(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a facelift wand, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an upper plan view of an embodiment of a facelift wand.

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the facelift wand of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the facelift wand of FIGS. 1-2.

FIG. 4 is a lower plan view of the facelift wand of FIGS. 1-3.

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the facelift wand of FIGS. 1-4.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the facelift wand of FIGS. 1-5.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the facelift wand of FIGS. 1-6.

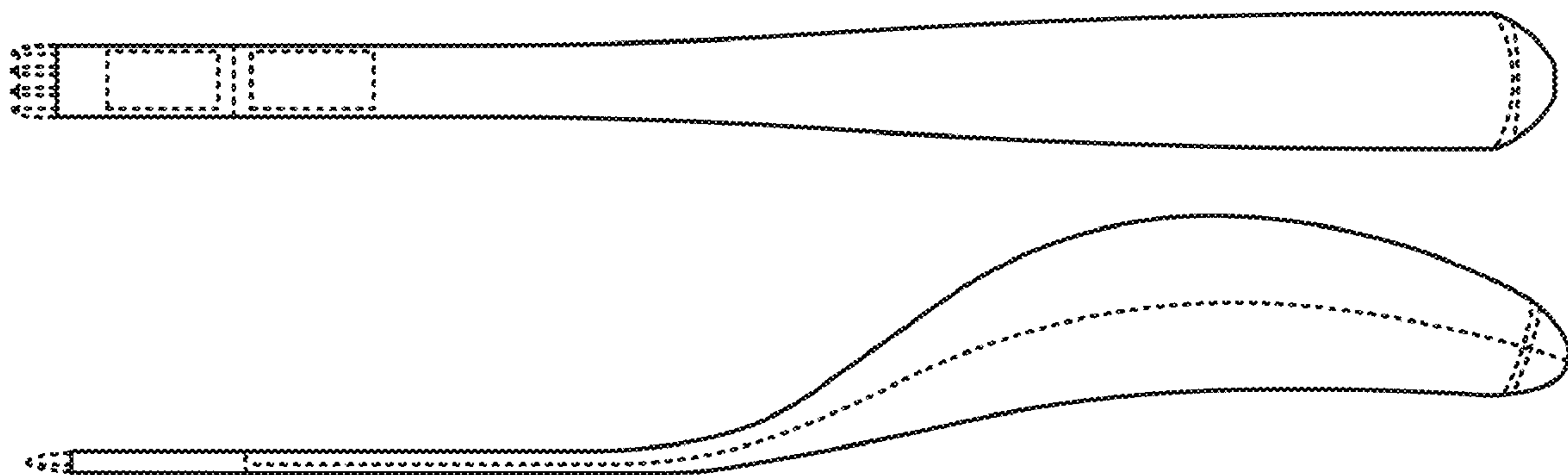
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the facelift wand of FIGS. 1-7, shown from the side opposite to that shown in FIG. 7.

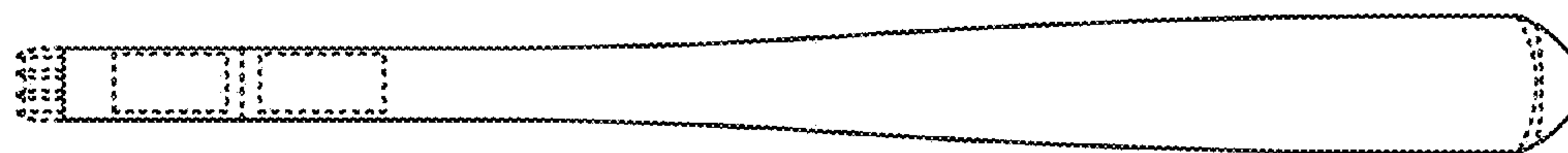

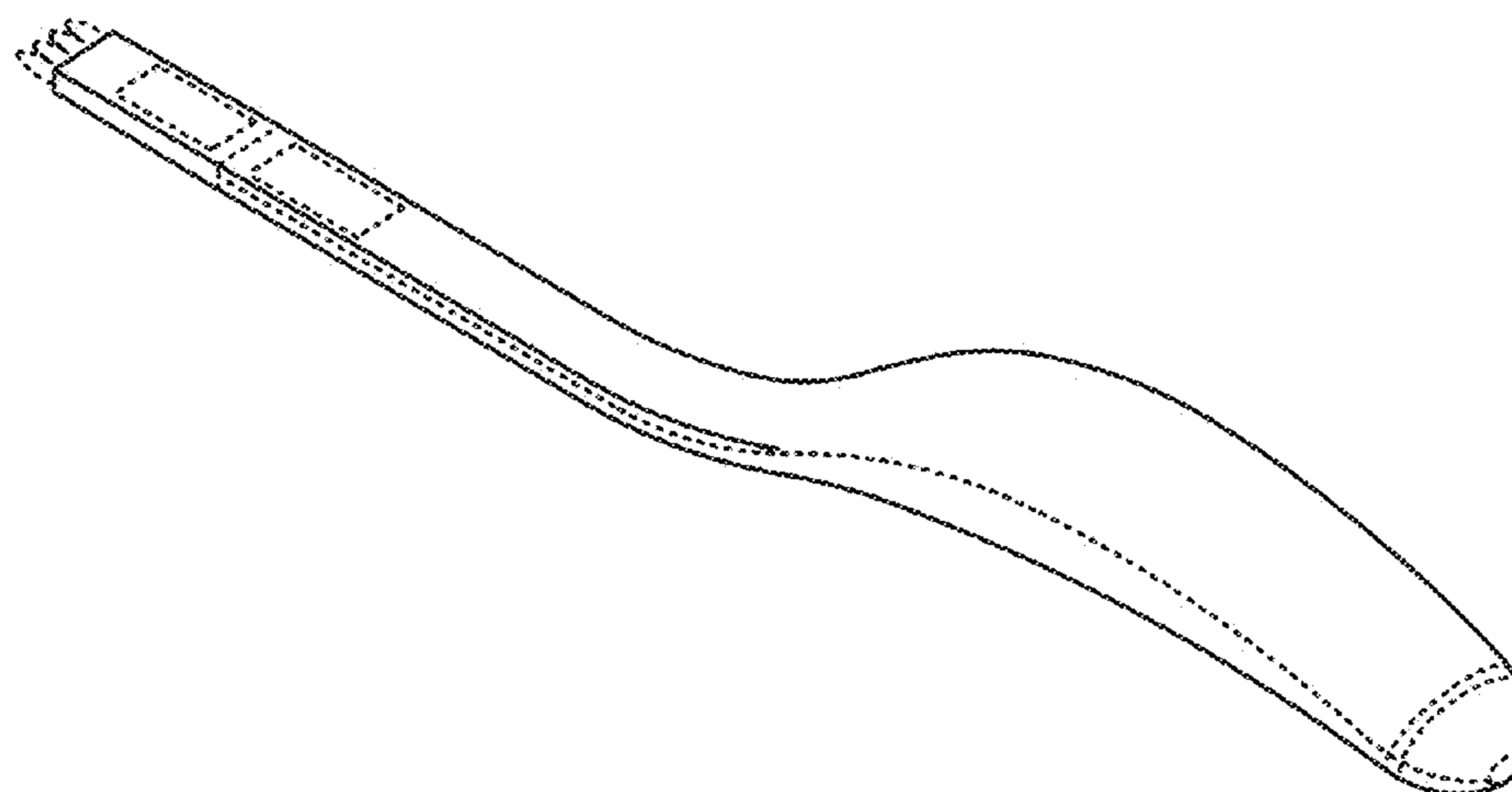

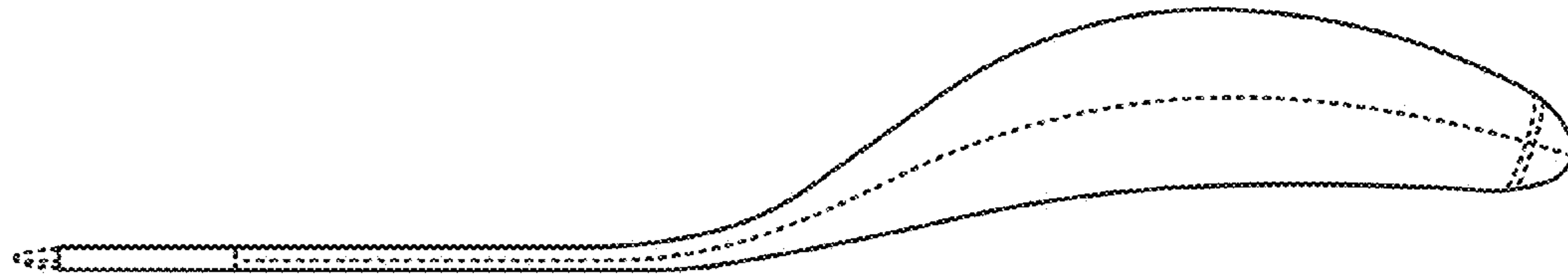

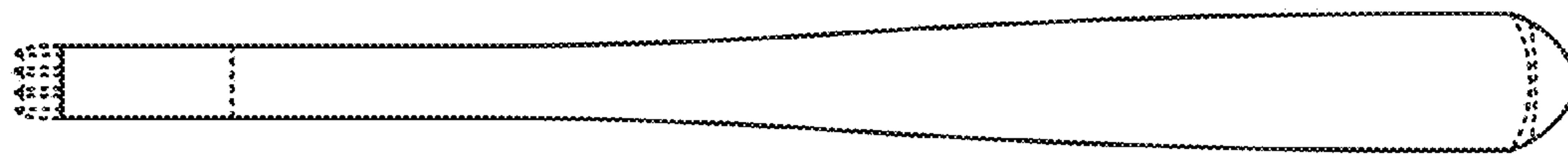

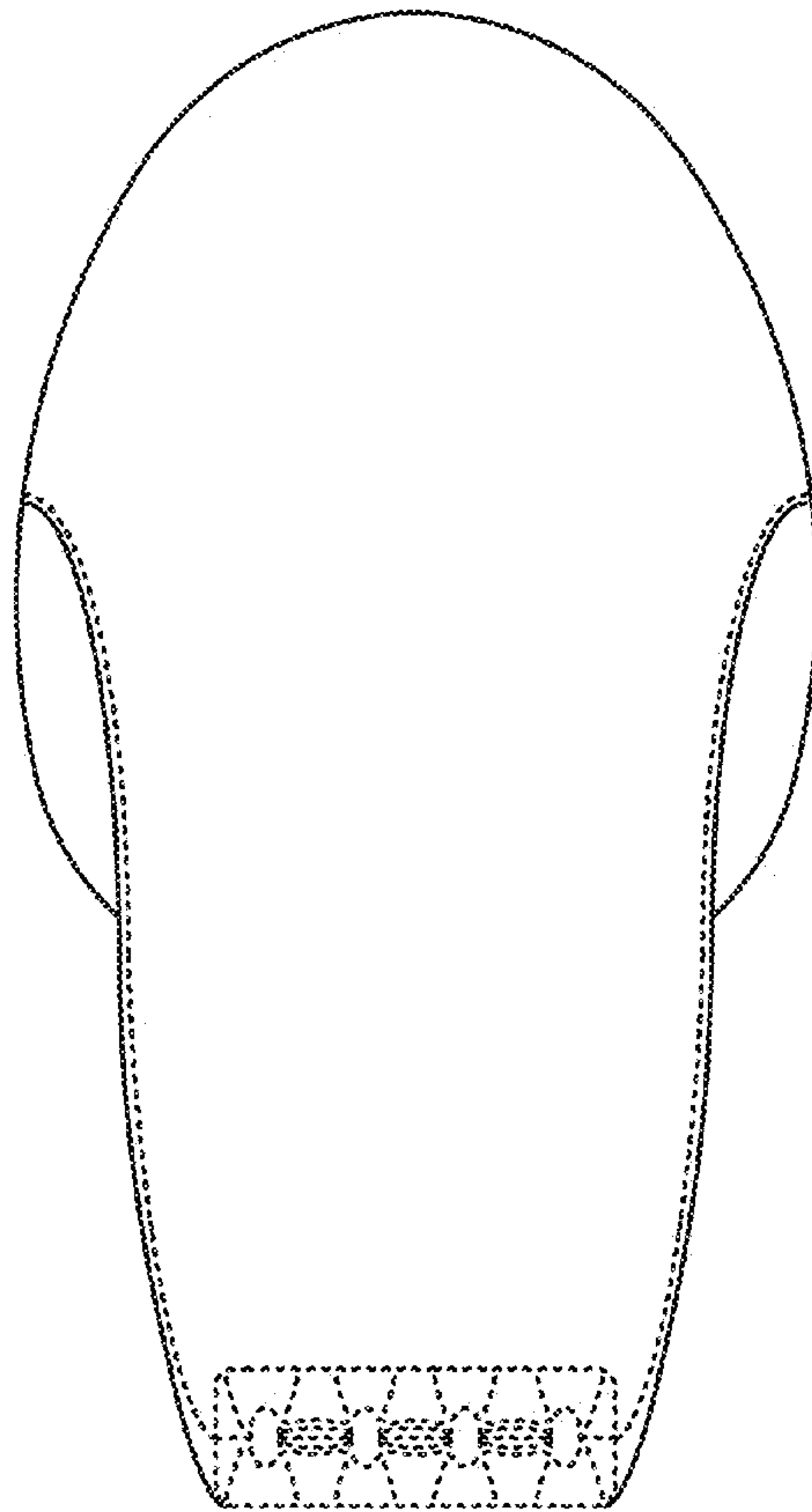

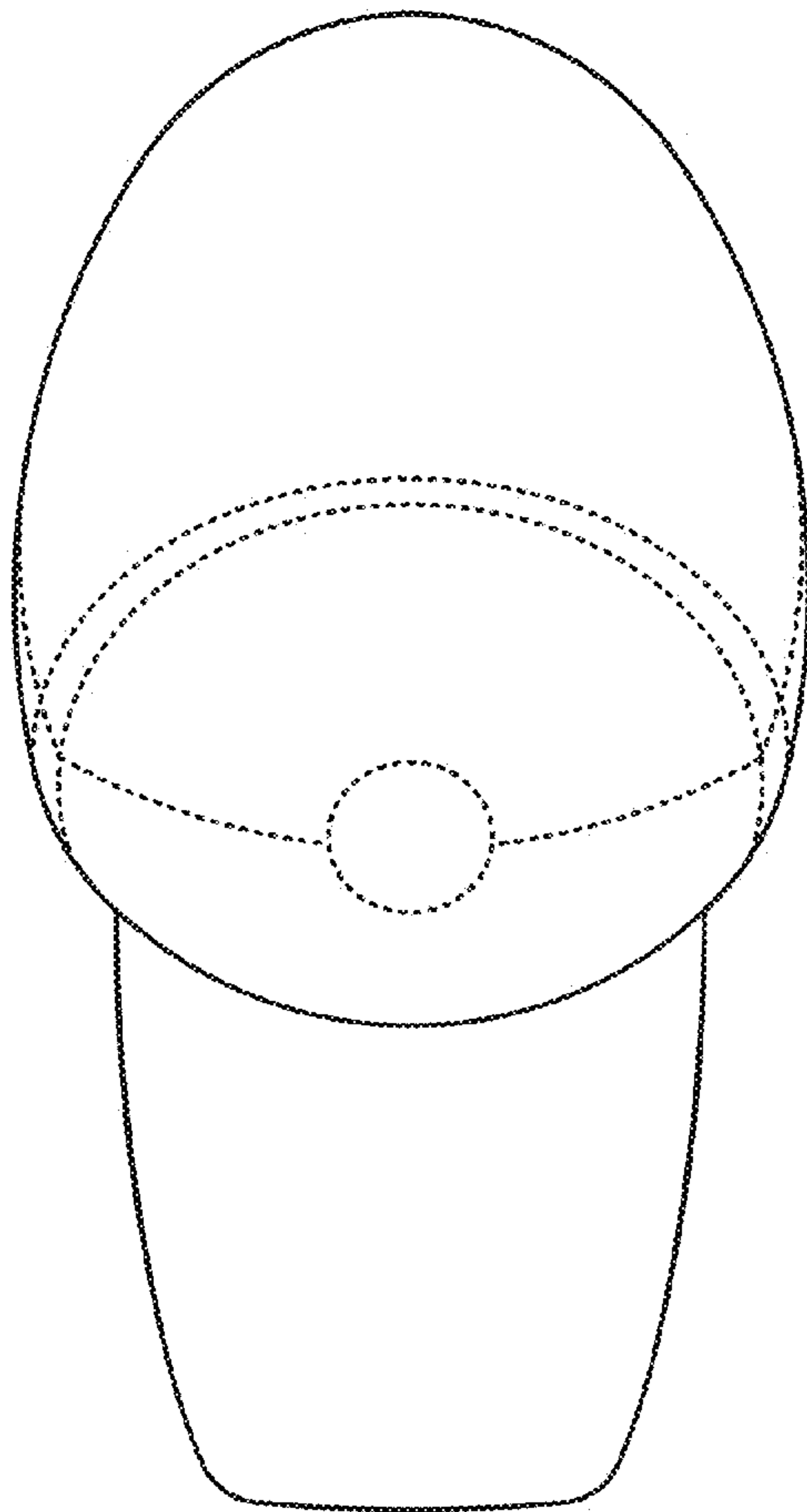

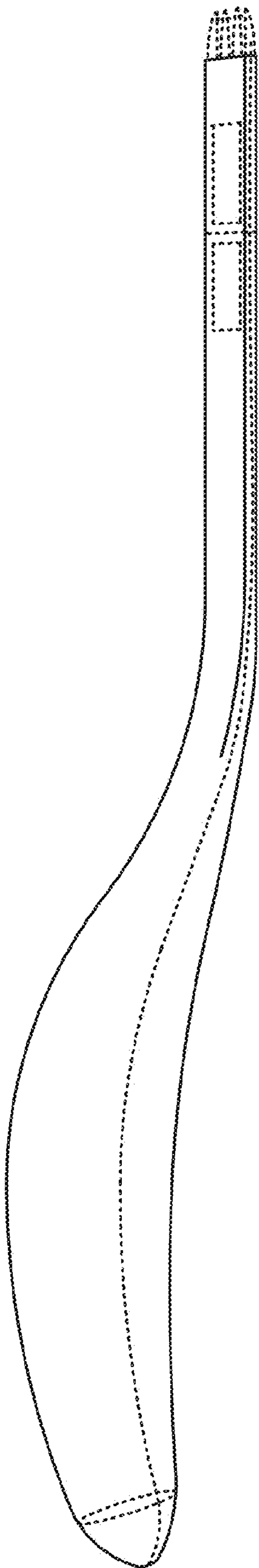

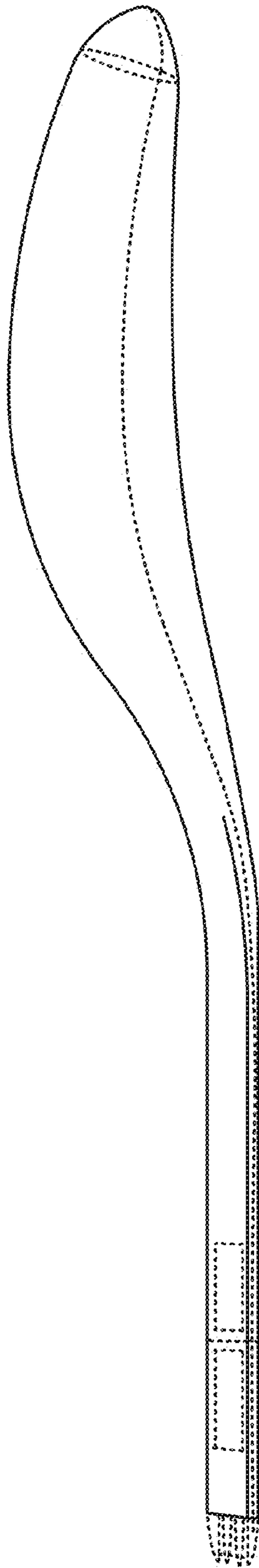

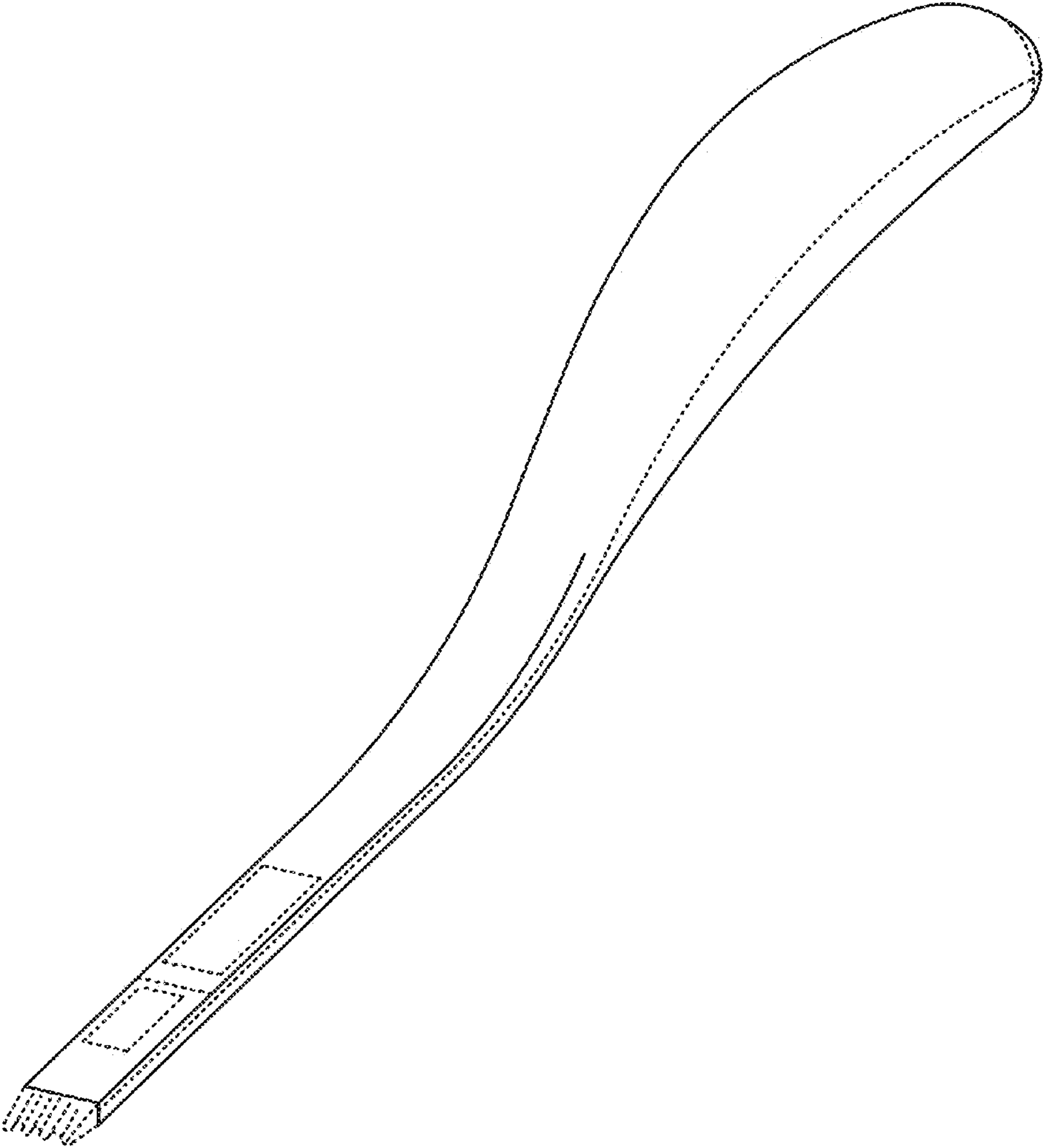

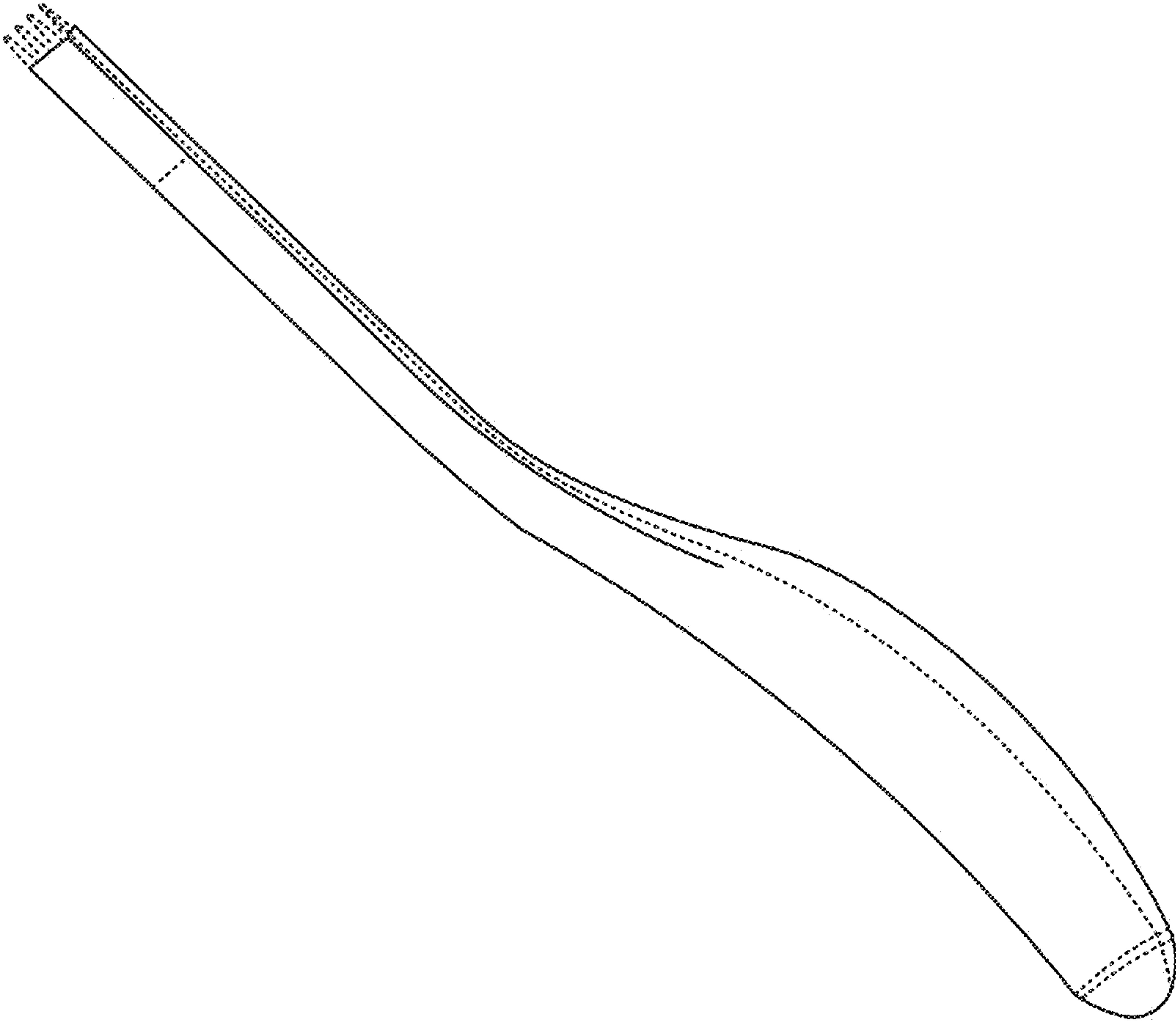
