We claim, the ornamental design for a refrigerator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

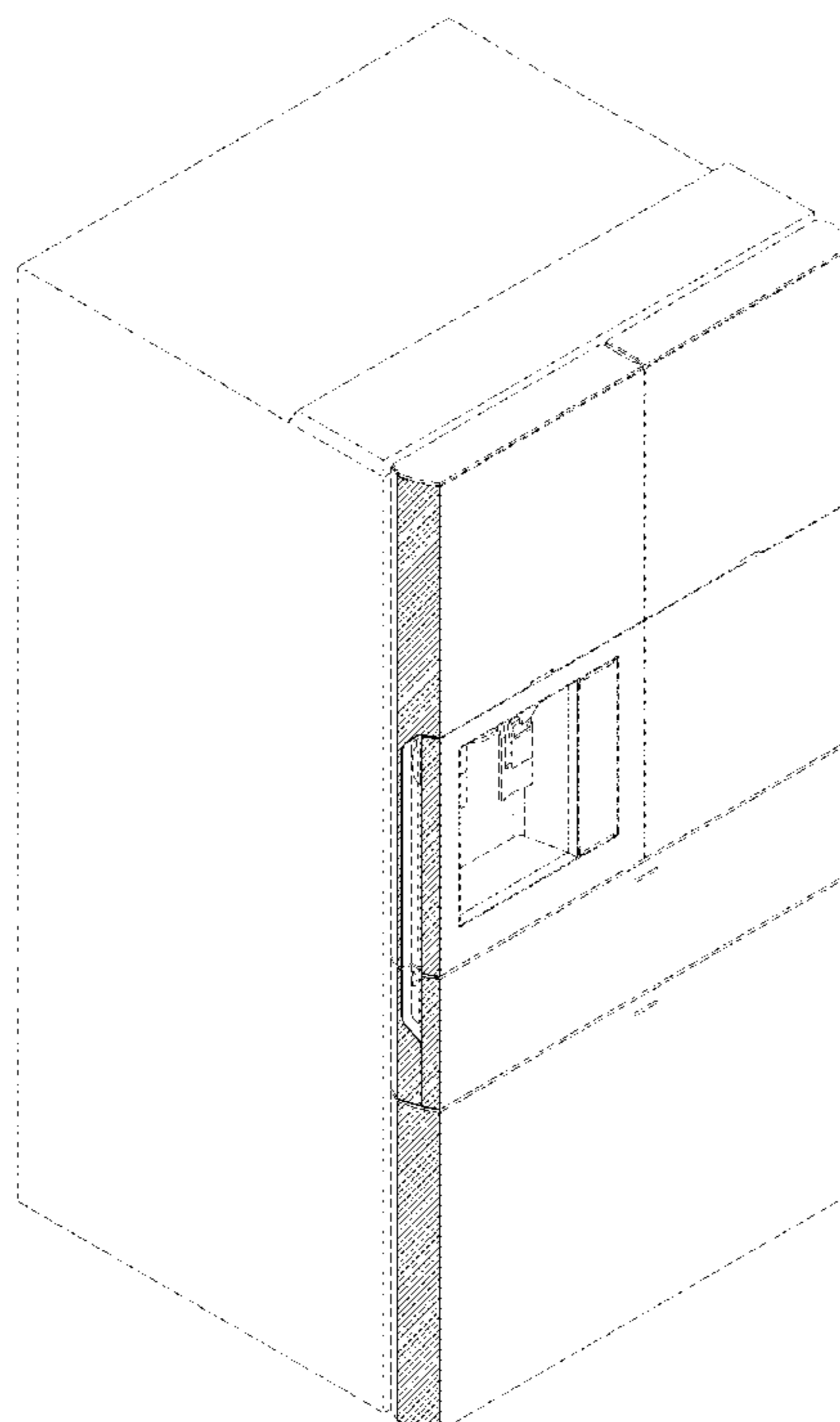

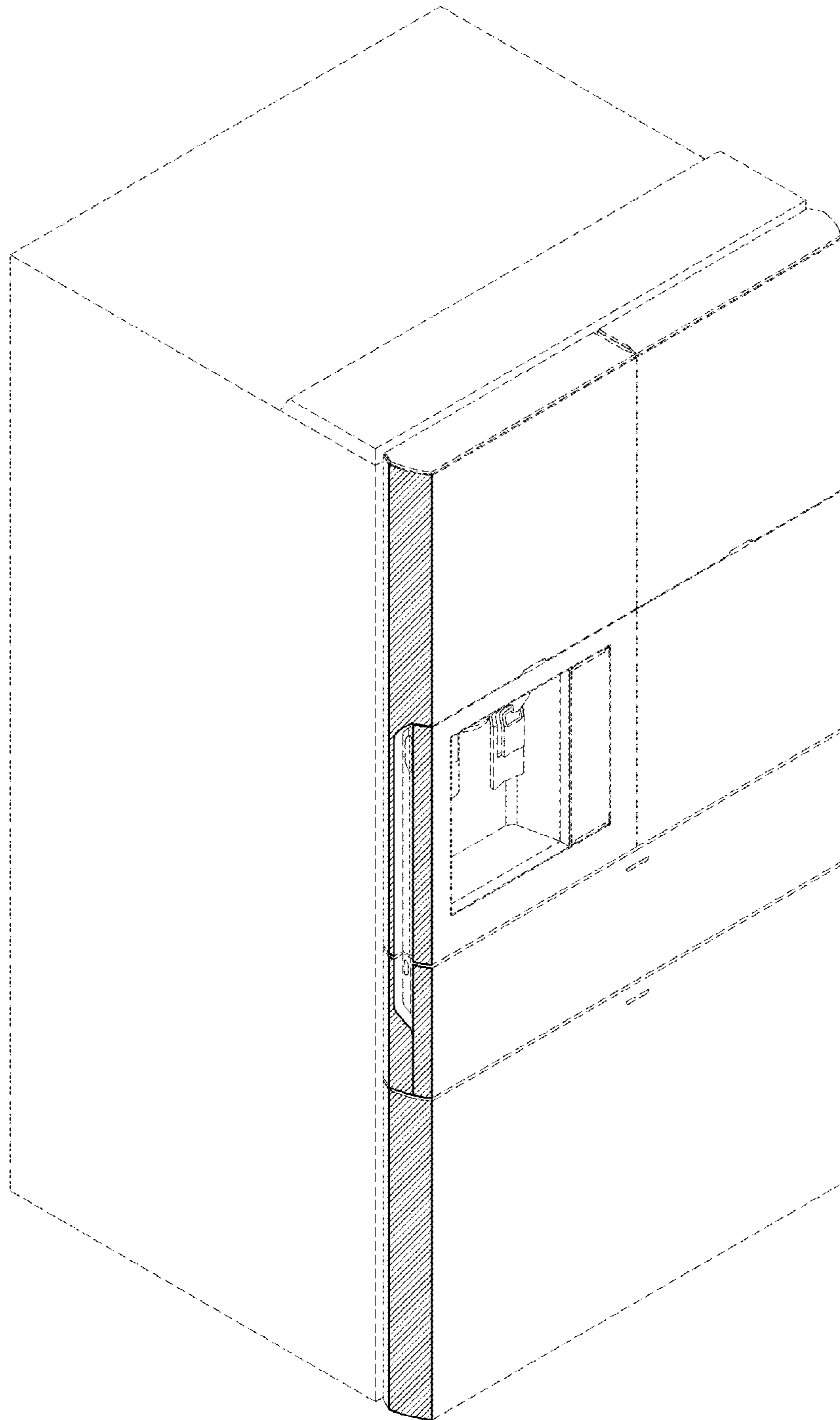

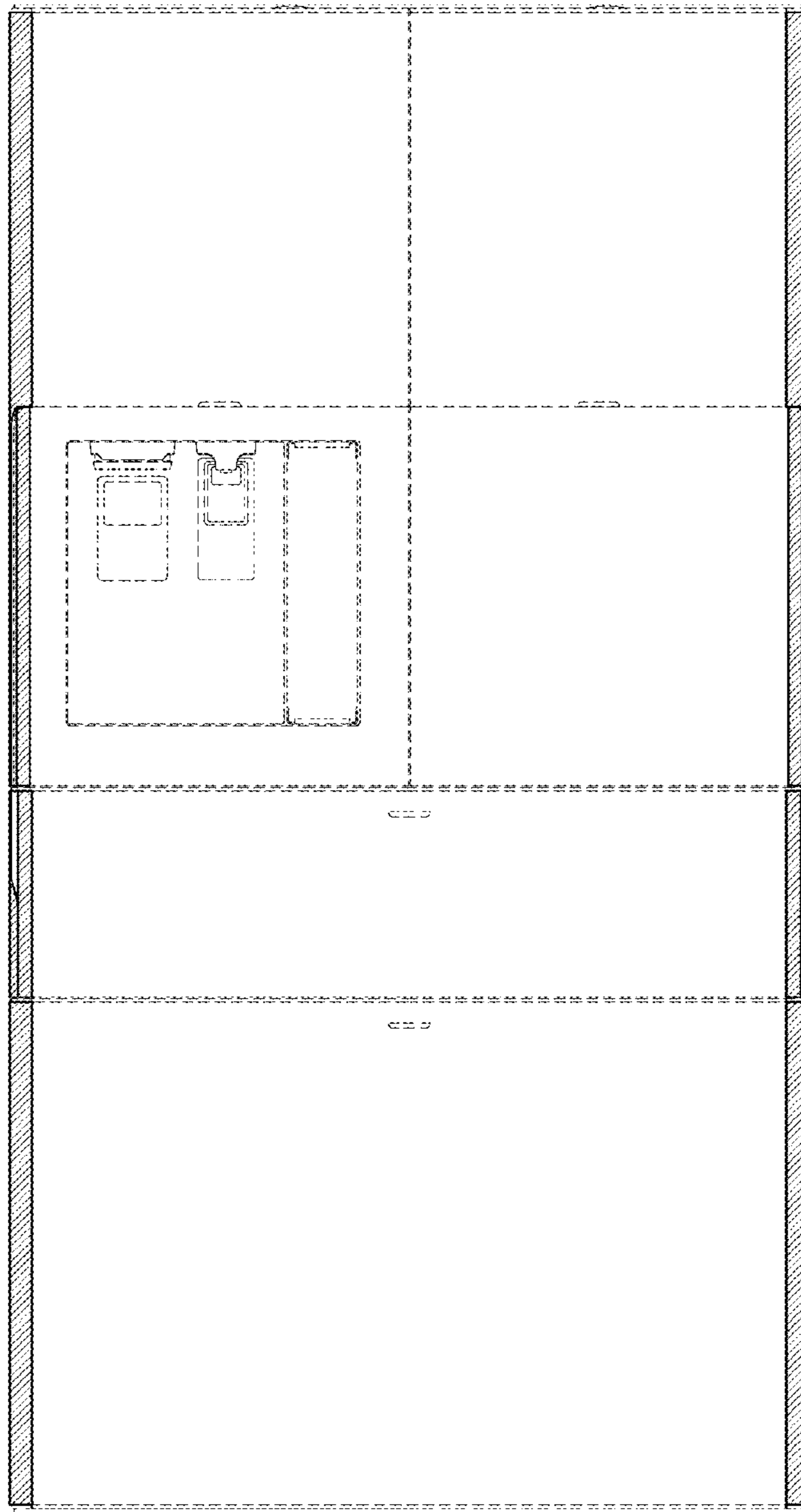

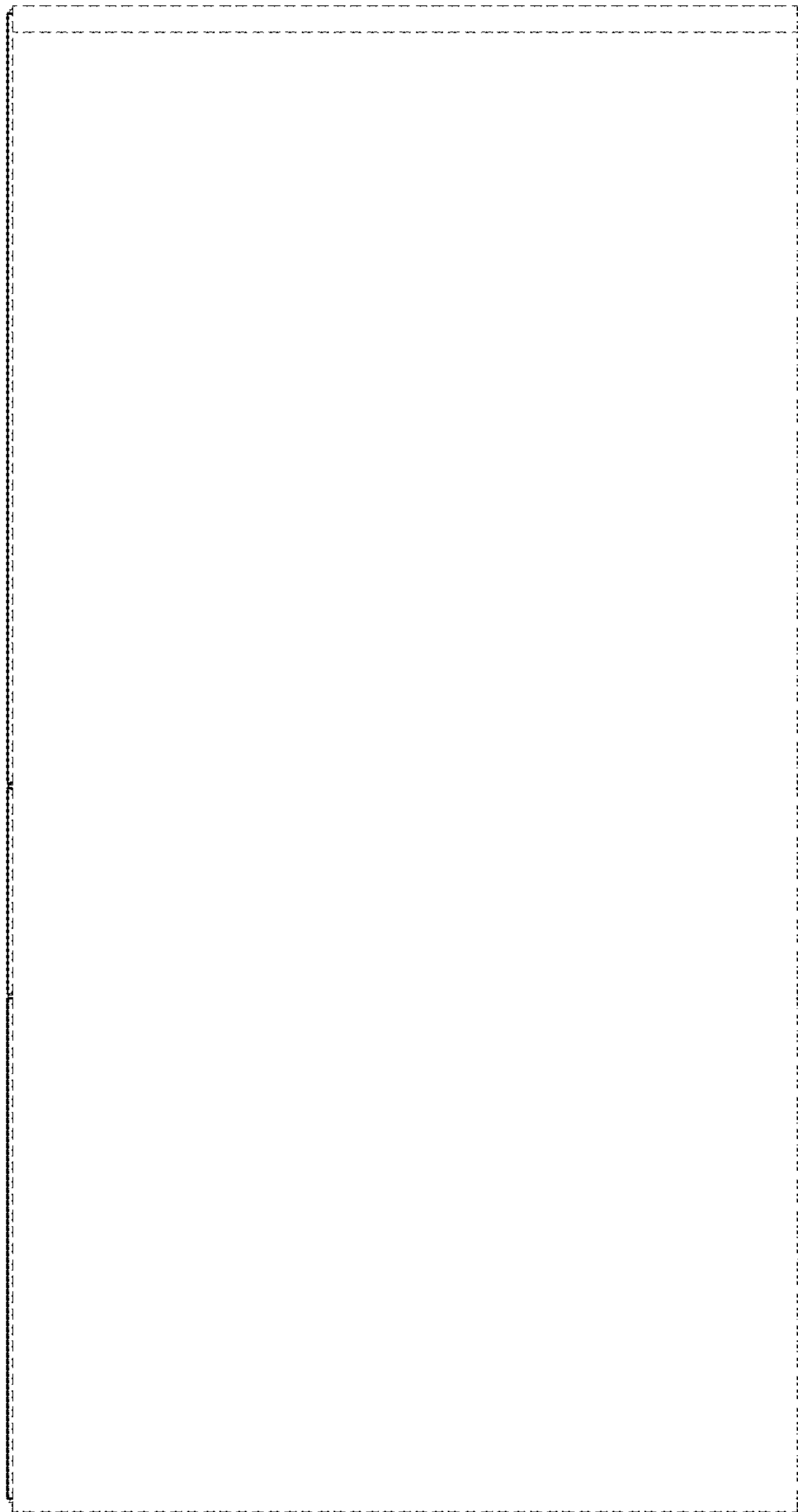

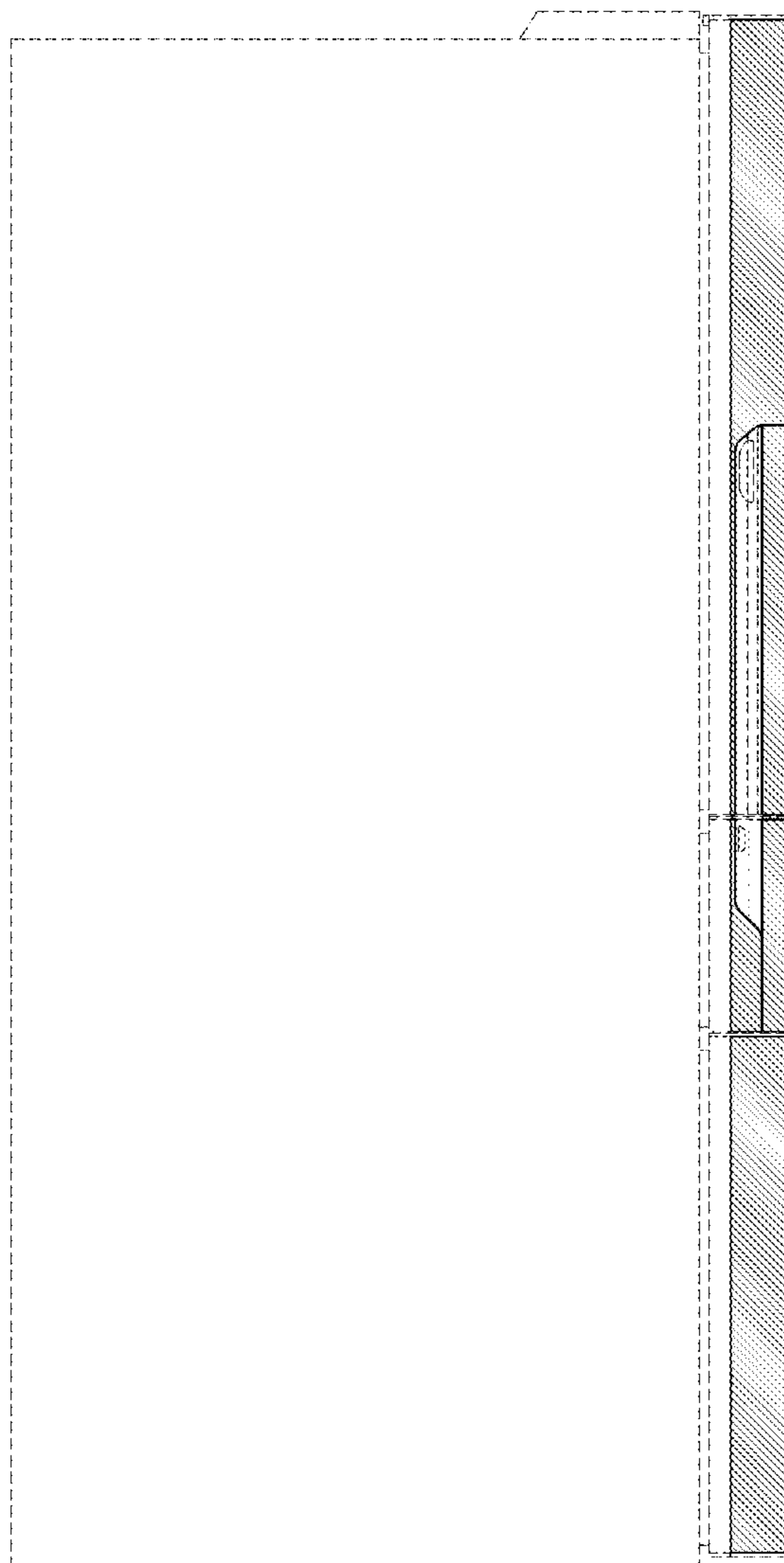

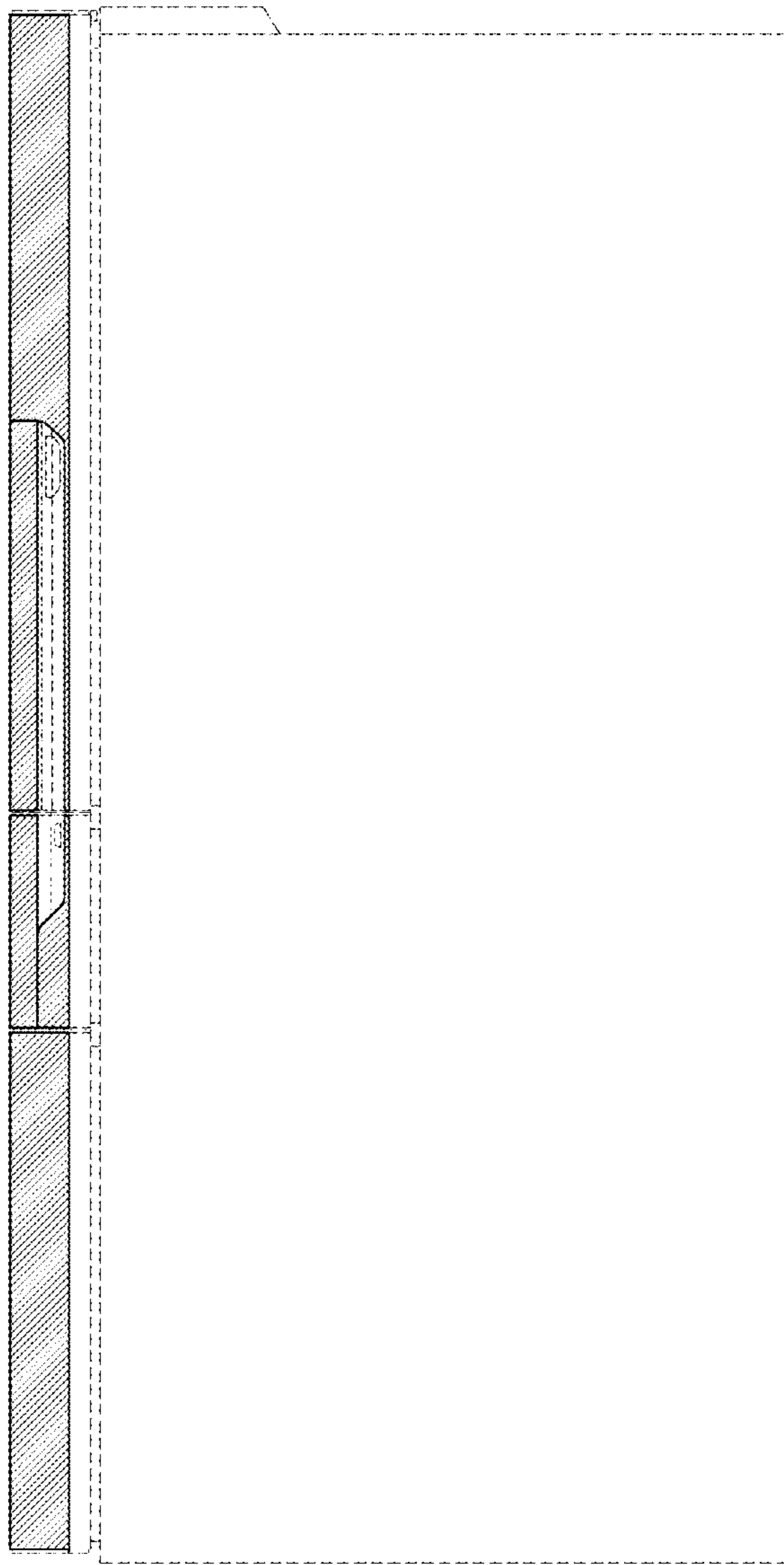

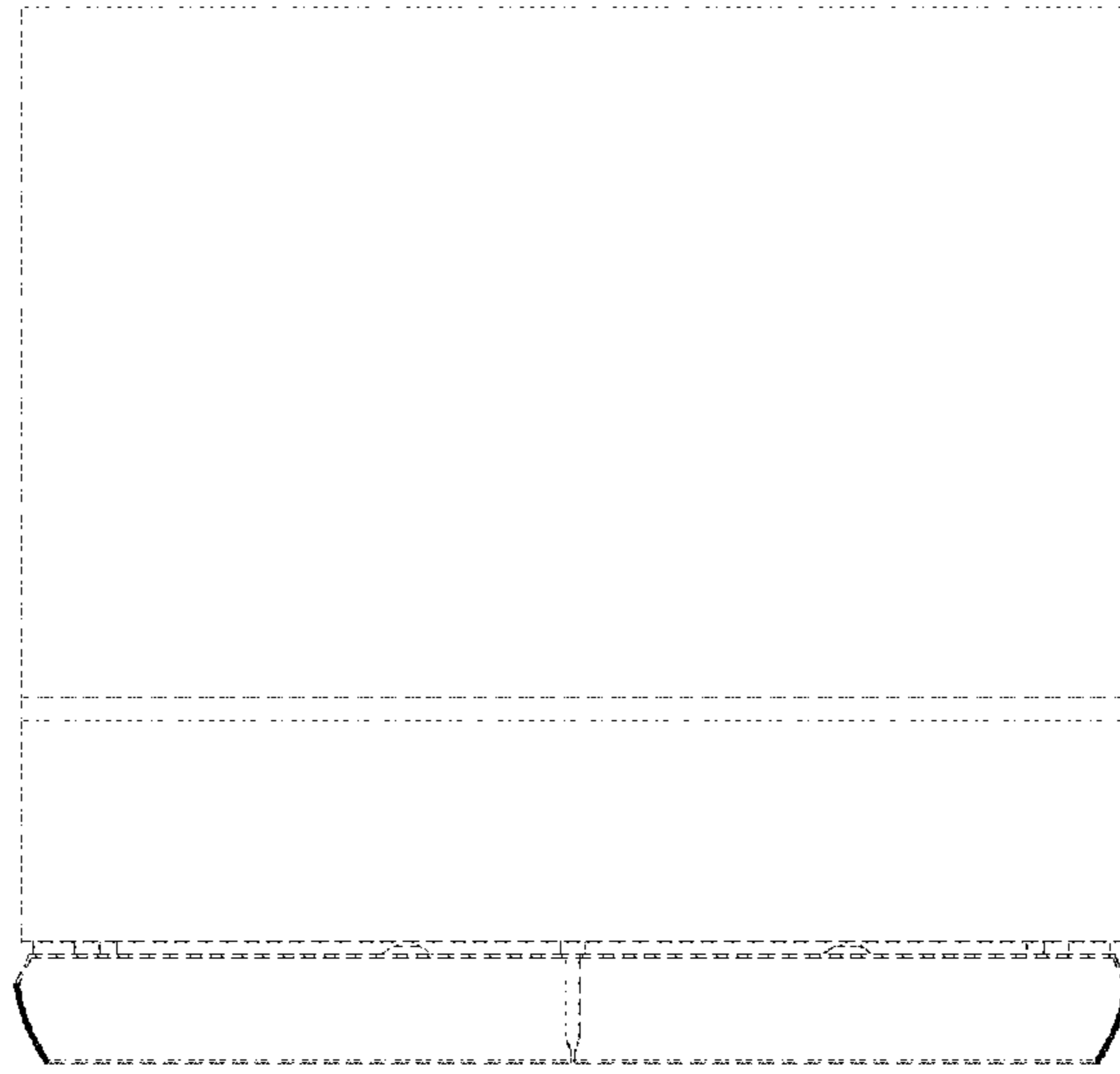
