luggage bag;

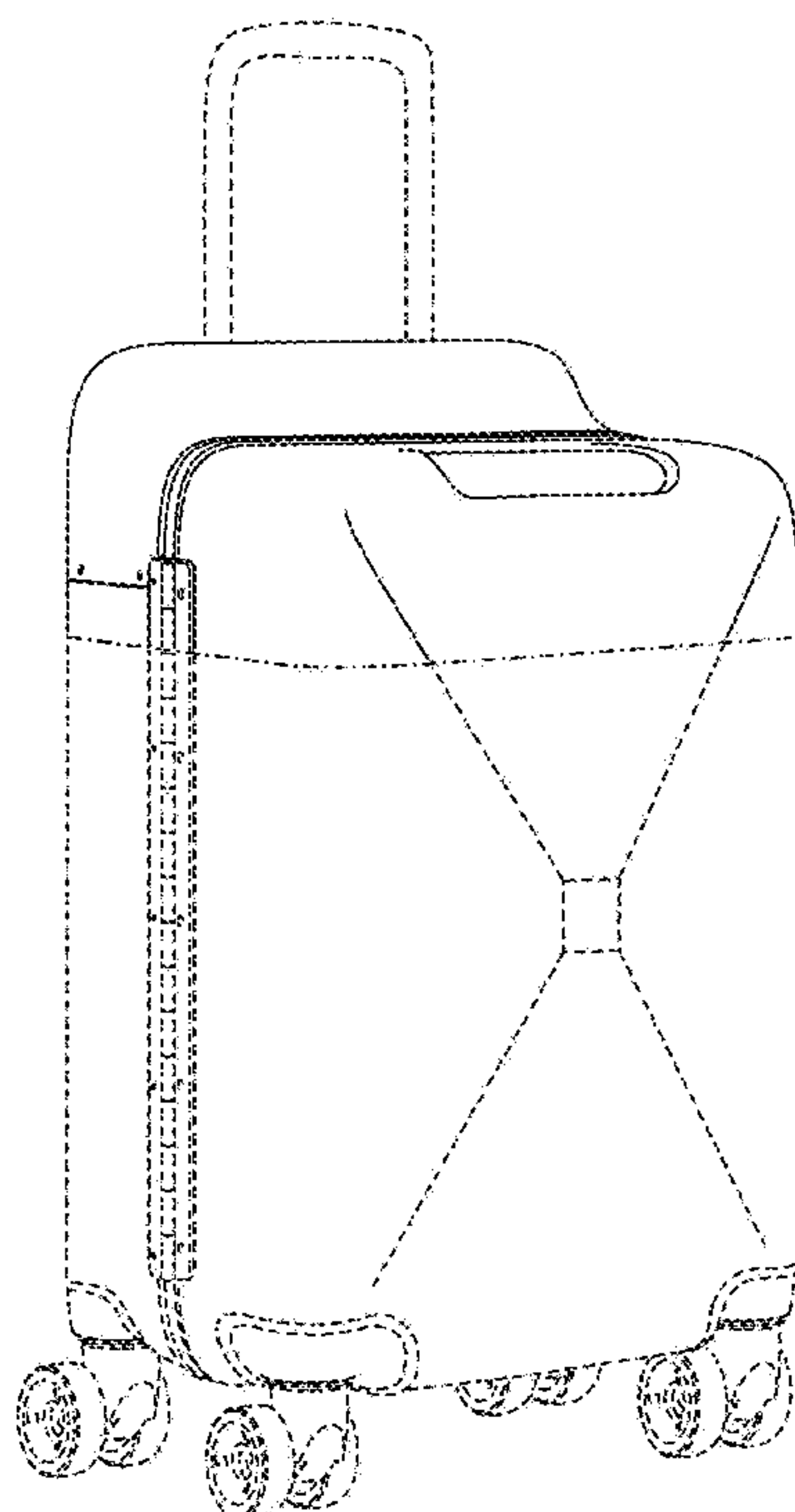
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the luggage bag shown in FIG. 1

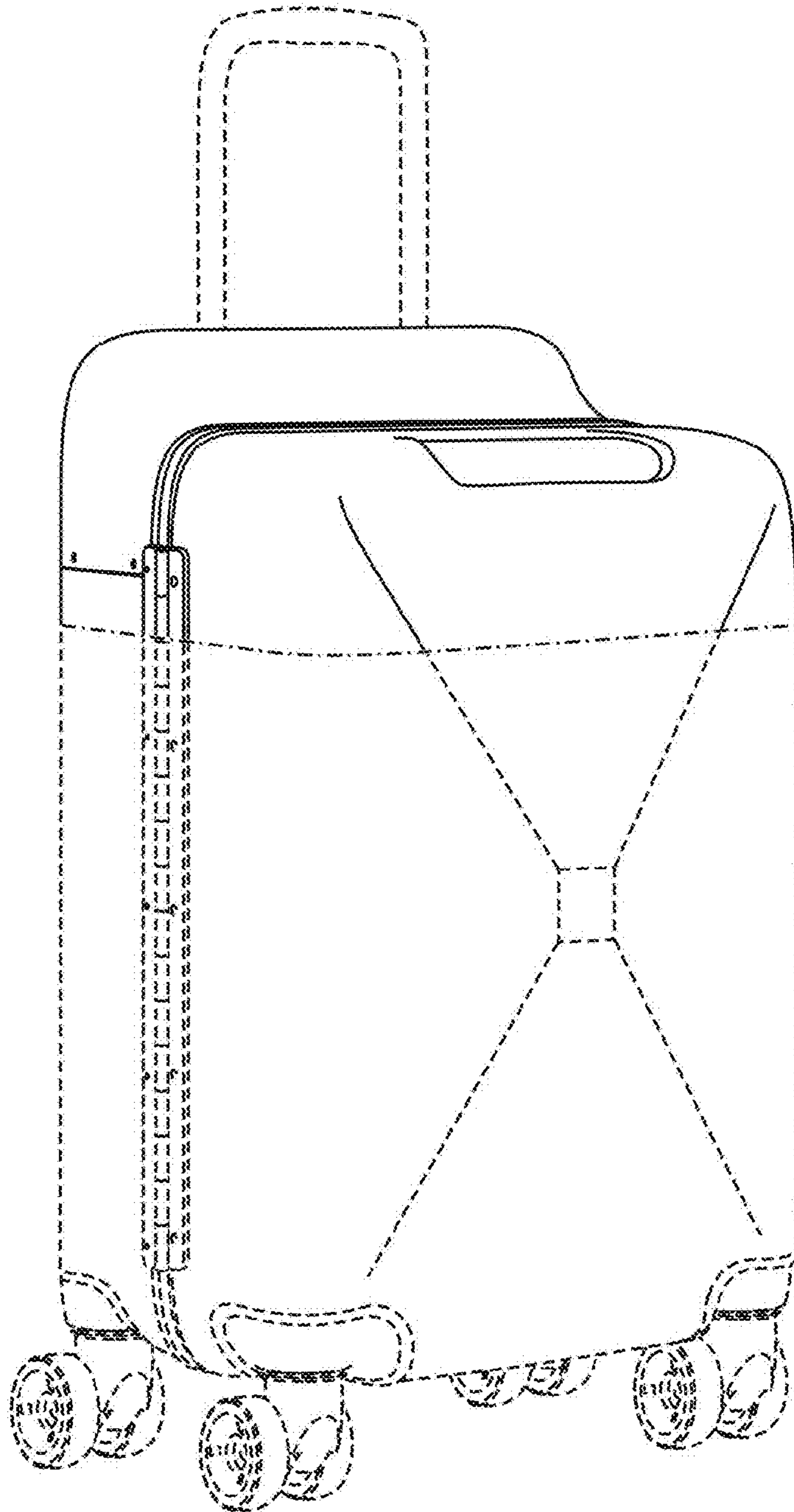

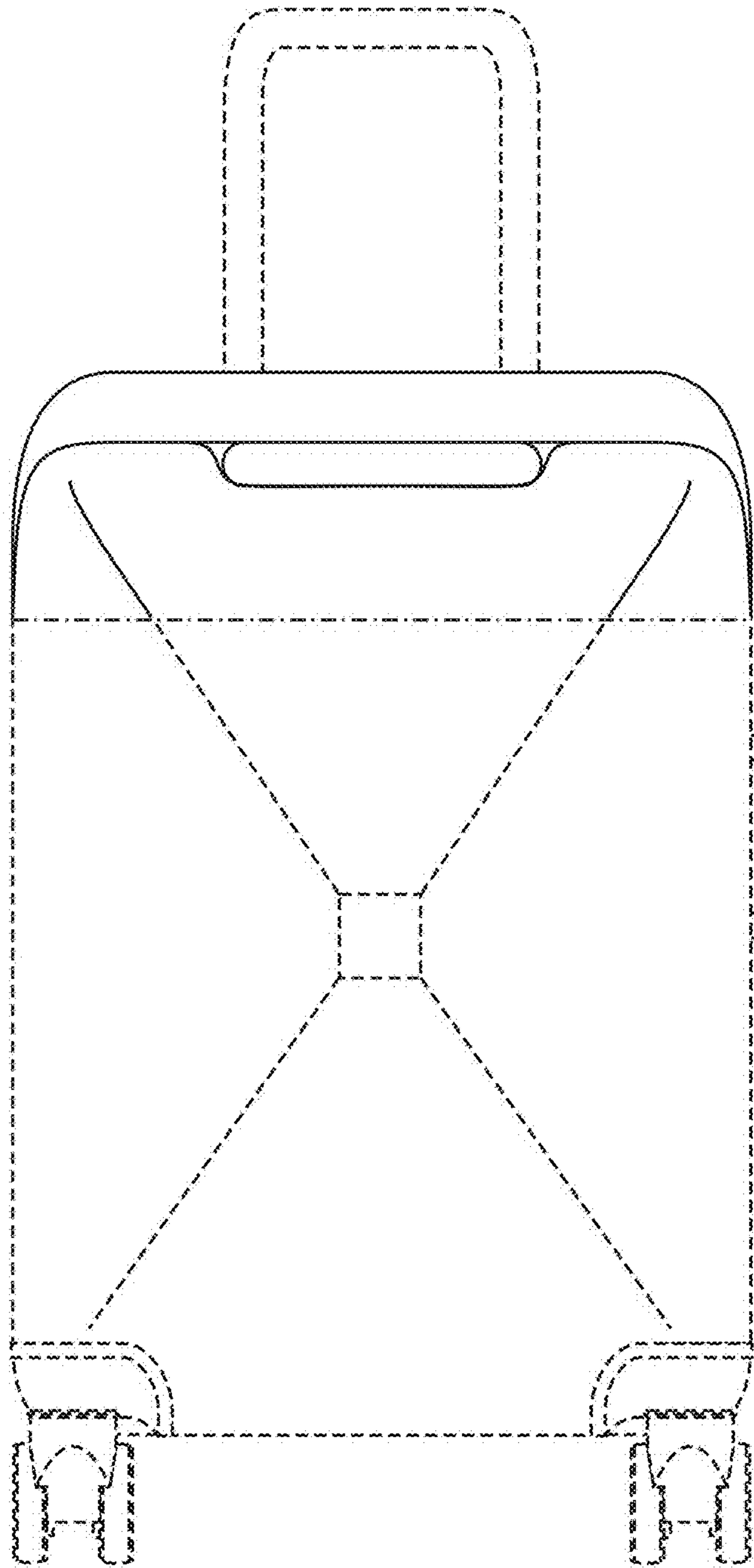

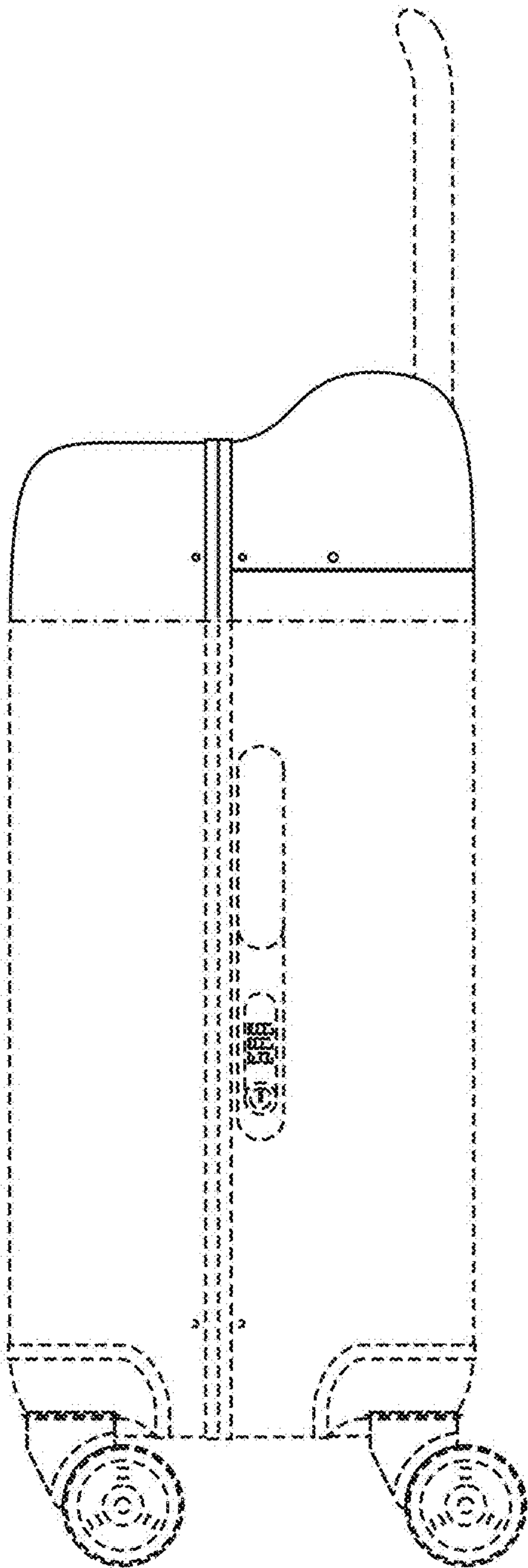

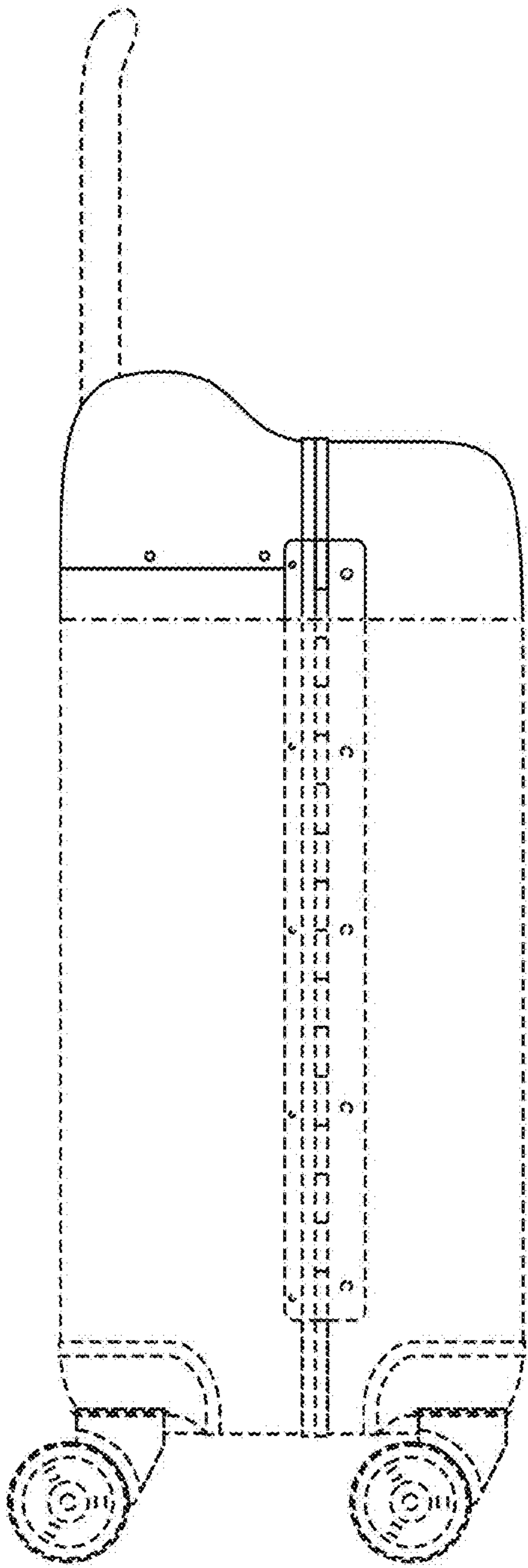

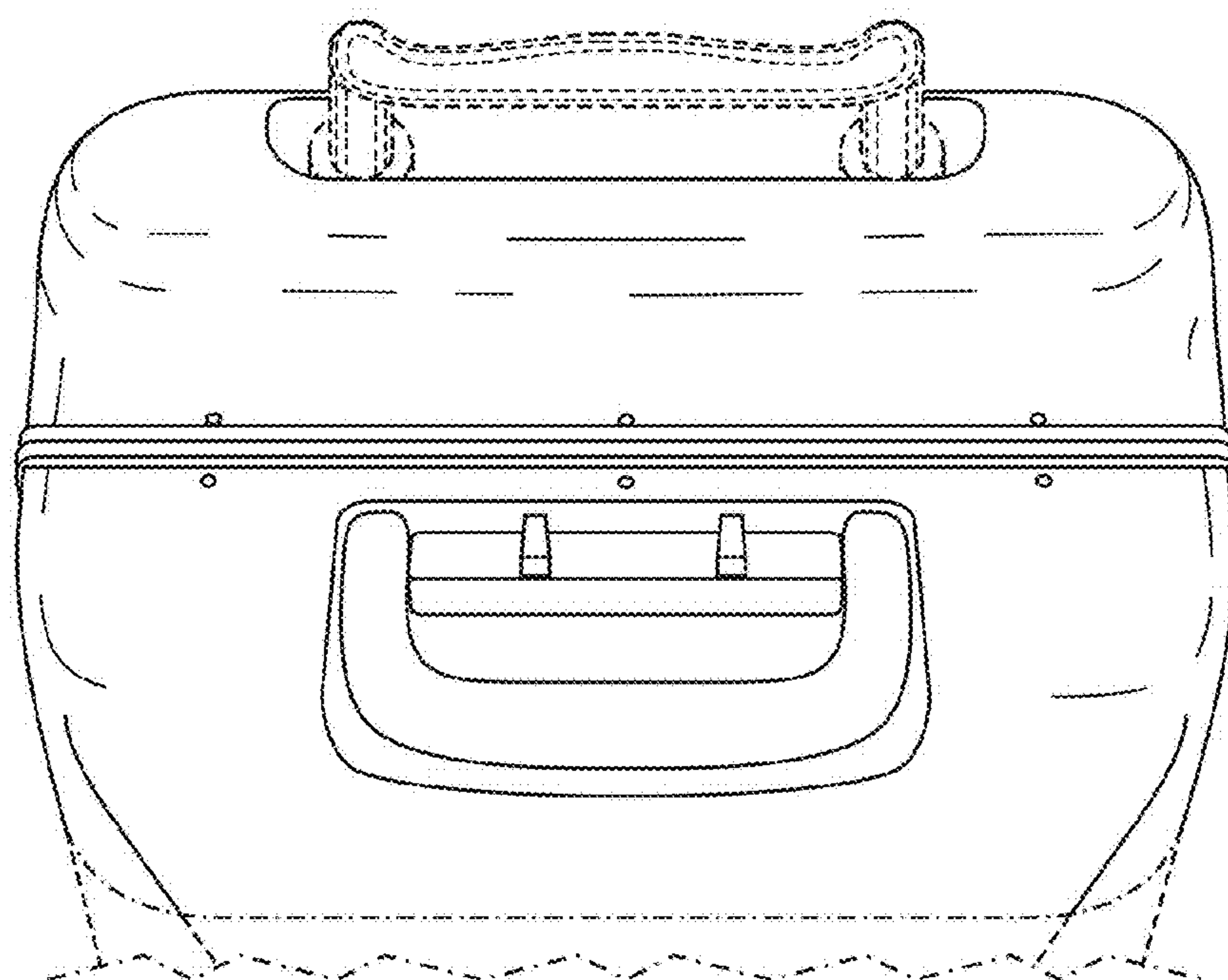
