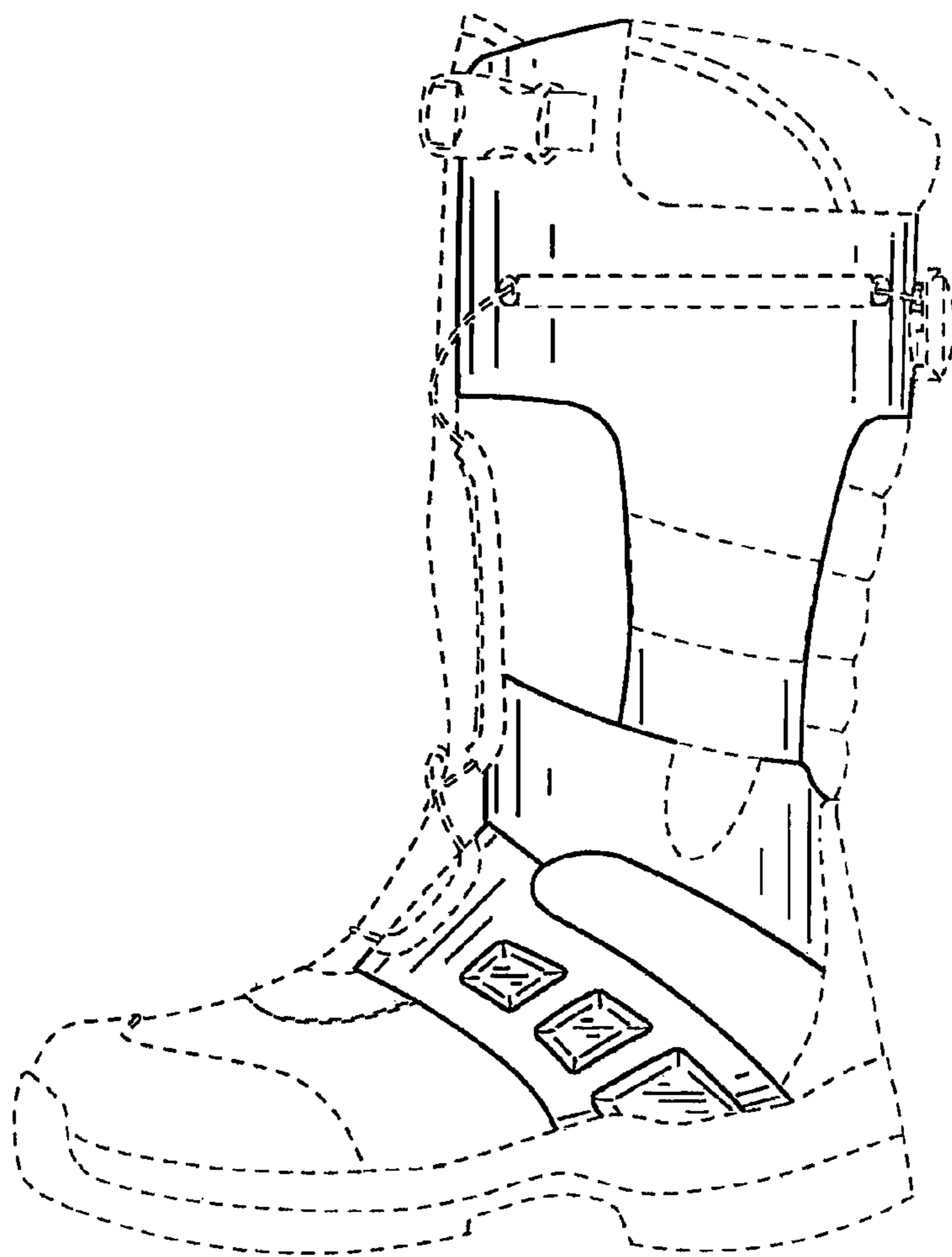

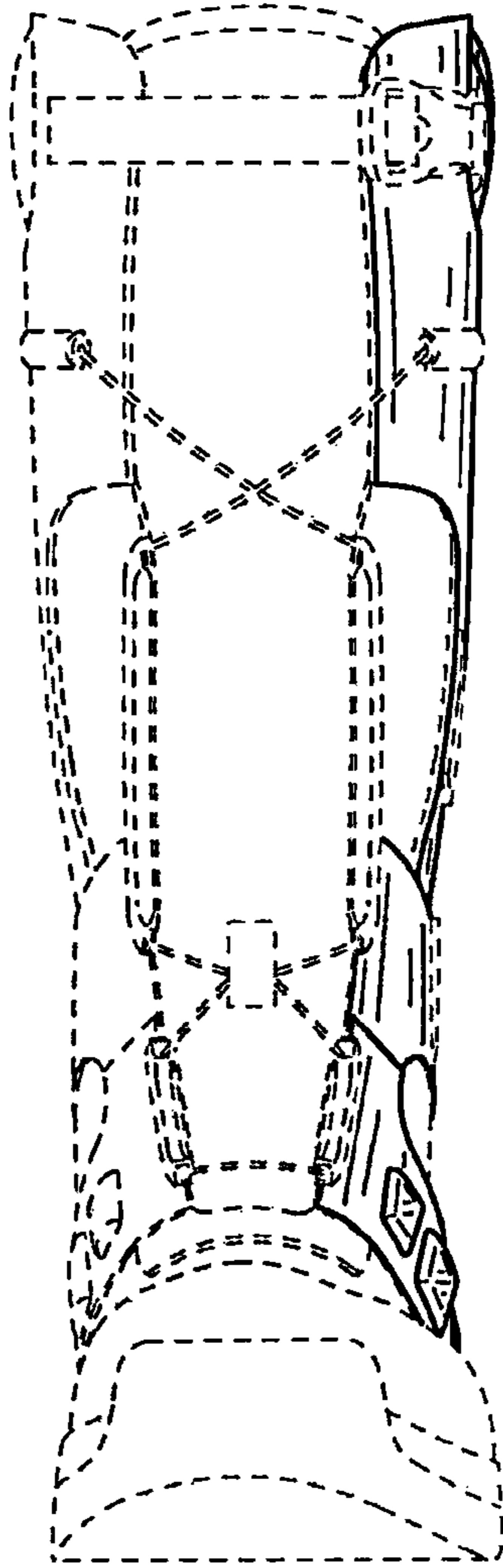

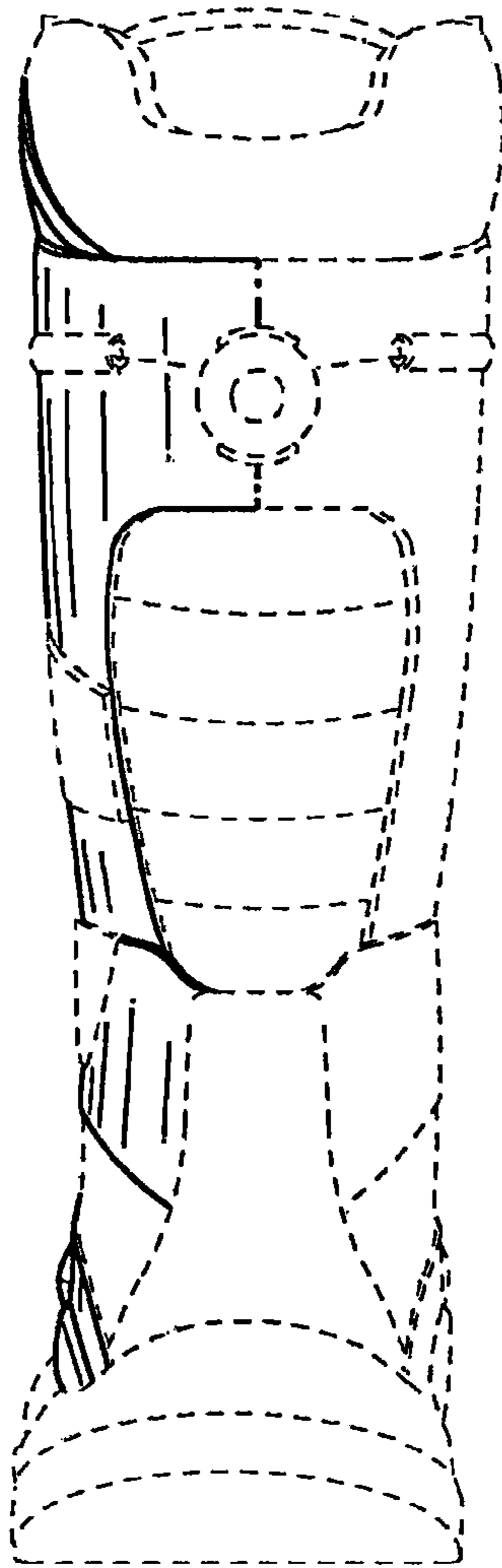

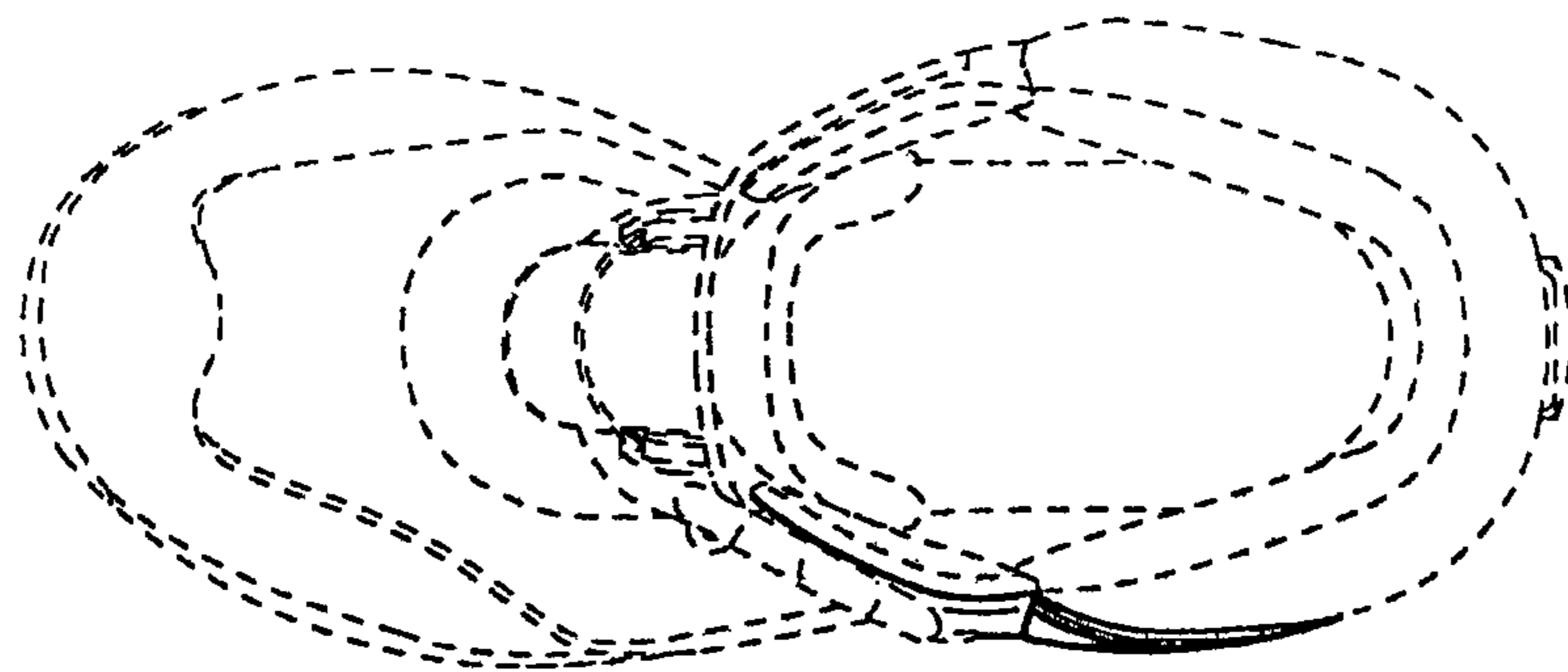

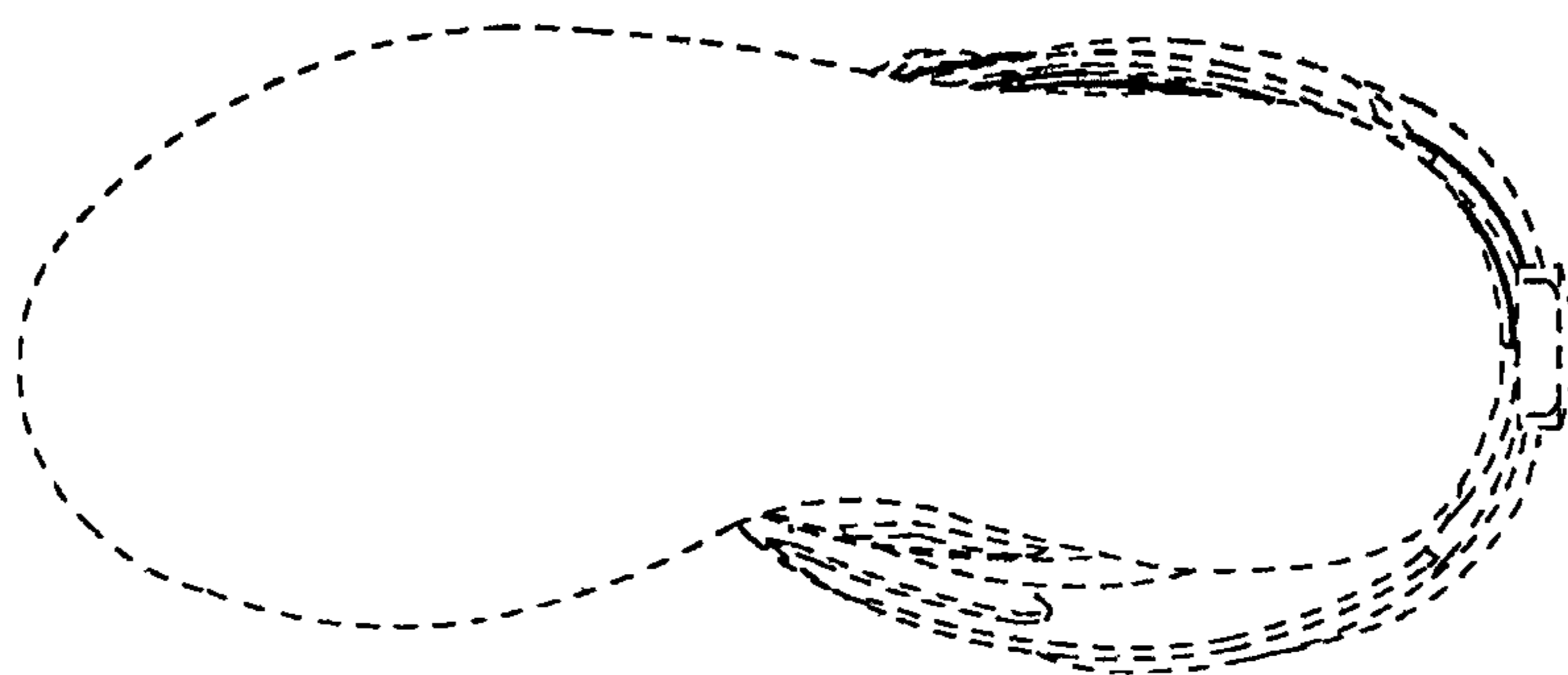

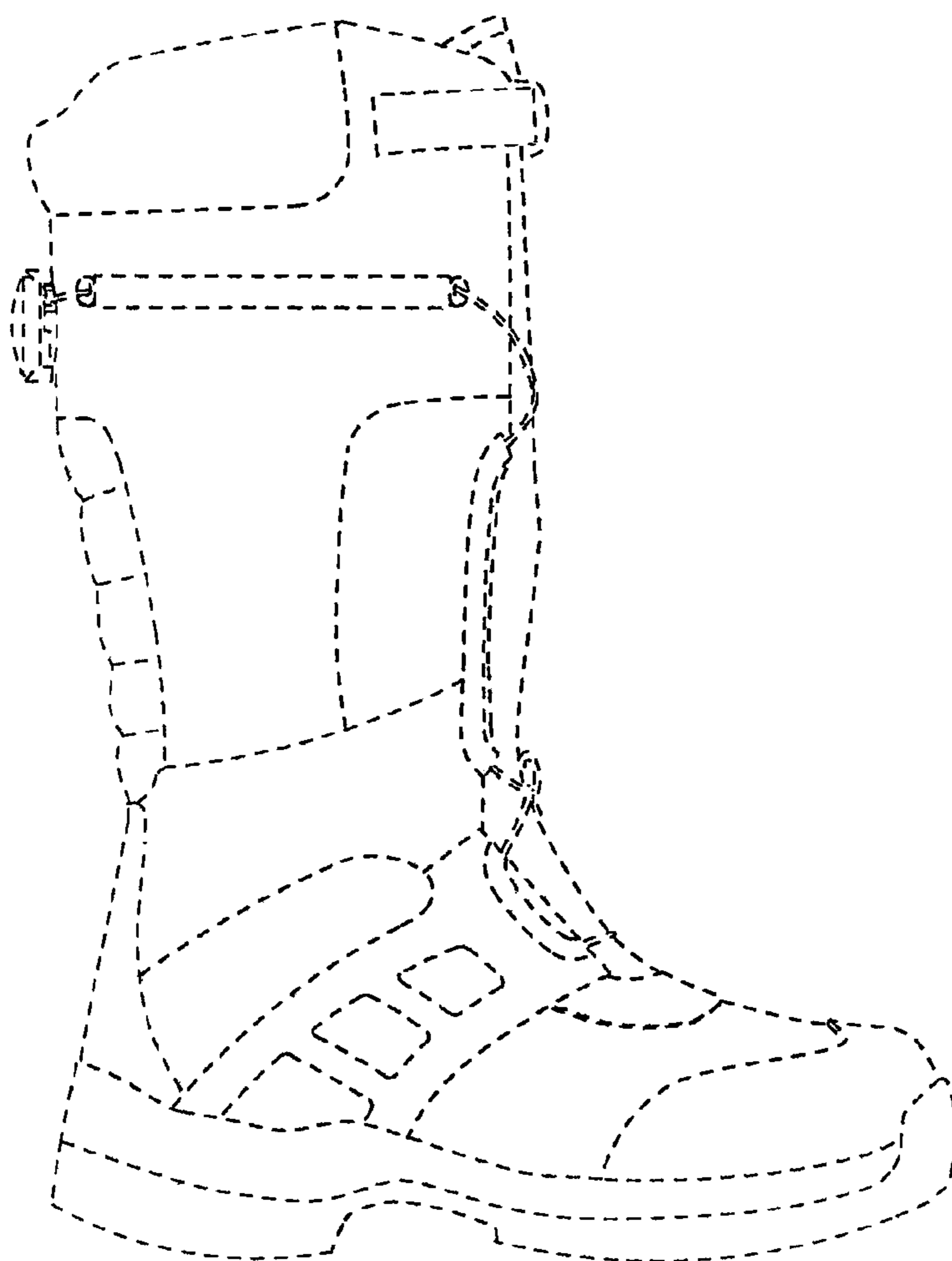
