(57) **CLAIM**

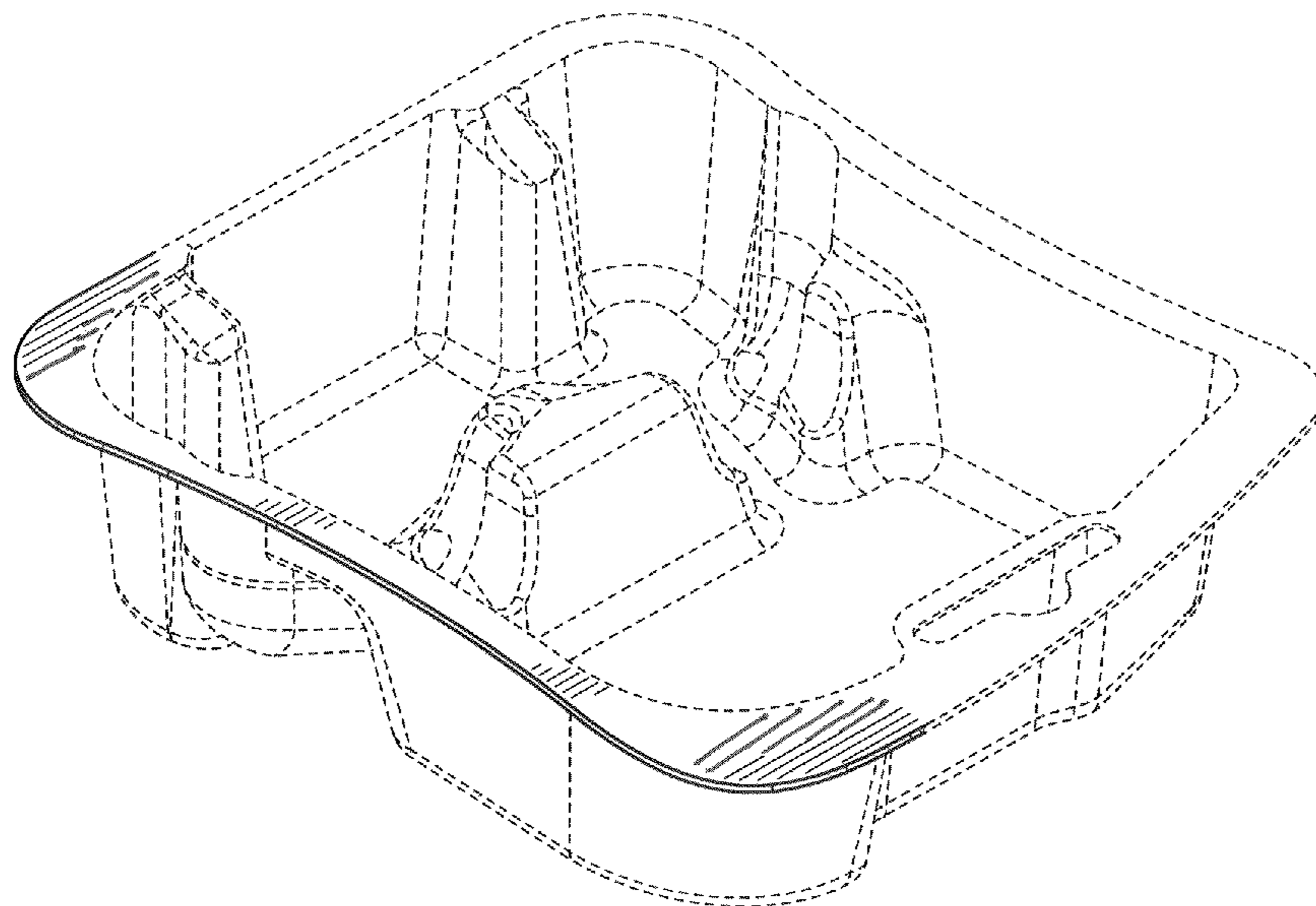
The ornamental design for a package for a consumer product, as shown and described.

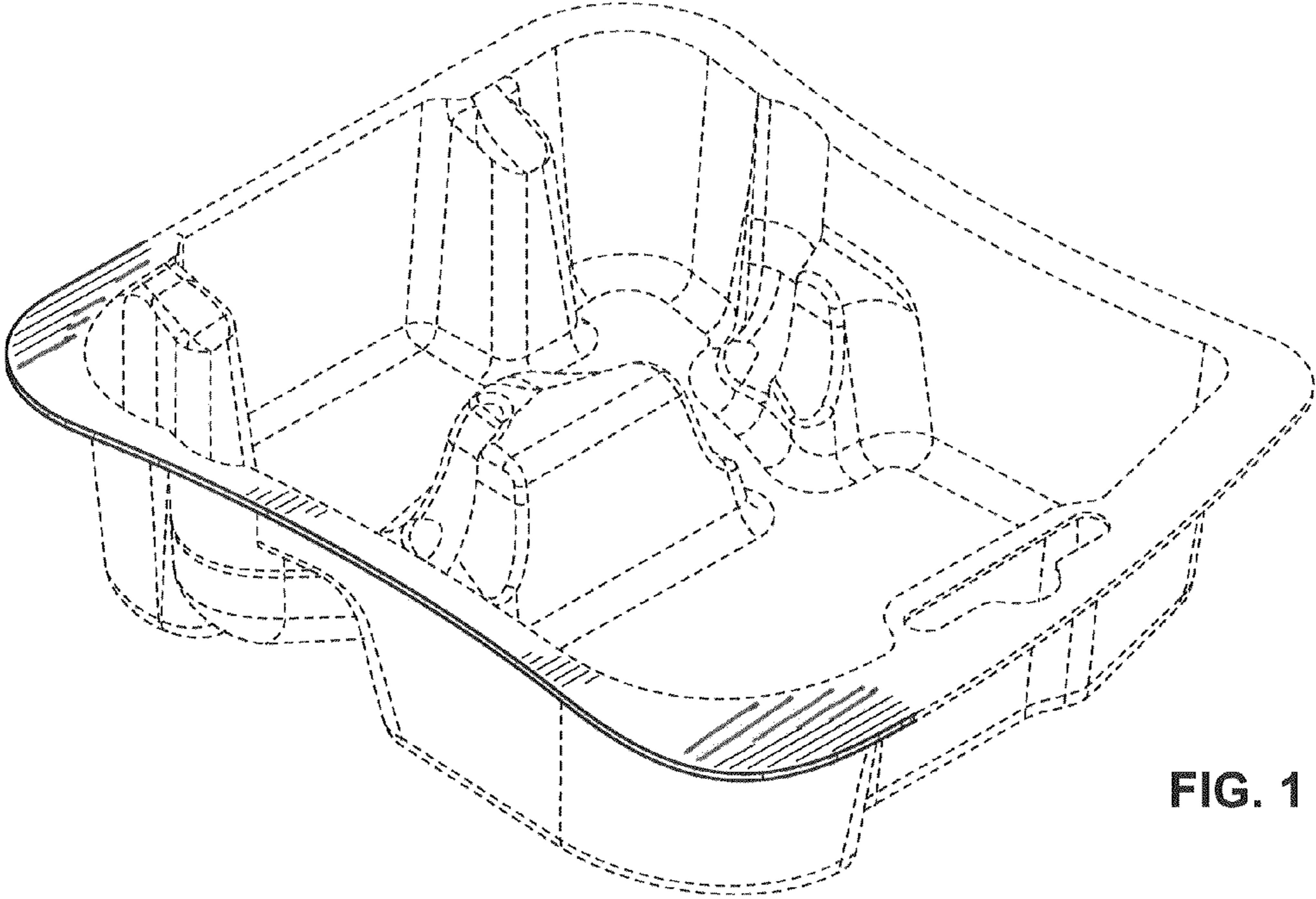

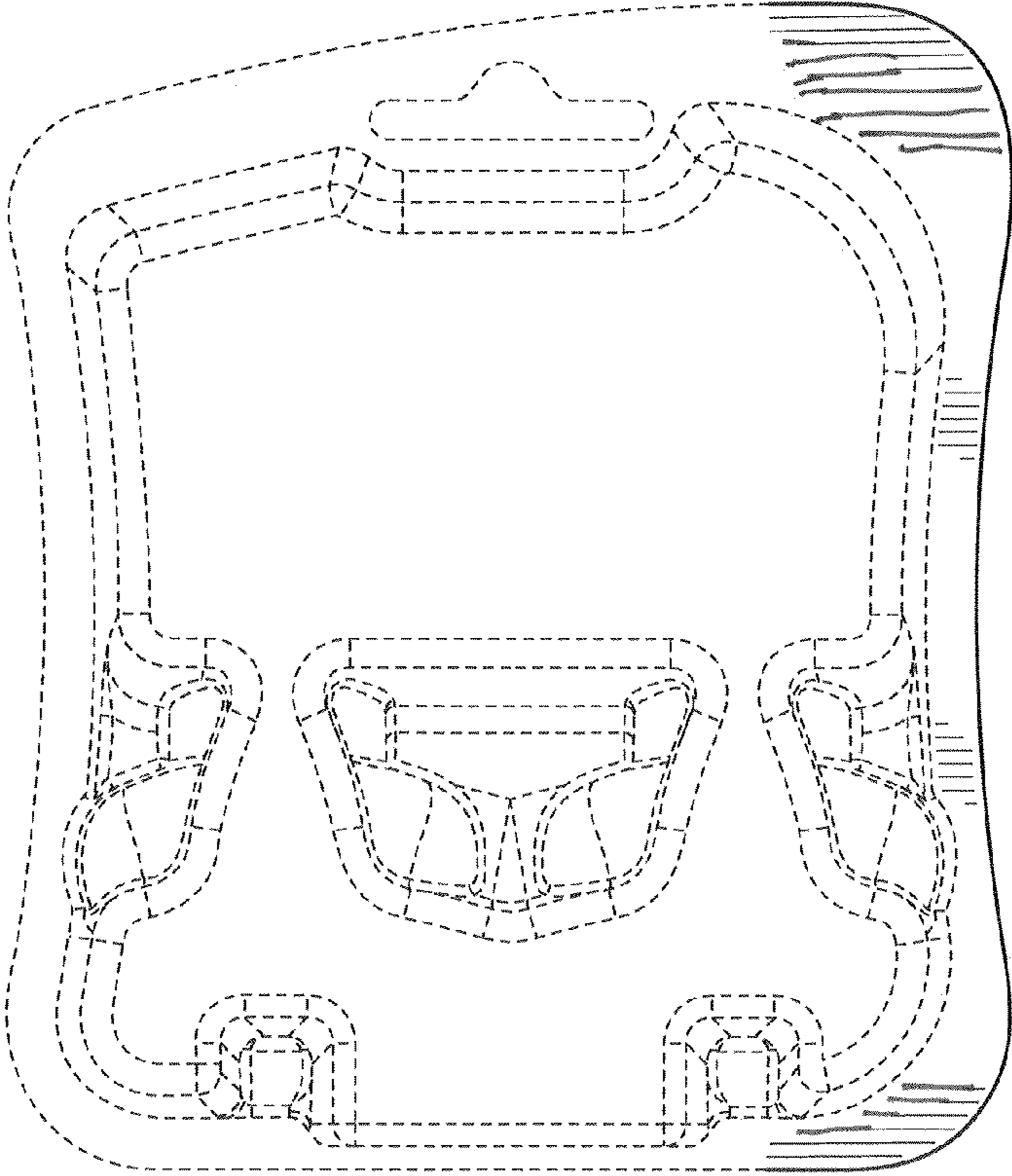
