DESCRIPTION

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2;

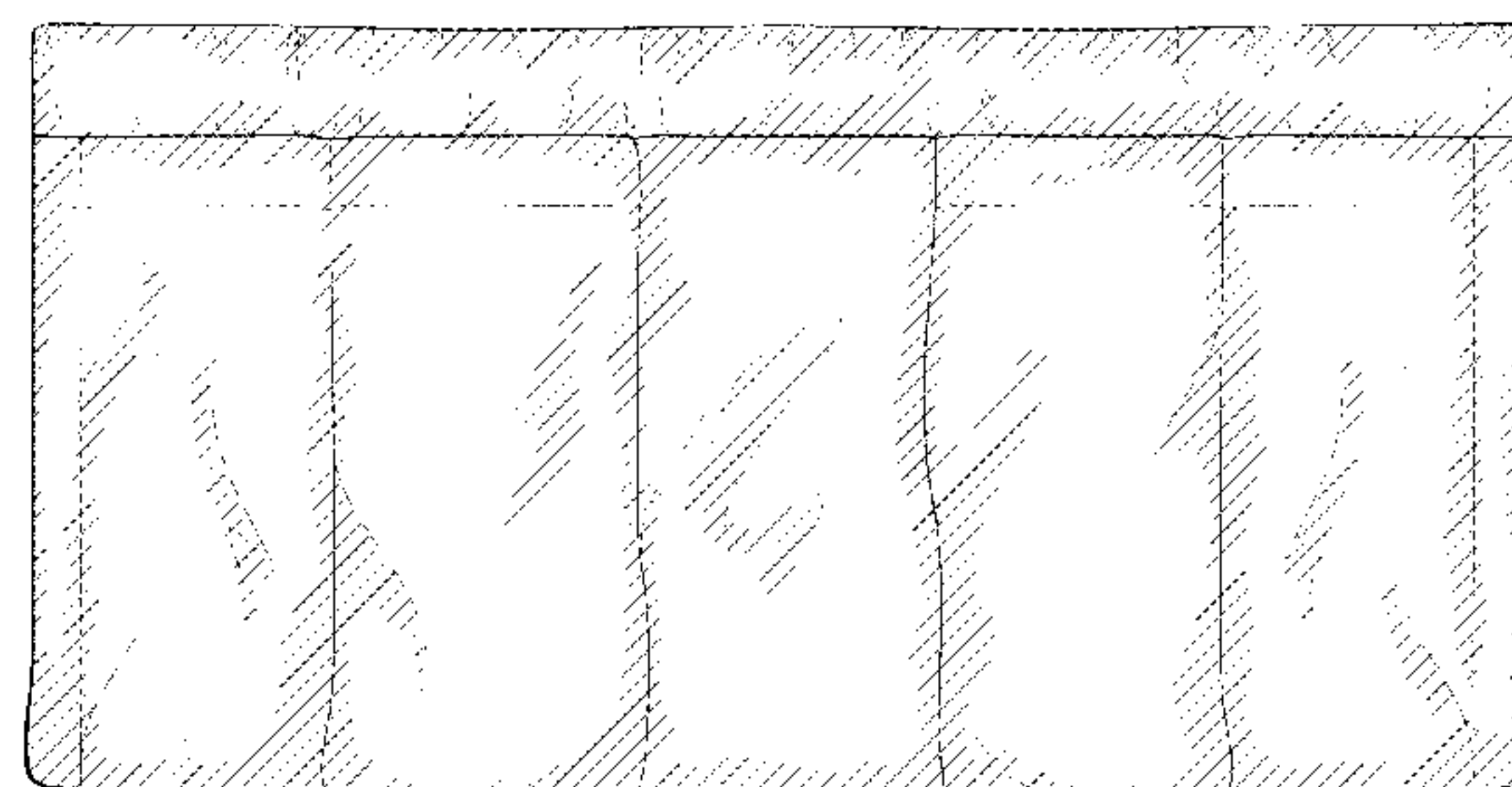
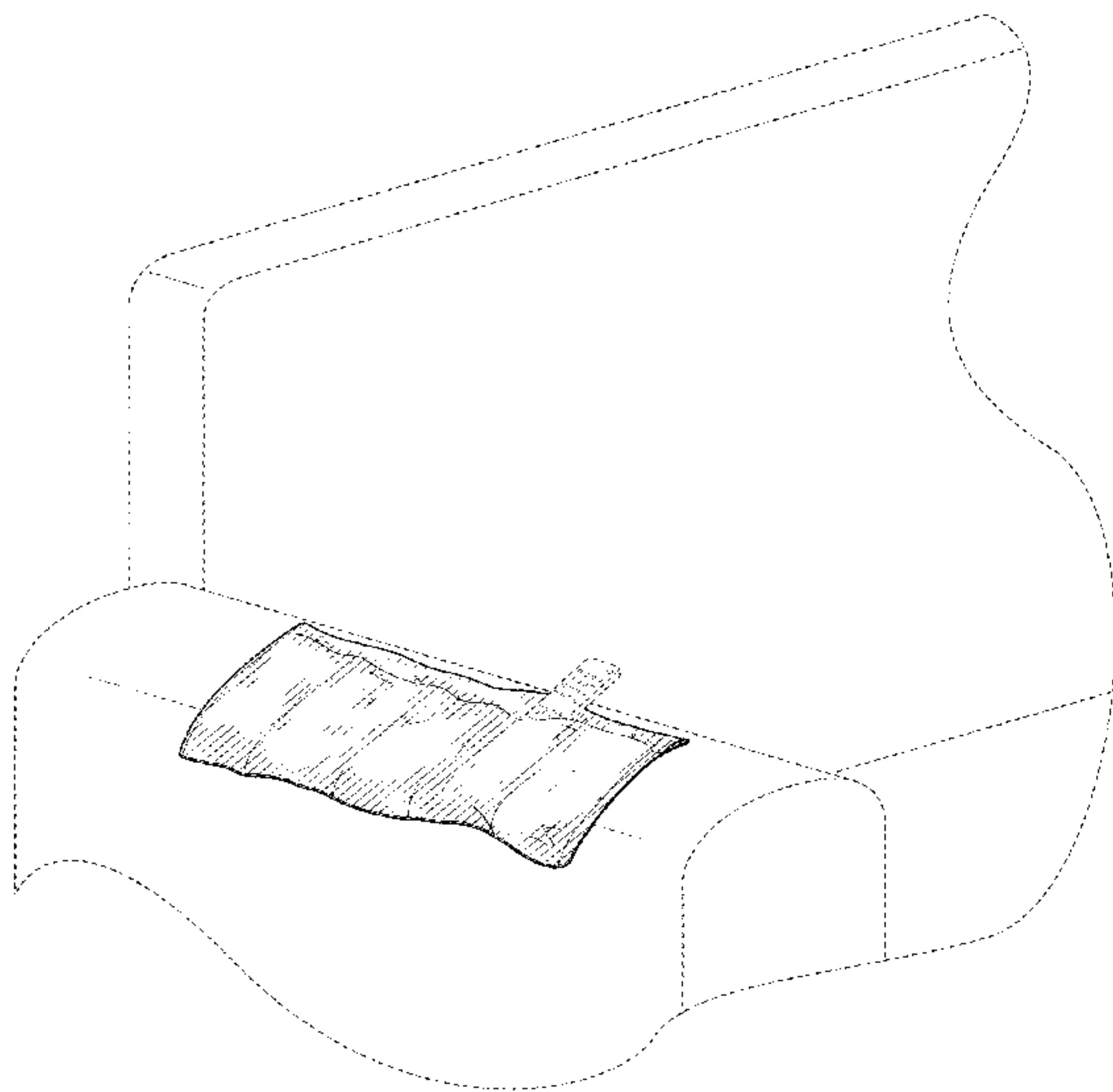
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 2, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

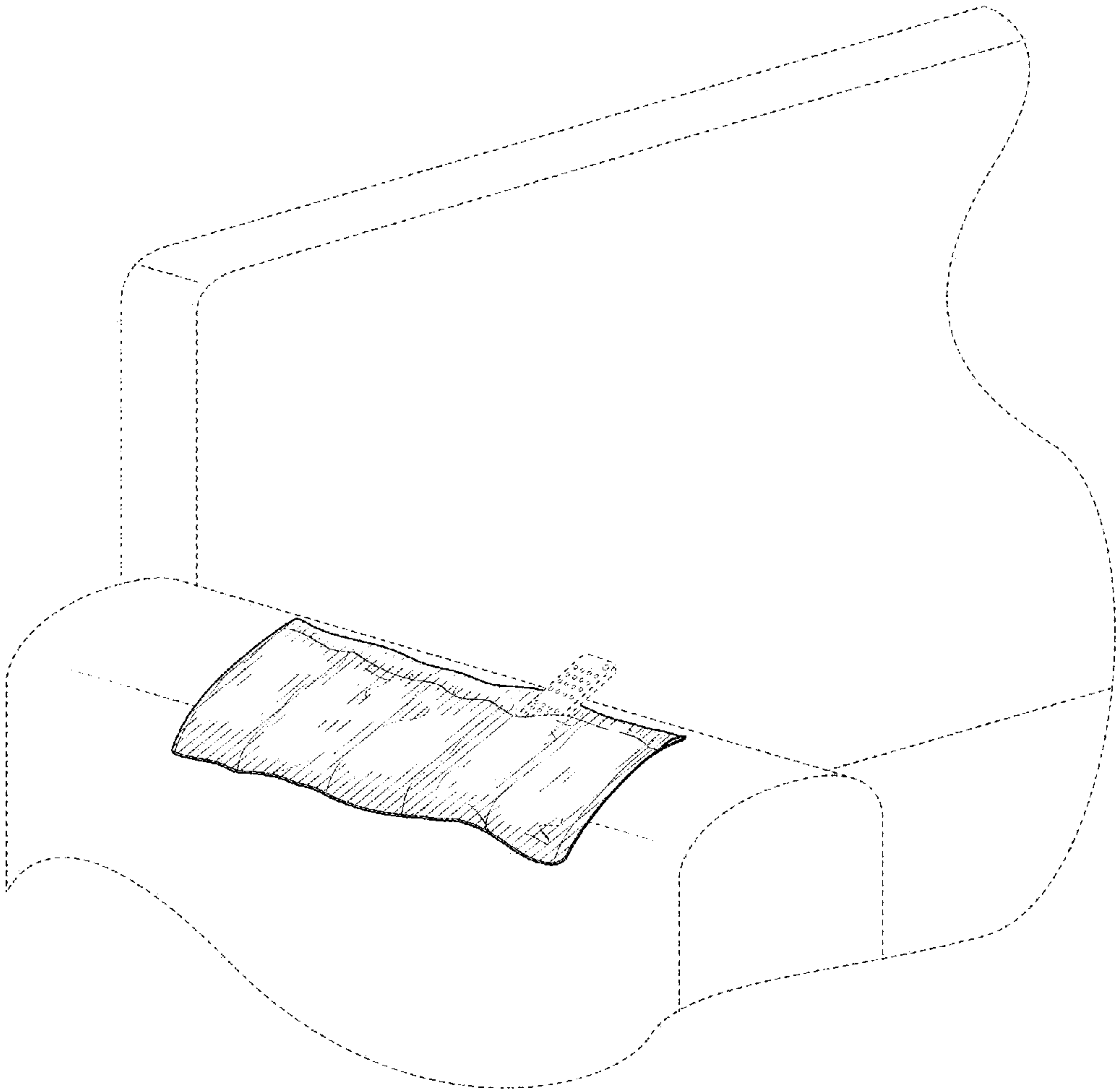

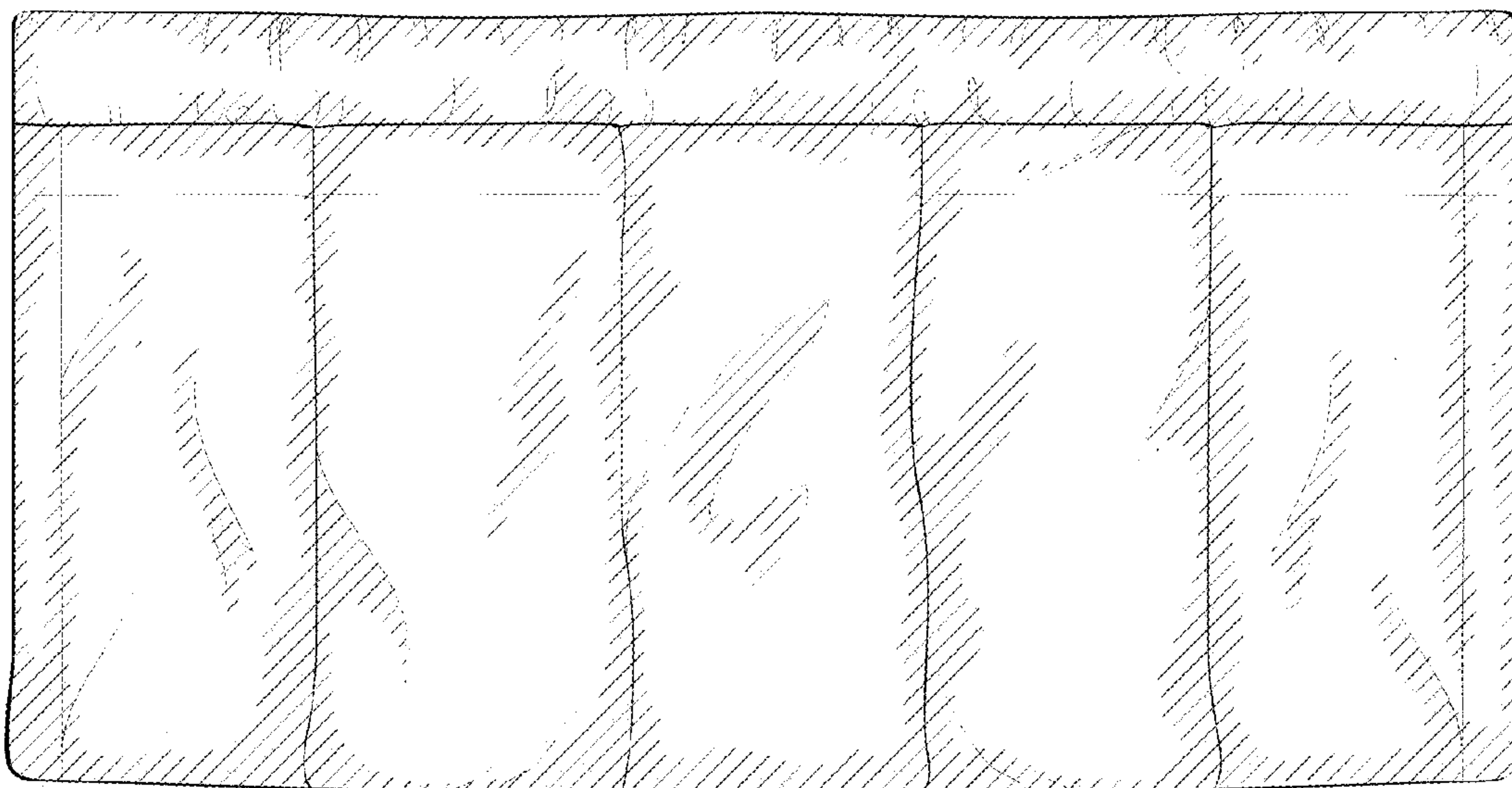

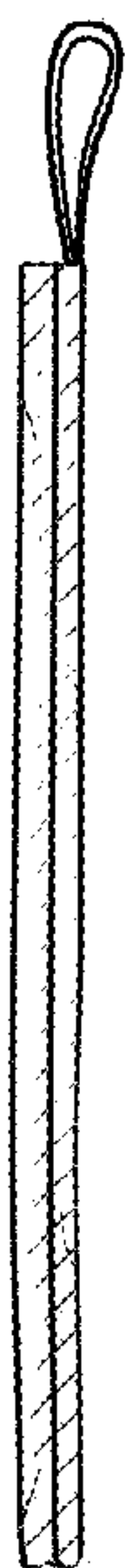

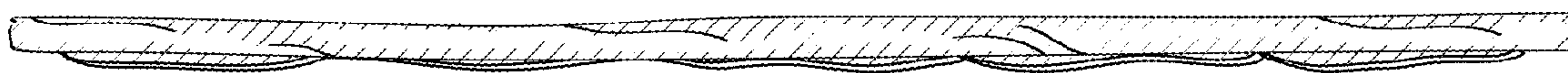

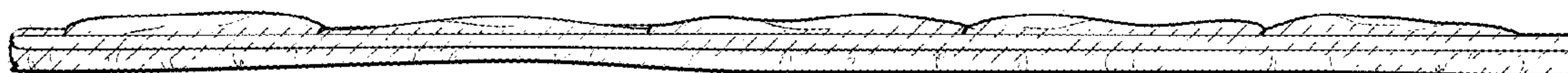
