in FIG. 17;

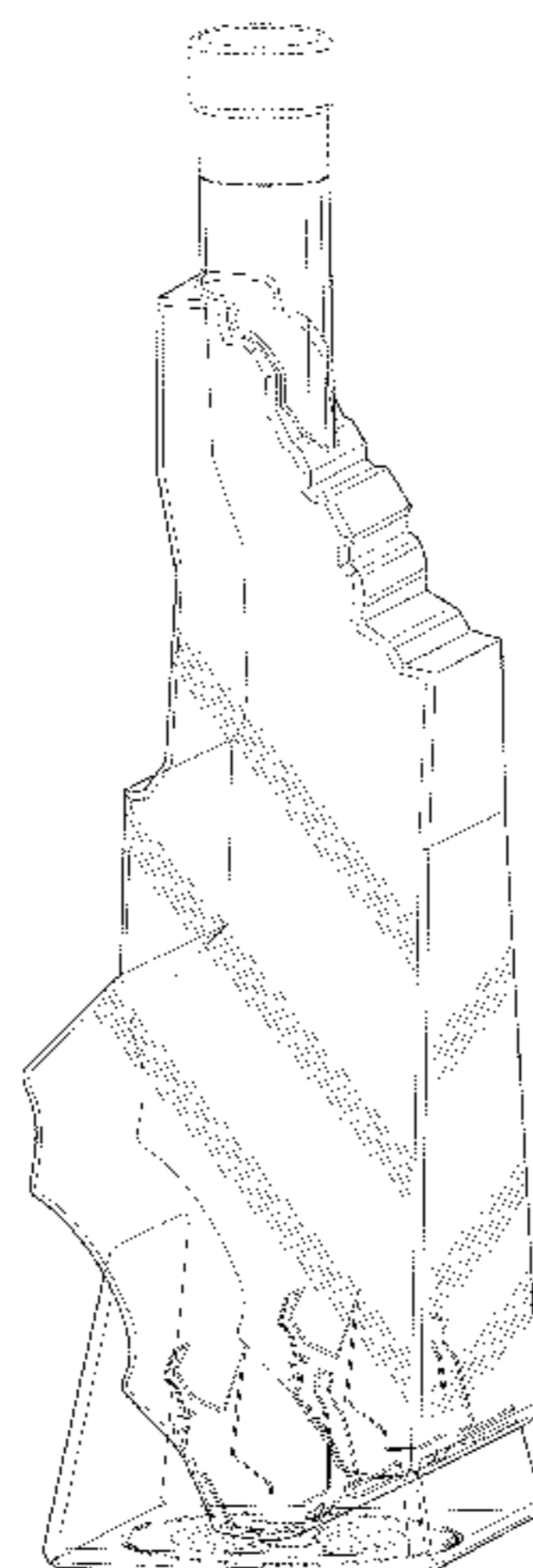
FIG. 22 is a bottom view of the embodiment of the bottle as

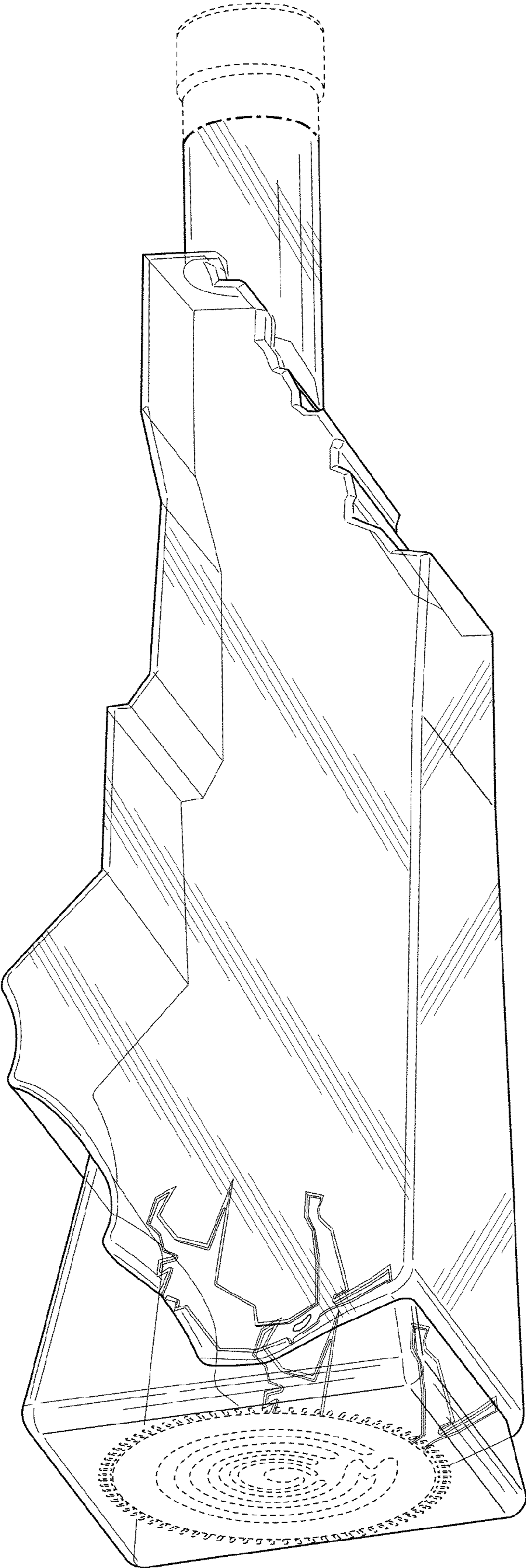

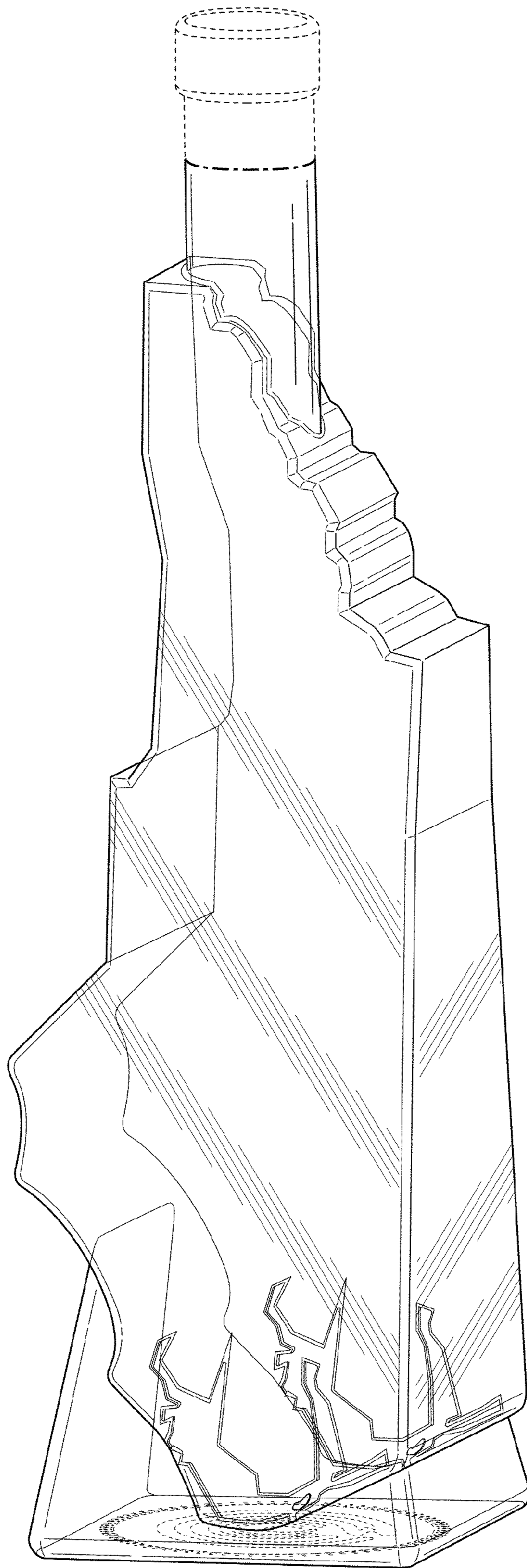

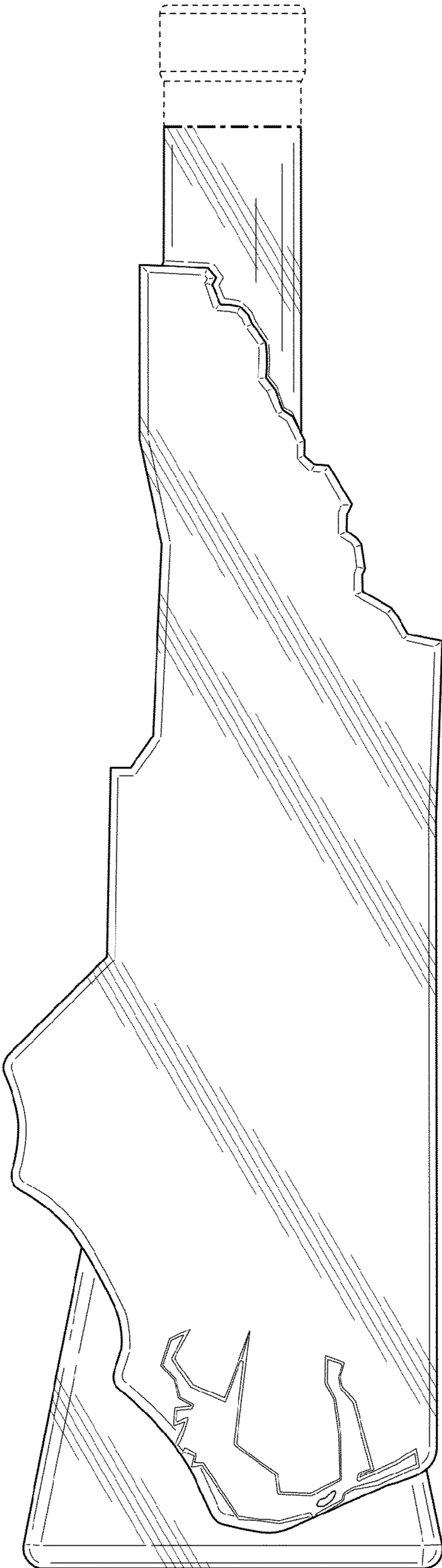

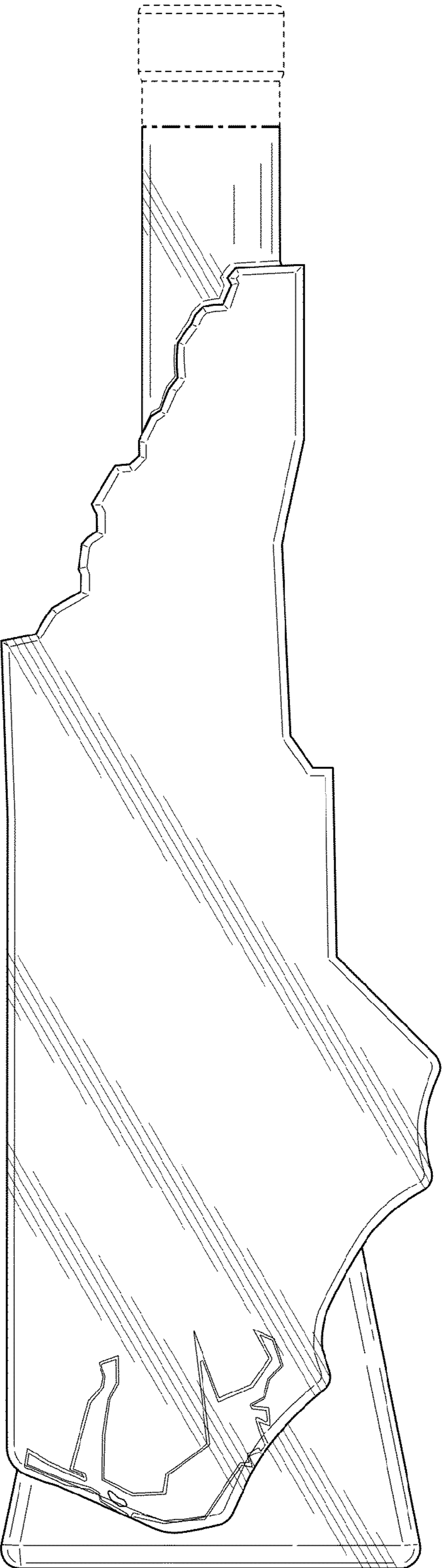

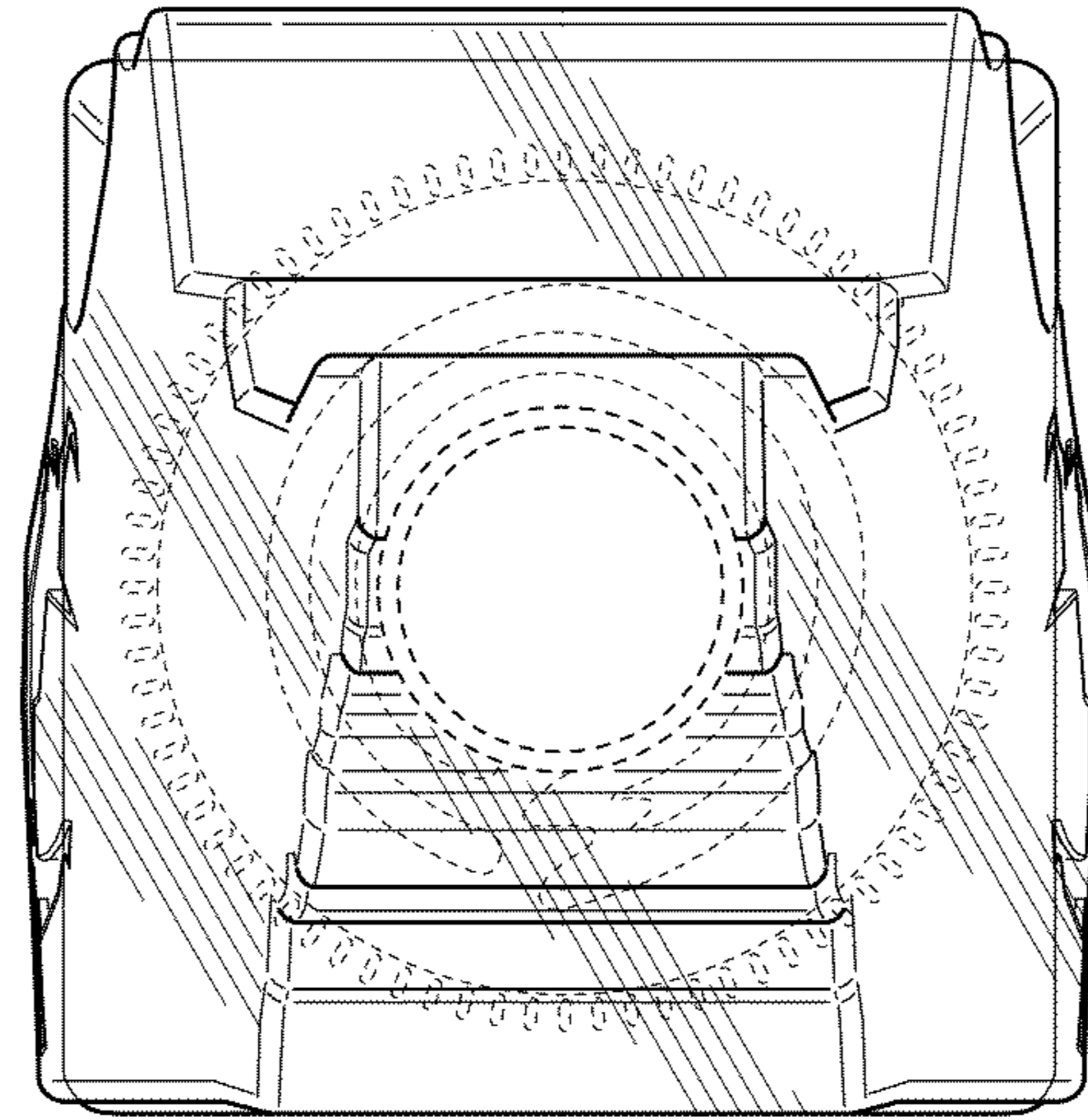

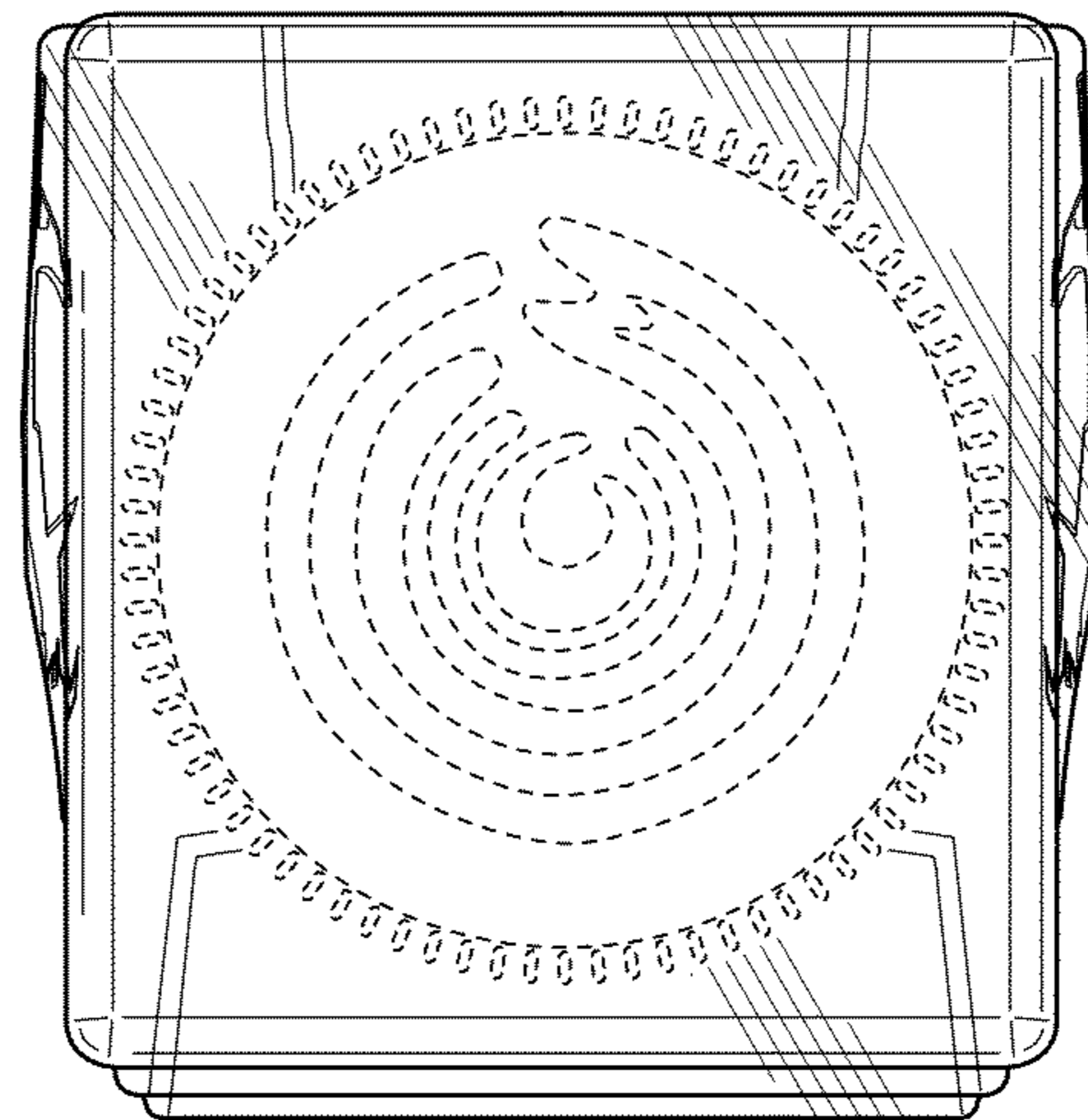

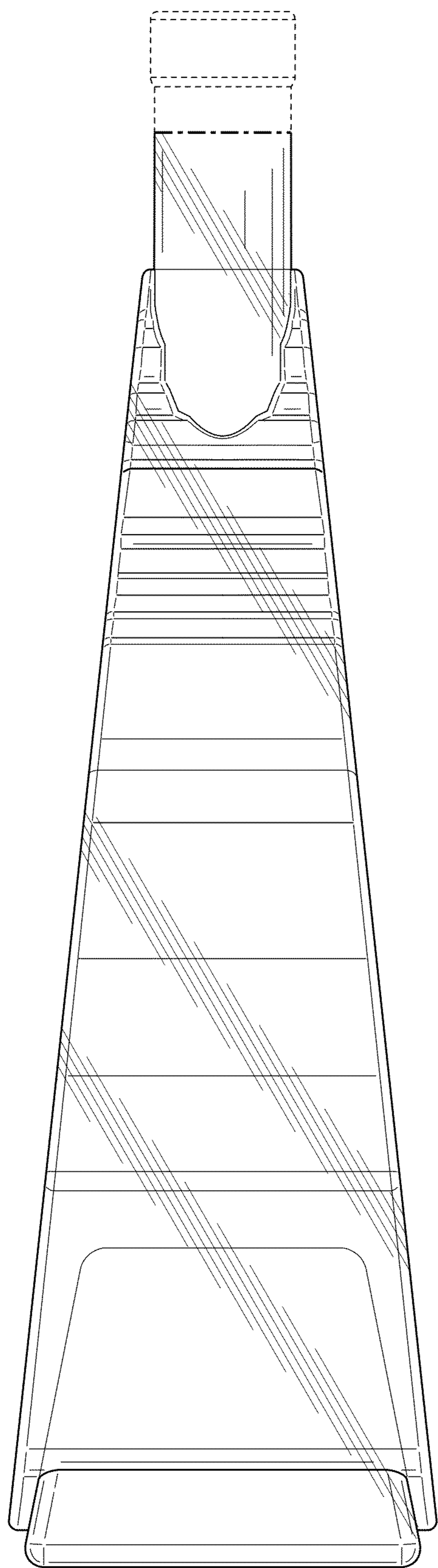

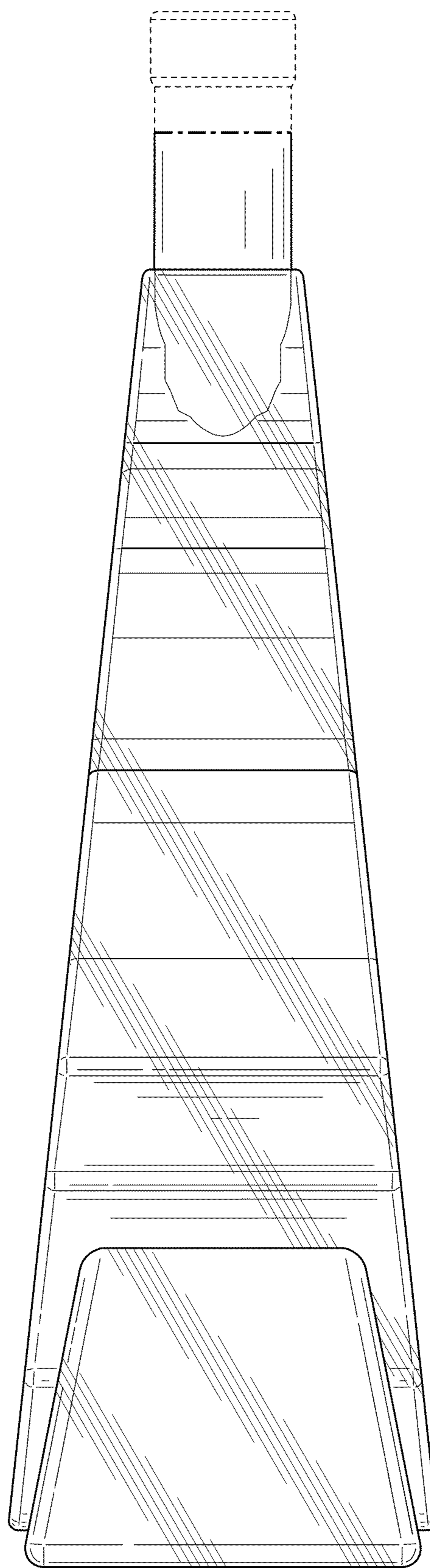

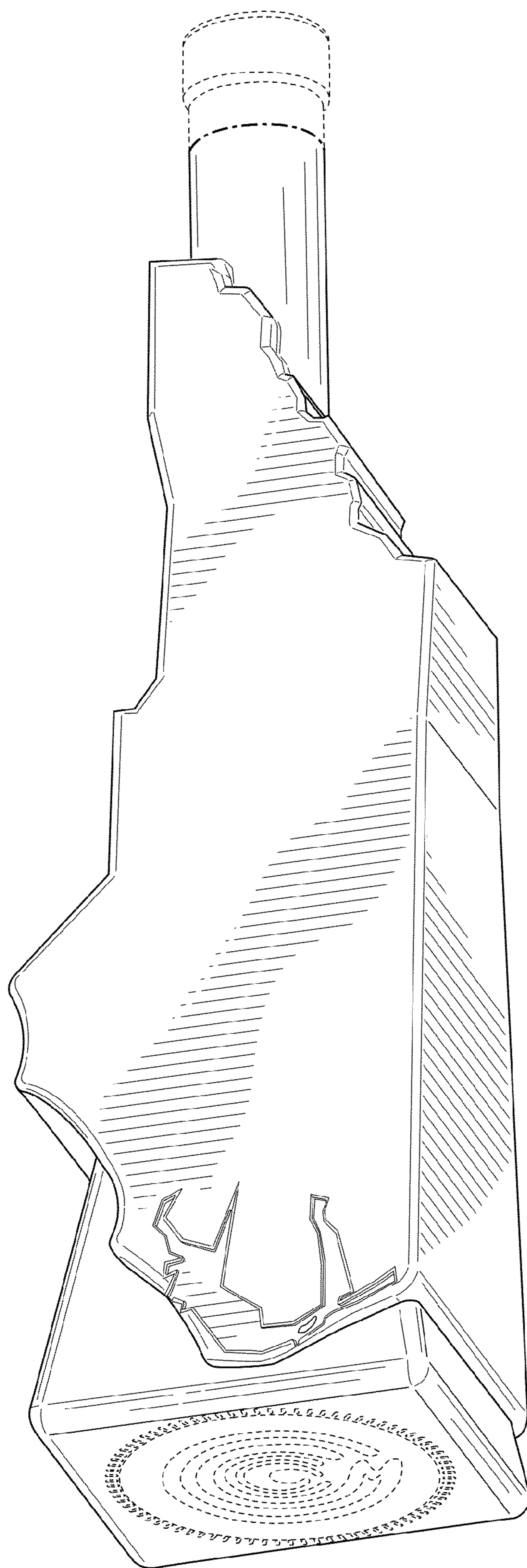

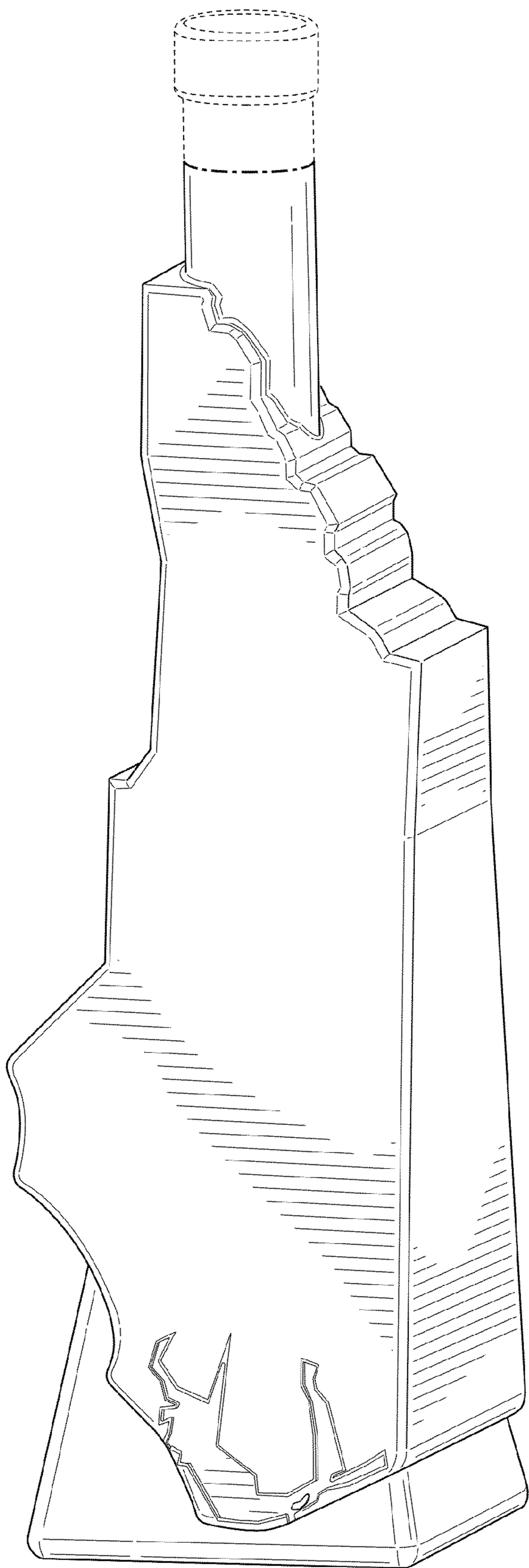

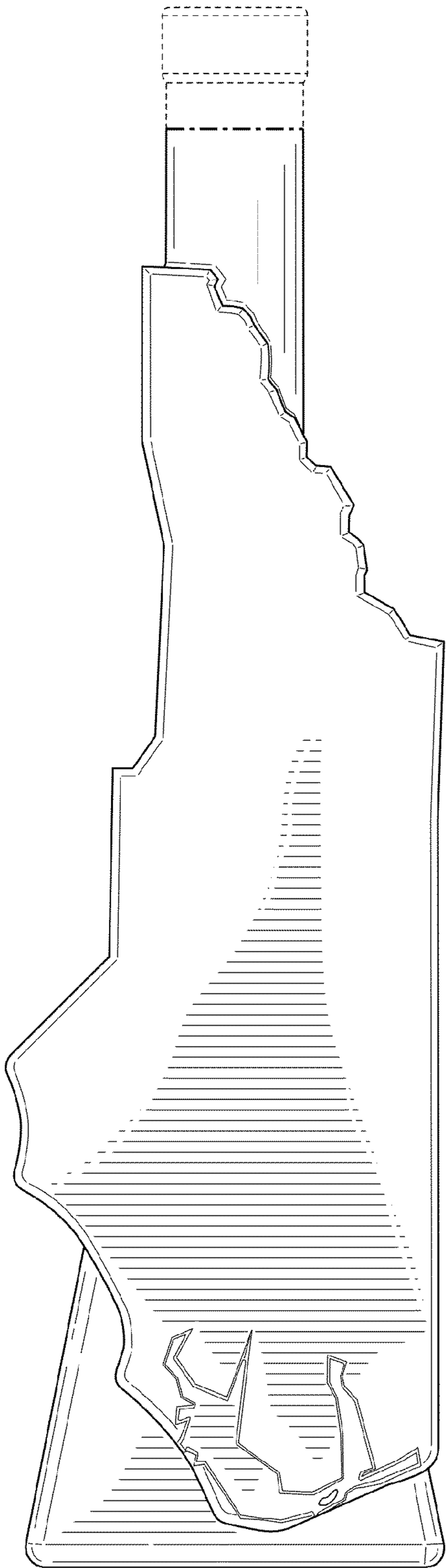

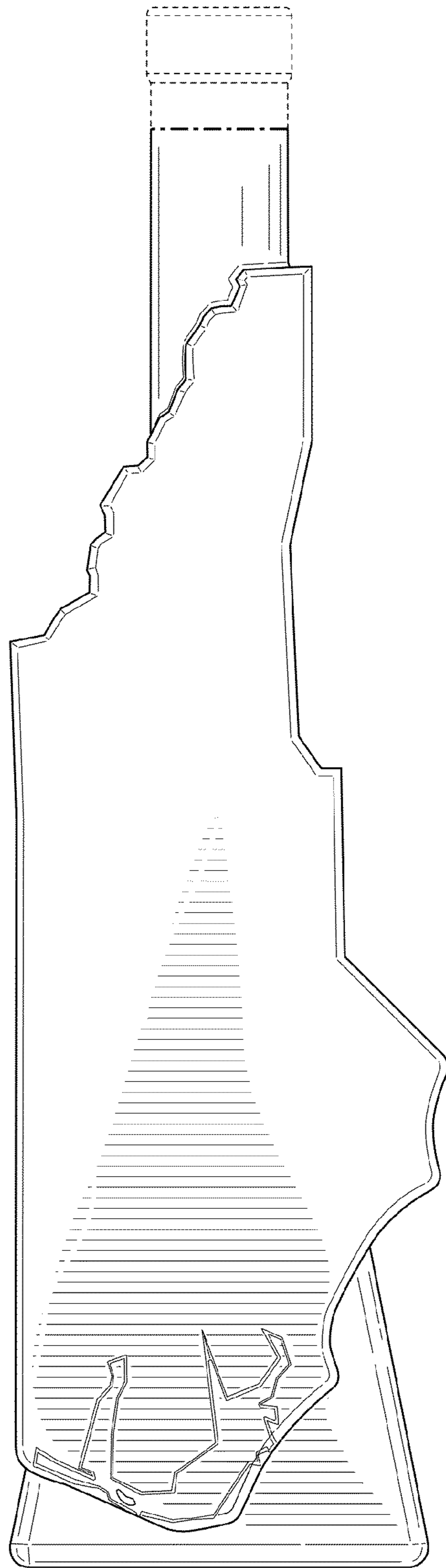

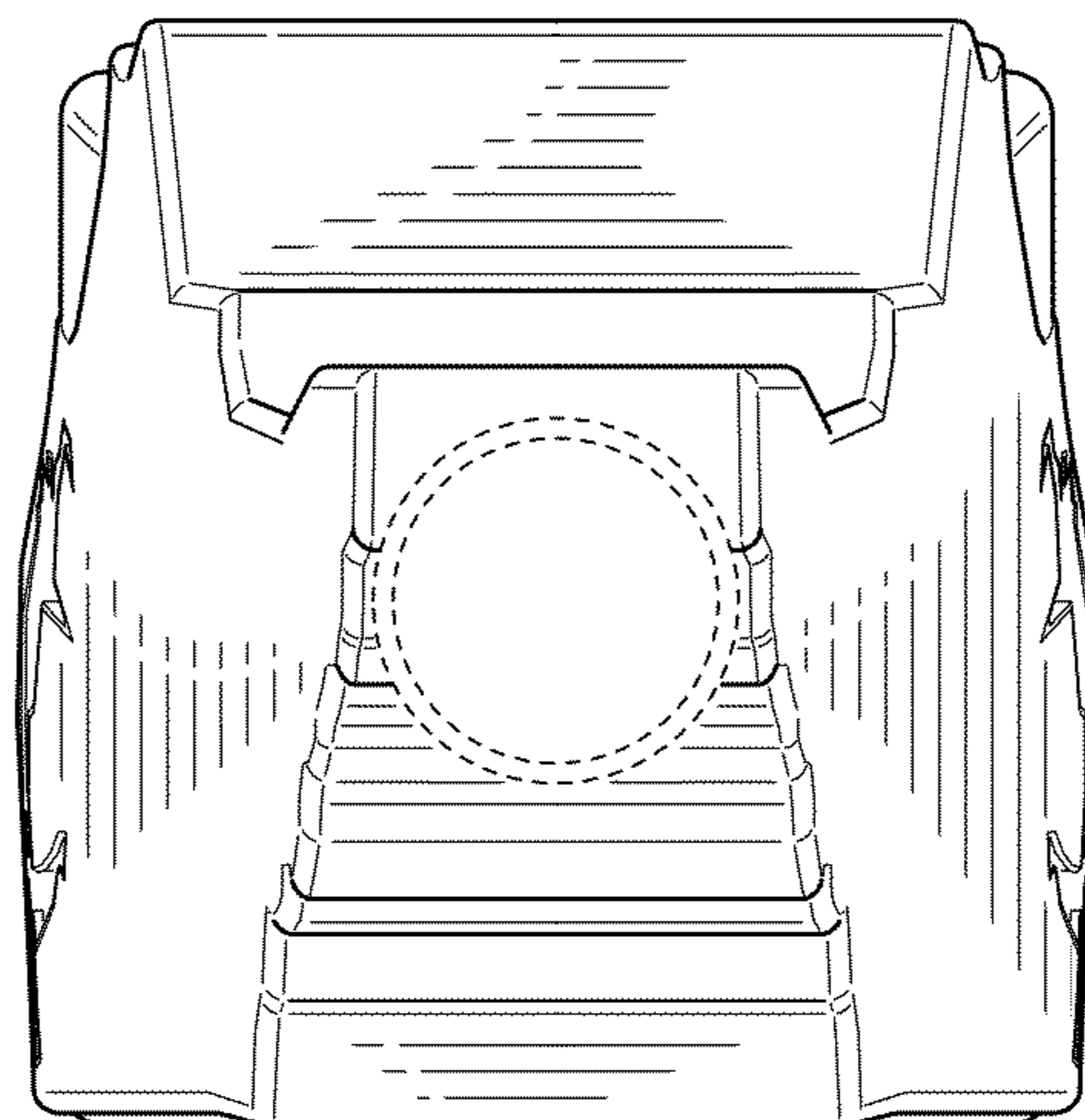

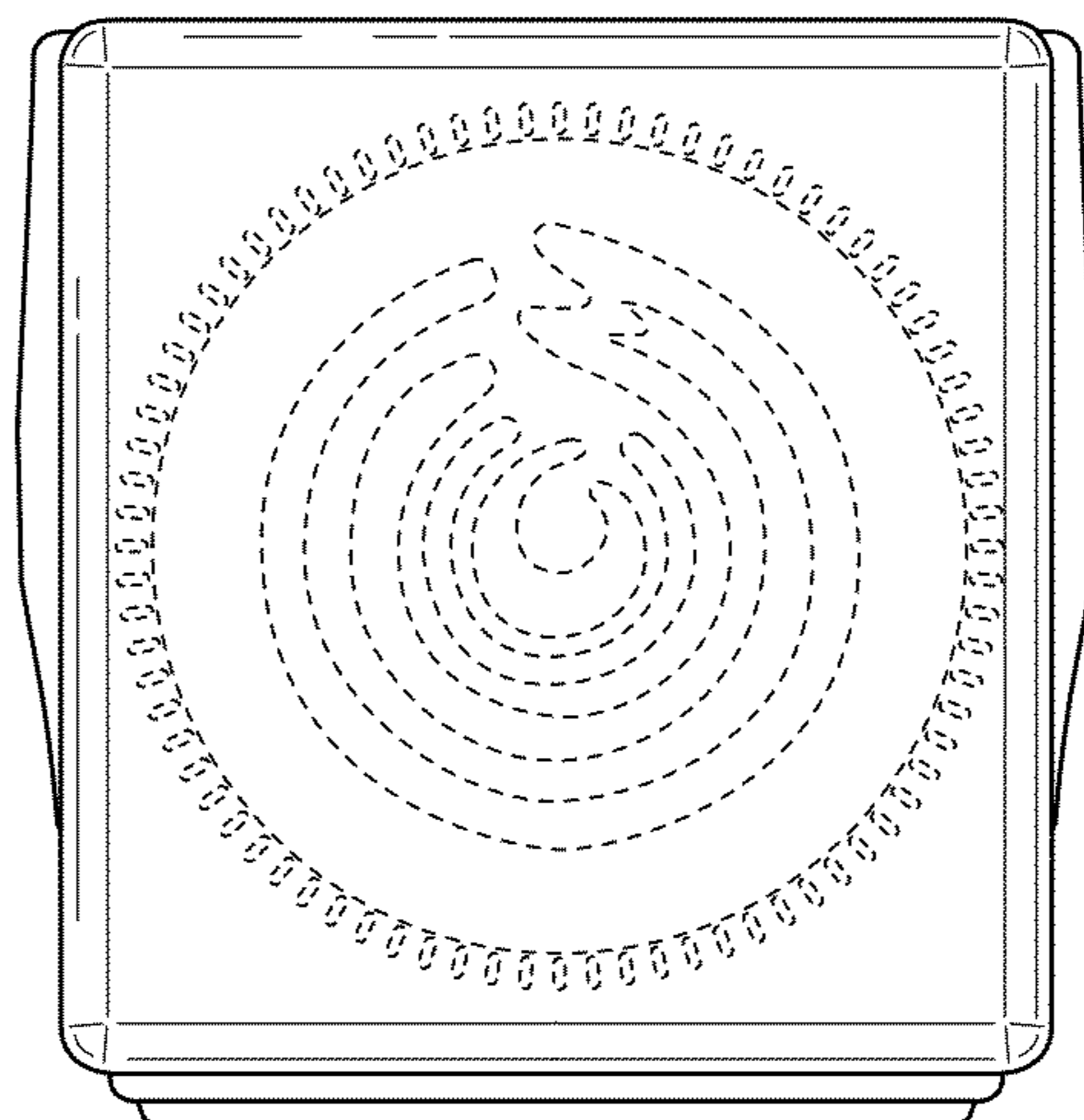

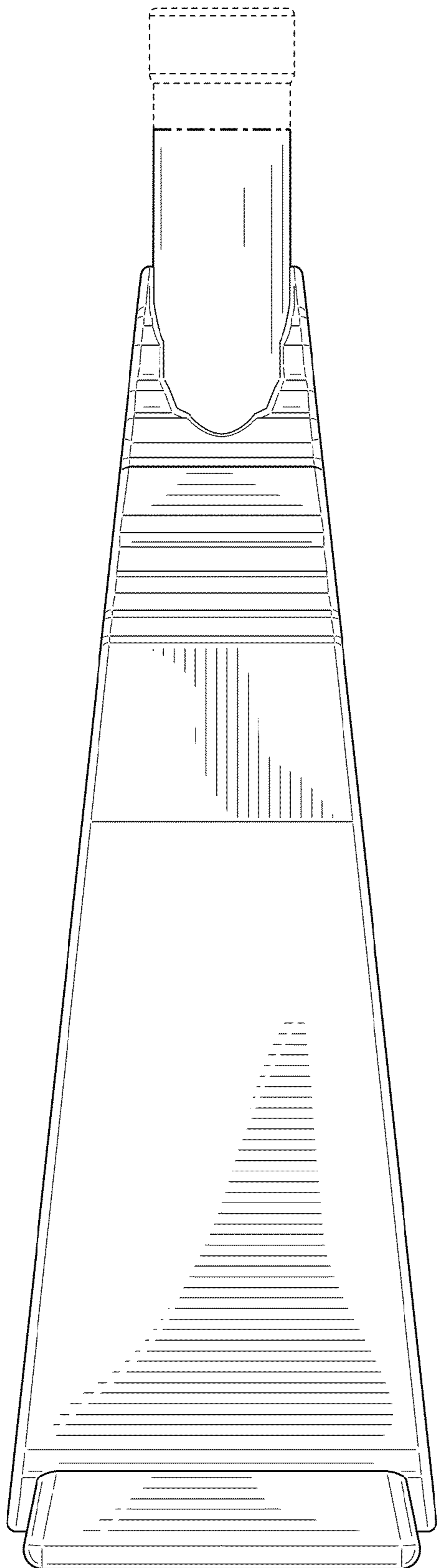

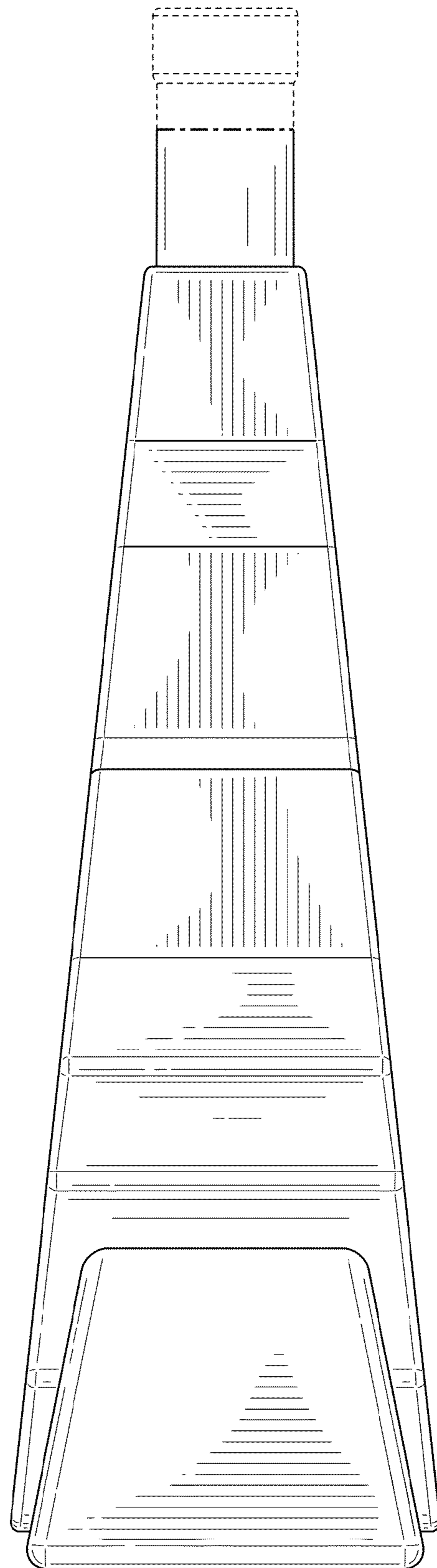

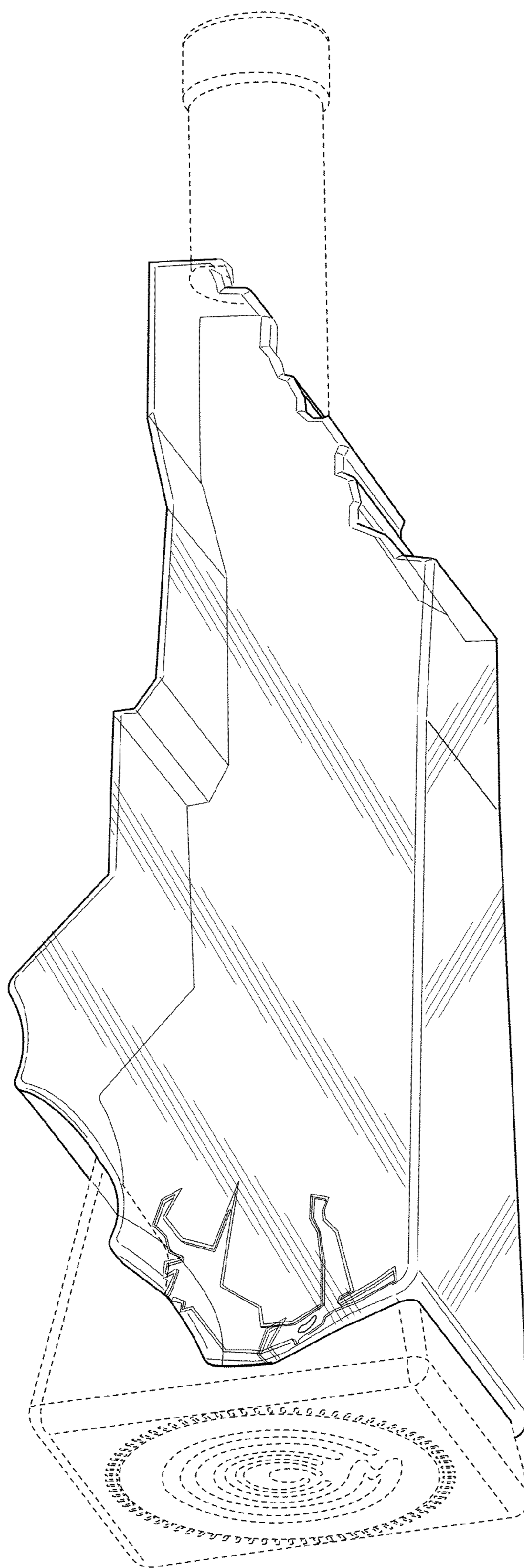

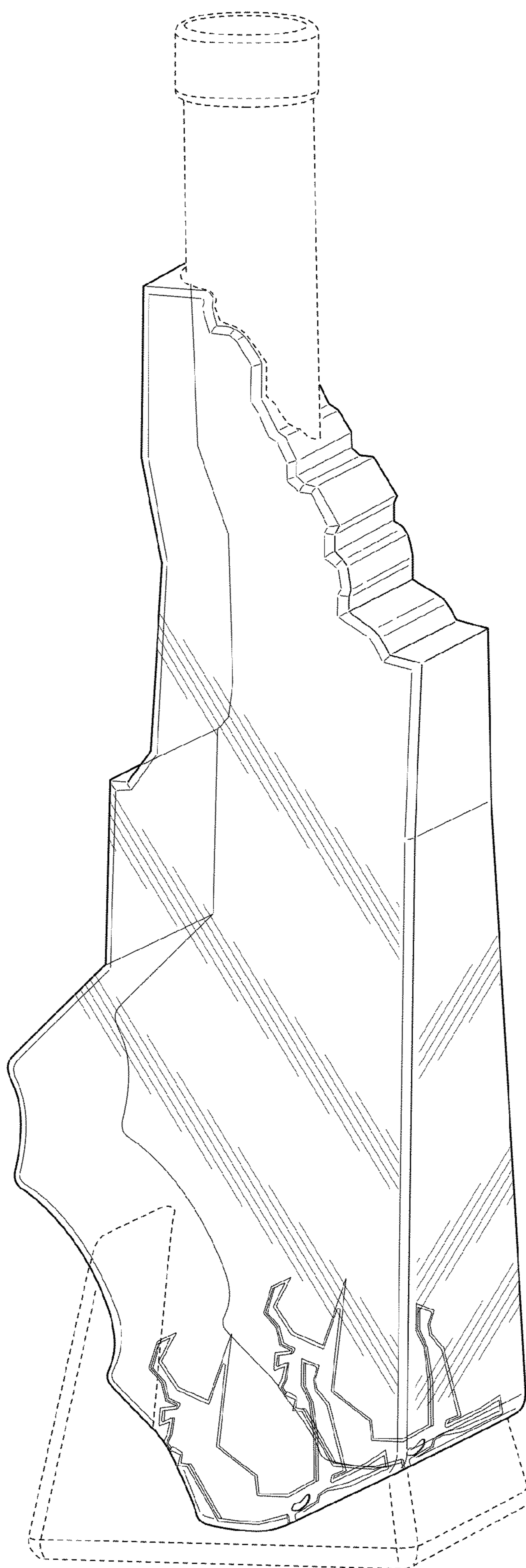

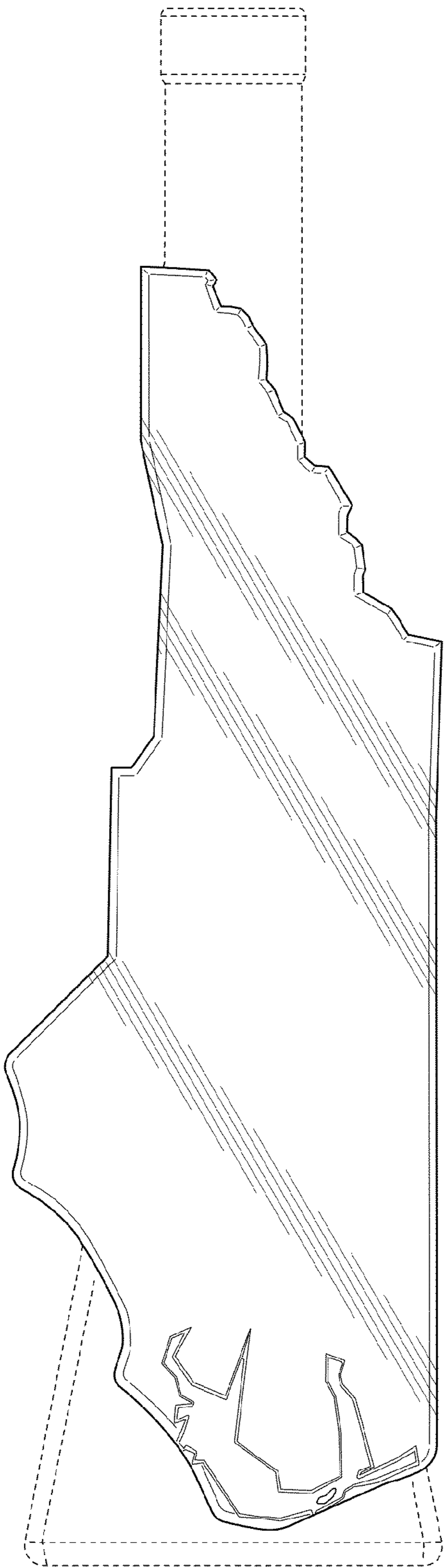

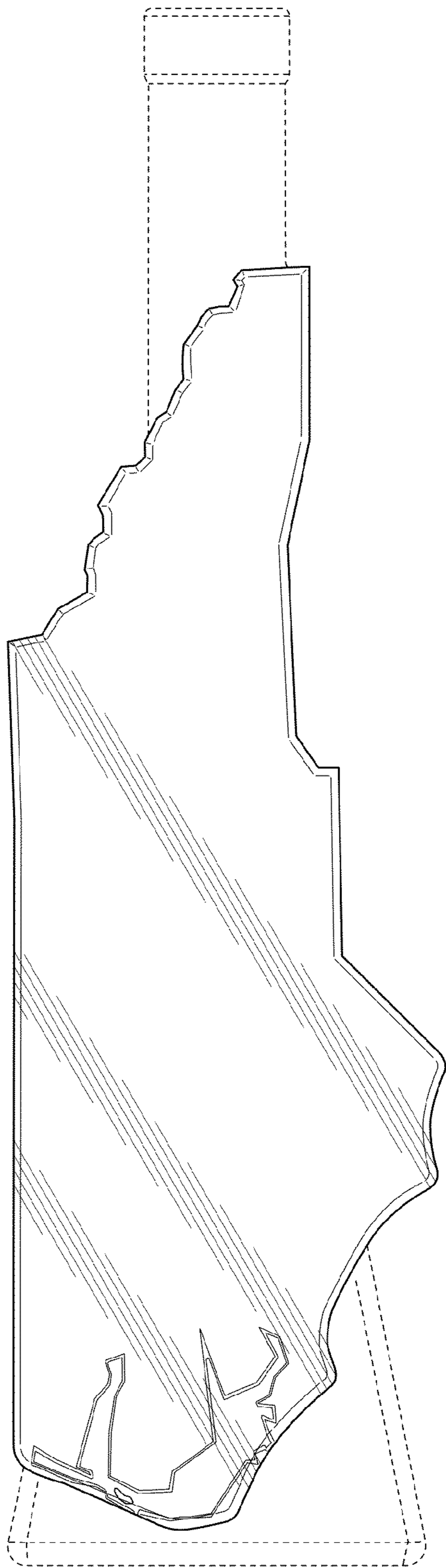

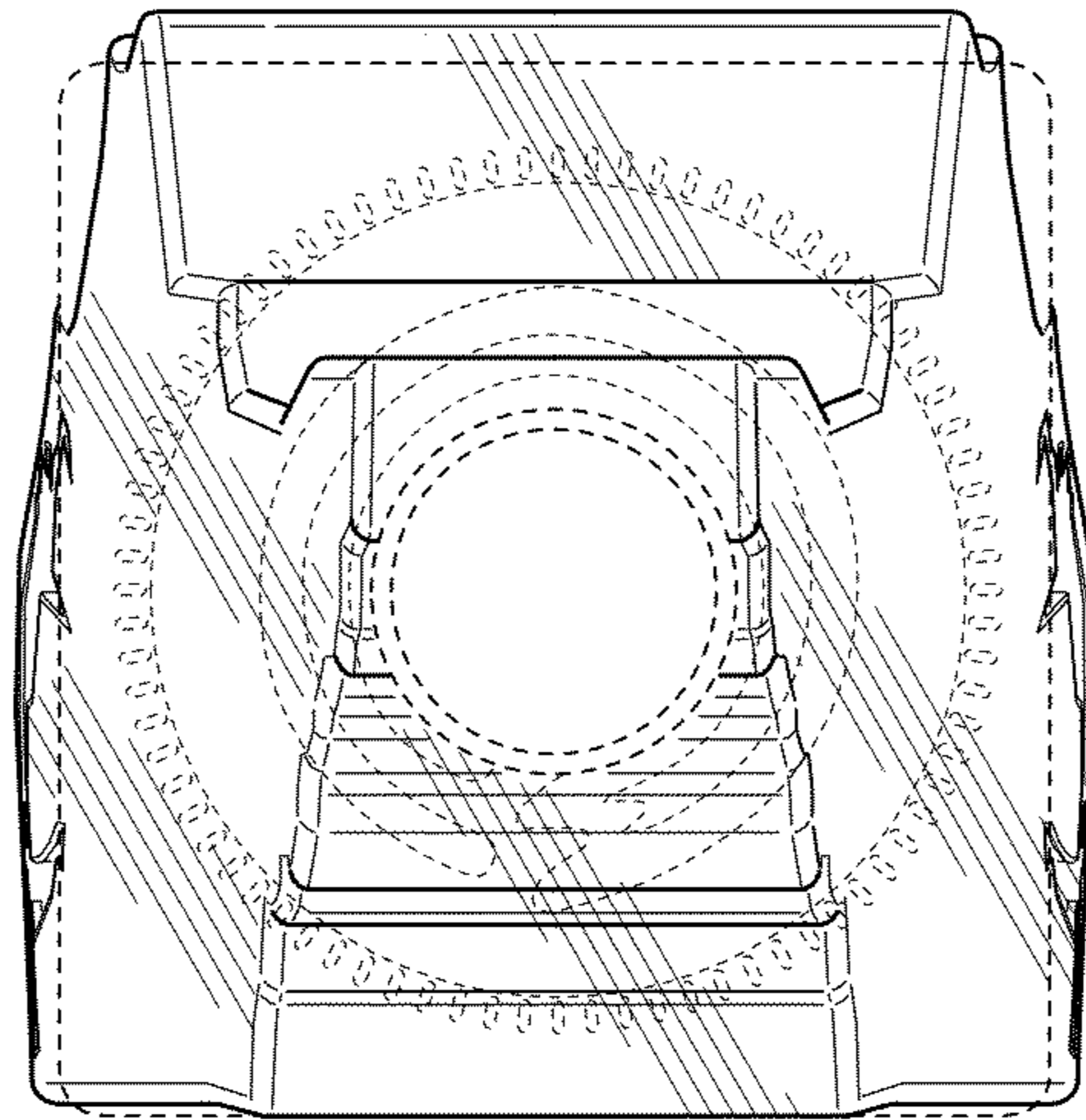

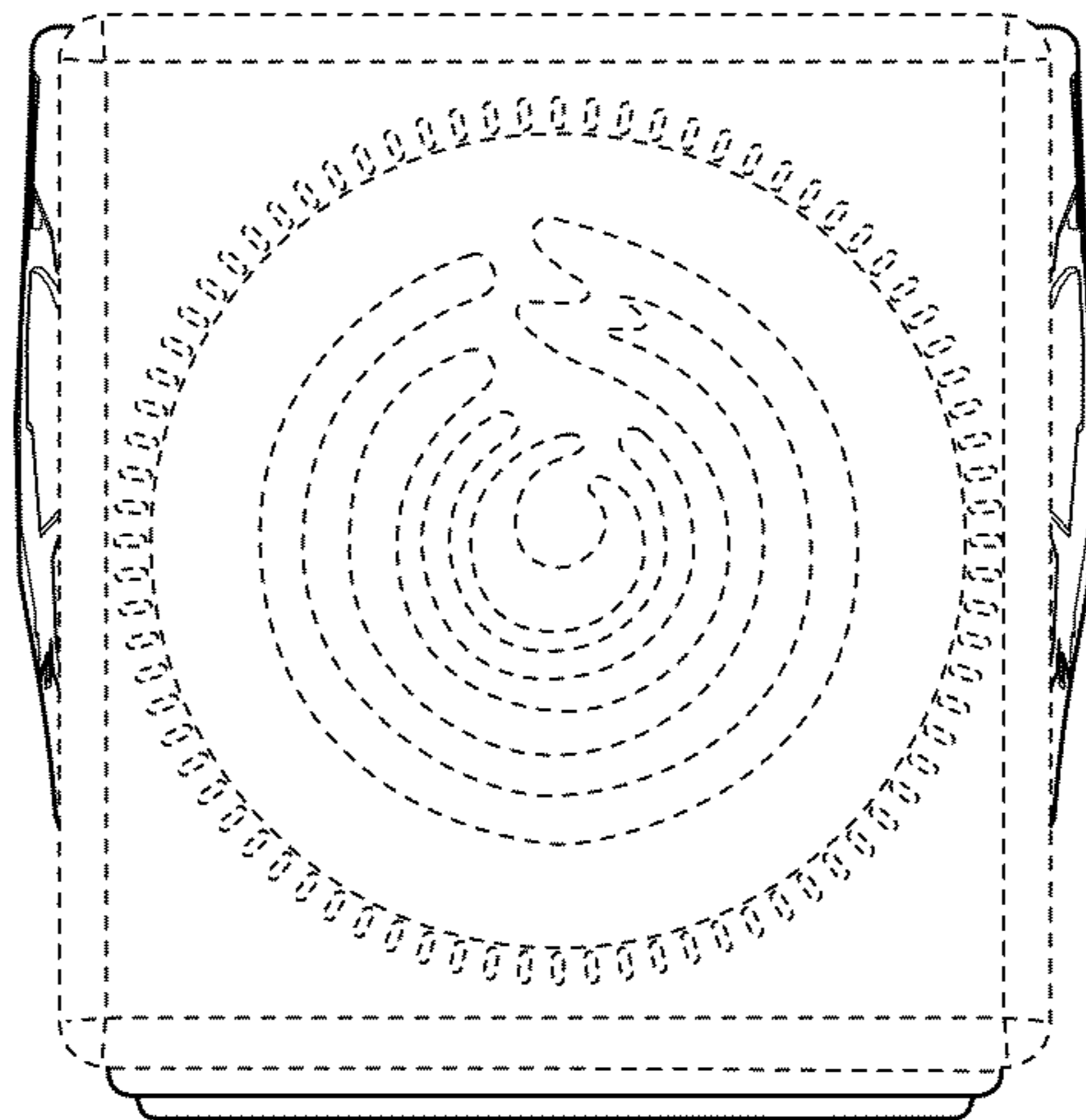

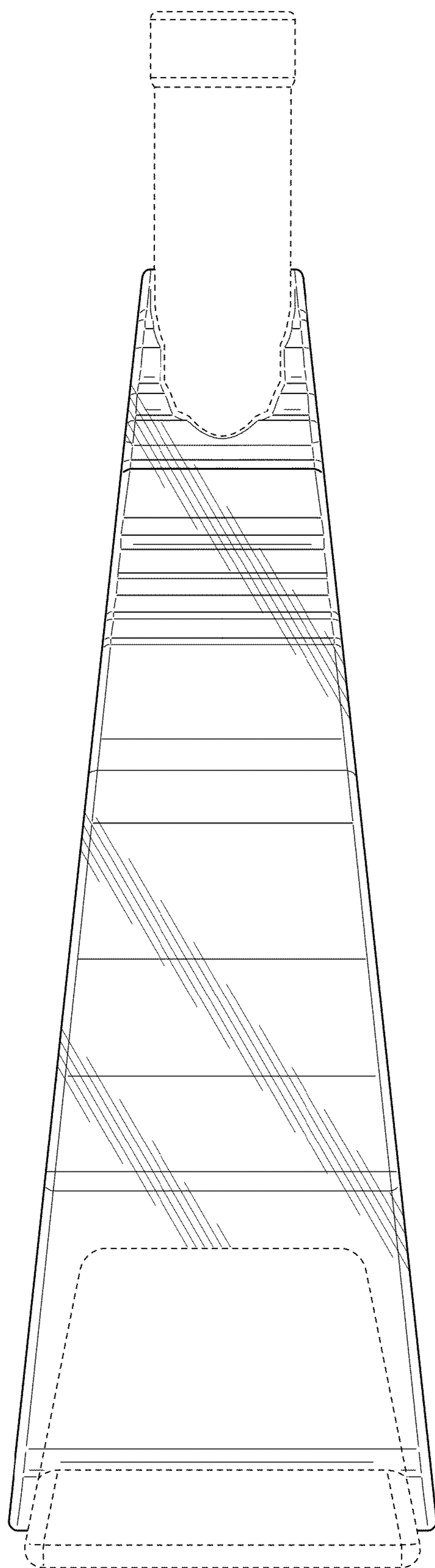

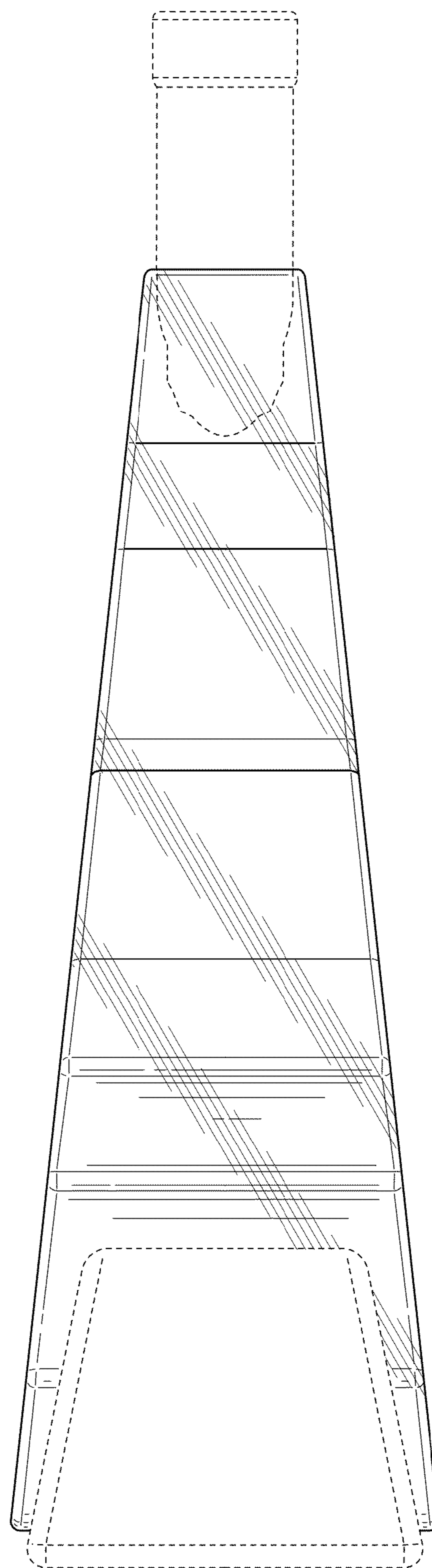
