(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a card pocket for portable electronic device, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a card pocket for portable electronic device disposed on a portable electronic device showing my new design;

FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view thereof;

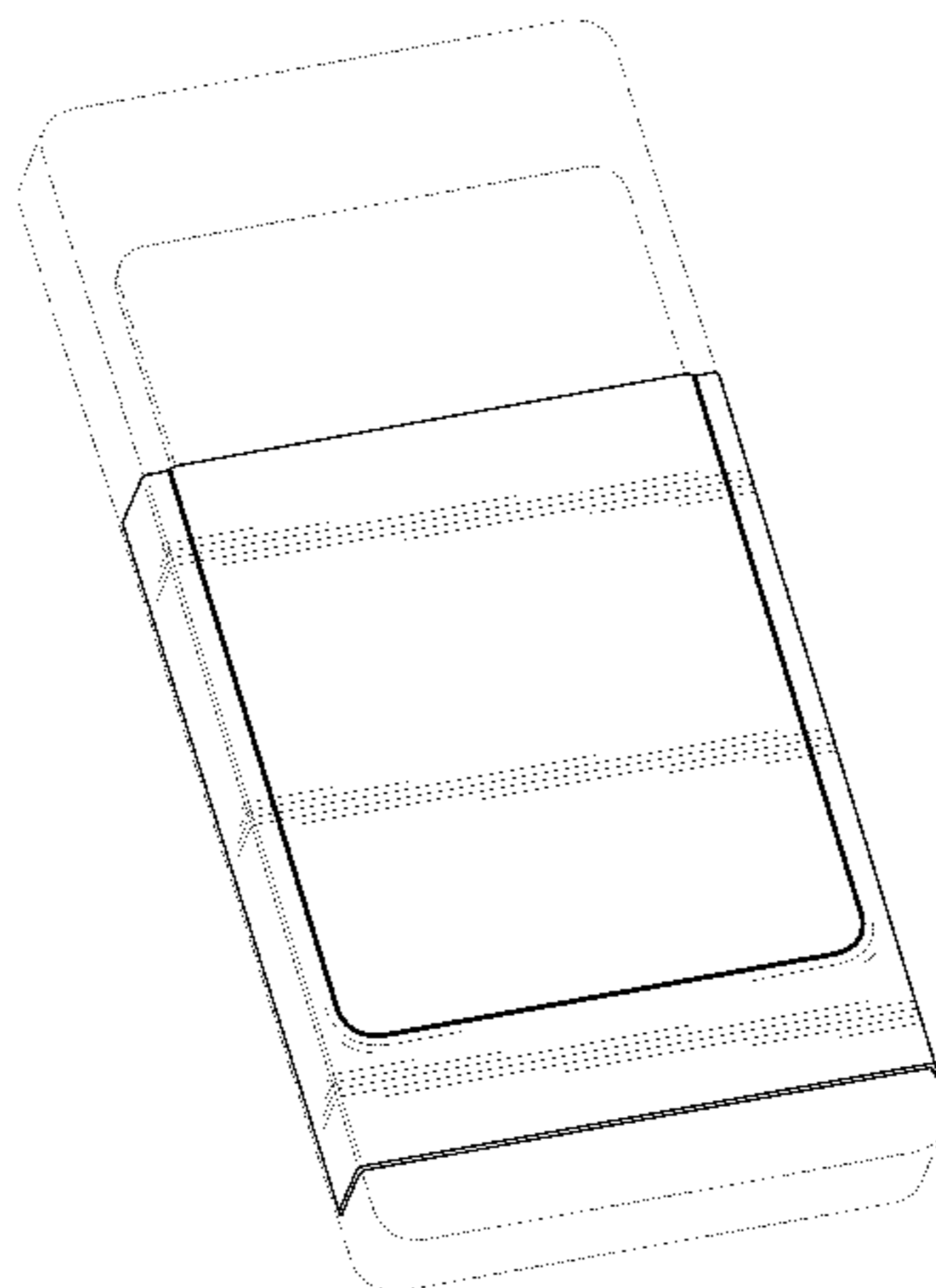
FIG. 16 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

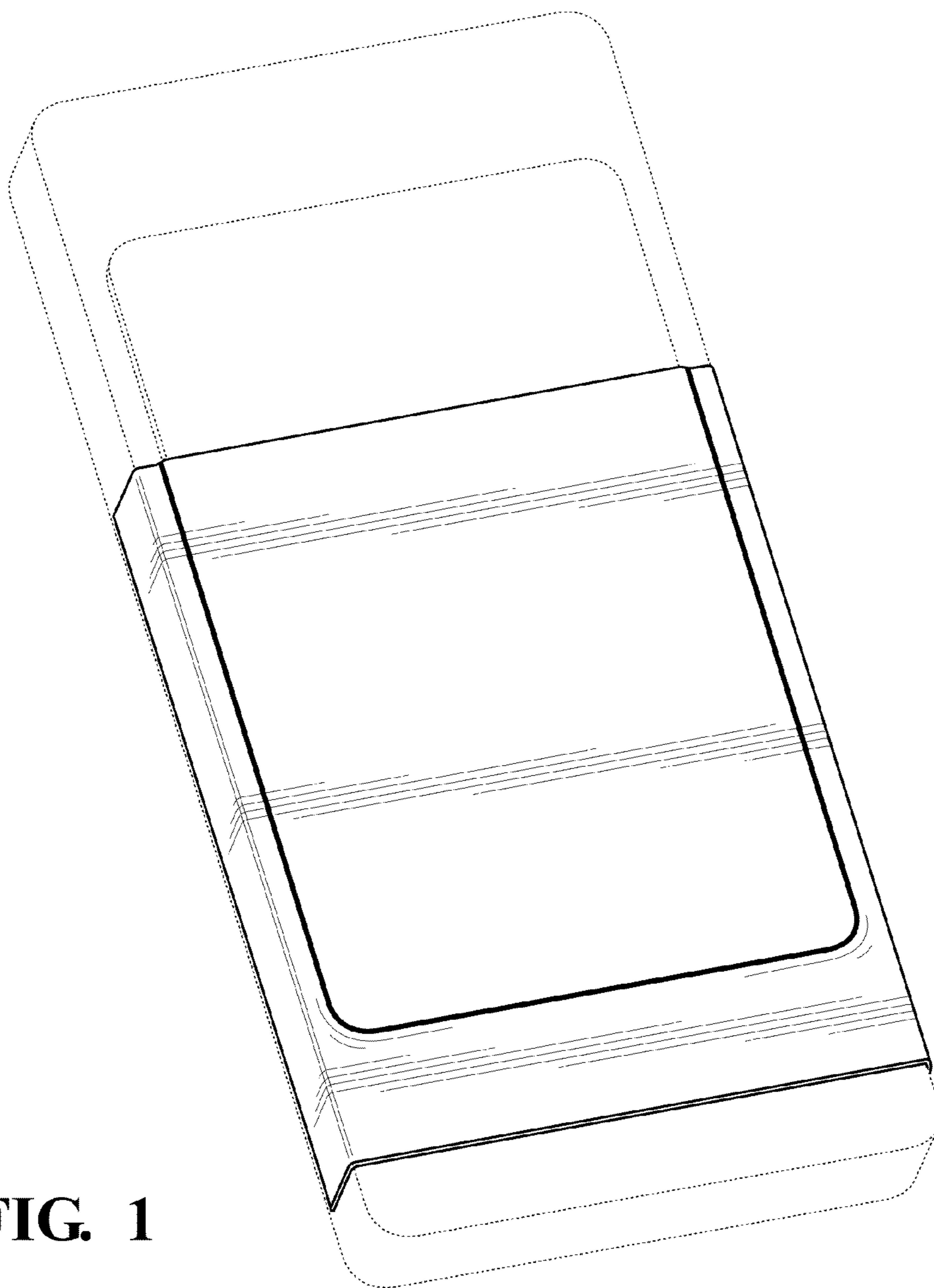
FIG. 17 is a top plan view thereof.

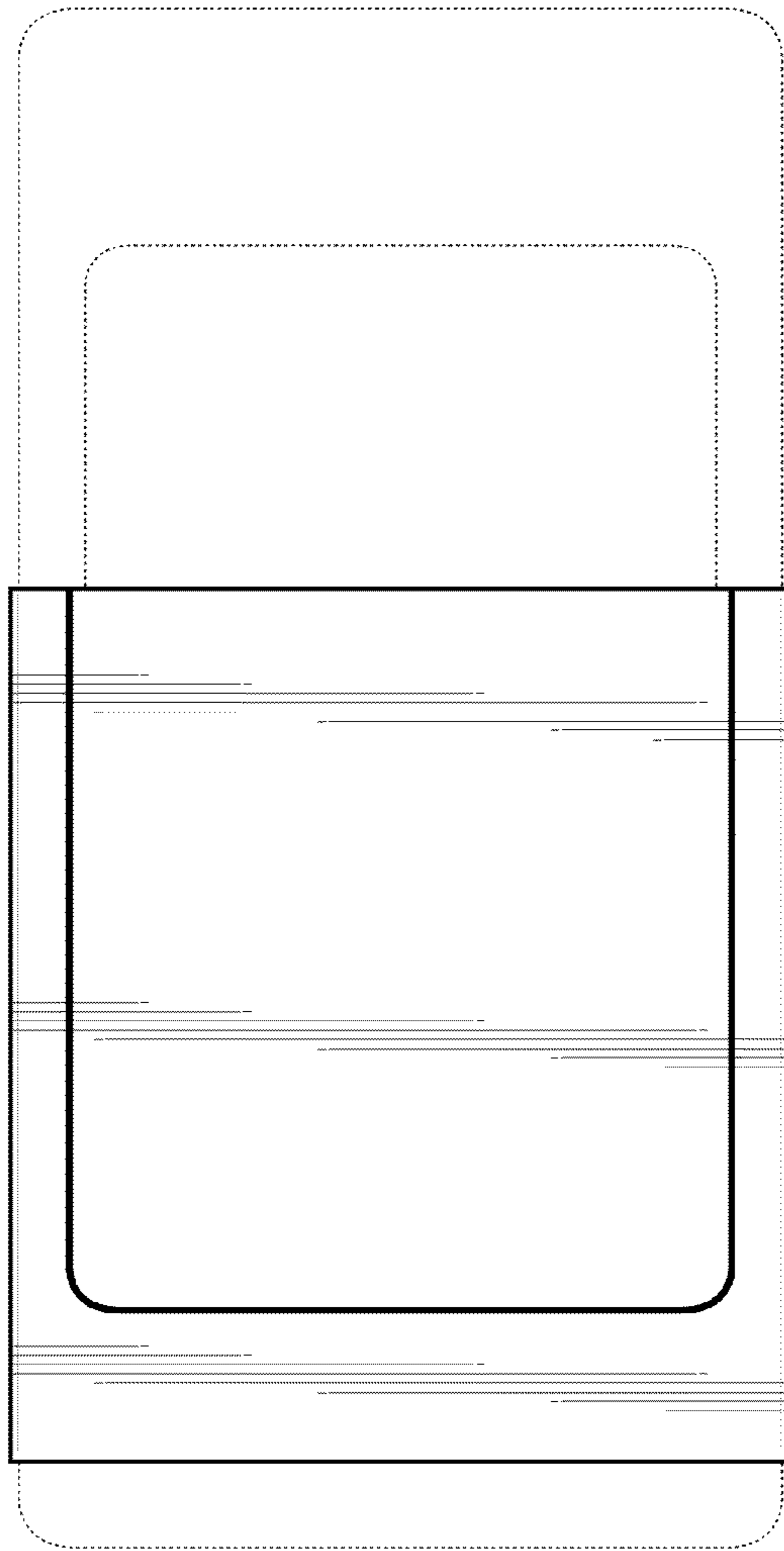

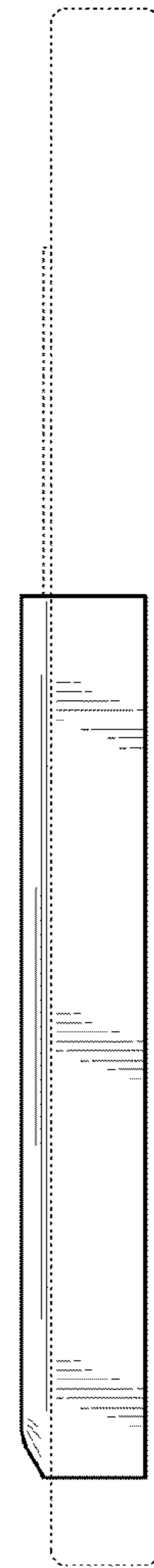

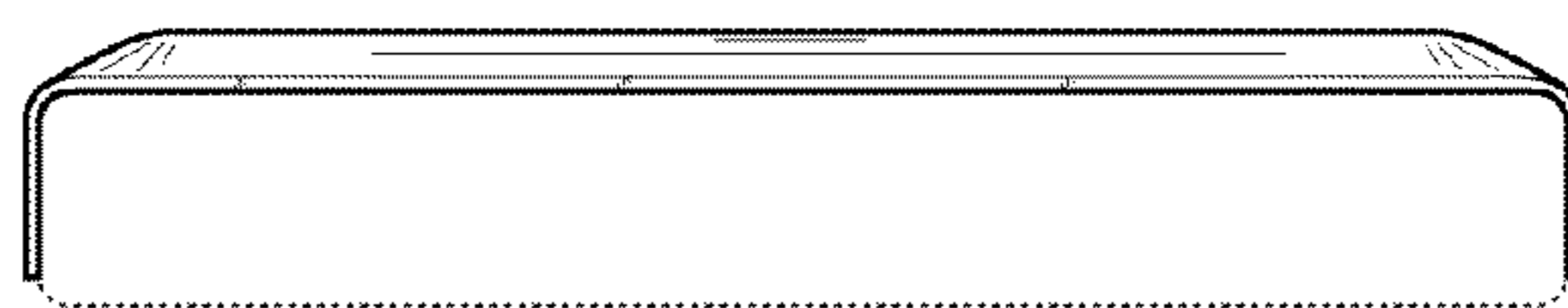
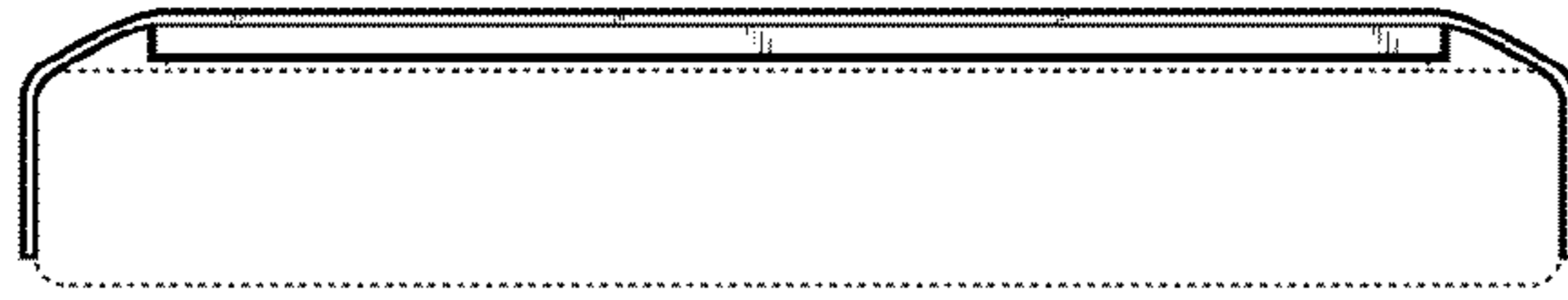
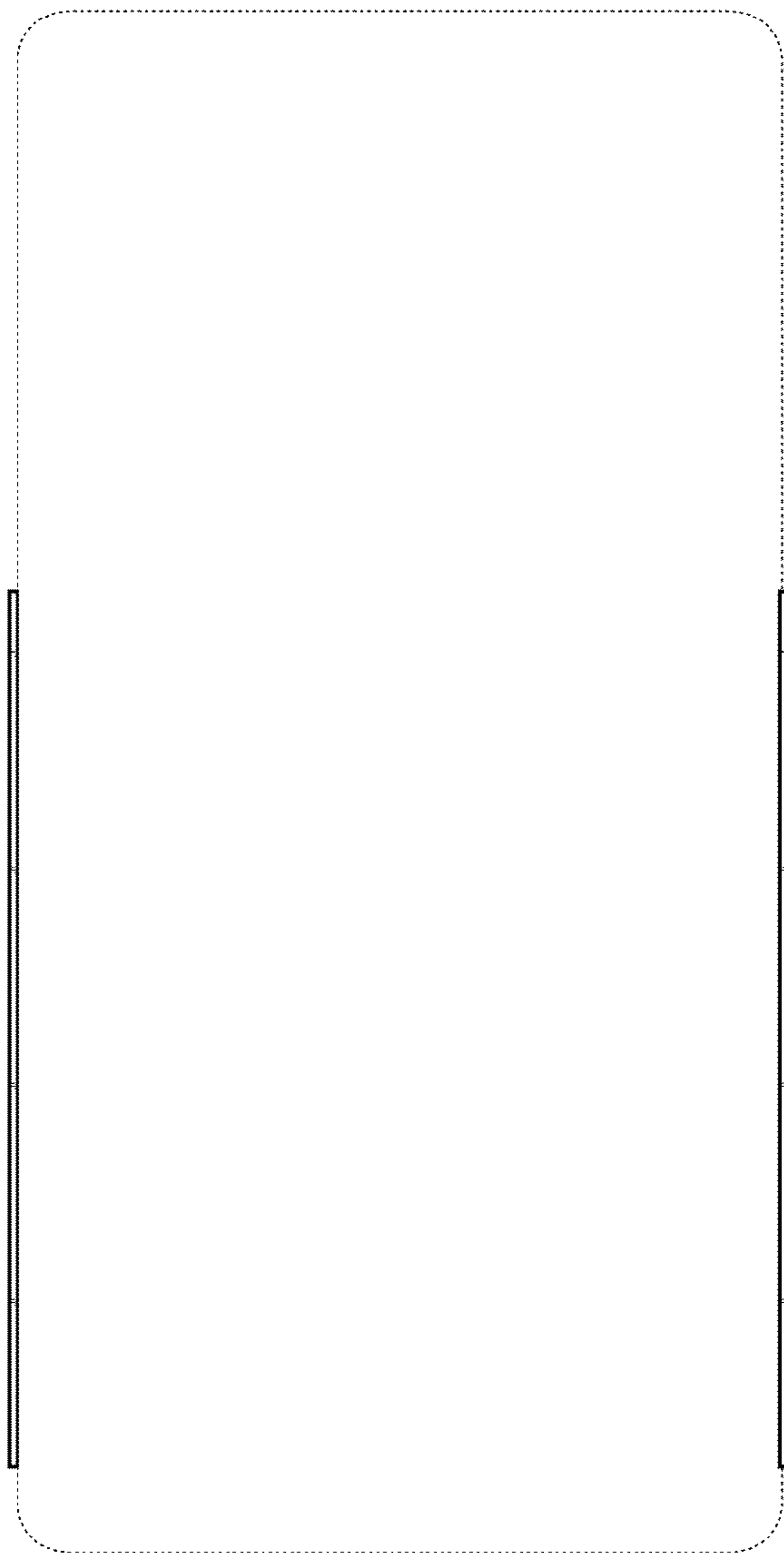

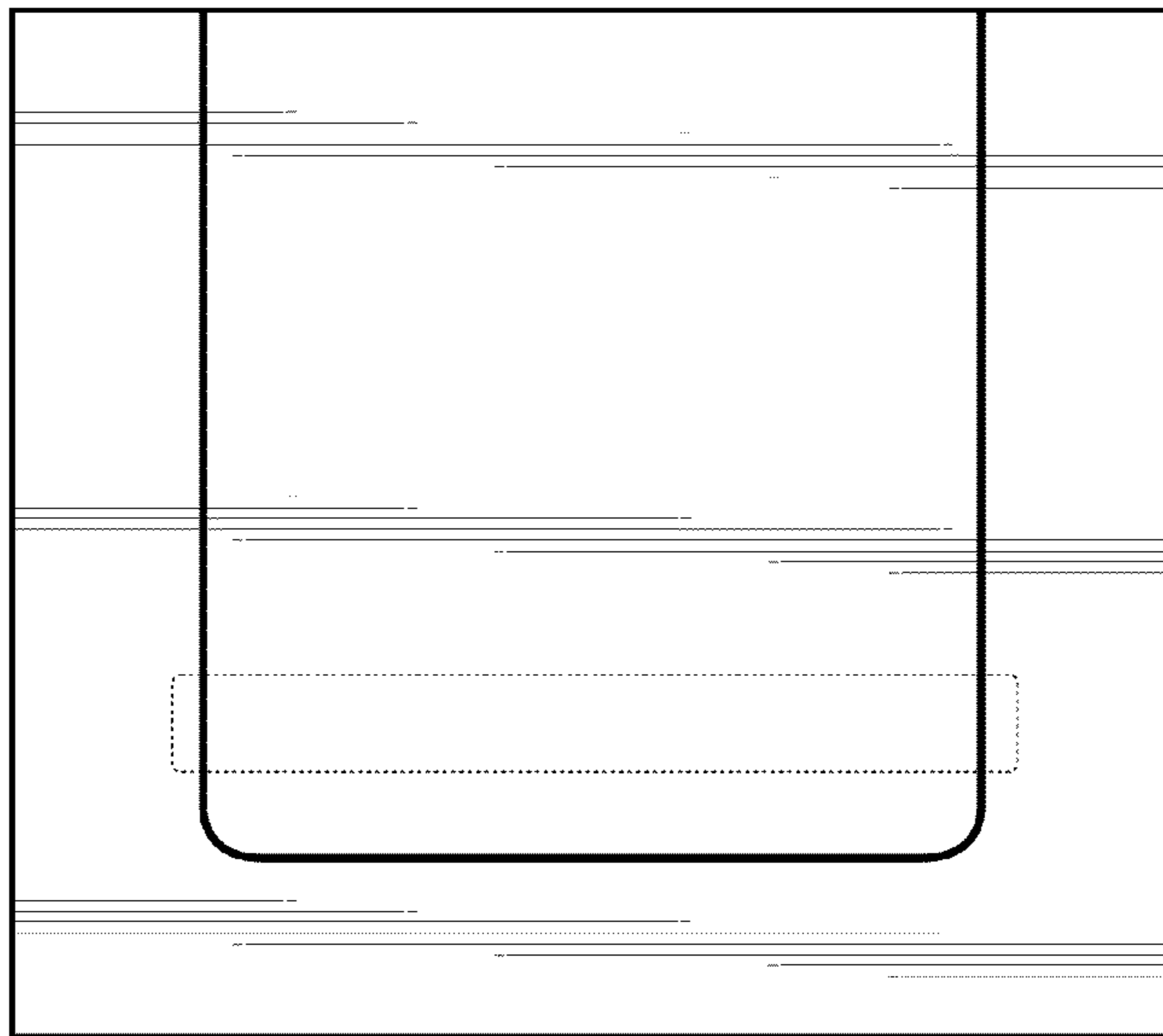

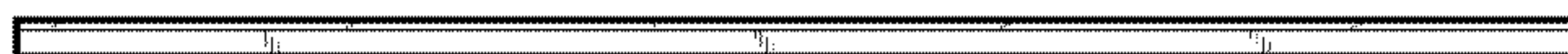

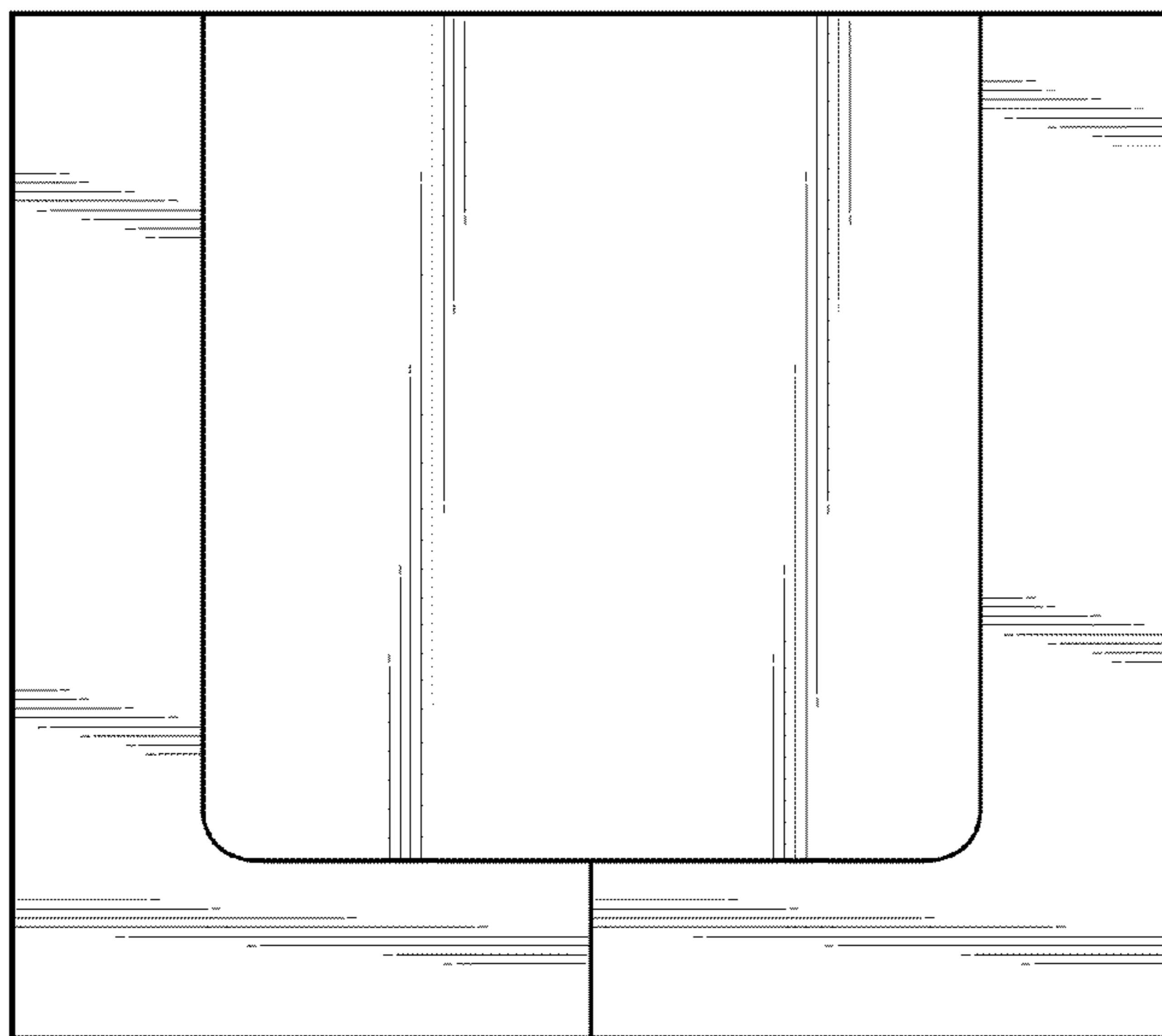
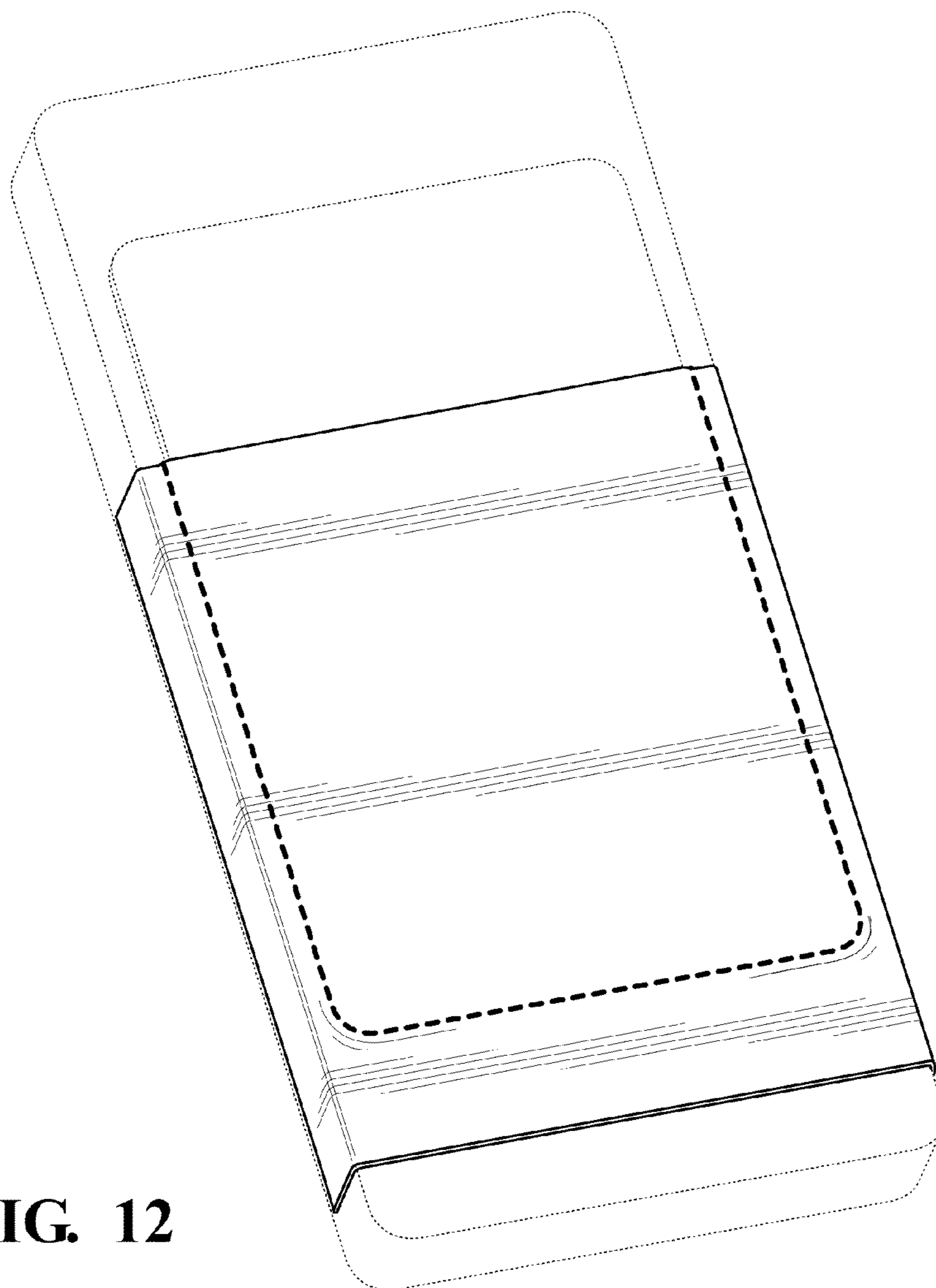

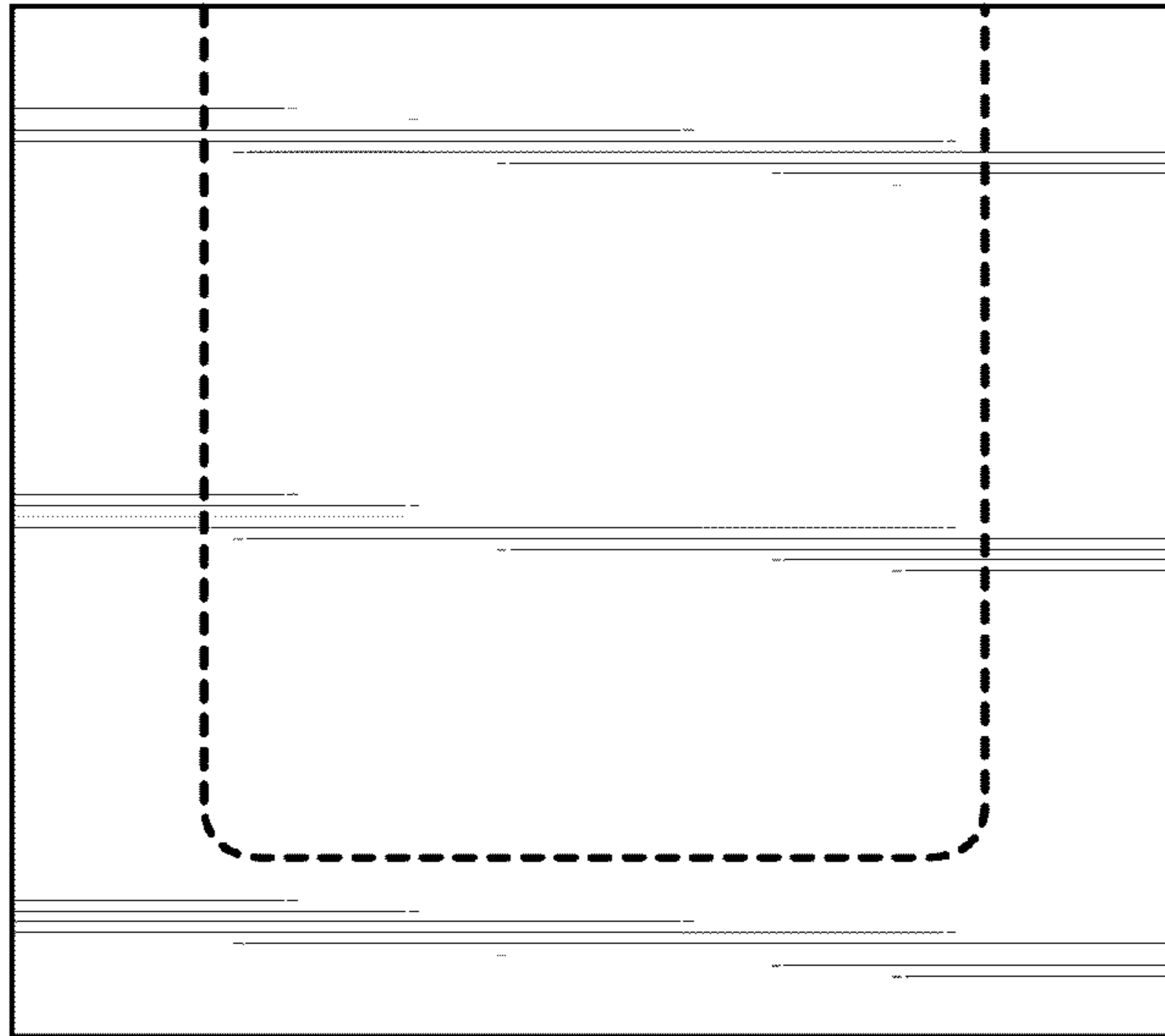

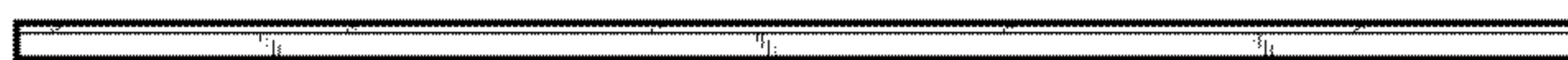

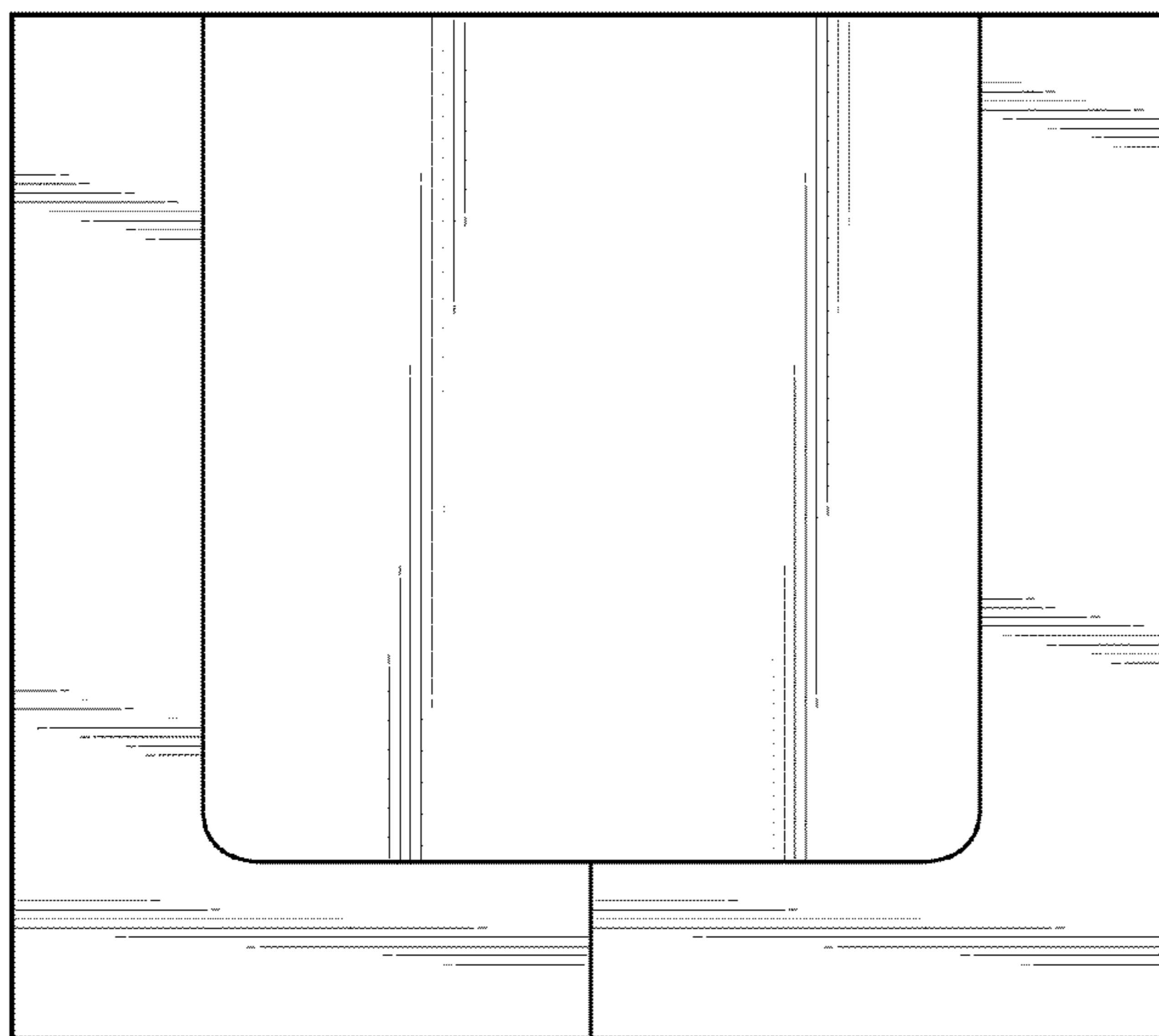
