(57) **CLAIM**

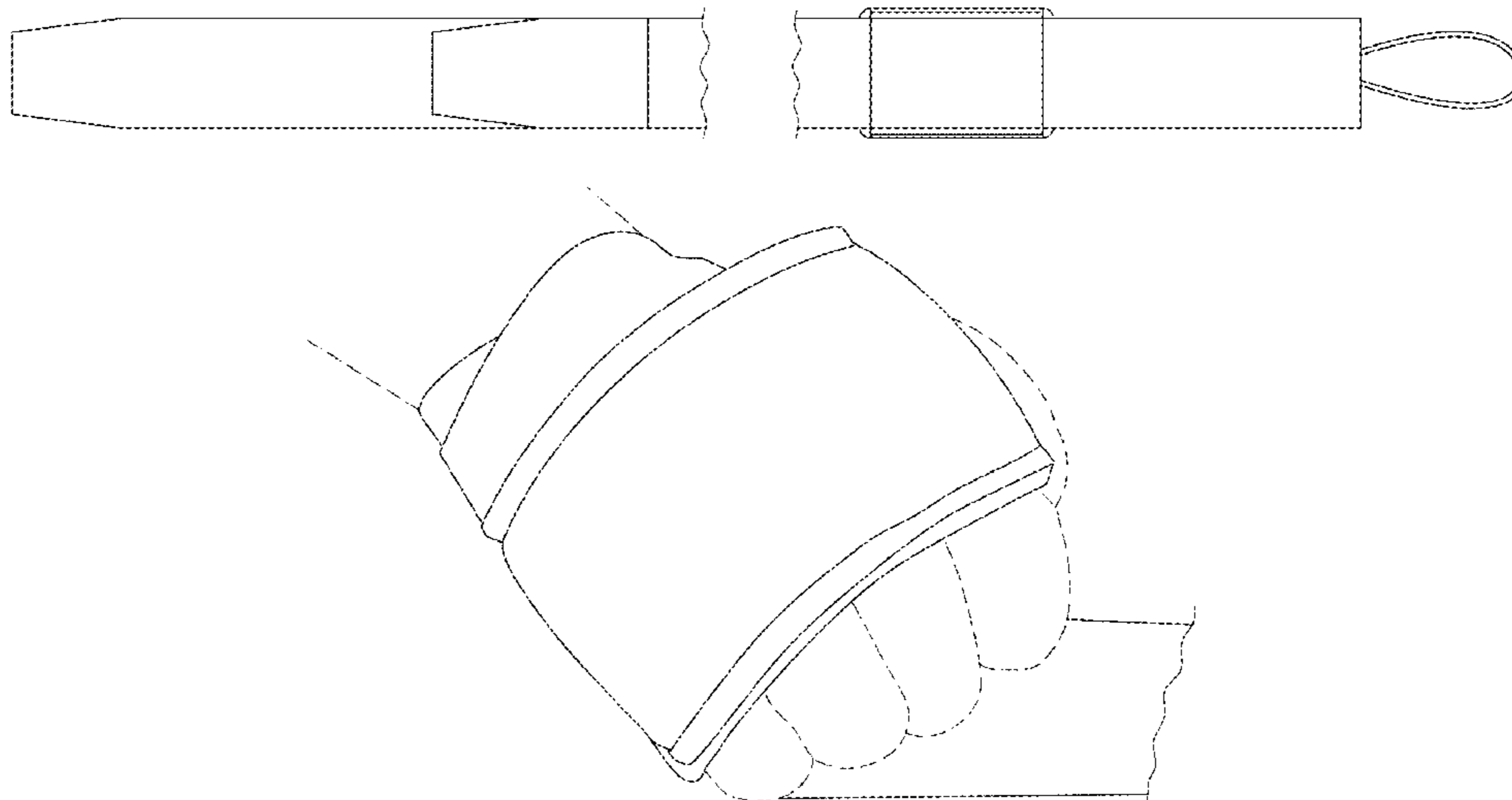
The ornamental design for a padded hand wrap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the padded hand wrap;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the padded hand wrap;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of the padded hand wrap, where the right side elevation view and the left side elevation view are mirror images of each other;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged back elevation view of the padded hand wrap;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevation view of the padded hand wrap;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged partial perspective view of the padded hand wrap being placed on a user's hand;
 FIG. 7 is an enlarged partial perspective view of the padded hand wrap being placed on a user's hand; and,
 FIG. 8 is an enlarged partial perspective view of the padded hand wrap in place on a user's hand.

The broken-away symbols in the drawings indicate that any portion of the article beyond what is shown forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines showing a human hand in FIGS. 6-8 illustrate how the claimed design may appear when used. None of the broken-line subject matter forms part of the claimed design.

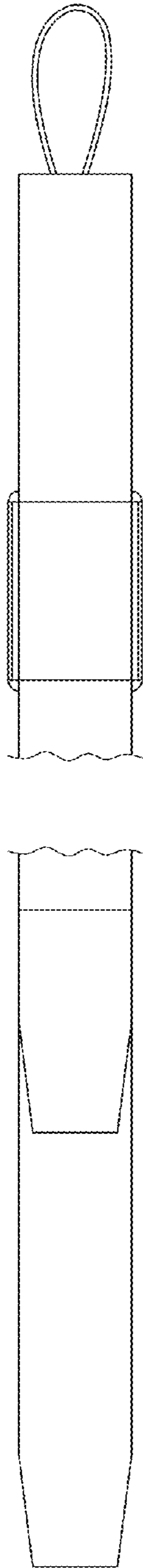

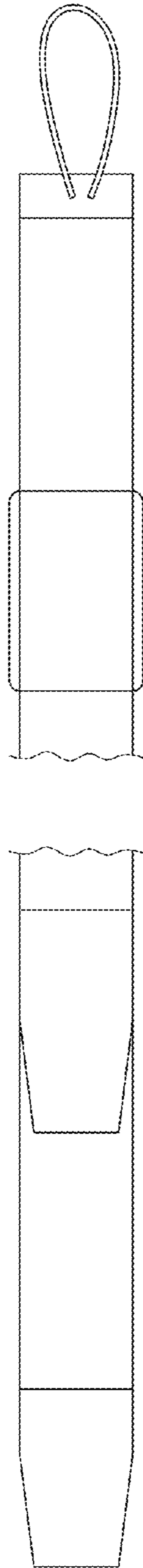

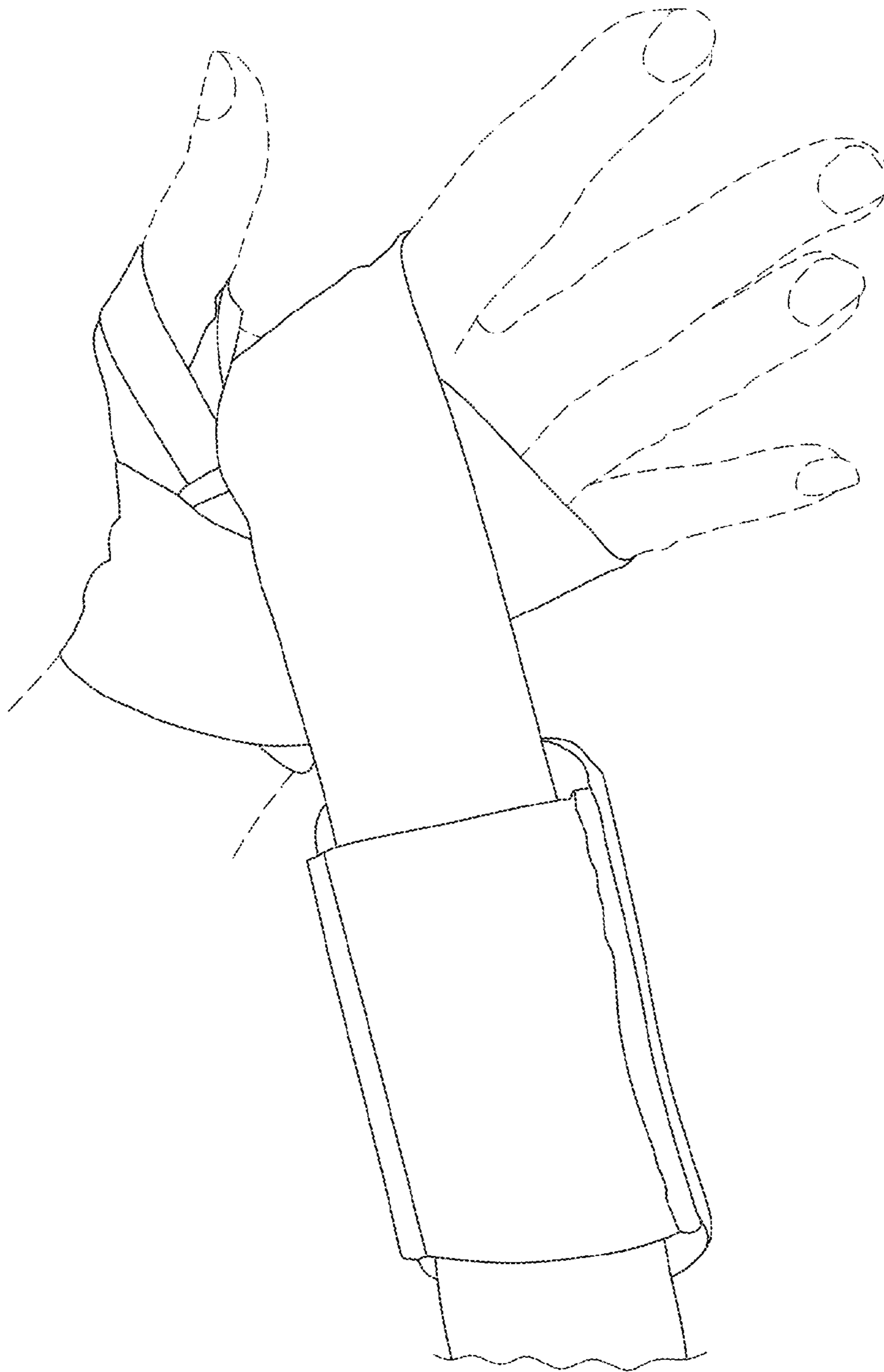

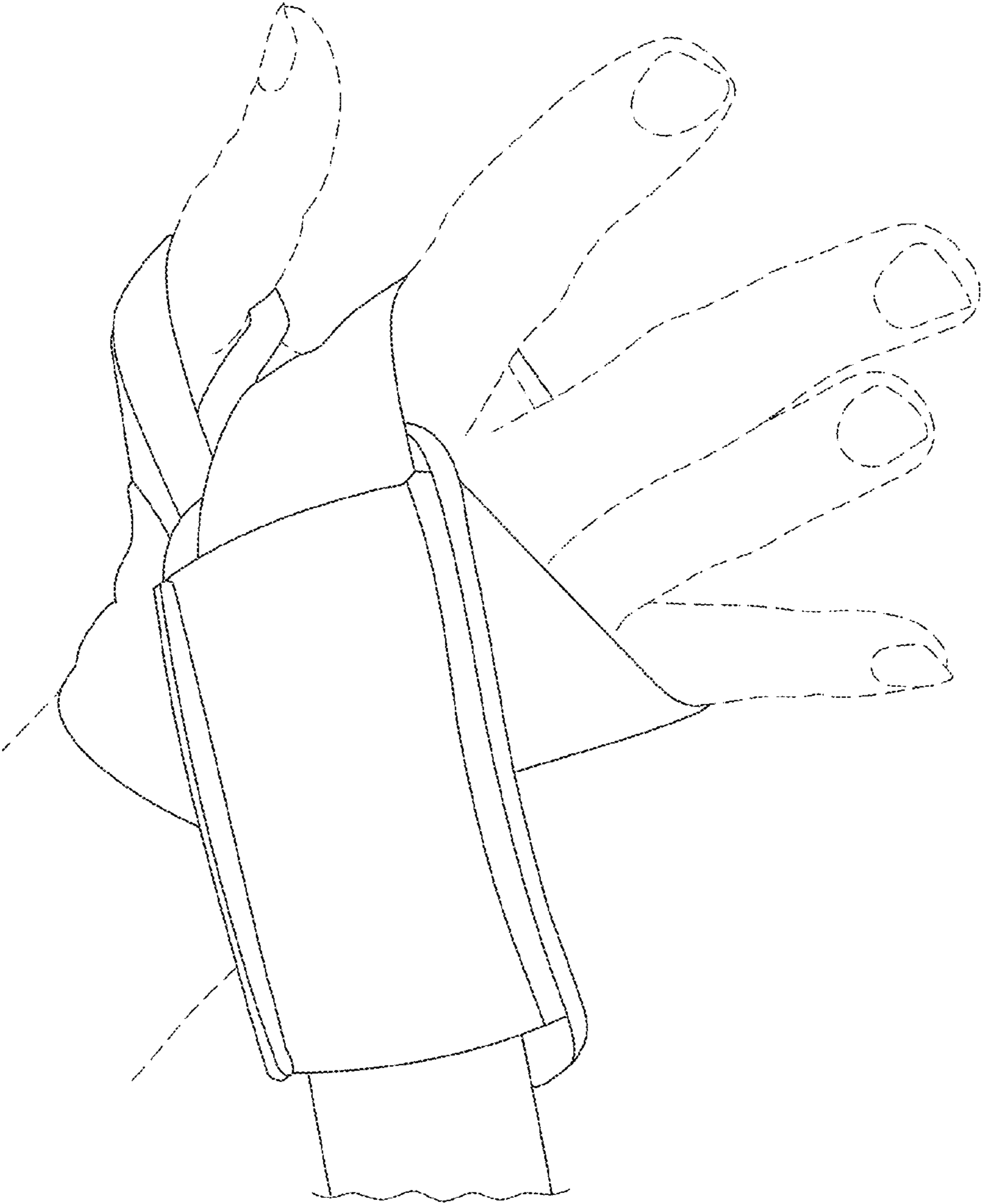

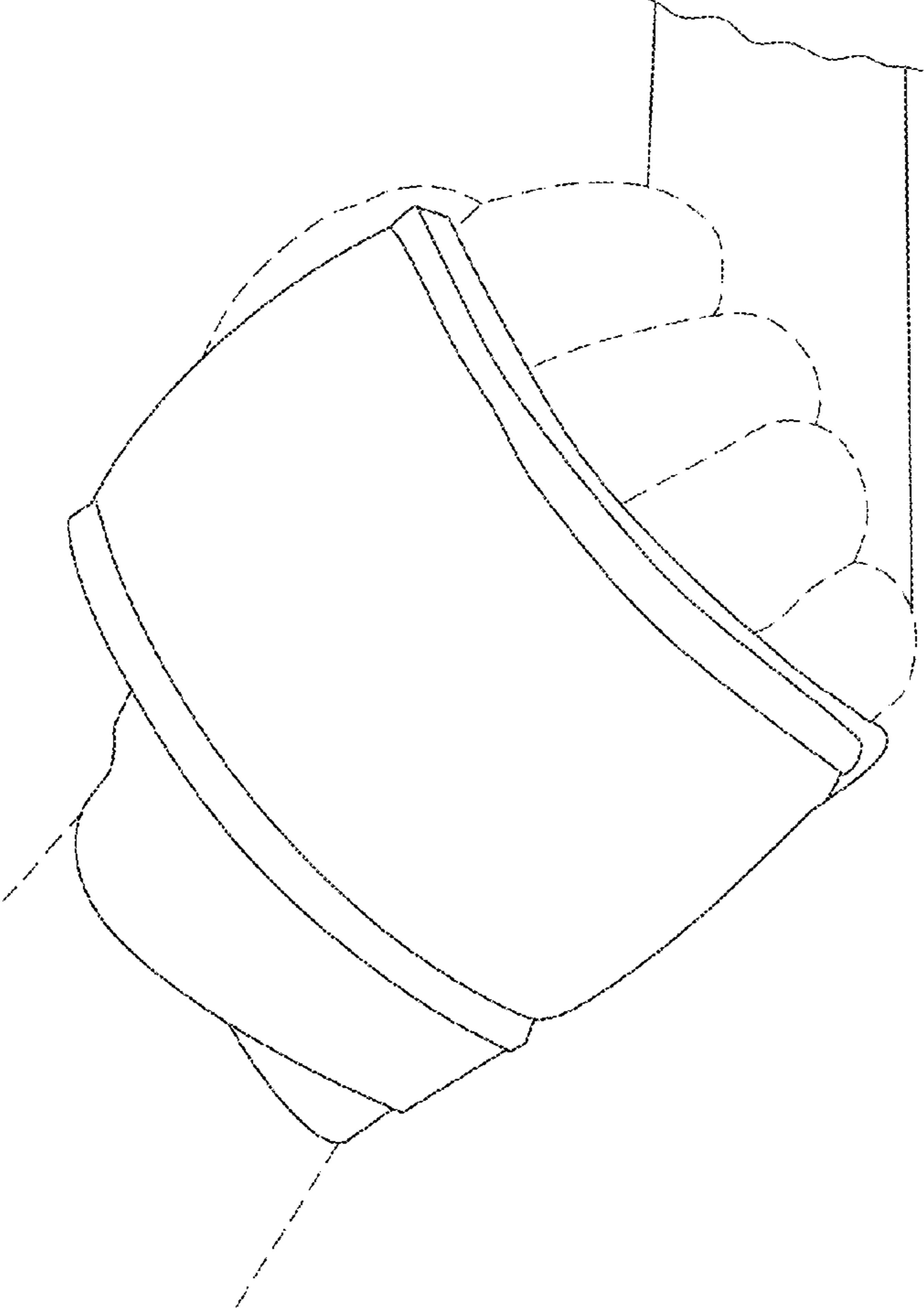
