FIG. 1.

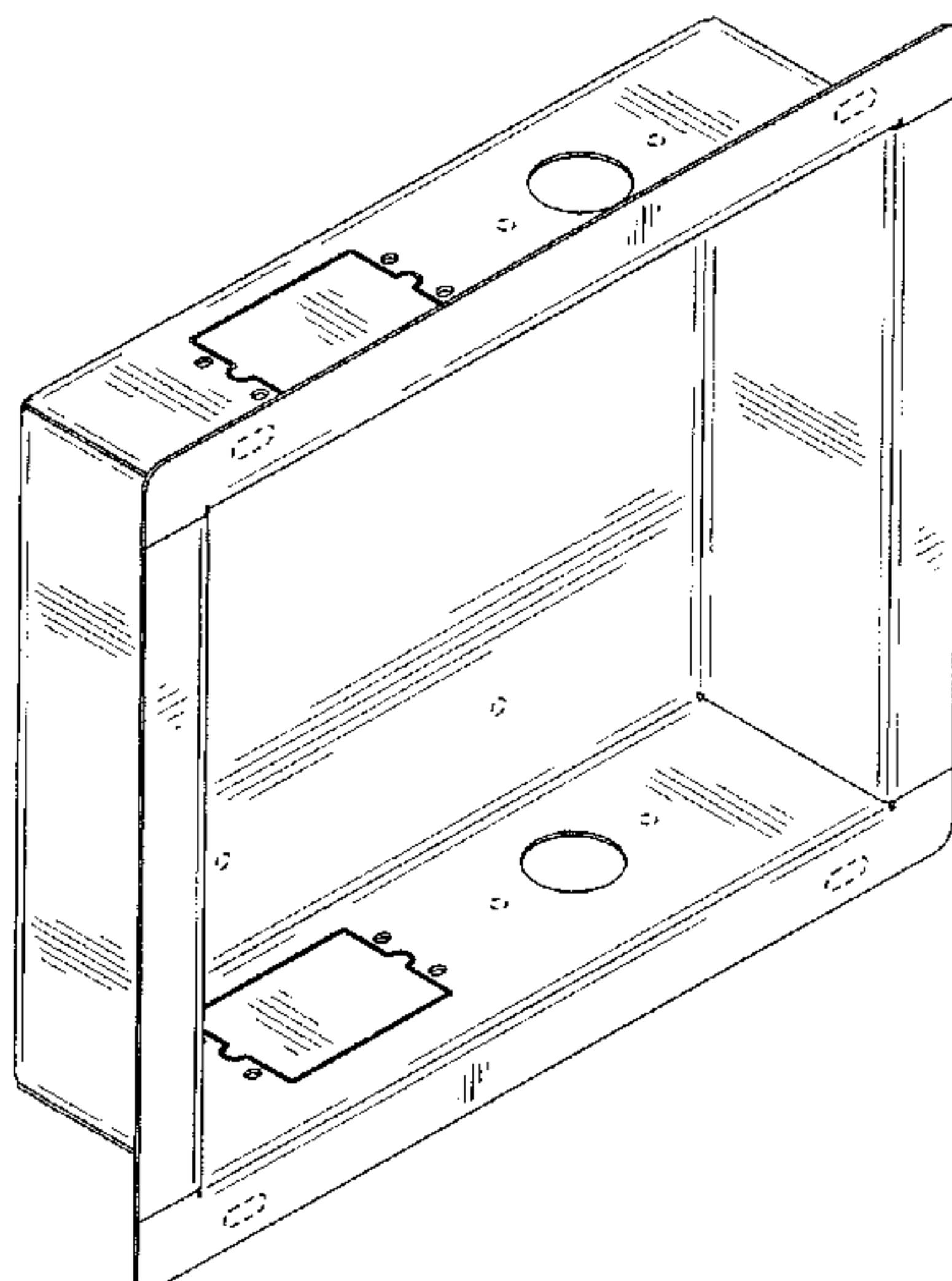
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the claimed design of FIG. 1.

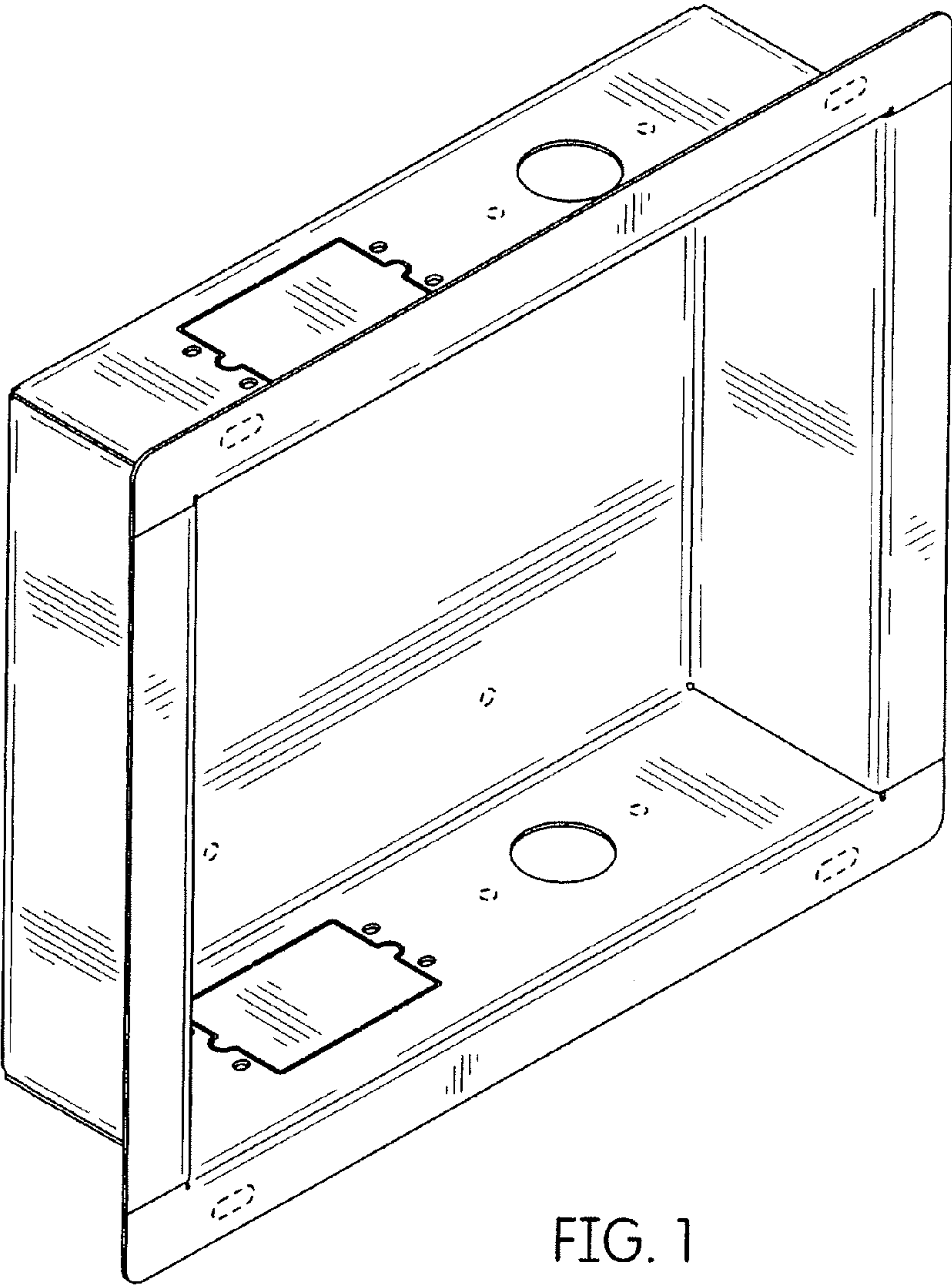

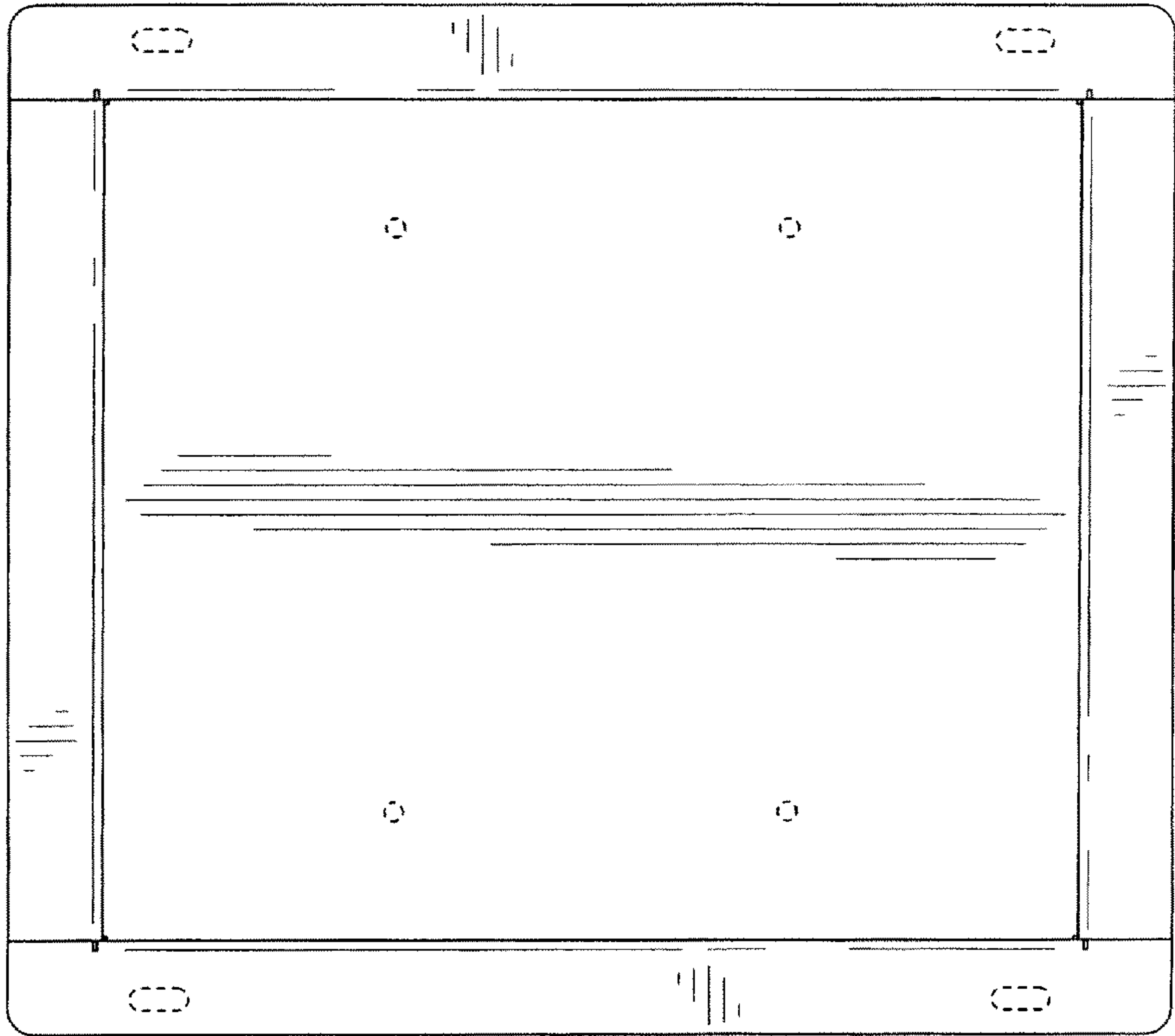

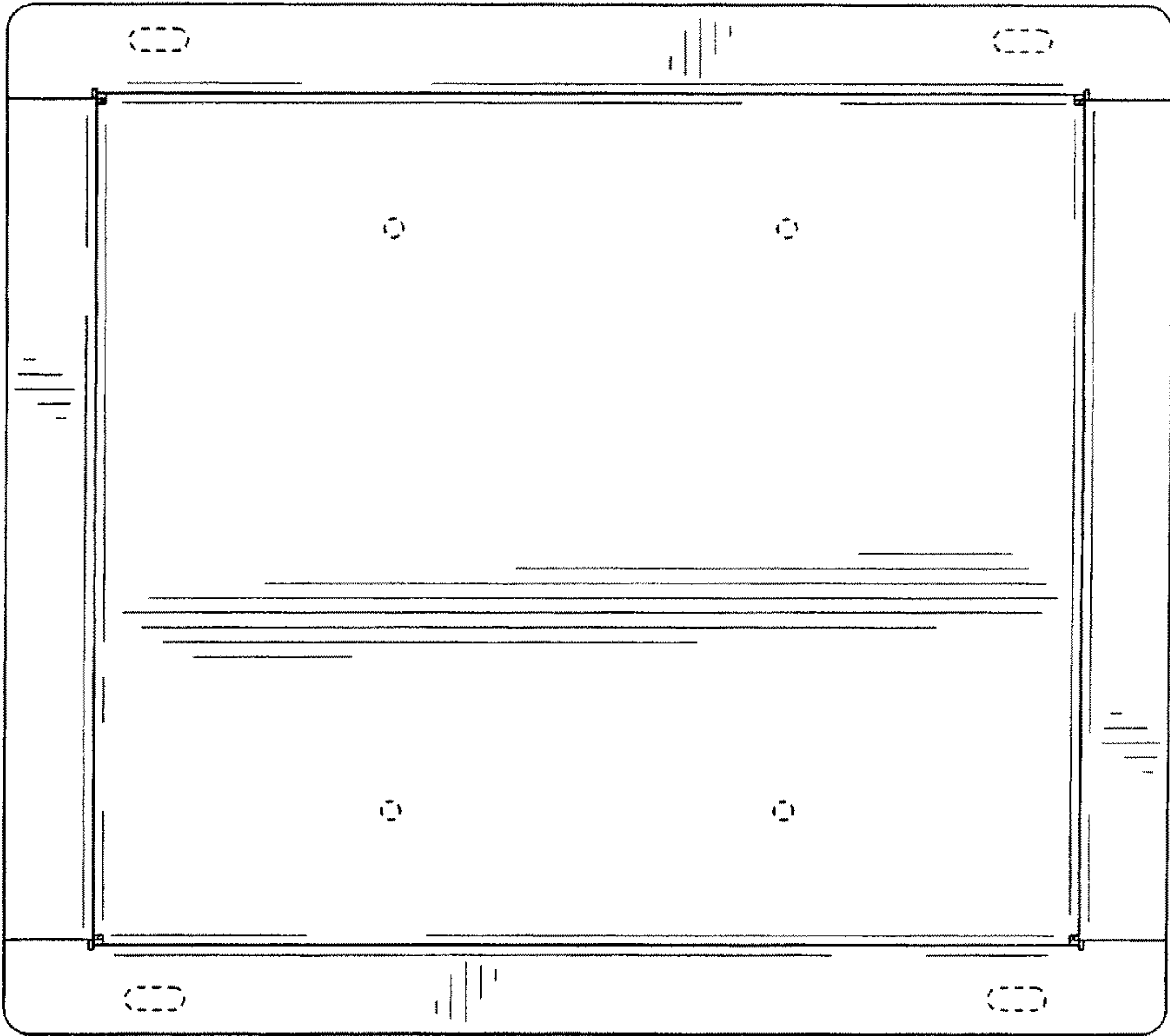

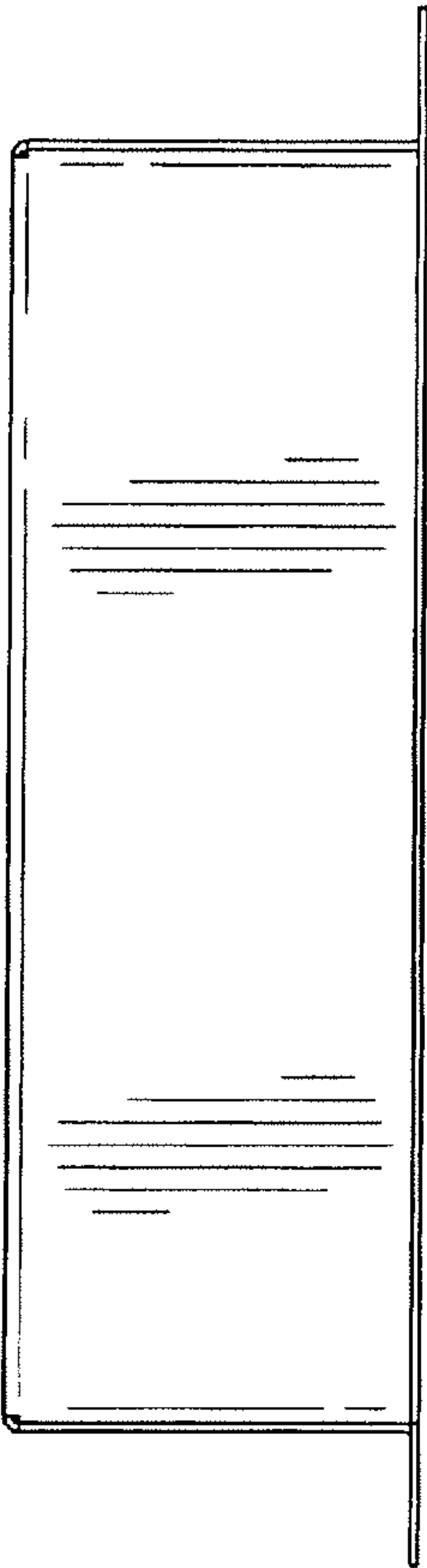

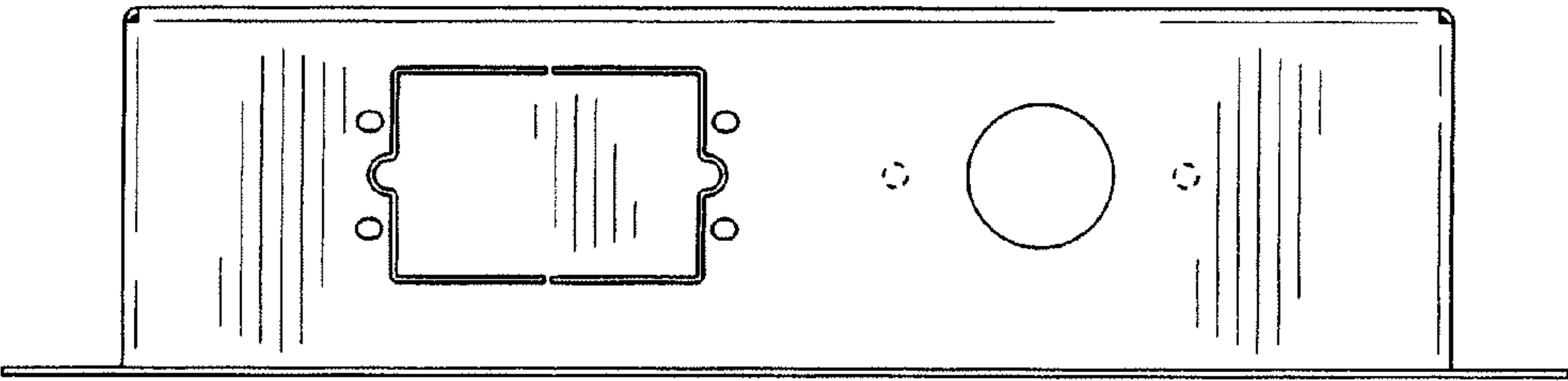

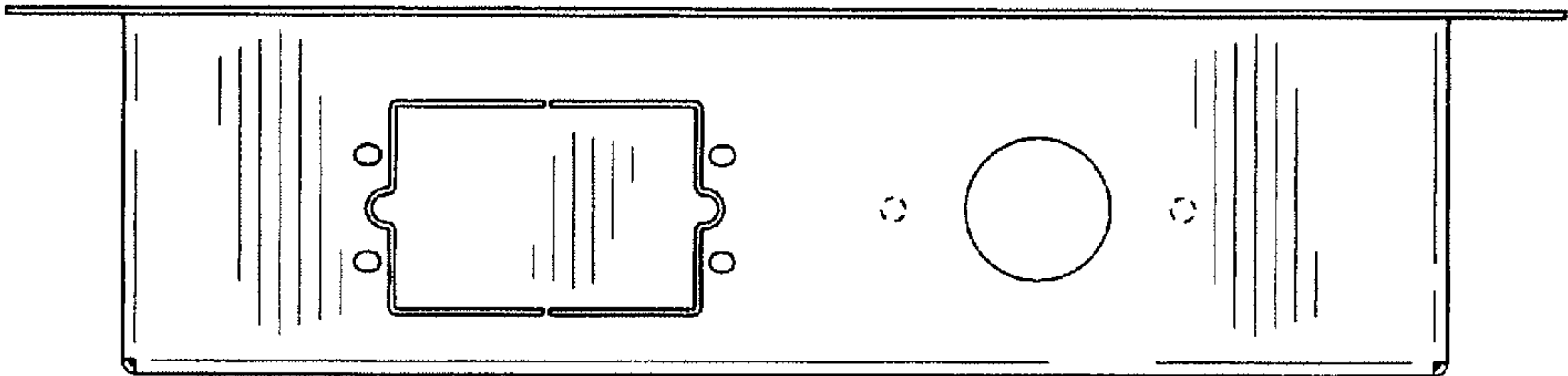

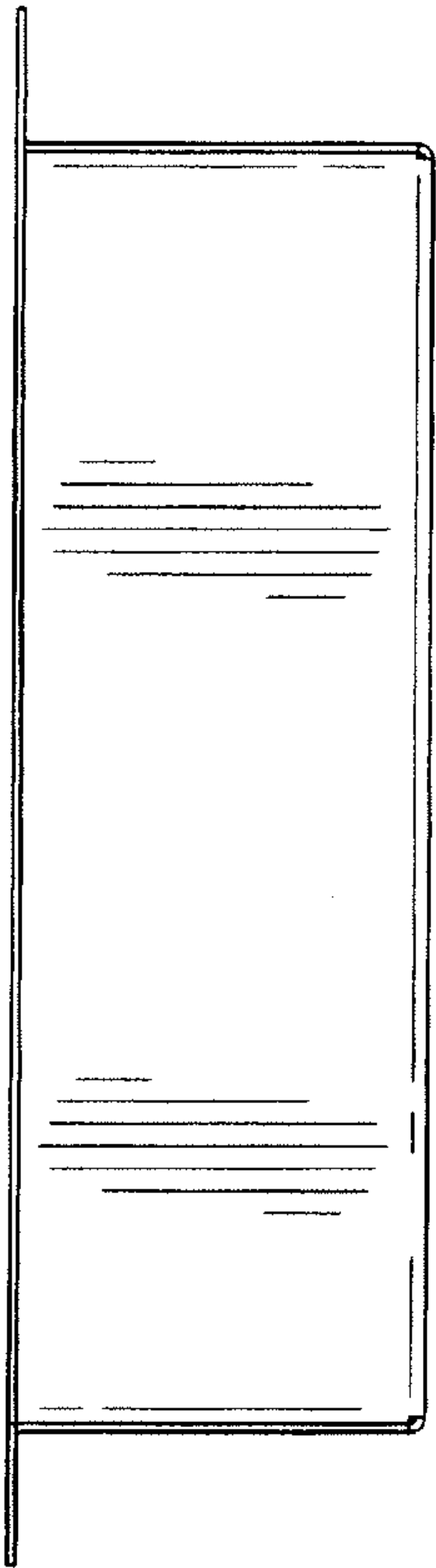
