DESCRIPTION

FIG. 13 is a top view of thereof; and,

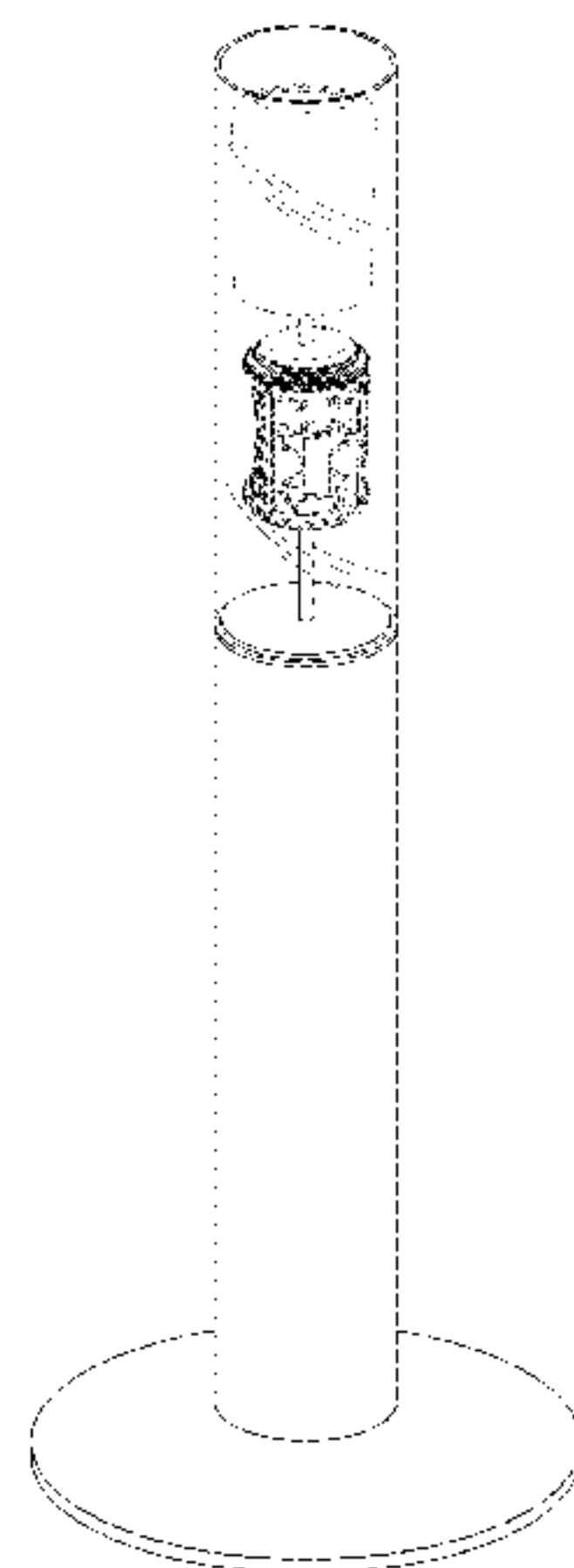
FIG. 14 is a bottom view of thereof.

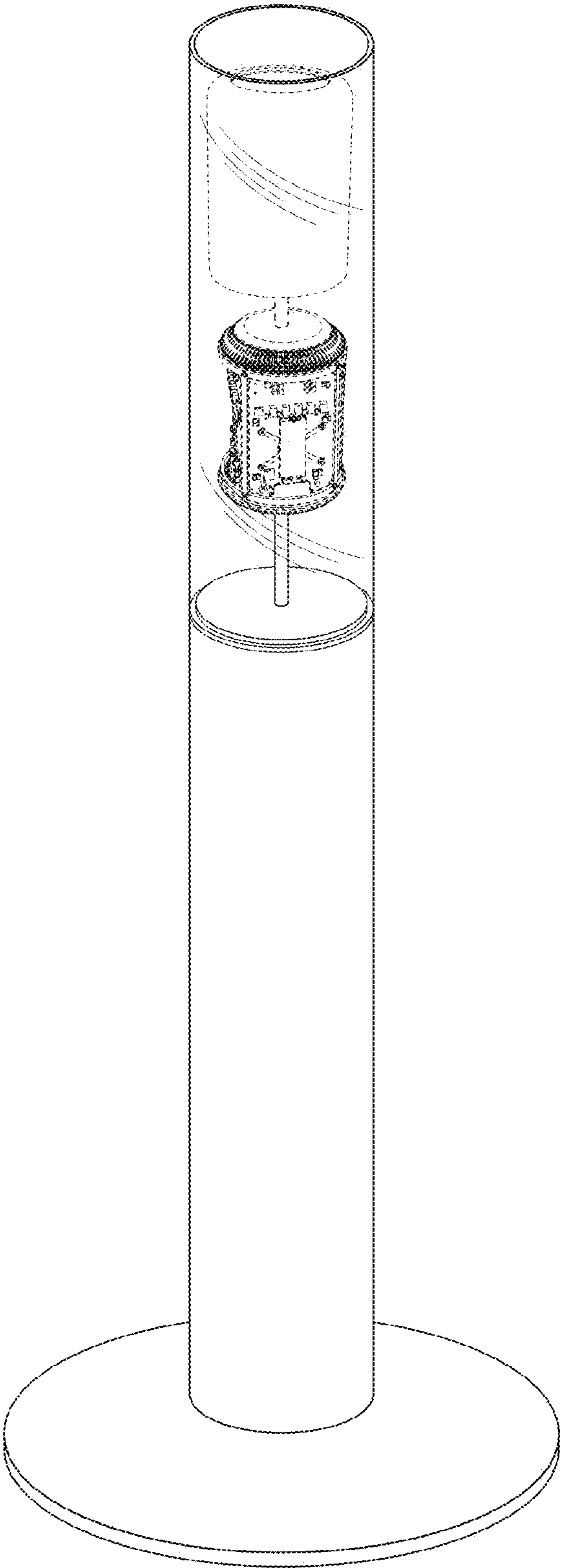

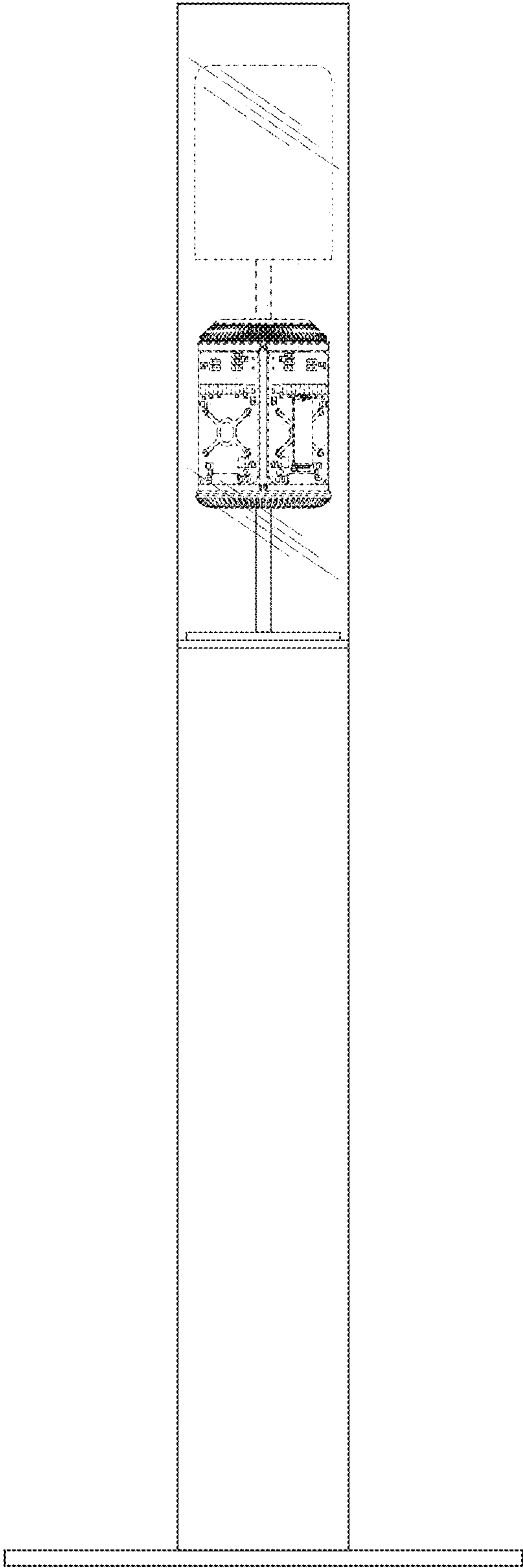

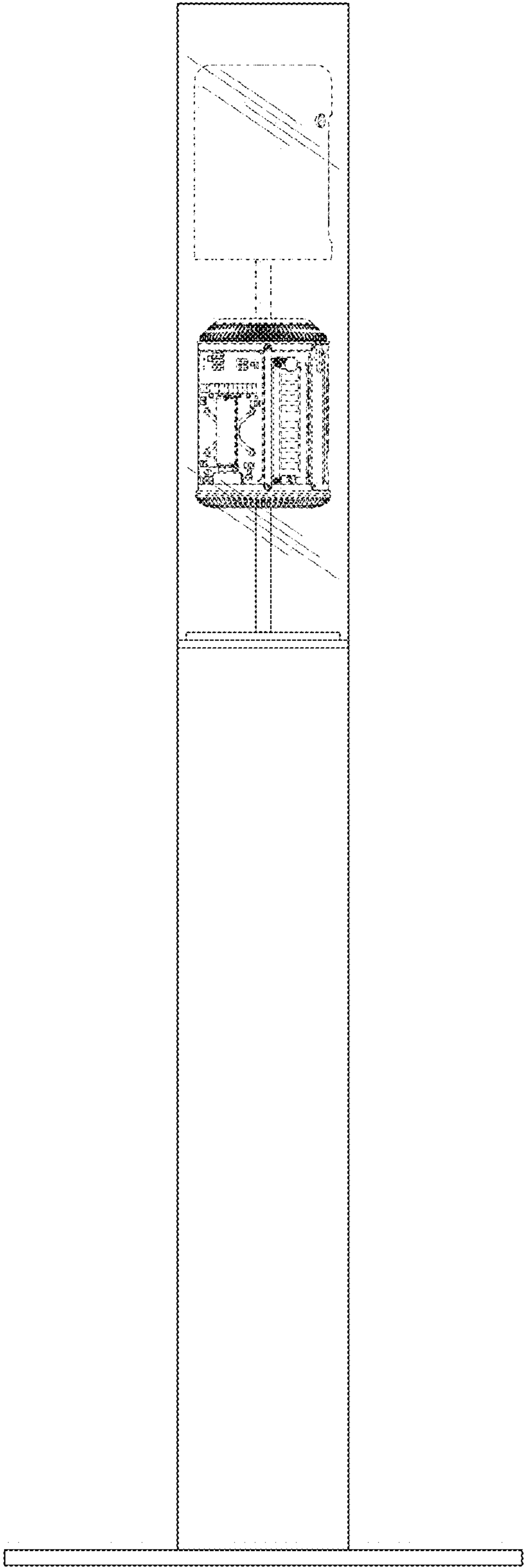

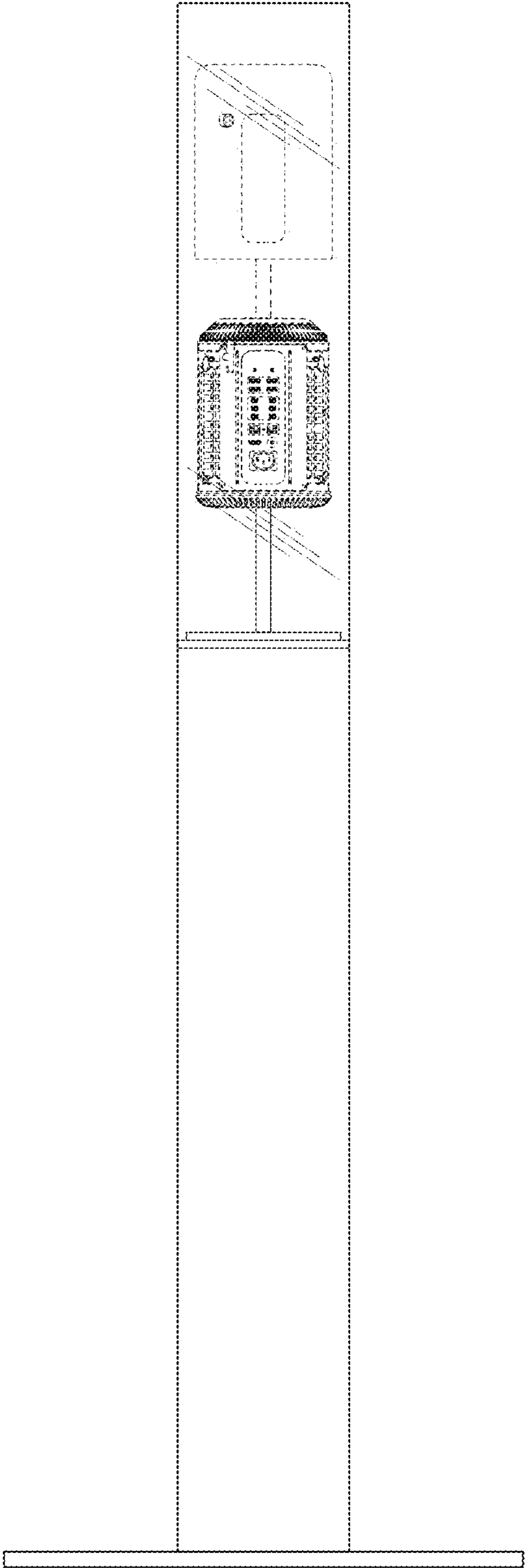

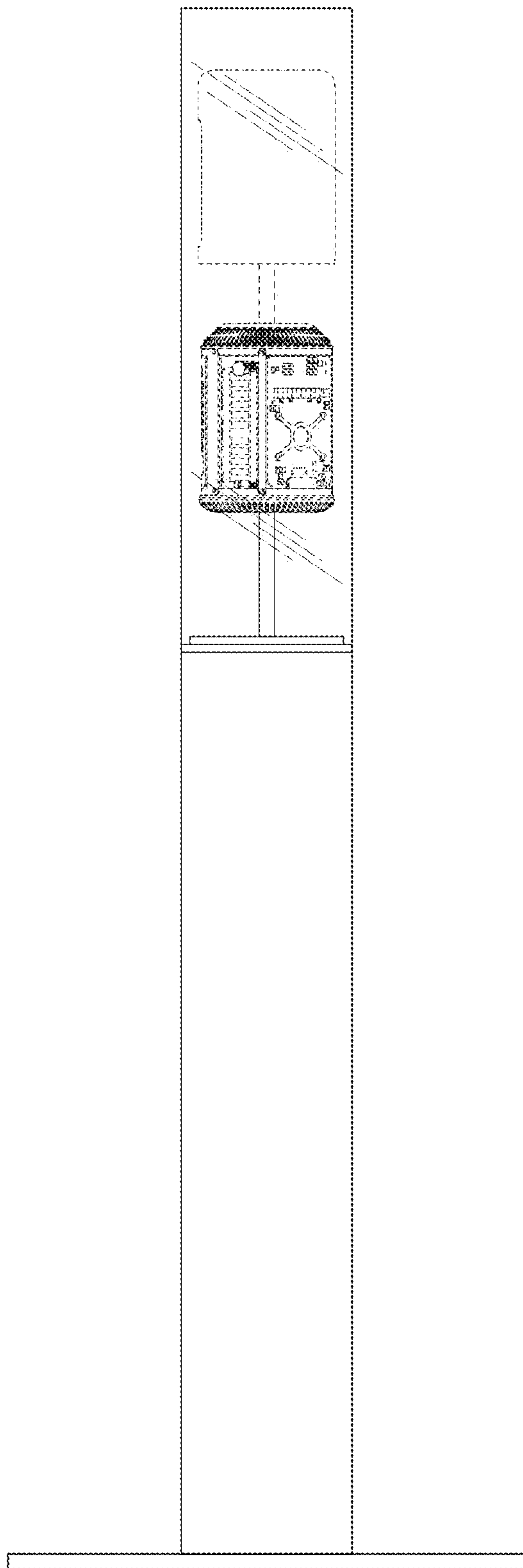

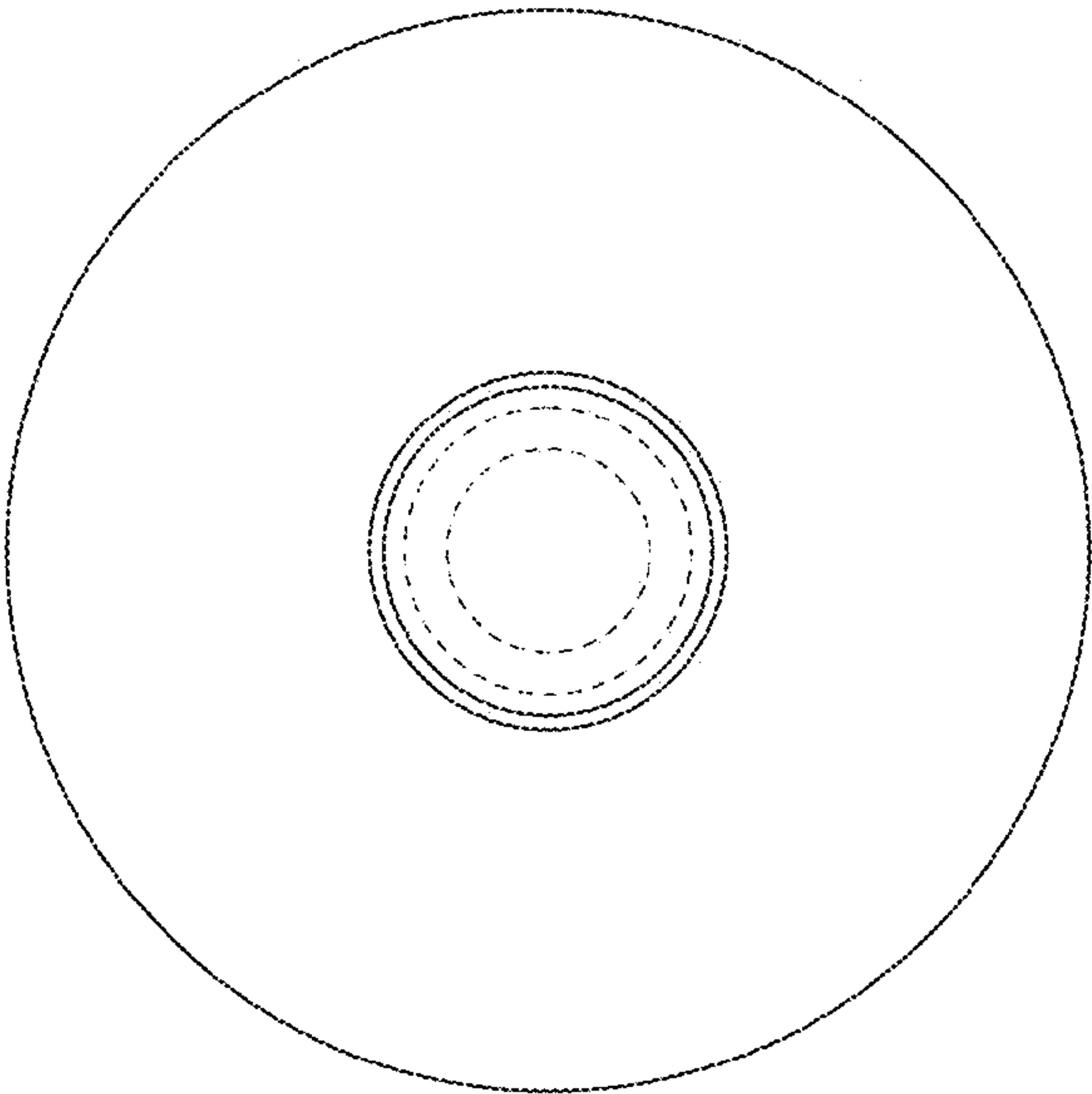

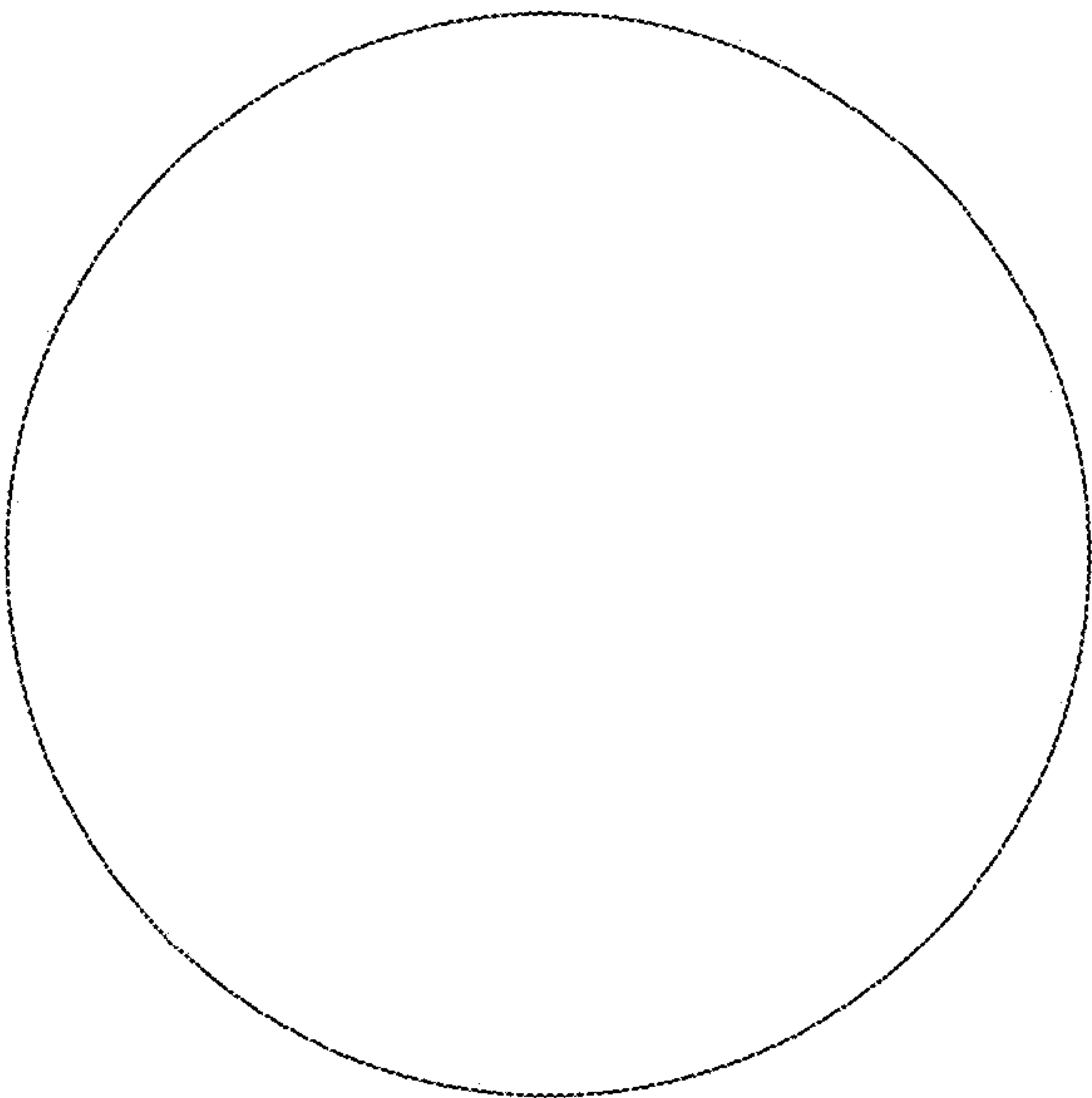

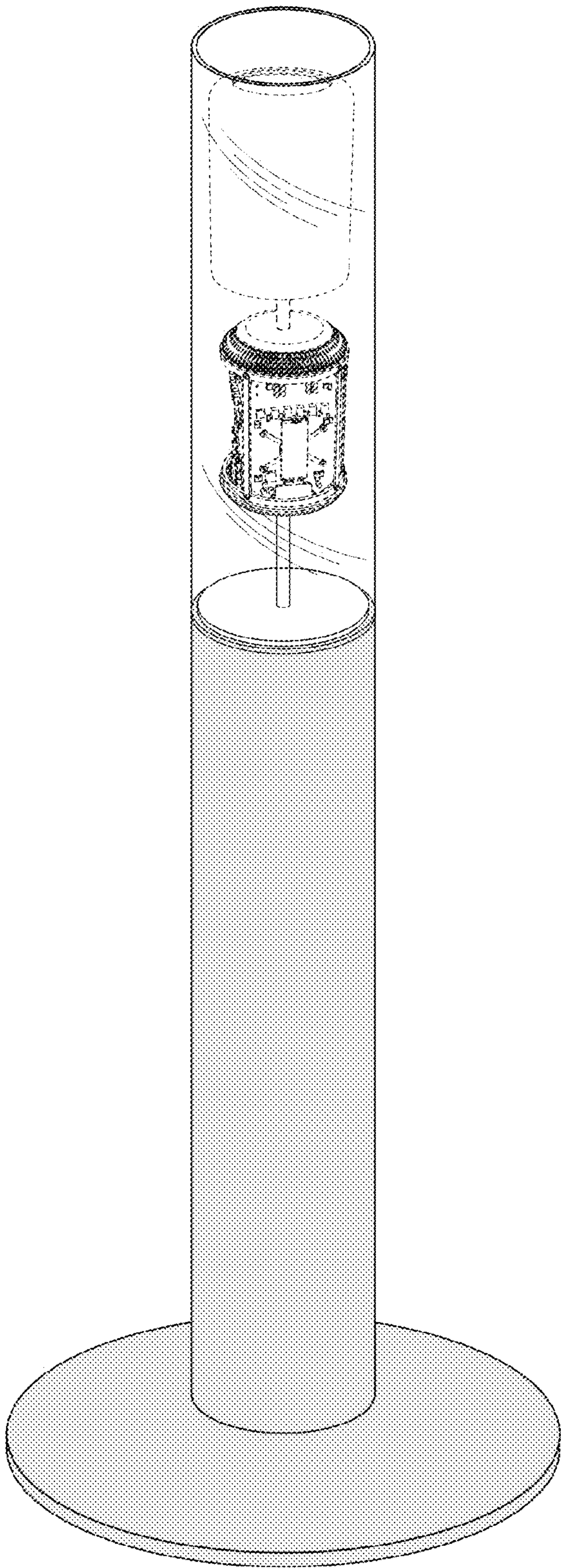

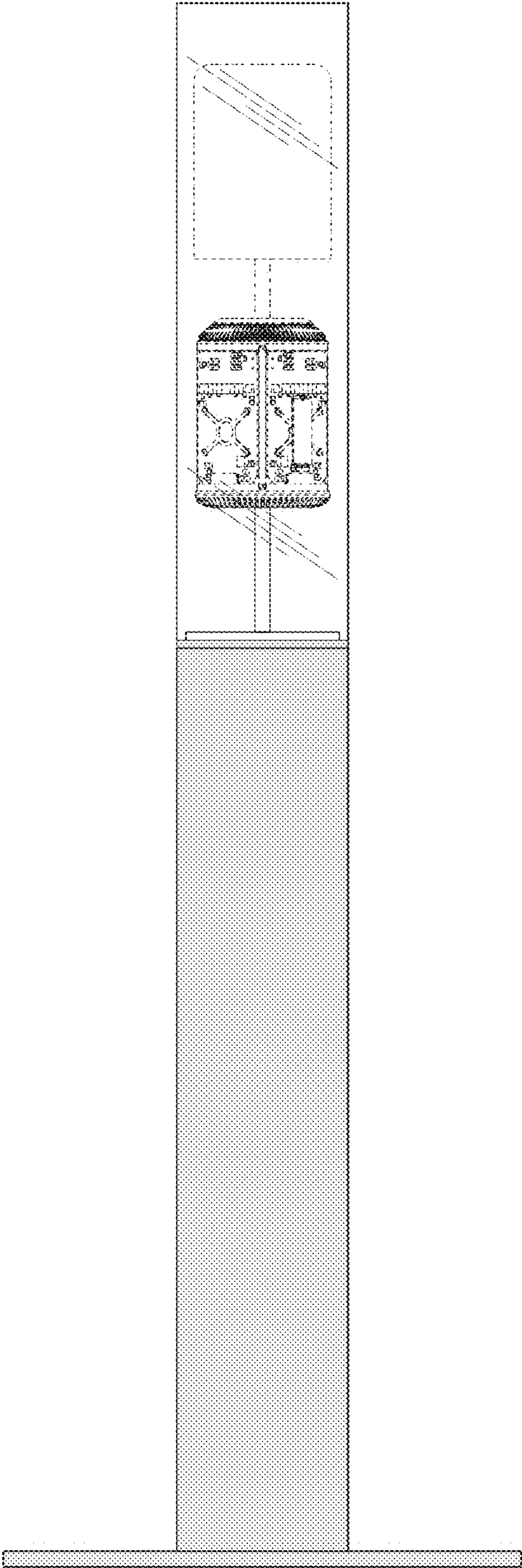

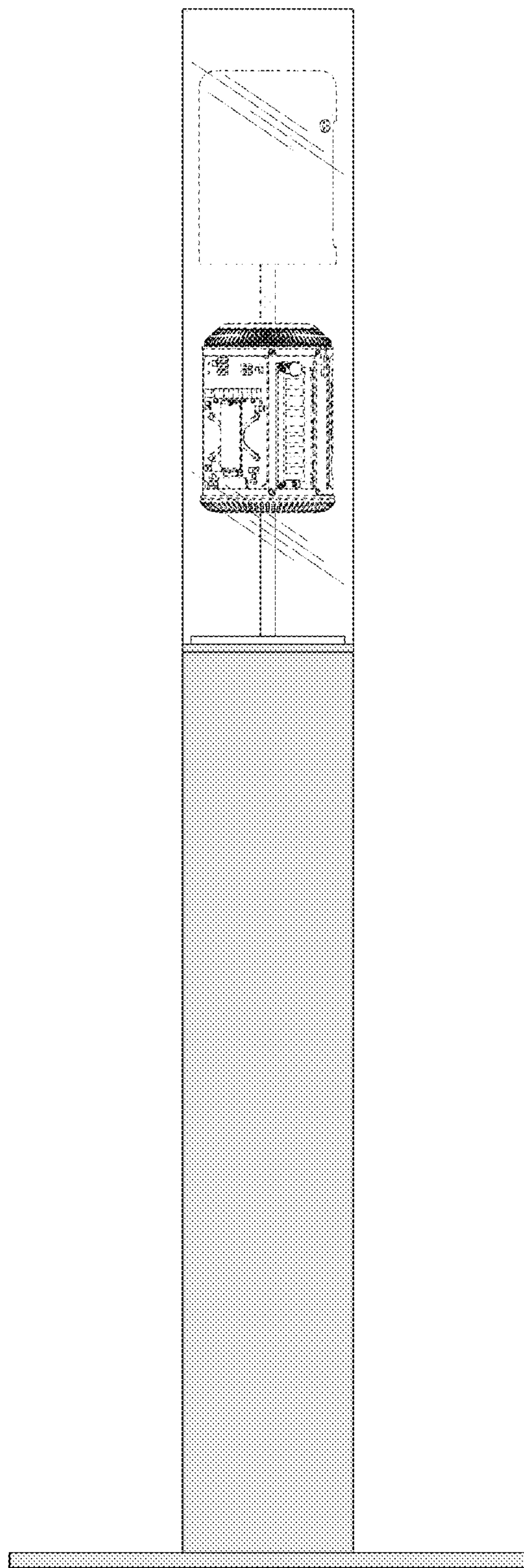

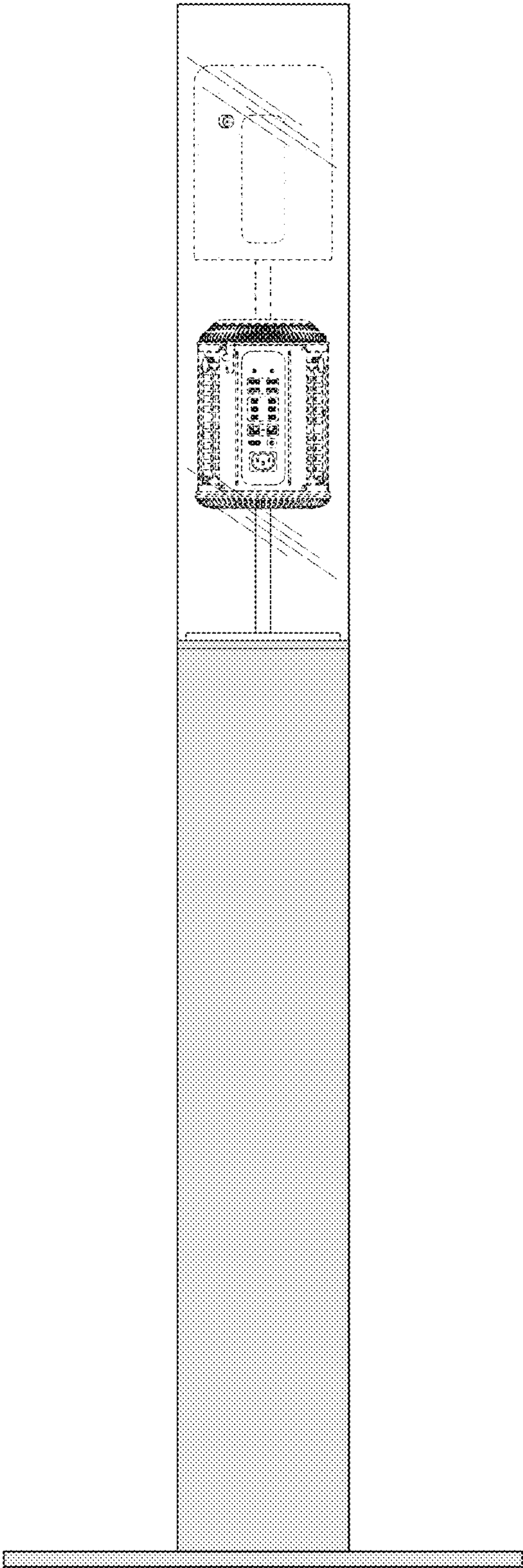

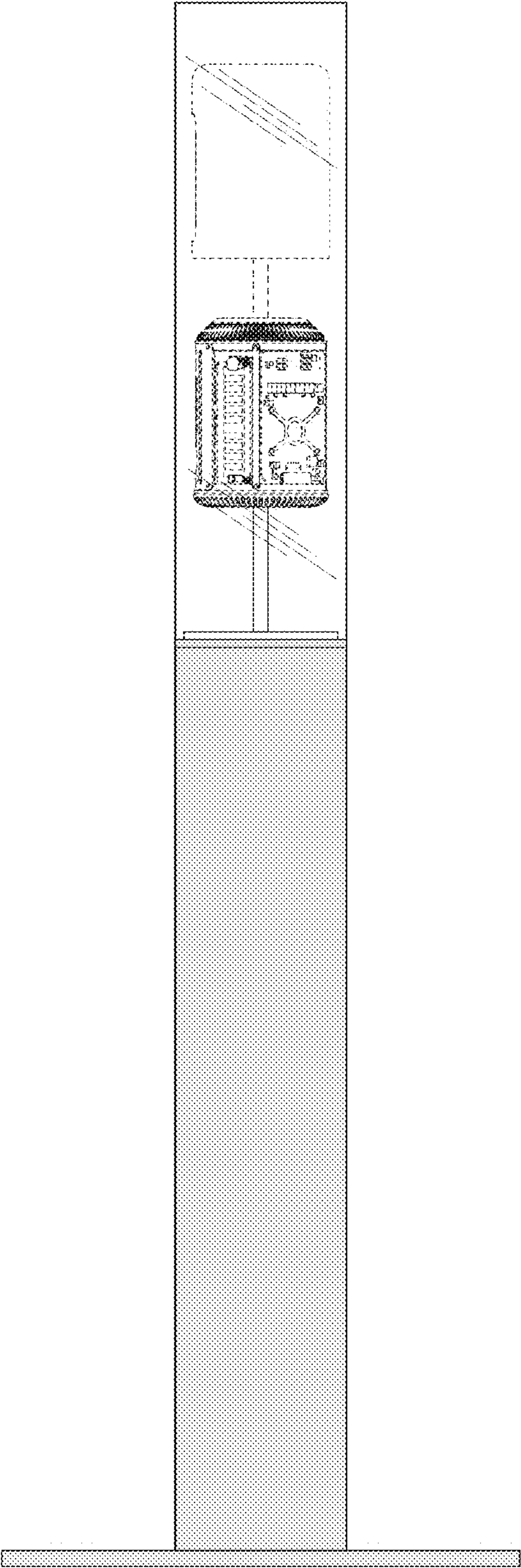

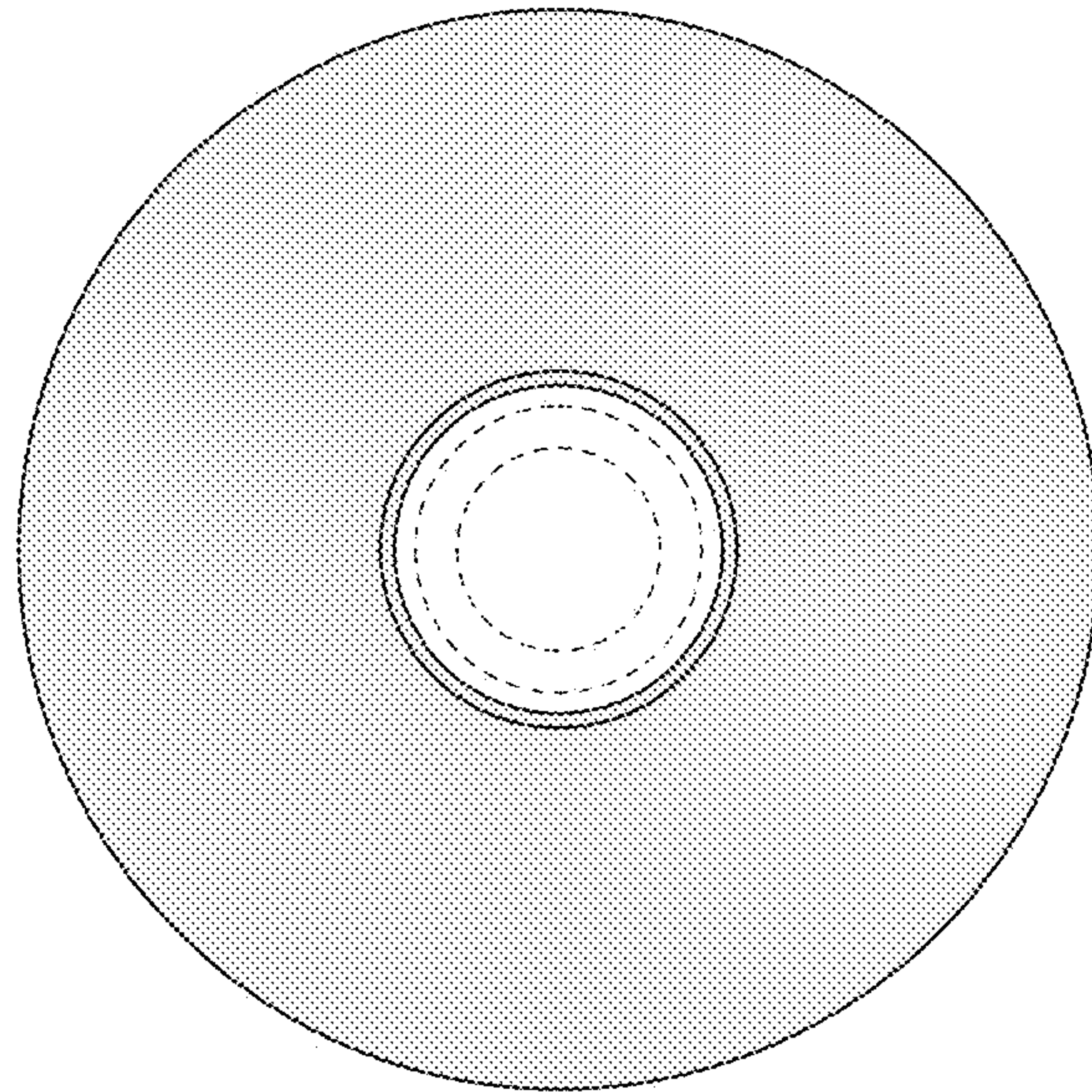

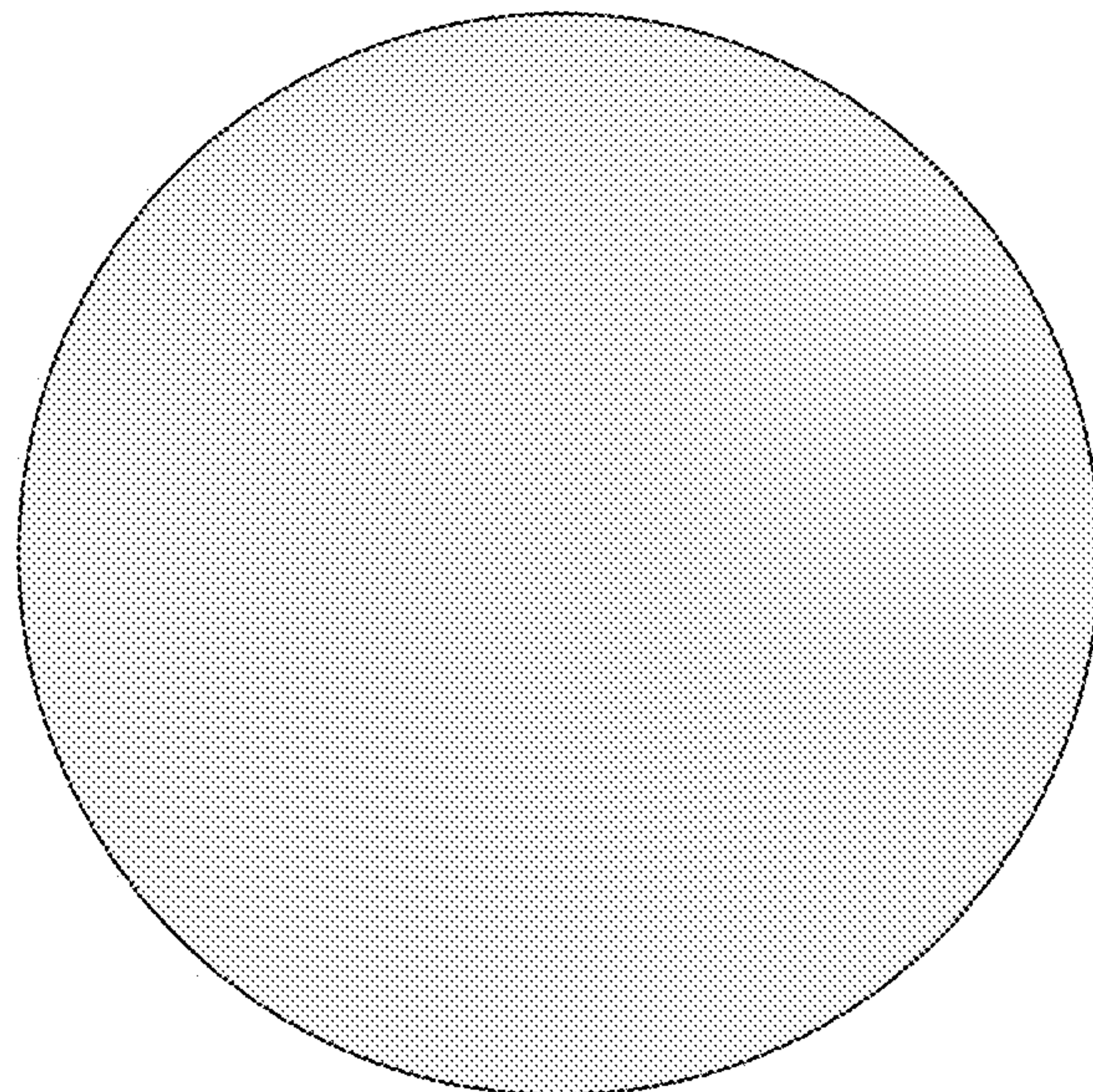
