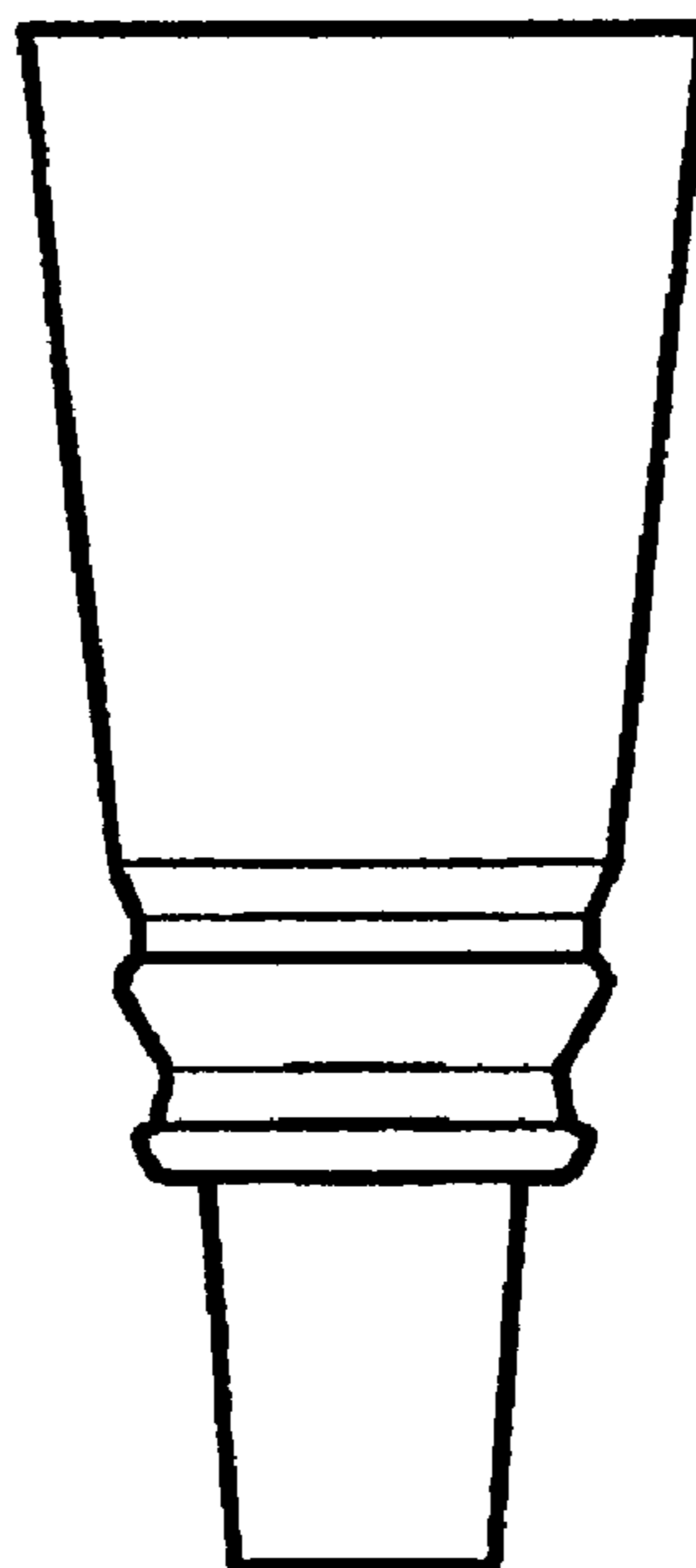
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a glass bottleneck tap handle ornament base, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bottleneck tap handle ornament base showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top perspective view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken lines in the drawings are included for the purpose of illustration and form no part of the claimed design. A glass bottleneck is adhered to a manufactured tap handle that attaches to a beer tap faucet. The round hollow top of the bottleneck serves as a base to mount a decorative ornament. Ornament examples include: billiard balls, golf balls or custom wood fixtures.

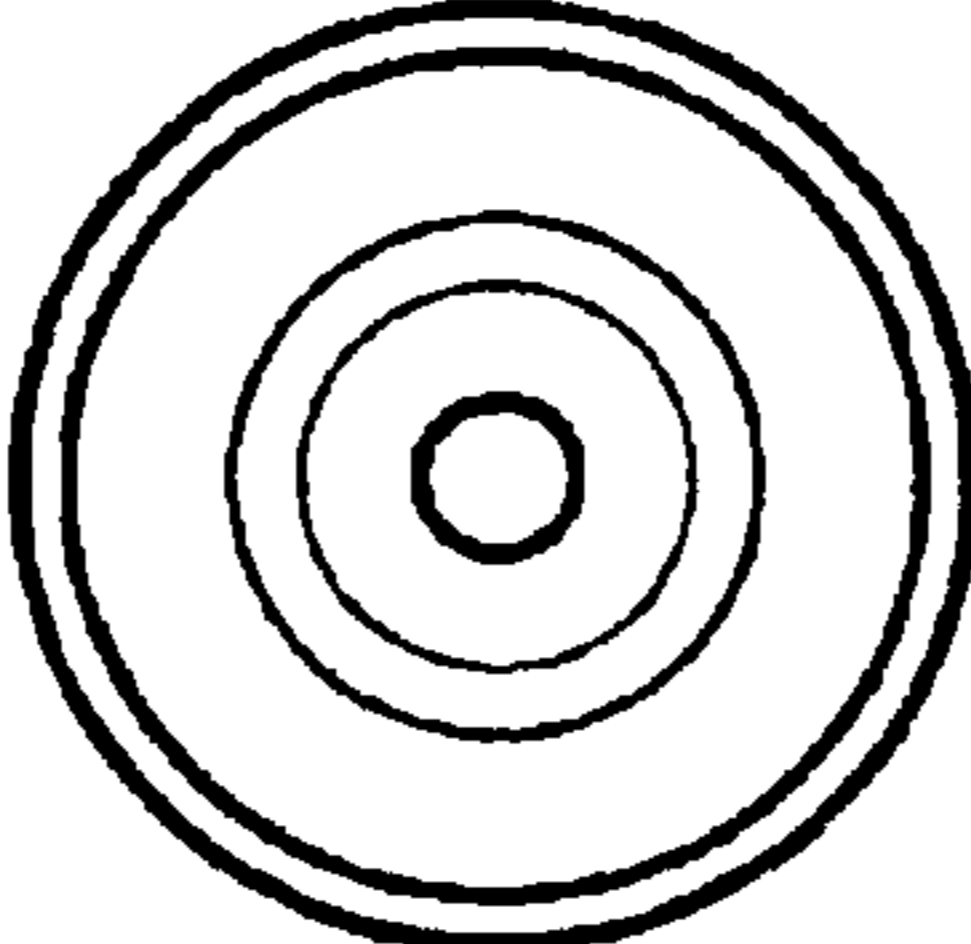

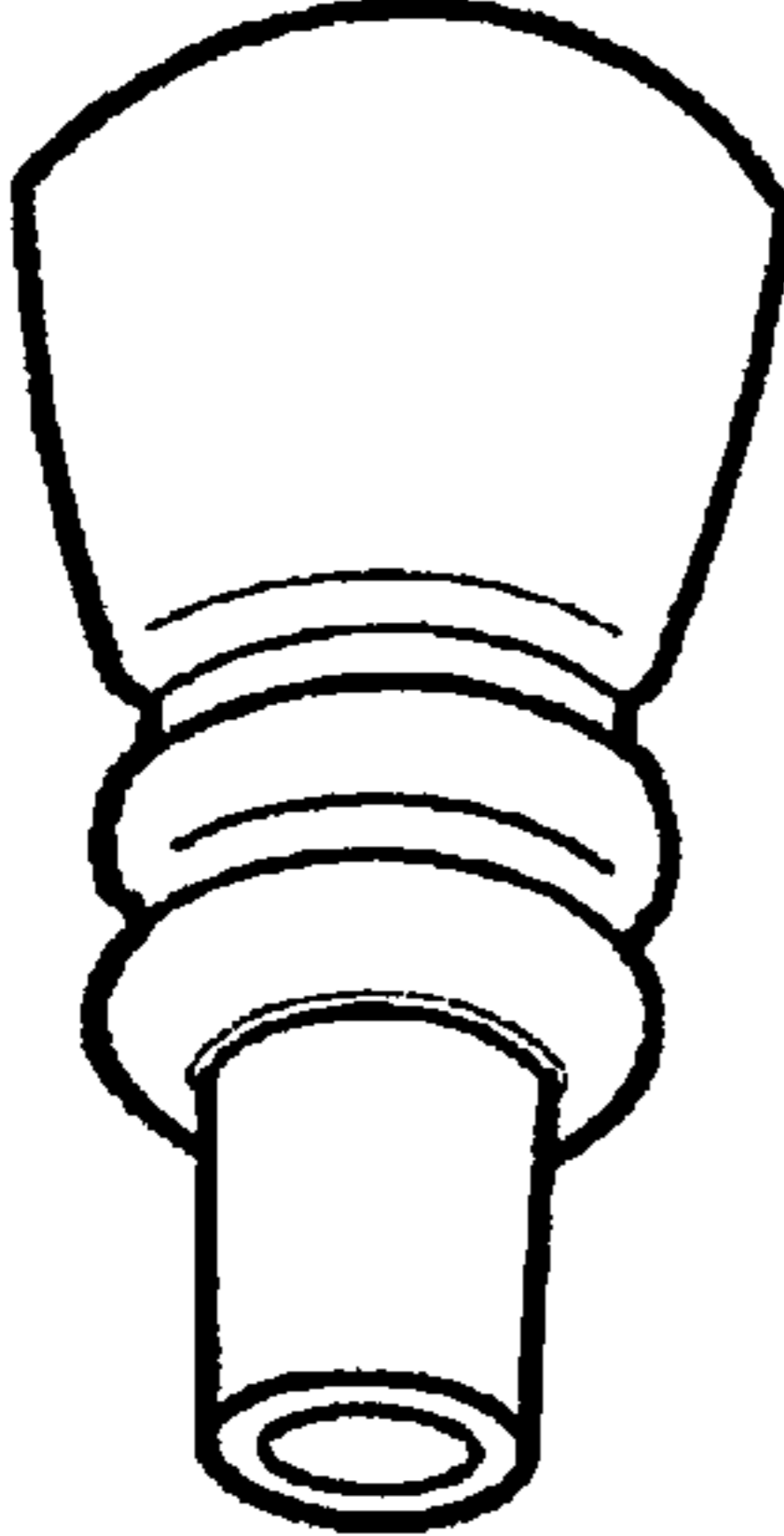

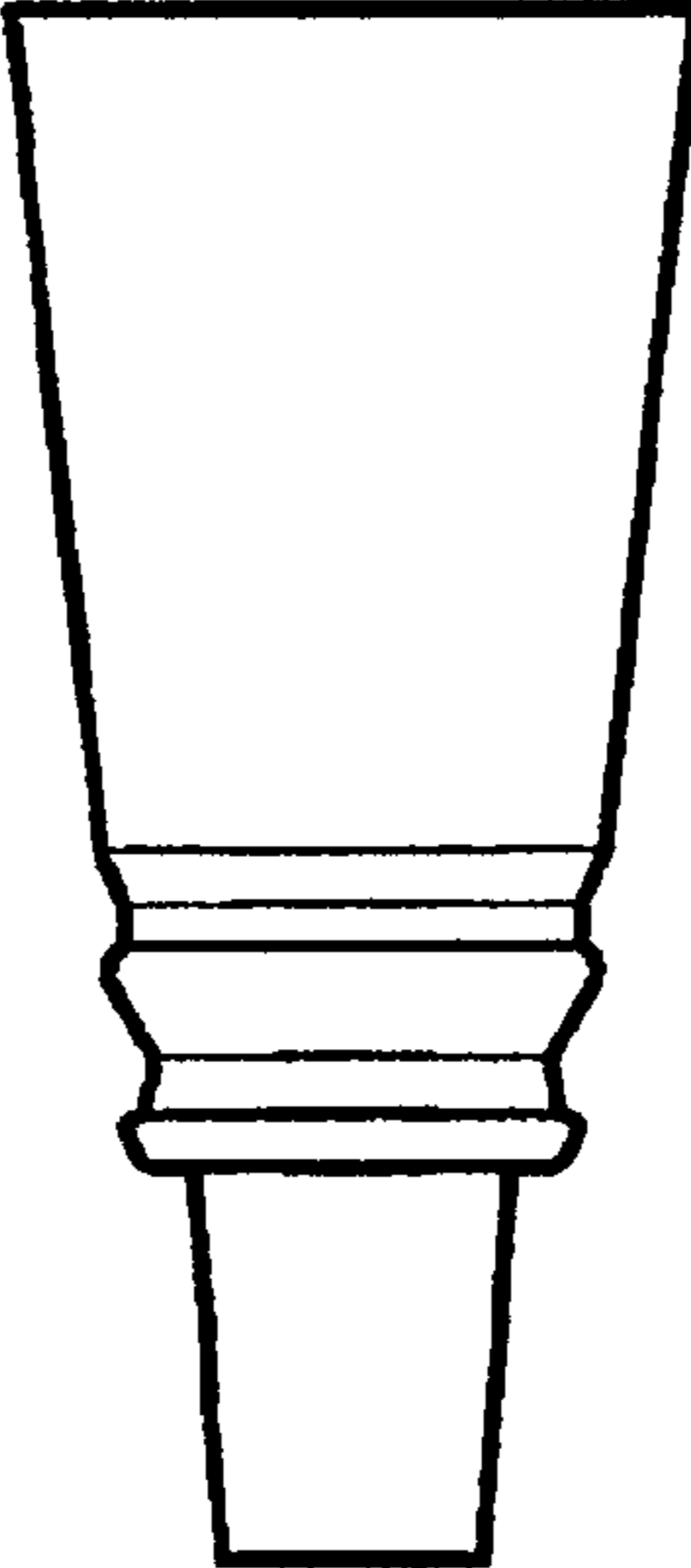

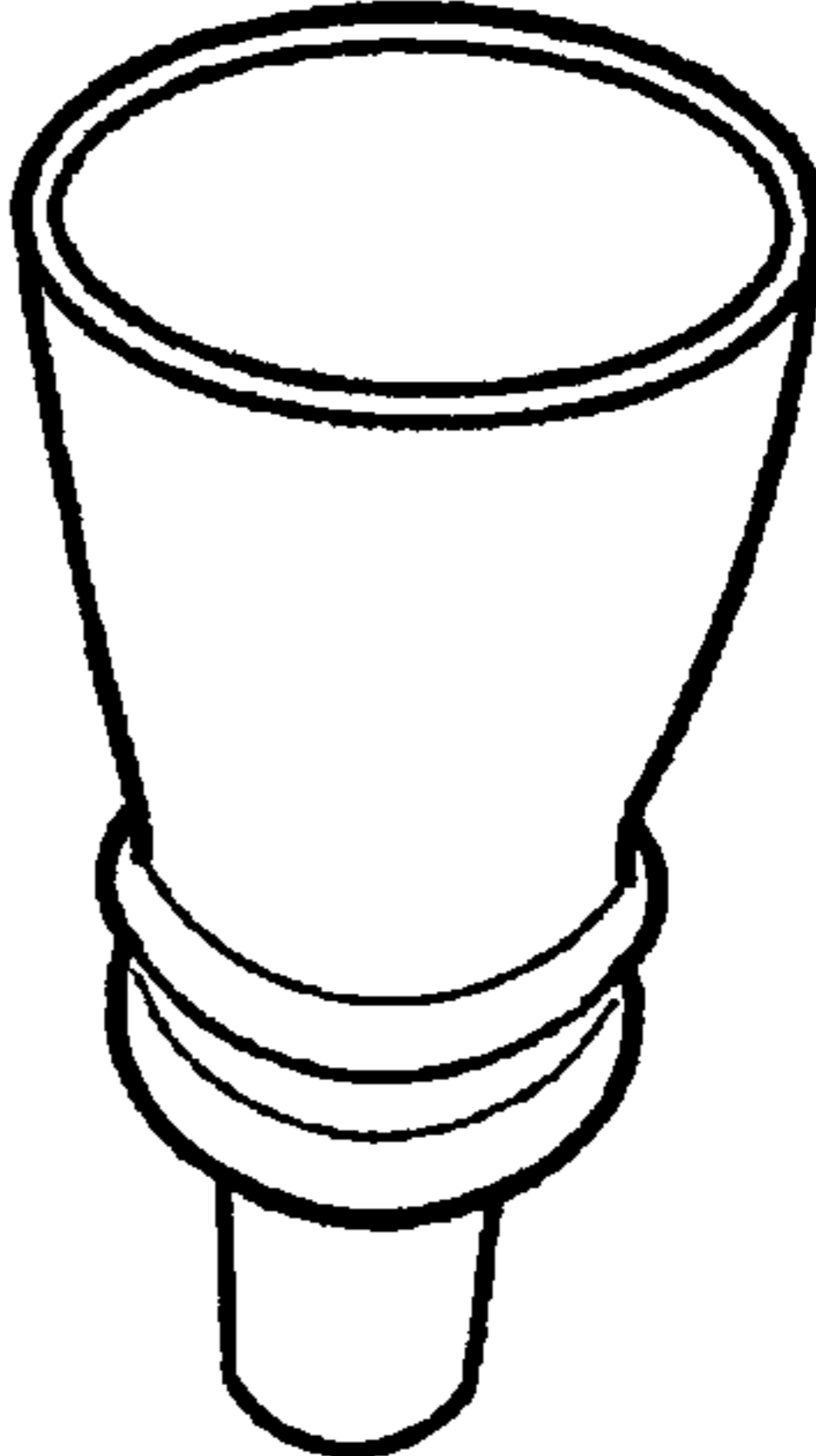

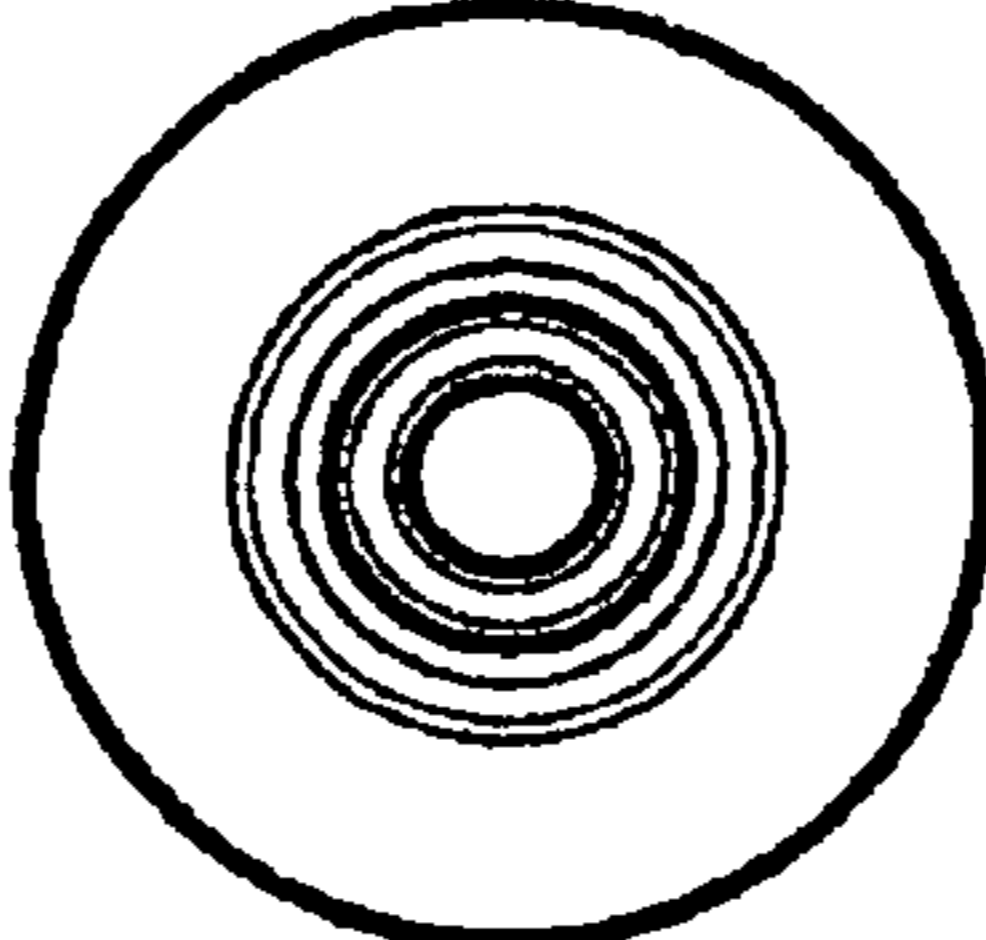
